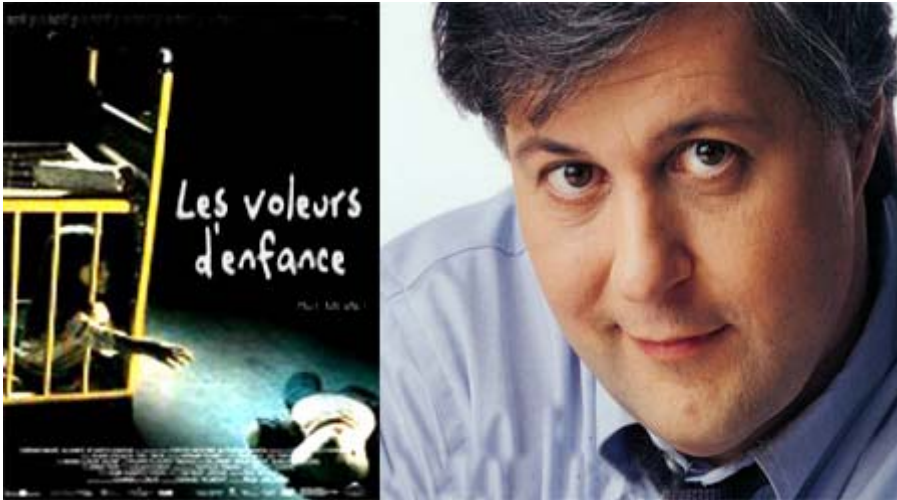
Gilles Vigneault the artist

The foreword is signed by Hubert Reeves and is coedited by the Editions the Archipel from France and by Édipresse of Quebec. The book of 400 pages, including 16 pages of photographs, will be launched here to Quebec at the time of the Salon du livre de Montréal next November. Gilles Vigneault is one of the great poets in Quebec who marked the French-speaking culture. In all, more than 50 songs albums were produced over a 40 years career. 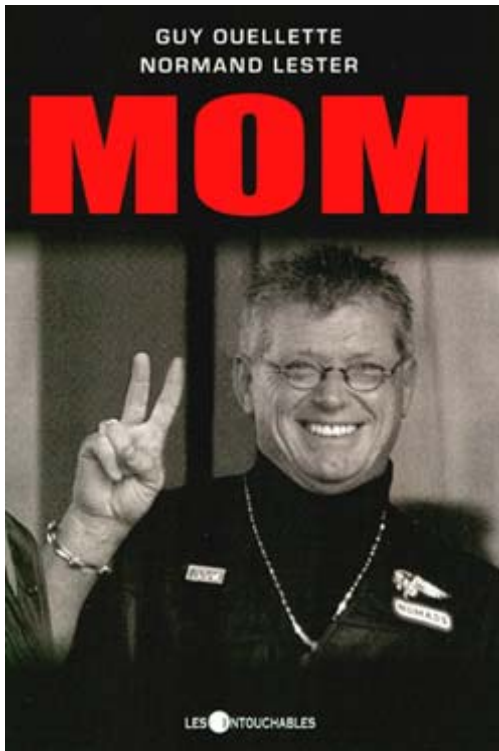
Paul Arcand and the children

The Symphony Orchestras in Quebec

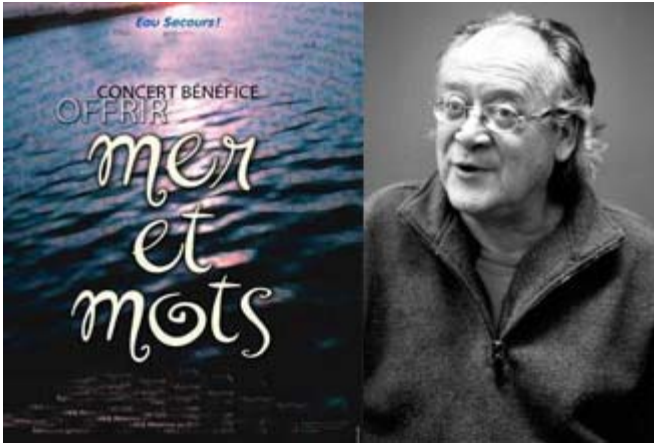


The Symphony Orchestra of Longueuil
