THE BAZAAR TRIAL.
 PARIS, October 9.—The Bazaar court trial to-day the reading of Mr. Rivier's report was continued. His evidence showed that the means of communication between Metz and Paris were simple. Bismarck's only thought of maintaining the field was criminal. The Marshal is accused of pursuing a policy by which the enemy would be led into the hands of the French army, and that he had been refused to assist in an effort made to provision Metz. Bismarck's intention is said to have been to prevent the secret negotiation with the enemy. Whatever Government there was in France he should have been told of the existence of the overtures of the enemy, receiving their agent, and plotting the restoration of the Empire by the means of maintaining the army in good condition to play the political part he designed. Had Bismarck been told of the existence of the overtures of the enemy, he would have been able to defend himself with the garrison, which could have been used to the advantage of the French army. The trial is expected to continue for some days.
