Finding the right wine not an impossible task

Recently, changing hats for a moment, I found myself faced with the problem of selecting 'the right' wines to sell at the Piggery Theatre bar.

When making this sort of decision, there are invariably a number of factors that must be considered. What price range do you want to offer the clientele? How much of a mark-up is justifiable? Will you offer a full range of wine types or settle for the basics? Each of these questions had to be answered and several others I haven't mentioned.

My decision was to go with the basics, and to keep the price as low as economics and the necessity for profit would allow.

Much of my reasoning, I must confess, was based upon a recent experience that I had in Montreal. Here, at the William Tell restaurant on Stanley Avenue, I was offered a wine list, that, among other things, advertised a bottle of Mommessin Export for a staggering \$22.00! Now, as many of you know, I have often praised this particular wine for being a good buy for the money since it offers a sound wine at around \$4.65. But to tack on a mark-up of over 470% strikes even me as a bit excessive.

Part of the reason many restaurants, not just those in Montreal by the way, feel the necessity to demand such outrageous prices is the fact that they not only pay the ridiculous prices for wine that we normal types pay, but they are forced to pay an extra 4% tacked on by the Société

des Alcools.

That's right, the SAQ rewards the wholesale purchaser by charging him or her more. So much for volume purchasing.

But there is a limit. Doubling the price of wine in a restaurant will guarantee a profit. Quadrupling it is much akin to the type of gouging heretofore reserved for the Saturday night wrestling antics of the Beast or Gilles the Fish Poisson. In short, it just isn't fair.

Happy to say, The Piggery will feature a selection of wines that should sooth the taste buds without damaging the pocket book too badly.

By the way, if you are looking for a good buy in a red wine, check out the 1980 Riserva Ducale from Ruffino. A dry, full-bodied wine, with lots of flower to it, the Ducale is a very good buy for the money and rates about an 8 on a scale of 10. Not as good as the superb 1975, but worth stockpiling in case of nuclear war. Cheers!

More on standard mistakes

More on varieties. In the past we looked at a few known and listed varieties.

There are many common and unlisted varieties that daily pass before your very eyes without your noticing them. Errors and flaws of one kind or another are quite common. In fact, a flawless stamp is almost an oddity today, or so it seems.

Lately, I have been going through the Queen Elizabeth II definitive issues of 1977, 12 cent blue and grey, the 1978 fourteen cent red and grey, the 1979 seventeen cent green and grey, the 1982 thirty cent violet and grey and the 1983 thirty two cent dull blue and grey. I'm of the opinion that the printing of these definitives is the sloppiest you'll ever see, considering today's modern printing technology.

Double strikes are the greatest flaw you will find within these stamps. A double strike creates a double impression of the whole or part of the portrait. The twelve cent club has, over and above double strikes, printing shifts. In fact, the whole series has, but some are a little worse than others. The double strike on the twelve cent is generally fine and must be seen through a magnifying glass. The printing shift is, as a rule, above or below its normal position. Illustration one below shows a normal Queen's portrait. Illustration two shows a twelve cent with a double strike and a downward printing shift. This is a significant variety.

The fourteen cent red and grey was probably the best printed of the series. The double strikes are few and far between. I have yet to find a printing shift.

The seventeen cent green has a rather significant double strike. Most of those found will have come from booklet panes. The double strike is so outstanding that, in many cases it may be seen without the aid of a glass. The printing shifts are generally to the left.

I might state here that, my idea of a printing shift is when any part of the black printing overlaps the white border as shown in the various illustrations below.

The thirty cent violet and grey value is probably the sloppiest of the series. The double strikes are very common, and the printing shifts are anywhere from one to three millimeters to the left or right, up or down. In addition, there are various shades of violet. On some stamps the ink seems veined like dry parched earth. You'll also find minute particles of black missing from numerals and letters. The copyright dates are, in some cases undecernable.

There seems to have been some improvement in the thirty two cent. Although it has its share of double strikes and printing shifts, they don't seem to be as numerous as the thirty cent.

One thing the series has in common is a blurred appearance in the portrait of many stamps. It

doesn't seem to be a double strike. It looks more like a worn plate.

More studies are being done on the series and, as the information trickles in I'll pass it along.

Quebec CBC expands

SHERBROOKE — The CBC is doubling both the time and money it spends on the radio side of its Quebec Community Network.

The Quebec City-based public-affairs morning show Quebec AM will be getting an afternoon partner to be broadcast from 3 to 6 p.m. from the system's 41 repeating-transmitter towers scattered in rural areas of the province, including Sherbrooke and Thetford Mines.

The increase in spending and activity comes smack in the middle of 1985, otherwise known inside the CBC as the Year of the Big Cuts, which saw over \$75 million snatched from the Crown network's budget by Communications Minister Marcel Masse and CBC president Pierre Juneau, and sent heads rolling from sea to sea across the nation's electronic media map.

"We got the full go-ahead from head office last week," Quebec region English radio boss Ron Laplante said in an interview Thursday. "We think it's a remarkable achievement in a period of retraction. They cut \$75 million, and we get more."

What provoked the new spending, if not the fact that the Quebec Community Network provides the only English-language radio and TV service available in Prime minister Brian Mulroney's home town of Baie Comeau? "If we ask the fundamental question, 'what are the CBC's most important functions', it comes down to two things," Laplante said.

"First, the CBC is there to provide service coast-to-coast in the language minority of every province. Second, we must serve the isolated, outlying districts of the country. In both these situations, in many cases the CBC provides the only service the people of the communities can get at all."

"So the increase in service fits right in."

The "doubling" of Quebec-City-based programming, which is widely listened to in Quebec's many remote areas, will mean hiring

four new staffers and an estimated extra expenditure of between \$150,000 and \$200,000 a year to begin with, although Laplante won't talk dollars.

"We'll hire a host, a producer and two researchers," Laplante said. "They will all be journalists, all broadcast journalists, although the show will be lighter in tone than a straight news report."

"Of course if there's a hard-news story breaking, we'll go with that up front. But in general the afternoon show will have an easier tone than Quebec AM in the morning. It will be more like the show from Montreal it replaces, Home Run."

The new afternoon show will "put a lot of emphasis on culture and sports, like the show from Montreal does, but it will definitely be oriented towards the rural communities," Laplante added. For example, he said, "the people who don't live in Montreal won't have to listen to the Montreal traffic reports every day."

"And the music will definitely change" to a more rural flavor, featuring country-and-western, old standards and rock and roll, the clear preferences of the non-urban listening market.

To feed the new afternoon show, as yet un-named, Laplante says the network will "obviously have to look into the need for more reporters and correspondents." As well, a "dialogue" is going on about the addition of a part-time technician for the National Assembly press gallery newsroom, which until now has used the idle Quebec AM studio to prepare and transmit news reports after the show goes off the air at 9 a.m. "We're looking at solutions for that problem."

Laplante says current CBC staffers will likely seek the new posts, "but they will be mainly filled from outside. We're posting the jobs now."

The new show will go on the air Oct. 1 as part of a network-wide programming shakeup. A new afternoon "lifestyles information" show will replace the music-request show RSVP in the 1 to 3 p.m. time slot, among other changes.

"I'm going to be like Moses parting the Red Sea"

Elvis Presley has finally paid back a debt to Terry Wheeler.

When Elvis was going through trying times, Lennoxville-born Wheeler went to Nashville to help the 'King'. He gave Presley a song, *Sing out Sweet Jesus*, in 1969. Wheeler says it helped Presley get through the year: "He needed something in his life."

Now Presley, who died in 1977, has given Wheeler a song in return.

"The song, *Tupelo*, was given to me in 1982. All I can tell you right now is that it was delivered to me at three o'clock in the morning. In the middle of the night, I heard it. He (Presley) was singing the whole thing."

And the story gets even stranger.

Wheeler sees himself as the world's newest musical prophet. He's tired, he says, of the travesties of New Wave, heavy metal, and rock music that just isn't what it used to be. "1985 is a revival. I'm going to be like Moses parting the Red Sea" of music, Wheeler claims.

After a twenty-year career on the club circuit, K.D. Records in Nashville is going to release the single, named after Presley's birthplace. The record should be out

in mid-August.

The song, says Wheeler, will create a sensation. Because of its message, more than everything else.

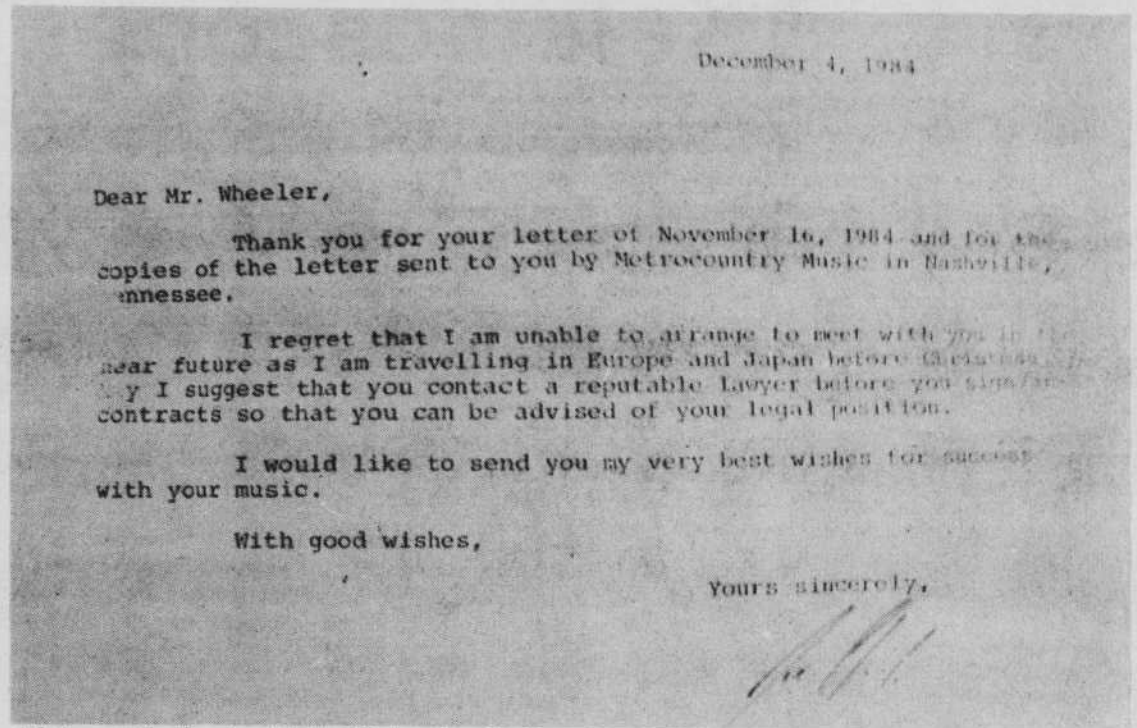
But the message will only be there for the true believers who listen closely to what Wheeler is singing. "There's a spiritual force behind this one," he says.

"There's a possibility in there somewhere that someone's going to say, 'Is he (Presley) really alive?'"

Wheeler looks a lot like his dead idol. He sports the patented Presley hair-do and sideburns. The pink silk shirt he wears for the interview is unbuttoned halfway. The almost bell bottomed jeans, held up by an ancient black belt, are so faded they're almost white. Brown cowboy boots round off the Nashville country boy look. He even cuts off the 'g' sound in words ending in 'ing'. He speaks in measured tones, carefully considering each word.

"There's so much involved here," he tries to explain. "I'm sortin' it out — it has to be right."

Wheeler says the band he's forming to back him up will consist of Presley's oldest friends and confidantes. He won't give names, but says country star Johnny Cash has been contacted,

among others.

But Presley's closest friend, says Wheeler, is himself.

Wheeler put a demo tape in Presley's mailbox in 1969. A year later, at a concert at the Hilton Hotel in Las Vegas, the two finally met. Wheeler says Presley got his tape and "through his connections, it was recorded in 1972 by a black girl out of Detroit named Toby Lark." Distributed in Canada by RCA, it didn't sell.

"The only way to reach him was a little cassette tape — it cost me a dollar and a half. I was able to reach him with this cassette. The message on that tape was sent out for help." There was no other way to contact Presley because the only person he trusted in the world at that time was his mother, claims Wheeler. He was protected from the outside world: "He was protected not by bodyguards, but by God's angels all the way." But the angels charged with the safekeeping of Presley's "ghost — no, that's the wrong word, spirit — have lost it. But Elvis' spirit is alive and well. I've heard him, made contact with him."

"Put it this way. Whether they believe it or not, there's only one person to get in touch (with Elvis') mind, body and spirit. Listen, there are some things we as human beings don't understand."

"Tell them to attend my first concert. The whole mystery: 'Is he alive? Has he changed his face?' — will be revealed."

"What happened is, I got tuned into what Elvis was all about," says Wheeler. His father first introduced him to Presley's music in 1955, and the fascination with the singing star grew.

And with what Presley stood for. "Elvis Presley was needed to do something very special for the people. The real basics of it where Elvis was concerned was to help where he could." Wheeler swears his mother, on welfare, will never have to pay another phone bill again.

Continental Drift examines American problem

Continental Drift by Russell Banks (FITZHENRY & WHITE-SIDE): \$26.50, 366 pp.

Playing on the ambiguity of the book's title, **Continental Drift** is native New Englander Russell Banks's eighth work of fiction. It is about the drift in America into a society accustomed to gut-

mount, New Hampshire. As the 1980s begin, Dubois is seized by an overwhelming anxiety that he interprets as restlessness and dissatisfaction with his dead-end job, which leads him to a decision that seals his fate. Taking only their portable property, the Dubois family strikes out for the unlimited opportunities that seem to be offered by a new start in Central Florida. Once he is employed as a clerk in his older brother's liquor store, the locale of Oleander Park does not turn out to be the golden opportunity it had seemed to be when it beckoned to the troubled Bob Dubois in the midst of a harsh northern winter.

Russell Banks catches the minutiae of life in America equally well from two perspectives — the economic and the emotional. Through his traumatized protagonist Bob Dubois, Banks strips the soul of America bare, while writing in a serious, engaging style. The story is by turns comical, up-lifting, tragic and totally depressing, but it is as clear a portrait of the ennui that grips America in the 1980s as has found its way into print to date.

At the other extreme in the book's dual focus is the tragedy of a young Haitian woman, Vanise Dorsinville and her infant son, and teenaged nephew, who yearn to escape the absolute poverty of their Caribbean island/prison for the economic salvation of Reagan's America. Russell Banks's plot brings Dubois and the illite-

rate Haitian woman into a collision course that is no less real than yesterday's headlines in the Miami Herald. **Continental Drift** has an inevitable conclusion, given the emotional and economic turmoil of its characters, but there is nothing predictable or ordinary about Russell Banks's style or his ability to fashion believable characters who gain the reader's sympathy and empathy.



KIDS' BOOKS

Hansel and Gretel, story by the Brothers Grimm/ Illustrations by Arnold Lobel (DELACORTE-DOUBLEDAY): \$18.95, 38 pp.

Illustrator Arnold Lobel takes few liberties with the text of the original folktale in this brutal, stark story that gives motherhood a bad name. In this version the mother of Hansel and Gretel persists in her scheming to make some economic retrenchment in the form of jettisoning her loved ones into the cruel dark forest. Once the lost children encounter the disguised wicked witch, posing as a kindly old woman who takes the children in and feeds them, the tale moves into the familiar ending. The grisly end to the naive witch comes as she challenges Gretel's baking talents, and the children make their way back to their widowed father. The evil mother having died, as the ending states, the abbreviated family lives happily ever after. The illustrations in this edition have a rough, sketchy quality about them that reinforces the brutality of the tale. It's a pity the price of the book couldn't have been held to under

ten dollars so that parents could be enticed into adding this book to their children's library.

Return To Oz by Walt Disney Pictures (RANDOM HOUSE): \$8.75, Illustrated with stills from the film.

Disney's attempt to rekindle the excitement of the perennial children's favourite about Dorothy and the Wizard of the Emerald City has met with mixed reactions. In the book spin-off it is clear that the charm of the original cast has been replaced by an attempt to create R2-D2 and D-3PO figures in the "Wheeler" and a squat copper-kettle looking character called "Tik-Tok". This book opens with Dorothy's family doubting the girl's absurd tale about Oz, sending her to a shrink for some frightening analysis — both relatives and doctor dressed in symbolic, suggestive black garb. Once poor Dorothy escapes from a sinister looking psychiatrist-type when the building catches fire (a couple of children's nightmares being played on), her wandering in the woods leads her into an **Alice In Wonderland** journey adrift along a river, culminating in her reappearance in Oz.

The plot then takes on the kind of twists and entries of quirky characters that characterized L. Frank Baum's original book treatment. Kids who delight in the colourful parade of puppets that made Jim Henson a billionaire obviously will love the clutter of creatures that people the **Return To Oz**. How this confused jumble of new folk will register on kids will depend on their reaction to the film. If they like the movie, they'll probably love this book.

RECORD REVIEWS

Richard Thompson **ACROSS A CROWDED ROOM** (POLYGRAM)

Their professional career and their married life both sundered by those inevitable irreconcilable differences, Richard and Linda Thompson have released solo albums simultaneously. While Linda's is hardly a light-hearted, lyrical work, hubby Richard's is a *crie de coeur* that shouts out the anguish of perfidious lovers. Despite this album's title, there are few enchanted moments being sung about here. Instead, Thompson rails forth at the deceit and cruelty of a lover who has left.

"When The Spell Is Broken" is a tear-jerker that serves up generous doses of the guitar style that made Thompson and the Fairport Convention into cult figures in the U.K. The influence can be heard in a reverse sort of way in that Richard's guitar licks on most tracks sound like the now stylish Mark Knopfler's. By the third track into this album, you become aware that this is an inspired, classy record with a bluesy belter like "I Ain't Going To Drag My Feet No More", really setting a solid groove on the big, beaty numbers. Just as well, as the emotion dripping off slower

songs like "Love In A Faithless Country" might wear thin after two sides. Instead there are some frantic, rocky tunes like "Fire In The Engine Room" and "Little Blue Number", the latter a Mick Jagger vehicle with inspired guitar noodling. "She Twists The Knife Again" should perhaps be the representative tune here, epitomizing the antipathy that remains of the love Richard had for Linda Thompson. What saves **ACROSS A CROWDED ROOM** from soap opera, maudlin tediousness is that Richard's emotional trauma has been refined into a remarkable, captivating album of original music.

Amy Grant **UNGUARDED** (A&M)

It's not that gospel and rock have ever really been strangers, given the use Elvis and his Jordanaires made of the churchy rhythms and fervor, but beauty Amy Grant is making a large impression with her love songs directed to Jesus. "Love Of Another Kind" uses the standard language, rhythms and pleas, but the object of the singer's affections is her saviour. Now, in a society flipped out over Madonna and her coy declaiming to be virginal with everything in her physical mien shouting the opposite, Amy Grant would seem to be bucking a trend. She does it with a very strong, likeable voice, with not quite the edge of Anne Murray's but certainly superior to a lot of fem-rock vocalists working like Cyndi or Prince's harum guards.

A variety of songs on **UNGUARDED** allows Amy to sing to a less spiritual lover, her husband, which she does on "I Love You", or to jump into a "Footloose" style of foot-tapping tune on "Fight". There's probably a great chance that the lyrics to Amy Grant's songs won't even be suspected of being directed toward an ethereal amour, so the gospel slant may not even prove a liability in the glitter world of contemporary rock. When Springsteen's "Born In The U.S.A." in misinterpreted as being a proud celebration of America, with nary a listen to the condemnatory accusations of aggression and violence, Amy Grant's gospel rock will likely be accepted without question. This album is slickly produced, well-played and a good showcase for the young artist who has been proclaimed as representing "to Christian pop music what Michael Jackson is to the rest of the recording world."

shuddering violence; the rootlessness of labor-seeking drifters and their unsettling influence on populations; as well as the inevitable movement of the destitute living in the satellite nations on the fringe of the U.S.A. toward the Sun Belt and its fabled opportunities.

Continental Drift tells, with shattering reality, the story of Robert Dubois (pronounced locally as "Doo-Boys"), an oil furnace repairman living with his wife and two small girls in Cata-

'To be a potter forever and ever' — Lucy Doheny

LENNOXVILLE — "Beauty without purpose is futile," says Lennoxville potter Lucy Doheny, and her work is anything but futile.

Doheny, who works from the delightfully eccentric but comfortable clutter of the Doheny family estate on Lennoxville's Moulton Hill, surrounded by an uncertain number of dogs, cats and other wildlife, is a rare breed — a successful, full-time working craftsman who's frantic output is matched only by the clamor of potential purchasers. "Yeah, I'm not doing too badly," she admits.

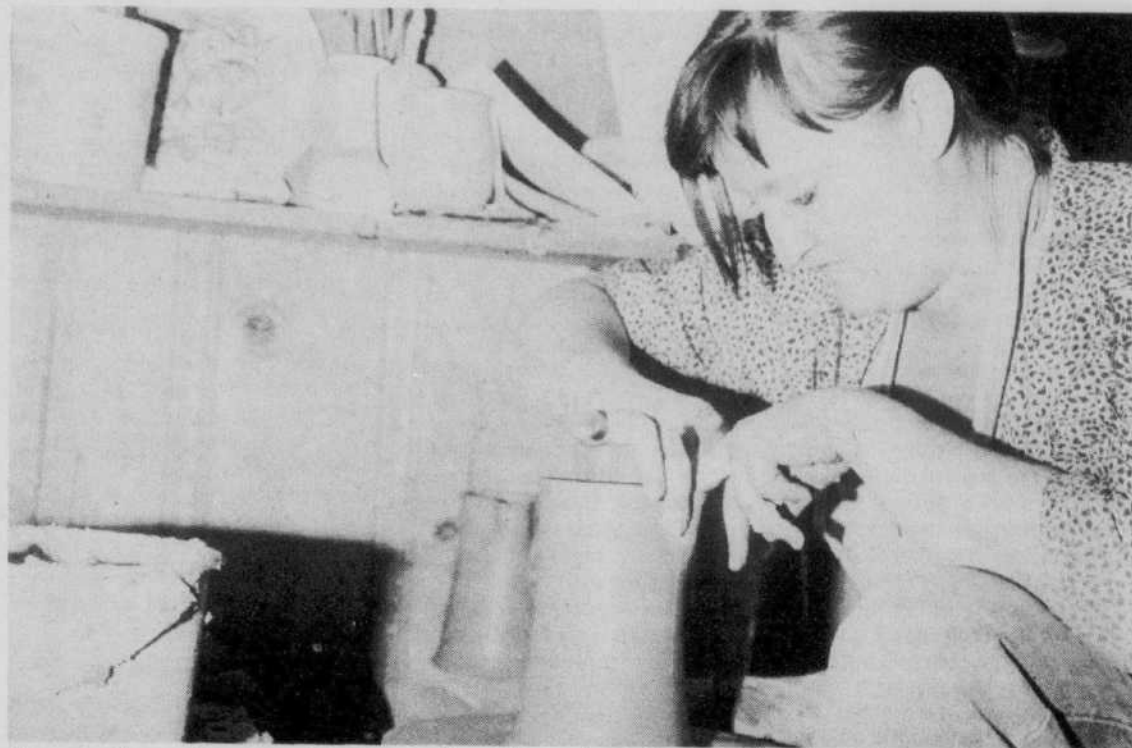
Doheny came to potting by the back door, as it were, while a student of classical studies at Bishop's University in 1981. "I was fascinated by archeology," she explains, "and an awful lot of that concerns sifting through broken pottery. I decided that the only way to understand the medium was to get into it myself. After that, I was hooked."

Doheny studied under Cham-

plain fine arts professor Dean Mullavey, himself a brilliant potter, and still finds herself largely under his influence, if not his control. "Dean still terrifies me," she admits, "and I still cringe when I wait for him to comment on my latest work. He is my favorite person in the whole world, but a ruthless critic. He thinks I've sold out."

The "selling out" that Doheny refers to, is that process of simplification that has fallen over her work in the last couple of years. Producing "purposeful" pieces and sets, with deceptively simple lines and understated, almost ethereal designs, Doheny says she feels she has finally found her style.

"For a long time," she says, "I was trying to live up to other people's standards — I wanted to be like Dean or like Alan (Gerish, another local potter). This was frustrating in the long run because I am not those people and I can't be like them. Alan is brilliant — a genius — I'm just a potter. And I want to be a potter forever and ever."

Doheny says that her work started to really develop the Doheny style when she began to concentrate on producing useful, working pottery. "Much of the inherent beauty of a pot comes out through its day-to-day use. Pots are and should be useful things."

Doheny's latest exhibit is at North Hatley's Piggery Theatre where their clean and simple lines are proving a popular attraction. "I have also started getting a lot of orders from restaurants and hotels which is really helpful." Doheny built most of the pottery used at the Hovey Manor in North Hatley as well as for several other local institutions. "A little bit of gravy for the bread and butter."

Doheny's ambition is to be able to devote herself full-time (as opposed to the six-hour a day, 300 days a year schedule she now maintains) to potting, an ambition thwarted by the economic necessity of holding down a part-time job to make ends meet. "It's in sight," she says, "if not yet in reach."

Doheny spends most days in her studio working her deceptively small, but effective wheel with everything from coffee cups to wine coolers rolling off with surprising ease. Her dogs, of which there appear to be three (they move too fast to be sure), inspect every piece carefully before giving the final approval that allows for the piece to be fired in one of Doheny's two electric kilns. "I really like these kilns, they're compact and efficient and I can fire them both about four times a week, as opposed to about once a month with the tra-

ditional brick kilns."

The cats — business mangers and accountants all — stare approvingly at the potter from their perches across the room — less approvingly at the disorderly canines.

"Yeah, I know it's nuts, but the animals actually help me work. They're in on everything — not to

mention into everything — and they are my best pals, after all," she says.

Lucy Doheny's most recent works are now on display — and sale — in the lobby of the Piggery and will be until July 13. If you like your beauty useful, you might wish to investigate the purposeful product of a remarkable and beautiful lady.

A gift of love lights up North Hatley church

Brand-new window couple's 'return to find sacred things'

NORTH HATLEY — A year ago two good friends in North Hatley decided to do something good for their church, the St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic church in North Hatley.

"We love our community, and we wanted to contribute to our community and parish," said Ninette Sylvestre.

So now the front of the church is adorned with a unique stained glass window, about 10' by 12', designed and built by two of its very own parishioners.

Sylvestre, 44, and Maurice Biron, 75, met about four years ago while taking a course in stained glass at Alexander Galt. Both have done many lamps and small ornaments, and Biron has made a few small windows, but the church window is by far the most ambitious project they've ever tackled.

Originally, the window at the front of the church was composed of panes of white glass arranged in the shape of a cross on a background of gold.

The new window leaves the cross at the centre but replaces the gold background with a delicate and complex pattern rich with color and carefully chosen symbols.

LIGHT AND LIFE

"The cross: source of light and life" is the overall theme of the window. Leaves, vines and fruit clustering around the cross symbolize life. Bunches of grapes, traditional symbol for the blood of Christ, here symbolize the abundance and blessing brought by His sacrifice.

Birds of paradise mounting toward the sky suggest holy aspiration, while radiant blossoms are intended "to represent the ideal life which Christ by His cross suggested to us."

In a bulletin from the dedication service two weeks ago, the artists say they also chose the natural elements because "in a setting so close to nature as our village and its church, we thought it fitting to use these pastoral symbols."

The artists have worked two

full days a week for the past year to complete the project, but Biron says "It was a type of prayer, and that's why we took pleasure in doing it."

"In our age, we have lost much of our sense of the sacred," said Sylvestre. This project represents for her "a return to find things that are sacred."

Biron and Sylvestre gave their time and the materials to the church completely free of charge. They declined to say how much the whole effort cost them, but later revealed that on their first trip back from Montreal with supplies the car was loaded down with 100 square feet of glass, which can range from \$3.50 to \$20 a square foot depending on the type of glass and the color. There are about ten types of glass used in the window.

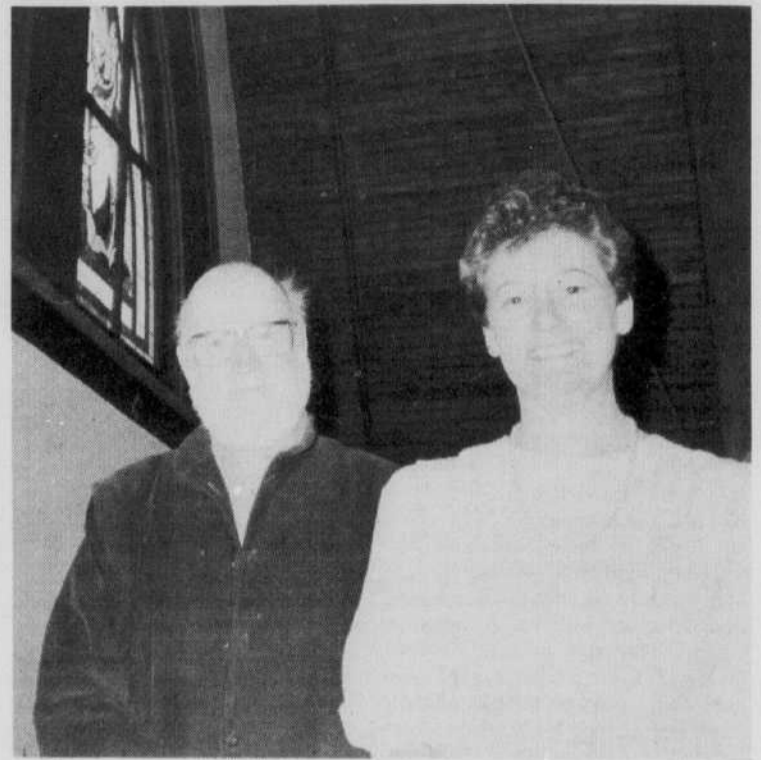
They had to make a couple more trips back to Montreal when they ran out of supplies.

In working with glass you have to count on about 25 per cent loss because of breakage, says Biron, especially when working with such small curves as those featured in the St. Elizabeth's window.

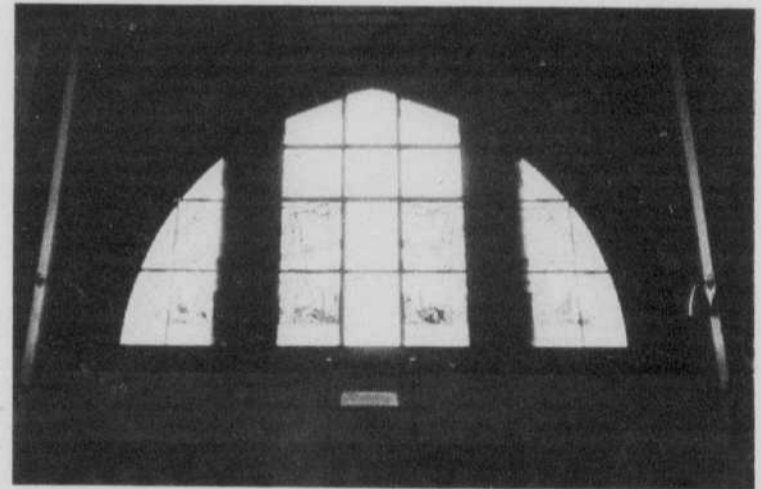
The artists worked in Sylvestre's workshop, cutting the glass, in many cases filing the edges, and then binding them with copper tape to be soldered together. The week before it was installed, Sylvestre spent three days cleaning the window.

The congregation has reacted enthusiastically to the new window, says Sylvestre, and someone even suggested they fill the rest of the windows around the church, which are still the basic white and gold squares.

Are they going to follow this suggestion? "Not tomorrow morning," says Biron.

Tennessee Riders are the attraction over at the **Motel Bretagne** in Waterville, with good-time traditional country tunes on Friday and Saturday.

The rough and ready **Pig Bone** have escaped their haunts in the western Eastern Townships for a month-long stint down at **The Maples** in Stanstead. These guys are raunchy, but they are also good and provide a lot of fun.

Country music reigns supreme at **Lennoxville's The Hut** this weekend with music by **Rocky River Country** Saturday night.

Exhibitions/Events

That delightful face you see beaming up at you on this week's cover belongs, of course, to none other than potter extraordinaire **Lucy Doheny**, a very gifted and personable lady whose pots are now on display and sale in the lobby of **The Piggery** theatre in North Hatley. For those of you with a penchant for finely crafted, extremely serviceable pottery, this show is a must. **Doheny's** work is simple yet lovely — and even affordable. Do check out this show when you catch the play, and bring your checkbook. You will not want to go home empty-handed.

Also on display and sale at the **Piggery**, are the paintings of **Antonia Mitchell**. **Mitchell's** work shows a marvelous diversity of both technique and style. As the artist readily admits, she is still experimenting and has not as yet developed a definitive style, but her imagination and daring are quite commendable. Both the above exhibits continue throughout the running of **Mommy** at the theatre until July 13.

In **Coaticook**, the **Beaulne Museum** has a collection of 25 new pieces by talented *eaux-fortes* artist **Jeannine Bourret**. **Bourret** has chosen a nature theme this time, and presents a delightfully informal — friendly even — collection of animal and nature scenes that are full of whimsy and humor. **Bourret** is a serious artist, but her art is anything but sombre and is a pleasure to behold. The show continues throughout the summer, and the **Beaulne** is open daily from 11 a.m. until 5 p.m.

In **Sherbrooke**, the art of Vietnamese artist-in-exile **La Toan Vinh** is on display during the month of July. The artist here makes definitively bold statements in his work to varying effect. While his use of color is daring, it doesn't always work, but then again **Mikey** doesn't always work and he's not even daring — reckless maybe, foolhardy definitely, but not daring. Anyway, in this case I will allow the viewer to make his own decisions on this artist, because I don't feel like arguing with anybody about it.

My old favorite the **Asbestos Mineralogical and Mining History Museum** in **Asbestos** has three recently-opened exhibits on display these days, and you might want to take the kids along with you to see these rather informative displays. You might even learn to identify the species of rock bouncing around inside **Junior's** skull. The first one is called **Minerals and Photographs — Bolivia 1950-52** a collection by mining engineer **Louis Conneveld** who visited the area way back when. Since as far as I know the **Bolivians** haven't taken to farming any brand new rocks, the samples of the geological foundations of the **South American** nation are still valid. The second exhibit is a little closer to home base, and is called **Solbec, Cupra, d'Estrie and Weedon — Four Mines of the Townships**. These four former base-metal mines are situated in the **Lac Aylmer** region of **Stratford-Fontainebleau**, and each offers some interesting mineralogical curiosities collected by **Paul Fortin**. Finally, **Rock Specimens from the Appalachian System in the Townships** which looks at the areas from **Kingsbury** to

St-Adrien and **East Angus** to **Hereford**. The **AMMHM** is open daily from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. and is located at 104 **Letendre Street** in **Asbestos**.

This next was a little late arriving on my desk, it seems, but the **Arts Sutton Summer School** program is ready to begin. The program runs from July 8 to August 7 and includes bilingual workshops on drawing, watercolor, painting, music, and papermaking and is designed to offer maximum instruction to teenagers and adults, beginners and experts. Now, according to the blurb **Mikey** got in the mail, the deadline for applications has already passed, but I can't help but feel that if a particular workshop has not already filled its available places, you might still squeeze your way in. In any event, for more information on this valuable program, I suggest you call either **Eve Gossage** at (514) 248-3969, or **Yvon Geoffroy** at (514) 538-3809. Whattya got to lose except your whiskers?

The latest efforts by well-known E.T. artist **Gordon Ladd** can still be seen at **Arts Sutton** until Sunday, so keep that one in mind too. **Ladd** has a formidable reputation as one of the region's finest artists and his work is displayed in the area far too infrequently. This is a good chance to catch up on what the man is up to. **Arts Sutton** is open from 11 a.m. until 5 p.m., and the artist will be present in person on both Saturday and Sunday.

Theatre

Since the demise a few years back of the murdered **Festival Lennoxville**, the only regular summer theatre in English in the area is at the **Piggery** so it will be natural for this place to dominate this section. However, be that as it may, the **Piggery** is now offering a fine piece of theatre at the moment with **Mommy** a translation by **Michael Sinelnikoff** of an internationally-acclaimed one-woman piece by **Louise Dussault** about the frustrations and joys of motherhood. There is much to commend about this play, particularly the exhausting physical performance by actress **Christine Moynihan** in the title role. I know I said it's a one-woman play and therefore referring to the role as 'title' may sound redundant, but **Moynihan** is also charged with bringing us into contact with the character's twin daughters, a bus driver, a drunk, a floozie, a snob and her aging mother and a few other types anyone who has ever ridden on an inter-city bus (probably about 2.3 per cent of the average **Piggery** audience) is far too familiar with. By the time she's done, **Moynihan's** remarkably athletic performance has allowed us to meet and get to know all these people. **Mikey** cannot claim that he now understands what being a mother is all about (yeah, right, cut the cracks) but he did find both the play and the performance delightful.

In **French-language** theatre, the **Théâtre Entre Chien et Loup** is presently producing **Jeudi le 12** a horror farce written by **Yves Lebel** and directed by local wiz **Patrick Quintal** starring **Luc Brière**, **Denise Lamontagne**, **Rita Laverdière** and **Andrée Soucy**. The play is now being performed at the **Théâtre du Thé des Bois** in **Deauville** at 8:30 from Wednesdays through Saturdays until August 24. This company has been responsible for some of the better summer theatre in the region in recent years and wild comedy is almost the house specialty. Be forewarned, however, as in much comedy, dialogue can be a bit speedy so you really should have a reasonable grasp of the language if you want to know what's happening.

Back in **Sherbrooke**, the **Centre Culturel** at the **University of Sherbrooke** has another approach to motherhood with **André Roussin's La Maman** — about a widow trying to take care of her family in southern Italy. This is a comedy as well, with an intense but loving look at the Italian **Mamma** stereotype. This play stars **Françoise Arbour**, **Benoit Dumont**, **Pierre Gobeil** and **René Lefebvre** among others and is directed by **Pierre Gobeil**. Performances are at 8:30 on Wednesday and Saturday evenings from tomorrow until August 10.

Movies

Well there's something a little different coming to town this week at the **Capitol** in the form of **Back to the Future** a **Steven Spielberg** production starring **Michael J. Fox** and **Christopher Lloyd** (Taxi's **Jim Ignatowski**). This is sci-fi adventure yarn about a kid who is never on time for anything until one day he suddenly finds himself in another time zone altogether and I don't mean the 'half-an-hour-later-in-Newfoundland'-kind-either. The guy spends the rest of his time trying to get back into his own

time period and generally whoops it up in all kinds of adventure. Spielberg's name attached to a film generally means some technical wizardry combined with kids, weird things and fast-paced action. This could be good.

There ain't no anglofilm at the Carrefour this week.

In Cowansville, the *Cinéma Princesse* is holding over the new Clint Eastwood silent stranger film *Pale Rider* which, from what I understand gives you more of what Eastwood's incredible reputation is based on — quiet tough stranger comes into town and blows away all the bad guys with particularly satisfying violence. Also on hand is *Protocol*, the Goldie Hawn vehicle about a cute, but dizzy blonde who is appointed a protocol officer by the U.S. government after she takes a bullet meant for an Arab prince in her nice little butt.

Boring, boring, boring down at the Merrill's Show-place Cinemas this week as everything is back one more time including *Pale Rider*, *The Goonies*, *A View to a Kill* and *Rambore*.

I realize full well that not everyone shares Mikey's taste in flicks, but why does a movie have to contain more blood than Lebanon in order to make any bucks around here. It is particularly frustrating for those of us who enjoy things other than pointless violence and almost equally (but not quite) pointless teenage sex. Theatre owners know their audiences well and program accordingly. Mikey recently saw two excellent films in the big city that will never come here because of this and it's a shame. But I'll recommend them anyway.

The first is called *Birdy* an Alan Parker (Fame, Midnight Express) film about two young friends, each of whom has been seriously damaged by his experiences in Vietnam. The first, played by Nicholas Gage is physically scarred but recovering, while his buddy (Matthew Modine) has more pressing problems. The war has damaged him psychologically and he has reacted by turning in completely on himself and totally baffling his doctors. His friend however understands his pal, and recognizes that *Birdy* (a childhood nickname) has reverted to his lifelong passion for birds and flight and perches on his bed like a bird staring into space. This movie is a masterpiece as was recognized by the Cannes jury which awarded it a special prize this year. The story is at times hilarious, at others gripping, but sensitively and carefully done. A real gem.

The second is a low budget first-feature put together by a couple of New York sisters named Marisa and Dina Silver and it too is worth keeping a lookout for. It's called *Old Enough* and it's speaks of the relationship between a young girl from a well-to-do family (Sarah Boyd) and a supposedly street-wise working class 14 year-old from the other side of the tracks (*Rainbow Harvest*). This film works largely because of the young actresses and although it is a little rough around the edges it is a fascinating look at two youngsters learning about themselves and each other during a summer teenage friendship. A classy debut for a couple of kids we will see more of, I'm sure.

By the way, there is no gratuitous sex or violence in either of these films, so ya see, it can be done.

Television

Summertime is never noted for the great abundance of television programs worthy of mention that air during its reign, but frequently the summer provides the opportunity for networks to rerun some of their more popular shows, thus giving people a chance to catch up on what they've missed. There are a few examples of this in the upcoming week.

But first, we'll glance at something else, namely the 10:30 p.m. showing of *Our Sacred Land* on Vermont ETV tonight. This controversial half-hour documentary looks at the South Dakota regions known as the Black Hills and Bear Butte, considered holy grounds to the native Americans. These people claim that their historic and religious rights are being abused by development of these areas and they're really steamed about it.

For insomniacs out there, Channel 12 presents *Errol Flynn: Portrait of a Swashbuckler* at the ungodly hour of 1:50 a.m. tonight. Narrated by frequent Flynn co-star Christopher Lee, the film gives an in-depth look at the life and times, loves and laughs of one of Hollywood's greatest stars. Scenes from some of Flynn's best-known movies highlight the narrative.

At 2:50 Melvyn Douglas stars as a famous attorney who comes out of retirement to help his son defend a

man accused of murdering his terminally ill wife. *Bradford Dillman* and *Denver Pyle* also star.

At 2 p.m. Saturday, the 1947 comedy *The Farmer's Daughter* sees *Loretta Young* as a headstrong Swedish woman campaigning for a Congressional seat against the man she loves. Young won an Oscar for this role. *Joseph Cotton* co-stars.

For a little inspiration, you might want to check out *The Sporting Life* on Vermont ETV at 6 tomorrow as that show profiles *The Three-Quarter Century Softball Club*, all of whose members are at least 75 years old.

At 9, on Radio-Québec, *L'Histoire en jugement* looks at the life and times of *Erwin Rommel*, one of Nazi Germany's most brilliant military tacticians. Rommel, through his ability and gentlemanly reputation managed to win the respect and admiration of almost everyone he had anything to do with. Implicated in the July 1944 Hitler assassination plot, however, the days of the Field Marshall were numbered. Because of his status as a national hero, however, Rommel was allowed to end his own life rather than face the torture and humiliation that was the reward of many of the other officers connected with the plot.

Also at 9, on Vermont ETV, *Julie Christie* and *Alan Bates* star in a weird but alluring film about a young boy who inadvertently becomes *The Go-Between* for two lovers in the Victorian era.

At 10:30, Channel 12 presents a special called *Just Jazz* featuring *The Montreal Jazz Sextet* a group composed of some of Montreal's best-known jazz players. Included are *Charlie Biddle*, *Stephanie Biddle*, *Oliver Jones*, *Charles Ellison*, *Nelson Symonds*, *Bernie Primeau* and *Glenn Bradley*.

The CTV Saturday late-show, starting at midnight begins with *Sharky's Machine* starring *Burt Reynolds* as a cop determined to uncover the boss of Atlanta's crime and corruption.

At 2:25, *Elke Sommer* stars as a beautiful German model found bludgeoned to death in *I Love You Hugs and Kisses*. The film, based on the notorious *Peter Demeter* case co-stars *Donald Pilon* and *Chuck Shamata*. Demeter, you may have noticed was just convicted of trying to have his young cousin murdered as well and in general seems to be a thoroughly marvelous individual.

On Sunday at 2 p.m. *William F. Buckley* and his panel discuss *Is There a Case for Legalizing Drugs?*. Buckley is joined by *Dr. Gabriel Nahas*, of Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons, and *Arnold S. Trebach*, author of a book called *The Heroin Solution*.

At 7:30 on CTV, *In Session* features *Ronnie Hawkins* and *Beverly D'Angelo*. Besides being the godfather of Canadian rock and roll, Hawkins also discovered and tutored *D'Angelo* who has since become a seasoned actress and performer and has been highly acclaimed for her work in such movies as *Coal Miner's Daughter*.

If you overlooked this past season's premiering of the CBC series *A Planet for the Taking*, don't make the same mistake twice, as the CBC begins a rebroadcast of the nine-part series this Sunday at 9. Hosted by *Dr. David Suzuki*, the show examines the complex nature of man's relationship with the planet. This series is not only provocative and educational it is highly entertaining as well, although it does require a certain amount of cranial activity to keep up with the theme.

Following this at 10, on the CBC, *Alex Colville: The Splendour of Order* offers a portrait of one of Canada's most successful painters.

On Monday at 8, Vermont ETV's *The Heart of the Dragon* looks at the production, philosophy and theory of contemporary Chinese art.

At 9, still on Vermont ETV *Smithsonian World* offers *Designs for Living* an examination of some of the incredible adaptations man has made in order to allow himself to survive in outer space, under ground or underwater.

The CBC will never of course cease to amaze me, but even I was startled when I realized that they had dedicated last week's late movies to the theme *Americana*, probably due to the fact that the old Yew Ess of Eh celebrated its Independence Day this past week. Of course, we celebrated something that used to be called Dominion Day as well, but that doesn't count for much I guess. Anyway, this week the theme is *French Postcards* and your guess is as good as mine as to the why behind this one. Anyway, *The Story of Louis Pasteur* starring *Paul Muni* kicks off the thing this week on Monday. This is the seventh time CBC has shown this movie in the last 2 years. Pretty good, huh?

On Tuesday at 8 on Vermont ETV, NOVA presents

Stephen Jay Gould: This View of Life a program focussed on paleontologist and philosopher Gould, who provides some striking insights into the way things work.

Also at 8, CBC's *This Land* offers *A Paddle Through Time* a loving look at the noble canoe, without which the Canadian wilderness would never have been opened up.

At 9 Vermont ETV features *Lifeline*, a rebroadcast of the series that brings the tension of modern medicine right into your living room. You may be healthy and happy now, but a couple of episodes of this one will bring out the latent hypochondriac in you.

At midnight, on channel 12 *Willie Nelson*, *John Savage* and *Ben Cross* star in *Coming Out of the Ice* the true story of an American's struggle to survive a 10-year sentence in a Siberian labor camp.

On Wednesday, Vermont ETV offers eclectic musical variety beginning at 8 with *Live from Lincoln Center* featuring *Mostly Mozart Meets Salieri*. Conductor *Gerard Schwartz* leads the *Mostly Mozart Music Festival Orchestra* in works by the two composers.

This is followed at 10 by the *Happy Jazz Band* — a special highlighting the best of Dixieland swing and traditional jazz with performances by *Pete Fountain* and the *Jim Cullum Jazz Band*.

Radio

While Mikey frequently criticizes the good ol' CBC, he is also full of its praise when they do something right, which is exactly what they are doing this week. Starting at 6:30 CBC Stereo tonight will be broadcasting some of the action live from the *Montreal International Jazz Festival*; From the *Théâtre St-Denis*, we get the *Dave Young Trio* from Toronto along with trumpeter *Wynton Marsalis* and *Trio Music*, composed of pianist *Chick Corea* bassist *Miroslav Vitus* and drummer *Roy Haynes*. From the *Spectrum*, the *Widespread Jazz Orchestra* offers some swing tunes, while *The Persuasions* offer some all-male gospel-oriented *a capella music*. Finally, from the *Bibliothèque Nationale Montreal's* own avant-garde pianist *Jean Beaudet*. Now that's programming.

Now what has this country been missing all these years? You're absolutely right, what Canada has needed for an awful long time is an all-Inuit hard rock band, and now we've got one — *Northern Haze*. The band is composed of four young men from Igloovik, N.W.T. and writes its own music and sings entirely in Inuktitut. Now, I have to admit I'm curious about these guys as the hype has been very positive and we'll all get a chance to hear them on CBC Stereo's *The Entertainers* in a premier broadcast of their new CBC recording on Saturday at 10:45 a.m. The program is broadcast on CBC Radio Sunday at 1:30. Lotsaluk, guys.

Once we get over that, we can look forward to *Saturday Afternoon at the Opera* at 2:05 on CBC Stereo. This week, from the *War Memorial Opera House* in San Francisco *Das Rheingold*. The first of *Wagner's* four *Ring of the Nibelungen* operas. The Ring cycle is based on a mediaval Germanic myth and begins with the discovery of an enchanted golden treasure found at the bottom of the Rhine River. A ring forged from this gold will bring absolute dominion to whoever wears it. The ring gets stolen of course, and is passed from character to character in a larger than life morality play about virtue, greed, and power. The opera is performed by the *San Francisco Opera* under my favourite conductor the great *Edo de Waart*.

At 10:10 on CBC Radio, *Anthology* offers a reading of *The Kingdom of the Golden Dust*, by Toronto-based writer *Neil Bissoondath*. Bissoondath is a native of the Caribbean island of Trinidad and much of his work concerns the plight of blacks or East Indians living in Canada.

On Sunday afternoon on CBC Stereo, *Command Performance* offers the *Toronto Mendelssohn Choir* performing *Elijah*, Mendelssohn's great oratorio. During the break, a documentary on the choir itself.

At 4:05 on CBC Radio *Sunday Matinée* features *God of the North* by *Frank Jones*. This is the very strange story of a series of religious murders in the Belcher Islands in the Canadian Arctic in 1941. Nine Inuit were killed during a period of religious hysteria that offered a particular challenge to the Canadian legal system.

At 7:05 Stereo Theatre presents *The House on the Hill* by *Paul King*. It seems that on the night of Good Friday, 1962, Edmonton golf pro *Frank Willey* disappeared and was never seen again. Although no trace of his body was ever found, before long two men stood trial for his murder.

Historic Park honors last clash

Record editor Charles Bury has recently returned from a trip around the Gaspé peninsula. The following is the first in a series of reports on attractions and facilities for travellers there which will appear over the next few weeks.

CROSS POINT, Que. — This Baie des Chaleurs coastal village and Indian reserve is best known for a series of confrontations in 1981 and '82 between local Micmacs and the provincial government over salmon fishing rights. But a new federal historic park here sheds new light on a much older battle, and gives visitors an intimate look at a seaman's life in the mid-18th century.

Battle of the Ristigouche National Historic Park opened for the first time ever Saturday June 22, and by happy coincidence, that was the day I stopped there.

It was a coincidence in two ways. First, I hadn't known that there were a park and museum under construction there at all (let alone that it would open that day), so I had gone down by the water on a dirt road which by-

passes the federal site, and just happened to spot the big federal sign in my rear-view mirror as I turned back onto Route 132. Second, the official opening was supposed to have taken place exactly one year earlier. Both the Parks Canada builders and I were one year late!

The Ristigouche park commemorates the last-ever naval battle between France and England over the franchise for North America. The British won. Several French vessels were sunk in the shallow water at the mouth of the Restigouche River (yes, they are spelled differently), at Cross Point.

Let's let Parks Canada give us the historic background, as described in the Ristigouche management plan:

REINFORCEMENTS NEEDED

"Although Quebec had fallen to the British in the autumn of 1759 the authorities of New France, entrenched at Montreal, did not believe that the colony was irretrievably lost. On November 25 the Chevalier François Le Mercier, bearing letters and requests for reinforcements from Governor Vaudreuil, managed to slip past Quebec on the *Machault* un-

der cannon fire from the city and reached France on Christmas eve.

"Upon learning of Vaudreuil's requests, France agreed to accede to them, but only in part, deciding to send the *Machault* accompanied by five merchant vessels back to New France. However, the expedition dispatched by the minister, Berryer, in response to Vaudreuil's petitions fell far short of what had been asked, as only 400 of the 4000 men requested were sent and the ships carried scarcely an eighth of the flour needed. Also the response came very late since the fleet, which was scheduled to set sail in mid-February in order to reach the St. Lawrence river ahead of the British reinforcements, did not leave Bordeaux until April 10. **400 SAILORS, 375 CREW**

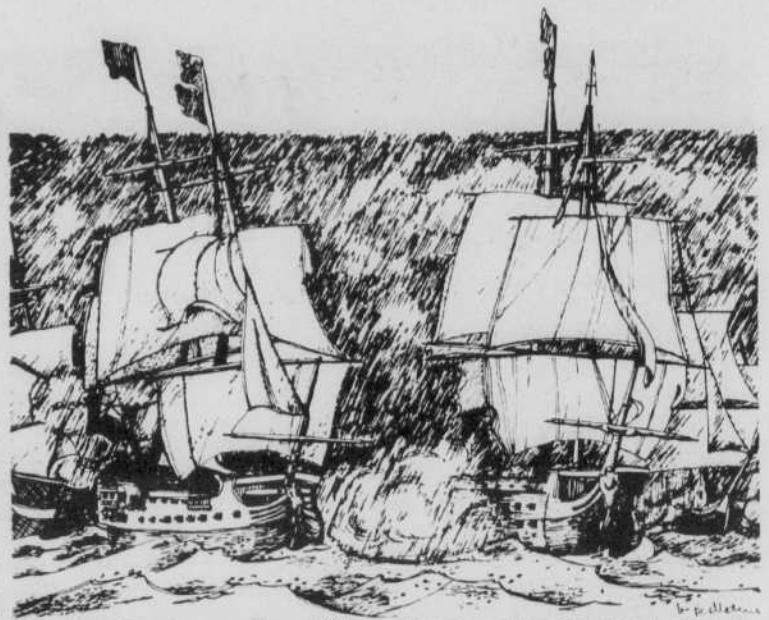
"Altogether, the six ships which sailed down the Bordeaux River weighed 2,424 tons, were fitted with approximately one hundred small cannon and carried 800 tons of flour and nearly 2,000 rifles; 400 soldiers and 375 crew were also on board. One day out of port, the fleet, commanded by François Chénard de la Giraudais on board the *Machault*, was forced to split up in order to escape the British ships blockading the coast. When the fleet managed to regroup, only three of the six ships were at the rendez-vous point: the *Machault*, the *Bienfaisant* and the *Marquis-de-Malauze*. The *Aurore* and the *Soleil* were stopped by the Royal Navy and the *Fidélité* was shipwrecked off the Azores on or around April 30. Consequently, the relief expedition saw its cargo cut by more than half and was minus some forty cannon, 180 soldiers and 120 crew.

REFUGE IN THE BAY

"After a crossing unmarred by further mishaps, the three ships sailed into the Gulf of St. Lawrence and, on May 15, intercepted an enemy ship. As a result, La Giraudais learned that the British had preceded him into the Gulf. Since the route to Montreal was therefore closed, La Giraudais decided to take refuge at the head of Chaleur Bay, out of reach of the British warships. It was thought that this strategic withdrawal would give the fleet time to take on provisions and drinking water and to send messengers to Governor Vaudreuil. Between May 15 and 19, the French fleet captured five more British merchant vessels before dropping anchor at the mouth of the Ristigouche River. Some 1,500 Acadians worn out by privations, as well as a tribe of Micmac Indians consisting of nearly 150 families, had already settled the area. The timely arrival of the fleet and the hope of obtaining provisions attracted many more Acadians, who arrived daily aboard schooners and small vessels of all kinds.

BLOCKADED!

"This unusual gathering of vessels alerted the British, who quickly



dispatched a squadron of five warships from Louisbourg under the command of Captain Byron. By June 24, the French found themselves blockaded in the inlet.

"Supported by two gun batteries on either side of the estuary and well out of range of the British guns (because of a dangerous channel which the enemy did not yet know about and in which the French had scuttled several schooners) the three French ships did not have to engage battle until July 8. The cannonade began early in the morning but died out around noon, because the French ships were short of gunpowder. Those in charge of the expedition decided to scuttle the *Machault* and the *Bienfaisant* to prevent their falling into British hands.

SHIP, PRISONERS ABANDONED

"The *Marquis-de-Malauze* was abandoned to the British, along with the prisoners taken by the French since their arrival in the Gulf, and was subsequently set ablaze. The near total destruction of the French fleet marked the failure of the relief expedition. Byron therefore thought it unnecessary to pursue the matter, and the British fleet returned to base.

"Virtual prisoners at the head of Chaleur Bay, the Acadians and the French continued to await word from Canada. They spent the summer repairing the damage caused by the British and refloating several of the sunken vessels; they even managed to capture two British ships using Acadian schooners that had been recovered. The capitulation of Montreal on September 8, 1760, ultimately brought about the surrender of the garrison at Ristigouche toward the end of October. At the beginning of November, the French officers, soldiers and seamen were sent back to France."

FOUND AND REFLOATED

Almost 200 years passed. Then during the 1930s members of the Micmac reserve found and refloated one of the smaller ships. Although badly deteriorated through poor preservation techniques, this vessel can still be seen in the northeast corner of the Cross Point Catholic churchyard.

Another 50 years passed. Then several years ago (in the days when Ottawa still thought it had money to spend), a group of skin

divers working for Parks Canada turned up some of the sunken wreckage and federal marine archaeologists moved in. They brought up the flagship *Machault* and Ottawa decided to make a museum out of it. They have done a good job.

Along with large sections of the preserved wooden hull of the *Machault*, there are many things to see in the Ristigouche museum-park.

A 10-minute animated film (soundtracks in both English and French) tells the story of the battle. Displays of artifacts give the visitor an intimate look at many sides of the life of a French sailor during the Seven Years War. Many of the exhibits are placed in life-like settings. Fluently bilingual guides are pleased to fill in the gaps and add details.

PART OF THE SHOW

Speaking of the guides, look for one whose nameplate says he's André Grégoire. He and his work are worthy of an exhibit in themselves.

Grégoire was a happy Cross Point biker until one sunny day a few years ago when his motorcycle went out of control and spilled. The bike was a write-off; Grégoire almost was.

"I broke my neck," he told me.

"When I got out of hospital I took therapy to see if I could get some use of my limbs back. I was learning to draw and I found I enjoyed it. Some of my friends said I was pretty good. When I got back into a bit better shape, I decided to pursue art. I got into the Fine Arts department at Concordia University in Montreal (which has a national reputation, by the way), and learned many techniques and some of the theories of art."

Back home with his fine arts degree, Grégoire set himself up in the stained glass business. His reputation has now reached regional proportions and I guess it won't be long before he is a national art figure. Watch him. In the meantime, you can see some of his work in the decorative windows of the Cross Point Church."

After you visit the museum, 10 to 5 (I think I remember right), seven days a week (this I'm sure of) until September.

Battle of the Ristigouche National Historic Park may not be the kind of place you want to grow old and die, but it's an interesting place to spend an afternoon.
