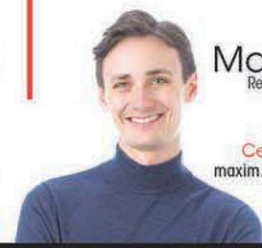

Next vaccination campaign to start Aug 15

Quebec's public health director, Dr. Luc Boileau gave an update on the COVID-19 situation in the province on Thursday afternoon, stating that the infection indicators across all age groups were down for the first time in seven weeks.

"This does not mean the wave is over or that the virus is no longer circulating," Boileau said, clarifying that the positive sign means that things are getting better, even if people have and will continue to get sick.

The public health director reflected that this seventh wave of the pandemic proved to be quite significant, placing a heavy burden on the hospital system, and said that things are still slightly more serious in areas like the Estrie Region and the North Shore.

Although things are currently improving, Boileau said that it is likely there will be another rise in the coming weeks and in the fall and, as a result,

Bishop delves into Desirous Wonder

"A few people have told me there was a healing element to (*Desirous Wonder*). That fundamentally is my goal, to help others," said new Eastern Townships author Greg Bishop.

Bishop has taken the goal of helping others seriously, evident from his former position as executive director of Grace Village and his former role in the RCMP, where he was known as an accomplished forensic interviewer.

"I worked all over the world in that field teaching and conducting

interviews on very high profile crimes," he explained. Many of these interviews brought him face to face with offenders who have committed terrible crimes such as murder, genocide, and crimes against children. Over time, the exposure to such intense situations took a toll on Bishop's physical and psychological health. "I went through a very difficult time with post-traumatic stress disorder and I came to understand the stigma attached to that," said Bishop.

Desirous Wonder is a collection of passionate, sincere poems and songs about Bishop's experiences throughout

his life, many pieces having naturistic elements. Bishop hopes to help, motivate, and encourage his readers through his work. "You want to be able to entertain through writing, but if you can walk away with an idea, a concept, a new perspective, that's even better," he said.

Bishop's poems and songs have a level of spontaneity to them. "I'll awaken in the middle of the night and have a poem right away or I'll pull my truck over, pull out a piece of paper, and write out a poem," he said. When asked about his favourite piece of work

Two tales of one journey

LENNOXVILLE LIBRARY

Rudy Wiebe's 1994 novel, *A Discovery of Strangers*, earned him his second Governor-General's Award for English fiction. Whether it could do so today when there is so much concern about cultural appropriation is an interesting question. The story is a description of the first Franklin expedition into the Canadian north from 1819-22. Wiebe presents the events from two points of view: that of the British explorers who have been mandated to travel to the mouth of the Coppermine River on Coronation Gulf, from whence they are expected to map the coastline from that point east to the western shore of Hudson Bay; and that of the local Yellowknife tribe who have been hired to hunt for caribou so that the English entourage will have sufficient food for their trip to the shore of the Arctic Ocean and back, as well as to get them through the upcoming winter.

The explorers' group had only five members of the Royal Navy: four officers and one seaman. John Franklin himself was a thirty-five year old lieutenant. The other twenty were Métis or voyageurs, whom the Yellowknives referred to as "paddle slaves". They had travelled overland from the south through Lake Athabasca and Great Slave Lake. Wiebe picks up the travellers in June 1821 as they are building a fort on the shore of Winter Lake so they will have a sheltered place to return to after the mapping expedition.

Wiebe's story is a bit confusing at first. The terms used by the Tetsot'ine (Yellowknives) to describe places and animals are different from the ones the Europeans use. Wiebe does not always provide a translation. He lets readers wade in and figure things out on their own, e.g. the Coppermine River

is referred to by the Yellowknives as the Coppermother. (The Yellowknives are the ancestors of the people we now refer to as the Dene).

In addition to getting the local tribe to provide them with food, the English are also anxious to get them to produce a map of the territory the English plan to visit. This turns out to be problematic for a variety of reasons. The tribes don't use anything that resembles a written or printed map; they rely on landmarks. Keskarrah, the tribal elder, does not want the English to leave for a variety of motives, and he is using the map as a stalling tactic. Some of his motives are selfish and some are benevolent.

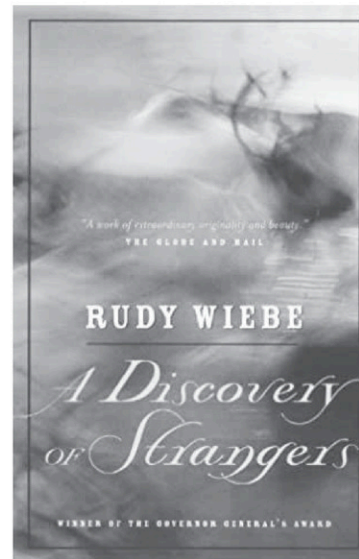
Keskarrah's wife has an ailment on her face. John Richardson, the crew's doctor, has been treating her condition with a salve; Keskarrah thinks it is helping her and doesn't want the doctor to go away. The Tetsot'ine also believe the English have waited too late in the season to be heading to the land of everlasting ice. The English expect weather to be like it is at the same latitude in Europe, or southern Norway. But without a Gulf Stream to warm things up, the locals know that once the autumn equinox has passed there are no guarantees as to what the weather will be like. They also know that a journey to Hudson Bay is a matter of at least several weeks.

Another reason Keskarrah does not want These English, as the locals refer to them, to go north and east is that he is afraid they will encounter the Inuit, tell them where the Tetsot'ine are and how to find them. It is apparent that Keskarrah is terrified of the Inuit, in spite of the fact that few, if any, of the present generation of his tribe have actually met any Inuit.

There is also a romance built into this tale. Robert Hood, the expedition's draftsman and mapmaker, falls for Keskarrah's teenage daughter. He gives her the green stockings that his mother had knitted for him, and that becomes the girl's name. But this gift also proves to be a fatal mistake.

The expedition moves north early in July. But the journey is far longer than anticipated and they begin to run out of food late in August. Despite being far from Hudson Bay, the journey is broken off. But they are now trying to retreat over land instead of travelling on water and progress is very slow. Winter catches up with them when they are still far from Fort Enterprise.

Franklin himself never appears in the text. All we know of the Thick English, as the locals call him, is what other



characters tell us about him. But what we do learn makes one wonder how there ever came to be a second Franklin expedition. That there was cannibalism seems to be beyond doubt. Killing is also confirmed. The only question is whether these were acts of murder or self-defence.

Once I got the hang of how Wiebe has organized his narrative, it was easier to follow and much more interesting. As I mentioned, one does have doubts about whether he is the one who should be telling the Dene's story. But this also applies to the English sailors' version of the adventure. They were very different from modern Canadian writers too. But they did leave some written records that could be studied, an advantage Wiebe did not have in proposing the Dene's version.

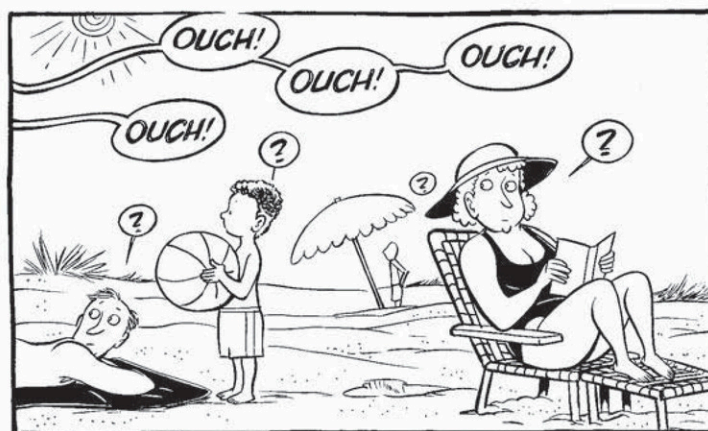

Val-des-Sources fire still under investigation

The Régie du bâtiment du Québec (RBQ) is continuing to gathering information as to the source of an explosion and ensuing neighbourhood fire in Val-des-Sources last week.

RBQ spokesperson Sylvain Lamothe told The Record that he was unable to provide any details about the origin of the fire until a full investigation has been completed. An RBQ investigator was sent over to Val-des-Sources on Tuesday. They spent the entire day collecting information.

However, Lamothe noted it appears the property owner where the fire started in the small town had been operating, filling and storing propane without a provincial permit. There are security measures to follow, and clearly the owner didn't adhere to these rules, he explained Thursday.

The situation is slightly shrouded in mystery because of the extent of the fire damage on the home. If the RBQ report finds any fire safety violations, then the property owner could face

finances anywhere between \$1,200 and \$18,000. It is not a trivial infraction, Lamothe shared.

While the RBQ conducts its due diligence, Lamothe noted that although the onus falls on the property owner, nearby residents should never hesitate to speak up. It isn't normal to be in a house or garage in a residential neighbourhood and find a propane operation, he continued.

"I think one of the important elements is that as a resident, when seeing a situation like this, as a consumer, it's a question of security and there shouldn't be any tolerance for this. If we see a similar situation, we need to denounce it immediately to the proper authorities," Lamothe said.

He told The Record that he isn't trying to be an alarmist, adding propane tanks are generally very safe, and they rarely explode. But it also requires some precautionary measures from both consumers and distributors. There are 3,200 propane operating permits in Quebec, he said.

"If we have any doubt about security then advise the authorities, the municipality, and the fire department, or simply communicate with the RBQ, so that we can do the proper verification. Propane is secure, reliable, as a combustible, but it does bring some risks," said Lamothe.

The important thing is to minimize the risk, he continued, which is easily attainable. When it comes to small propane canisters, those used on camping trips, for example, they cannot be refilled, Lamothe said, sharing it can become extremely dangerous to anyone in the vicinity.

And when it comes to the number of tanks permitted in a household, Lamothe said he isn't certain whether or not there is a limit per Quebec resident. Although, the RBQ does not recommend having too many tanks on any given premises. The tanks also must be outside.

"If you have more, because it's not rare for someone to have two, one in use and another on the side as a reservoir, it's important to conserve

these propane tanks outside. We never recommend storing these propane tanks inside or in a closed off environment," Lamothe said.

Propane is famously flammable, and it can become a dangerous situation if tanks are stored inside. If a tank is leaking outside, the gas will dissipate into the air, but if it's inside, it will only build up and lead to potentially disastrous outcomes. It's an unacceptable practice, he said.

Lamothe told The Record that the investigation will most likely last a few more days. And he emphasized the need for neighbours to not tolerate this type of behaviour or operation. It was an irresponsible and illegal operation, he said, and it led to a fire that consumed two houses.

"From what we see, because I only saw a few images of what is left of the house, there were definitely several tanks on site. I'm not able to tell you if they were stored in the garage, though. What I can tell you is our investigator is still out there validating information," said Lamothe.

in *Desirous Wonder*, Bishop landed on Cry for the Abenaki, a rhythmic song which incorporates historical references about Indigenous peoples in North Hatley. "The music came later," he said, reminiscing about a time he played the song and people got up to dance and sing along.

"I have an entrepreneurial side I haven't tapped into in many years," he said, sharing that the book is self-published. After reaching out to lawyers in Sherbrooke to help him with the legal side of published work, he connected with Richard Faith, a good friend and printing company owner, for help. The end result was impressive, with the front cover featuring intricate Celtic knot artwork by Karen Elizabeth Hones, while the back cover is splashed with a bright and cheery fox painting by artist Norma Jean Morrison.

Bishop is keeping busy with two more books in process, one of which will be a memoir.

"Over the years, a number of people tried to encourage me to either collaborate with the (RCMP) or work on my own to write a book about

that work. I always declined because I did not want to sensationalize the crimes, particularly what happened to the victims in the cases I worked," he said. "I also didn't want to educate the criminal element such as the techniques of forensic interviews."

In the spring of 2020, he explained that a former colleague proposed a different approach: to write in the perspective of perseverance through mental and physical illness. "Although my memoir will include some of the work I done, there will be nothing sensitive that is revealed and crimes will not be sensationalized." The other book will be targeted towards adolescents young adults. "It's messages of hope on many levels," said Bishop.

Right now *Desirous Wonder* can only be found at the Centre du Nutrition Animale in Lennoxville, LeBaron grocery in North Hatley, Brome Lake Books, and Studio Georgeville. On Aug. 16 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., join Bishop at Gillygooly Farm & Art Gallery for a book launch sponsored by North Hatley library.

Summer Camp Stories

The Eastern Townships has been the home to many summer camps, which have all made a difference in people's lives. I have had the opportunity to be a participant at Camp Livingstone, Cedar Lodge, Frontier Lodge, Quebec Lodge, Parkside Ranch, and Camp D'Action Biblique. In addition, in my student internship in Saskatchewan, I helped at Camp Woodboia. When I was ordained in 1979 my first pastoral charge was in New Brunswick, and I discovered Camp Chaleur in Charlo, one of my four preaching points. I ended up being Camp Director there for five years. When I returned to Townships I began a summer theatre camp at the Piggery which is about to finish its 10th season. I thought it would be fun to write about these many experiences. There are too many stories to fit in one article, so I hope our readers will indulge me for a few weeks.

My summer camp experiences began at Camp Livingstone on Lake Lovering in Georgeville when I was 13. My older sister had gone to teen camp the year before and had a wonderful time. We were quite close and I wanted to follow her footsteps. Money was a bit tight, but I was told about an unusual way to help. If I could memorize a chapter of Scripture and recite it, I could have some of my way paid. The challenge was on. Unlike most kids, I loved memory work. I memorized chapter 55 of Isaiah,

and remember much of it to this day.

I was hooked on camp after the first few days. We played "capture the flag" and I surprised everyone by quietly sneaking around and stealing the flag in the first game. I was a new camper and somewhat invisible, which helped. We got to swim each day, and sing songs by the campfire. One song, "In the skies God's handiwork I see" has helped me on my spiritual journey and I sing those lines so often to myself. The camp also included a few mentally challenged people, like Andrew, who was a fixture every summer. He always got excited and wanted us to sing his favourite song, "Love lifted Me". He couldn't read but knew those words by heart.

For the next three summers I spent two weeks in August at the camp. My best friend from Ayer's Cliff, David Walker, was there, and I met new people, some from the Black community in Montreal. We had bible study in the morning, campfires and singing every night, and lots of sports and swimming. I, myself, learned how to pray at camp. Each night our counselor would gather us in a circle, and we would pray. He always took lots of time and silence was part of the process. On the first night he invited us to say a prayer if we wanted, but not to be anxious if we didn't. Only one other camper said anything, but by the end of camp we all were able to say a few simple words.

We also had a game called a sword drill. We would hold our Bibles in the air (we had to bring bibles) and the leader would shout out a scripture verse. We would repeat it. He would say "draw your swords" and the first person to find the verse stood up and read it.

For a nerd like me this was so much fun. Sometimes, though, he would fool people by shouting out a fictitious verse, like James 6:3, or Hezekiah 5:2, I would calmly keep my bible in the air, while others frantically search, till they figured out those verses didn't exist.

We also had silly fun of course, like playing soccer in our bathing suits in the rain. We played a game where we had to get others to smile by saying "If you love me honey, please smile." The victim would have to respond with a straight face, "I love you honey, but I just can't smile". This is much harder than you might think when the speaker makes silly faces. In my third year, a few of us stole out of our bunks at 2 a.m. to ring the camp bell. We managed to get back undetected, but the Camp Director was not pleased. One of our campers took time away to listen to a radio, which he hid from the counselors. I remember listening to "Born to be Wild" with him. I guess even my love of Classic Rock began at summer camp.

I learned more about life after my last year. I was fifteen years old by then. After two weeks of glorious summer fun and Bible study at Camp Livingstone, Jim Carter, the Camp director, approached our Senior boys cabin with a proposal. He invited us to stay at camp for two more weeks, two weeks to enjoy swimming, waterskiing, and wonderful evening campfires. All we had to do was spend each day dismantling the Magog Railway Station and bringing the lumber back to the camp for storage. Next spring it would be used to build a chapel and new dining hall. Of course, I jumped at the opportunity. When my parents arrived to retrieve me and my

sister Eva, they were surprised that I didn't want to return home just yet. It was work, my Dad was always a total enthusiast about that, and so I began my journey to adulthood.

By day we used hammers, crowbars, and nail pullers, and were drenched with sweat and insulation dust from the collapsing walls and ceilings. By night we swam, waterskied and enjoyed camp without rules, schedules or curfews. But boy did we did work! There were five of us, just enough to fill the seats of the van Jim Carter drove. Ron Scantlebury and Vance Arthur Davis Junior the third (yes that was his name) were from Little Burgundy in Montreal, David Walker was from Ayer's Cliff, and Glen Eastwood was from Ormstown. We were quite a crew.

Each day the train station shrunk, and the lumber pile grew. Our apprentice hands, which at first seemed tentative and uncertain, became strong and skilled. It felt like a contest. Could we finish the work in only two weeks? Our competitive spirits led to longer and longer workdays, as we desperately wanted to win this challenge. Where once we needed Jim's strict instructions, we soon became independent contractors, freeing him to do other tasks. We became a team, anticipating each other's needs and working smoothly together.

This experience paved the way for my next camp experience at Cedar Lodge the following summer. I was 16, and was asked to be a counselor. You'll have to wait for next week to hear my stories from there. However I am grateful for every summer camp where children are valued, and spirituality is alive.

Haskell Opera House to host night of short films with live orchestra

The Haskell Free Library and Opera House plans to bring music to the silver screen on Aug. 27, in a collaboration between the Vermont Symphony Orchestra (VSO) and Middlebury New Filmmakers Festival.

Featured in the presentation are seven short films, all produced locally, with the 22-piece orchestra performing their scores live at the venue.

"A lot of the films were part of this long-standing collaboration we've had at the Middlebury film festival. Three brand new films were conceived of and made together between composer and filmmaker," said Matt LaRocca, VSO artistic advisor and project conductor. "We paused and looked back on all these films we've made so far and decided it would be an amazing time to do a retrospective on what we've done for the last five years."

The short works vary from animated to live action, with all sorts of styles; some silent, that let the score do the talking, and some being remixed for the occasion.

"A lot of the sound effects like rushing winds and thunder are, instead

of having recorded audio, recreated using sounds by the orchestra."

The screening will last around an hour, and the choice of location LaRocca said was a perfect place for it.

"It's one of my favourite places to be in Vermont! The location, the venue; I've only been up there a handful of times, but every time I just loved it."

They're hopeful the unique location will draw in people from both sides of the border to experience the hard work of both composers and filmmakers.

Some, like Jack DeBouter, composer for the film Estrellita, see the collaboration as a fantastic opportunity

"This was the first project of its type I've worked on, and I did it while I was still an undergrad at Middlebury College," DeBouter said. "Daniel Houghton was approached to do a film, and then approached me; I immediately said yes!"

Houghton is the director of an animation studio at the college and the filmmaker for Estrellita, who used the opportunity to involve his students as much as possible.

"I reached out to the music professor and asked if she knew who might think film composition was fun; not all of them feel it has inherent value," he

said. "I asked them to submit film scores they loved along with some of their own music. From that, I tried to pick tonal qualities that had a shot of aligning with the subject matter of the film. Some of them were beautiful but felt further away from where the film was. Jack leapt forward because I felt it was closest to what the film needed."

Unlike the more regimented filmmaking process, the collaborative nature allowed for more exploration and teamwork among the groups.


"Often music comes later because you time it to things happening on screen, but a lot of the work I did was in tandem with the filmmaking. We each changed things here and there as it went along and I think it really put an emphasis on collaboration," added DeBouter.

Houghton said he went out of his way to find students because "finding ways to create opportunities that might be inaccessible at this point in a composer's career felt enticing. I was a college student myself not too far back and was looking for these types of collaborations, and paired with the students helping me with animation, it felt like a good match."

When he passed away in 2001 at the age of 102, latex glove pioneer Neil Tillotson left the bulk of his assets for charitable purposes. His wife Louise established the donor-advised Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund at the New Hampshire Charitable Foundation in 2006.

Tillotson's philosophy was simple: "Be humble, be creative and be kind."

The vision of the Fund is "To serve as a catalyst for the region to move toward sustainable community and economic development in Coös County and surrounding communities in the United States and Canada."

The Coaticook Region Fund received a record number of requests in the Spring of 2022, resulting in over


\$150,000 distributed throughout the community. Following up on that, the Coaticook Region Fund is inviting Non-Profit organizations to apply for funding for Fall 2022.

As usual, funding is available for projects that support basic needs and create a community safety net, including healthcare, education, youth recreation as well as programs and services for the elderly.



Once a musician, always a musician!



COUNTRY CONNECTION

Early in life, François Bricault decided that he would make a living out of playing music. Sometimes wishes come true, but sometimes they remain a dream. Born and raised in Sherbrooke, Bricault was lucky enough to be part of a very musical family.

“My grandfather Bricault was a fiddler and so was my uncle Rene, who had a band called The Blue Birds. On my mother’s side of the family, my grandfather Cloutier played the mouth organ, while my grandmother played piano, guitar and mandolin” he said in an interview.

His uncle Raymond Cloutier was a well-known musician in the region. He played violin, and guitar and had his own band. Bricault added with pride that his mother, who will soon turn 99, still plays her mouth organ once in a while at the residence where she lives.

Bricault had one brother who didn’t have any interest in music at all. He was drawn to sports and travel, but was very talented mainly with electronics.

Bricault was 15 when, with a neighbor, they decided that they would love to be musicians. Since they

had no money, they had to be crafty to find a solution.

“My friend Jacques Loubier and I decided that we would make our guitars ourselves. We did, we made electrical guitars using pieces of wood and fishing lines to replace guitar strings. It was not a success” he stressed.

Seeing their determination, both of their mothers finally bought them flat top guitars, with the understanding that if they were able to learn, they would eventually get electric ones.

“We started practicing and my uncle Denis showed me a few chords. Soon we were able to sing and accompany ourselves. We met Michel Rivest, who showed me more chords, at which point, Jacques decided the he would rather play drums instead and he did.”

After a few months of practice, they decided their band would be called the Black Jack and they played their first gig at St-Charles Garnier, under the church, during the parish bingo evening.

They recruited the late Normand Hamel on the bass, so they were now a complete band and as soon as they graduated, they decided to hit the road.

Their first tour lasted for a little over a year and during this time, the musician said he found out that people’s appreciation came in part from the talent you have and the other half came with the way you interact with them and how personable you are.

“We dealt with a booking agency. Our first contract was in Lake Mégantic but from there, they sent us everywhere. We often had to travel many hours from one job to the next one. From Havre St-Pierre to Forestville to Chibougamau, the road was exhausting but we did it” he recalled.

In order to reassure his mother,

Bricault sent her a postcard from every place they played. He remembered that she had a map of the province and pinned every card on the city where he had been.

The musician has so many stories and anecdotes about his life on the road. I am positive we can write a book about all his adventures. Bricault has a phenomenal memory and is very interesting to listen to.

“At one point, the booking agency introduced us to a transvestite who was working under the name Diane Chantal. We became her back-up band. It was crazy how people loved her show, it was just unbelievable” he

explained.

“The guys eventually each went their own way and I came back to Sherbrooke. I managed to find guys in order to form another band. They were all excellent musicians and we started rehearsing intensively six hours a day, until our repertoire was ready” Bricault added.

As they were ready to hit the road again, the guitar player decided that this was not the music genre that he wanted to play, so he left. Bricault said he learned so much from those guys, but everything had been a waste of time since they had to start over again.

The theme for many of the film projects revolves around the local area, and their work in bringing regional artists together even allowed new opportunities for experienced creators.

Teacher and composer for the film *The Greatest Night*, Matthew Evan Taylor, said, "I moved to Vermont in 2017 and am now a composer and educator at Middlebury College. The executive director at the time approached me about being the composer in residence for the *Made in Vermont* commission, which, as the name suggests, is a commission for Vermont composers with the VSO."

As a result, *The Greatest Night* was the first film project he'd ever composed for, and he said it's made him interested in composing for film again in the future.

This kind of support for future artists gives opportunities that some might have extreme difficulty finding otherwise and creates connections among those who may have never spoken.

Jesse Kreuzer, the filmmaker for the film *Breath*, even credits a lot of his success to the nature of his primary schooling at Marlboro Elementary School, which progressively gave students the resources to explore their talents.

"From an early age, they recognized

my interest in filmmaking. They put a camera in my hand, and I guess I was always one of the ones who knew what they wanted to do."

Through those formative experiences, he continued his education and ended up creating the film *Black Canaries* for his college thesis project.

"I was the guinea pig selected for the first collaborations between the VSO and Middlebury New Filmmakers Festival. I was selected by them after showing my film *Black Canaries* at the festival and then spent the year collaborating on a new film."

He said the process was unorthodox, the score being written before the film, but the music inspired the edits and

it eventually turned into something beautiful.

The method of collaboration between the VSO and film fest has been the catalyst for seven short films to date, all being shown in their greatest form yet during the upcoming *Night at the Movies*.

Starting at 7:30 p.m. on the 27, residents of both the US and Canada are welcome to come to the Haskell Opera House. The night will have a "pay what you want" ticket model whose sales support the artists involved in the project.

Children under 12 are also free, and LaRocca said he's excited to present their years of creative passion and collaboration.

This is when he decided to find a job and play music exclusively on the weekends to have fun. His dream was fading away, but he felt he had no choice.

"I found a job in a grocery store and played on the weekend with Real Labbé on guitar, Diane Labbé on lead vocal, Andre Trahan on the drums and me on bass. I had changed the guitar for the bass when I went on tour the first-time around. And I finally found work as a cook. I spent the next forty years working in that field" he stressed.

He later joined another band who all dressed with nice matching costumes and people appreciated their fancy look on stage. They would go on to play together for five years.

"By that time, I was working as a Chef at the University of Sherbrooke at the cafeteria, where we even offered a catering service. I was more and more involved with the 'Association des Compagnons de la Bonne Fourchette' and I had no time for weekend gigs anymore. But I was happy doing it," said Bricault.

Music was still on his mind stronger than ever despite his lack of time. He

met musician Marc Cusson and the two worked as a duo for many years. They performed at La Brasserie La Romaine, as well as many Bars Salon in the region.

One day, he met singer Francine Roy and decided to work with her and eventually married her. When his second daughter was born, he decided to quit playing music.

"Francine and I had two shared passions, music and making videos. We love to capture other musicians' performances on film. And with time, we have invested in better equipment and we keep making videos that musicians can use as demos or simply as

a souvenir" he stressed.

With his retirement, he is now working on a mega project. He wants to provide virtual musicians for those who work alone with music tracks. They will project musicians who are really playing the song they will sing on a screen behind them. There're still a few details he has to perfect, but he sure is hoping to succeed.

The man is a talented and passionate person who could tell you stories for hours. I hope his big project will soon be a reality. And, of course, he still plays once in a while. Once a musician, always a musician!

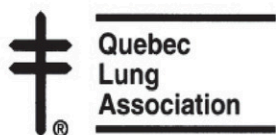

Dear Annie: Back in the 1960s, my father inherited some land with houses on it from his uncle who raised him. For some reason, he let his sister, my aunt, and her family move into one of the houses rent-free.

In 2002, my father died. My sister, my brother and I inherited the property. I bought my brother and sister out at an agreed price. My aunt continued to live on the property and would repeat quite often that my father's will stated she could live there for free.

After eight or nine years of doubt, I went to pro-bate court. It turns out the will did not say this. So, I started charging my aunt rent. My whole family got terribly upset about this. I have not spoken to my sister ever since. As far as I am concerned, my aunt owes me about \$35,000.

My aunt is not poor. Just like my family, she was a penny pincher. I am a Christian, but I just cannot think of having anything to do with somebody who would pull a stunt like this. How do you feel? – Crooked Relatives

Dear Crooked Relatives: Legally, your aunt has no right to live on your property without paying rent. Remaining on your land without permission constitutes trespassing. Relaying this to your aunt may be enough to get her to start paying.

However, you might also want to consider the arguments of your family. Think how hard it must be for your aunt to leave the land that ties her to her dead brother, land on which she's been living for decades. Maybe you have it in your heart to negotiate a deal with your aunt – charging her rent that is well below the market rate. And please, get it out of your head that she owes you \$35,000 for back rent, especially when your father refused to charge her anything.

Dear Annie: My cousin, who was a dentist in Kansas, died of pancreatic cancer two years ago. My side of the family was very supportive of his wife and children. We called and wrote to them several times to offer our support, and I drove over 400 miles to attend his funeral.

A year ago, my sister was diagnosed with lung cancer. The wife of my late cousin has known this for at least six months. She has made no effort to communicate with my sister (or me) in any way. Is this a form of narcissism or just a bad character flaw on her part? – Cancer Support Not Reciprocated

Dear Support Not Reciprocated: Grief comes in waves, and the healing process looks different for anyone suffering a loss. Perhaps it's neither narcissism nor negligence on your late cousin's wife's part but simply a reopened wound too close to home right now following her husband's death two years ago.

Whatever the reason for her radio silence, the only thing you can control is how you support and show up for your sister. Continue to stand by her during this difficult period, and over time, hopefully others in your family will follow suit.

Render the enemy harmless

Elsa Maxwell, who was known for her parties for royalty and high society figures, once said, "Enemies to me are the sauce piquante to my dish of life." She would have been an avid bridge player, particularly enjoying the deals on which it was imperative to keep one particular enemy - opponent - off the lead.

On today's deal, South was in three no-trump. West led the heart five, and East put up the king. How should declarer have continued?

In the auction, North might have rebid three clubs after his initial transfer bid.

South had eight top tricks: three spades, one heart, two diamonds and two clubs. He needed only one more winner.

Seeing that that could come from either black suit, declarer won the first trick with the heart ace and cashed his three top spades. When West discarded a diamond, South continued with three rounds of clubs. However, East won the last and West discarded another diamond. Now a heart through declarer's jack-four produced four more tricks for the defense: down one.

South realized that if he had taken his four minor-suit winners and exited with a diamond, West would have been

endplayed to give declarer a trick with the heart jack.

That would have been lucky. The best line, which alleviates guesswork, is to cross to dummy in either minor at trick two and play a spade to the eight. South keeps East, the danger hand, off the lead and sets up a fourth spade trick in the process.

It is important to ensure that the enemy's sauce piquante - their strong suit - cannot upset your stomach - I mean, your contract.*
