## Taking art for a ride

Derick Adams loves vintage cars. Several times a year he and wife Linda may be seen cruising down Quebec roads in their canary yellow 7-liter '67 Galaxy Excel.

His first foray into luxury cars was a Peerless Model Six-90 "boatail" with

77,000 miles on the odometer he received in trade for cash and a '27 Chevy.

The most recent addition to his private collection is a 1927 Peerless Eight-69, a seven-passenger sedan that in its own day represented the height of prestige and state of the art technology.

A look at this vintage auto in its current state shows how ephemeral those trappings can be: its tin panels are pit-

ted from decades of rust and exposure and the once luxurious black upholstery is now lacklustre.

Adams is smitten with his rare find, however, and promises to have his Peerless restored to its former glory and back on the road in about a year.

It all began when Adams was in Stowe, Vermont at the annual Stowe

## Be heard

### Support needed for community radio

Missisquoi Community Radio is moving towards becoming a licensed station.

Spokesperson Susan Reininger says the marketing study needed to apply for a Canadian Radio-television and telecommunications Commission (CRTC) license is now underway.

"The marketing study is to find out if merchants will buy (advertising) from the radio and yes, we've started it," said Reininger. "So far I have had just one negative response."

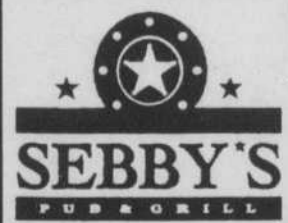
The group must demonstrate that it is able to raise 50 per cent of its annual operating budget from local sources before the CRTC will approve its application.

At the same time, its members have placed petitions at strategic locations throughout the area and urge the public to sign as a show of support.

Petitions are currently placed at the Book Nook in Sutton, Lac Brome Books in Knowlton, F.G. Edwards General Store in West Brome, Lakeside Depanneur in Foster, Knowlton Packaging in Knowlton, Emmanuel United Church in Cowansville and Café Floral in Knowlton.

Volunteers are looking for one or more petition locations in Mansonsville. Any businesses willing to host a petition should contact Reininger at (450) 263-5068.

Reininger said that Missisquoi Community Radio recently received a generous grant from Townshippers' Foundation, money that will put them one step closer to bringing the station to reality.

## A feast for the eyes and taste buds

### *Auberge Sainte-Catherine-de-Hatley a family affair*

An evening at the Auberge Sainte-Catherine-de-Hatley is as close to homestyle dining as it gets. The intimate dining room of the charming turn-of-the-century auberge, which can seat 20 to 30 guests, is owned and operated by the multi-talented Drouin-Gagnon family.

Mom Bibiane greets guests and seats them comfortably in front of the picture windows which provide an exquisite view of rolling hills and Lake Magog, with Mont Orford as a backdrop. In better weather, the outdoor patio and lawn seating totally immerse diners in the pastoral setting.

Son Grégoire informs guests of the specialties of the day, takes care of drinks and delivers the orders to the kitchen where sister – and chef –

Mélanie begins to work her magic. Until his death two years ago, Yvon Gagnon, the family patriarch, also brought his personal touch to the family operation.

The menu is not expansive, but highly specialized, highlighting the Swiss/California-style specialties favoured by Mélanie Gagnon, who received her training as a chef at l'Institut du tourisme et d'hôtellerie du Québec à Montréal and has honed her culinary skills borrowing tricks of the trade from chefs around the globe.

Sunday's table d'hôte offered a choice of two entrées: A salad with a selection of colourful fresh greens in an oil and balsamic vinegar dressing, or sliced boiled potato on melted raclette, with pickled onions. Both were satisfac-

tory.

This was followed by a hearty lentil soup with a Mexican flair. Ample time was left between the substantial soup course and the main dish.

The main course offerings included Italian-style veal served with a sprig of fresh rosemary, tarragon chicken in a light cream sauce, and a pasta and vegetable dish. We opted for the meat dishes and both were served with decorative and tasty grated potato, grilled to perfection, and fresh veggies attractively served in a paper thin pastry

cup.

A strawberry tarte with a custard base was included with the table d'hôte.

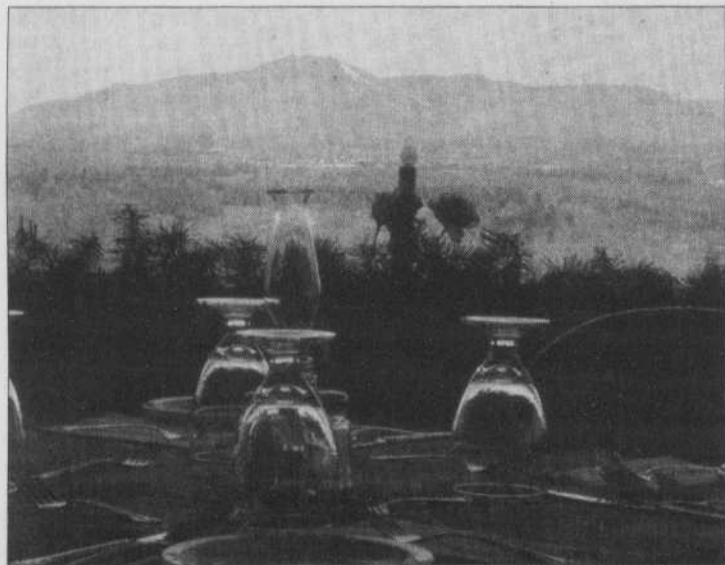
During the summer, chef Mélanie capitalizes on the auberge's rambling garden for a variety of fresh herbs and spices to enhance dishes and allow for healthy eating. Overnight guests at the auberge also get to sample homemade preserves and chutneys.

Prices are surprisingly low as the view alone merits a hefty price tag. The three choices on Sunday's table d'hôte

were priced at \$10.95, although the menu posted outside features meals in the \$18.95 to \$25.95 range. The auberge is open for lunch during the summer months, starting at \$6.95.

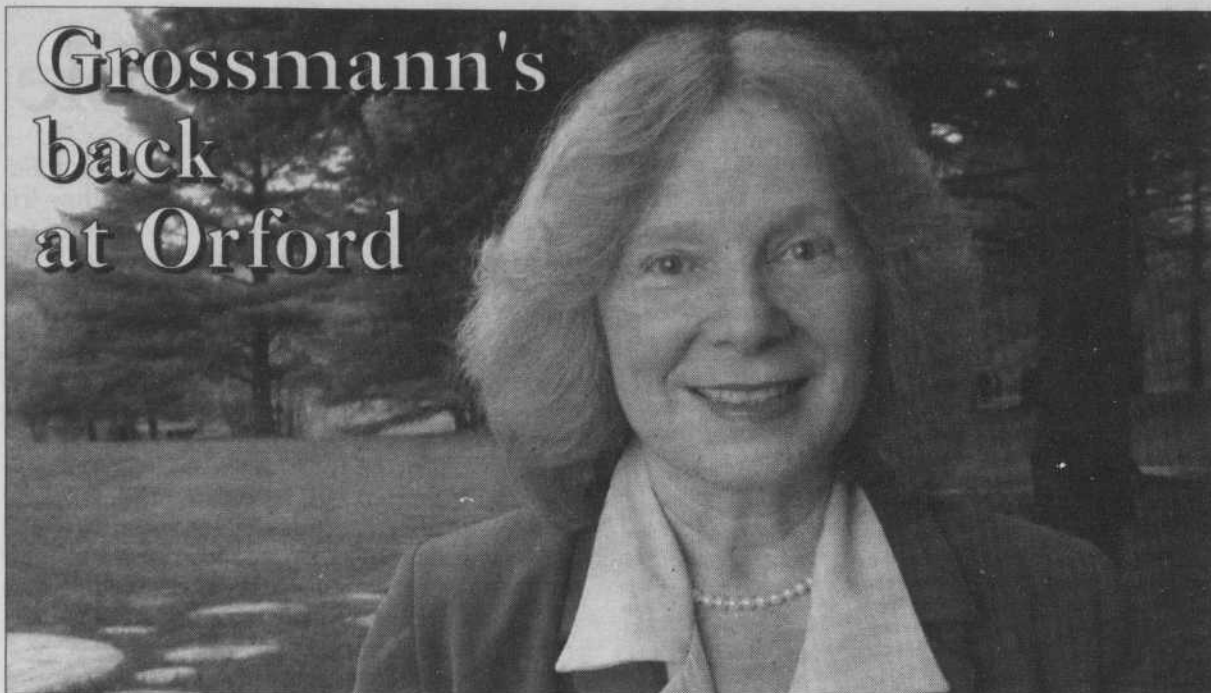

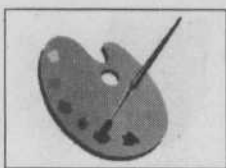

## Adams now looking for the Roadster convertible

Auto Show looking for parts for his Peerless Six-90 boatail (so named for the fold-out, two passenger rumble seat).

"A fellow at the show saw me walking around asking for Peerless parts," recalls Adams. "He came up to me and said, 'I know where there's a Peerless but you'll never get it'."

The owner of the phantom Peerless turned out to be a doctor from St. Albans, VT. The car, he was told, had once been owned by a former President of I.T.T. (a man credited with bringing telephone service to Vermont). The Peerless came to the executive's vacation place in Ward, VT where it remained until it was acquired in the 1950s by the St. Albans collector.

After the collector's death, Adams put in an offer to buy the Peerless from the doctor's estate.

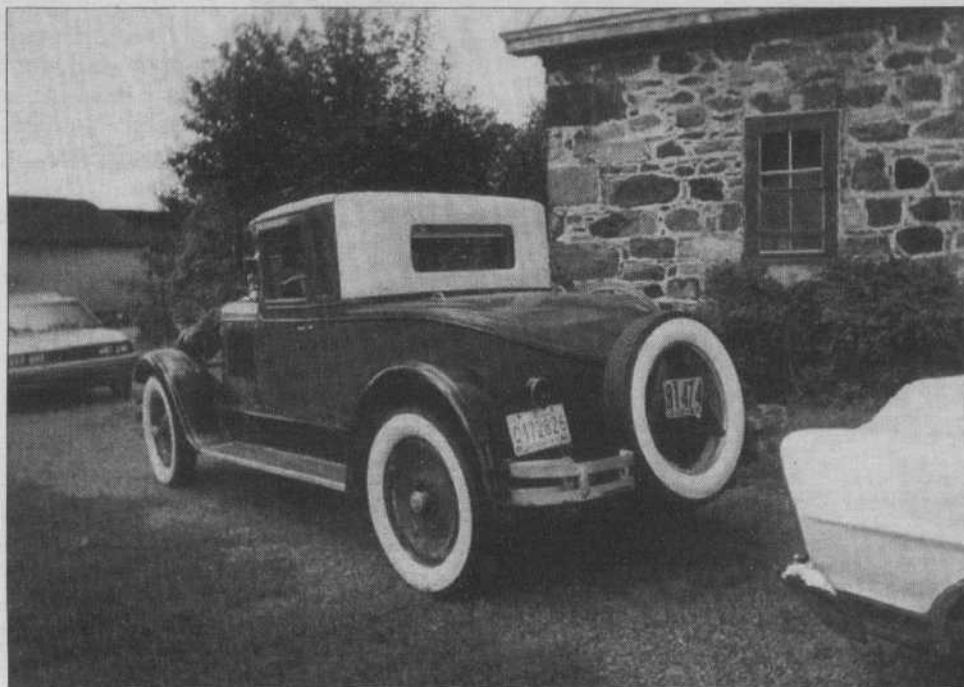
"Peerless always has been a good car," says Adams.

The 'three P's' of the automotive world - Packard, Pierce Arrow and Peerless - once dominated the American luxury market.

Peerless started life as a bicycle maker and entered automobile production in 1906.

It continued until 1932 when it ceased production, a victim of the Great Depression. (In 1934, the Peerless Motor Car Company became the Peerless Corporation, brewer of Carling Ale.)

Adams points out that Peerless was at

the forefront of automotive engine design: The company was one of the first to employ the V-8 engine and its 'Equipoised 8' engine design was vibration-free at all speeds.

Peerless was an early adopter of the aluminium block engine in 1923. Its corporate bulletin touts the Peerless Equipoised 8 as an ideal police car 'so fast (that) a 100-mile speedometer was found necessary'.

The motor fan was gear driven (and thus, had no belts to slip or break). Its engine was one of the first to employ a

safety clutch fan and had duel exhausts for greater horsepower.

And, former Pinto owners, take note: Peerless employed a vacuum gas tank (as opposed to the cheaper gravity fed tanks) that meant the tank could be placed in the back under the car for greater safety.

The Peerless also had four-wheel hydraulic brakes, an item not introduced on Ford cars until 1936.

Its dash held the heat gauge easily visible to the driver (an innovation) and a Waltham clock embedded in the dash

(a luxury). And unlike the cantankerous Henry Ford who would allow his customers to choose any colour for their auto "as long as it was black", the Peerless marketing department offered, in addition to the standard Peerless Green with black fenders, an optional choice of auto colours including Peerless Blue, Peerless Lake and Peerless Gray.

For all its innovation, the Peerless was, in other ways, a Neanderthal by modern standards: Its innovative engine rested on a wooden frame to which its tin skin was attached. (Adams says that Ford went to all metal chassis in 1931.)

Luxury has never come cheap, and the 90-degree V-type Eight-69 retailed in 1927 for around \$3,595. Compare that with the more plebeian Fords, which were retailing for about \$500.

Although Adams acquired his latest Peerless around 1990, he began serious work on it last November and estimates he has about five more months before completion. He does all the bodywork in his own shop, sending some of the more advanced work such as chrome plating to specialists.

His Peerless is currently receiving its last coat of acrylic primer before receiving its final body coat.

Adams admits that in spite of owning two Peerless autos, he is on the lookout for a third, the Holy Grail of Peerless collectors, the Roadster convertible.

Somewhere out there, there is a survivor of this primordial line of babe-magnets, just waiting.

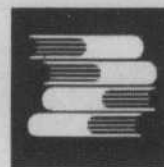

## A Star Called Henry fails to shine

*Roddy Doyle's latest novel is long on historical reality and violence, but short on characterization*

Roddy Doyle, known for his novels chronicling modern Irish life and his 1993 Booker prize-winning novel 'Paddy Clarke Ha Ha Ha' has turned his hand to a historical novel.

While 'A Star Called Henry' shows promise with its rollicking beginning, the book becomes weighed down by the violence and destruction during the time of the Catholic rebellion and the war of Independence. Character development takes second place to the inexplicable and inescapable carnage.

No doubt this is a point Doyle sets out to make - that passionate motives like loyalty and freedom easily take a back seat to greed, revenge and manipulation during war.

The book, however, struggles to

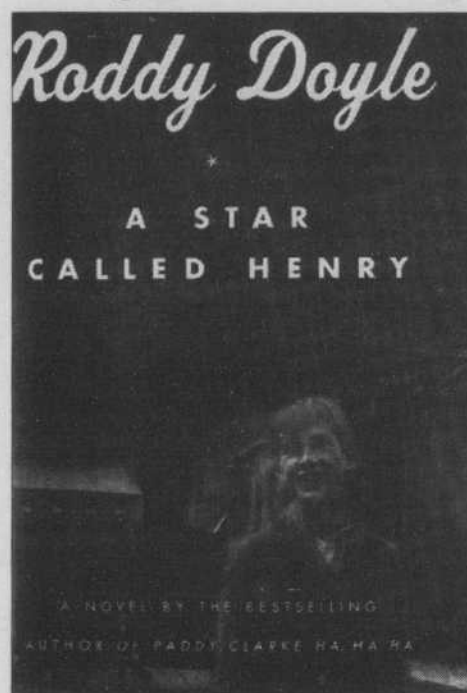
achieve the right balance and tone. The novel starts off on a grand scale with Henry Smart (of song and legend) being born to Melody Nash, old before her time, and named for his dead younger brother.

The loveless 16-year-old Melody Nash meets up with Henry Smart Sr., a drunk propping his leg up with a shovel, (having misplaced his wooden leg) when she accidentally knocks him over.

Melody decides that the filthy, vomiting Henry is not a bad looking sort. Pathetic but nonetheless amusing, Henry tells Melody: "It was my good one too, he said. - Your good one? - Me Sunday leg."

Melody wipes the vomit off Henry's face and proceeds to take a walk with him. Henry Sr. makes his living as a bouncer at a whorehouse and whacking people to death with his wooden leg.

When Henry Jr. is born, he's a huge baby and a huge boy, often mistaken for being much older. Henry and his younger brother Victor scrounge around the streets of Dublin trying to make their way. Befriended by a school-teacher named Miss O'Shea, Henry and Victor are taught to read for a couple of days before being thrown out of the school by the headmistress.



After Victor dies of consumption, Henry has a series of adventures that involve him with the Irish Republican Army and a number of relationships with older women, in-

cluding Miss O'Shea who eventually becomes his wife.

The book moves uneasily between the larger-than-life tone, historical reality and sentiment. The older women who use Henry including Miss O'Shea never become likeable to the reader's mind. And the violence drones on.

Only Granny Nash, Henry's bibliophilic grandmother who exchanges information for books by women authors, really comes to life.

Perhaps with a sharper lighter tone, a shorter narrative and a few well-drawn characters close to Henry, the reader could get a foothold on the narrative.

The reader eventually tires of Henry Jr. smashing heads in with his departed father's leg and of his chummy exploits with characters who seem to pop up out of nowhere and depart just as quickly.

Still, Doyle is capable of a wry turn of phrase and some trenchant satire. Unfortunately, the inexorability of Irish history threatens to engulf the novel.

## Dark secrets

**Some Deaths Before Dying**

English writer Peter Dickinson has been called a master of the mystery genre, and his latest novel, *Some Deaths Before Dying*, does not disappoint.

Rachel Matson lies paralyzed and bedridden when her son Dick confronts her with some disturbing news. A dueling pistol, one of an antique pair Rachel bought for her husband Jocelyn in the 1940s, was spotted on the Antiques Roadshow, brought in by a mysterious woman. The question is: how did the pistol end up in a stranger's hands?

Dilys Roberts, Rachel's dotting nurse, helps Rachel sort through countless old photographs and gets in touch with old friends in order to solve the mystery. Colonel Jocelyn Matson was a

Japanese POW, and survived horrifying conditions in a camp along with many of his fellow soldiers. When he returns to his wife Rachel after the war, he is a broken man with secrets he cannot share. When a strange young man visits her, Rachel discovers that Jocelyn has developed a dark side while being in the Japanese camp. She holds on to her marriage, however, and the reader finds out that Rachel has her own dark secrets to hide.

With the help of Sergeant Albert Fredricks, now an elderly man with a failing memory, Jenny Pilcher, his nephew's wife who now has possession of the pistol, and an antique dealer, Rachel pieces together the puzzle of the pistol's disappearance. Dickinson's take on the mystery genre is refreshing; the characters are more realistic than typical mysteries, such as those of Agatha Christie.

Dickinson's style is more complex than that of other mystery writers, such as in this pas-

sage, where he describes Rachel's attempt to recover memories: "Buried memory, unconsidered for decades, can't simply be dug up, unpackaged, and laid out for inspection. After such a span in the earth, though the shape may still be plain, the individual parts will at first be unrecognizable, compacted, clogged, corroded, some of them of stuff too transient to endure, others readable after careful cleaning...All the essentials she was sure of, though parts she knew to be reconstructions - sequences of minor events, the actual words of a conversation - but even these didn't merely ring true but were flecked here and there with the gleam of metals that burial doesn't corrode."

Solving a mystery can be satisfying, while at the same time causing painful memories to be dredged up and exposed. *Some Deaths Before Dying* is a fascinating look at the psychological implications of a mystery.

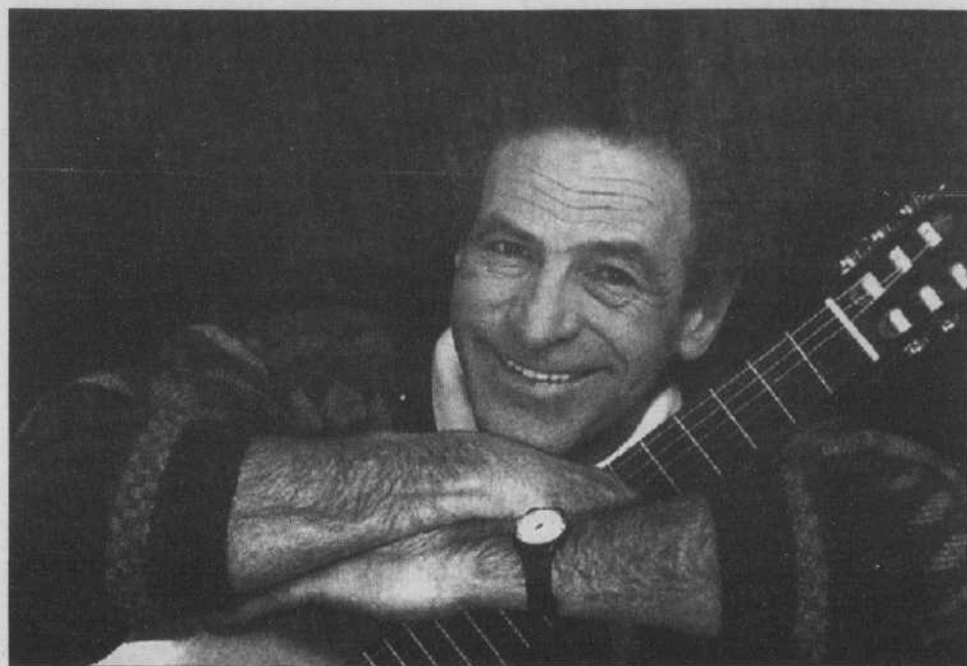

# Director delivers honest look at world of dance

## Center Stage shows the blood, sweat and tears

It's the end of a long day of rehearsals. A young dance student wearily removes her ballet slippers and discovers that her feet are bleeding.

Many audience members encountering this moment in the new movie *Center Stage* refuse to believe that it could happen in real life. They're convinced the filmmakers are exaggerating. But these moviegoers are wrong.

"Dancers' feet bleed all the time," says director Nicholas Hytner. "Their feet are a total mess. A dancer I know in London once explained to me what dancing on point feels like. She said it was like having your toes permanently crushed by two bricks."

*Center Stage* opens Friday after several weeks of wildly successful previews throughout North America. Although its main purpose is to entertain, the famed British director also believes it has succeeded in accurately depicting the world of the young dancer in all its triumph and heartbreak.

"The whole aim was to do it as an entertainment piece, hopefully for as broad and as young an audience as possible," Hytner says by phone from London. "But I also think that what these dancers do is so extraordinary and so admirable. I find it so moving. I hope that what we have done is to make it exciting for moviegoers who would never imagine they might be interested in dancing."

But Hytner, an internationally renowned stage director whose body of work ranges from Shakespeare to Miss Saigon, also wants audience members to understand the staggering degree of dedication and sacrifice required for a career in ballet.

Hytner's movie output includes *The Madness of King George*, *The Crucible*, and *The Object of My Affection*. He's reached the point where he could work full time in film, but he emphasizes that will never happen. In fact, he finds something off-putting about a lot of movie actors.

"I need to go back to the theatre all the time. I could never leave the theatre, especially after this movie and working with all these dedicated, committed dancers. It made me realize that the important thing is to work as much as pos-

sible with people who have a vocation rather than a career." Then he adds tartly: "Movies are full of career people, not vocation people."

Hytner finds something special and unique about young people who take up dancing fully aware of a physical toll so immense that they frequently have to hang up their dance shoes by the time they're 40.

"It's a degree of commitment and a degree of selfless pride and a degree of determination to be good for its own sake that is completely foreign to the kids who hang around L.A. waiting to be movie stars. It's a completely different kind of life. I think there's so much chaos and so much importance attached to fame and fortune - yet none of these people are after that."

Hytner was prepared to wage battle with Columbia Pictures to ensure the right tone for a film that follows the fortunes of a group of young dance students and the countdown to the crucial performance day which will determine whether they win a place in a major ballet company. Hytner shunned conventional young movie actors for these roles and instead opted for genuine dancers with acting ability. He admits going the star route might have ensured better box-office. He also says that to get his way he had to do a selling job on studio bosses.

"They were extremely nervous over the way I wanted to cast the film, and they fought me about it, but in the end they totally supported me. From their

point of view, it was an enormous step to take - to cast a film like this entirely with dancers who have no movie profile at all. But I felt there was no point for me to cast actors who didn't know what dance entailed."

Hytner says that without outstanding young dancers, he would never have been able to bring off the two new ballets - one choreographed by Broadway's award-winning Susan Stroman, the other by New York City Ballet's Christopher Wheeldon - which form the film's climax. However, he also found it personally stimulating to work with the likes of youthful American Ballet Theatre superstar Ethan Stiefel and 21-year-old Amanda Schull, who has just landed a job in the corps of San Francisco Ballet.

"If you talk to any of the dancers in this movie, they're not doing it for fame and fortune. They have a very demanding, almost austere view of the high standards to which they aspire. They want to be good because they have both an instinctive and in some cases an intellectual idea of what's good. Maybe they can't describe to you what a perfect balletic line is, but they damn well know one when they see it. And they risk serious injury all the time."

Dance injuries are part of the world depicted in this film. So is the ruthlessness of a selection process that sees too many young aspiring dancers competing for too few professional places.

He cites the case of Schull's character, a dedicated young student named Jodie who lacks the right foot and body

structure. A more conventional script, anxious to fulfil the fantasies of audience members, would have her triumphing and making it into the company against all odds. This doesn't happen in *Center Stage*.

"I've worked intimately with dancers throughout my career. Once you set up the idea that there's something wrong with your heroine's body or feet, it would be inconceivable to me that these problems would mysteriously disappear and she would make it into a ballet company that disapproves of her body type in the first place.

"These things don't happen in ballet companies. They have to be brutal."

That's one reason Hytner insisted on some major script revisions. "It would have been a lie to have ended the film with Jodie actually making it into the equivalent of the American Ballet Company."

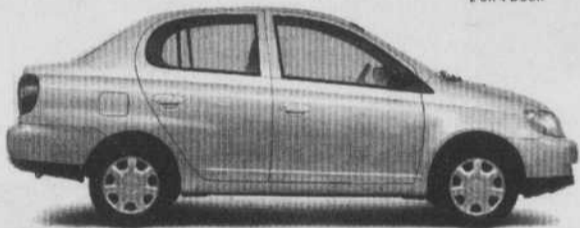

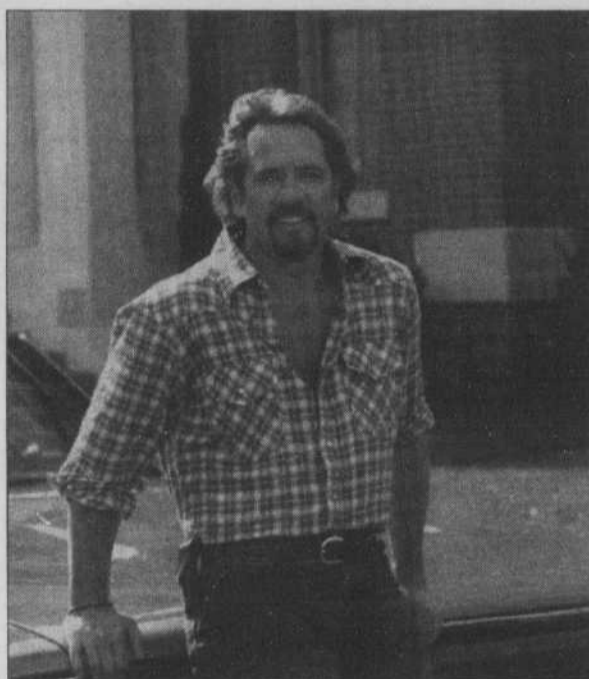
