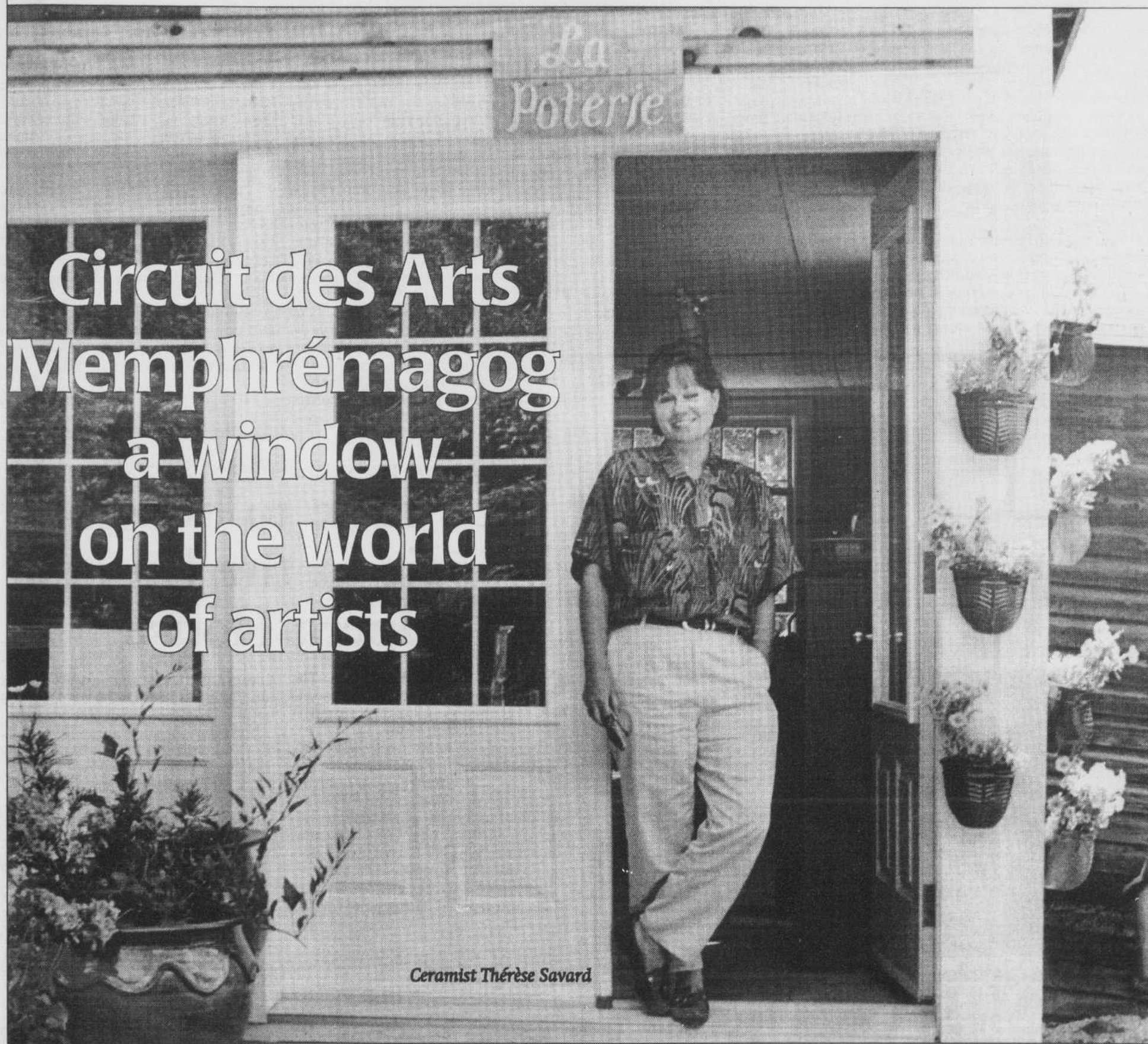

# Bread and Puppet presents annual festival

Vermont's Bread and Puppet Theater will present its annual two-day outdoor festival, Our Domestic Resurrection Circus, on Saturday and Sunday, Aug. 8 and 9 at Bread and Puppet Theater on Route 122 in Glover, Vermont. The event begins at noon. Admission is free, donations are welcome.

The Domestic Resurrection Circus will feature Bread and Puppet's characteristic combination of serious and light-hearted theater, with outdoor puppet and mask shows as well as exhibits, music, pets, speakers, guest performers, and free sourdough rye bread. The Bread and Puppet Museum will be open all day with posters, banners, and Cheap Art for sale.

The Domestic Resurrection Circus will begin with performances of simultaneous small sideshows from noon to 2:30 p.m.

In addition to a variety of performances and exhibits based on plays and poetry by Brecht, these shows will in-

clude a cantastoria based on Brecht poetry set to Bach Chorale, a cantata based on the music of Hildegard von Bingen in the newly-planted Hildegard Garden, and a 25th anniversary revival of "The Mountain Man from Chile" which tells the story of Victor Jara.

The sideshow period will also feature a new show by Paul Zaloom and guest performances by Dragon Dance Theater, artists from Very Special Arts, and poetry readings by Grace Paley, Burt Porter, Galway Kinnell, Peter Dufault and others.

At 3 p.m. the Puppet Circus will take place in Bread and Puppet's giant outdoor amphitheater. The Circus combines puppet circus tricks with political satires of the year's events and is performed to the music of a live 25-piece brass band playing a variety of traditional circus tunes, New Orleans jazz, and songs by Brecht.

It will feature a circus ring transformed into a stormy sea, a complete explanation of Vermont's Act 60, an

intergenerational stilted act, and the ever-popular heartstopping tigers.

At 5 p.m., "The New York City Community Gardens Passion Play" will combine Sacred Harp singing, brass band music, and giant puppets in a traveling performance about New York City's endangered community gardens and the gardeners' struggle against Mayor Giuliani's plans to privatize public lands.

At the same time, Brecht's and Kurt Weill's "Threepenny Opera," adapted by Bert Franke as "The Penny Opera," will be performed with the help of painted cardboard in the Pine Forest.

At 6 p.m. there will again be an open rehearsal for anybody who wants to be part of the 7:30 p.m. pageant. "This year," Peter Schumann says, "the gates of hell will open and release all evil necessary for a good show; and again the condemned will be saved as miraculously as ever."

Our Domestic Resurrection Circus comes to a close at 9 p.m. with an evening program of several performances, including "The Proletarians," a soap opera with giant puppets, and a special guest performance of "Toy Theatre Brecht" by New York City's Great

Small Works.

Out of concern about traffic congestion, Bread and Puppet asks that circusgoers refrain from parking or vending along Route 122 and Route 16. Neighboring landowners both above and below Bread and Puppet will open their fields for parking and camping on this weekend.

Our Domestic Resurrection Circus is created with the volunteer help of its many participants and much local community support. Although admission to the Circus is free, the event depends upon donations from the audience and the sale of posters, banners, books, and tapes.

The Circus is a family event, and drugs and alcohol jeopardize its continuation. Bread and Puppet Theater continues its policy of no drugs or alcohol at the Circus. Please leave your dogs at home, they will not be admitted to the Circus grounds.

Volunteers are still needed for important non-performing tasks on the Circus weekend. For more info or to volunteer, call Laura Helton at (802) 525-3031.

# Bolton Centre craftsman works with wood, natural growths on trees

## The all-natural world of Whitehead

Lorne Whitehead is a unique individual. His view of society, like his artistry with wood, has a natural beauty people often miss.

His furniture is like nothing else made. He uses natural growths on trees and fits them into the lines of each piece he creates: All natural curves.

To some, such materials are grotesque, but when matched with the eye of an artist and worked with the hand of a craftsman, these pieces become one-of-a-kind objects of beauty. They are also sturdy and functional.

"I find specific pieces (of trees) that I want to do certain things with, which is what I really like to do - making unique pieces," said the Bolton Centre craftsman. "You could never do it on a large scale, but six or a dozen pieces."

Art cannot be mass-produced, but there is also a practical side to limiting production: the set-up time would be prohibitive.

Normally the economics of scale would benefit large-scale production, but these pieces have to be matched and every one is different. It's not like setting up a fence on a saw and sliding the wood through.

He takes wood that would otherwise be discarded and combines the bulges and curves as only an artist can to produce esthetically pleasing lines with a style all his own.

Whitehead has used the same principles to remodel his home. Using logs and mortar, he created a magical atmosphere in which the elves, hobbits and wizards of a Tolkien novel would feel quite at home.

Lorne's individuality is important to him.

"I find that with my work I can make my own choices," he said.

"You have to be careful with newspapers," he added. "You can sound like a non-conformist completely and I don't really look at myself that way."

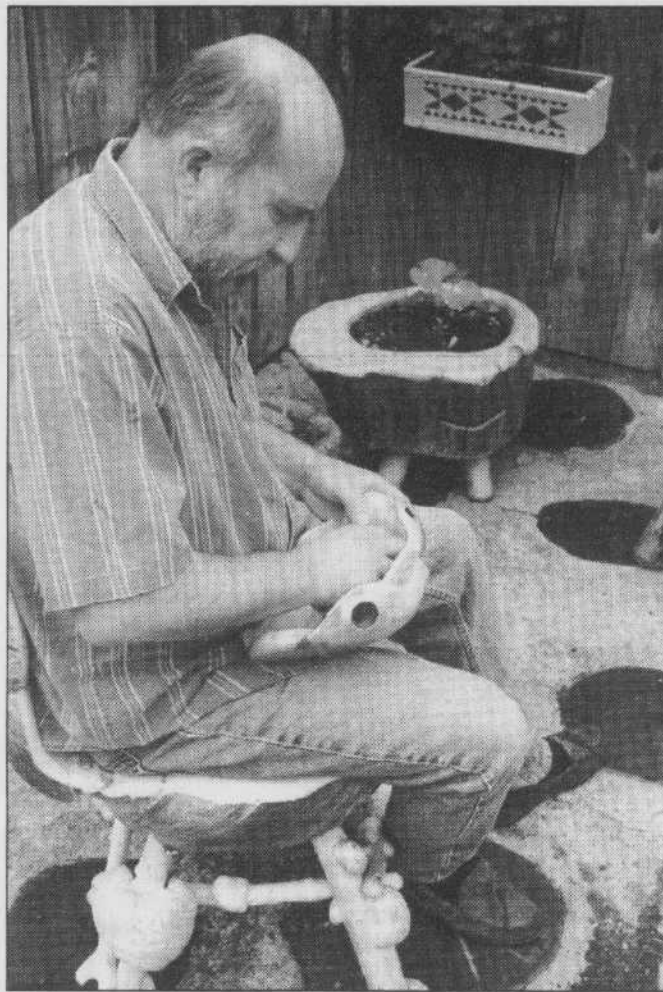
Yet Whitehead looks at society with the clarity of someone who is not caught up in the daily scramble of that society.

"I feel that we are at the end of a period of history and the beginning of a new period of history," he said. "There's a lot of old things that have been lost, that we need to find again. Everything is here, but we're misusing it."

Like many people, Whitehead is concerned with the natural world and what man is doing to it. His search for suitable wood takes him around the countryside and he has learned to appreciate the lakes and forests and what they have to offer.

"The land, I feel, is a garden and needs to be looked upon, each species, for the truth and understanding of it. With this kind of knowledge we can live rich and wholesome, sharing lives," he said.

He was part of the recent Tour des Arts, but says he was disappointed there wasn't a greater communication with other

artists and a sharing in the arts community.

"Sell, sell, sell," is what it was all about, he said.

He understands he won't get rich as an artist but is motivated by the creative process and the idea of marrying beauty with function.

He is also concerned about people. "People who don't have the money to move within the system get isolated in the community," he said.

His own artistic isolation seems to have generated a sympathy for others who are isolated in a variety of ways. "We've lost the will to work together and we've got to get it back," he said.

The mechanical, straight lines of modern furniture he describes as "masculine" don't hold much attraction for him.

He said the curves of nature are more "feminine" and he prefers to work with these, yet the combination of these elements, like the oriental yin & yang, is important to him.

He said he would like to teach others how to build as he does - not in his own style, but each finding themselves in their art.

"If there's people who have a project but are having a hard time, and are looking for simple, inexpensive solutions, but are still quality-oriented, I can help those people."

More than 10,000 people took part in the Circuit des Arts Memphremagog last year, enjoying the tour of studios, galleries and other showplaces around the MRC.

What makes this tour, now in its fifth year and continuing through Aug. 2, so attractive? I stopped at the final destination on the tour, #55 in Georgeville, to find out.

The fresh warm rays of the early afternoon sun spilled out into the yard outside of the pottery and ceramics studio of Thérèse Savard, who is also the publicist for the event.

Just outside the driveway of the intimate studio is the familiar yellow hexagon-shaped sign that marks the house as a participant in the tour.

Inside the artist's sunny studio where the shelves are adorned with a wide variety of ceramics and pottery, Savard sat comfortably behind her potter's wheel, talking about how the Circuit began.

"From the beginning we always had about the same number of artists participating in the tour, but we did not always have the same number of visitors, because we were just starting," said Savard. "Now the artists have become much more involved in the organization of the tour. For the last three years, the artists alone have taken care of the publicity, funding and organization."

"Now the Circuit is entering its fifth year, so we have earned quite a bit of credibility with the local media and we have found that we are getting a lot of attention."

Each of the close to 100 artists who are exhibiting on the tour has submitted a proper CV and was chosen to participate.

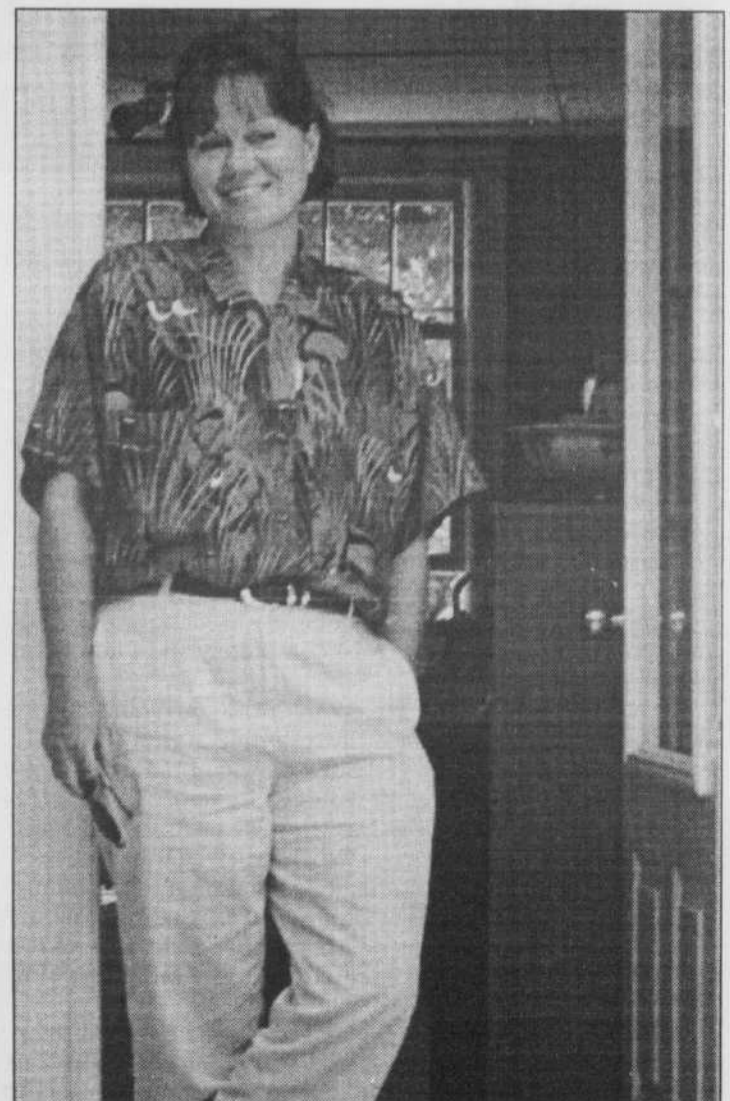
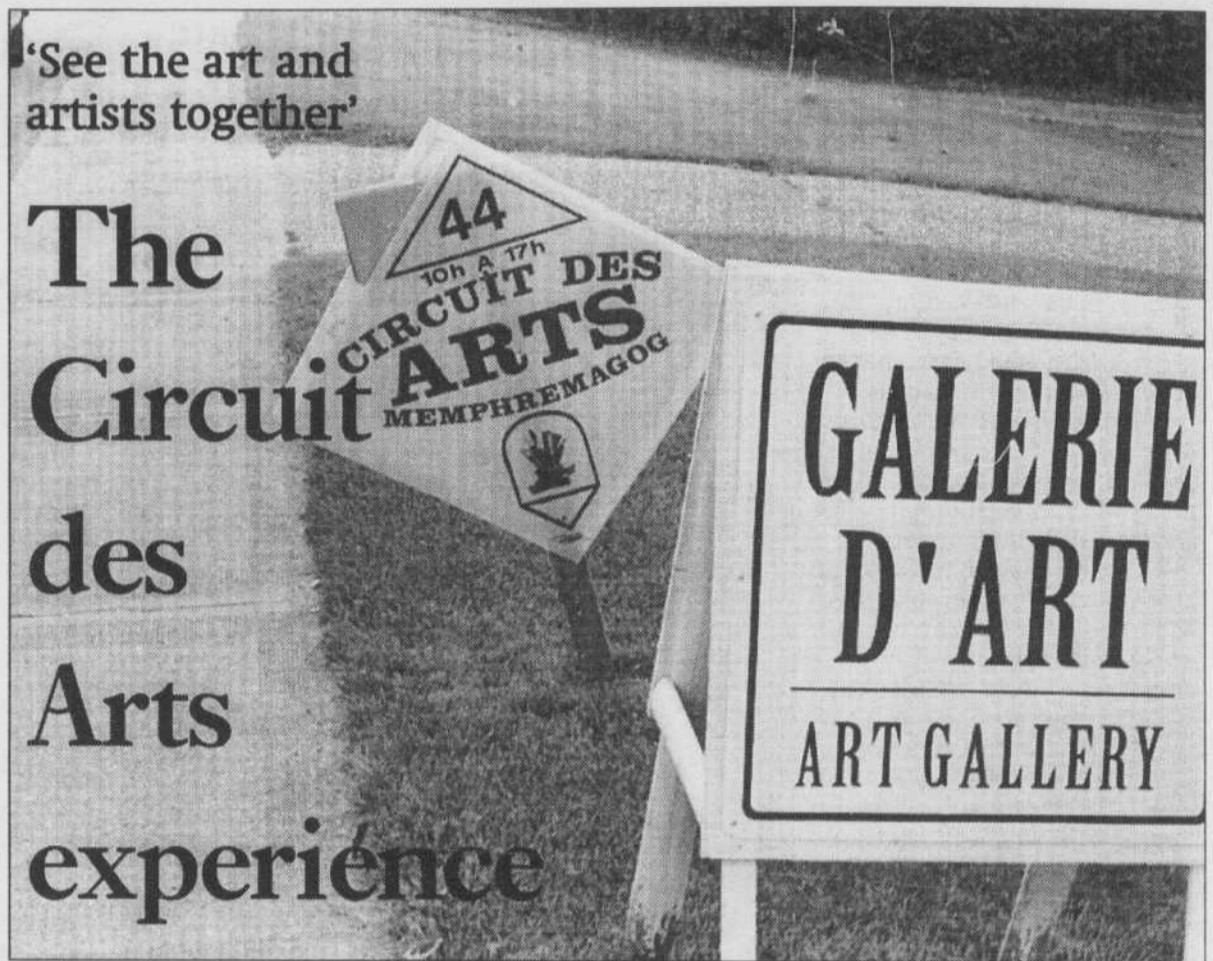
"We first ask that the artist who wishes to participate be a resident of the MRC Memphremagog and we hope that they are living here year-round or have a summer house here at least," said Savard.

"After that the art is judged by a committee of 15 and after we study the artist's dossier we judge on professionalism and quality work and, of course, the artist must be available to speak with the people participating in the Circuit des Arts."

Watercolorist Luigi Tiengo has been on the Circuit des Arts Memphrémagog before, but this year is special. The Italian painter is exhibiting his work at the new studio he built in his home.

"This is first time I have real studio," he said with enthusiasm. "I decided one year ago I needed a studio, and even if I'm old and decrepit I wanted to have a studio!"

The 72-year-old Tiengo is full of spark as he speaks of his new space.

"I made it to be a nice place for me to paint, with the window on the north, for the northern light, and I designed the furniture myself since I am also a furniture designer," he said. "There's a showcase where I hang six or seven paintings and inside the showcase there are some panels that I take out so when I have a show I assemble it around the room and hang more paintings."

Tiengo is exhibiting with his wife, painter Diethild Schott Tiengo, at the studio at 2395 Benoit in Ste-Catherine-de-Hatley - #37 on the Circuit des Arts, which ends on Sunday.

The first show he ever organized by himself was the opening of his studio at the end of June, just one of many highlights in a career that has spanned 25 years and has taken him from his birthplace of Adria, Italy, to the tiny town of Ste-Catherine-de-Hatley.

Tiengo sent out 4,000 flyers to homes and businesses in the Memphrémagog MRC for the weekend opening.

"I had two nightmares: The first one

is that nobody would come and the second one is that everybody would come," said Tiengo with a laugh.

Throughout the opening, many of those 4,000 came, including a well-known local politician who purchased a painting the minute he arrived.

"He said, 'I'm going to buy a painting.' I said, 'You're kidding.' He said, 'I know which one I want.' And he showed me my invitation. 'That one.' He bought the painting that I put on the invitation," Tiengo recalled.

Tiengo divides his time between homes in Ste-Catherine-de-Hatley and Montreal's Town of Mount Royal, but he is clear as to where he prefers to paint.

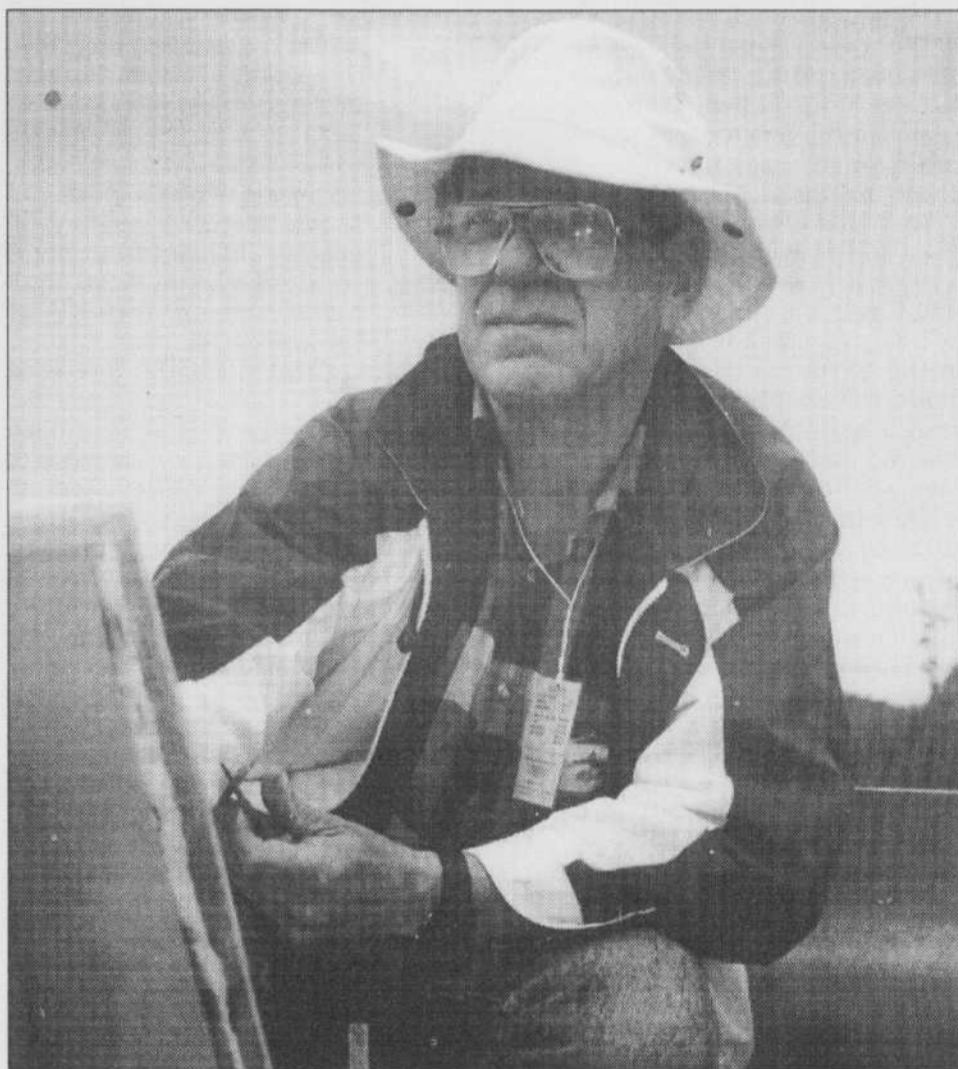
"Around Magog and around Katevale, and one of my favorite lakes is Little Magog because it isn't manicured; it's natural. And another favorite is Cherry River because there aren't any cottages; it's as natural as it can be."

The septuagenarian paints every day and is proud when he says, "I'm still in shape."

"I am keeping busy every day. I get a lot of exercise. I love bicycling. It's one of my favorite things, bicycling. The winter I do cross-country and there's where I look for subjects - when I go skiing, when I go cycling, when I go walking. I'm always on the look-out for subjects to paint."

He says it's never too late to enjoy life.

"Let me tell you I enjoy life sometimes more than when I was much younger. I had too many complexes when I was younger. It's never too late to enjoy life as long as God gives you health."

"It is very important to us that the artist meet the people who are enjoying the art, that interaction is what the Circuit is all about."

This year, the tour features artists from Bolton Centre to Ayer's Cliff and Bowker Lake to Stanstead. Up-and-coming artists, as well as some of the province's most respected veterans, are featured on the tour.

"There are many famous artists working within the structure of the Circuit des Arts. One of them is Marcel Poirier, who is a well-known oil painter who recently did an exhibition in the House of Commons," said Savard. "Marcel Beaucage is exhibiting

with us this year, and he is very renowned for his work in pottery. He is just back from pottery studies in Japan so his work is also very exciting."

Patrons on the tour may take part in a draw to celebrate the event's fifth anniversary. By purchasing a ticket, patrons have a chance to win one of five prizes: Two works of art and three dinners, a total value of \$800. Tickets are sold at every location on the tour at a cost of 99 cents each or six for \$5.

Savard said taking the tour can be a gratifying experience in many ways.

"Our audience for the Circuit are mainly adult art lovers who wish to see the art and artists together in the creative environment," she said.

"It is a wonderful experience when we can all get together and learn and that is what the Circuit des Art is all about!"

Here are my reviews for this week:

**CHRIS LEDOUX: One Road**

**Man (Capitol)**

Long before Garth Brooks praised LeDoux and made country fans eager to discover who he was, LeDoux was already rocking the country music scene.

Now Brooks has become a superstar and LeDoux who has released over 30 albums, including a bunch of early ones on his own American Cowboy Songs label, is still around and doing great.

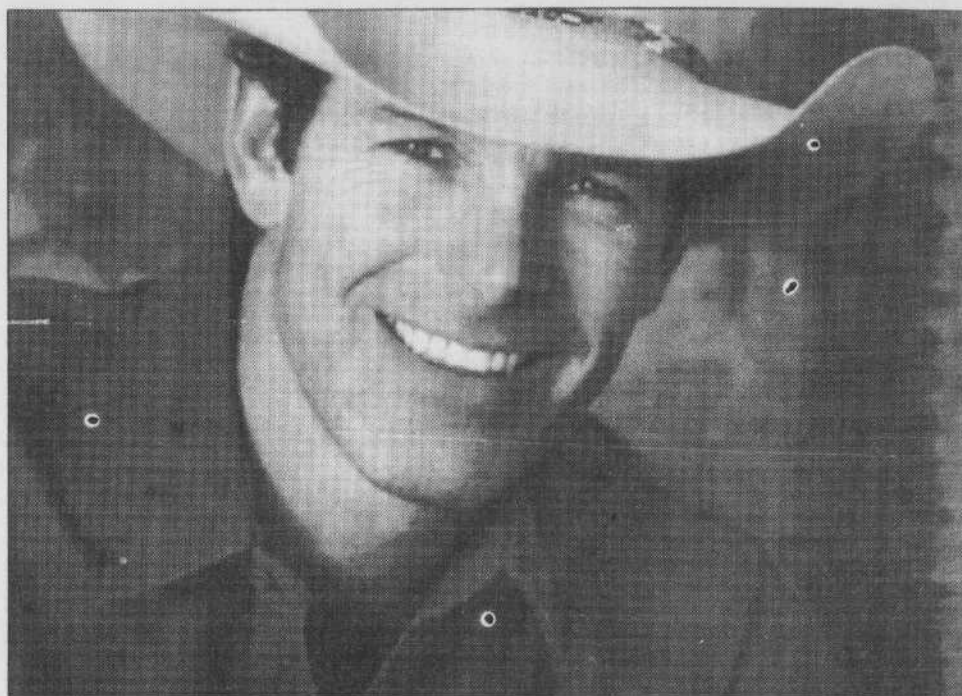
His special blend of country, rock and cowboy music was surely a great influence on Garth Brooks. LeDoux has never reached a big radio audience and never did very well on country music charts (only two Top 40 singles), but he has legions of fans around the world.

LeDoux, a former a world champion bareback bronco rider, began riding in the rodeo when he was only 14. This was the same year he began to write his own music. He has lived everything he writes about and his cowboy hat is not a country music must have, it is the real thing.

The musical influences on his new album, *One Road Man*, are as wide as the huge open spaces in his home state of Wyoming. However, country fans beware. This is not traditional country music.

The song really rocks on the infectious duet "Bang a Drum," where he enlists rocker Jon Bon Jovi to share the microphone.

On the next track, "Caballo Diablo", Charlie Daniels fiddles and sings on this very hot number.

LeDoux has released more than 30 albums, yet remains relatively unknown to radio audiences.

LeDoux then trades verses with his cousin, Billy Bob Shane, on the standard "Ole Slew Foot". Longtime country music fans will recognize Willie Nelson's gut-string guitar on the beautiful "The Borderline."

Borderline could also be used to describe what Chris LeDoux does with this new album. He's a little bit country and a whole lot rock 'n' roll but his fans will love the direction he's taking and those who don't know much about him might enjoy discovering his music.

**COLLIN RAYE, The Walls Came Down (EPIC RECORDS)**

When it comes to Collin Raye one thing is certain. He is considered to be one of country's most dynamic live entertainers, always full of energy and giving everything he's got for the pleasure of his fans.

We all remember hits such as "That's My Story" and "My Kind of Girl". But the fact is, since his debut in 1991, Collin Raye has always tackled lyrics that surpass the typical love ballads or dance numbers.

His music has touched many hearts and the fans have always been happy with his sound. This time around it's a bit different since his new album is more of a personal statement - each song seems to be a snapshot of Raye's life.

For example, the first single he released from his new album, "I Can Still Feel You," was co-written by a former girlfriend, and Raye believes the tune is about the two of them. His fluid tenor wraps around each word, hinting at the

lingering effects of a long-time relationship gone sour.

On the new collection, he writes two of the 13 songs, serves as co-producer and pours his heart into every number included on the album. "The Walls Came Down" is one of Collin Raye's own compositions, and he deserves a lot of credit for writing and recording such a personal tune.

There's also "The Eleventh Commandment", which tackles the gritty reality of domestic violence and child abuse. For Raye, who's voice is very expressive, the more emotive a song the better.

Other songs such as "All My Roads" and "Survivors" refer to the troubles in a modern day relationship, yet each number remains optimistic.

This new album is excellent and it's wonderful to hear Collin Raye sharing the music that is so deeply rooted in his own life. With such a personal approach it seems that the album helps us to know him a little better and this will also please his fans. On the other hand every song can also be good advice for people going through a similar experience.

Music has always been soothing for the soul and this is what you find with Collin Raye's new recording. He is growing both as a singer and a person, and this album will certainly contribute to his success.

## Proceeds fund Club's good works Lions Club to hold ninth annual racing day

Ladies and gentlemen place your bets," will be a very likely phrase in Melbourne on Sunday as the Richmond-Melbourne Lions Club hold their ninth annual harness racing day at the Dustin Jones Farm.

The big money raising event, which features pari-mutuel betting, saw 1600 spectators and \$21,014 wagered last year.

"All of the profits - even the tips, since everyone works as volunteers for this event - go to the good works of the Lions Club. We give money to things like the new playground at the English school, Christmas baskets, and people who need it for glasses or other things. We also gave \$800 during the ice storm," said Jean-Marc Poulin, a Lions Club volunteer who has been working hard organizing the big day.

The Melbourne race day is one in a series of more than 30 races across the province called the Regional Circuit which are all put on for charity. This local race placed high in last year's Regional Circuit statistics.

"We were the third in spectators and third in pari-mutuel betting. We had the second-highest amount given in prizes with \$11,600 going to the winners. We were third in the number of horses registered, and first in the number of races starting with 12 races last year," reported Poulin proudly.

This year there will be 97 horses from all over the province starting in 10 races, with \$9 800 in prize money up for grabs. The special sixth race will be dedicated to the many volunteers who make the event such a success, and will be called the Volunteer's Race. The winning blanket for the sixth race will be presented by longtime volunteer, Leo Vallieres, 75.

The organizers promise harness racing action rain or shine. With two restaurants and two bars on the premises, spectators will have no problem finding refreshment regardless of the weather.

The races will take place on Sunday afternoon, Aug. 2, at the Dustin Jones farm - 954 Galbraith Rd. in Melbourne (Exit 83 off route 55, then follow the signs). Spectators will be charged \$2 at the gate.

Others committed to play include Australian Patrick Rafter, who won the 1997 U.S. Open; Wimbledon semifinalist Tim Henman of Great Britain; and hard-serving Dutchman Richard Krajicek, who won Wimbledon in 1996.

Wimbledon champion Pete Sampras will skip the event to rest up for the U.S. Open later in August, but fellow American Chris Woodruff, who won last year's tournament, will be in Toronto to defend his title. He may have a tough time reaching the finals, however, because he is nursing a knee injury.

The du Maurier Open is part of the Mercedes Super 9 series, which is com-

posed of the championships offering the most prize money and the most points toward world rankings.

The women's du Maurier Open will be held at Montreal's Jarry Park from Monday, Aug. 17 through Sunday, Aug. 23. Czech Jana Novotna, coming off her Wimbledon title, and No. 1 ranked Martina Hingis of Switzerland are scheduled to play. American Monica Seles, the defending champion, has yet to commit.

Tennis Canada's Steve McAllister says the annual championships raise 95 percent of the organization's revenue for training programs.

• CBC Television is already promoting the new season of Hockey Night in Canada, set to start Oct. 10.

The first games of the Saturday doubleheaders will start at 7 p.m., which is a half-hour earlier than previous seasons.

The new start time means CBC's pregame show, hosted by Ron MacLean, will air at 6:30 p.m.

Documentaries track the lives of baboons and orangutans

## Discovery goes ape during Primates week

They look a lot like us, except they're hairier. They act a lot like us, except they can't be housebroken. No, it's not our neighbors to the south, it's apes and monkeys. Discovery Channel kicks off Primarily Primates, the subject of their latest theme week on Sunday, Aug. 2, with two documentaries making their Canadian premieres.

First up is Primarily Primates: Baboon Tales. Glenn Close, who was no friend to animals in Fatal Attraction and 101 Dalmatians, redeems her image among our furry friends by narrating this look at baboons that is based on the work of internationally acclaimed

anthropologist Dr. Shirley C. Strum.

Strum, who has spent 25 years studying the olive baboons of East Africa, is noteworthy for her once-controversial theory that baboon society is a matriarchy.

Like many mammals that live in groups, baboons have a complex social structure based on friendships and rivalries.

The hourlong documentary follows infants from three wild troops during their first year of life. The apes are not entirely wild, of course, as they are accustomed to the members of the Baboon Research Project and the ever-present cameras.

Following Baboon Tales is Primarily Pri-

mates: Orangutans: The High Society. Although orangutans are almost as unattractive as baboons, they are quite dissimilar in other ways.

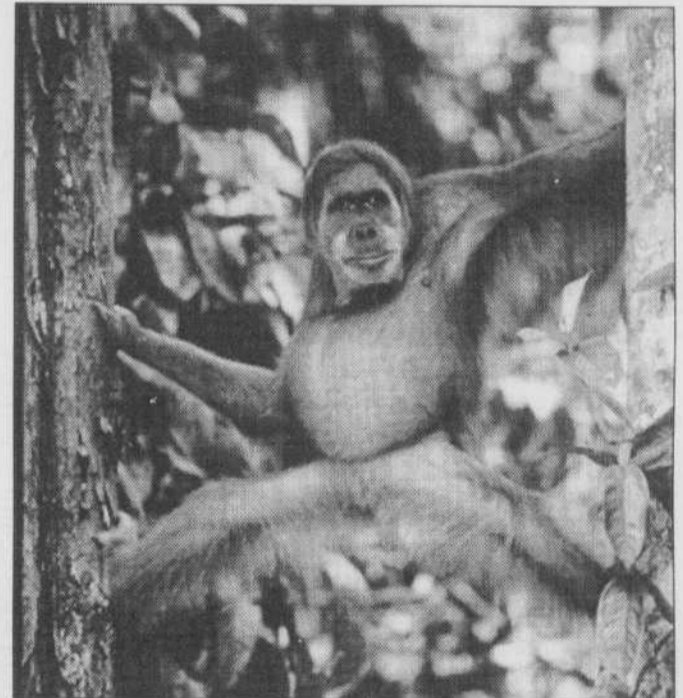
Considered the loners of the ape world, these tree-dwelling animals have a group social structure and hierarchy, but the conditions under which they live force them to spend most of their time alone, foraging for food. As such, their lives are different from those of all other primates.

This documentary follows two orangutan families through their daily lives. A family consists of a mother and her child - the father doesn't stick around any longer than he has to.

The Gunung Leuser National Park in Sumatra is one of the few places where orangutans, who once could be found in much of Asia, still live. It's a harsh environment that is suitable for habitation by only a few animals, with plants remaining barren for months or years at a time.

Orangutans, are threatened by the encroachment of humans. There are now only a few thousand orangutans left in the world.

Both documentaries, while informative, are melancholy. We have not made a comfortable world for our relatives, and it's difficult to watch their struggle to survive.
