Theatre Lac Brome celebrates 20th season

One of the sure signs of summer in Knowlton is the opening of Theatre Lac Brome's eight-week season of English theatre at Arts Knowlton. This year the company celebrates its 20th anniversary with an all-Canadian roster of plays, including an East Coast premiere and three world premieres.

The season kicks off this Saturday, June 25, with a one-night-only light-hearted "retrospective of the past 20 seasons and a sneak peek at the upcoming one." The evening begins at 7 p.m. with music by Stanley Lake and drinks in the marquee and on the pub side. The show, which will include slides from past years as well as comedic sketches and songs by Alex Paterson, Jane Wheeler, Laura Teasdale, Ralph Steiner, and others, runs from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m. The party continues with more music and drinks afterward. Tickets are \$50 and include hors d'oeuvres, refreshments, coffee and sweets, and the sparkling company of local theatre enthusiasts.

The four-play repertory season starts July 1 with the world premiere of George Rideout's latest comedy, *The Tall Girl*. Directed by Greg Tuck and starring Jo Jo Rideout and Laurel Thompson, this season-opener is a family romance with a twist, which tells the story of the meeting of a young woman's lover and her parents.

The season continues with another world premiere on July 8, of Montrealer Laura Teasdale's musical, *Honky*

The champions of chili

Chili, like barbecue, is a dish that has been adapted and revised — purists would say brutalized — into wholly different dishes that bear little or no resemblance to the original.

Think those first cowhands who patrolled the parched ranges of Texas used celery and beans and — god forbid — turkey in their chili? Not on your life. Their chilis, legend has it, basically consisted of beef — not ground but cut into small cubes — a few tomatoes, some wild onions and garlic and spice mixes that featured various dried and ground chili peppers as well as Mexican oregano and cumin. That's it.

Those legendary chilis have spawned a whole nation of chiliheads (www.chili.org) who travel all across North America to chili cookoffs. In late April, a chili cookoff at Eat! Vancouver crowned two locals and a Washington cook as chili champions. Judie Anderson of Olympia, Wash., took first place while Fred Roycroft and Grier Goldsby, both of Port Coquitlam, B.C., came in second and third, respectively. The cookoff champs use powdered garlic and onions so they wouldn't lose judging points for "chunks of unknown things," says Roycroft, but you can certainly use fresh garlic and onions. No cowboy would object.

ANDERSON CHILI

2 pounds (1 kg) stewing beef, cut into 6-mm chunks
1 tablespoon (15 mL) vegetable shortening
1 1/2 teaspoons (7 mL) hot sauce
1 8-ounce (236-mL) can tomato sauce
2 beef bouillon cubes
6 tablespoons (90 mL) chili powder
4 teaspoons (20 mL) ground cumin
1 tablespoon (15 mL) onion powder
1 teaspoon (5 mL) garlic powder
1 teaspoon (5 mL) monosodium glutamate (MSG)
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) salt
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) ground white pepper
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) cayenne

1 can beef broth

Cook meat over medium heat in melted shortening until meat is grey in colour. Add hot sauce, tomato sauce, bouillon cubes and water just to cover. Simmer, covered, 40 to 60 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add water if needed.

In a small bowl, combine the chili powder, cumin, onion powder, garlic powder, MSG, salt, white pepper and cayenne.

Stir in one-third of the spice mix and add beef broth as needed. Simmer for another hour. During the last half hour, add another one-third of the spice mixture. Continue cooking, adding beef broth as needed. In the final 15 minutes, add the remaining and continue cooking. In the last 5 minutes, taste for seasoning and adjust chili powder, cumin and salt if needed.

ROYCROFT CHILI

1 1/2 pounds (750 g) inside round roast, cut into 6-mm cubes
Vegetable oil
1 can low-sodium chicken broth
1 can low-sodium beef broth
2 teaspoons (10 mL) paprika
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) cayenne
2 teaspoons (10 mL) onion powder
2 cubes each beef and chicken bouillon
4 tablespoons (60 mL) chili powder, divided
1 7-ounce (213-mL) can tomato sauce
1 teaspoon (5 mL) garlic powder
1/8 teaspoon (.5 mL) ground white pepper
1/8 teaspoon (.5 mL) brown sugar
1 tablespoon (15 mL) cumin
Juice of 1/2 a lime
Salt, to taste

Brown meat in oil in medium saucepan. Add chicken and beef broths, paprika, cayenne (more if hotter chili desired), onion powder, beef and chicken bouillon cubes and 1 tablespoon (15 mL) chili powder. Bring to a boil and simmer, covered, for 1 1/2 hours or until meat is tender. Add water if needed. Add tomato sauce, garlic, white pepper, brown sugar and remaining chili powder. Simmer for 20 minutes. Add cumin and salt to taste.

Just before serving, add lime juice.

GOLDSBY CHILI

2 1/2 pounds (1.25 kg) eye of round roast, cubed into 9-mm pieces
1 tablespoon (15 mL) vegetable shortening
1 15-ounce (443-mL) can chicken broth
1 tablespoon (15 mL) chili powder
1 teaspoon (5 mL) cumin
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) cayenne
6 tablespoons (90 mL) chili powder
1 tablespoon (15 mL) paprika
1 tablespoon (15 mL) garlic powder
1 tablespoon (15 mL) onion powder
1 tablespoon (15 mL) cumin
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) cayenne
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) ground white pepper
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) salt
1 15-ounce (443-mL) can beef broth
1 15-ounce (443-mL) can chicken broth
1 8-ounce (236-mL) can tomato sauce
1 teaspoon (5 mL) brown sugar

1 teaspoon (5 mL) cumin
1 teaspoon (5 mL) chili powder
1 beef-bouillon cube
Water

Melt shortening and brown the meat in hot pan. Add chicken broth, chili powder, cumin, cayenne and salt to taste. Simmer for 30 to 40 minutes or until tender.

Mix second amount of chili powder, cumin, paprika, onion, garlic, pepper and salt and divide in half. Add chicken and beef broths and tomato sauce to pot. Bring to a gentle boil and add half the spice mix. Simmer for 30 minutes, then add the second half of the spice mix. Cook for another 30 minutes. The sauce should start to thicken by this time. Turn off the heat, cover pot and let sit for 30 minutes to allow spices to marry with the meat.

Reheat chili and add brown sugar, and third amount of cumin and chili powder. Adjust thickness with water and cook another 5 minutes.

Rhubarb isn't just for pairing with strawberries

We're so busy chopping it into pies and cobblers and crisps that it's easy to forget rhubarb is actually a vegetable. Or that it can survive without strawberry.

This early arrival on the local produce scene is almost unbearably sour on its own. But sweetened with sugar, honey or fruit juice, its sharpness offers an interesting tang to jams, chutneys, desserts, even drinks.

Instead of the ubiquitous pairing with strawberries, combine rhubarb with pears, raspberries or peaches.

When buying rhubarb, choose only bright pink-red stalks that are crisp and firm and free of blemishes. To prepare rhubarb stalks, it's best to remove the stringy surface fibres, as with celery. And stay away from the leaves — they're toxic.

For a thirst-quenching summer drink, try iced rhubarb tea. In a large,

heavy saucepan combine 4 cups (1 L) of water with 4 cups (1 L) of diced rhubarb. Bring to a boil, then simmer until very tender, about 20 minutes. Strain and add the juice of one lemon and 3/4 cup (175 mL) sugar (more or less, to taste). Cool well and serve over ice in tall glasses.

Rhubarb and ginger is another interesting combination. This variation of a recipe for rhubarb-ginger jam from epicurious.com is simple. Combine 4 cups

(1 L) diced rhubarb with 2 1/2 cups (625 mL) sugar, 6 tablespoons (90 mL) chopped crystallized ginger and 2 teaspoons (10 mL) grated lemon peel in a medium saucepan. Stir over medium-high heat until sugar dissolves. Bring to a boil and reduce heat to medium. Simmer until jam thickens and mounds on a spoon (about 20 minutes); stir often to prevent scorching. Transfer to jars, cover and chill. Keep refrigerated. (This makes 3 cups/750 mL.)

Kuerti performs at Orford gala opening

The Orford Arts Centre will kick off its new season in grand style in a sold-out performance tonight featuring pianist Anton Kuerti, who has been both a masters teacher and performer at the centre since the 1970s, awing audiences in more than 25 performances.

Dubbed "one of the truly great pianists of this century," Kuerti has played in all of the great concert halls of the world performing with major orchestras in 40 countries, and sharing the stage with world renowned artists such as Gidon Kremer, Yo-Yo Ma, Janos Starker, and the Cleveland, Colorado, Guarneri, St. Lawrence and Tokyo String Quartets.

But the Viennese-born musician, who has lived in Canada for the past 35 years, doesn't confine his talents to major music halls. Kuerti has brought his music to more than 140 Canadian communities.

"There are so many interesting, and interested, cultured people who choose not to live in large, polluted congested cities and who have a great desire to hear wonderful music," Kuerti said Wednesday. "In larger metropolitan areas, people have the choice of eight or ten concerts a night where they can choose from the most celebrated artists in the world. They say they are going 'to see' so-and-so, rather than 'listen' to what they are performing."

Kuerti added that audiences in smaller communities are especially

grateful and appreciative of high calibre performances.

"We are fortunate to live in a country where we have a large number of high calibre concert halls," he said, commenting that the Salle Gilles Lefebvre concert hall in Orford is blessed with good acoustics. "We have a number of outstanding venues - more per capita than the United States which has a number of poorly-designed lemons."

And though Kuerti believes Canada could do more to fund the arts, he said it's an improvement over the situation in the United States where 'illiterates are attempting to stop funding public radio'.

"Culture is at the very heart of a country," Kuerti said. "It's nice to have good roads and health care, but that's not what people live for. They live for the things that touch them."

Kuerti will perform works by Brahms, Schubert and Mendelssohn at the Orford Art Centre's gala opening Thursday, June 23 as well as Beethoven's, Sonata No. 13 in E-flat Major (Op. 27, No. 1).

He will return to the stage Saturday, June 25 at 8 o'clock for an all Beethoven program which will include the popular Moonlight Sonata and Waldstein Sonata opus 53, composed in 1791 and named in honour of the young Beethoven's first patron, Count Ferdinand Waldstein.

This season, the Arts Centre will join in celebrating the 150th anniversary of the Orford County municipality.

Buck 65 branches out with new album

In his mind, "Stinkin' Rich" Terfry — the man behind Buck 65 — is about three albums ahead.

The Halifax musician, widely praised by fans and music snobs alike for his artful genre-mashing, says he takes a "chess-player's approach to (his) career — always thinking a few moves ahead." But for now, he's content to step back a little bit for Tuesday's release of his latest record, *Secret House Against the World*.

"This album is very different from most of the work that came before it," says Terfry. "My whole *modus operandi* is to sidestep any expectations of me and surprise people."

Speaking over a crackly phone connection from Oxford, England, the artist who many teachers said "doesn't work well in groups" says the biggest leap he took with this album was collaborating — mostly with artists he knew only through their music, such as D-Style and Claire Berest.

"I had a lot of new voices, female voices especially, which was important to me," he says. "I had to open up this really personal area that's usually kept

really deep inside, and suddenly there are people saying, 'OK, it's time to open up the deepest recesses of your heart!'"

And he opened them up quickly, too, a process he calls "an exercise in terror by design."

But while this all seems to add up to something completely different from his previous work, *Secret House* still has a very Buck 65 feel to it. Despite the fact that no song resembles his previous hit *Wicked and Weird* off 2003's *Talkin' Honky Blues*, which helped land him a Juno, there is a subtle hint of hip hop that wafts in and out of each track. The lyrics remain typically unfocused — whereas before he'd rhyme about the East Coast or his science degree, he's now moved onto alligator heads and busses.

"I think the lyrics tie the whole thing together," he says. "I tried to make it so that, from one song to the next, it might be kind of an abrupt turn, because I think that, as human beings we're not one-dimensional. If at any given time we're happy, it's rarely just that. We only enjoy it because of some undercurrent of sadness or something else that preceded it."

And he's not overly concerned about bringing his fans along for the ride — as he writes on the inside of his album: "I hope you like it, but it's okay if you don't." But this isn't to say he doesn't care about staying power.

"The records that mean most to me are the ones I want to keep for life," he says, "and I want my albums to last, to be rediscovered years down the road, to be one of the three records that people say they'd pick if they got stuck on a desert island."

It should be noted, however, this is coming from the owner of about 30,000 records.

"I'm an obsessed man in a lot of ways," says Terfry, who adds that the sheer amount of vinyl he owns is a serious burden on his nomadic lifestyle. "I have Japanese stuff, Inuit, Jamaican, everything. I could pretty much DJ anyone's wedding."

But he'll probably land better gigs than that. After recording in Chicago and Paris, living in New York and Montreal, performing all over the globe and heading back to Halifax for scattered doses of down time, Terfry is not only

an international citizen but an international hit.

"I've traded in my roots for an anchor," he says. "It can make for a good life, while you're young; I'm glad to be seeing the world."

The only downside is that, as Terfry gets more immersed in his work, he also seems to acquire more bruises. On his website, he writes about how in the past year alone he's been in a car accident, seriously cut himself three times and been severely burned.

"I think it's because I've really got my head in the clouds recently; I've become quite a dreamer," he says. "So while I'm off trying to think about words that rhyme, I get some guy on a bicycle hit me on the street."

But as long as these work-related injuries don't become fatal, Buck 65 will continue to innovate, whether through a rap ode to Johnny Cash or a poppy, bluegrass song about the Maritimes.

"If I challenge myself, that will challenge the listener, and that's what makes me feel best," he said. "That's better than a five-star review."

Nightmare Alley release cause for celebration

It's one of the most notorious movies to emerge from a major Hollywood studio in the late '40s. It has also been out

of sight for decades: because of a rights dispute with producer George Jessel's estate, its TV exposure was virtually non-existent

and it never had a VHS release.

But now the 1947 *Nightmare Alley*, which featured matinee idol Tyrone Power in a disturbing performance which had moviegoers fleeing for the exits, has finally arrived on DVD as part of a fascinating collection of film noir classics from Fox Home Entertainment. All the films — *Panic In The Streets*, *The Street With No Name*, *House Of Bamboo* and *Call Northside 777* — are worthy of attention, contain excellent commentaries, and are attractively priced. But *Nightmare Alley* stands in a class by itself as a noir masterpiece.

The film chronicles the rise and fall of a carnival hustler (Power) and is set in a seedy subterranean world of freaks and geeks, of the dissipated and the deranged, the exploiters and the exploited. Power's Stan Carlisle is the consummate exploiter — an oily opportunist who initially hooks up with a faded carnie medium (Joan Blondell) and her alcoholic husband (Ian Keith) with the ultimate intent of gaining control of the valuable "code" which is the basis for their mind-reading act. Once he seduces Blondell into giving him the secret, he dumps her and runs off with an immature circus performer (Colleen Gray) who becomes his wife and partner in a lucrative nightclub show. But then Stan starts making some serious errors: he falls into the clutches of a manipulative psy-

chologist (Helen Walker); he also believes he can get away with playing God as he preys on the vulnerability and despair of those who have lost love ones by setting himself up as their spiritual connection to the afterlife.

Power, normally a somewhat bland screen presence, crossed over to the dark side with this one and delivered perhaps his best performance. He had to use his enormous box-office clout to persuade reluctant studio boss Darryl Zanuck greenlight a story of unrelenting sordidness and to allow him to play such a creepy character. The picture was a flop. Those filmgoers who did attend were revolted by the story and by their beloved Ty Power's characterization. Fans were even denied the promise of redemption for him: instead, once Stan's world collapses, he becomes a hopeless alcoholic and ends up as the dregs of the carnival culture — portraying a pathetic "geek" who bites the heads off live chickens for the delectation of audiences.

The superb screenplay was by the legendary Jules Furthman (*To Have And Have Not*) and the director was surprisingly the patrician Edmund Goulding, best remembered today for *Grand Hotel*. The wonderful atmospheric photography is by Lee Garmes. A strange, unsettling and memorable movie.

Five questions with George Rideout

George Rideout has built a strong reputation for himself not only as a drama professor at Bishop's University for the last 19 years, but also as an experienced playwright and director. Many of his works are based on personal experiences as a child living in Austin, Texas, dealing with the family decision to move to Canada and life here after the move. Rideout has found an interesting and sometimes challenging way of combining various cultural differences that he had been exposed to with particular time periods in history.

George Rideout recently took time out from his busy schedule to speak with *The Record*:

THE RECORD: "How have you taken the cross cultural exchanges that you have been exposed to and turned them into something that you think an audience would enjoy?"

RIDEOUT: "Too often we register events and people only on a surface level and don't take the time to really understand the whys of it all. Life is an exciting cultural exchange that everyone can learn from. By creating a play that takes place during a period of heightened awareness, like the Vietnam War for example, seems 'to bring home' not only the differences in our culture but more importantly the similarities of it all. The upcoming production, which will be presented at the Lac Brome Theatre, has been described as a romantic comedy — based on the events and personal feelings at a time that everyone can associate with.... Bringing a new suit or home to meet Mama. This play, somewhat biographical, centers on a Franco-American love story, taking place just before the U.S. entered W.W.II, definitely a period of heightened awareness for everyone of that era."

THE RECORD: "What are the most important concepts that you try to teach your students about the theatre?"

RIDEOUT: "Working in dramatic theatre, you are faced with several challenges. You must try to understand what the author was really trying to say and be able to combine that with your own skills and experiences to create a character or scenario that will capture the audience's interest. A teacher can teach the basic outlines of theatrical production but it is the actors' own personal instincts that are the key to a successful performance. It is a fine line really... to cre-

ate a flow that will draw people into the realm of what's happening on stage, at a pace that will keep their attention until they leave the theatre, but will also provide something that will stay with them afterwards, making them take a closer look at what they have seen. In a play, it is understood that every character wants something, be it material or emotional, they all have a goal. It is not just the plot that makes a play successful, it is also the interaction of the characters, each with their own traits."

THE RECORD: "Did you intentionally surround yourself with people in the theatre world or did it just evolve?"

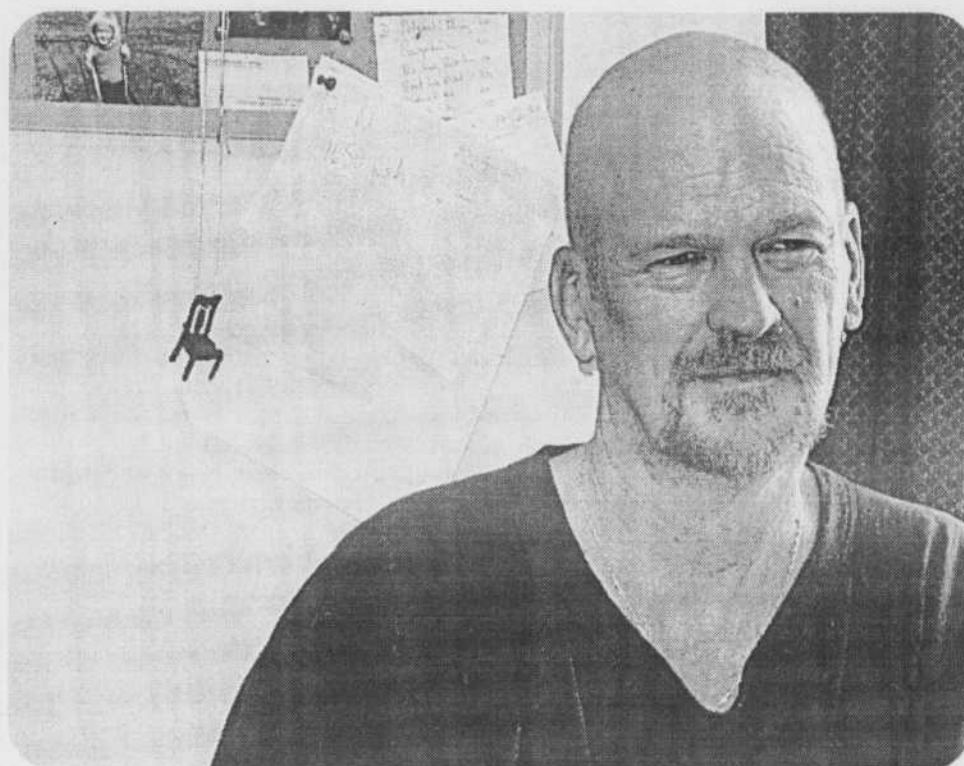
RIDEOUT: "I guess you could say that it just happened that way. Dramatic theatre has been a part of my wife Jo-Jo's world for a very long time. It just seemed natural to become involved as well. She has acted or at least participated in several of the plays that I have written. For a long time now, I have wanted to create a play that would really showcase what she and Laurel Thomson possess. I finally created a romantic comedy called 'The Tall Girl' which is a two-woman show. I'm pleased to say that it will be presented at the Theatre Lac Brome in July and August. I have always been interested in people and why things happen the way they do. The theatre is a perfect outlet for these observations."

THE RECORD: "Would you explain what you mean when you say that the world of art can be interpreted in many different ways?"

RIDEOUT: "Theatre is a written form of art. They are all collaborations between not only the artists and the medium that they choose to work with but also the active or passive role that is played by the audience or the visitor to an exhibition. While some artist use paints and colours to tell a story or recreate a moment in time, playwrights and authors use words, actors and characters in a play to relay the same kinds of messages. A successful playwright has to make allowances for the creative talents of each character actor to shine through, completing the image he is striving for. But in the end, it is the actor who has to make the audience identify with the character and want to understand more about him and the challenges that he faces. At first glance, people and experiences may be perceived as entirely different but upon closer examination, we find that they are actually very similar in nature."

THE RECORD: "Would you tell us

about the other fine line that an author/playwright must respect?"

RIDEOUT: "While the story line must be clear, there also has to be a careful balance of set-ups and pay-offs. It is important to remember that audiences like to play detective. If you make it too predictable, they will soon get bored. It is not good when people are heard to say 'Oh, yeah, I knew that was coming!' Equally ineffective is a script that is so vague that the interest of the audience is lost out of frustration. A series of insightful incidents can be used to propel the audience forward without losing their interest."

"The job of any artist, whatever the medium, is to keep the audience engaged. My studies in music have given me a good understanding of the importance of rhythm, be it the rhythm of a play or a song. The rhythm of a play, its basic building

blocks, creates the actual heartbeat of the production. Music taught me that it is possible to respect the basic structures set out for us while still allowing for a sense of natural and spontaneous creativity. Being able to relate to music or life, in general, comes about through a sense of curiosity, exploration and understanding of what is taking place around us."

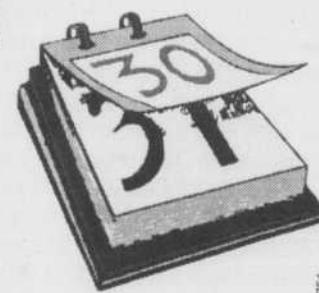

The Yvonne L. Bombardier cultural center in Valcourt will be started its summer season on June 21 with an exhibition of paintings by the late Kingsbury artist Mary Meigs.

According to center official Louise Lemay, Mary Meigs is the first of several Eastern Townships artists the center wants to feature in the coming months and years.

"Meigs was a very passionate painter who decided to come Kingsbury from the United States and created some great works using Townships scenes," said Lemay.

"We believe she and other E.T. painters deserve some exposure at the center."

Meigs was born in Philadelphia in 1917 and served in the U.S. Navy during the latter half of the Second World War.

During and after the war, she travelled the world and sketched what she saw.

In the 1960s, she moved to Brittany region of France to escape the social and political crisis in the U.S. caused by the Vietnam War.

In 1975, she moved to Kingsbury, next to the Township of Melbourne, to paint and write.

"She was a fan of Matisse and did a lot of portrait and nature painting," said Lemay. "The exhibition is entitled 'Peindre écrit elle' (Paint, she wrote), which comes from a book she wrote about her travels and her art."

Meigs died in Kingsbury in November, 2002. Her paintings will be on display at the center until Dec. 4.

Robson Arms

One of the peculiarities of prime-time comedy and drama is that Asian actors are all but invisible — on those rare occasions they appear in a TV show at all.

That's probably the least important reason to watch tonight's delightful outing of Robson Arms, Susin Nielsen and Gary Harvey's parable about life in a West End Vancouver low-rise apartment block, but it's a consideration.

The Eyes of Grandma Tan, written with flair and witty verve by Warren Jefferies and directed with a lively snap by Jason Furukawa, focuses on the multi-generational family of eccentric Hong Kong immigrants who live in apartment 100, right next door to many of the same customers they wait on every day in their corner grocery, the Pendrell Market.

There's not a clichéd character in the lot. Ricky (a pitch-perfect Jim Tai) is young, Canadianized and dreams of winning a karaoke competition at the local night club and earning a little pocket money on the side, all so he can splurge on a spiffy new software program for his giant-screen PC.

Bao Tan (Colin Foo, also pitch-perfect) is the quiet, benevolent family patriarch, still baffled by Canadian customs and reduced to playing Gordon Lightfoot and Parachute Club tunes on his tuba in the basement, hoping in vain to land a job one day in the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra.

Grandma Tan (Helena Yea, in one of the great comic performances of the season, in this or any other TV program) struggles with English, suffers from a serious case of

glaucoma and regards every customer in the family store with a thinly veiled glare of hostility and suspicion. The only two words of English she knows, often delivered at full volume, are: "Shop — lifter!"

While Ricky works the cash register, trying to keep the customers satisfied, Grandma Tan lurks in the background, delivering one frightfully rude remark after another in rapid-fire Cantonese. One of the pleasures in watching this brisk, clever episode is the constant back and forth between nattering siblings, parents and grandparents, a fevered clash of subtleties and broken English.

Jefferies' slight but surprisingly wise and deep tale revolves around Grandma Tan's glaucoma, and a particularly novel treatment calculated to leave the viewer in stitches by the time it's over.

Robson Arms practically burns with joie de vivre. The tone shifts from funny to sad to reflective to profound to funny again with a confidence rare in a TV comedy today.

One of the problems Canadian television drama and comedy faces is that too many Toronto reviewers heap praise on inadequate programs out of a misguided sense of loyalty to homegrown talent. The result is that viewers at home, who know better, are inclined to overlook well-reviewed programs that show genuine promise because they've been burned once too often.

Robson Arms is unique. Just two weeks in, it shows signs of evolving into one of this country's most invigorating new comedies, an intoxicating concoction of fable, parable and real life. See for yourself, if you doubt me.

Strange We Should Meet Again (Reprise)

Ever since Radiohead became the next U2, bands have been knocking themselves out trying to become the next Radiohead. Idiot Pilot is no exception.



Strange We Should Meet Again is a heavy-dose of heady art-rock that calls to mind the bubbling strains of the first Radiohead album, but with a twist. The strange meeting on this album is between the ethereal art-rock strains of Radiohead, and the angry shouting of Limp Bizkit. The result is something vaguely more masculine than Evanescence. The sounds are interesting, and there's potential here, but Idiot Pilot will need to decide who's taking the wheel before they take over the world.

NOUVELLE VAGUE

Nouvelle Vague (Justin Time)

Here's a neat idea: Put a selection of punk and new-wave songs from the late



seventies and early eighties, by the likes of Killing Joke, XTC, and the Clash, in the hands of a group of kitschy, French-pop revivalists, and see what happens. The result is smooth and goes down easy, but seems to have stripped the songs of any of their fire. Though Nouvelle Vague manages an excellent job of making these tracks their own, it's hard not to feel that something has been lost in the coquettish translation. The Sex Pistols have never sounded so seductive — but is that a good thing?

FOO FIGHTERS

In Your Honor (Sony/BMG)

There are two sides to every story, and two discs to the latest Foo Fighters offering. The first is a blistering selection of muscle-bound, monster rock that takes the Foo Fighters into some of the heaviest territory they've covered. This is a Foo Fighters with a

little Black Sabbath and Motorhead thrown in for good measure. The second disc is like a Dave Grohl lullabye in comparison, and offers a stark contrast to the heavy rock of the first, but it's in the



quieter, more introspective moments of the second disc that the Foo Fighters seem to mine the richest vein. In Your Honor shows off all the facets of a band that seems determined to outlive the sound it grew from.

ROBBIE FULKS

Georgia Hard (Yep Rock)

Robbie Fulks specializes in the kind of country music they don't make anymore — witty, swinging, and melodic. It's also light years removed from the country mainstream, which means Georgia Hard stands a snowball's chance in hell of getting any airplay. But somewhere, you know Roger Miller must be smiling at Fulks' brilliant blend of classic country song form and hilarious lyrics.



Case in point: I'm Gonna Take Her Home and Make Her Like Me, which inverts the standard bar pickup vignette with a surprise ending — the protagonist is so drunk, he's oblivious that the woman he's trying to pick up is his wife.

Really, how can you go wrong with country songs that have titles like All You Can Cheat, You Don't Want What I Have and Goodbye, Cruel Girl? Leave It To A Loser is a classic C&W weeper that sounds an out-take off an early 60s George Jones album, while the title track Georgia Hard is a twanged-up lament from a lost soul from the south who's stuck in Chicago — maybe the best tune about the subject since Detroit City.

Throw in a couple of murder ballads the Everly Brothers would never sing (If They Could Only See Me Now and Coldwater, Tennessee) and the rollicking Countryman Than Thou (with the George Bush insult "He's got a ranch, he wears a Stetson/ He's a hip-shooting ex-oil king/ Even talks like Buddy Ebsen/ But

he's sittin' in the West Wing") and you've probably got the best country record of 2005.

James Blood Ulmer

Birthright

(Hyena Records/Fusion 3)

If you're wary of getting your blues from artists barely old enough to pay their dues, then go to the source. Go and hear a musician like James Blood Ulmer.



A worldly 62, a man who grew up has played just about every genre of music including avant-garde jazz (he was Ornette Coleman's guitarist in the early 1970s), Ulmer has recently turned to explore his roots. He sings and plays the blues with real feeling. Sure, there are flashier guitarists out there — as a soloist, Ulmer is a primitive — and as a singer, he wouldn't have a prayer on American Idol.

And that's precisely the appeal of this old-timer. He's been around the corner a few times, has lived a full life, and that worldliness comes across in every note he sings or plays.

That life experience is apparent on his latest solo release (just Ulmer), Birthright, a follow-up to 2003's No Escape from the Blues. On the closing Devil's Got to Burn, he practically spits out the lyrics, cackling as he does. I Can't Take It No More is a lively shuffle with lyrics about a man walking out on a hopeless relationship to which he's given too much time and energy. He deals with injustice on White Man's Jail, a slow blues where Ulmer laments, "I've been accused of everything but murder."

Those of us who came upon the great blues songs through white rock bands will recognize a couple of songs here — I Ain't Superstitious, which Rod Stewart popularized, and Sittin' On Top of the World, a hit for

Cream — but you've never heard them done quite like this. Best track, Geechee Joe, is not bluesy at all, but a heartfelt tribute to Ulmer's grandfather, "a hard-working man who took a stand."

CUBACUBA

Various Artists

(in2 Music/Fusion 3)

Cuban musicians can make anything sound uplifting. Take, for example, Company Segundo's Francisco Guayabal, an exuberant, danceable number with lyrics about a man's body failing

him. "I got kidney fever/ Cascades in the jaw," shouts the vocalist, and you tap your toes as he chronicles his bad back, knee problems, diseased lungs. This group could make a CRTC hearing seem like Carnivale time.

"Uplifting" describes this 15-song compilation of such well-known Cuban musicians as Ibrahim Ferrer, RubZ'n Gonzlez and Omara Portuondo, and lesser lights like Teresa Garcia Caturia and Eliades Ochoa. Ferrer's El Platanal de Bartolo features a bright call-and-response vocal and a trumpet soaring into the high-note stratosphere. Ochoa's Beso Discreto is both lulling and lively at the same time, with congas and cowbell providing the pulse. Portuondo sings the haunting melody for the love song Tres Palabras with tremendous feeling, sounding like someone who's given her heart to the one she loves. Special mention goes to in2 Music for the packaging of this recording, which features some great colour shots of street scenes in Havana.

JOHN MAYALL AND THE BLUESBREAKERS

Road Dogs

(Eagle Rock)

British musician John Mayall, who turned on a generation of new listeners to the blues in the 1960s, returns to the studio with his band the Bluesbreakers, giving a solid performance on a record that was meant for playing on the car stereo as you hit the open highway.



Mayall, who plays keyboards, harmonica and sings, wrote 13 of the CD's 15 numbers, the other tracks co-penned by members of his band. The title track, which opens the CD, sets the tone, a driving number with a biting guitar and lyrics about the joys of the road. Mayall's lyrics advise rock bands to keep the road life simple and quit bitching about the details. Mayall plays a rolling piano on the slow blues number So Glad, where he celebrates the great musicians who set his own musical course. The band cooks, especially guitarist Buddy Whittington, who gets just the right sound on every number, and elevates the band with his mercurial solos. On You'll Survive, which has a Western swing arrangement, Whittington and guest violinist Dale Morris Jr. play pulse-quickening solos, then trade four-bar passages right through the song's fadeout. The next track, the funky Awestruck & Spellbound, builds on the strength of Whittington's fretwork. At 71, John Mayall is still going strong.

Writing 'Bewitched' meant finding hook

Nora Ephron didn't spend a lot of time watching television in the days *Bewitched* cast its original network spell. She was too busy pounding the keys on her typewriter, working as a young journalist in the days when smoking and scotch were still a fundamental part of newsroom ritual.

That was then — when Ephron's significant other was Carl Bernstein, Washington Post Watergate reporter.

Thirty years later, she's got a new literary squeeze, Nicholas Pileggi (*Goodfellas*), and has a wealth of knowledge about *Bewitched* — with insight into every nook and cranny of character, every ounce of artificial magic, every twitch of a witch's nose.

Ephron spent month upon month studying the internal codes of the popular sitcom in order to write the screenplay and direct the new film adaptation of *Bewitched* starring Nicole Kidman and Will Ferrell which hits theatres nationwide Friday.

"Part of me wanted to work on this project because Nicole Kidman was attached and I think she's fantastic. The other part was hooked on the puzzle of how to update the show and still make it work," says Ephron over the phone from New York.

"But it was never about the show for me because I didn't really watch it. It didn't really fit my life.... It didn't have that 'this is me' quality that Mary Tyler Moore had a bit later on. Mary Tyler Moore really resonated for me because she was working in the world of journalism and that was something I could identify with," she says.

"If the studio had wanted to do a straight remake of the original show, like *Charlie's Angels*, I don't even know what that would have looked like."

Clearly, it wouldn't have looked anything like the smart revision Ephron creates with her take on the show

about the witch Samantha, and her goofy human husband Darren.

Ditching the idea of a straight remake, this new version of *Bewitched* takes place in the present day and pivots on the premise that a famous actor is trying to rescue a floundering career by doing TV.

Jack Wyatt (Ferrell) is offered a remake of *Bewitched*, but he's so threatened by the idea of a co-star with more charisma, that he demands an unknown in the role of Samantha. The producers eventually find a perfect Samantha in Isabel Bigelow (Kidman), but little do they know she's a real witch — echoing the same dilemma as the original sitcom.

"The whole thing about *Bewitched*, as a friend of mine pointed out, is that it's really about whether or not your husband will still love you once he finds out you're a witch," says Ephron.

"For me, the most important thing was to make sure Samantha wasn't just a housewife because that's sort of how I saw the series. She was this nice woman who spent all the time trying not to use her powers, only to use her powers and then feel terrible about it. That's sort of it, but I wanted to get beyond that, otherwise, it would have been little more than a pale imitation of the show."

Ephron talks about the sexual politics beneath the veneer of a conservative 1960s comedy, and says *Bewitched* wasn't a landmark show, but it did give women power — albeit to do laundry and vacuum without lifting a finger.

She says with Kidman in the role of lead witch,

she was able to find a graceful fulcrum between potency and naivete.

"There's this one moment in the opening credits of the film and the real estate agent tells Isabel (Nicole Kidman) that she can't have the house because she doesn't have any references, and then suddenly, there's this split-second shift in the way she looks — and there's no need for references any more. Nicole really shows what she can do in that moment.

She goes from absolute innocence to OK — if that's the way you want to play it..." says Ephron.

Understanding female power, and female viewing habits, has become part of Ephron's collected skill set, having been a news reporter, but also having penned such scripts as *Silkwood*, *Heartburn*, *When Harry Met Sally* and directing films that include *Sleepless in Seattle* and *You've Got Mail*. The industry sees Ephron as one of the few females worthy of the director's chair, and she's happy for the trust, but she says it's not just about finding the magical key to chick flicks.

"I mean, this isn't *Beaches*. There aren't any women crying their eyes out in this movie. Besides, it was very important for me to reach both sides. You'd be surprised by how many men watched that show and loved it," she says.

"The show has hardly ever been off the air... and Elizabeth Montgomery is

seen now as divine. I can't tell you how many people loved her. Everyone I spoke to who worked with her just loved her."

Ephron says it was only fitting that an A-list actress like Kidman take on the role of Samantha because Montgomery had the same chops, she just never got a chance to show them off — unless one counts the depressing made-for-TV movie she made about rape.

"Nicole and I didn't have a lot of theoretical discussions about Samantha, it was more a case by case thing. She'd tell me what she thought might work in a given scene — things like that," she says.

"But the most important thing about Nicole — she's funny. An actor who's funny can take what's on the page and make you laugh at it. If they don't have it — they don't have it. That's what (my sister) Delia and I call 'NF' — not funny...."

Ephron says she encountered few NF moments over the course of shooting *Bewitched*. The only real stress came in the final weeks — after the studio pushed up the release date.

"Everyone looked at what had come out so far and I guess the feeling was there was enough out there for the boys — it might be the right time to put something out there that would appeal to both sexes."

Bewitched opens nationwide on Friday, June 24.

Lively role gets starlet hooked on acting

Blake Lively never wanted to be in the movies — until Sisterhood Of The Travelling Pants came along

The thing to remember about Blake Lively — the tall, blonde 17-year-old who's one of the delights of *The Sisterhood Of The Travelling Pants* — is that she is the one person in a family of show-business people who had no plans to make acting her career.

In fact, it was real pain for her to leave her high school prom in order to go to Los Angeles to talk to reporters about her performance in the film as Bridget, the leggy star athlete whose summer at a soccer camp in Mexico leads to an emotional crisis.

"My whole family's in the business," Blake admits. That includes her mother, a talent manager, and father Ernie Lively who's an actor and director and also has a role in the movie as — you guessed it — her father. Then there are siblings Jason, Eric, Robyn and Lori — all of them actors as well.

That leaves Blake as the odd girl out. Apart from her performance at the age of 10 in *Sandman*, a small movie which never had a theatrical release, she has chosen to pursue other interests.

"I've been so busy with high school and I'm in all the clubs there. I've been in cheer and choir and I've been class president, so my past four years at high school have been very busy."

But her brothers were convinced she'd love acting once she did it again, so they took the initiative and set up a meeting with a talent agent.

"They set me up on some auditions and after a very short amount of time I got this movie."

And now, she says she's hooked on

acting and eager to do another film.

In the Warners film, Blake costars with Amber Tamblyn, Alexis Bledel and America Ferrera as four close friends who start leaving their teen years behind them in the course of one eventful summer. Blake related to the script immediately because it deals with the kind of friendships she has enjoyed growing up.

"I have my friend Jessica whom I've had since I was three years old and my friend Brittany whom I've had since seventh grade, and we can fight like there's no tomorrow and we can have these crazy times and then go do nothing together, and it's this great friendship because you have such a deep understanding of one another. We know each other so well inside and out that it's amazing."

Reporters have been telling Blake that she's a potential star, but she doesn't believe it.

"I don't think of myself as that," she says. "I'm such a dork. I'm such a loser."

She struck a close friendship with her costars in *Sisterhood*, although Amber Tamblyn affectionately labels her "the biggest klutz you'll ever meet in your life."

Blake cheerfully agrees. "I am a klutz!" she declares. Every time she goes to a dance, her date waits at the bottom of the stairs to catch her: "I have not gone to one dance where I have not fallen down the stairs!"

She's also a non-conformist. She says that at last night's prom everybody else on the floor was doing "freak dancing" so she decided to swing into some riverdancing. "I just do what's fun for me. I don't try to fit into any category or anything. I'm crazy and will do whatever it takes to have a good time."

She also says she has one big passion these days: "Rhinestones. I rhinestone everything — My Letterman jacket, my cell phone, my iPod, my shoes."

CTV Canada's host broadcaster for Live8

The Dire Straits tune Money for Nothing may have made "I want my MTV" part of the popular lexicon, but when U2, Coldplay and Oasis take the world stage on July 2 for Live8, Canadians will enjoy the concerts live on a mainstream network, CTV, not a cable music channel.

CTV has also been named the host broadcaster of Live8 Canada — now confirmed for Barrie, Ont. CTV will air segments from concerts around the world, as well as the entire Live8 Canada concert. In all, CTV will broadcast 11 hours of live coverage.

The historic, all-day, rock 'n' roll television event is a follow-up to 1985's Live Aid, and follows nearly 20 years to the day after Live Aid raised worldwide awareness of famine in Ethiopia and made Sir Bob Geldof a household name.

Organizers hope The Live8 series of concerts will generate support for The Long Walk to Justice, a grass-roots movement calling on the leaders of the world's wealthiest countries to act decisively against global poverty when they meet in Gleneagles, Scotland on July 6-9.

Social activists, led by Geldof, Live Aid's original organizer, are calling for complete debt cancellation, more and better aid, and trade justice for the world's impoverished nations, many of

them in Africa.

CTV will broadcast live from 9 a.m.-8 p.m. ET, beginning with the anchor concert at London's Hyde Park, to feature U2, Sir Elton John and REM, among others.

The Canadian concert will air live, in its entirety, from Barrie's Park Place, beginning at 11 a.m. ET. The Barrie concert will be hosted by Tom Green and Dan Aykroyd, and will feature performances by Bryan Adams, The Tragically Hip, Celine Dion (via satellite) and Barenaked Ladies, among others.

Canadian Sarah McLachlan is scheduled to perform at the U.S. concert at Philadelphia's Museum of Art.

Concerts have also been confirmed for Paris, Berlin, Rome, Cornwall and, possibly, Tokyo and Johannesburg.

CTV will remain live until 8 p.m. A two-hour recap, featuring highlights of the most memorable performances of the day, will air later in the evening.

The London concert will feature the unexpected, much-anticipated reunion of Pink Floyd between original bandmates Roger Waters and David Gilmour. Geldof told Britain's Channel 4 Monday that he hopes to see a reunion of the Spice Girls. The only person holding up the regrouping is Melanie Brown, better known as Scary Spice.

Some music industry analysts have said they don't expect Live8 to have the

global impact Live Aid did in 1985, in part because the mid-1980s were a different era in music, and a different era in broadcast television.

Supporters of the original Live Aid insist, however, that Live8 could re-ignite

interest in those music fans who are disillusioned with music today, while at the same time re-energizing the world to take a stand against world poverty.

Copyright bill to tighten up file-sharing laws

The government intends to table a long-awaited copyright bill on Wednesday to bolster laws against file-sharing and outlaw the cracking of digital locks on DVDs, but the bill is expected to be a departure from the more stringent laws of the U.S.

The bill is expected to make it an offence to crack the digital locks preventing the copying of CDs, DVDs and e-documents.

Legislative proposals suggest the bill will include an exception, so that cracking digital locks on CDs is only illegal if it serves an "infringing purpose." For example, it would not be unlawful for consumers who buy a CD to crack the digital lock to download content onto their computers.

It signals that Canadian copyright reforms will be more lenient than those in the U.S., where cryptography researchers have run afoul of the law for cracking digital codes and legislators have outlawed programs that copy DVDs, said Michael Geist, Canada research chair in Internet and e-commerce law at the University of Ottawa.

"It's a significant departure from the U.S. approach," he said.

The bill will also clarify that the distribution or posting of copyrighted music on the Internet is an offence. This will not make downloading music illegal, but will create a new legal avenue for the recording industry to go after file-sharers for distributing music, Geist said.

Graham Henderson, president of the Canadian Recording Industry Association, whose members include industry heavyweights such as EMI Music Canada, Sony Music Canada and Universal Music, said the proposals will bring Canada in line with Canada's major trading partners on the law and the Internet.

"From our perspective it's a good bill," Henderson said. "It's not about getting authorization to sue people."

Henderson said the legislative proposals do not go far enough on the issue of digital locks. For example, the bill is not expected to provide the legal mechanisms to go after people like "DVD Jon" Johansen, the Norwegian teenager who wrote DeCSS, a popular program that cracks the copy-protection on DVDs, he said.

The bill is also expected to recognize ISPs as intermediaries and exempt

them from being liable for copyright infringement. However, a "notice and notice" regime is expected to be set up, which would require ISPs to notify website administrators about complaints of copyright infringement. ISPs would only force their clients to take down infringing material when under court order.

Two other controversial issues, however, will not be addressed in this round of legislation. Publishers have been calling for a general licensing scheme to

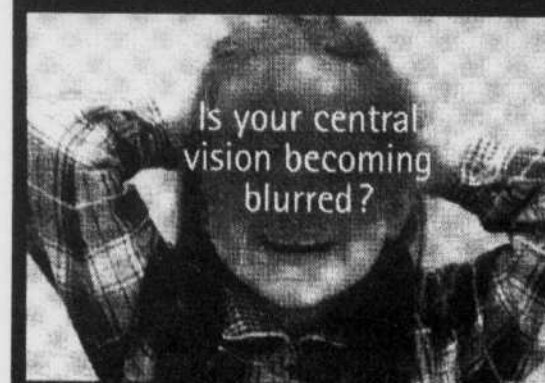
collect money from school libraries, on the premise that students look at copyrighted material on the Internet without paying for it.

Retailers and major hardware companies have also been lobbying to remove the 21-cent levy on blank CDs, which is used to compensate rights owners for the free copying of music.

Heritage Minister Liza Frulla recently said the bill will not include either of these amendments.
