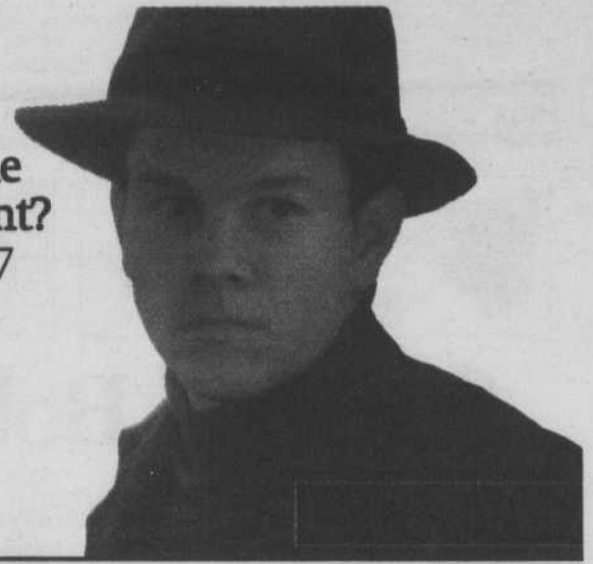

### Outspoken fiddler plays Centennial

The headline was his idea. It's a joke, see, about his sexuality, which, like pretty much everything under the sun, he's happy to chat about. If there's a secret to Ashley MacIsaac, the Cape Breton fiddle prodigy turned media whipping boy, it's that he has no secrets. At least he doesn't seem to.

After filing for bankruptcy in 2000,

MacIsaac seems to be turning things around. He's managed to extricate himself from his contract with Loggerhead, the Toronto record label he feels treated him unfairly and partially blames for some of his infamous public outbursts. "When people aren't acting in good faith, well, who can expect me to be anything but the real Ashley MacIsaac," he asks?

The 'real MacIsaac' is not just candid, though. He's a musician and a businessman who has, over ten years, probably put \$25 million into the economy, he says. The topic of money returns with

the regularity of a phone bill in our conversation, understandable from a small-town boy who became toast of the continent almost overnight in 1995, after his second album, *Hi How Are You Today?*, went platinum.

"I definitely have one goal in my life, he readily offers, and that's to get to the upper caste of Canadian society. And if I don't make it there because I'm rich, well, I definitely know at this point it ain't gonna be because I'm famous, because I had that upside down and backwards.

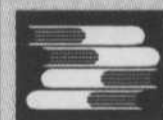

## Sue and Bob Black off to Stratford Festival

Sue Black will be imagining herself on the Stratford Festival stage when she and husband Bob arrive in Stratford, Ont. as the winners of The Record's Fall Weekend Getaway contest.

Sue, a nurse at the Connaught Home in North Hatley, was a passionate amateur thespian throughout her school days and continues to act in the occasional community production.

"I was in *The Importance of Being Earnest* at (the former) Sunnyside High School in Stanstead," she recalled with fondness. "I was *Lady Bracknell*. I was also in *The Sound of Music* at Galt. I was a nun and a party guest. I keep asking Nelson when the next one is going to be."

Nelson Gonyer, the drama professor at Alexander Galt Regional High School in Lennoxville, directed a successful student/community production of *The Sound of Music* a few years ago.

"I love plays. My sisters and brother and I used to go in anything we could," enthused Sue. "I used to go down to the University of Vermont and see the Shakespearean Festival there. I saw *Richard III* there. They were so taken that we came all the way from Canada that they took us backstage and gave us a tour. It was fascinating."

In her own backyard, Sue attended productions at the now-defunct Festival Lennoxville in the 70s.

"That's where I got to know (actress)

Lally Cadeau. We used to go to the swimming pool at Bishop's and she'd be there with her daughter."

Coincidentally, Cadeau is currently in her sixth season at the Stratford Festival, appearing as Juliet's Nurse in *Romeo and Juliet*, the Duchess of York in *Richard III: Reign of Terror*, as well as multiple roles in *The Swanne: George III (The Death of Cupid)*.

As part of the contest, Sue and Bob will be attending performances of *Romeo and Juliet* at the Festival Theatre and *The Swanne* at the Festival's new Studio Theatre, along with *The Scarlet Pimpernel* at the newly renovated Avon Theatre.

The Blacks will also be staying at the Swan Motel and dining at three of Stratford's exquisite restaurants — The Sun Room, Tony's Bistro and Tapuz. They will also take a tour of the Festival's Warehouse of Costumes and Properties.

The Blacks were randomly chosen from among a hundred entries to the contest. They correctly answered the contest's skill-testing question, identifying the name of the two feuding families in *Romeo and Juliet* — the Montagues and the Capulets.

Although Sue is the one with a lifelong passion for the theatre, it was Bob who decided to fill out the coupon in *The Record* to enter the contest.

"I had a feeling I was going to win," said the retired real estate agent. "I sent in a coupon last year, too, but this year I had a feeling I would win it."

## The Swanne: a sprawling new work at Stratford

There is no disputing *The Swanne: George III (The Death of Cupid)* is an admirable effort. The first in Peter Hinton's trilogy of plays about the rich and poor of Regency London (early 1800s) is an engrossing work the playwright calls "a speculation on history."

However, with 21 actors portraying 64 roles in a piece of theatre that clocked in at three-and-a-half hours at a preview before the play's world premiere Oct. 9 at Stratford's new Studio Theatre, something got lost in the translation.

The premise of this drama written in verse is exquisite. Inspired by an article printed in a coffee house circular in 1819, Hinton imagines that Princess Charlotte's stillborn son, who would have succeeded George IV to the throne, had in fact not died, but was living and was black (the result of an affair between Princess Char-

lotte and one of her servants).

It follows that the rightful heir of the British monarchy's identity would then be suppressed by the House of Lords in a complex web of lies.

Hinton says since history is told by the victors, he wanted to write a history from the point of view of the vanquished, "the men and women who were felled by a history that deemed them unworthy or demanded they best be forgot."

For the insight into the lives of orphans, wet-nurses, beggars and maids of Regency London, Hinton's work is a remarkable achievement. *The Swanne* is entirely a work of fiction, created from letters, diaries, novels and photos; gossip, rumour and fact. Hinton has created an emotionally charged language for his piece, full of heightened sexuality, romantic sensibilities and from-the-hip vulgarities.

His main flaw, however, is he tries to de-

velop too many themes and ideas in a single play. With the number of characters and plot points the audience has to mentally track throughout the evening, this sprawling work gets confusing rather quickly.

Add to this Hinton's penchant for shuffling scenes around and playing with time and space. The play is presented in non-linear fashion. The concept of past, present and future existing in a single moment is one worth exploring, however, for all but the most adventurous theatregoer history buff, the play will be difficult.

Hinton, who has directed more than 50 productions of new plays in Canada, infuses the production with his passion for history and creates some memorable moments with some of Stratford's top talent, an acting company that breathes life into all 200 minutes of this work.

Particularly memorable are Lucy Peacock, who brings tremendous humanity

to her turn as poverty-stricken wet-nurse Mrs. Peabody; Diane D'Aquila, turning in a tour-de-force performance as an actress named *The Scarecrow*; and Seun Olagunju, delivering a sensitive portrayal of William, "the black prince," in his debut season at Stratford.

Stratford is committed to developing Hinton's trilogy. Part two, titled *The Swanne: Princess Charlotte (The Acts of Venus)*, will be presented next season.

By developing and presenting Hinton's admirable, albeit self-indulgent speculation on history, the 50-year-old Stratford Festival, often criticized for its commercial sensibilities, is clearly taking some chances.

## Blue skies and colour abound at Uplands

Photographer Dr. Robert Paulette was the first artist to exhibit at Uplands when it opened in 1988. Fourteen years later, he returns, having put some 12 exhibitions under his belt in the meantime. Looking at his photos, one quickly sees why.

The Sherbrooke native has been an avid photographer since his teens, and has always enjoyed pursuing the local landscape with his camera in all four seasons. He has a knack for framing beautifully, and thereby enhancing, some already spectacular scenery. Fall colours glow and lakes shimmer through Paulette's lens.

But his return to Uplands comes with a twist. His daughter, painter Laurie Paulette Kral, is showing with him. Born and raised in Sherbrooke, she attended Alexander Galt High School before pursuing her McGill degree in dietetics. Unsatisfied with that line of work, she decided to attend the Ottawa School of Art.

"It goes way back to when I was a kid, she said. Something I always dreamed of was studying art."

Laurie has happily made her home for the past 11 years in Vankleek Hill, a rural community between Montreal and Ottawa with gingerbread homes 'a lot like Lennoxville,' as she described it.

Laurie's interest in art surfaced at a young age, explained father Robert. "I was interested in photography, and she took some pictures in high school I was really impressed with, and we had them framed. She just seemed to have a special talent early."

Her choices of colour spread through large, painterly brushstrokes make for harmonious oils and acrylics, and reveal the influence of Van Gogh and Tom Thomson.

But her father has been an influence a little closer to home. "At least half the pictures here are inspired by photographs I've taken," he said. Some are copied directly from his pictures, while most are amalgams comprising elements from the landscape between Sherbrooke and Coaticook and down to Lake Wallace, where the family has a cottage.

"We'd always talked about

doing an exhibit together," said Laurie, happy to be finally hanging it on Wednesday. She called Uplands with the idea because of both the subject matter and her father's history with the museum.

Many will come to the show only partly for the art, however.

"I'm well known in the area," said Robert, who treated over 35,000 patients in his career as thoracic surgeon at the Sherbrooke Hospital from 1961 until its closure in 1996. Some 50 of his landscape pictures hung in its rooms and corridors, a pleasing palliative for sick Sherbrookers.

Now, in his retirement, Robert finds much more time to capture images, and, like any serious photographer, he takes his camera with him wherever he goes.

"One of the biggest things that makes a photographer is just seeing a picture as you travel around," he said.

Robert is quite pleased to be showing, for the first time, with one of his four children, one of whom spends his days as a doctor, two as engineers, and one, Laurie, an artist. A lover of art who decided to treat it as a hobby rather than a profession, Robert said he always encouraged his kids, "to get a good academic background, and then pursue whatever they want in music or art. I think that art should supplement your life. I think it's very hard to make a living at it."

Despite his pronouncements, Laurie is making a go of it. She works about five hours in her studio every afternoon, opening it up about twice a year to sell her inventory. Her success has meant she hasn't needed to seek gallery representation.

And judging by the talent on display at Uplands; her father, if he had chosen to, could have pursued an artistic career as well.

## Two artists, two different approaches

### Public helps create art at Galérie Horace

Bars on the wall, clouds near the ceiling, people in paint and other evocative images are all part of the black and white passage of time and the colourful appearance of people represented in art in the new exhibitions of Anne Thibault and artist in residence Renée Lavaillante at the Galérie Horace in Sherbrooke.

Two different approaches to art meet in two exhibition rooms at the gallery as the artists show their works representing the narrative approach to society and a collaborative effort in time keeping.

Alice Letourneau, artistic director of the gallery explained that there are the

two spaces in which visitors will see the exhibits. Both of the artists have a clearly defined vision of what they aim to express in their art. Conveyed in both exhibits there is a love and dedication to the art.

"The visitor will see very large canvases in the first exhibition room," said Letourneau. "They are very real representations of actual society. The colours are very strong though there are nuances. When I walked in in the morning I was struck by the strength of the colours."

The second room has the works of Lavaillante. They are drawings. There will be clouds created high on the wall with pencils. The colours will be grey and black. Visitors are invited to add to the work.

At the conclusion of the work it will be like a landscape. There will be clouds and the marks of the visitors in the form of lines. These bars will

have the appearance of a field of wheat and will signify the marking of the passage of time.

Whether your interest is captivated by painting and the many directions it can take or the stark calculation of time as marked by the artist and the viewers of the exhibit, both are worth pondering for the messages behind the medium.

Though the exhibits are contrasting they both represent distinct visions. Thibault seeks to represent society and capture it in paint. Lavaillante looks to enable a more interactive approach to art and the marking of the passage of time.

Thibault uses colour, figures and persons. Lavaillante's work is evocative, in black and white on a 20-foot wall. Lavaillante will be transforming the space and working throughout her two weeks as artist in residence here at the gallery," noted Letourneau.

Lavaillante noted that she wanted to create a work people could participate in and it stems from her explorations in drawing.

Drawing is one of the essential elements of art and there are different ways of going about it. Previously she had experimented in drawing with eyes closed and this project sees other hands involved in the drawing.

"The bars have been used to count time, and many other things throughout history. One does not need to have artistic ability to participate in this fresco. I wanted people to have the experience of being part of an artist workshop in creation," Lavaillante concluded.

## Fame comes with a price for Canadian fiddler

From one end of the country to the other, you can go and ask someone who just immigrated here in the last 30 days and they've probably already heard of me."

But he doesn't sound pleased to have the fame without the financial rewards it usually brings.

"Well, how would it make you feel if you ain't got enough for a pack of smokes? Figure that one out. I'll be a much friendlier guy when I don't have

to say yes to things for money - I like to play, but I would like to be able to choose where I play, and no, I can't yet."

He now finds himself, he hopes, on his way to that dream, in the black and happily signed on with Decca Records. Currently cutting a new album for them between concert dates, he estimates it will be out in February or March. It will be self-titled, he says, a sign he is trying to turn a page in what could be described as a very long short career.

MacIsaac has been playing fiddle music all his life. He started performing nationally in 1994, and international

fame soon followed with that famous second album, which rejuvenated interest in Celtic music far and wide. But controversy soon plagued the Cape's golden boy. First, he bared his genitals on the Conan O'Brien Show, then revealed some sexual details not everyone wanted to read in their morning paper over eggs and toast. In the ensuing couple of years he punched out his former manager's spouse, revealed a crack cocaine habit, and went on an expletive-ridden political tirade at a millennium New Year's rave in Halifax that sent some, and we're talking ravers here, packing in disgust.

But regrets are not what the often naive Ashley MacIsaac is made of.

"Sometimes I think 'maybe this person didn't need to know that,' or 'I didn't see this coming,' but that's the game, what can you do? "I just don't think I have a problem with being honest. Lots of times things come out in interviews that people find unusual, distasteful, or not to their liking, and that's fine by me, that's just my personality. They can just change the channel."

As for the outbursts, they're generally by design, he insists. "The few times that I've been rude, that's been planned. Part of my goddamned act is to grab attention and to grab people's minds so they'll still listen to my fiddle music."

It's worked, but has left him feeling

older than his 27 years. "If you put yourself on a mild simmer long enough, he says, eventually you'll come to a boil. I've been going at it for awhile."

His love-hate relationship with his violin continues, and he says he still has to get angry at his fiddle in order to play it. "I figure if I didn't, I wouldn't have any emotional attachment at all to it. I like it, and I love it, and I hate it on some days - the day I win the instant million in the lotto, I guarantee you I'll play when I want, and not when I need."

Believe it or not, a man with so much musical talent sees it as a means to an end, partly because he knows nothing else.

"Fiddle music is my life. That's my bread, and what I've made a career of and listened to, and was exposed to since before I was born, and I don't imagine that I have much of a way out of that."

Still, though, he takes his job of lighting up an audience, which he does with ease, quite seriously. He'll be doing that Saturday night at Centennial Theatre (822-9692, \$25), accompanied by fellow Cape Bretoner Patrick Gillis on acoustic guitar, and possibly others. "If there's any local musicians that I see in the audience, there might be room to do a tune together. The Nova Scotia musicians like me and Patrick have some connection to the Québécois musicians, and maybe there's some tunes that we could share. Bring your spoons along."

## Grants open to more students

The du Maurier Arts Council is expanding its granting program for individuals to all of Canada in time for the next applications period.

The decision to broaden the scope of the program was made in light of its unprecedented success with students in their final year of studies at Quebec and Ontario universities.

The du Maurier Arts Council launched its granting program for individuals in 2001 to assist emerging Canadian artists attending institutes of high learning in Quebec and Ontario to complete arts projects and present them to the public.

The program is now available to all Canadian students over 19 years old who are enrolled in their final year of study of either an undergraduate or graduate program in visual arts, cinema, video and animation or multimedia and new technologies.

"The granting program for individuals is entering its third year, and we are consistently impressed by the quality and sensitivity of the projects that are brought to our attention and by the passion of their authors," said du Maurier Arts Council president Neil Blanche in a written statement.

All students who are nearing completion of their studies in one of the aforementioned disciplines in a degree-granting post-secondary institution are invited to submit a grant application.

Completed applications and attachments must be received no later than April 1, 2003 for arts projects that are to be presented between July 1, 2003 and June 30, 2004. 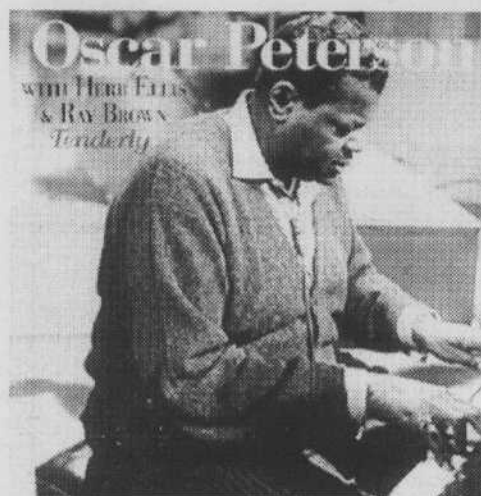

# Timetravelling with Montreal's Oscar Peterson

First off, you know this album is bound to be a worth your time because it features none other than the legendary OP in fine trio format with his early jazz chums Herb Ellis and Ray Brown. Entitled *Tenderly*, the disk released on Just A Memory, the sub-label of Justin Time Records. This is a live recording from a Vancouver concert on the Aug. 8, 1958. 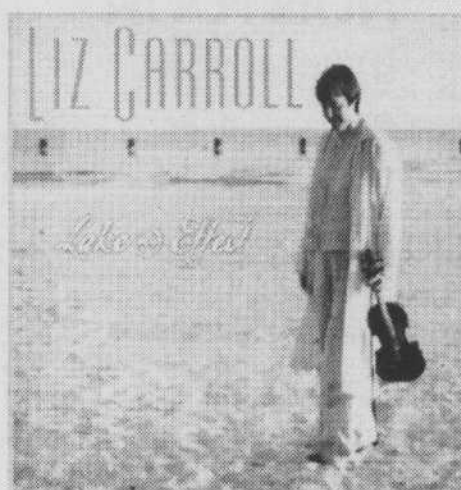

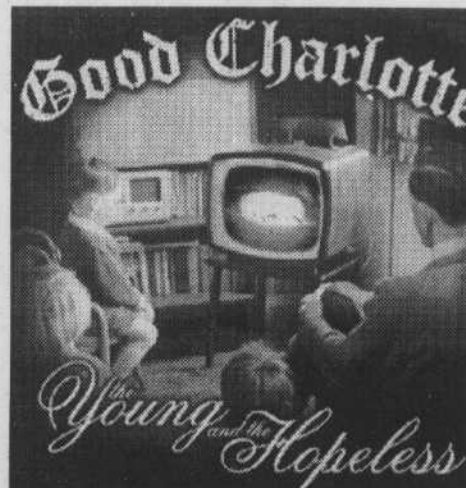

## Saidye's Glass Menagerie not to be missed

Chris Abraham has done it again. After directing an exquisite production of *Salt-Water Moon* last season, which won Best Production of the Year at the Montreal English Critics Circle Awards, he returns for a fourth season at the Saidye Bronfman Centre for the Arts with a superb, emotionally charged production of *The Glass Menagerie*.

Abraham brings a unique interpretation of Tennessee Williams's masterpiece to the Saidye stage. The young director's own exploration of emotional realism is a perfect fit with Williams's depiction of the extremes of human behaviour.

Abraham has taken the elements inherent in Williams's 1944 script and has infused a new urgency in them to tell the story to a modern audience. An example of the "poetic realism" he became known for, Williams utilizes music, screen projections, lighting effects and a narrator moving in and out of the action to tell the story in *The Glass Menagerie*, all innovations when the play premiered in Chicago in 1944/45.

Williams used these elements to create a dreamlike atmosphere for his memory play. Based on his own difficult childhood and troubled family, it is the recollections of Tom Wingfield about life with his overbearing Southern belle of a mother, emotionally repressed sister and absentee father.

To create a soft, hazy atmosphere ideal for this memory play, Abraham, set and prop designers Guido Tondino and Victoria Zimski and lighting designer Luc Prairie use every trick in the book to transform the sprawling Saidye stage to depict the various locales of the play.

Damien Atkins as Tom walks onto the stage first, turning on lamps, getting dressed and cleaning up, helping to create the space his story will be told in.

"Yes, I have tricks in my pockets, up my sleeve," he tells the audience in his introduction to the play, promising to tell the "truth in the pleasant disguise of illusion."

He introduces a fiddler, who remains seated on stage right throughout the play, injecting a musical language to Williams's words. This was an inventive directorial touch, adding a dimension to this production of *Menagerie* unseen elsewhere.

### The Glass Menagerie

By Tennessee Williams, directed by Chris Abraham, continues at the Saidye Bronfman Centre for the Arts, 5170 Côte-Ste-Catherine, through Oct. 20. Final performances take place this Saturday at 8:30 p.m. and Sunday at 2 and 7 p.m. Tickets: \$16 to \$38. Box office: 514-739-7944.

Abraham also uses the fiddler, Rick Hyslop, in a superbly subtle moment alluding to Tom's homosexuality. Not referred to directly anywhere in the script, Abraham creates a brilliant scene that works for the character, for the play and reflects Tennessee Williams's own homosexuality at a time when it was not spoken of in public.

Abraham elicits highly charged performances from his actors, making *Menagerie* an intense ride. Damien Atkins is superb as Tom, delivering a performance rich in nuance and colour.

Rosemary Dunsmore, who played a cancer patient in *Wit* at the Centaur two seasons ago, is transformed as Amanda Wingfield, a perfectly irritating Southern matron hanging on to the faded glory of a time long ago when 17 gentlemen callers visited her in one day. Dunsmore's performance is not as three-dimensional as one would expect, but it is assured.

Michelle Monteith is quite good as the emotionally unstable Laura, who is as fragile as her collection of precious glass animals thanks to a minor walking impediment, which at the time was looked upon as being crippled, and her pushy mother.

Seann Gallagher, a native Montrealer, has a difficult role as "gentleman caller" Jim O'Conner. For the entire first act, he sits stage left with his back to the audience,

representing, as we are told by Tom, that something special we all hope for in life. In act two, he visits the family for dinner and gets his chance to shine.

Gallagher does, delivering an excellent performance that makes a journey from a one-dimensional, sporty young man to one who reveals himself

emotionally and admits to the disappointments in his life.

Williams's vision of the human condition and Abraham's unique interpretation of it combine for an excellent production. Do yourself a favour. Make yourself free one evening this weekend or Sunday afternoon and see *The Glass Menagerie*.

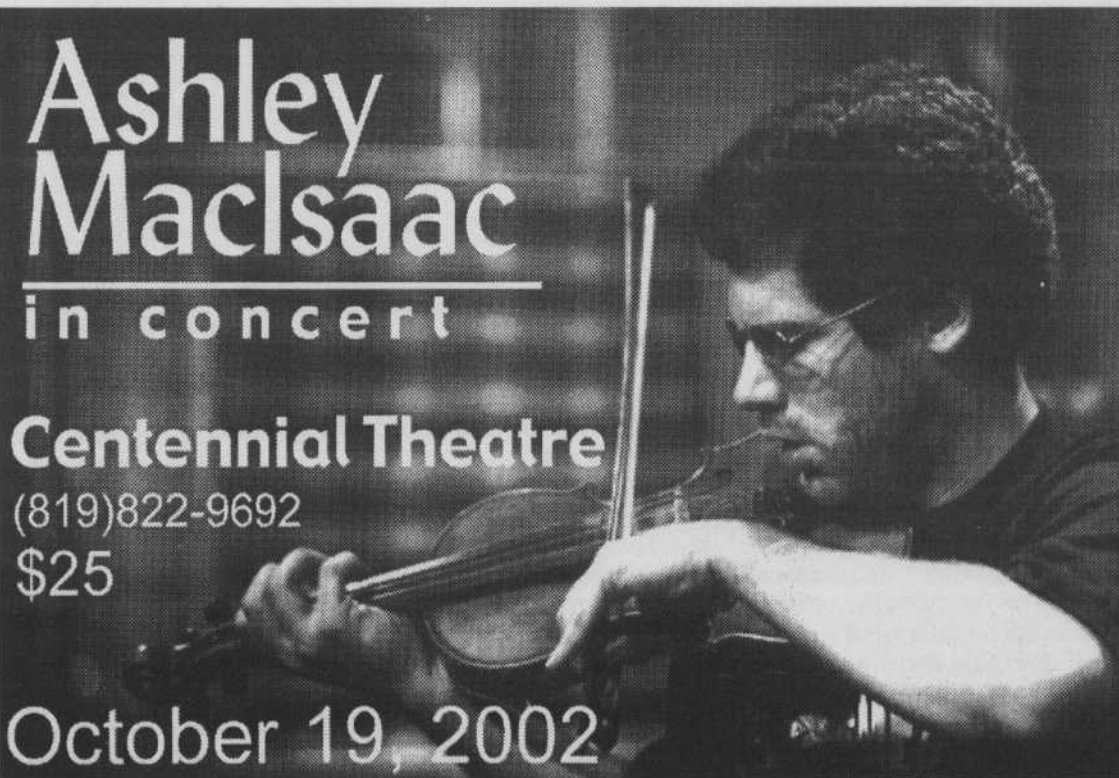

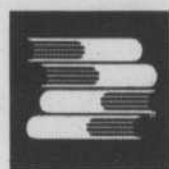

# Rotstein weaves sparse words into rich portrait

When Nancy-Gay Rotstein gets a poetry attack, there's no holding her back.

Rotstein, one of Canada's premier poets who has been internationally recognized for her work, says when the spirit moves her, she is overcome by the urge to put pen to paper.

"Something compels me to write a poem," said Rotstein. "When it hits me and I feel something has to be said, the words just come. Later, I will fine tune

the poem, but I always write a poem when the spirit and the passion are there."

There is no contradiction in Rotstein's background as a lawyer — the facts and only the facts, ma'am — and her more mellow side as a poet. Rotstein's poetry has a skeletal quality where every word matters. There is no extraneous verbiage or cutesy couplets in her work. Each word evokes an image or an emotion adding new dimensions to the reader's journey through a time or place.

"I've learned to respect the process. You

can't recreate a moment. There's an honesty and intensity to allowing the words to flow and there's a reason each poem has to be written."

Rotstein's poems exhibit an amazing ability to see beyond the banalities of daily life. She raises motherhood to a new level and invites the reader to join in the celebration of a Canadian ice field, or share the buried pain of a war veteran.

"In Marking Time, I was sitting across from a war veteran who had served in Calais. He appeared to others to be content, but I saw that his eyes were empty," she noted.

The Horizon and Beyond, her newest volume of poetry, is a mosaic of Rotstein's own life experiences, and a compilation of her work over 25 years. It's also written from a distinctly Canadian vantage point.

"The social context is Canadian, the landscapes are Canadian and the values are Canadian," Rotstein said. "It's from Canada I draw my inspiration and strength as a writer; it's my centre."

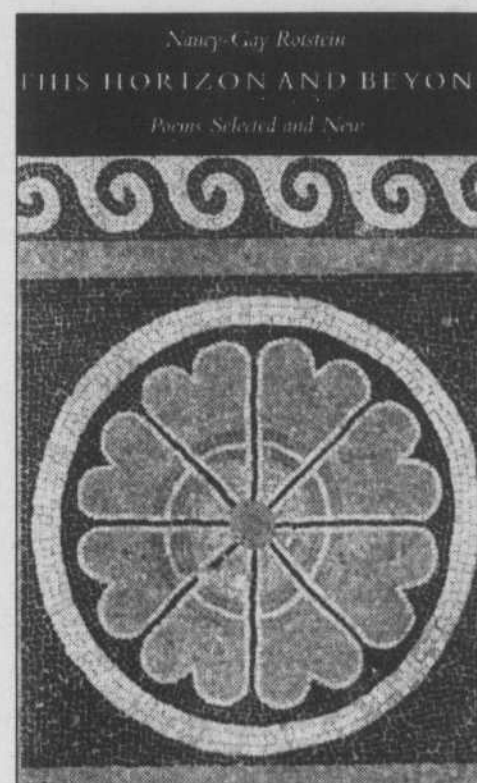
Rotstein wants the reader to discover their own connections through her poetry. "I want to create an awareness, to help others find insights."

Rotstein, who is also the author of the critically acclaimed novel, *Sharing Glass*, said writing poetry is very different from the more regimented work of a novelist.

"You can't go into a room at nine and come out at five with poetry. You have to write it when it hits you."

She said she has noted a resurgence in interest in poetry, and most particularly after the Sept. 11 tragedy.

"Poetry steadies us. It moves us beyond the moment to personal strength and comfort," Rotstein said. "People are looking for more meaning in their lives."



# Churchill biography still provides good copy

Winston Churchill still fascinates. Love him or hate him, few are indifferent towards him. In the aftermath of Sept. 11, 2001, numerous references were made to the former prime minister of Great Britain.

In "Leadership", former New York mayor Rudolph Giuliani mentions that, when he returned home on that historic day, he opened a biography of Churchill, by Roy Jenkins. Some commentators also pointed out that Churchill's attitude during the Battle of Britain is a source of inspiration for President Bush in his war on terrorism.

While it is always interesting to read about Churchill's life and numerous achievements, historian John Lukacs offers a different kind of opportunity. In "Churchill: Visionary. Statesman. Historian.", this famous academic — who wrote acclaimed books on World War II — reflects on Churchill's place in history. It's hard to put his book down.

First, Churchill was a visionary. "As early as 1940 he saw two alternatives: either Germany dominates all of Europe; or Russia will dominate the eastern portion of Europe (at worst for a while); half of Europe is better than none."

Even if some among Churchill contemporaries "even believed that the very pres-

ence of a new Germany was a welcome factor against Communism", the future British prime minister "had a conviction that the fate of Britain was not and could not be separated from the fate of Europe." History proved him right, but it was not all that evident at the time.

Second, he was a unique statesman. In fact, he was the man who saved Britain from Nazi hegemony. He was also the man who did not lose World War II. Despite his negative opinion of communism, Churchill was ready to ally his forces with those of Stalin, to combat Hitler. "If Hitler invaded Hell I would at least make a favourable reference to the Devil in the House of Commons." He was a practical leader. For without Stalin's presence on the allies side, one can suspect it would have been much harder for Churchill and Roosevelt to win the war.

In that regard, he also realized that the United States was an essential ally to Great Britain, in the war. "But in his concern about how far the Russians would advance into Central Europe he had no American help — quite the contrary." But he was statesman enough not to make his disappointment known. On that score, John Lukacs illustrates that Churchill's relations with US presidents were not always easy. At the beginning of the war,

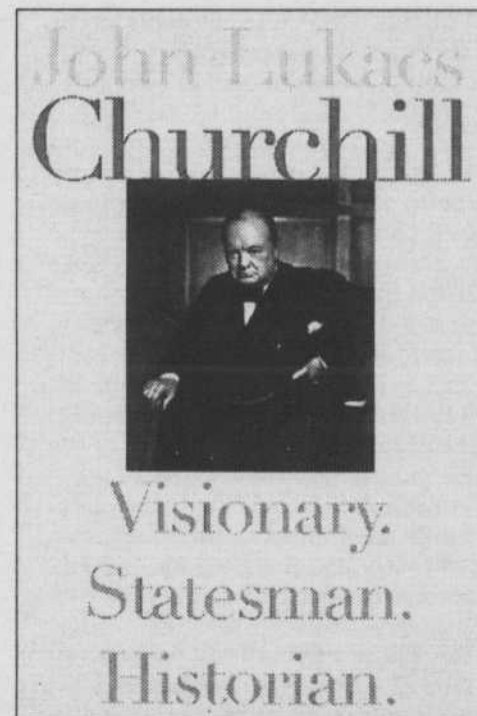

FDR and Churchill were great companions. By the end of the war, that special relationship had cooled. Relations with Eisenhower were frosty as Churchill served the last leg of his political career.

Finally, Churchill was an historian. And he was a great one. In Lukacs words, "Churchill was a writer mainly because he was attracted to history." In his youth, he wrote about the military campaigns in which he was involved. He later wrote a biography of Marlborough — his ancestor — and another about his father. He also wrote extensively about World War I and World War II, along with a "History of the English-Speaking People". While not a professional historian — in the sense that he did not hold a professional degree in this field — Lukacs observes that his work is a "model for historians."

With a lucid mind, Lukacs also looks at the failures and critics of Churchill. They are sometimes harsh, and sometimes biased. Lukacs does not let the book conclude without questioning the motives of



critics. Context and motives are two useful tools in history. Lukacs makes good use of them. He also points out that some important aspects of Churchill have still not been researched enough.

Lukacs' book has merit, reflecting on Churchill not only as a public figure but also as an historical subject. An historian reflecting on an historical figure can be interesting and fruitful.

# Wahlberg puts own stamp on Charade remake

Mark Wahlberg wants to set the record straight. He does not regard himself as the new Cary Grant, and he is not playing Grant in his new romantic thriller, *The Truth About Charlie*.

Furthermore, he says it was merely a misunderstanding that he seemed to suggest otherwise on the David Letterman Show earlier this year.

The problem is that the film, which opens Oct 25, is director Jonathan Demme's remake of *Charade*, a 1963 hit that starred Grant as a debonair mystery man who materializes out of nowhere to help damsel-in-distress Audrey Hepburn solve the murder of her equally mysterious husband.

Demme, of *Silence Of The Lambs* fame, had long wanted to make an updated version of the film which would again be set in Paris and again be heavy on old-fashioned romantic intrigue.

However, the director also admits the shadow of the earlier movie, and its two legendary stars, hangs heavy over the new project and its two current players, Wahlberg and Thandie Newton.

It is why Wahlberg has fielded questions recently about what it feels like to be the new Grant.

"It was never about that," he protests, good naturedly. "It was never a matter of Jonathan saying 'you're the new Cary Grant.' He thought I was the right guy for the part, the guy to bring something different and interesting to the role, so I said sure. I wasn't a huge fan of the original... I was a huge fan of Jonathan Demme, so I said: 'I'll work with this guy in whatever role. I'll play the guy on the bus who doesn't say anything.'"

But he's not playing the guy on the bus in *The Truth About Charlie*; he's starring in an eagerly awaited fall movie.

Yet, to Wahlberg, who will never forget the days when he was a convicted Boston street hood, it's a learning experience - another mile on his acting "journey" and further proof he's become a mature adult.

It was never part of Demme's vision to have Wahlberg imitate Grant, and the actor says it's unfortunate if he gave that impression when chatting with Letterman.

"Jonathan wasn't very happy about that," Wahlberg grins. "He wrote me this four-page letter... and it's not flattering. It says: 'Had I wanted to do the Cary Grant thing, there are so many other actors I could have cast instead of you.'"

Still, Wahlberg manages to look as sleek and sophisticated as a modern Grant.

Unlike many young actors who seem to embrace scruffiness when meeting the press, Wahlberg is clad in a black Armani suit.

"They (Armani) are nice enough to give me free clothes," he smiles. "I even wear this to the gym, man."

Wahlberg says he loved filming *The Truth About Charlie* in Paris, and he was intrigued by Demme's decision to emulate the free-wheeling visual style of the French New Wave cinema of the 1950s and 1960s.

Wahlberg, who soaks up cinematic knowledge like a sponge in anticipation of one day producing and directing, also loved the way Demme embraced modern technology by using hand-held cameras whenever possible. He also laughs that Paris had a downside when it comes to filmmaking.

"The only thing that sucks about working in

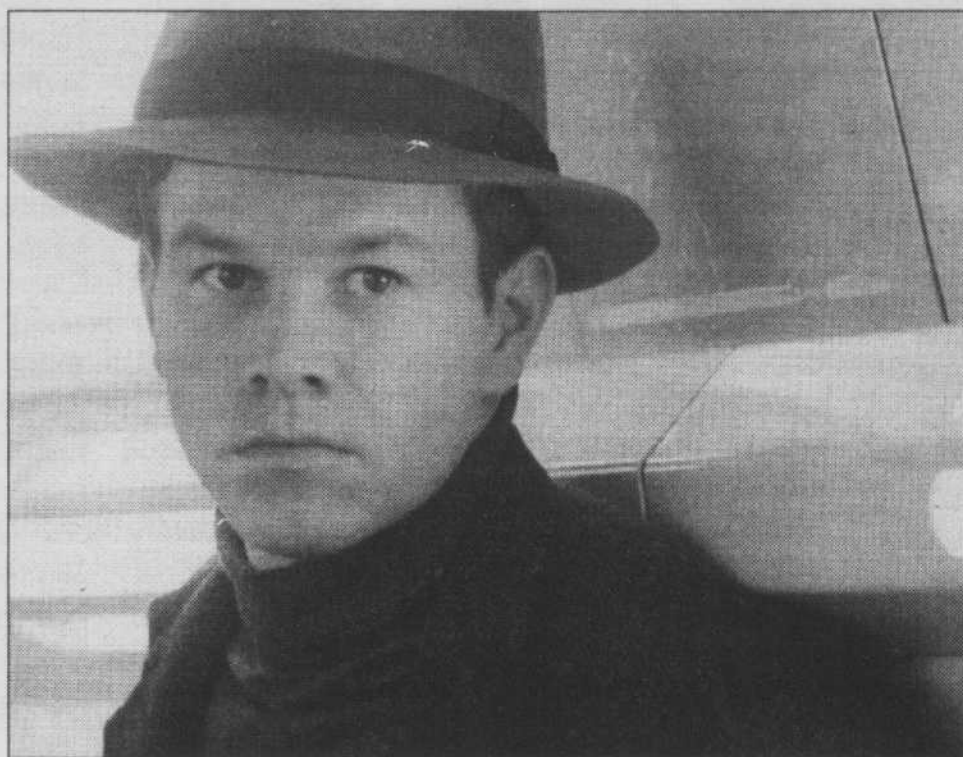
France is that you're required to drink a bottle of wine at lunch, and it's hard to keep up that sort of pace."

Wahlberg, 31, says that now, as in the original film his is a character who is constantly teasing and tantalizing the audience, leaving it in the dark as to whether he is a good guy or a bad guy.

"That was a lot of fun, but it was a fine line to walk because I always wanted to push the darker side."

Wahlberg will never forget his own darker side.

Even in the flush of stardom, he re-

fuses to draw a curtain over the fact that 15 years ago, when he was 16, he was imprisoned for beating up a Vietnamese man while drunk and high on pot, simply because he wanted a case of beer in the victim's possession.

It's almost as though he sees it as an obligation to remember his origins, whether when talking to the media or visiting troubled youth in boys' clubs. Yet, he says that if he hadn't gone through those experiences, he wouldn't be the person he is today.

"It was a tough road getting to where I am, but looking back now it seems nothing."

Wahlberg believes that everything that happens in life happens for a reason, and as a Roman Catholic, he believes that people are put in this life for a purpose.

Ask him to name the things that excite him, he quickly lists off "my work,

my spirituality, my maturing as an adult."

But perhaps his spirituality is most important.

"Everything has happened because of my spirituality. It's not something I try to advertise. It's just something that means the world to me. I have a hard time talking about it because people always think this is just some sort of image I'm trying to present - but it's just who I am."

He talks of the "wonderful" people who stood by him during his worst times.

"I didn't realize who they were. I was always trying to impress people that I thought were important - the guys on the corner. Thank God for those people who never gave up on me. So when I realized that I was basically being an idiot, I knew that what I needed to get back on the right track was to refocus my faith."

## Long layoff pays off for Keith Urban

Keith Urban travelled a long way before making it as a country singer. His musical journey took him from the Australian farm town of Caboolture to Music City.

Urban began playing guitar when he was six, trying to master chords so that he would be able to reproduce his father's favourites — Don Williams, Glen Campbell and Charley Pride to name a few.

By the time he turned seven, Urban knew that one day he would move to Nashville to become a country music singer. He started winning talent shows, and even formed a band that was booked at local clubs.

Numerous gigs and countless hours of practicing guitar eventually helped him develop a signature style, attracting EMI Australia. The company signed Urban in 1990, and he recorded his first solo album soon after, which charted four No. 1 hits.

Encouraged by that success, he decided that the time had come for him to move to Nashville in 1992, where he formed a three-piece band called The Ranch. Capitol Nashville almost immediately offered the trio a deal. Although

critics loved the group's innovative sound, the members disbanded and Urban returned to his solo career.

His self-titled solo debut in North America was certified gold. It produced three Top 5 hits, including the No. 1 hit 'But For The Grace of God'. He received many honors such as CMA's 2001 Horizon Award plus ACMA's 2001 Top New Male Vocalist Award and a Grammy nomination for his instrumental 'Rollercoaster'.

Urban is also an accomplished guitar player. His skills and dexterity earned him feature roles on albums for Garth Brooks and The Dixie Chicks. He is well respected by his peers as well as country music fans not only for his guitar playing but also for his songwriting abilities.

The self-confidence that comes with all the honors has given Urban a new strength to keep going on, thus Golden Road, his sophomore effort.

It's been a long time between albums (three years), but this new collection was well worth waiting for.

Urban's use of the Ganjo (guitar-banjo hybrid) gives the record a distinctive sound and special flavor — his dexterity as an instrumentalist can be heard through the whole album. He also wrote or co-wrote eight of the album's 12 songs, and he shows the same ability to decide which tunes will go on the album as he is talented for picking the guitar. If this album reflects his state of mind, we can say that he's in good spirit and willing to talk about love.

Different aspects of love are displayed here from joyous love to love for God and love for yourself. It is a positive album recorded by an artist who has all the reason to feel that way.

The debut single, 'Somebody Like you', is a good-time tune with the freedom feel of the 70's music, while 'Song For Dad' is written from a very personal point of view and is very elaborated with its rock orchestrations. Urban may push the boundaries of country music, but never far enough to stray too far.

Another good-time tune is 'You Look Good in My Shirt', while 'You're Not My God' is about Urban's battles with drug addiction. There's also 'You're Not Alone Tonight' about having faith.

In many songs listeners can hear Urban's influences, and maybe more on 'You'll Think of Me' a ballad about staying behind and the bitterness that someone can experience in such a situation.

Urban's melodies and lyrics are catchy and contagious. Despite the many musical influences, listeners can always hear his own unique style coming through. He covers Radney Foster's 'Raining on Sunday' and it works very well. He also wrote 'You Won' and 'What About Me' with Rodney Crowell.

The last cover is an old David Dundas' number titled 'Jeans On' which might be the only song that doesn't fit with the rest of this wonderful collection for diverse reasons.

All together it might be a little more raw than the first album, but it reflects Urban's personality with realism and gives listeners a chance to know him much better musically. The artist is definitely on the road to super stardom.

The deadline for applications is Nov. 13 for juried categories and Jan. 17, 2003 for categories with nominations based on sales.

Submissions are open to Canadian artists, songwriters, recording engineers, and video producers (citizen or landed immigrant) who have released product during the period of Sept. 1, 2001 to Dec. 31, 2002. In the case of juried categories, the cut-off date for submissions is Nov. 13 to accommodate the critical path for nominating and voting. Individuals and

their representatives are welcomed to apply.

While certain categories such as International Album of the Year or Francophone Album of the Year are determined by sales, most of the categories are determined by ballot vote or by a panel of expert judges.

The 2002 JUNO Awards Telecast will be broadcast by CTV in April. Information related to the location and date will

be confirmed in the coming weeks.

CARAS is a not-for-profit organization created to preserve and enhance the Canadian music and recording industries and to contribute towards higher artistic and industry standards. The main focus of the organization is the exploration and development of opportunities to showcase and promote Canadian artists and music through television vehicles such as the Juno Awards.
