**City aims to maximize bicycle parking space with new two-sided racks**

As the number of Westmounters getting around by two-wheeled conveyance appears to be on the rise, the City of Westmount is keeping up with the trend by facilitating the parking of bicycles.

As part of a pilot project, the City recently purchased a total of 30 bicycle racks that fit onto the steel posts that support parking meters. Each rack will allow two bikes at a time to be anchored to a post.

The first rack has been installed on a parking meter on the north side of Sherbrooke Street near the corners of Elm and Mount Pleasant avenues.

"These are racks that occupy less space than the large moveable racks," said City Councillor George Bowser, who oversaw the purchase.

The City plans to install the racks mainly in Westmount's commercial areas, including Greene Avenue, Victoria Avenue and Sherbrooke Street, for a trial period, beginning in September.

Bowser said the rack model chosen is a prototype which is considered more efficient than other designs. He said it can be installed without the loss of a parking spot. "Parking is at a premium in Westmount, particularly in the commercial sectors," he said.

Although the first rack is painted black, he said the remainder will be grey to match the parking meter poles and other City property. The unit cost per rack, in standard black, was \$275. Taxes, transport and repainting brought the total bill to \$9,970.63.

According to Bowser, some residents, and the Healthy City Environment Committee, had been urging the City to install additional racks for bicycles since the current city council took office. "We looked at possible locations, and then we were always dealing with the problem of the size of the conventional four-rail rack that you'll see," he said. "There's one near City Hall, for example, where you push the bike in.

"They have a large footprint, and so the larger the footprint the harder it is to fit them into a convenient or appropriate space. And so it was a question of design ... You're not occupying any more real estate, but you are accommodating more bicycles. That was the plan ... Council hopes that the units will be well-received."

If the trial period study ends on a positive note, additional racks could be installed throughout the commercial sectors of Westmount. "If they're well used and people like them, then we'll get more and we'll spread them around," said Bowser.

The locations where the new racks are being installed are Sherbrooke (north side) between Grosvenor and Victoria at each parking meter; Sherbrooke (south side) between Claremont and Prince Albert; Victoria (west side) Sherbrooke to Somerville at each parking meter; Greene (both sides) Sherbrooke to laneway (east side) and Sherbrooke to parking lot (west side); Greene and de Maisonneuve intersection, in front of TD Bank, in front of Bank of Montreal, and in front of Cinq Saisons on Greene Avenue.

# Urban wildlife is here to stay — and it's bat season

**U**rban centers share their space with urban wildlife, much to the chagrin of many citizens. The words 'private property' do not apply to the skunks, raccoons, squirrels and bats that like to squat in attics, under patios and inside chimneys.

However, there is a way to get the message across and in a humane fashion.

Westmount is home to a variety of wildlife that has made its way down the mountain. Within the island of Montreal, there are as many as 15 to 30 raccoons and skunks per square kilometre. For safe cohabitation to succeed, the first rule is to protect the home and prevent animals from finding or creating entry points.

Bill Dowd, president of Humane Wildlife Control, says the most important action to take when dealing with wild animals is not to give them a reason to visit in the first place.

Humane Wildlife Control is a company with service centers throughout Ontario and Quebec. They respond to calls regarding wildlife conflicts and provide solutions that benefit both home owners and urban wildlife.

Dowd advises against facing off with animals like raccoons and bats and recommends calling in professionals at first

sighting. People should always be cautious. "Just like you don't want to go and pet a stray dog or cat," Dowd says.

Westmount Public Security responds to residential calls but will often refer the callers to wildlife control experts. They will not remove the animal.

"When you remove a raccoon, another will take its place," said Richard Blondin, director of Westmount Public Security.

Humane Wildlife Control wholeheartedly agrees. Removing animals, Dowd said, "creates a vacuum for others to move in. Raccoons are here to stay."

What's more, relocating a family of animals is equivalent to sentencing them to death because they will be placed in unfamiliar surroundings and new territories in which to forage. However, to close off an animal's entrance to the nest it has made in your home simply forces it to return to another of the five or six den sites the animal has in its territory. This is the suggested humane solution.

Susan Spencer encountered a family of skunks living under her deck on Lansdowne Avenue. She called Humane Wildlife Control who initially placed a trap door in the small opening used by the skunks, allowing them to leave but not return. The company also placed wire meshing deep into the ground so the skunks could not dig themselves back underneath the deck.

"Your home is probably the biggest investment you will make and you should protect it," Dowd said. That includes proofing chimneys, roofs, foundations and any other small openings animals can access.

Dowd also warned that August is bat season. This is the time of year when young bats learn how to fly and accidentally end up in attics and wall shafts. Humane Wildlife Control receives about 150-200 bat related calls during this time.

The danger posed by bats is twofold: bites

from rabid bats and spores found in bat droppings are both extremely hazardous to your health. Dowd says not to go after bats with brooms and tennis rackets, as any escaping liquids expelled by a blow to the animal can also be dangerous.

For these reasons Humane Wildlife Control stresses the importance of animal-proofing homes. And of course,

when a wildlife conflict or encounter does occur, don't do it yourself — call in the experts.

# Will Martin's 17-item To-Do List lead to a council legacy?

City Councillor Patrick Martin said last week that it was possible for a council's "body of work" itself to be regarded as a legacy. I wonder whether many would agree — apart from other councillors!

After all, if you walk eastward along de Maisonneuve Boul. from Victoria Village, you cannot ignore the beautiful collection of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers that mark the entrance to the Park.

Then you realize that it covers what was once a minor autoroute through the Park and have to agree the change was an imaginative use of taxpayers' money and a terrific enhancement to the City.

I think many would agree that was a great legacy provided by John Shingler, who guided it through council during his one-term as an alderman.

Of course, the present council will produce things of lasting value, although it has only two years remaining to do so!

Councillor Martin has now accepted my challenge to prove that the present council's

"body of work" will make the history books. He highlights 17 events or actions that will, he claims, build this council's legacy. Certainly, it is an impressive To-Do List.

**Hybrid vehicles** — Selection took a year longer than expected, but we persevered. Staff eventually proposed models that are good both for the environment and operating costs. It marked a subtle policy change — these objectives must be met with future purchases.

**Communication** — At first, Council must do its work privately, until we are sure we know everything we ought to know. We debate the issues. Sometimes it takes a year, but we end up, almost always, unanimous. Then we have to reach out to citizens, and it takes a lot of work if that is to be well done.

**Preparation** — I like to think that, as we carefully prepare for the future, this is a legacy in itself. Currently, if we can establish an environment strategy so that we have a plan for treating all the opportunities brought to our attention, then I think we will have created a legacy. I know you cannot touch or feel it, but it is there for the future.

**Sports project** — The new Sports Complex, Arena or whatever it will be called is not going to be built in the next year and a half. In fact, probably the most we can do in this mandate is to get our heads around the project: to define it, perhaps design it and say "This is how it will be financed". To

know where we are going within two years would be amazing, based on my engineering experience. We have to know what the stakeholders and the financiers expect.

**Green buildings** — The new complex will be the ideal opportunity to embrace green technology. Additionally, we should take a lead in demonstrating how savings can be applied to existing buildings. I hope we can take the initiative to show residents how it can be done.

**Visual pollution** — Why do we tolerate electrical and other cables on the skyline? Why don't we get them buried? Admittedly, that brings maintenance problems to the people who have to repair them. I know it is not as easy as it looks, but we have to try.

**Noise** — As someone who lives in a house with open windows in the summer, I have sensitivity to outside noise. Council is looking at a new bylaw for air conditioners because too many of them are making a nuisance. It is our duty to allow everyone to enjoy their property. In making the town

better with such laws, the average citizen doesn't see the result, but it is there.

**Hydro metering** — We should be thinking of a plan — or even beginning to implement it — for metering our power supply with peak and off-peak rates. It would also be very cost efficient as long as the expense of metering does not exceed the savings. It is a very common system in Europe.

**Water metering** — I'm looking forward to Dessau-Soprin's report on our infrastructure, because we need to know the expected replacements over the next two decades. Then we can look at other opportunities. There is no doubt that metering potable water is one of the best ways to reduce consumption. At present there is no incentive to turn off lawn sprinklers even when it rains! It will mean a different contract with the City of Montreal, because currently it saves us nothing by reducing consumption. Meantime, council is looking at changing the bylaw to make better use of rain water.

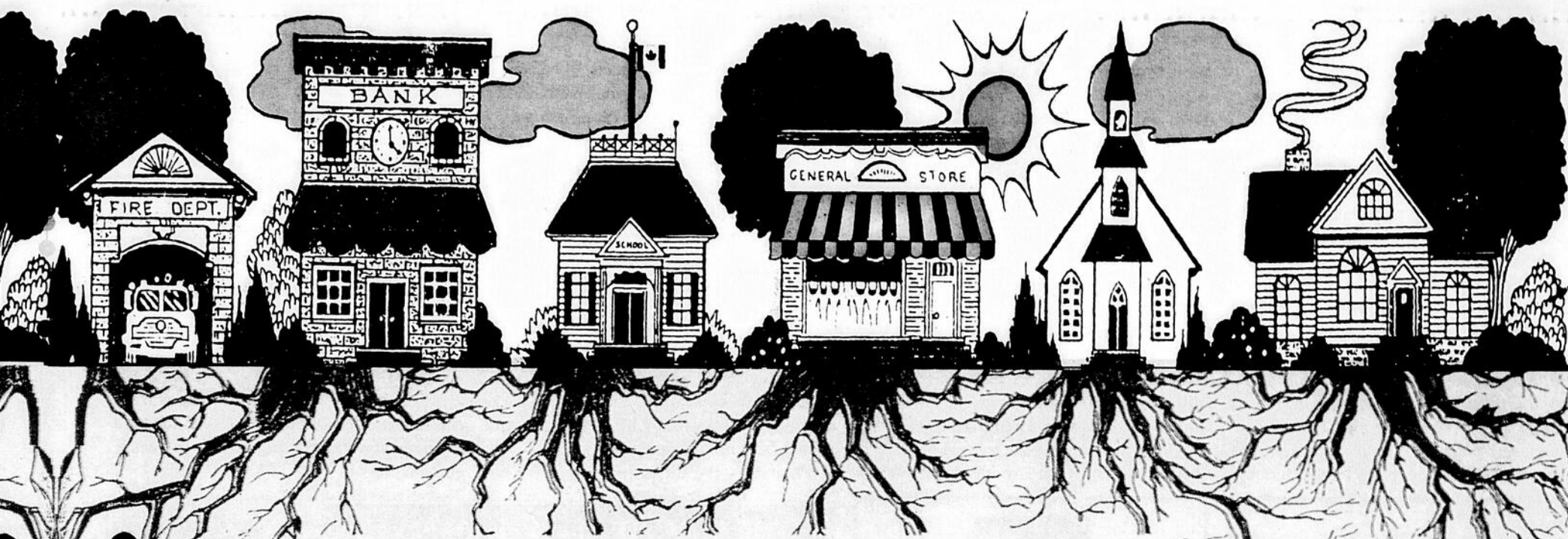

**Employee relations** — Maintaining harmonious relations with employees is surely a legacy worth pursuing. The recent negotiations to take over the maintenance of the water systems was a win-win example for the Blue Collar union and everyone. Being assured of labour peace is something to be proud of.

**Cenotaph** — I have strong family attachments to the War Memorial. An uncle's name is carved into the stone and my father became head of the family when only 14 years old, because my grandfather had been killed in the war. An amazing number of Westmounters served in the military and far too many did not come back, so I don't like the Cenotaph surroundings being turned into a recreation area. Some of us think it can be reclaimed, although

it will probably straddle mandates. The land on which it stands was once known as Garden Point and that is a direction we might take. It is difficult to skateboard through shrubs.

**Light** — Hydro Westmount, for which I have a responsibility, has energy saving among its objectives. We are trying to reduce consumption with the lighting we use throughout the city. Our task is to reduce the amount of light that escapes upwards so that it is most effective where needed — on the ground.

**Marianopolis** — Fully integrating a major English CEGEP into the city would be a legacy to leave for the next century. Successfully absorbing 2,000 students into the north-west corner of the town is a tremendous undertaking. We will probably have enough time left in this mandate to make any adjustments neces-

sary after the opening semesters. There was a special reward for me in working on this dossier — as a child, I went there for music lessons!

**Recycling** — I hope we can find a solution to commercial recycling during the mandate. We are surrounded by the Big City which does not offer the service — it has to be done by contractors. I'm puzzled why the government does not require the SAQ to do what the beer and pop industries have to do — charge a fee for the containers so that it is profitable to take them back.

**Website** — To have a city site full of up-to-date information about all aspects of the council and the community would be a real legacy. There should be access to the council's background information. The site could, and should, be constantly improved.

**Finances** — We began in a big hole. It is not

my dossier but the debt with the interest payments must be at least \$50 million. Getting back to pay-as-you-go will be an amazing accomplishment. Current finances are sound; we are within budget and anticipated revenue.

**Big Montreal** — Finally, I hope we can establish harmonious relationships with Montreal and the Agglom. But working the Marianopolis move with Marcel Tremblay proved that cooperation is possible and worthwhile. It also confirmed to me that small is beautiful. It is different for us; no councillor lives more than 20 minutes' walk from City Hall. When you walk to work, you see the problems close up.
