Camp musical de L'Estrie celebrates 20 years

It's the only music camp in the Eastern Townships that offers specialized instruction for string musicians and it's called Camp Musical de L'Estrie.

The camp's 20th summer session began this past Monday, and runs through Aug. 13. Eighty participants ranging in age from five to 14 years old are taking part in the two-week camp this year, located at Bishop's University in Lennoxville. Twenty teachers and counselors are also on board.

"We are unique because we cater to violin, viola, cello and bass players," said camp director H el ene Veillette. "There is a music camp in Asbestos, but that one is only for winds. Campers come from all over the region. We even have two girls who used to live in Montreal, but now travel from Texas to be here."

Aside from practising, there are also many opportunities to perform at the camp. There is a daily concert from Tuesday to Friday, as well as a theatre evening next Thursday.

"We incorporate these components to get everyone more comfortable with performing in front of an audience," said Veillette. "It also gives participants a chance to play in a recital/concert-like environment."

Veillette herself has been a part of the program for 19 years, which was created by violin teacher Isabelle Monsarrat.

"I worked my way up from being a camper, counselor, assistant teacher, and teacher," said Veillette. "And I've helped manage the camp for the past three years."

Veillette is confident the camp will continue to be successful for decades to come.

"There is so much musical talent here. It's a great way to motivate youth. They do great work in these two weeks."

Will Webster knows sangrias

Food

My sister in law's family – the Websters of North Hatley – have an incredibly fun tradition. Every summer all 20 or so of them hold a drinks competition with a specific theme, varying from martinis to margaritas to... you get the idea.

Entries, all unidentified for the sake of fairness, are judged very carefully by family members, some of whom even take notes and change glasses after sampling each concoction (so flavours don't mix).

Last weekend I was fortunate enough to be invited to this oh-so-civilized booze tasting. The theme – sangria – was chosen by Will Webster, still today nostalgic of the nights he spent in Spain drowning his sorrows and sharing anecdotes over a glass or six of the wine-based drink.

It wasn't a surprise when we found out Will himself won the trophy (an impressive three-foot high affair with gilt plaques). His sangria had gotten my vote before I ever knew what was in it.

Doubtlessly the best I've ever tasted, it had an elegance and a lightness that the other entries couldn't match. His secrets? Tequila, Grand Marnier and

a good red wine instead of that awful *dépanneur* stuff, and no fruit juice at all.

If you choose to cheat (as I did), so that you don't have to buy three bottles of spirits, skip the Grand Marnier and double the quantity of Triple Sec – but in that case, you'll need to add four tablespoons of sugar to balance things out.

WILL WEBSTER'S AWARD-WINNING SANGRIA
(YIELDS EIGHT TO 10 GLASSES)

1 bottle dry Spanish red wine
1 bottle club soda (1 liter)
1 oz tequila
1 oz Grand Marnier
1 oz Triple Sec
2 oranges
2 lemons
sugar to taste (Will doesn't use any, but you might want to add a tablespoon or two)

Directions: Refrigerate the wine and the club soda. Wash lemons and oranges, pat dry and slice. Put all ingredients in a very large jug (or two smaller ones) and stir. Taste, and add sugar only if necessary (this is very subjective, of course). Add about two trays of ice, and serve.

Picnics by the book

Food always tastes better when it's accompanied by the sauce of fresh air, and someone you love to eat it with. But sometimes unfortunate basket blunders occur with less than appetizing results.

Fruit salad too warm? Cookies rock-hard? Veggie dip leaked all over your new capris? Learn how to avoid classic picnic pitfalls like these through a number of new books that take you through every step of setting up the perfect outdoor repast.

Here are a few of our favourite tomes on dining al fresco:

- In *Picnics: Easy Recipes for the Best Alfresco Foods*, Robin Vitetta-Miller (Clarkson Potter, 2005) shares easy-to-make recipes divided into five simple sections: finger foods, wraps and sandwiches, salad, dips and spreads, and sweet temptations such as pecan squares and almond biscotti.

Here's a tip: To keep your cookies moist, add a few apple slices or a piece of bread to the sealable plastic container where they are stored.

And to prevent sandwiches from becoming soggy, wrap them in plastic and

put them in resealable plastic bags. Make sure to separate bread and wet ingredients such as tomato slices with dry lettuce leaves.

- For those of the hedonism-in-a-hurry variety, who prefer skyscrapers to farmhouses, and are more likely to take a 15-minute bicycle ride to the park than a SUV-fuelled day trip, *The Urban Picnic* by John Burns and Elisabeth Caton (Arsenal Pulp Press, 2004) is for you. It's not just a cookbook but a handy reference tool on everything you ever wanted to know about the history of the picnic.

There are no photographs, but there are loads of quotations, trivia, song lyrics and advertisements of yore to distract you from cooking or, conversely, help you while away some time as the chicken grills and the raspberry tarts set.

A quirky feature is the list of suggested menus, complete with wine pairings and music soundtracks. Try the vegetarian 'hipnic' to the tunes of Ani DiFranco and Elvis Costello, while noshing on Jalapenos Stuffed with Chevre and Caramelized Oranges with Greek Yogurt. Or how about a "backpack" picnic, that includes vegetable sticks with Sun-Dried Tomato Hummus, Bacon and Egg Pie, fresh fruit

and lemonade to wash it down with.

- In *Picnics: Simple Recipes For Eating Outdoors* (Ryland Peters & Small, 2005), a team of food writers have come together to offer heart-healthy recipes that incorporate loads of fruits and veggies, as well as modern twists on classic brunch favourites.

Try Bagels with Smoked Salmon and Wasabi Sour Cream, using Japanese horseradish instead of the usual cream cheese spread.

Mini Pork 'n Apple Pies, Chicken and Tarragon Pesto Pasta, and Fava Bean Salad with Mint and Parmesan promise to please the most discerning of palettes, without breaking the bank or having to spend all day in the kitchen.

And for dessert, try making Pear Gingerbread or Nutty Candied Apples – your dentist won't be happy with this recipe, say the authors, but you and the kids will be.

- There's ideas for every possible kind of setting in *Picnics* by David Herbert (Conran Octopus Limited, 2004). And contrary to what some may believe, what's on the menu should vary depending on whether lunch is on the road, in the car, on a boat, on the beach

or with the kids.

Tea time in the park requires significant catering to those with a sweet tooth – nothing like beating off those mid-afternoon sugar lows with cake and all its gooey variations like hazelnut macaroons and banana bread.

If you're heading off to your picnic via bicycle, you'll need food that requires minimal packaging and can stand up to rough treatment as you bump along the pathway. That means robust wrapped baguettes, high-energy goodies such as the Chewy Cranberry Bars and savoury offerings like Feta, Cheddar and Chive Muffins.

None of the recipes recommended for a romantic picnic contain even a hint of garlic – so as not to spoil the post-picnic kisses, explains the author. Choose your spot carefully so as not to be disturbed by rowdy hikers or worse yet, any errant cows. And an armful of cushions can go a long way towards enjoying an idyllic afternoon.

Each of Herbert's recipes are conveniently followed by preparation, storage and serving tips to ensure your feast is an experience you'll want to repeat.

Compton to be overrun with country flavours

Throughout the summer, the Parks Canada site in Compton is the scene for specialty events each Sunday.

The Weekend with a Country Flavour is a two-day event, open from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, August 6 and 7. This is the fourth edition of the event and 19 regional producers and specialty chefs of various gastronomic delights will be in attendance, including seven new participants.

There is no admission charge to the grounds, however, visitors can purchase coupons which will permit them to choose the delicacies they prefer under one tent and then proceed to another where they will be able to enjoy their meal.

Wines and aperitifs, with or without alcoholic content, will also be available. Necessary utensils will be supplied. Additionally, three young musicians from the area will supply pleasant background music for their dining enjoyment.

Not a public market, but rather a 'gastronomic' event designed to make visitors aware of the many high-quality foods produced in the area, visitors will only pay for what they eat. Coupons are

available in strips of 10 for \$5 or 20 for \$10, or may be purchased individually at 50¢ each.

Based on last year's attendance, it is expected that between 1500 and 2000 visitors will attend over the two days.

This event, as well as several others held this summer, is sponsored in conjunction with a co-operating association known as the Companions of the Louis S. St. Laurent National Historic Site.

This organization, boasting some 60 members representing all walks of life within the Compton area, is under the leadership of president, Michèle Lavoie.

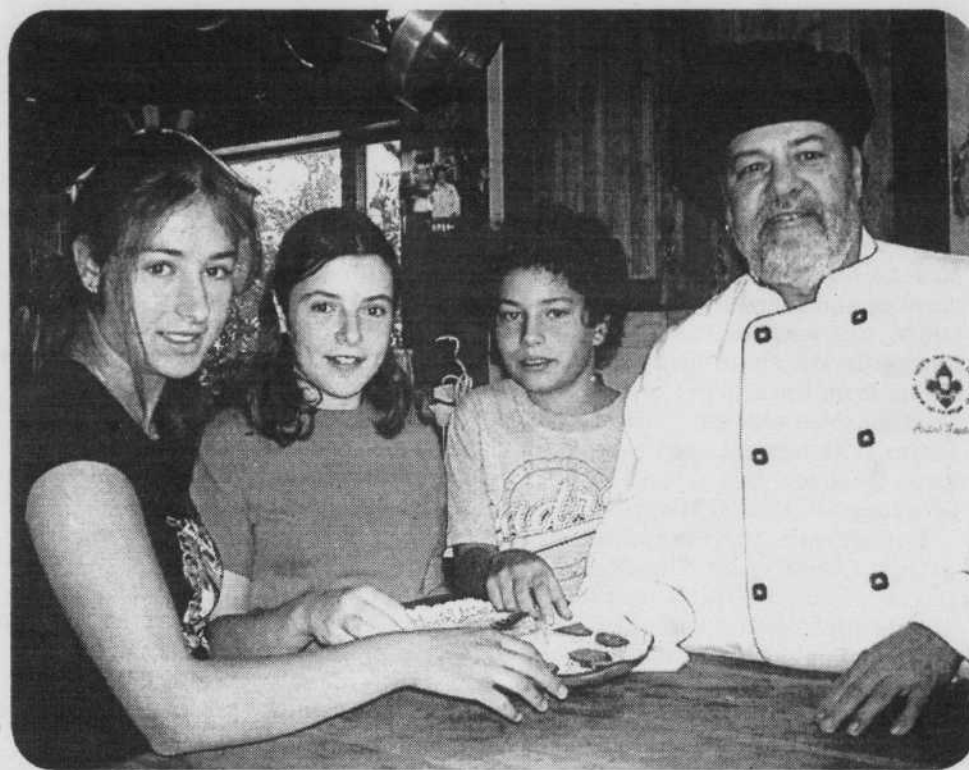
On Sunday, Aug. 14, the well-known area barbershop quartet, Quatuor à Médée, will perform.

Love List hits the funny bone with absurdity

So it's Bill's 50th birthday, and his best friend, Leon, gets him a dating service run by a gypsy woman. Bill's task is to fill out a 'love list' — the 10 qualities he's looking for in a woman, in order of importance.

Sense of humour, by the way, is ini-

tially number 10.

If that gypsy part sounds fishy to you, you're definitely more with it than either Bill or Leon, but that's the best part of Tonships Stage's production of Norm Foster's *The Love List* at the Piggery Theatre in North Hatley — the anticipation that something is going to go very, very wrong.

And it does. Eventually, after telling

Leon about the only woman he ever passionately loved, a Californian named Justine who died young in a car crash, a woman named, you guessed it, Justine, shows up at Bill's apartment in the middle of the night, spouting details of an intimate — and ongoing — relationship with Bill.

Figuring she's the real gift sent by his

friend, Bill goes with it. And that's where the fun really begins.

Foster's script is funny, and just needs a good cast and some good direction to bring it to life. Luckily, the Townships Stage production has both.

The weakest link in the cast is probably Doug Hooper, whose portrayal of

Momentous reunion at Orford Arts Centre

Music

The Orford Arts Centre brings together five musicians with ties to the Orchestre Symphonique de Montréal tonight as part of its Momentous Reunions series.

Current OSM members André Moisan on clarinet, Theodore Baskin on oboe and Stéphane Lévesque on bassoon join former members Robert Langevin on flute and James Sommerville on horn to perform R. Murray Schafer's *Minnelieder* (with mezzo soprano Julie Nesrallah), David Maslanka's *Quintet No. 3* and Mozart's *Serenade No. 12 in C Minor*.

For Moisan, who made his debut with the OSM in 1977 under Andrew Davis and as a soloist in 1997 with Charles Dutoit, the audience will certainly be enchanted by the Schafer and Mozart pieces, but according to him it is Maslanka's work that will truly surprise everyone.

"Maslanka's piece is the most technically demanding of the program. It

forces me to take my instrument to its limits," said Moisan, who compares the composition to a fireworks display that also features touching and serene moments. "I'm known for experimenting and going nuts with my clarinet but this piece actually calls on me to do just that."

A student of Larry Combs and Karl Leister, Moisan has been performing as a soloist, chamber musician and conductor for the past 25 years. His many concerts abroad, notably at Carnegie Hall in New York City, the Concertgebouw and Radio-Berlin have earned him international acclaim. As an orchestral musician, he has worked under the direction of conductors such as Mehta, Boulez, Mazur and Menuhin. He also teaches at the University of Montreal and gives master classes at the Sapporo (Japan) Pacific Music Festival.

His work away from the OSM — conducting, chamber music, teaching — is something Moisan cherishes.

"I told (then-conductor) Charles Dutoit when I joined the OSM that it was

a priority. They said it would not be a problem," explained Moisan, who began studying the clarinet with his father, a clarinetist with the OSM from 1952 to 1998. "Playing solo and with chamber music groups gives me more opportunities to express myself. Teaching does that too. I'm able to accomplish much more. It makes me feel like I'm more complete (as a performer)."

The musician, who has not ruled out one day doing it on a full time basis, says conducting calls on an entire new set of skills.

"You don't have an instrument to express yourself. (A conductor) is like a painter who all of a sudden has a variety of colours at his disposal. He must decide the dosage each section will bring to the piece," he said. "As a musician you must listen to those around you to develop a sense of being one. As a conductor, you're counted on to be the uniter."

Co-founder with the late Bruce Bower of the ensemble *Les Vents de Montréal*, he also founded one of Canada's rare clarinet choirs, the *Choeur de clarinettes de l'Université de Montréal*.

His favourite composers are Bach, Brahms, Mendelssohn and Stravinsky.

Bill was good, but just not as dead on as either Jane Wheeler as Justine, or Michel Perron as Leon.

Wheeler's performance at first smacks of overacting, but as the play goes on, and the audience starts understanding who Justine really is (long before either Bill or Leon clue in), the overacting is dead on.

Perron, who starred in last year's Townships Stage production of Norm Foster's *The Foursome*, was again dead on as Leon.

Sunil Mahtani's direction is light-handed enough to not be obvious, while the action runs so smoothly that the fact that the direction is there can't be denied. The characters are developed and the timing works well. As well, the staging for the play always works. The

set design is very developed — a full apartment appears on stage at *The Piggery*, which usually has much sparser sets. The best touch, though, is the half-wall in the kitchen for the audience's benefit, which shows the hallway approach to the front door.

Many of the scenes couldn't work without that touch.

The props are also an important part of the staging, and the piles of papers and magazines were perfect for Bill's statistician, without being too distracting.

The production is great, overall, but not for those who don't appreciate a good laugh at sexual innuendo and adult situations. Mahtani said that he planned to shake up *The Piggery* this summer, and so far, with two plays in with one more to come, he's on the right track. Has *The Pig's* stage ever heard so many jokes about oral sex? Probably, but probably not during a performance.

Banjo Dan & The Mid-Nite Plowboys will be making their sixth visit to the Haskell Opera House in Stanstead tonight (Aug. 5).

The group of talented bluegrass musicians started performing for the sheer love of the music. Over the past 33 years, they have created a following throughout the United States, Europe and Canada.

"We try to add a lot of variety to our program — old fashioned bluegrass, standards that are familiar to people, new tunes that we have composed ourselves and some gospel music," explained Dan Lindner, spokesman for the band. "Our music is not the super sophisticated slick type but more the down-home and harmony type that comes from the heart with a purely acoustic sound — banjo, guitar, fiddle and contrabass."

Lindner said the band tries to tailor performances according to the audiences, having expanded from traditional bluegrass, which is popular in the North Eastern area, to a sound that originates from old-time bluegrass but has a hint of Cajun/Jazz, which is popular in other areas. "People often leave our concerts feeling a little surprised that they have discovered a new appreciation for such an old style of music," Lindner said.

Since their last visit to the Haskell Opera House, they have added a new fiddler, French-Canadian Freeman Corey. His expertise and musical repertoire contribute a new dynamic to the group. Corey's father was also a fiddler.

The group has also created original material by taking 'good songs' and reinventing them in the bluegrass style, with a unique blend of instruments and vocals in both trio and quartet styles. Often the tales mentioned in their ballads are factual and very regional in nature.

The band's main goal is to keep people entertained and to provide living proof that something 'very old' can actually fit in with the sounds of today. Lindner feels this down-home kind of entertainment has once again risen in popularity, especially since the production of movies such as *O Brother, Where Art Thou* and *Cold Mountain*.

Banjo Dan & the Mid-Nite Plowboys play the Haskell Opera House at 8:30p.m. Aug. 5. Tickets are \$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors, and \$10 for children under 12. For more information or to reserve tickets, call 819-876-2020.

Bedouin Soundclash on the rise

A Zellers commercial plays on the television, the single 'When the Night Feels My Song' is playing in the background. It is Bedouin Soundclash you hear, a clever Canadian trio of young men from Vancouver, Toronto and Kingston, Ont.

Jay Malinowski is on the right, playing guitar and singing, Eon Sinclair is producing bass grooves from the left and Pat Pengelly is drumming up a storm at the back centre of the stage. Playing their own hybrid of music made possible by reggae, rock and punk bands of the past, they are captivating the hearts of young women with their pleasing appearance and intriguing the varied crowd at the Vans Warped Tour stop in Montreal with their reggae fusion.

On July 29 they played a mix of songs from Root Fire and presented vibrant and catchy music from the recent *Sounding a Mosaic*, released in spring 2004 on Montreal's own Stomp Records. It was re-released with great critical ac-

claim this year on Side One Dummy Records in the United States.

After their 30-minute showcase Malinowski takes time to sit down at a blue picnic table away from the action at the Hippodrome in Montreal to discuss their musical past.

"One day we just started talking about music, we came from different backgrounds but we met at reggae," Malinowski continued to detail seeing Sinclair playing bass and his own guitar playing. They started to jam, made a demo, attracted the attention of Pengelly and decided to add him to the mix.

"We realised within three weeks we had made a band without any intention of doing it."

Rapidly the band has gone from meeting in their first year at university, to appearances on radio stations in Los Angeles and airplay on BBC Radio 1 in the United Kingdom. Plans to continue touring, promoting the record are foremost in the minds of the members with a return to the US, UK and plans for a cross Canada tour in the fall. The next

chance to see the band perform live will be in October.

Malinowski said the album title points to being part of the greater whole of the multicultural nature of Canada. He did the album cover art, 'Framing the Colonials; Mind the Gap Please'.

"I wanted to show the disparity and the gaps between communities within the city where there gaps are a lot of people co-existing who don't even communicate between each other so it's kind of disjointed," noted Malinowski. "But we're lashed together by this sense

of ideology that this country has that will live in harmony even though that harmony may or may not exist depending on where you go."

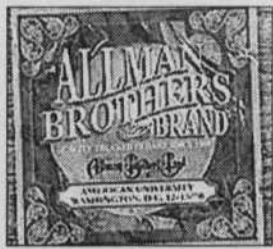

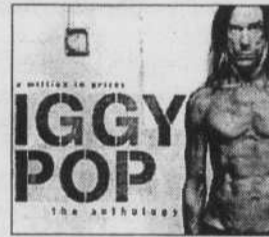

Mofina out with a new series that turns blood cold

Rick Mofina is a self-described "ordinary guy," a government employee who rides the bus to work each day. As such, he may be the last person you'd associate with Stephen King.

But, in fact, the Ottawa crime writer has a real connection to the King of Macabre. The literary agent who pulled King from the ranks of the unknown also inspired Mofina after reading a partial manuscript of his first novel in the mid-'90s.

Mofina, who has just published his sixth novel (*The Dying Hour*, Pinnacle, \$9.99), is sitting in a Toronto bar, sipping ginger ale through a straw and ruminating about how that connection affected his career — a career that has earned him star status, at least in Canadian terms.

Bill Thompson was the magic thread.

Thompson, who discovered King in the backwoods of Maine almost two decades ago and is mentioned in *The Shining*, also pronounced on Mofina's novel when it landed, uninvited, on his desk.

"A friend of a friend offered to take my manuscript to New York," Mofina explains. "I was halfway through the book and stricken with self doubt, so I thought: 'Why not?'"

The 48-year-old author, who is now considered one of Canadian mystery's brightest new stars, was stunned when word came back.

"You're on the right track," Thompson wrote. "Your pacing is correct. Your language is correct. The tone and structure is correct. Everything is fine. Good luck."

At the time, Mofina was working as a police reporter at the *Calgary Herald*. He wasn't even sure he had it in him to finish the novel. "His comments just filled me with enthusiasm."

Thompson suggested Mofina consider a "wider market" and relocate the story from Toronto and the Thousand

Islands.

"I looked at the book," Mofina says, "and thought, 'what the heck, I'll reset it in San Francisco.' I finished the novel, showed it to my wife and trusted friends, and started shopping for an agent."

He sent 100 letters to 100 agents. One from New York took the bait. "She called and said, 'Send me something.' I did. She said, 'Send me more.' I did. Then she said, 'I think I can place it.' She did."

That's how, in 1998, *If Angels Fall* landed in North American bookstores, garnering instant kudos.

Now in its second printing, the book is one in a five-part series that has accumulated a print total of more than 500,000 copies. (In Canada, 5,000 copies ranks a book a bestseller.)

It has not been an easy ride for Mofina, though. Despite raves for his Tom Reed/Walt Sydowski series, which includes *Cold Fear*, *Blood of Others*, *No Way Back* and *Be Mine*, he, like most Canadian authors, remained among the ranks of starving literary artists. His day job as a parliamentary reporter paid the bills.

But despite his reputation as one of the best journalists in the business, Mofina's world fell apart in June two years ago.

On the very day he was named Canada's best crime writer and given an Arthur Ellis award for his mantlepiece (for *Blood of Others*), his job as a reporter vanished.

"It's a day I won't forget," Mofina says. "It was surreal, like living in one of my own novels, with all its twists and turns."

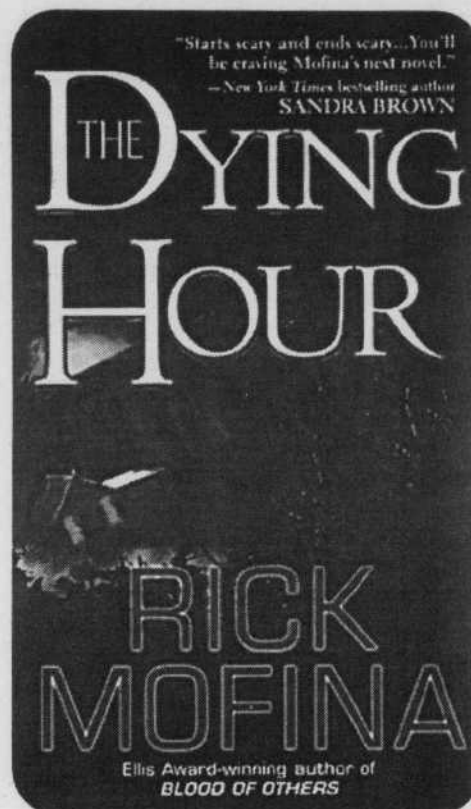
He only hinted at his pain at the awards banquet.

"Of all nights, I really needed this award tonight," he told the audience.

"Don't call it a firing, that means wrong-doing," says Mofina. "I was laid off."

It knocked the writer's equilibrium

for six. "But I've had it back for more than a year now," he says, pointing to his newly minted series-opener starring a young Seattle reporter. He even found another day job as a communications adviser with the federal government.

With the Reed-Sydowski series on ice ("I do have an idea if they want to bring it back"), Pinnacle Books is pinning its hopes for the new Pacific-Northwest series on Mofina's unbridled success.

Early indications suggest it's a safe bet. Apart from New York Times bestselling author Sandra Brown putting her stamp of approval on *The Dying Hour*, other A-list authors like Dean Koontz, James Patterson and Michael Connelly, have already given Mofina their blessing. The book is ranked seventh on the Quill & Quire bestseller list for new releases.

The Dying Hour, which stars Jason Wade, an intern with the *Seattle Mirror*, is unquestionably one of the best

mysteries you'll read this summer. Not only is it a compilation of actual crimes, including a ritualistic slaying, taken from Mofina's days as a police reporter, but it's terrifyingly real — not to mention laden with cliff-hangers.

The story centres on Seattle college student Karen Harding who, after a fight with her boyfriend, drives out into a storm to visit her sister in Vancouver. She never makes it. Her car, abandoned on a lonely stretch of highway, raises suspicion and draws Jason Wade into the story.

Your blood will run cold as Wade, fighting for bylines and a full-time job at the paper, uncovers connections to a less-than-religious minister known to patrol lonely highways in his RV — to "help" stranded motorists.

What makes Wade so endearing to Mofina, he says, is that he makes mistakes, like any rookie.

"It's all totally real. He's an underdog. He's got problems (alcoholic father and a girlfriend who abandoned him). He's competing for a job and knows if he fails, his career could be working in the brewery with his old man."

Mofina seems confident *The Dying Hour* will succeed and, like most of his first series, fall into a much-welcomed reprint category. He is already close to finishing a first draft of Wade's next case, tentatively called *Every Fear*.

His deadline is Labour Day, but he's ahead of the game. When he's not, he admits, he gets grumpy, a fact to which his wife and two children will attest. But behind or ahead, Mofina says his mood melts when readers' responses arrive on his desk.

"I have readers all over — in Iceland, Norway. The South African National Library just sent me the Braille edition of *Cold Fear* that they had produced. It's a real honour."

"It's mind-blowing for me, really. I'm just a regular guy who rides the bus to work, who has this other compulsion. No, just a minute, make that affliction."

Simpson dons 'Daisy Dukes'

Once again, they're having to smuggle Jessica Simpson in and out of this posh New York hotel. That's because at the start of the weekend, word somehow leaked out she would be here to give interviews about her upcoming new comedy, *The Dukes of Hazzard*, in which she portrays the very sexy Daisy Duke.

That led to a madhouse situation on the first day with hundreds of screaming fans plus an excess of paparazzi photographers cramming the lobby and spilling onto Park Avenue sidewalks.

The result: tightened security and muted discussions between Warner Brothers publicists and hotel staff about how to deal with the situation.

Still, despite the fact it was something of a cloak-and-dagger operation to spirit her into the building, there's a surprising lack of tension in this cheerful Baptist preacher's daughter turned pop sensation.

Her arrival leaves a couple of immediate impressions.

The first is she's in danger of spilling out of that body-clutching, low-cut flowered dress she's chosen to wear today. The second is her forthrightness about potentially inflammatory subjects such as the state of her marriage and the scandal her sexy image is causing within the Christian right.

She does mangle her syntax when she first enters and is asked why she chose to make her feature film debut as the bottom-wiggling Daisy Duke, proud wearer of the shortest shorts in the south, in this big-screen remake of a popular TV series.

"I wanted to do an ensemble thing. I didn't want the pressure of carrying a movie. I did not want it. I think Daisy's strong enough and she was a great first role for me."

Still does she think she could carry a future movie herself? "I really do hope so," says Simpson who, at 25, is serious about pursuing a film career. "I mean - I believe in myself. I think I can."

She speaks quickly and articulately - bimbo rumours aside, *Vanity Fair* magazine reports she has an IQ of 160 - and punctuates many sentences with that whinnying laugh which is a Jessica hallmark. She also leaves no doubt she thinks she will weather the tabloid frenzy which continues to swirl around her.

It's been 11 years since Jessica, then 14, recorded her first album, a collection of Christian music, and became a fixture on the faith-based circuit. It's been six years since her quest for a larger audience was dramatically fulfilled with the release of her first major-label album, the platinum-selling *Sweet Kisses*.

"I trust that every step I take is under God's control," she said at the time. "I knew that I would get a bigger audience by doing the secular, and I have more of an opportunity to be a positive role model."

Since then, her career has skyrocketed and one of the key factors in her rise was her excursion into reality TV when she and her husband, 98 Degrees singer Nick Lachey, allowed MTV to chronicle the ups and downs of their marriage on the enormously popular series, *Newlyweds: Nick And Jessica*.

But this exposure also triggered an obsessive interest in her private life, and for months Simpson has been fielding tabloid rumours about a now shaky marriage, while her *Hazzard* co-star, Johnny Knoxville, has been busy denying reports he and Simpson had an affair during shooting.

Simpson says her way of dealing with this kind of publicity is quite straightforward.

"You know, I don't read it. I know a lot of people will read it. I don't think a lot of people believe it even when they do read it."

She seems to think many of these reports are motivated by jealousy.

"Unfortunately, people want to see people fail," she says.

"And," she adds firmly, "my marriage is rock solid."

Moreover, such intense public

scrutiny hasn't come as a complete shock. "I was pretty prepared. I was prepared at a young age. I was a preacher's daughter. I lived in a glass fishbowl and I had to deal with gossip and rumours and mean girls at a very young age. So I was prepared."

The *Dukes of Hazzard*, which opens Aug. 5, chronicles the shenanigans of those fun-loving, good ol' boy cousins, Bo and Luke Duke (Seann William Scott and Johnny Knoxville) as they tear up the countryside in their notorious orange Dodge Charger, delivering the moonshine concocted in the still of Uncle Jesse (Willie Nelson) and infuriating the authorities, especially mean and corrupt commissioner Boss Hogg (Burt Reynolds).

Simpson beat out Britney Spears for the role of the boys fun-loving cousin, Daisy Duke.

When Catherine Bach played Daisy in the original TV series, her microscopic shorts became a fixture on the

show and the most important component of her character. Director Jay Chandrasekhar recalls those shorts drove him "bananas" when he was a kid, and he wanted them to have some of the same effect on today's audiences.

In the course of the movie, Simpson wears 23 pairs of "Daisy Dukes" - none of which cover more than 25 centimetres from the waistband to the top of the thigh. Chandrasekhar jokes he and Simpson had some earnest negotiations about the length of the shorts and he kept demanding they get shorter and shorter.

Simpson says it was "not really" a big deal.

"I just didn't want butt cheeks hanging out," she grins. "That was very important to me, so they had to be a little bit lower-waisted. You know - you gotta meet in the middle. It's like marriage - you've got to compromise."

Toby Keith's latest album possibly best ever

If, during his career, some of Toby Keith's songs ruffled a few feathers in the country music industry, it didn't stop him from being one of the most liked country stars of today.

If you think about it, there's nothing shocking at all about his music, if you do not take life too seriously. It is Keith's redneck side taking over.

The talent and in-your-face attitude of the two-time Entertainer of The Year manages to capture people's attention. Some people are shocked by his sometimes redneck behaviour while others take it as being part of the singer/songwriter's personality.

For the major part, fans know that Keith is a sensitive artist who has been investing a lot of work and genuine emotion in all his recordings. Most of all, he is always true to his roots and honest, which reflects big time in his music.

His brand new release Honkytonk University finds him in perfect vocal condition and offers a great mix of humour, love ballads and uptempo numbers. I think it's one of his best albums, ever.

The tall Okie, as always, wrote or co-wrote every song on the new album. The collection is honest, convincing and heartfelt work and as usual it offers some of Keith's trademark humour.

The tall singer has proved a long time ago his huge talent as a songwriter. He can tell a story with a clever twist, a touch of humour or sophistication combined with piercing insight.

The leadoff single 'Honkytonk U' is an autobiographical look at Keith's musical beginning, a true story set to southern rock. His famous attitude shines through on the current single 'As Good As I Once Was'. Even if years have taken their toll, he still has a good dose of southern male pride.

Later, Keith's sarcastic wit makes a welcome appearance on the swing flavoured 'You Ain't Leavin' (Thank God Are Ya)'. There's a few great ballads such as 'You Caught Me At A Bad Time', and 'Your Smile' and both make a very strong and poignant impression. Keith can be very tender and make us forget that he can also be very shocking.

One of the highlight on this album is Keith's duet with veteran Merle Haggard on the die-hard country song 'She Ain't Hooked On Me No More'. The pairing of the two is even more effective than his pairing with legend Willie Nelson on 'Beer For My Horses'.

Their voices blend so well that it is

sometimes hard to tell who's singing.

If you start comparing the two artists they have so many similarities that it is breathtaking. They're two rowdy patriots, rednecks, who can sing about heartbreaks like crazy and they are both accomplished songwriters.

Keith now claims in almost every show that he is the spokesperson for the rednecks of America. I must admit that he is sometimes blunt, but extremely honest.

If the singer has something on his mind he will say it or he'll find a way to sing it. Sometimes he brings us back to the rebel days of country music by stepping outside the lines. 'Just The Guy To Do It' is a catchy tune about a guy who flirts with a redhead right in front of his girlfriend, it is trademark Keith. 'Big Blue Note' turns out to be a very witty 'Dear John' letter while 'Where You Gonna Go' is a very classic and sad country number set to Paul Franklin's beautiful work on steel guitar.

Keith is the Merle Haggard and Waylon Jennings of modern times. He stands for what he believes in and he is a firm believer in his country, in God, and in love. He's not ashamed to write and sing about it either. It is like he knows exactly what emotional button to push to get fans to react.

This album offers a little less attitude and a lot more emotions almost like his early work. I strongly recommend this new album - it just grows on you. The more you listen the more you want to hear it.

Brandt, Road Hammers lead CCMA nominees

Paul Brandt and **Jason McCoy's The Road Hammers** will take centre stage at next month's Canadian Country Music Association Awards, each receiving six nominations Wednesday.

Brandt, who is up Male Artist of the Year, will host the 29th annual ceremony in Calgary on Sept. 12. The Calgary native is also up for best single, song, album and video, as well as the fan choice award in which he will face off against **George Canyon**, **Terri Clark**, **Carolyn Dawn Johnson** and **McCoy**.

The Road Hammers, meanwhile, are up for best group of the year, as well as best video, single, song, album and video after releasing their debut self-ti-

tled album.

Canyon, who finished second in *Nashville Star*, picked up five nominations, including song of the year for *My Name*. **Johnson of Westlock, Alta.**, received four nominations, as did the **Corb Lund Band** and **The Poverty Plainsmen**.

Lisa Brokop, **Clark** and **Aaron Pritchett** also recorded three nominations each.

Gord Bamford, the 29-year-old singing sensation from **Lacombe, Alta.**, is a first-time nominee, picking up nods for rising star and Independent Male Artist of the Year following hit singles such as *'Heroes'*, *'My Heart's A Genius'* and *'All About Her.'*

"It's very exciting," said Australian-born **Bamford**. "It's also quite a relief after all the hard work and money that goes into trying to get where you want to get to."

Organizers of this year's awards ceremony said the quality of nominees underscores the reality that Canada is the second largest provider of country music stars to the world's ever-burgeoning country music industry.

"It shows that we have a star system built in Canada," said co-chairman **Phil Kallsen**. "We can develop stars here that may or may not export to the world. So over the years, with the system in place, the Canadian Country Music Association, we can actually develop home-

grown stars who can make a nice living without ever having to leave Canada."

This year's awards show is just one component of *Country Music Week*, an annual celebration which attracts approximately 2,500 delegates from all over North America. The four-day festivities will also include televised live performances, a wide variety of musical showcases and seminars and industry-centred gatherings.

The public will also have several opportunities to mingle with their favourite country music stars at events scheduled throughout Calgary.
