To all to whom these presents shall come or whom  
the same may concern. Greeting

Whereas it is expedient to erect into a Township a certain Tract  
of our waste Land situate lying and being in our Superior District of Gaspé in our said Province  
and in and by the Report of Thomas Parke Esquire our Surveyor General of our said Province made  
and certified to the Administrator of our Government of our said Province described as bounded on  
the South by the rear bounds of Seigniorie of Shoobred, on the North by our waste lands on the  
East by the Township of Carleton, in the said Superior District and on the West by the Township  
of Mann in the said Superior District - Beginning at the North East corner of the said Seigniorie  
of Shoobred on the western boundary line of the said Township of Carleton thence running along the  
rear boundary lines of the said Seigniorie of Shoobred westerly to the North western corner of the said  
Seigniorie thence astronomically North one degree thirty minutes East to the depth of Ten miles from the  
Bay or river Restigouche thence on a direct line Easterly to the North western corner of the said  
Township of Carleton, thence along the said western line of the Township of Carleton astronomically South  
one degree thirty minutes West to the place of beginning - The superficial contents of the said Tract of  
waste Land being about Sixty thousand acres of land more or less

Now know ye that we of our especial Grace certain knowledge  
and full power have created erected and constituted, and by these presents do create erect

and constitute the said Tract of our waste Land so as aforesaid herein before described, and every part and parcel thereof a Township forever hereafter to be continue and remain a Township and by the name of Nouvelle for ever hereafter to be called known and distinguished.

And we do moreover of our especial Grace certain knowledge and mere motion, declare that these our Letters Patent shall be good and effectual in Law to all intents constructions and purposes whatsoever, notwithstanding any misbording misnaming or other imperfections or omissions of or concerning the said Tract of land hereby erected into the Township of Nouvelle as aforesaid,

In Testimony whereof we have caused these our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of our said Province to be hereunto affixed.

Witness, our Trusty and well Beloved Sir Richard Dames Jackson, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Administrator of the Government of our Province of Canada, and Commander of our Forces in British North America.

At our Government House, in our Town of Kingston, in our said Province of Canada, the ~~10<sup>th</sup>~~ day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two, and in the fifth year of our Reign.
