Centennial's season shines with stars

*The public is invited
to meet the artists
before and after shows*

In an effort to bring performing artists closer to the public, Centennial Theatre's director of programming is trying something new this season.

Luce Couture is inviting the public to meet artists from various shows prior to and after their performances.

On Saturday, Oct. 14, soprano Suzie Le Blanc and the Ensemble Arion with flautist Claire Guimond present a program filled with the works of Vivaldi.

"To get to know these two soloists, Suzie Le Blanc and Claire Guimond, we are inviting them to give a press conference Friday, Oct. 13, during the Job Fair in the lobby of Centennial Theatre," said Couture. "This will be a good opportunity for people who would like to know how to build a career in music. This will be held in the art gallery."

Guimond has recorded many CDs, including music by de Boismortier and Telemann.

"(And) Suzie Le Blanc specializes in Baroque music," added Couture. "She's had a very interesting career for many years in Europe and is back here in Quebec. It will be good for people to get the opportunity to know her. It is a light program and quite accessible to everyone."

Other shows on the schedule include the festive 'Sweet Follia' performed by the Ensemble Caprice in the theatre's Classical Series; an eclectic range of performances, including Tuyo's 'Rouge De Vinci,' featuring invented instruments,

Rosemary Miller exhibits her meticulous and vibrant fall landscapes in acrylics and watercolours.

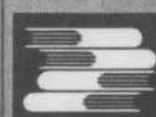

For beignes to breads, Dora's Donuts is treasure

*When I die I want
to go to Dora's*

Traveling down Route 112 from Magog to Eastman sits a small, unassuming bakery.

Les Beignes Dora has been bringing fresh baked goods to locals since 1957. Now in the hands of young bakers Patrick Jacques and his wife, Marie-Claude, Dora's Donuts offers an as-

sortment of baked goods, including pastries, pies, preserves, muffins and, of course, donuts that are a well-kept secret.

For the last 10 years, Patrick and Marie-Claude operated the business with a partner before buying out his share three years ago.

"This is a weekend business," says Patrick, whose shop is open Thursday through Sunday. It is also a seasonal business: during the summer, as weekenders flock to the area, the staff swells to as

many as 10 to handle the demand. Now, with the summer crush ended, the owners are working with one assistant, Giselle Vincent.

Early Thursday morning is not a good time to visit, as the cupboards are nearly bare as the couple is in back preparing the fresh-baked goods that will stock the shelves for the weekend rush.

By noon, however, the bread shelves are lined with an assortment of yeast and non-yeast breads, hot muffins, pies and cookies that have just come out of the oven.

Marie-Claude is a trained pastry chef while Patrick is largely self-taught as a baker. Together, the couple and staff bake 12 types of bread, in-

cluding their own "house recipe," using Patrick's own recipe and their popular 'pain italien' with black olives and olive oil.

They also prepare croissants, French pastries and pies made with their own fillings. Their assortment of muffins, including coconut-nut, carrot, blueberry and banana, are warm and fresh.

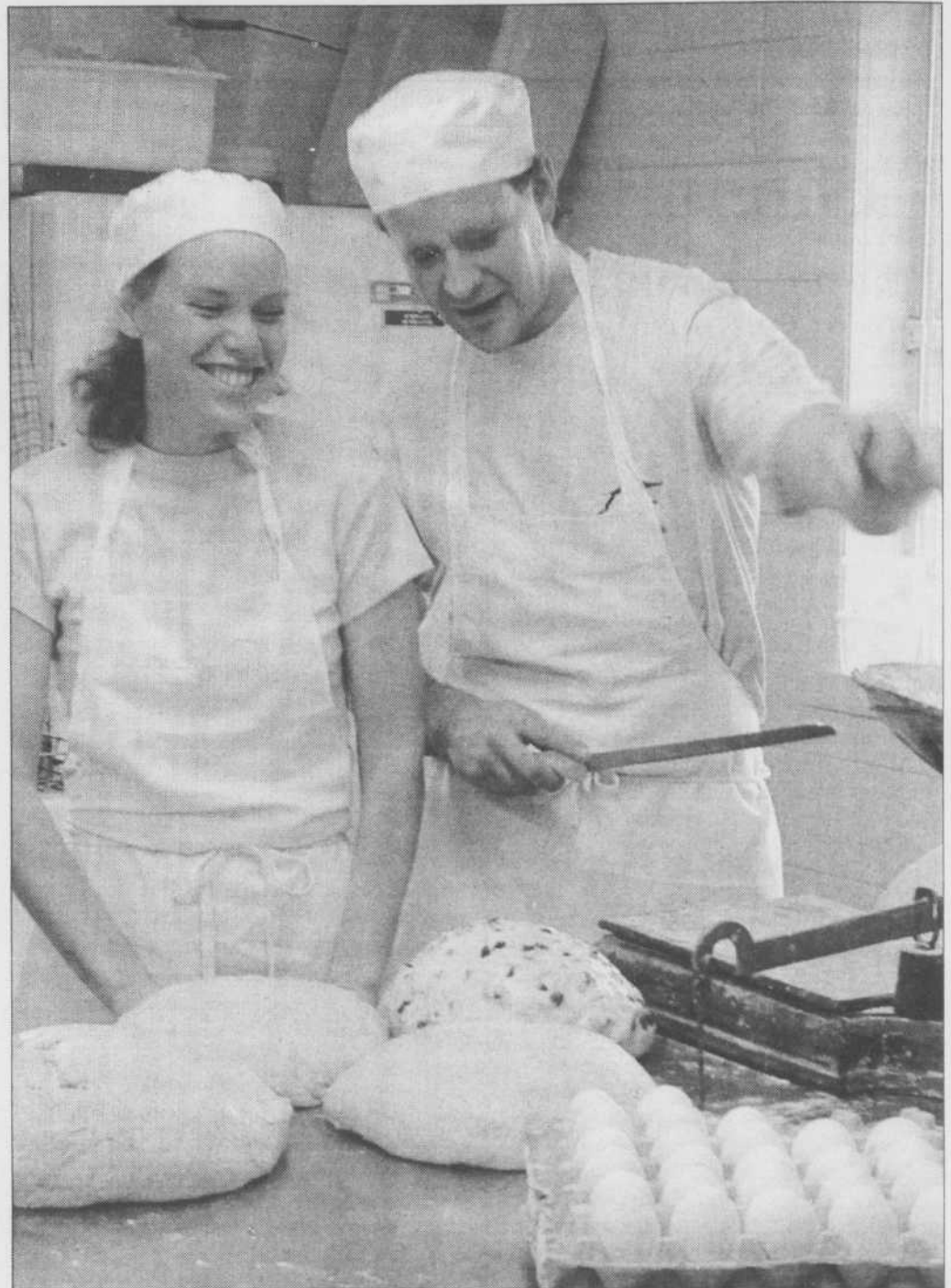
Nearby shelves are stocked with an assortment of their relishes and pickles, as well as homemade spaghetti sauces for those who crave home-cooking without the headache. They also sell their

own homemade cereals and granolas.

On a summer weekend, it is not unusual to see a queue 10-deep waiting for the delectable fare. The owners, so far, have no need to advertise, depending upon word-of-mouth amongst locals and out-of-towners.

In fact, the business is just where the couple wants it to be and, despite the fact that the shop has been profiled on radio and television, they are shy in the face of publicity.

"Small is beautiful," says Patrick. "We want to stay small: we have three kids."

Students organize Musique Chez Nous series

'It's about as eclectic as anything can be'

This season's Musique Chez Nous concert series at Bishop's University promises a wide variety of music ranging from lute music and a sitar concert to a world premiere composition by Andrew MacDonald.

Selected concerts will be recorded by CBC Radio, employing the fine acoustics of Bandeen Hall. At \$10 per adult ticket, the concerts continue to be a great bargain.

Fourth year honours music students Scott Birchall and Karla Mundy have worked enthusiastically to help promote and organize the series. The friends, who have attended school together since childhood, expressed confidence in this year's program.

"It's about as eclectic as anything can

be," said Birchall.

"The concerts were chosen from tons of proposals," added Mundy. "CBC helps us decide which concerts are most suited to recording."

"We get talent we couldn't afford otherwise," Birchall acknowledged.

Music students at Bishop's look forward to the concerts and workshops given by artists-in-residence.

"We get two artists-in-residence a year," explained Mundy. "The organizers try to match up the artists with what the students are doing here. Usually a pianist will come in. Last year, a string quartet worked with 10 to 12 people. This year, the Viva Voce choir, which specializes in Early Music, is coming in to work with students and, next semester, the Russian pianist Alexander Tselyakov will visit."

Each year, the public and students eagerly anticipate a concert featuring German artists, put on in collaboration with the German consulate. Members of the Klenke Quartett Weimar with

Christina Fassbender will perform works by Haydn and Rossini and two flute quartets by Mozart.

The group includes Beate Hartman (violin), Yvonne Uhlemass (viola) and Ruth Kaltenhauser (cello). This internationally acclaimed group has recorded two CDs and traveled throughout Europe and Canada. The consulate provides a reception of German wine and cheese. The concert will take place Friday, Oct. 6, at 8 p.m. at Bandeen Hall.

Both student organizers were excited at the prospect of Jaap Schroeder's concert coming up Oct. 27.

"Jaap Schroeder is possibly the world's best Baroque violinist," said Birchall. "This is an unbelievable thing we're getting."

A sitar concert by Guy Bernier with Gabriel Dionna on tabla will prove an interesting part of November's lineup.

Another international act in November promises to delight audiences with lute solos and duets. Jacob Heringman and Gail Gillispie

will play works by John Dowland, Alfonso Ferrabosco I and Philip Rosseter of the 16th century English school of lute song composers.

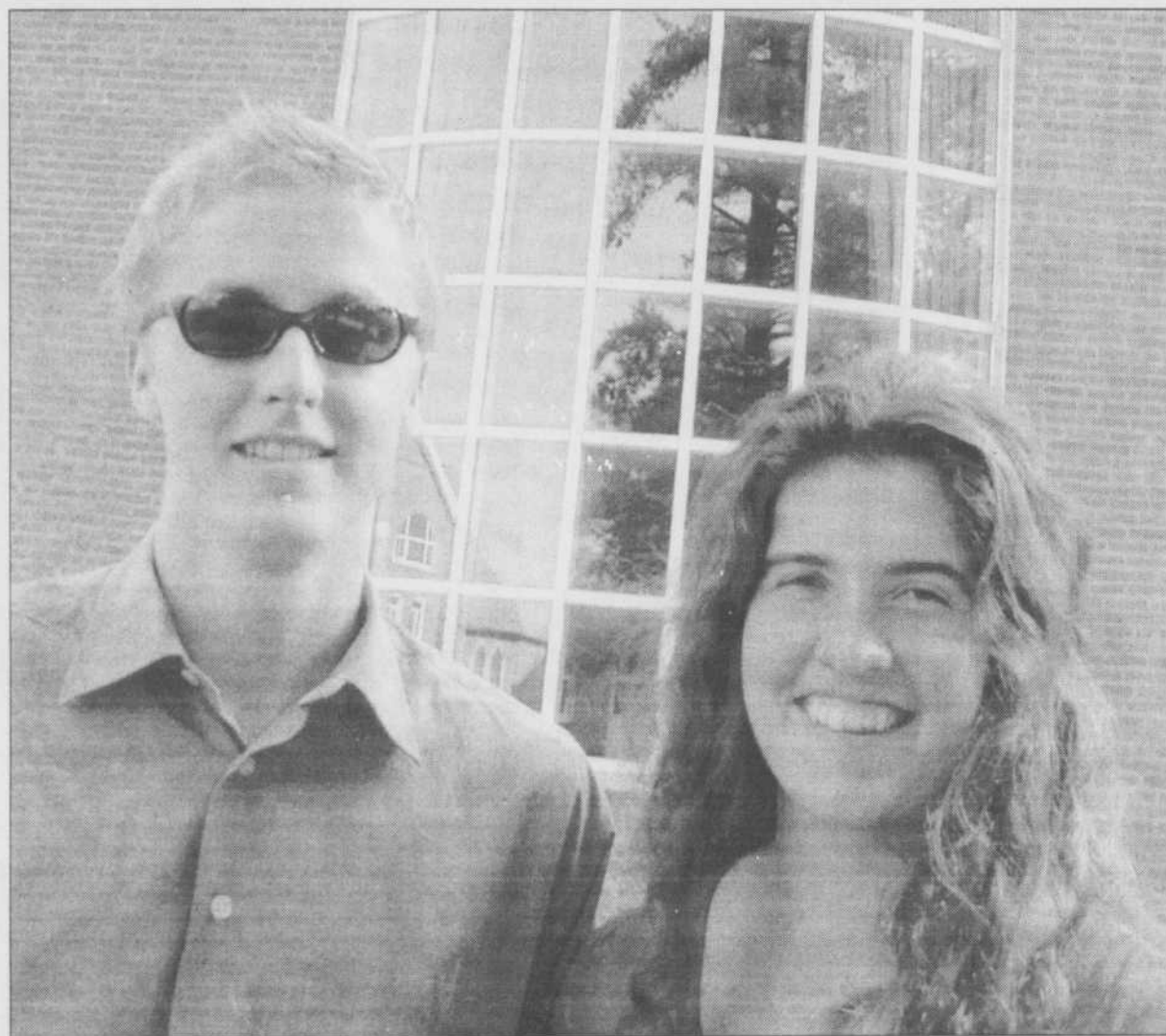
Brigitte Poulin, a performance instructor in the music department, is performing something a little different this year.

"She's performing a concert of Sonatas and Interludes by John Cage. It works using a scientific method. The strings of the piano are muted with different objects - nuts and bolts and erasers. The sound becomes very percussive," said Birchall. "It should be quite interesting."

"It hardly even sounds like a piano," added Mundy. "It's like 88 drums."

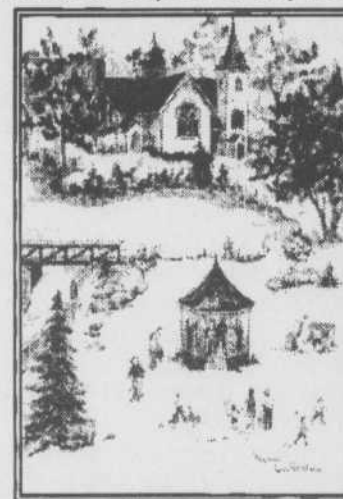

and the popular and acclaimed fiddler Nathalie McMaster in the Upbeat Series; and dancers Sylvain Énard and Louise Bédard in the Modern Dance series.

'Victoria,' a dance drama examining old age through the eyes of a woman suffering from dementia, is just one of the exciting non-subscription shows coming up.

The concert 'Sweet Follia' is slated for early December. The Ensemble Caprice released a CD of the same name last Christmas which promises works by Couperin, Blavet, Gershwin and Maute. The ensemble is made up of two flautists, a gambist (playing the viola da gamba) and a percussionist.

"The music is very festive, very light, very much in the spirit of Christmas," said Couture.

Tuyo's 'Rouge De Vinci,' inspired by Leonardo Da Vinci, arrives Oct. 27.

"The show is about perpetual movement and it's very visual, very choreographed," said Couture. "The animation of Pierre Hébert, who engraves directly on film and worked for the National Film Board for 30 years, are used as a background. The group plays invented instruments with strange names - like

beluga and Moby Dick."

"The group will give workshops on sound exploration with these instruments," Couture continued. "They're going to have the students create instruments. Tuyo is working with students at high school and college levels."

Nathalie McMaster, the internationally acclaimed Canadian Celtic fiddler, takes the stage in March. McMaster has four best-selling CDs to her credit, as well as performances with The Chieftains and as part of a concert in honour of opera star Pavarotti in New York.

Dulcinea Langfelder & Co. star in the dance drama 'Victoria,' which was presented at Montreal's Centaur Theatre last May. The production has toured the United States and France and comes to Centennial at the end of November.

"'Victoria' includes dance, theatre, music and mime," said Couture. "It's about a lady who has dementia and (it's about) her vision of the world, how she copes with age and solitude. It's very touching."

Dance, drama, music - it's all in the offing at Centennial this season.

The music will begin at 8 p.m., but come a little earlier for a good seat, coffee, juice and/or munchies. The cafe is housed in the Lennoxville United Church, corner of Queen and Church.

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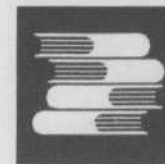

Trenholm quilter publishes first book

The Townships has produced yet another author. Celebrated professional quilter Sheila Wintle of Trenholm has added new credentials to her name with the publication of *Colonial Appliqué: Inspirations from Early America*, a quilt project book with patterns based on her research of early New England textiles.

"It was a wonderful learning experience," exclaimed Wintle of her recent achievement.

It was also a major undertaking even for an experienced pattern-maker and quilter like Wintle.

"With the research, quilt design and production, and the writing and editing process, it took 18 months from start to finish," she added.

The book itself, with its rich colour and clear explanation of pattern design, colour choice and appliqué method, is a delight to the eye even for non-quilters. This is not only a project book, but is based on scholarly re-

search of Colonial 'bed rugg' designs.

"They (bed ruggs) were something that was like the precursor to quilts. There aren't many left in existence - only about 75. I was able to adapt the patterns and combine them with traditional piecing and original appliqué so that things were tradition-based yet had a new look," explained Wintle.

The book is for everyone - from the true beginner to the experienced quilter with projects for every level of ability. Wintle's layout also accommo-

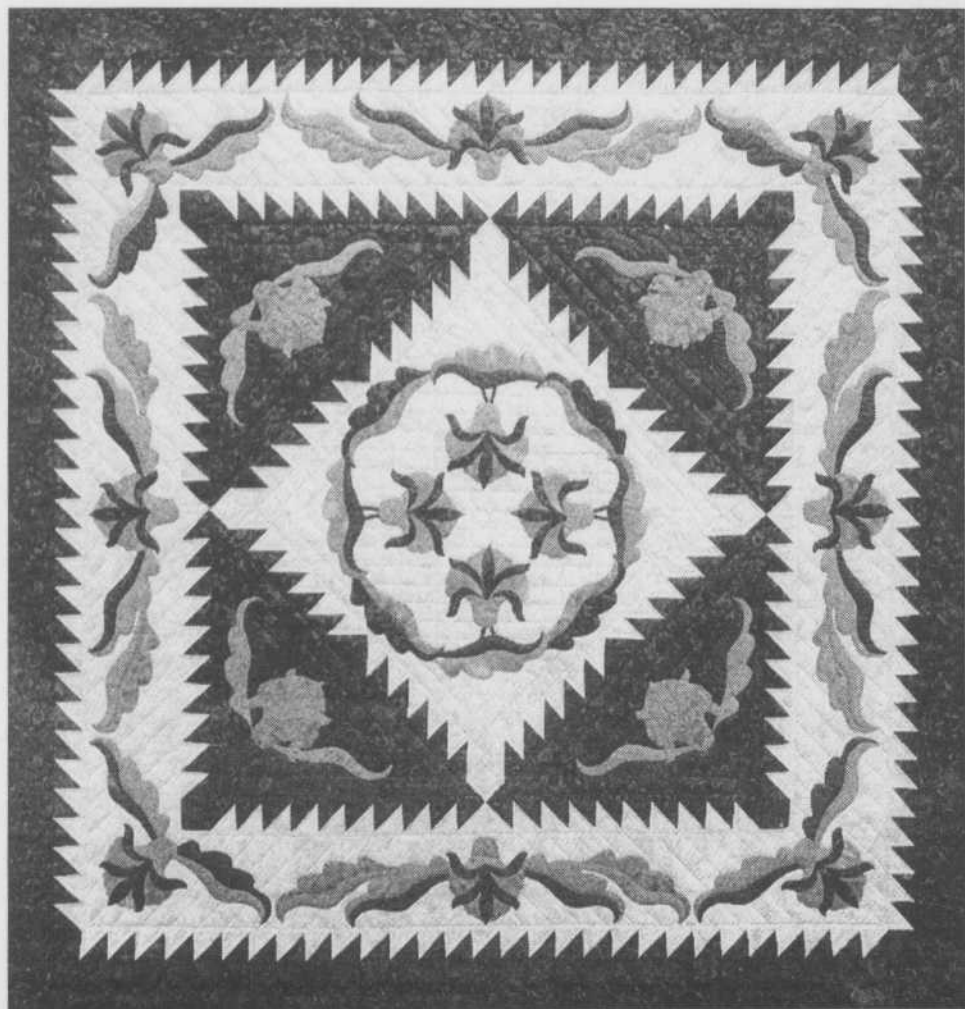
dates those with their own creative bent. The patterns are all made to the same scale so that they can be mixed and matched as the quilter desires. The projects are also relatively scaled down as quilts go, with most being under 50" x 50".

"Today it has changed. People don't want to invest the time to make a large project. They want a tangible results project - they are product-oriented rather than process-oriented so this is the format that I worked out," said Wintle.

Sheila Wintle's collection of floral appliqué blocks and quilt designs captures the enduring beauty of Early American textiles.

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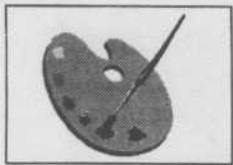

Chronicling the past, item by item

Museologist Francine Godbout inventories Townships history at the Uplands Museum

Museologist Francine Godbout is in the first stages of documenting the collection at Lennoxville's Uplands Heritage and Cultural Centre thanks to a grant from the Townshippers Foundation and the Bélanger-Gardner Foundation.

Hired by the Lennoxville-Ascot Historical and Museum Society, Godbout is concentrating on a wide variety of objects, including clothing, artwork, books, china and furniture.

Much of the collection comes from the Speid family, who were the most recent owners of the house. The rest was donated by the community.

Godbout is in the process of registering each object at the museum with an accession number for categorizing.

"This is used to document where each object came from and where they were used. This is especially important now that we're losing touch with those objects," Godbout said.

"Most objects here have been recorded with a first system, but now we have to use a standardized system to allow museums to speak to each other, so everyone in the field speaks the same language."

The standardized system explains the object, starting with the year the piece is from, its name, the category, sub-category and location.

Using this system makes storage and retrieval easy. It allows a museum to know its entire inventory and gives researchers direct access to information about the collection.

"Each object must have its place," Godbout explained. "Those places are standardized too."

She displayed a number of treasures carefully preserved in acid-free boxes, including an exquisite tiny pair of woolen mitts for a child and embroidered satin slippers.

"Each time you discover something you've never seen, it satisfies your curiosity about these objects. You want to go further - to know more about it. These objects strike you. You've never seen them and you want to share them with people to explain what and how. At the same time, they are like witnesses to the past. This is why I am so con-

cerned about their conservation," said Godbout.

Godbout developed her interest in art and antiques while studying at Bishop's University for a BA in Fine Arts.

"I noticed they had an art collection. I started to work with Chris Ljungkull at the art gallery mounting exhibitions. I started doing work on the inventory at the art gallery."

She liked this work so much, she decided to pursue a Master's degree in Museology while at the same time working as a technician in restoring a wall painting in Montreal at Notre Dame de Bon Secours.

She has also worked in Sherbrooke with conservator Patrick Legris on three projects.

Godbout is dedicated to articles from the past.

"It helps when people know their treasures are in good hands. People give you good things. Another aspect of this work is you cannot rush," she explained.

"You have to be careful, the material is old. Another aspect you learn about is the materials used to make the articles - perhaps about the strong material used to dye a textile."

The conservation specialist displayed a special coat donated to the museum.

"This jacket made of rabbit comes from England. The nurses wore them underneath their uniforms. The rabbit-skin outside is very soft so it doesn't in-

terfere with movement and the fur is on the inside for warmth," said Godbout. She pointed out the holes under the

arms to allow for the body to breathe. "When you look at this, you can just imagine what the conditions were like, what the time was like where the nurses were working."

In an upstairs room, dresses and suits from long ago are carefully shrouded in special protective bags. Each item is tagged with an identification number. Each article of clothing is organized by size.

"We get a lot of help from volunteers," Godbout said. "They have been sewing new covers. We have an army of volunteers ready to help."

She opened up a closet full of neatly ordered acid-free boxes. "Mr. Tracy helped with this," she acknowledged. "He made shelving for this cupboard."

Last June, Godbout started work on the collection by organizing the contents of the attic, now an orderly storehouse for a host of interesting items.

"I started in June and I will continue until I reach the final goal of digitalizing some of the most significant objects to make a profile of the museum. We'll try to have a portrait of the museum to describe the institution," she said. "Thanks to the grants from the foundations, we can make this inventory and have exhibitions for the community at large."

Mystic artist turns silk into wearable art

Art for the soul

Myctic is a small village that is easy to overlook because of its off-the-beaten-path location (halfway between Farnham and Bedford). Yet, it is home to a landmark of agricultural technology (the Walbridge octagonal barn), an outstanding restaurant (L'Oeuf) and quaint architecture more reminiscent of Vermont than Quebec.

It is also home to artist Sylvie Bouchard, whose workshop is open during the Tournée des 20 art tour and, at other times, by appointment.

Bouchard's work combines the arts of costume design and painting to create tableaux that are both functional and decorative. She completed a Fine Arts degree from Laval University, later studying costume design and theatre production at the National Theatre School in Montreal.

The Lac St-Jean native learned English while traveling in Australia, where she met future husband Peter Dare. The couple now resides in the sunny house that serves as both home and studio.

While studying theatre, Bouchard acquired skills in costume design.

"I am a lover of fabric," she says.

Her most exotic works, hand-painted silk kimonos, are produced with the aid of her sister, a teacher of costume design.

"We produce a limited number of

the kimonos a year because they are so labour intensive," said the artist, whose kimonos sell for \$800.

These high-end items sell to a limited but regular clientele who either wear them or use them as decorative wall hangings. For those on more limited budgets, she produces hand-painted neckties and scarves that are both elegant and functional.

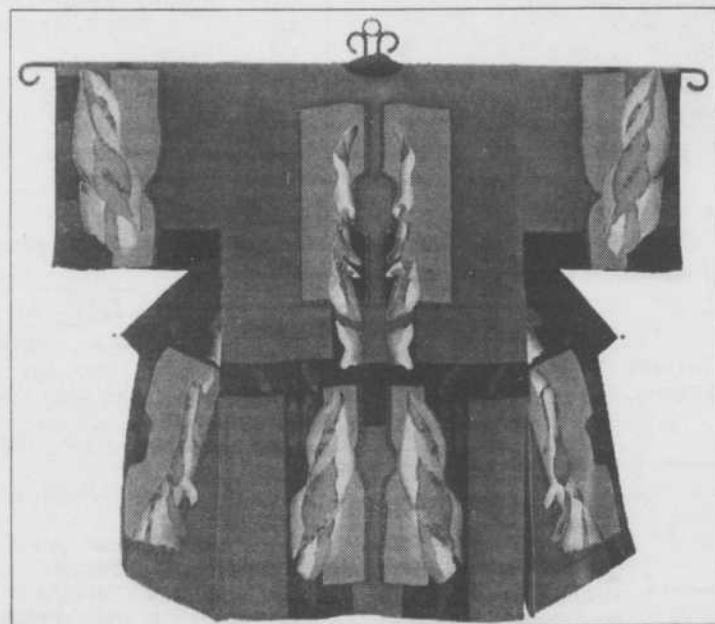
Her works combine several different techniques. After stretching the virgin silk on frames, she draws patterns onto the silk that will be

painted and later, cut and sewn. The painting of silk requires careful preparation, patience and a steady hand.

"The 'serti' technique is a European technique for making fine lines on fabric," she said, holding aloft a small, dye-filled plastic bottle capped with a fine nozzle. "This is one of the most difficult techniques to master: the dye must go through the fabric evenly or else the line will not be straight."

Mastering the technique requires both a steady hand and speed to ensure a good outcome. She also uses wax to protect an area while painting around it with one of the more than 100 sizes of brushes she keeps in stock. The application of coarse salt to the wet paint produces a mottled effect that provides contrast to smooth brush strokes.

After the painting has been completed, the silk is detached from its frame, rolled in paper and then placed in a steamer to fix the dyes. Then, the completed fabric is ready to be cut and sewn into wearable scarves, ties or kimonos.

Bouchard also produces conceptual pieces, painted fabric that is mounted between two pieces of glass and hung as a painting. In these, she experiments with unusual fibers - even human hair - to produce unexpected effects.

Though she maintains a steady, private clientele, her works are also on display at the crafts cooperative Farfelu in Montreal and in galleries in Winnipeg, Vancouver and Stratford, Ont. Once a year, she goes to Toronto for the annual One-of-a-Kind show, one of Canada's most prestigious artisan shows.

For those who would like to see the artist at work, Bouchard's workshop, located at 121 Walbridge Road, will be open during the final weekend of the Tournée des 20, Oct. 7, 8 and 9. Her workshop is also open throughout the year by appointment by calling (450) 248-2780.

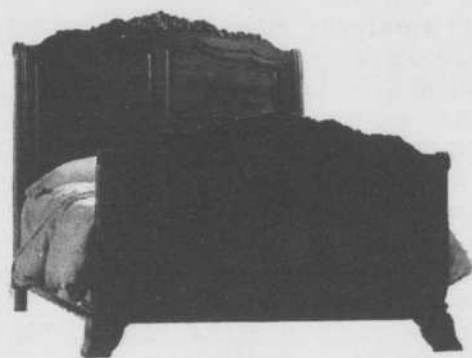

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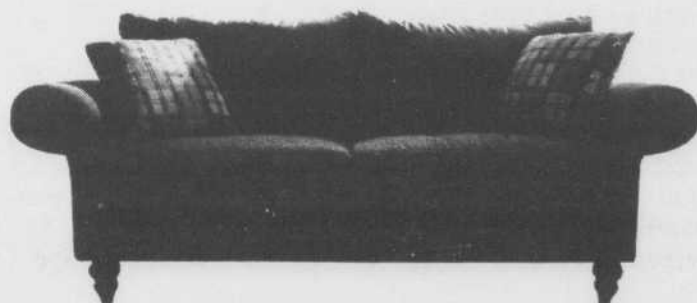
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
