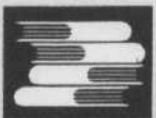

Touring exhibit settles down

Sherbrooke museum exhibits Visages et paysages until Jan. 5

As the hectic holiday period draws ever closer, there is a world of contemplative calm and peace at the Musée des beaux-arts de Sherbrooke, where the some 50 drawings and a few oil paintings by Frederick Simpson Coburn will return as part of *Visages et paysages* (Faces and Places) starting Nov. 30.

The touring exhibition, organized by the Museum, was previously presented at the Stewart Hall Art Gallery in Point-Claire and the Musée Laurier in Victoriaville. After Jan. 5, the Coburn collection will move to the Pulperie in Chicoutimi from March 5 to June 20, and later in Sept-Îles.

"We took it back for Christmas. During the post-impressionist exhibit, we found that people went all through the museum, and a lot of them discovered Coburn," notes Lise Boyer, director of communications at the Museum. "We had planned to have the exhibit anyway. It was unanimous with visitors to the museum."

Born in 1871 in Upper Melbourne, Coburn found recognition in English Canada for his depiction of winter scenes in later years. He was educated abroad, and returned to Canada in 1913, at which point he established a studio in Melbourne. While there, he worked for 40 years, and was made a member of the Royal Canadian Academy of the Arts in 1920.

Polenta's potential is phenomenal

Some of the world's best dishes are those made with minimal ingredients. Polenta is a delicious example. In fact, the ingredients are so simple you initially wonder what there is to get excited about.

According to the Dictionary of Italian Food and Drink, polenta, an Italian culinary staple, translates into English to mean "cooked cornmeal." After reading that, I could see many cooks turning the page because cooked cornmeal does not exactly conjure up the mouth-watering images of Italian delights such as prosciutto, white truffles or gelato.

But trust me, polenta has plenty of potential once cooked to perfection and combined with complementary ingredients.

Polenta was born when corn was introduced to Italy in the 16th century. The cornmeal made from it was used in a variety of dishes that began with boiled cornmeal that might be served as porridge; baked and cut into squares; grilled or fried; or served in any of the aforementioned forms as main-course, side dish or pasta course where it is used as a base for meat sauce, mushrooms or other ingredients.

That's quite a range of use - more potential than pasta or rice - and it has broadened over the centuries as cooks in and out of Italy, in fine dining establishments and home kitchens, have worked polenta into appetizers, salads and desserts.

Basic polenta might sound simple - cornmeal, water and salt - but there's

an art form to transforming those ingredients into perfect polenta. In Venice, they say, it should be like silk and have an almost glossy finish. It's also a bit of a workout.

To make it white or yellow, fine- or (most commonly) coarse-grained cornmeal is added in a slow, gentle stream to boiling, salted water. Most Italian cookbooks say you must stir the mixture constantly during this process and throughout its 40-plus minutes of cooking time to ensure the polenta is lump-free.

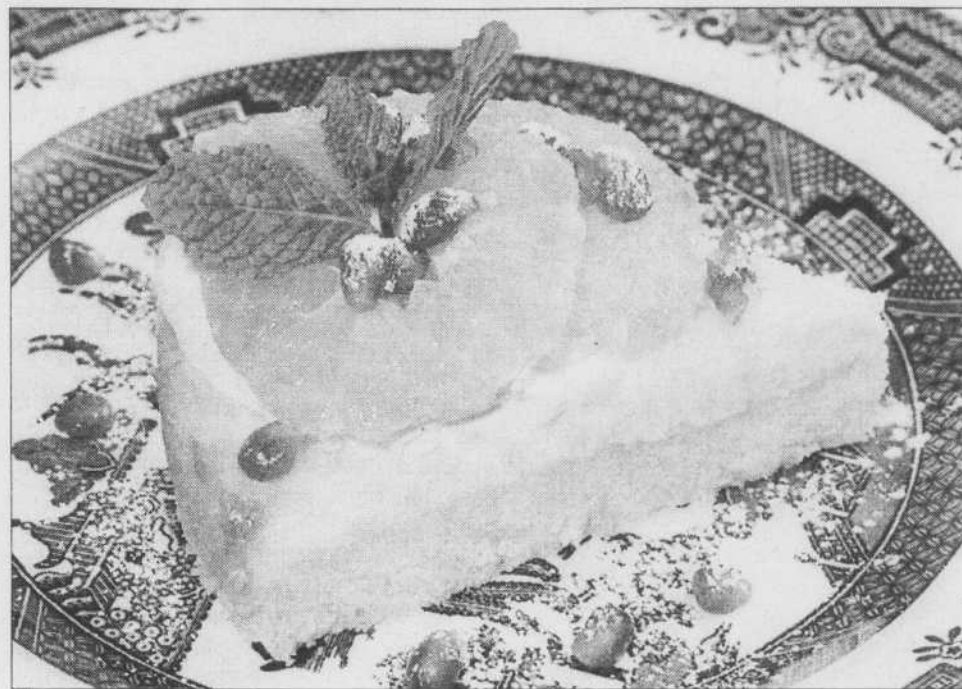
That's a lot stirring, especially for a modern-day cook on the run. But in *The Classic Italian Cookbook*, famed Italian food writer Marcella Hazen gives your arm a bit of a break.

She writes: "Some traditional Italian recipes tell you to stir polenta for an hour or even more. But with a modern stove this is completely unnecessary."

Hazen goes on to say that 20 minutes of steady stirring after all the cornmeal has been added will produce absolutely perfect polenta. Hazen says the polenta is done when it tears away from the sides of the pot as you stir.

Another book, *The Food of Italy*, sort of agrees, saying that once stirred well in the beginning you can leave the polenta to gently bubble away, stirring it every few minutes to prevent it from sticking, until it is cooked. But the book still suggests, as do many others, 40 minutes of cooking time.

There's a big difference between 20 and 40 minutes of stirring. I attribute it to the type of pot you use to cook the polenta.

I speak from personal experience. If you use a thin-gauge, low quality pot, which I used years ago when I was a poor apprentice, the polenta would take longer to cook, since I had to use a very low temperature to ensure it would not burn. But when I made it for this article in a heavy-gauge pot that beautifully held and evenly distributed the heat, the polenta cooked up more quickly, in about 25-30 minutes, since I could have the heat a little higher.

If you don't have the time or the arm strength to make polenta in the traditional way, there is a solution: buy instant or quick-cooking polenta. It cooks up in anywhere from five to 15 minutes, depending on the brand, and produces polenta that is good, but in my estimation not quite as good, as the made-from-scratch variety.

If you're in a total rush you can also buy cooked polenta, which is sold in tubes ready to slice, heat and eat. Both of these products can be found in Italian and European-style delis and some supermarkets.

Plain old cornmeal can be found in just about any store that sells food. This week I offer several ways to turn it into palate-pleasing polenta.

Once cooked, this basic polenta can be served on its own with grated Parmesan cheese, melted butter, chopped fresh herbs such as basil, coarse salt and freshly cracked black pepper. It can also be served as a side

dish and is particularly nice with meat sauce, stews and braised dishes. It can also be used in a variety of other ways. See below for some of the possibilities.

POLENTA TART WITH MANDARIN ORANGES AND POMEGRANATE SEEDS (Serves 8)

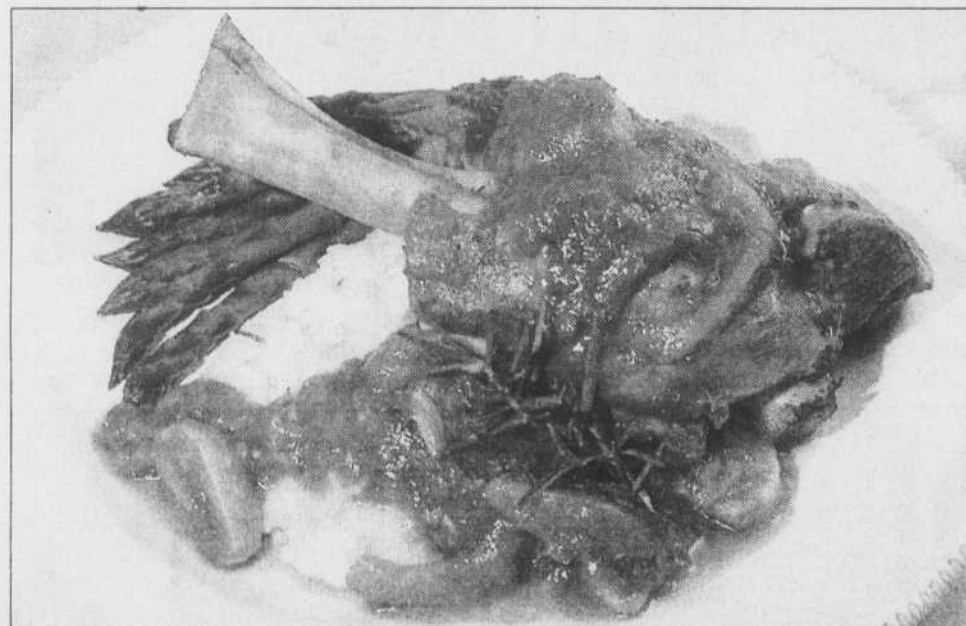
1 cup (250 mL) mascarpone or cream cheese, at room temperature
1/4 cup (50 mL) butter, at room temperature

1 cup (250 mL) sugar
1 1/2 cups (375 mL) milk
1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) vanilla
1 1/2 cups (375 mL) cornmeal
1 teaspoon (1 mL) finely grated orange zest
1 cup (250 mL) whipping cream, whipped and sweetened to taste
Mandarin orange slices and pomegranate seeds
2 tablespoons (25 mL) icing sugar
mint sprigs for garnish

• Preheat oven to 325 F (160 C). Beat cheese, butter and sugar until light. Whisk in milk until mixture is lump-free. Stir in vanilla, cornmeal and zest.

• Pour mixture, which will be quite runny, into a tight-sealing, lightly buttered, 10-inch spring-form cake pan. Bake 55-60 minutes, or until golden on the edges and set.

• Cool to room temperature and then unmould. Top wedges of tart with a spoon of whipped cream. Top whipped cream with slices of orange and pomegranate seeds. Dust with icing sugar, garnish with mint and serve.



If you're cooking for a garlic lover, serve Braised Lamb Shanks with 10 Cloves of Garlic and Rosemary Parmesan Polenta (pictured below).

Hardest working musician earns his title

You would think bluesman Duke Robillard doesn't like his home. The veteran musician plays some 250 concerts a year, spending a mere three months in Rhode Island. And his time spend at home is done recording albums or producing work for others in his home studio.

It's a hectic schedule that he modestly explains he chose to take on because otherwise, it would betray the dedication and passion he has for his craft.

"Music is my life. I produce for several artists for about three to four a year now," said Robillard, who will perform at the Granada Theatre in Sherbrooke Tuesday, Dec. 3. "I hardly have any time to myself

"I could be on a plane writing on a vomit bag, on napkins in restaurants. I have these things in my file, and later I

might refine them and turn them into a song."

Robillard said he first discovered blues by way of his brother's vinyl recordings.

"I discovered the blues because my brother, who was 10 years older, was listening to records in 1954 for the birth of rock n' roll. At the age of six, I would listen to both sides of my brother's records."

After high school in 1967, Robillard followed his passion for blues, forming the group Roomful of Blues. Since then, he has been involved in numerous solo projects.

Many awards and accolades have been presented to Robillard for his outstanding work. He won Maple Blues Awards in Canada, awards in France and most notably the W.C. Handy Award, the Grammy of the blues.

In 2000 and 2001, he was awarded the honour of Guitarist of the Year and nominations for Blues Band of the Year and Blues Album of the Year.

Despite working for nearly four decades in the music industry, there is a down-to-earth air about Robillard. He loves his work, consistently striving to do the best, and has, in no uncertain terms, garnered many fans from his most recent recording *Living with the Blues*.


When asked what was in store for the live performance in Sherbrooke, he explained there were variations in their style to suit a number of tastes.

"We have jump music and swing, blues music and R&B. Whatever your pleasure you will find it," concluded Robillard.

Sounds to soothe the savage beast

Post mortem premature for Cochrane's career

To quote an overused, but appropriate cliché, "It's not over until the fat lady sings."

Sitting in his Oakville, Ont home with wife Kathy and two kids, Tom Cochrane pays no notice to critics pronouncing the time of death of his 20-plus year music career.

In fact, he's never really paid attention to the acclaim or disdain that has splashed magazine fronts since his early Red Rider days.

It's a reflection of the real Tom Cochrane; a storyteller turned musician with small town blood in his veins, and a career that, once mapped out on a line graph, resembles the Rocky Mountains.

It's a humbleness only found in a Canadian musician who's gone from driving taxis to topping music charts, only to draw inspiration from it.

That's not to say Cochrane isn't a fascinating interview. On the contrary, the

down-to-earth singer/songwriter nearly made the fatal mistake of taking up journalism soon after moving to the Toronto area as a teenager.

Add that to countless interviews over the last two decades, and he's a veteran when it comes to these things.

Lately, Cochrane is busy promoting the November release of *Trapeze: The Collection*, a two-disk anthology accenting his Red Rider days and early '90s solo fame. But in talking to the Canadian rock icon, it's clear he's not so much interested in capitalizing on another best-of collection. Instead, he's focused on the album's underlying message: It's not over yet.

"*Trapeze* is not so much a reflection as it is a new beginning," admitted Cochrane in an interview with *The Record*. "It represents a new phase that also takes care of business with Red Rider. We're trying to say that we're not wrapping things up. It's not over."

But for Cochrane, it almost ended before it began. After releasing a largely unnoticed, acoustic rootsy debut album, entitled *Hang On To Your Resistance* in 1974, Cochrane's music career took a back seat to mounting bills. As a result, he went from driving cabs and hauling paint cans in Toronto, to crewing on fishing boat in the Caribbean to washing dishes in Los Angeles.

It wasn't until a friend took Cochrane to Toronto's beloved El Mocambo in 1978 that he met Red Rider, then made up of bassist Jeff Jones, drummer Rob Baker, keyboardist Peter Boynton and steel guitar player Ken Greer.

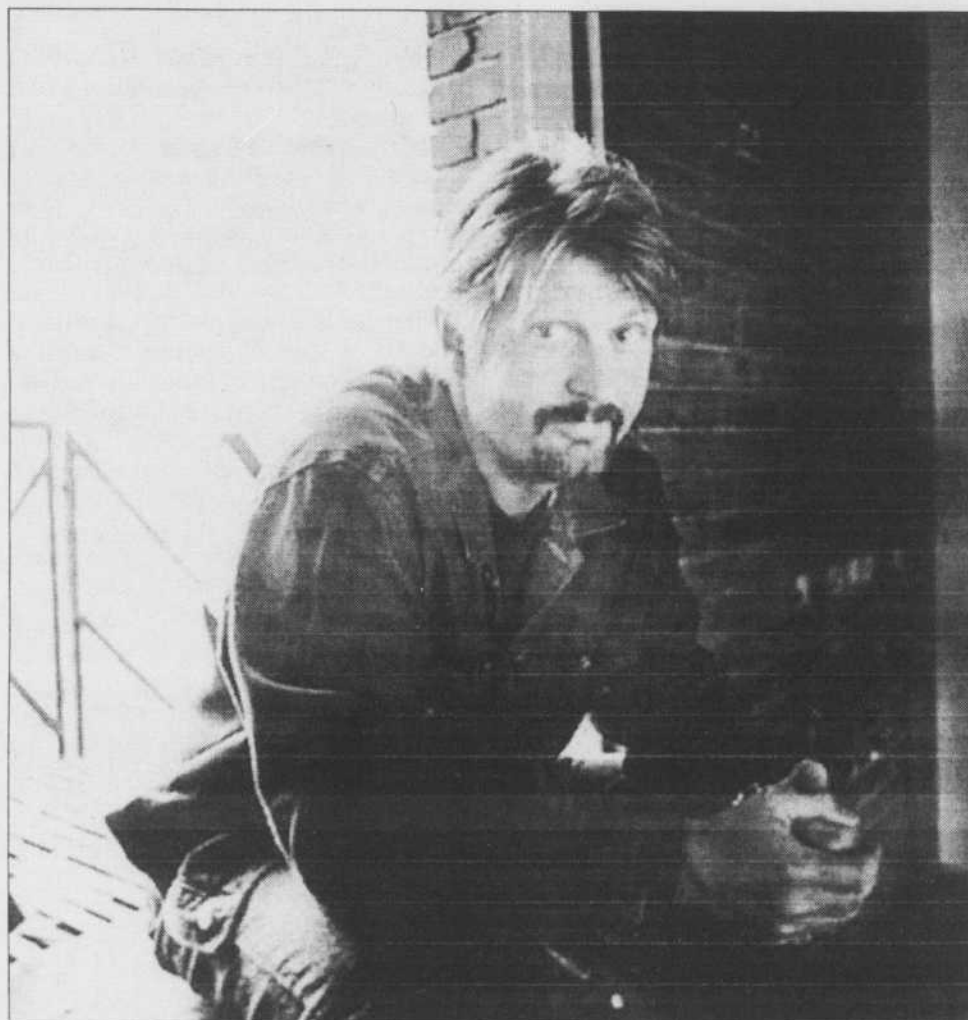
Now, 24 years after first joining forces with the quartet, and 14 years after the subsequent break up, Cochrane said the decision to get together again to re-record material for *Trapeze* was easy.

"Sometimes you have to go back to find yourself," said Cochrane. "The many phases of the group is thanks to the human condition. It means sometimes we are not always happy with the present, and are constantly looking to the future."

"(*Trapeze*), however, gives listeners a chance to listen to stuff from Red Rider they otherwise couldn't. It draws a tether between Red Rider and the Mad, Mad World of Tom Cochrane."

The 30-song album includes an assortment of Red Rider classics, notably 'White Hot', 'As Far As Siam' and 'Power (Strength in Numbers)' and the critically-acclaimed 'Lunatic Fringe'. It also contains seven live performances, and two new singles, highlighted by 'Just Like Ali'.

Debuted during the CFL Eastern semi-final half-time show in Toronto, which included a tribute to Muhammad Ali, the new atmospheric blues single was in-

spired after Cochrane witnessed both his father and Ali struggle with Parkinson's disease.

"It's a bit like B.B. King meets Beethoven. It's lyrically strong, and is meant to show that we are inspired by heroes to make contributions," he said, adding that sales from the single will benefit Parkinson Society Canada.

"It says we are not limited by the frailty of our bodies."

The new single also falls in line with Cochrane's characteristic Canadian folk narrative style. Born in Lynn Lake, Manitoba, and later growing up in southern Ontario idolizing folk icons Gordon Lightfoot, Leonard Cohen, Joni Mitchell and Neil Young, it's no wonder Cochrane's music continues to reflect the classic isolated storyteller figure that his predecessors made famous and he perfected.

"I feel much of my music is timeless, or I try to make it so," said Cochrane. "I'm not really concerned with sitting down and writing a hit. I'm more concerned with stories and lyrics that can touch people. My informing is the journalist in me—

it's important to make people not feel alone.

"It's also the common thread between all the musician I grew up listening to. They are poets before musicians. I subscribe to the theory that music is only as relevant as the person who sings it. You have to be able to stand by your work. If you don't, the work is meaningless."

And despite many of the songs from *Trapeze* being born out of the early to mid 80s, Cochrane said he believes they continue to translate well today.

"It's good to have a platform for traditional songs. They are sometimes forgotten in our disposal society—that tradition is important. That's what *Trapeze* is."

"I've always wanted to create music that is not outdated in a year. I want songs that will stand the test of time."

So more than two decades after finally making it big, does Cochrane believe the sweet is never as sweet without the bitter?

"Absolutely! Life is never as good without the bitter," said Cochrane, laughing. "As a songwriter, it's always important to funnel the bad into songs."

New program to connect performers to wider audience

How are you going to get relatively conservative theatregoers to try something new?

That was the question facing members of the Réseau Centre in Richmond, a group comprising 18 theatre and concert promoters of the Estrie, Mauricie, Chaudière-Appalaches and Centre du Québec regions who book talent in the area's performance venues.

Among the various halls appear all sorts of diverse, interesting shows. Great for variety, but how does a potential viewer know what quality to expect?

After all, this area, while rich in culture, is not exactly a hotbed of household-name talent. And when the only information available about these relative unknowns is biased promotional mumbo jumbo, why take a chance?

Searching for something to jack area residents out of their La-Z-Boys and into theatre seats — to exchange their remotes for show tickets — the Réseau's promoters put their heads together and came up with one of the oldest promotional techniques in the book — the money-back guarantee.

What may at first sound like a plan to send promoters searching for their shirts is actually a well-conceived de-

sign. While some performers are known commodities who will naturally attract a crowd, promoters have to round out their season, often with artists they strongly believe in and want to expose to as great a public as possible.

To guarantee this onstage 'talent' an audience, they guarantee the audience some talent.

"It's to get people to venture out to

see shows of little known or misjudged artists, and with no risk," explained Dominic Chamberland, press agent for the 100 % Garanti program.

All the performances they promote with the policy "are great shows they're confident in guaranteeing," she said. "If someone isn't happy with the show, they can get their money back."

All a dissatisfied audience member has to do is present him or herself at the wicket within 30 minutes of the show's end, leave their contact infor-

mation and the reason they didn't like it.

So far this season, the policy has only been applied to two shows in November. Chamberland said very few customers took advantage of the scheme, and audience response was, as expected, good.

Chamberland said it is important to underline that it is not the artists who are putting themselves on the line, but the promoters. The artists have already been paid for the guaranteed gig.

Guaranteed to wow the audience tonight is flutist Ron Korb. Since graduating from the University of Toronto's classical music program, Korb has traveled widely, collecting more than 40 different flutes.

His last album, *Celtic Heartland*, featured collaborations with Loreena McKennitt and the groups in Riverdance and Lord of the Dance. Lorb's music has been featured in *Dances with Wolves*, and he was selected to compose the theme song for Toronto's 2008 Olympic bid.

Korb will play the Richmond Arts Centre tonight at 8 p.m.. Tickets (\$15) and information are available at 819-826-2488.

Tomorrow night's performance at the Waterloo Cultural Centre (441 rue de la Cour) is also guaranteed. Cuban Carlos Placeres will appear at 8:30 p.m., singing lyrics filled with humorous and poetic social commentary over both traditional and contemporary rhythms of samba, bossa nova, jazz and blues. Information is available at 450-539-4764.

The guarantee will next apply to shows in March. Until then, all shows will be buyer beware.

Foo Fighters are back with a vengeance

One By One
(RCA/BMG)

It didn't take long for The Foo Fighters to rebound after the disappointing 2000 release of *There is Nothing Left to Lose*. Led by some phenomenal writing by Foos frontman Dave Grohl, *One By One* is faster, harder and taps in on the group's previously unexplored '70s influences. From electro pop to through-and-through rock, the two-disk album/DVD represents the quartet's comprehensive self-searching over the last several years. At times, the Fighters' rugged vocals and soaring guitar riffs

are reminiscent of classic Led Zeppelin (i.e., 'Lonely as You', 'Disenchanted Lullaby'). In other instances, the group's unwavering guitar rock sound sets them in a league alongside today's best post-grunge outfits. Add to that the album's profoundly emotional lyrics that touch on love and commitment through singles like 'All My Life' and 'Low', and the Foo Fighters have one of the more complete rock albums in years.

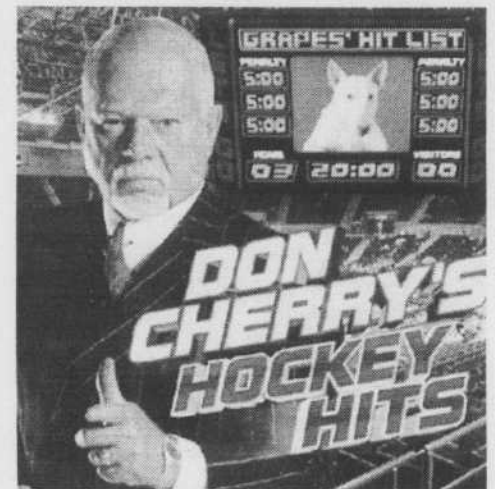

Hello Lisa

American singer/songwriter Lisa Loeb is back following a five-year layover

between albums with her third disk, entitled *Hello Lisa*. Despite the time off, however, her characteristic dear-diary sound is unchanged. Loeb first made waves with the Grammy-nominated independent single 'Stay (I Missed You)' on the soundtrack to *Reality Bites*. Now, with *Hello Lisa*, she has returned to her roots by signing with Artemis Records to gain the flexibility of an independent label. What else would you expect from a pop storyteller born out of the mid-90s Lilith Fair movement? On *Hello Lisa*, the Dallas native co-wrote all 11 songs, and is joined by a host of songwriters and producers, including Randy Scruggs, Dweezil Zappa, Glen Ballard and Peter Collins. She also co-produces the album with Zappa, and infuses it with free-spirited, hippie-like sonnets one would only expect from an artist like Loeb.

Whatever the reason, the young singer has released his debut album, entitled *Justified*. It's interesting how producer Lou Pearlman is the man behind Timberlake's album, as well as the Backstreet Boys Nick Carter's timely solo debut. More entertaining still, these two are on the same label. So why the competition? Market share and promotions aside, Timberlake manages to put out a pretty sweet pop record, and can hold his own with a nice vocal range. Musically, there are a variety of tracks with assorted styles. Hardcore fans will have already sold their soul for the album. It is hard to take him, seriously but "if you give (him) that chance to be a man," then maybe you'll be surprised.

The Morning After

Back in the day, she was a young Canadian songstress collaborating with others to bring her skills to the public eye. Several years later, it's a similar story, but Cox now has two more albums to her credit, and has moved to the U.S. Her latest disk, entitled *The Morning After*, includes a collection of pop vibes tinged with hip hop and R&B elements. Cox has come a long way since her mid '90s debut — her sound today is more refined, and is reminiscent of the Toni Braxton style. The lyrical content on *The Morning After* may be similar to her early material, but is modified for today's radio-friendly format. Highlighting the package is the single 'Like I Did' and the touching love sonnet 'Play Your Part'. With the bonus album of remixes, this makes it a must buy for anyone needing a pleasant candy floss sound for their party.

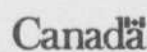

Christmas show is a trip down memory lane

As the magic of Christmas slowly invades our world, the third edition of the musical revue 'La Magie de Noel' (Christmas Magic) presented at the Cabaret Box Office in Drummondville continues until Dec. 31.

La Magie de Noel offers a repertoire of Christmas music performed in numerous different styles — from traditional to blues, jazz, swing, gospel, hip hop and classical. The show is a trip down memory lane, visiting different eras and countries at Christmas time.

"Over 60 per cent of the show is different from our 2001 edition," said producer and director Jonathan Guilbault.

"Songs have been replaced or are done in a different way. This gives a chance for people to realize that Christmas music, even if we refer to old standards can sound different."

Guilbault should know — he listened to more than 2,000 songs to select which would be included in the extravaganza.

From a Christmas Eve visit in a cabaret to time spent celebrating a Victorian Christmas with its beautiful costumes, the production will take you back in time and around the world.

This year's production is much slicker, with new choreography and a few artists have joined the ranks of Paris Paris. Two young singers — Julie Bedard and Valerie Cardin — are now part of the cast that also includes Cassiopee, who was this year's winner at Le Festival de la chanson de Granby.

Marie-Pierre Guilbault who started with the group when she was only 15, and Mathieu Gauthier, the only male singer in the group, round out the cast.

La Magie de Noel features six singers, six dancers, seven musicians including a brass section and a violin player and to link the numbers, a talented comedian.

"Our strong point is all the vocal talent in the group and it is fully exploited"

said Guilbault who didn't think, when he created La Magie de Broadway (a regular show presented in the summer) four years ago, that everything would expand so quickly.

Paris Paris was actually performing in Quebec at The Capitol last week-end to a full house.

"We are not really equipped to put the show on the road yet but we managed to transport over 300 costumes. The worst is to carry the hair pieces because some are rather extravagant" explained communications director Marie-Pierre Simoneau, who joined the troupe shortly after the first edition of La Magie de Broadway.

Simoneau laughed remembering how La Magie de Noel came to life.

"A radio host here in Drummondville announced that after its huge success, La Magie de Broadway would surely have a winter sequel titled Magie de Noel. We weren't really ready for that but we liked the idea and decided to go ahead and do it," she stressed.

"The problem with us is that we love show business; getting involved with huge projects without realizing what kind of work it represents. But once it has started and since we are perfectionists. We worked extremely hard to deliver the merchandise" she said.

Both Guilbault and Simoneau said they are already working on the next Magie de Broadway.

"Our shows are different each year and it's imperative for us to come up with new staging, new songs, new musical arrangements for the songs that we keep," said Guilbault. "We are actually working at a whole new concept for a future show."

With each new success, the director and artists of Paris Paris come back, more confident and more in control. They have also released a studio-recorded CD which includes 40 songs from the show. The album will be on sale after every performance.

For two-and-a-half hours, the audience will get lost in the magic of Christmas through a string of excellent performances enhanced by some extremely tight harmonies, breathtaking, glittering stage costumes and original choreography executed by talented dancers.

Nobody misses a beat, there's not a dull moment, the whole show rolls like a ball of fire. There's a lot of heartwarming moments brought by wonderful renditions of 'Ave Maria', 'White Christmas' and 'O Holy Night'.

The stage setting has been kept fairly simple to leave as much space as possible for the dancers to evolve while a lot of emphasis has been placed on the cos-

tumes to recreate precisely the era and the style we are visiting.

The average age of the cast and directors ranges between 16 and 25 years old. Most of them are music graduates or are still studying in the music department of the Drummondville CEGEP.

Guilbault and Simoneau see Paris Paris as a preparation stage for those who would like to make show business their trade and life. They also agree that if they can help any of these artists to go further, they will.

Coburn's works continue to have an incredible scope — they are regularly published in numerous magazines including Harper's New Monthly, McLure's, Monthly Illustrator and Scribner's.

From novels and biographies to cookbooks and beyond, there's nothing like a good read

In the War Room brings reader to the table

During World War II, Winston Churchill's command centre was dubbed the War Room. Following the events of Sept. 11, 2001, President George W. Bush established, with his senior advisors, such a decision-making apparatus. And it's fascinating to learn more about it.

Washington Post's legendary investigative and political journalist Bob Woodward frequently offers excellent insight into the power plays in Washington and his latest book is no exception. In "Bush at War", he brings the reader into the meeting room with those who helped shape the course of the war against terror-

ism and the operations in Afghanistan. The author also offers the reader an opportunity to understand the influence and positions of the major players in that war.

Through the pages of this book, we encounter the rapid and brilliant efforts of CIA director, George Tenet, to start ground operations in Afghanistan. We also meet his assistant, the shrewd and colourful Cofer Black, the head of the Counterterrorism Centre. All in all, "Bush at War" portrays the CIA as extremely proactive, while the Pentagon had difficulties coming out with a plan after 09/11. On that matter, Defense

Secretary Rumsfeld had to push to get something done, while Director Tenet didn't have to whip his subalterns into action. The reader also discovers that Donald Rumsfeld and Colin Powell are anything but close allies and friends.

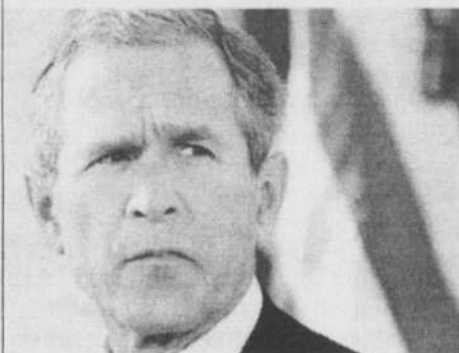
Woodward also presents the different aspects of this war, such as the impor-

tance of keeping a broad coalition, the public relations effort and the need to present this war as a liberation - not an invasion - of Afghanistan, among other things.

The author points out that President Bush was the first to come up with the proposal to drop food - and think about humanitarian efforts - towards Afghan people. When he raised the idea, the President apparently caught his collaborators off guard. And it was not the only time. At some point, he asked who would run Afghanistan, after the dismemberment of the Taliban regime. Around him, nobody had addressed that. Thus, Woodward writes that Condoleezza Rice "most awful moments were when the president thought of something that the principals, and her in particular, should have anticipated."

While it is often

said that President Bush is not a micro-manager, Woodward offers the reader an opportunity to encounter another vision of the 43rd President of the United States. In the war against terrorism and the Taliban regime, the president insisted on being well-informed about the various details emanating from the different operations. We also realize that President Bush was, most of the time, the one getting impatient and calling the shots. At the beginning of his mandate, the author notes, there was a "widely held view that he was a lightweight, unconcerned with details, removed, aloof and possibly even ignorant, and that would have to be dispelled. He had much work to do." President Bush did his homework. In the planning and execution of the war against terrorism, he was there to ask questions, formulate propositions and, ultimately, make decisions. Woodward's book is there to prove it.

One of the invaluable contributions of Woodward's book is it sheds light on the role and importance of Bush's senior advisors. Colin Powell, Dick Cheney, Donald Rumsfeld, Condoleezza Rice and George Tenet - just to name the principals - have been major players before and since 9/11. Thus, it's important and interesting to read about their rivalries and strategic stands since there was not always agreement on the course to follow.

For those interested in knowing more about the way foreign policy decisions are actually made in Washington, "Bush at War" is essential reading. Once again, Woodward has produced a great piece of political journalism.

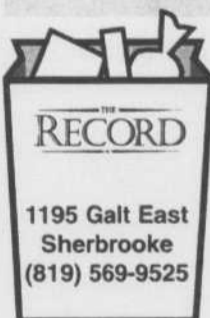

Extreme Ops is fun without thinking

Extreme Ops is about a group of extreme sports athletes who go to the Austrian Alps to film a commercial, only to discover the dreaded war criminal Slobodan Pavlov and his destructive plan.

Sports adventure film has its share of adrenalin

Amazing things happen in *Extreme Ops*, an extreme sports adventure that zooms down snow-covered mountainsides with all the energy — and much of the motivation — of an avalanche. Some of the other amazing things are the script, the direction and the acting.

However, if you're out for as much fun as you can have without thinking, *Extreme Ops* does have its share of adrenalin.

It's the story of a group of extreme sports people who go to the Austrian Alps to film a commercial. While there, they discover that the dreaded Serbian war criminal Slobodan Pavlov (talk about your dogs of war) is not dead like everyone thinks, but is in hiding, waiting for the moment when he can blow up that Belgian courtroom and thus escape justice.

Before you can ask, 'huh?', there are lots of extreme sports to paper everything over, even if director Christian Duguay — a man who is a stranger to the words "fear" and "comprehensible" — makes even the exciting action sequences into a mish-

mash of dangling ropes, hands grasping at rocks, and people shouting directions from everywhere.

You're never sure where anything is in *Extreme Ops*, or why it's there, which takes away a bit from the excitement. But it's fairly certain that there is a whole lot of stunts going on.

In fact, 178 stuntmen were needed to do all the vertical snowboarding down mountainsides and wild snowboarding attached by rope to a speeding train and ski jumps in front of helicopters and jumping from a cable car down to a cliff, and a frighteningly authentic-looking run down the slopes just ahead of a rumbling avalanche, a sequence that recalls the centrepiece of *XXX*. In fact, it does it one better: the *Extreme Ops* avalanche does not have the computer-generated look.

As for the rest of it, *Extreme Ops* is

the most arbitrary adventure of the year, and it stops so abruptly that the audience should be given seatbelts. Just when the big excitement gets rolling, it's over, just another example of the Duguay technique of sudden stops and starts, separated by whirligig caprice.

It starts with commercial director Ian (Rufus Sewell) and his partner Will (Devon Sawa) taking their crew to Europe to shoot a sequence for the high-tech video camera they've been hired to sell. They bring along their crew of X-tremers, including hell-bent-for-leather snowboarders Silo (Joe Absolom) and Kittie (Jana Pallaske) and the "World Games" gold-medal winning skier Chloe (Bridgette Wilson-Sampras, a former Miss Teen USA).

Chloe has technique, but will she be able to find the courage to impro-

viser those heart-stopping runs? Well, she is a former Miss Teen USA.

There are a few X-treme appetizers on the way to Austria, like skateboarding on top of the train that takes them there, but *Extreme Ops* keeps throwing in bizarre notes: the grizzled guide who meets them in Austria and has them walk all the way to their helicopter; the conversation at the Austrian hotel about Will's "weenie;" the strange high-tech, half-finished chalet in the mountains where the crew ends up staying, as if they were in a base camp for an assault on Everest.

There is one note that should appeal to Canadian audiences, however. One of the crew complains that the chalet has no cable, no TV and it's freezing cold. "Might as well be in Canada," he says. Nice to know we stand for something.

Wills rides success into Greatest Hits album

Country singer's collection features two new numbers, including the hit 'Nineteen Something'

Riding the success of his four previous albums, Mark Wills has released his first Greatest Hits album.

The collection includes two new numbers, including the hit 'Nineteen Somethin'. Co-produced by Chris Lindsey, the rollicking song perfectly captures perfectly the essence of what marked the decades in which he grew up in — everything from Star Wars and MTV to The Dukes of Hazard and Daisy Duke.

'Nineteen Somethin' is also the fastest-rising hit Wills has ever had in his career. He has always had great reviews, but he's never managed to achieve the fame or as many sales as his peers Toby Keith, Clay Walker or Tim McGraw.

Wills' collection includes his first number one, 'Jacob's Ladder, the tale of a rich girl and a poor boy who's love triumphs. There's also the powerful but sad 'Wish You Were Here',

which is about the pain of losing someone you loved (plane crash).

'Don't Laugh At Me' brings us back to when we were kids — to the lessons we have learnt but have a tendency to forget now that we are grown-up. Wills has the ability to take a song and make it sound so country even when he sings pop material such as Brian McKnight's 'Back at One'. His southern drawl just might be the reason why he sounds so positively country.

The young native from Blue Ridge, Georgia just turned 29 and also celebrated his sixth wedding anniversary. He and wife Kelly have a four-year-old daughter, and are expecting another child next year.

There's also a sixth album in the making, and Wills has more than 100 tour dates, so it is obvious that his career is well handled.

But I think it is time for him to be a little more adventurous with his music. Wills need to go one step high-

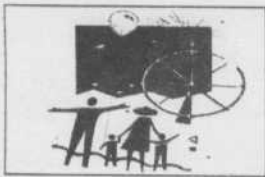
er, and I think his fans are ready to follow him and support him as he takes new directions with his music. Don't take me wrong, I don't mean that he should stray away from pure country, just spice-up everything and try new avenues.
