Wandering Wainwright wonders what's next

*Sherbrooke had
second chance
to see rising star*

The seemingly delicate, saucy vocals of Martha Wainwright floated through the Granada Theatre last night, her second visit to the historic stage in less than a year.

It has been a big year for Montreal-born Wainwright, who has been touring North America and beyond virtually non-stop since her first full-length album — *Martha Wainwright* — was released early in 2005.

"I've been really busy, though it's really great to go to places like Australia, all over Europe, or up to Tadoussac, and Alma, and Lac Saint-Jean," said Wainwright.

The singer-songwriter was speaking to *The Record* via cell phone as she ducked into a Starbucks in New York, the city she now calls home.

On stage Wainwright is comfortable and confident and fast to engage her audience. Not only did she grow up surrounded by music, it's in her genes. She is the daughter of renowned musicians Loudon Wainwright III and Kate McGarrigle, and brother of Rufus.

Wainwright is proud of her family's musical roots — her brother appears on her album. While she said her connections helped attract early attention, it was up to her to make her own way.

"I always knew that I was going to have to prove myself anyway. There might be people who would come and see me play because of who my parents are, but if they didn't like it they wouldn't be coming back."

In spite of her family tree, like any emerging artist, Wainwright said she was walking on eggshells as she entered the musical fray with her first album:

"I'm pretty relieved the critics were kind and they didn't pan my record. It would have been really difficult to come home for Christmas if people hated it. Generally, I think things have gone pretty well."

Wainwright's album and performances have left a trail of rave reviews in her wake. Late last year, she released another five-song EP in Canada — *I Will Internalize* — and a special edition of her album in the United Kingdom. She's riding high, but that means there's pressure to get back in the studio to record another album.

"This is the first time I've really had a deadline, in a way. Hopefully this last year on the road has given me something to write about. We'll see. If not, I'll have to have my parents write lyrics, and my brother, and I'll just steal them from them," she suggested jokingly.

Wainwright doesn't know what form her next album will take.

"I don't usually have very defined musical thoughts about something until I start to hear things and get into the studio and do things."

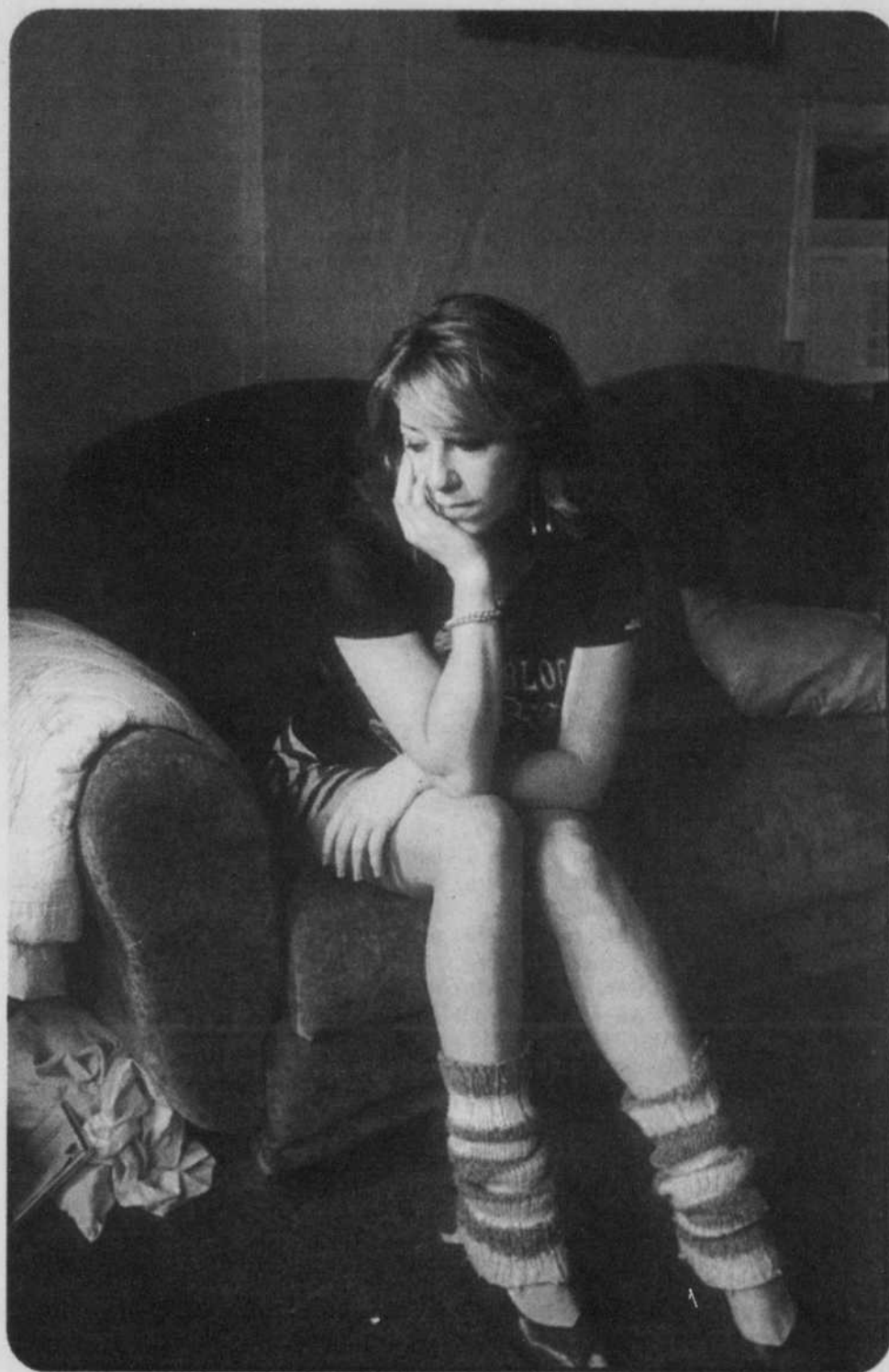
She said there are a few songs in her repertoire that didn't make the first album that she may release on her next album, and added there are also many songs already out there she would love to cover. Wainwright hopes to draw on her hectic year of touring for her new material, but she said it's not her style to write on the road.

"I don't like to write on the road because I'm very private and embarrassed. I've been on the road with seven smelly guys in a tour bus. They're like my children," she said, noting things are about to slow down, in spite of the fact her tour schedule will take her to Australia and Europe in the coming months.

"I've written a few songs that I think are pretty good. This time is about writing, gathering songs, going into the studio, and starting to think about the next record."

With thoughts of her next album in the back of her mind, Wainwright said she was looking forward to a more relaxed tour schedule. Though she said, as always, she was happy to return to the stage at the Granada theatre and her home province.

"Playing Quebec is always the treat for me. Audiences are always incredibly warm."

No shortcuts needed with creamy béchamel sauce

Food

With the advent of ready-made powdered sauces, many of us gave up on making them *comme il faut*, from scratch. Some of my friends even tend to (mistakenly) associate classic sauces with hard work! The truth is that many sauces are quite easy to make, and simply taste better and fresher than those whipped up using industrialized powders. Take the béchamel, for example. This classic, creamy white sauce is ultra-versatile, and can be ready in 20 short minutes. Here I pair it with fusilli, because it's what I had in my cupboard, but it works just as well poured over chicken breasts, broccoli or almost anything else you might want to cook up. My version is a bit bolder than the blander, traditional one, since I add a bouillon cube and parmesan cheese. I find it has more flavour this way, and I hope you'll agree when you try it at home!

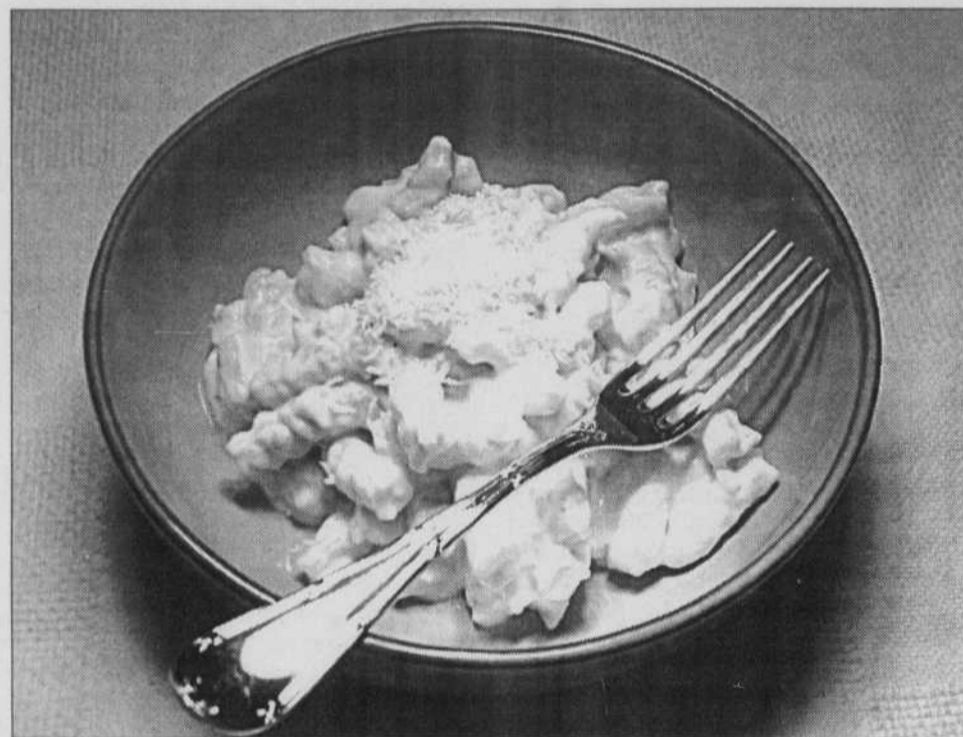
salted butter
3 tbsp. all-purpose flour
1 L 3.25% milk
1 cube chicken bouillon
1 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese
1 pinch freshly grated nutmeg
white pepper to taste

Peel and finely chop the onion. In a non-stick pot, melt the butter then sauté the onion over moderately low heat, stirring, until it is softened. Stir in the flour and

cook, for about three minutes, until it is bubbling and deep golden in colour. Don't let it brown. This paste is called a roux, and will thicken the sauce.

Add the milk in a stream, whisking vigorously until the mixture is smooth. Add the pinch of nutmeg, the bouillon cube and the white pepper, and simmer the sauce for 15 to 20 minutes, stirring often, until it is thickened to the desired consistency. Taste it and add salt if necessary (you probably won't need to, since both the butter and the bouillon cube are salted already). In the meantime, bring water to a boil in another pot, then add salt and a drizzle of oil. Cook the pasta until al dente, then drain.

Mix the pasta, the parmesan and the

white sauce, and let the dish sit for a few minutes. Don't worry if it looks too liquid: the longer it sits, the more it will thicken. And you can always re-heat it in the microwave, if necessary. Serve

with more grated parmesan on the side. If you want to save the sauce for later use, make sure you cover the surface with plastic wrap to prevent a skin from forming.

The Ancient Grain Salad is a pleasant contrast of nutty, earthy flavours of the grains with the lighter, sweeter flavours of the vegetables and currants. Fresh, colourful and satisfying, this is delicious as a side salad or portable lunch.

Oven-cooked old-time favourites make the most of B.C.'s blueberry

bounty. Blueberry Buckle coffee-cake-style dessert is dappled with fresh blueberries and sprinkled with a crispy streusel topping. Our homey version is the kind of dessert your grandmother might have made when the kids came home from picking wild berries. We've added a little grated orange zest and stirred it into the batter, imparting a subtle citrus flavour.

ANCIENT GRAIN SALAD

Serves four
Salad

1/2 cup (125 mL) kamut kernels
1/2 cup (125 mL) spelt kernels
1/2 cup (125 mL) drained, canned corn
1/2 cup (125 mL) diced red bell pepper
1/2 cup (125 mL) currants
2 tablespoons (30 mL) sliced green onion
Salt and pepper

Vinaigrette

1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon natural rice vinegar
1 1/4 teaspoons (6 mL) liquid honey
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) dijon mustard
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) salt
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) pepper
3 tablespoons (45 mL) olive oil
1 tablespoon finely chopped shallot
3/4 teaspoon (4 mL) minced fresh ginger

1 tablespoon (15 mL) chopped fresh cilantro

Salad: In medium saucepan, bring 4 cups (1 L) water to a boil. Add kamut and spelt kernels; bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low, cover and simmer for about 45 minutes or until kernels are tender (kernels will still be chewy). Let kernels drain in sieve for about 1 1/2 hours or until room temperature, stirring occasionally.

In large bowl, combine kernels, corn, bell pepper, currants and onion.

Vinaigrette: In small bowl, whisk together vinegar, honey, mustard, salt and pepper. Gradually whisk in oil. Whisk in shallot, ginger and cilantro. Drizzle vinaigrette over salad; toss to coat. Add salt and pepper to taste. Cover tightly and refrigerate overnight or until chilled.

BLUEBERRY BUCKLE

Serves nine

Topping

1/4 cup (50 mL) all-purpose flour
1/4 cup (50 mL) packed brown sugar
1/4 cup (50 mL) granulated sugar
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) ground cinnamon
1/4 cup butter, at room temperature

Batter

3/4 cup (175 mL) granulated sugar

1/4 cup butter, at room temperature
2 large eggs

1 teaspoon (5 mL) grated orange zest
1 teaspoon (5 mL) pure vanilla extract
2 cups (500 mL) all-purpose flour
2 teaspoons (10 mL) baking powder
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) salt
1/2 cup (125 mL) buttermilk
2 cups (500 mL) blueberries

Topping: In small bowl, combine flour, brown and granulated sugars, and cinnamon. Using back of fork, cut in butter until mixture is crumbly.

Batter: In large bowl, beat sugar and butter until fluffy. Beat in eggs, one at a time. Beat in zest and vanilla.

In medium bowl, combine flour, baking powder and salt. Stir flour mixture and buttermilk alternately into egg mixture, beginning and ending with flour mixture. Stir in blueberries.

Spread batter evenly in greased 8-inch (20 cm) square baking dish. Sprinkle evenly with topping.

Bake at 375 F (190 C) for 40 to 45 minutes or until top springs back when lightly pressed in the centre, covering loosely with foil during last 15 minutes of baking time. Let cool in baking dish on rack. Cut into squares.

Canadian Arts Coalition launches election Web site

The Canadian Arts Coalition, the largest consortium of artists and arts organizations ever assembled in Canada, has launched Votearts2006.ca, a Web site devoted to keeping the arts front and centre during the federal election campaign.

The site provides interactivity for Canadians to express their support for the arts and endorse the recent increase to the Canada Council for the Arts announced by the federal government.

The Coalition, made up of artists, arts executives and business leaders from across the country, is united for one purpose: To increase, by \$5 per Canadian, funding to the arts channeled through the Canada Council for the Arts.

"Last month, the Government of Canada recognized the importance of the arts in the lives of Canadians by making the historic announcement that it would invest \$306 million in the Canada Council for the Arts — bringing its annual allocation to more than \$300 million," praised a Coalition spokesperson, Sarah Iley, of the Canadian Arts Summit, one of the many organizations supporting the Coalition.

"The federal government and Parliamentarians from all across Canada heard and understood our message.

And now the Coalition remains united during this election period to ensure that this essential funding becomes a reality once a new government is elected.

"Traditionally, the arts have not been a focal point in federal election campaigns, but the Canadian Arts Coalition is working to change that.

"Canada's arts community is focused like never before and the Votearts2006.ca Website is one of the ways we will be advancing the interests of the arts community to benefit all Canadians during the election period."

Designed by Toronto's ecentricarts inc., the Web site is an interactive tool to enable voters to make their voices heard.

It provides:

- information on the current state of funding of the arts;
- direct ways to reach all federal party candidates through e-mail, phone and mail;
- information on the value of the arts to Canada, and
- comments by community and arts leaders about the importance of arts investment.

The Web site will evolve through the federal election campaign, providing updates on arts related issues and other features.

Savoie, Lacroix Exhibits At MBA

January is the perfect month for art lovers to head to Sherbrooke's Museum of Fine Arts. Those who haven't seen the exhibitions of the works of Paul Lacroix and Maurice Savoie still have an opportunity — the Lacroix exhibit ends Jan. 15 while Savoie's (*Playful Matters*) wraps up the following week. Savoie (pictured), a Sherbrooke native, is the 2004 laureate of both the Prix Paul-Émile Borduas and the Saidye Bronfman Prize for excellence in the crafts. He is one of Canada's pre-eminent ceramic artists, and his career in Canada and abroad has spanned more than 50 years. The 30 works shown in this venue prove that ceramic can stand on its own as a creative object that seek to inspire. There are also 40 works by Quebec City artist Lacroix, who began his career more than 40 years ago and is best known for his drawings and photographs. Persephone is a most unusual publishing house

It's a book shop unlike any other in London — and it is the public face of a publishing firm unique in the English-speaking world.

You find Persephone Books tucked away in an 18th Century building in Bloomsbury on a mysterious little thoroughfare called Lamb's Conduit Street. Famed mystery novelist Dorothy L. Sayers lived nearby and Virginia Woolf knew the neighbourhood intimately.

Indeed, it is characteristic of Persephone's philosophy that its list of publications should include one of Woolf's least-known books — the 1933 *Flush* which is a comic "biography" of Elizabeth Barrett Browning's spaniel.

You can order *Flush* through Persephone's excellent Web site (www.persephonebooks.co.uk) which ships all over the world. Or you can purchase a copy at this tiny and utterly charming book store, although the odds are high that you will leave with more than one item.

Persephone editions can be addictive. So can the shop itself — with its elegant furniture, colourful flower arrangements and unusual window displays. But the books are the most striking component — some on shelves, some in tempting stacks, and all of them with identical silver covers which exude their own warm texture.

They also carry their own sense of dramatic discovery: Open one of those volumes and the endpapers explode in a riot of colours based on fabric designs dating back to the year the book was written. This is a business full of surprises.

It is, as Persephone founder Nicola Beauman cheerfully admits, "a funny little shop." It essentially stocks Persephone's 60-odd titles and nothing else. The only exceptions are found in one small bookcase: It contains a few titles from other houses that she wishes she had published.

Persephone exists, not because of Beauman's desire for huge profits (they're non-existent) but because of a passion for books by 20th Century fe-

male writers — most of them now forgotten.

And since she established her little publishing firm six years ago, it has won a devoted following from both critics and public alike.

Beauman, herself a writer, had published *A Very Great Profession: The Women's Novel: 1914-1939* more than a decade ago. Her researches had left her painfully aware of the enormous number of lost books by largely forgotten 20th Century woman writers.

"I just thought there were these amazing books, so I would do them," she says matter-of-factly. "It was no deeper than that."

She decided to launch her own "feminist" press but one markedly different from Britain's best-known, feminist publisher, Virago, which had in fact published some of the authors mentioned in her study.

Virago, she says pleasantly but firmly, tends to be interested in "Feminism with a capital 'F' — what is loosely called the bra-burning feminist."

Beauman tends to be more interested in a softer, more domestic feminism — or, as she defines it, "feminism with a little 'f' which encompasses noble lives where people have husbands and families."

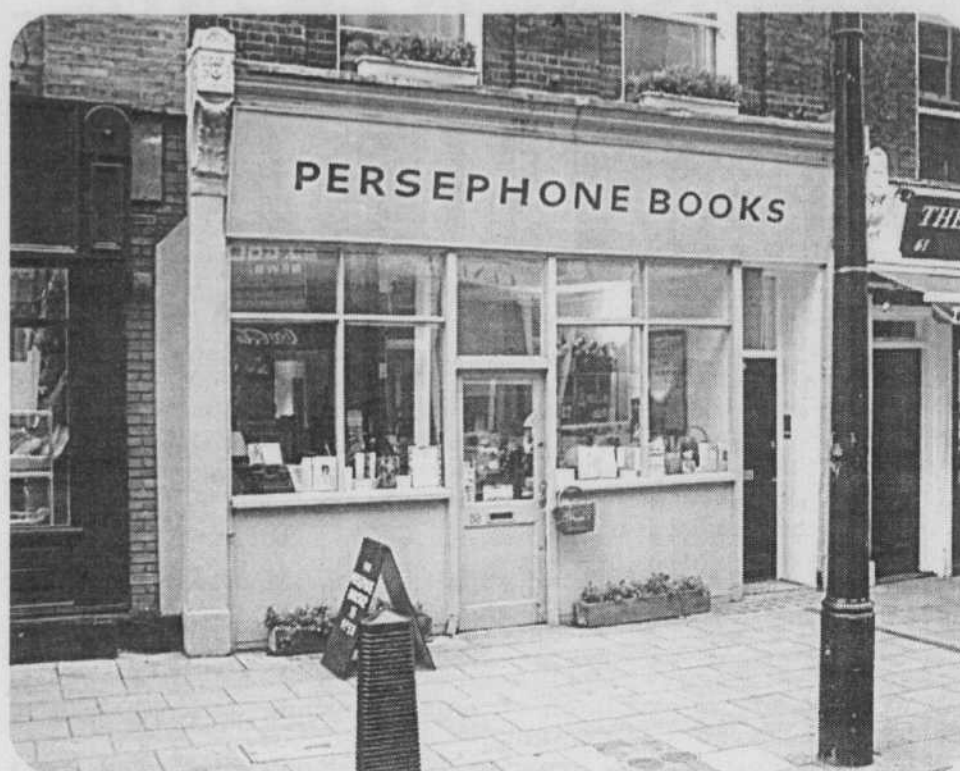
Beauman was a huge admirer of a forgotten British novelist named Dorothy Whipple — a writer that "Virago had always laughed at" — and her determination to restore Whipple to print was a key factor in her decision to start up Persephone.

Whipple's *Someone At A Distance*, a 1953 study of a disintegrating marriage, was one of three books which launched the firm.

"Dorothy Whipple is a domestic novelist but an amazing writer — very very subtle. She's always quite hard on women for not knowing what's going on, but she has this other incredible quality — which is story. She knows how to tell a story."

Those first Persephone publications also included Monica Dickens' *Mariana* about a young girl's life in the 1930s: "I wanted to make it clear from

the start that we were not going to be kind of highly intellectual, I'm not frightened of the middlebrow."

She also offered her first readers a neglected book that Beauman considers to be a literary masterpiece — Cicely Hamilton's 1918 novel, *William — An Englishman*, about the effect of the First World War on a suffragette and a socialist clerk.

Since then, the Persephone list has moved from strength to strength.

Canada's Ethel Wilson — "a great novelist that nobody takes any notice of" — is there with *Hetty Dorval*, which was successfully featured recently at one of the firm's popular discussion groups.

Noel Streatfield, an enormously popular children's writer, is represented on the list with one of her few adult novels, *Saplings*.

Another best-selling favourite from long ago, Helen Ashton, has made the list with *Bricks And Mortar*, which deals with the life of a London architect in the early years of the 20th Century.

The list is eclectic, ranging from the

recent reprint of *How To Run Your Home Without Help*, a long-neglected book now restored to vigorous life by Persephone, to Agnes Jekyll's *Kitchen Essays*, a witty 1932 volume about the art of cooking, to *The World That Was Ours*, the harrowing memoir of South African Hilda Bernstein whose husband was arrested and tried with Nelson Mandela.

Each soft-covered book, no matter how bulky, sells for a flat 10 pounds (Approximately \$21 Canadian). Purchase three and the total price goes down. Beauman cheerfully concedes that Persephone, which she operates with a tiny staff, is not a huge money-making machine.

The bookshop opened four years ago, a couple of doors down from an old pub, and it's become an integral part of the landscape — the place where you can drop in for a glass of Persephone mulled wine when the street fair is happening.

"We don't make a lot of money. We pay our rent here from people coming off the street."

Mochrie shines in new CBC series

Getting Along Famously is a hoot. A throwback and an original at the same time, Colin Mochrie's comic paean to the golden age of early '60s variety shows is full of gentle humour and silly sight gags.

Mochrie plays Kip Delaney, composer/musician husband to Canada's sweetheart, Ruby Kendall (Debra McGrath). Together, they are the stars of the hit 1964 CBC variety show *It's Ruby and Kip*, which has fallen on hard times: It has recently slipped from its No. 1 spot on the network, mirroring the rollercoaster lives of the off-screen couple.

Getting Along Famously relies on the usual sitcom set-ups — much of the humour comes from family members quarrelling, insulting each other and trading barbs, a formula that has worked in everything from *All in the Family* to *Everybody Loves Raymond*.

The retro setting makes Getting Along Famously feel different, however. In comic spirit, it most resembles Jimmy MacDonald's *Canada*, CBC's loving summer tribute to black-and-white archival clips and days of live television.

Mochrie, best known for his improv work in *Whose Line Is It Anyway?*, has split-second timing and an eye for wacky character detail: His Kip Delaney is talented but insecure. Egotistical but needy. Bitchy but benevolent.

McGrath is pitch perfect as the diva-in-waiting; watching the couple play off each other is like stepping back in a time machine to the screwball comedies of the 1940s.

Casual viewers may be mystified by some of the inside jokes — Getting Along Famously feels like an updated take on *On the Air*, *Twin Peaks* producer Mark Frost's short-lived 1992 insider comedy about a big, brassy off-the-rails TV variety show.

Getting Along Famously is fast, funny and frantic, with some of the most bizarre musical numbers this side of *Family Guy* — but without *Family Guy*'s crudity. Getting Along Famously is a

safe, unthreatening and entertaining way to spend half an hour in front of the tube on an otherwise slow Friday night. CBC

• Mary Walsh is funny — we know this. It's a shame, then, that based on early evidence, her noisy, disjointed new comedy *Hatching, Matching & Dispatching* isn't as funny as it should be.

Humour is subjective, of course, and others may find laughs in Walsh's dark satire about an eccentric family that provides wedding, ambulance and funeral services to the residents of a small town on Newfoundland's fishing coast.

There's something innately crude, however, about a gag that relies on a dead body and a potato for comic effect (trust me, you don't want to know), or a laboured comparison between gay sex and having a bowel movement.

And there's something innately lowering about the way the writers just won't let the potato gag go: The scene drags on for almost a full minute, an eternity in TV time.

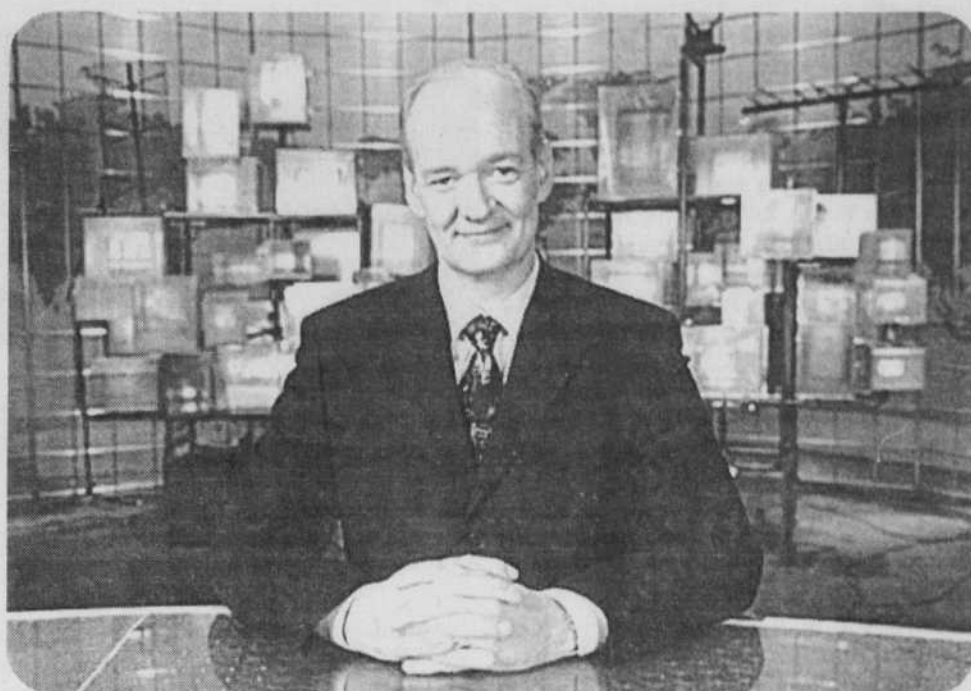
Hatching, Matching & Dispatching is part *Trailer Park Boys*, part *Little Britain*, the cult BBC comedy about the wacky denizens of a small village in Britain, but it has none of *Little Britain* or *Trailer Park Boys*' easy charm: Walsh and fellow cast members Shaun Majumder, Mark McKinney, Todd Meaney and Rick Boland try so hard the seams show.

That doesn't mean *Hatching* isn't worth a look, however. These are early days yet, and the series may right itself before the season is out. Walsh is always watchable; there's a charge of energy every time she appears on the screen.

The eccentrics of fictional *Cats Gut Cove* may grow on you after a while, too — *Hatching* was filmed in the real-life Nfld. towns of Torbay and Petty Harbour — and promising TV comedies almost always need a season or two to find their voice.

It'll have to hurry, though. True to CBC form, only six half-hour episodes have been made — three hours in all, or less time than many miniseries.

Hatching is more quirky and less pre-

dictable than most Friday-night sitcoms these days. That's reason alone to give it a chance. CBC

• Canadian television is in a strange state at the moment.

A new Mary Walsh comedy set on her home ground of Newfoundland warrants just six episodes from the public broadcaster, but a private-broadcaster documentary series about West Coast stunt performers warrants 13 episodes on the pay-TV movie channels *Movie Central* and *The Movie Network*.

Stuntdaws focuses on Peter H. Kent, Arnold Schwarzenegger's former stunt double — not the veteran newsman — and the technique and technology behind those big-bang moments that propel many of today's Hollywood movies.

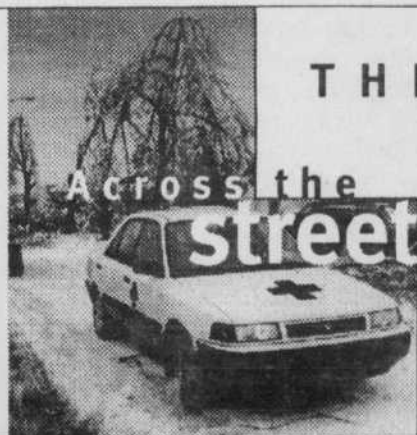
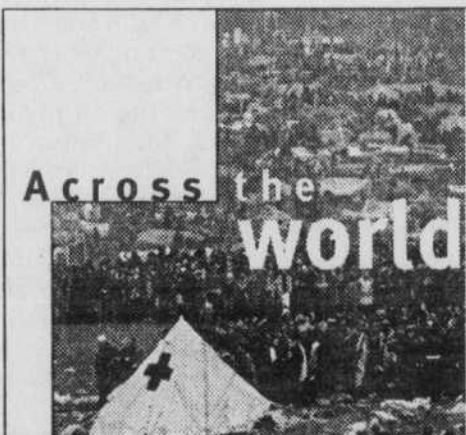
The series follows Kent as he works the stunt circuit in B.C.'s film industry, coaching and advising local stunt performers on pulling off death-defying feats without getting themselves killed.

In tonight's opener, Kent coaches a relative newcomer on the proper way to be blown through a plate-glass window — a relatively standard "gag," as insiders call them, in today's movies.

It's a fascinating and honest look at the nitty gritty of big-budget filmmaking. Anyone who has spent time on a film set will recognize the cool, steely-eyed determination and professionalism of the film crews at work — Vancouver has a reputation in Hollywood as having some of the best crews in the world, which has done nothing to ease the simmering tensions over runaway production in L.A.

Stuntdaws won't win any points for style. It's basic, observational documentary filmmaking. What it does do is provide a clear-eyed, unglamorous look at what really goes into pulling off a big movie stunt and it's fascinating to see. *Movie Central*, *Movie Network*

Hoodwinked a cheeky take on fable *Movies*

Cory Edwards wants your kids to get Hoodwinked, and he's doing all he can to make sure you will, too.

The United States-based filmmaker set out to make an animated kids movie based on Little Red Riding Hood, and over the course of some creative meetings with his business partners and his one key investor, he ended up with Hoodwinked — a cheeky take on the Red Riding Hood fable with a slightly new twist: This version of Red is recounted by several different key characters within the drama, and each one has a slightly different version of the truth.

"It was my brother who actually called and brought up the idea of doing Red Riding Hood with a Rashomon treatment," says Edwards of his filmmaking sibling Todd, who directed the 1999 Sundance film *Chillicothe*.

"He thought it would be a good idea to intertwine the two ideas for a kids' movie. And when I thought about it, I figured he was right because kids are more familiar with the structure than you might think," he says.

"It's a popular device now. We've seen it in other movies such as *Pulp Fiction* and *Run Lola Run*, even several TV shows have adopted it. I think kids get a lot more than you think. I remember when I was a kid and I got things pretty quickly."

It was Edwards' early ability to make movies that sent him down the road of filmmaking and got him started as a

music video director. He says his parents would often come home to find a "papier mache monstrosity" on the front lawn.

"In the movie business, I think you really have to be a self-starter. No one comes knocking, looking for movie directors. I've been doing this for a while now, and this whole film was created entirely outside the studio system — which is pretty tough, especially for a movie that uses computer animation. People have a high degree of expectation thanks to the work of Pixar and other big studios," says Edwards.

For a while, Edwards and his team

were thinking of doing a stop-motion piece, but that was limiting.

"You only get once chance at it with stop-motion, and if it doesn't work, you can't go back and redo it another way without wasting a lot of time and money. The computer gives you a lot of flexibility."

Once they decided on the computers over stop-motion, the next big worry was budget. Would they have enough cash to create something competitive?

For their chief investor, finding a story that was familiar — and didn't cost much — was key.

"It was all about finding a story in the-public domain," says Edwards.

In other words, the story is free, which explains why so many fairy tales are recreated over and over again on celluloid: there are no rights clearances to throw the budget off-balance.

"With the script itself, it was all about making it funny. We focused on what made us laugh, or situations with the characters that might be funny. Our gold standard was early *Bugs Bunny*. *Bugs Bunny* taught me about comedy — and it's all timing, timing, timing."

Timing was also key to landing a deal with the Weinstein brothers, who will release the film under their newly formed Weinstein Company banner.

"Bob and Harvey got involved towards the end of the production — when we were about 80 to 90 per cent finished — and they were the ones who enabled us to get the talent we did. We had other voices in there, just to keep production going, but when we got the Weinsteins interested, that opened a lot of doors."

At the moment, Edwards is just tickled he got *Hoodwinked* finished the way he wanted it. The real hard part is just beginning, he says.

"I've been working on this for a while now, and to have it all this close to being in a theatre is so exciting. There's a lot riding on it and we hope we've created a great popcorn experience, but right now the hardest part of all is waiting."

Now that the entertainment year is well under way — or, to put it another way, now that we've extended our Christmas holiday long enough that *Grandma's Boy* is safely behind us — it's time to look ahead to all the excitement and thrills that 2006 has in store for us.

Fasten your seatbelts everyone: It's going to be a bumpy ride, and due to declining revenues, no lunch will be served. And remember, these aren't the things that have to happen, but just the things that will happen if you don't change your ways.

MOVIES

- *Brokeback Mountain* tops the list of Oscar winners, setting off an immediate scramble by Hollywood studios to produce films about homosexual cowboys. Titles announced the next day include *Butch, Cassidy and the Tapdance Kid*, *Gunfight at the Fabulous Corral*, *Queer Eye for the Good*, the *Bad* and the

Ugly, and an adult-only Western entitled *The Magnificent Seven and a Half*.

- The success of family movies based on increasingly marginal children's stories, including last year's *Chicken Little*, encourages animation companies to announce a series of feature-length cartoons disinterring forgotten, once-beloved characters such as *Goosey Goose Gander* and *Wee Willie Winkie*. Rival studios immediately launch a lawsuit claiming both titles have already been registered for upcoming films about homosexual cowboys.

- The success of penguins as main characters (*March of the Penguins*) and supporting players (*Madagascar*) inspires Hollywood to radically extend its horizons in the fields of both wildlife documentaries and family animations by making such groundbreaking films as *March of the Penguins 2* and *Madagascar Goes Hawaiian*.

- The film version of *The DaVinci Code* is a smash hit, sparking a debate in the theological community about whether Christ was married and the

true role of women in Christianity. In Hollywood, it inspires plans for a prequel entitled *When Jesus Met Mary*.

TRENDS

- A continuing drop in revenues persuades the movie industry to try new money-making tactics. These include raising ticket prices to \$15; selling new expensive snacks in such hard-to-ignore flavours as onion, garlic, and curry; increasing the number of lucrative, pre-feature advertisements for beer, cars and membership in the U.S. Marine Corps; making sure-fire sequels — in 2006 alone the actual, no-kidding list includes *Big Momma's House 2*, *Basic Instinct 2*, *Scary Movie IV*, *X-Men 3*, *Superman Returns*, *Pirates of the Caribbean: Dead Man's Chest*, *The Santa Claus 3* and the 25th *James Bond* film, *Casino Royale* — and making more films that are spinoffs of the dwindling pool of television programs that have not yet come to the big screen, which at this stage comprise only *The Life of Riley* and *My Little Margie*.

CELEBRITIES

- The Tom Cruise-Katie Holmes relationship — already in tough shape after he met her family over the holidays and they apparently decided he had been jumping on couches that he should have been lying on — is put on hiatus. Meanwhile, the Angelina Jolie-Brad Pitt duo known as *Brangelina* splits up, as Pitt pursues Jennifer Garner, recently divorced from Ben Affleck who takes up with Jennifer Aniston, forming *Beniston*. Cruise, still looking for *Wife No. 3*, forms a liaison with Jolie, and the couple is known in the tabloids as *Thumbelina*.

- Tom Cruise, Katie Holmes, Angelina Jolie, Brad Pitt, Ben Affleck, Billy Bob Thornton, Jennifer Garner, Jennifer Lopez, Jennifer Aniston and everyone else in Hollywood named Jennifer all mysteriously disappear from the public eye in mid-year. They all resurface in Christmas movies about gay cowboys who have adopted penguins.

Land of legend

Wales has to be one of the most convivial places on earth. It enjoys breathtaking scenery, melodic village choirs, and, with its Celtic heritage, a tradition of literary excellence that includes the likes of Dylan Thomas, Robert Graves, and Dafydd Ap Gwilym.

In the works of contemporary mystery novelist Rhys Bowen we find the same regard for the well-turned phrase, the same eye for the beauty of the Welsh landscape, and the same ear for the idiosyncrasies and cadence of the Welsh language.

THE AUTHOR

Bowen was born in Bath, England, not far from the Welsh border. As a child she spent summers with her aunt in a little village in Wales. After completing her schooling in England, Austria and Germany, Rhys went to work with the BBC in London, which broadcast her first play, *Dandelion Hours*, followed by several other plays.

The urge for sunshine drove Rhys to move to Australia, where she met her future husband, also a native of England. They relocated to San Francisco in 1966, where they have lived ever since.

Lacking a market for her plays in the U.S., Rhys sought a different outlet for her creative urges. Her first children's picture book, published under the name Janet Quin-Harkin, won several awards and established Rhys in a new career.

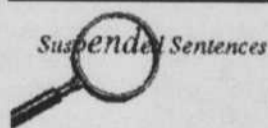
Children's books, young adult books, adult historical romances and sagas followed until she decided it was finally time to turn her hand to what she enjoyed reading most: Mysteries — the sort of mystery that gives the reader a genuine sense of time and place as well as a rattling good story.

As she reflected on her childhood summers spent with relatives in North Wales, Rhys realized she had a great setting for a mystery series: The wily publican, the domineering landlady, the battling ministers, the postman who reads people's mail, the local constable who struggles to keep the peace while not alienating his neighbours — all existed in villages very like Llanfair.

EVAN'S GATE (2004)

Like other novels in this series, *Evan's Gate* is set in the village of Llanfair, in rural North Wales. During the

course of renovating his cottage, Constable Evan Evans (yes, you read correctly) begins to dig a water line outside his front door. To his horror he soon uncovers the skeleton of a small child.

Evans believes it is the body of a former playmate of his, who had vanished in the mountains decades earlier. Adding to the mystery, another child has recently disappeared, while playing on a nearby beach.

The girls are very similar in appearance, and the family of the earlier child have only recently returned to the region. Evans is forced to consider the possibility that there is a serial killer lurking amidst the tranquility of rural Wales.

Adding to the complications in his life, Bronwen, his bride-to-be, questions his relationship with the attractive (and pushy) American forensic scientist investigating the case, who clearly has set her sights on the unsuspecting constable.

Before he solves the case Evans must confront the legend of the Twlwyth Teg — fairies who live in the mountains, and abduct little children.

RECOMMENDATION

Bowen offers the reader an enjoyable alternative to hard-boiled crime novels and gritty thrillers. She manages the difficult task of combining a light touch and a sense of humour with plots that are deeper and more serious than those found in most cozies.

Reminiscent of M.C. Beaton's *Hamish MacBeth* novels set in the Scottish Highlands, Bowen's *Constable Evans* series perfectly captures the ambiance of the landscape and the unique qualities of the people who live there.

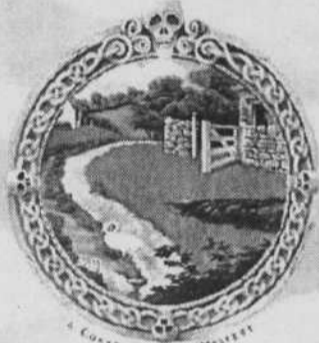
Evan's Gate succeeds in combining not one, but two mysteries set against the engaging world of an appealing cast of characters in an idyllic setting.

Other novels in the *Constable Evans* series include *Evan Blessed* (2005), *Evan Only Knows* (2003), *Evans to Betsy* (2002), *Evan Can Wait* (2001), the deliciously titled *Evan & Elle* (2000), *Evanly Choirs* (1999), *Evan Help Us* (1998), and the first in the series, *Evans Above* (1997).

In addition to her *Constable Evans* series, Rhys has written a mystery series set in New York City during the early part of the 20th century.

ROBERTO OCCHIPINTI

Yemaya

(Alma Records)

For a young man, Toronto bassist Roberto Occhipinti has an impressive discography, one which just got better with this new disc from Alma Records. Talk about an international effort. Occhipinti's septet, the Music Toronto String Quartet and the additional horns all recorded in Toronto, the 13 Cuban percussionists and singers added their tracks in Havana, and the Globalis Symphony Orchestra, heard on three of the nine songs, laid down their contribution in Moscow. The resulting Afro-Cuban-jazz-meets-classical-music fusion works very well. An example of this is 'El Otro Tipo', a sharply rhythmic Occhipinti original with crisp drumming by Ernesto Simpson, embracing orchestral work from the Globalis unit and outstanding solos by pianist Hilario Duran and tenor saxophonist Phil Dwyer.

Shostakovich: Piano Trios No. 1 and 2; Seven Romances

This late-2005 release manages to commemorate both the centenary of Shostakovich's birth (2006) and the 50th anniversary of the Beaux Arts Trio (2005). To answer the first question, pianist Menachem Pressler, the founding pianist and quarterback of the trio, is 83 years young, and still a master colourist as well as keyboardist, notably in the lyrical Trio No. 1, a teenage mash-note that nonetheless manages to sound fully by the bespectacled composer we know and love. Whiz-kid violinist Daniel Hope sounds properly parched and modern in the Allegro con brio movement of the better-known 'Trio No. 2', and British soprano Joan Rodgers, a Russian-studies graduate, sings the 'Seven Romances on Verses' by Alexander Blok with deep passion (not to say a fine cello obbligato in the first song by Antonio Meneses). Shostakovich and the Beaux Arts are both doing fine.

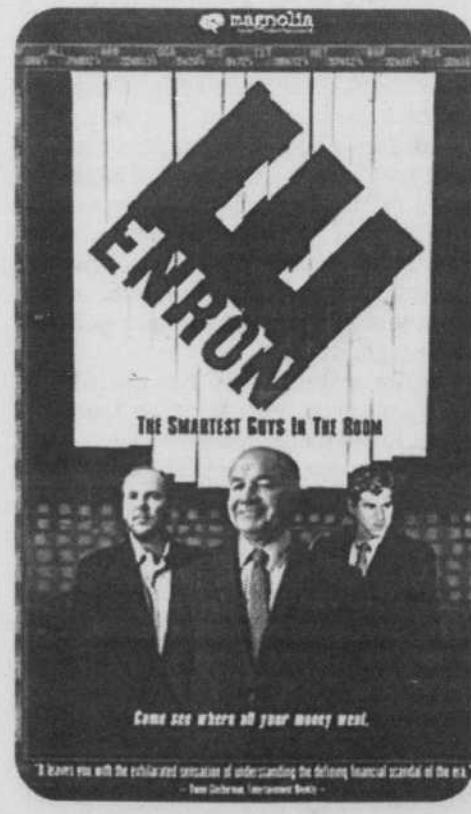

Enron: The Smartest Guys in the Room (out Jan. 17): In one of the most controversial films of last year, director Alex Gibney slowly dissects the machinations and lapses in common sense that resulted in one of the worst cases of corporate fraud ever perpetrated.

It looks deep into the compromised souls of Enron executives, and finds something that may not be surprising — but is nonetheless a wake-up call to consumers who rely on privatized energy companies.

Watch Arnold Schwarzenegger ride the wave of California brown-outs to the governor's mansion — as well as his backroom deals to jack up energy costs. A brilliant and disturbing portrait of insecure men and their need to make more money, Enron is a must-see movie. Rating: four stars out of five.

Wagnerian weepie gets big-screen treatment *Movies*

Tristan & Isolde is one of those sweet-faced, operatic sob-fests that gets you sighing a heavy "Alas!" from the moment it begins.

Just as in the Wagnerian opera that inspired this movie from Kevin Reynolds, a cute young boy witnesses the murder of his father on the eve of a peace treaty that would unify England against Ireland.

From that moment on, things for Tristan of Aragon (James Franco) just get worse. Dedicating himself to a life of revenge, he becomes one of the bravest fighters under King Marke, the strongest king among the warring lords of the English isle.

Tristan is so brave and handsome he's seen as the emotional heir to Marke's throne — even though the right to the crown belongs to his friend, and the nephew to Marke, Melot (Henry Cavill).

If that's not enough emotional tension to get his sword whetted, Tristan is assumed dead in a battle as a result of a poisoned wound. Set out to sea on a flaming raft, he washes up near dead on the Irish coast, where he's discovered by a beautiful young woman named Isolde (Sophia Myles) and her maid Bragnae.

The two women hide him away, nurse him back to health, then send him back to England a changed man. Thus Tristan now has love in his heart, and a desire to make a better world for the next generation — even though he still thirsts for revenge against the Irish, who at this point in history, run roughshod over the many divided English tribes.

Tristan's central desire is Isolde. The only problem is Isolde lied about her name and gave Tristan the name of Bragnae, so when he's given the chance to visit Ireland to compete for the hand of Isolde — the daughter to the Irish king — on behalf of King Marke, he's unaware of his tragic folly.

He wins the competition, but that only means he is doomed to suffer from close range as he hands Isolde over to his mentor and surrogate father, Marke.

Poor young things. Love at a tender

age is always so urgent and crushing, and for the handsome Tristan and the fair Isolde, such love would appear to be

the only reason to live. Yet, unlike their literary siblings Juliet and Romeo, the two lovers do see the bigger picture of

the grown-up world, which removes some of the senseless sting from this romantic weepie.

Tristan acknowledges the importance of a united England and places his own needs in second place. Similarly, Isolde attempts to be a good wife to Marke in the interest of civilian peace and stability.

Their self-denial makes them attractive characters, or at least more attractive than they would have been had they been allowed to selfishly wallow in their failed romance, and gives the viewer a chance to settle into the story at his or her own pace.

We can either see these two people as noble soulmates who sacrifice their greatest gift for the greater good, or as tedious teenage troublemakers who just can't seem to keep their lusty paws off the other.

Director Kevin Reynolds (Count of Monte Cristo, Waterworld) doesn't leap into the fray with a sledgehammer, and again, the more space we're given to find a comfort zone with the looming doom, the better.


Yet, for all the positives in this gritty and realistically staged Dark Ages tragedy, the film fails to burrow under the emotional skin because it's blunt at the point of entry. Leads Franco and Myles are indisputably gorgeous to look at, but Franco suffers from his apparent membership in the Josh Hartnett school of bovine facial acting.

With his big brown eyes and full lips, Franco pouts with the best of the Tyra Banks brigade, but sometimes he just looks whiny instead of deeply wounded.

Myles is nowhere near as leaden, but without a strong performance on the opposite side of the screen, the whole purpose of the story — and the idea of warring duties between the self and society — is lost.

The film is still worthy as a result of the art direction, supporting cast, Rufus Sewell's portrayal of Marke — and the the story itself, but in the big picture of big picture romances, Tristan & Isolde feels rather small.

Country's first lady still number one

Superstar Reba McEntire has released a two-CD set of her 33 #1 hits plus two brand new songs, the current single "You're Gonna Be" and "Love Needs A Holiday."

This collection is Reba's 30th release on MCA Records Nashville and is a testament to why this multi-talented artist's career has spanned over two decades.

When you hear the name Reba, right-off you think about one of the best contemporary female country singers but also about an actress who has played major roles in movies and has her own sitcom. Her voice is easily recognizable and she has been very consistent at charting hits but also at picking songs that capture the most dramatic moments in everyday life.

From "Can't Even Get the Blues" in 1982 to "Somebody" in 2004, the redhead from Oklahoma has been delivering number one songs for more than 20 years.

Her name and voice are synonymous with mainstream country music. Reba now marks that career by turning in that 35 song compilation of her number one singles, plus two brand new Reba recordings.

Reba # 1's, celebrates a career that has included 33 number one songs, 30

albums, multiple awards and countless shows and performances. This album is a collection of the songs country music fans have known and loved for different reasons.

As a favourite on country radio, Reba has become a singer of the human experiences and emotions. She voiced our heartaches with songs like "You Lie", "Somebody Should Leave" and "Rumor Has It"; she has been an inspiration with "I'm A Survivor" and "How Was I To Know"; and made us cry with "The Greatest Man I Never Knew" and "And Still."

Of course, no one can deliver a love song like she does, "Somebody" and "Forever Love" gave us hope that love really does triumph in the end.

The first new single from Reba # 1's, "You're Gonna Be", is about a mother's love for her child through the different experiences that life brings. The beautiful chorus offers a good balance of advice, encouragement and inspiration.

The second new number, "Love Needs A Holiday", is an upbeat number about a married couple who seriously needs a break from the daily routine that puts a

dampener on feelings sometimes.

Both songs are faithful to the passion and talent that Reba fans know and love, and listeners will relate easily to the stories they tell.

Her talent has also won McEntire many awards and honours, including 15 American Music Awards, 12 Academy of Country Music awards, seven Country Music Association awards and two Grammy's. In a career that has now expanded far beyond making music, Reba is also a multiple award winner for her acting talent.

Her critically-acclaimed Broadway debut in the 2001 musical Annie Get Your Gun, proved that she is versatile and fans loved it.

Now in its fifth season, her self-titled sitcom, Reba, is one of Warner Brother's top rated sit-coms, and has landed Reba a Golden Globe nomination and a People's Choice Award.

Through her music, television show, the many movies, and her new clothing collection, Reba has become a role model to young people who dream of a

country music career.

Reba grew up on a farm with a family who loved country music and rodeo. She's a living proof that anything is possible if you want it enough. Of course her personality and talent have been a major asset, getting her to where she is today, but Reba has always been a hard worker.

Intrepid travellers' impressions light the way **Books**

When he was 12, John Hughes lived in Morocco because his father, an engineer, had been sent there to supervise the reopening of an iron mine.

While there, he once saw a caretaker in the foreigners' compound stoop down on the surface of an abandoned tennis court and perform Muslim mid-day prayers.

"I felt as if I had seen something forbidden," Hughes, who now teaches history at St. George's School in Vancouver, writes in the introduction to his first book. "I had no understanding of Islam, or of Muslim or Moroccan culture; the idea that hundreds of millions of people all over the world did precisely what the watchman had done did not even occur to me."

House of Tears: Westerners' Adventures in Islamic Lands (The Lyons Press/Canadian Manda Group, 271 pages) is an anthology of writings by intrepid travellers who ventured into Islamic countries in the 18th, 19th and early 20th centuries and came away puzzled, moved, impressed and, sometimes, transformed.

"There's a real temptation to try to

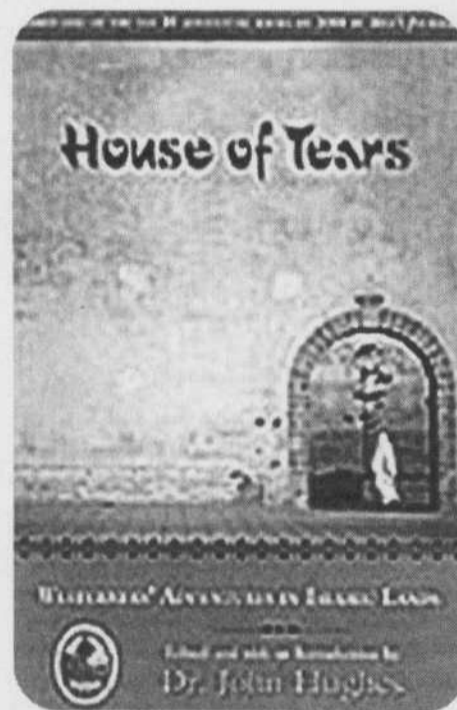
rewrite these stories, to package them," says Hughes. "I really wanted to say, 'This is what these people sound like, the people who penetrated these societies.'"

Hughes gave his book a name that was used to refer to a notorious warlord's Moroccan palace in the first years of the 1900s. Reminiscent of Anais Nin's A Spy in the House of Love and John Guare's The House of Blue Leaves, it fails to convey the spirit of the anthology. (The subtitle does that job.)

Still, this is a solid, interesting piece of work. Though only recently released, it has been named one of 2005's top 10 adventure books by Men's Journal.

At St. George's, Hughes taught Vancouver playwright/novelist John MacLachlan Gray's son, Ezra. He credits the senior Gray with having given him the confidence to find and select the explorers' stories ("There's enough material to fill 10 books like this") and bring them to the public.

Gray, for his part, doesn't think he deserves much credit, saying: "It took no great insight to tell him to write the way he talked, to stick to non-fiction, at least for the time being, and to mine his knowledge of the Middle East and



North Africa."

Hughes, 45, has a PhD in European history from England's University of Sussex. He hopes House of Tears will show readers how vast and various the Muslim world is, and also direct them

to seek out the books from which he has drawn excerpts.

Walter B. Harris, the author of an 1889 book called The Land of an African Sultan, is one writer whose work merits a closer look. Hughes considers him someone who had the same effect on pre-First World War readers as CNN's Christiane Amanpour has on modern TV viewers: "He became a familiar guide to indecipherable events that portended worse to come."

People will also want to read more by Lady Anne Blunt (Lord Byron's granddaughter) and Ella Sykes, the two female adventurers in the book. Hughes wonders if the West's relationship with Islam would be different if such women were better known and celebrated, to balance the legacy of men like T.E. Lawrence.

Hughes, a sixth-generation British Columbian, comes by his strong sense of history naturally. He has a strong sense of story, too, having learned at St. George's that "you can get through to a lot of people with a story, and it doesn't need to be fiction."

He's working on an anthology of writings about the Sahara Desert.
