DIVISION OF THE CITY WARDS.

Champlain Ward.—From Sous-le-Fort to Champlain Toll Gate.

Montcalm Ward.—From the Glacis to the St. Foye and St. Louis Toll Gates, divided by the south side of St. John.

Palace Ward.—From Mountain Hill steps to St. John Gate, divided by the north side of St. John, Fabrique and Buade.

St. John Ward.—From the Glacis to St. Foye Toll Gate, divided by the north side of St. John.

St. Louis Ward.—From Mountain Hill steps to St. John Gate, divided by the south side of St. John, Fabrique and Buade.

St. Peter Ward.—From Sous-le-Fort to St. Roch, and from the river to the Cape.

St. Roch Ward.—From St. Roch to St. Ours, and from the north side of St. Joseph to the river St. Charles.
