New Vintage to perform in Waterloo

The Townships Bluegrass and Old Tyme Music Society will host a concert featuring the North Carolina bluegrass band New Vintage on Tuesday, March 23 at 8 p.m. at the Waterloo Canadian Legion at 77 Lewis Street. The evening's opening band will be Older Vintage, featuring local bluegrass artists.

New Vintage, formed by mandolinist Russell Johnson and lead guitarist Earl Lewellyn in 1989, performs a mix of traditional and original bluegrass music. The band of North Carolinians has won two international band championships, released four recordings and performed at festivals and concerts throughout the U.S. and Canada.

New Vintage appeared in the 1995 International Bluegrass Music Association's Fan Fest and has had two top 10 albums.

Band founder Russell Johnson plays mandolin and sings lead tenor and vocals. He has been described as "among the most promising of the bluegrassers who will take the music of Bill Monroe into the next century" and his original songs can regularly be found in the Bluegrass Top 30 charts. Earl Lewellyn, a multi-instrumentalist from Walnut Cove, N.C. plays lead guitar and provides harmony vocals. Jody King, a champion banjo player from Winston-Salem, N.C., is also an accomplished guitar player and harmony vocalist. Kim Gardner of Franklinton, N.C. provides Dobro accompaniment and has been performing since age 14. James Doncsecz of Pilot Mountain, a veteran of the gospel and country circuit, plays bass.

Older Vintage featuring local artists Bob Fuller (guitar and bass), Larry Comeau (Dobro), Terry Howell (fiddle) and Jeannie Arsenault (guitar) will be the night's opening band. Double feature at the Haskell library

Seeing Through the Garbage

Saturday afternoon, Feb. 27 at 3 p.m. - The Haskell Free Library, Derby Line, Vt., and Stanstead, Que., invites adults and teens to a unique double feature - Luke Thompson's Litter-a-Tour and Bread & Puppet's Cantastoria; Life, 1,2,3.

Born in Charleston, Vt., a graduate of Lake Region High School, Luke Thompson is a young multi-media artist who created Litter-a-Tour after touring for several months with the University of Vt. debating team. They debated 500 schools and came in third in the nation!

What exactly is Litter-a-Tour? Technically, Litter-a-tour is a performance of Luke's thesis, first presented in 1996, when he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts from The University of Vt. But no graduate thesis in studio art has ever looked quite like this one. About the size of a large steamer trunk, Litter-a-tour (also called The Book) is a 45-minute, often funny, devastating monologue exploring Luke's revelations from the dump. If this sounds confusing it is because this is a show that defies description. Luke designed The Book (taller than he is at 6-foot-four) to challenge our assumptions to make us take a second look at things we normally take for granted.

"I want to help people draw some conclusions about the environment we live in," says Luke. "At the same time I hope to spark a positive note that will resonate in the future by offering a way of thinking about our environment that can help people really see through the garbage - to overcome it by seeing through it."

Luke has performed Litter-a-Tour at sBread & Puppet, for a Burlington television station, Flashpoint, and at various local community events. This is the first time he will perform with a French translator!

For our second feature and with the help of ten local young performers, Bread & Puppet's Maria Schumann and Lila Winstead will present Caotastoria: Life, 1,2,3 an old form of theater using a narrator, a chorus and a sheet of cloth to tell a story. They will also perform a mystery puppet show exploring the afternoon's theme - seeing through and overcoming the garbage.

Recommended for adults, teens and children over ten, there is no charge for admission. Plan to come early as seating is limited. There will be semi-simultaneous translation into French. Call 873-3022 or 876-2471 and ask for Miriam or Marie-France for more information.

Grenadine features 20 Canadian bands

Five Townships tunes included on CD

After two years, two releases and a new name, Grenadine Records is rolling with a new CD.

The brainchild of Bishop's student Eric Lapointe and former student Alex Megelas, Grenadine is a streamlined version of the duo's first label, Bittersweet Records. Syrup & Gasoline, Grenadine's first disc, is a compilation of 20 independent Canadian bands, including five from the Eastern Townships.

"We wanted to show our commitment to where we started," says Lapointe. "I'm a Townshippier at heart, and there's tons of talent out here." The Townships bands are Lowbrow (from Knowlton), Jalo-Pea (from Granby), and Les Thanatologues, Les Sequelles, and Les Macchabees, all from Sherbrooke. The disc is the result of two years of effort, starting with Lapointe and Megelas' original plans of creating a seven-inch compilation single.

"The seven-inch was scrapped," Lapointe explains, "so we decided to do an actual CD." The jump from a four-song seven-inch to a twenty-song disc added some complications, but filling the roster wasn't difficult.

"One of the bands on the seven-inch wasn't able to do it, but there were so many other bands willing to be on it that we decided to make a CD."

Now that the CD has finally been pressed and is ready to hit the shelves, Lapointe and Megelas are euphoric.

"It's amazing to finally see it in one piece," Lapointe laughs. "I've seen all the elements before, but there's nothing that measures up to this."

Megelas and Lapointe are no strangers to the music industry - both cut their teeth working for CJMQ 88.9 FM at Bishop's University, and Lapointe is both a DJ at the station and a member of a local band, as well as having released a demo cassette of his folk recordings last year. Megelas is an entertainment writer for Vice Magazine and The Mirror in Montre-

al, and has established a reputation as an indie-rock concert promoter.

The label's plans were advanced when Megelas secured a \$3,700 grant from Emploi Quebec. "Because of that grant, we were able to get Salgood Sam, an artist who has worked for both DC and Marvel comics, to do our cover art," Lapointe says. As Megelas worked on the grant, Lapointe used his skills as a Bishop's business student to create a business plan.

With the help of the Dobson-Lagasse Entrepreneurship Centre, he is now working on a second plan to see the label into the future. "We plan to get a business grant, and then try to put out ten records a year...our dream is to be able to do this full-time." Syrup and Gasoline will be available locally at Jukebox, Musique Cite, and other CD stores in early March.

ArtsSutton hosts Montreal artists in March ArtsSutton will host an exhibition by two Montreal artists throughout the month of March.

Accueil Bonneau choir in E.T.

The choir of the Accueil Bonneau will be in Sherbrooke raising funds for La Chaudronée. This choir is made up of homeless men who were living on the streets of Montreal and who came to l'Accueil Bonneau for meals and occasional shelter. They became much better known when they went to Paris last fall as an inspiration to 'les clochards' of that city.

La Chaudronée is a low cost restaurant offering meals to Sherbrooke to people who couldn't otherwise afford to eat out. In the process, jobs are created, as well as opportunities for volunteers. This benefit concert will be held at St. Patrick's church on the corner of King and Gordon Streets at 8 p.m.. Cost is \$10.

Sculptor/ceramist Naomi Pearl will display her works in clay, metal and glazes. Jackie Cytrynbaum, photographer, will present her recent black and white images.

Their works will be on display from March 6 to March 28. The public is invited to attend the opening on Saturday, March 6 at 2 p.m.

ArtsSutton will host a photography exhibition from April 3 to April 25. Joyce Rapoport will display recent photographic works.

Photographer billiewayne will display pictures from a series of 36 photographs entitled "extracts of SilverBlue".

This series was funded by a grant from the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec. The public is invited to his opening on April 3 at 2 p.m.

ArtsSutton is located at 7 Academy Street in Sutton. Gallery hours are Thursday, Friday and Sunday 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Shania Twain: She's still the one

Shania Twain who has gained international success as a singer/songwriter is without a doubt Canadians queen of country. She will be performing at the Molson Center Monday, March 15, 1999.

The downside of success is the demanding schedule and this is exactly what the country star is experiencing now. She has started the second leg of her two-year tour with shows planned in the States, Canada, Australia and Europe.

Twain's nonstop agenda included a string of TV shows with hosts Rosie O'Donnell, Jay Leno and David Letterman as well as her own TV special on CBS, Shania Twain's Winter Break.

The show aired March 3, and the producers successfully captured what Twain's live performance are all about. Her special guests were two of pop's hottest entertainers - Elton John and the Backstreet Boys.

Twain says she often listens to Elton John's music while and the Backstreet Boys before she goes on stage, because it pumps her up. Her show featured a nine piece band which includes three fiddlers with everyone singing. Energy is the key word, if you need to describe what's going on during her concert.

Twain's two-hour show could also be called a work-out session as she and her musicians are con-

stantly on the move. She has reworked some of the arrangements on certain numbers to permit more action on stage.

When Twain starts singing, people sing along and that's exactly what she wants - direct communication with her fans. She wants them to be a big part of that show, not sit back and observe.

On the other hand, she managed to create a segment in the show that's intimate and acoustic with her sitting as close as she can to the audience. This will be the second time she has performed her top notch concert in Montreal.

At this point, rumours that Twain wasn't touring because she couldn't recreate her big sound onstage, are a thing of the past.

First though, she wanted to have enough material to offer a good concert and this is why she waited well after the release of Come On Over before she decided to go on the road.

Twain launched her first leg of the tour on May 29, 1998, in Sudbury, Ontario - as close as she could get to her hometown of Timmins and treated her fans to a high-octane show with explosions, fireworks, giant video screens, costume changes and lots of her hit songs.

She soon moved to the top of the A-list of most-wanted performers worldwide. Her 1998 tour has been ranked

third of the top country tours by Amusement Business magazine.

Meanwhile, her music continues to clear a path for her on both the country and pop charts. Her single "You're Still The One," is the first record by a country artist to break simultaneously on country and pop charts since 1983's "Islands in the Stream," the duet with Dolly Parton and Kenny Rogers.

Twain now has two of the three biggest-selling albums ever by a country female and with Come On Over still selling, it should soon overtake the album in second place - Patsy Cline's Greatest Hits.

Twain obviously loves her job and Grammy voters love her music. They recently handed her six nominations. She won two Grammys at the Feb. 24 ceremony, both for her crossover hit "You're Still the One."

Recently, Twain graced the cover of Cosmopolitan, which named her "Fun, Fearless Female of the Year." The feature casts the spotlight on her beauty and fitness routine.

For Twain the combination of fitness, diet and beauty is important - and so is a woman celebrating her femininity. As she told interviewers, she refuses to downplay her looks in order to be taken seriously. She has a brain in her head but she's not going to downplay that she's a woman. She wants to be respected for both.

There are still a few tickets left for the March 15 concert so fans can make a reservation at the nearest ticket outlet.

Scenes from a life

Sacré Vie -- What a life! Loosely translated that's the title of an exhibit by photographer Alain Gareau being shown this month at Café Presse Boutique in downtown Sherbrooke.

The exhibit is a reflection of everyday life captured on film by Gareau.

Coming up with a title for the exhibit was hard for Gareau, who says he is used to expressing himself through images, not words.

The title *Sacré Vie*, which reflects both a negative and positive comment on life, seemed appropriate for the bright and gloomy images that reflect society, but don't revolve around a strict central theme.

"My life doesn't have a single theme, and nor does my work," he said, adding the photographs are of scenes that have touched him.

"I wanted to express the beauty that surrounds us," he said, adding he tries to transmit emotions and touch people's hearts.

Some images, like the one of a vagrant rummaging through a dumpster, reflect a less positive view of society. But Gareau's pictures don't moralize. They simply attempt to capture and reveal scenes which others pass by without noticing, he said.

Gareau's attempt to label his current exhibit and his photographs came recently when a literary magazine that was publishing one of his shots wrote and asked him to title it.

"That event triggered everything," he said, adding his decision to search for appropriate titles for each image in the exhibit led to many nights of interrupted sleep.

"I went to sleep and as soon as my head hit the pillow, the titles started coming to me," he said. "One night, it was getting bad, I came up with four titles and I thought, 'This is ridiculous. I have to get some sleep'."

While he had not thought of christening his works previously, he now believes the names add to the photos.

"Each photo is like a work of poetry to me," he said, adding the title adds an extra element which gives viewers a direction and allows them to dream.

Gareau, who divides his time between his passion for still photography and his job as a cameraman for CKSH-TV in Sherbrooke, said it's funny how some events, like the recent publication of one of his photos in *Tableaux* magazine, trigger other events.

Gareau, who has been a photographer for 25 years, said that in 1996 he

considered abandoning his muse. But an extraordinary event spurred him on.

Gareau said he has always strongly identified with renowned photographer Henri Cartier-Bresson, whom he considers his mentor. The work of the acclaimed magazine photographer, who was a founding member of the world-famous Magnum Photos agency, was the first to inspire Gareau.

"His humanist approach is what really impressed me," Gareau said, adding the master photographer really likes people and his photographs often express a comment on society.

"He did photos that made you laugh, made you cry and made you think," Gareau said, adding the best photos are filled with emotion and a reflection of real life.

"It's important to be connected to people."

On a trip to Paris, Gareau noticed Cartier-Bresson's daughter's name on a list of museum curators. On a whim, the artist wrote a letter to be forwarded to his master, telling the aging photographer of his great influence on his work and including a couple of his favorite photographs.

Gareau said he expected little, but to his great surprise Cartier-Bresson wrote back to say he was impressed with Gareau's work and encouraged him to continue. The photographer even included an autographed book of his work.

"It was a turning point for me," Gareau said. "The acknowledgement by Cartier-Bresson confirmed there

was something there. That I had somehow touched something."

While Gareau has always been inspired by the photography of Cartier-Bresson, he said he discovered his own style in mimicking his master. He said the same is true for most artists: He described a recent exhibit he saw in France which showed the works of Van Gogh and his lesser-known master.

"They were identical in method and subject, but after that Van Gogh's work took on his own personality," he said, adding that Cartier-Bresson's influence will always remain alive in his work.

Gareau said that seeking the perfect photo is like a hunting expedition, although he shudders at the comparison and the thought of killing animals.

"You travel, you move around, always seeking a magical instant, a strong moment," he said, adding when he sees something extraordinary, his heart beats quickly as he attempts to seize a forceful image at just the right moment.

Unlike his master, who has a full-time darkroom technician, Gareau enjoys early mornings pattering around in the crimson light of his darkroom, getting the chemistry just right, examining his contact sheets, selecting the right negative and witnessing the image emerge in the developer tray.

"For me the time in the darkroom is a primordial part of the process," he said, describing the portable darkroom that occupied the bathroom of his tiny 3-1/2 apartment years ago.

Gareau, who has worked at a num-

ber of community initiatives from starting a community newspaper to founding a community television station, said humility is an important aspect to his photography.

The self-effacing photographer enjoys the anonymity he has behind the lens.

"If your photo has character and force, it will capture people's attention," he said, taking pleasure in the various reactions to the photos he has hung at the popular downtown café.

"Exhibiting here is a real pleasure," he enthused. "It's like giving birth to little babies."

In the end, it is the strength of Gareau's photography and his commitment to his art that has advanced his career.

On another more recent trip to Paris, Gareau failed to connect with his mentor who was out of town. But Cartier-Bresson wrote him a letter of introduction to a number of top art book publishing houses, including his own publisher Robert Delpire.

Gareau said he believes he has a book in him, but he's not ready to cross that border yet. Besides, he said photographers have to have acquired a certain notoriety before they can expect to publish a book of their work.

But the support of his mentor and advice of the publishers he met inspired him to prepare this month's exhibit and to begin a retrospective of his work to rediscover the images that touched him over the years.

It is yet another event that has inspired further events.

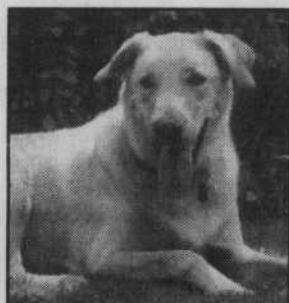

Martin Sheen grateful for the little things in life

*Actor says he's
gone from
despair to
freedom in
just one year*

Martin Sheen quotes from a favourite book, psychiatrist M. Scott Peck's inspirational bestseller *The Road Less Traveled*, to express what he has learned along the way. "Life is difficult and it's supposed to be," the acting veteran says.

"It's quite natural for life to be difficult and once you understand that that's life and it's difficult, it's not difficult anymore, it's life. It's a mystery to be explored, and not a problem to be solved."

Sheen is in Toronto filming *Forget Me Never*, an Alliance Atlantis TV-movie for CBS and CITY about one of the bleakest destinations on life's road - Alzheimer's disease. He plays a man whose wife is diagnosed with the disease.

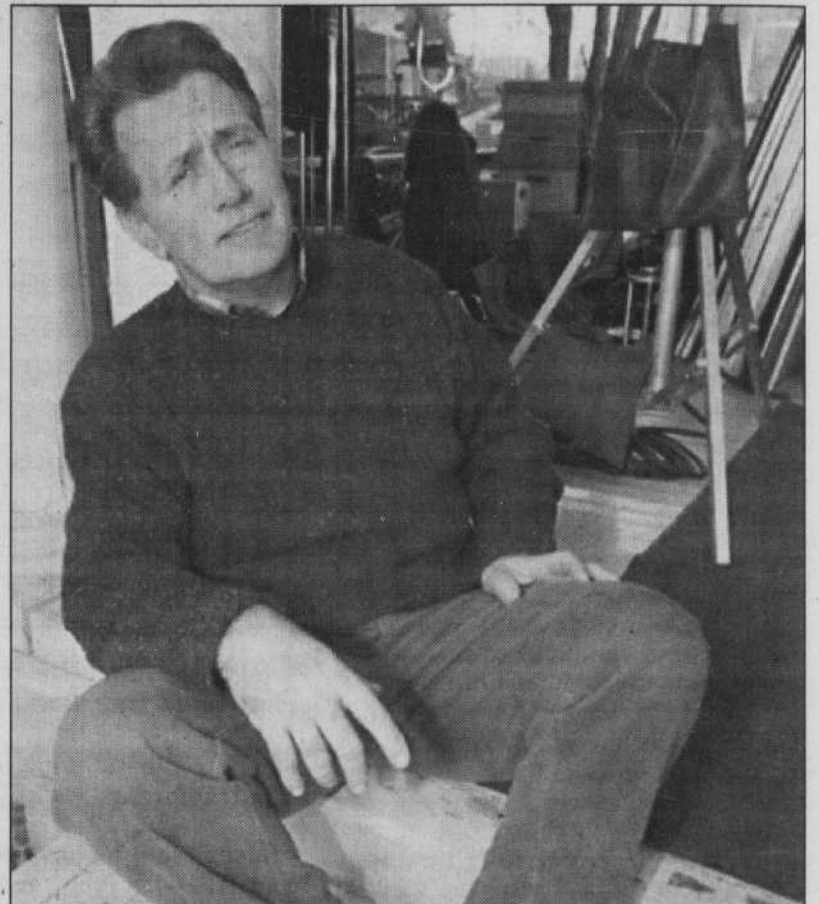
During a filming break at a stately century home near High Park, Sheen's publicity shy costar Mia Farrow slips past.

A member of Sheen's extended family suffered from Alzheimer's - "Heartbreaking," he says of that - but it was the opportunity to play opposite Farrow that convinced him to take the role.

"I adore her. She's one of my heroes," he says.

They appeared together in a 1972 movie-of-the-week, *Goodbye Raggedy Ann*, but didn't get to know each other then.

Sheen knows Toronto like a second home. The Subject Was Roses brought him to the Royal Alex in the '60s. He was back in 1978 for *Taxi!!*, then in 1986 for *The Believers*. Always, he rents a house and a car and makes an effort to get out and about. This time, that meant the first Raptors and Leafs games at the Air Canada Centre, the latter because son Ramon Estevez, an avid

fan and friend of Montreal Canadian Mark Recchi, was visiting.

"That was my third hockey game in my life," Sheen admits. "I still don't know all the rules. I don't know what the lines mean or what all the circles mean - I don't have a clue. It's very exciting stuff, though."

One of Sheen's few on-camera commercials - for a gas station chain promoting a dishware give-away - was also done here. Twenty-six years ago.

"Nothing's free from an oil company except for a bad environment," the anti-pollution activist says of that now.

"I wouldn't do it anymore. I wouldn't do alcohol or any product I don't use."

(In case you're wondering, he does drive a Toyota, the car he promoted for 10 years.)

Ethics play as much part in his career decisions as aesthetics now, although Sheen says that at 58, roles like those in *Apocalypse Now*, *Wall Street* and *Gandhi* are unlikely to come his way again. Tomorrow, he heads to South Carolina to play a basketball

coach in *O*, an adaptation of *Othello*.

"I'm limited by my status and my age, by very large measure. I don't get the big offers anymore. I don't do the big-budget films with big-name directors anymore, studio films. I haven't done one since American President and that was because Rob Reiner just insisted that I do it. He was just magnificent to me and I'm very grateful for it."

Mostly, what Sheen is grateful for is more personal, such as the drug and alcohol rehabilitation of son Charlie Sheen, near death's door after an overdose last spring.

"I was just thinking about the miracles of the past year. Every day should be spent in thanks and praise," he says.

"If I didn't get another miracle the rest of my life, I couldn't complain.

I've been the most blessed, the most blessed, man. I don't even know of anyone as blessed as we have been. We have been, in just one year's time, from despair to freedom. Just extraordinary."

Junos are bigger, glitzier and more Canadian

Celine Dion leads the awards race with six nominations

When Lynn Harvey produced her first live broadcast of Canada's national music awards show 10 years ago, the show still relied on international headliners such as Rod Stewart to draw a crowd.

The Juno Awards would routinely hire expatriate Canadian celebrities such as Rick Moranis to host the show, which was held in front of an invitation-only audience of jaded industry insiders at Toronto's refined O'Keefe Centre (now the Hummingbird Centre).

When Harvey returns after a six-year absence to produce the 28th annual Juno Awards show, airing Sunday, March 7, on CBC-TV, the all-Canadian lineup headlined by international singing sensation Celine Dion will perform before an arena full of raucous paying customers. And the show will be introduced by an exclusively Canadian television personality, CTV's Open Mike host Mike Bullard.

"Now I look back on (that first Juno show) and I think that it was ridiculous," Harvey says. "What were we doing showcasing anybody but Canadians? I think that's just reflective of how much the industry has changed."

Now that the Junos can fill Copps Coliseum in Hamilton, Harvey has dropped the intimate theatricality of her earlier productions and instead is relying on the grander effects of arena shows, including dramatic lighting displays. However, she's more concerned with the content of the show than its style.

"What I'm trying to do this year is just have a lot of music. We have, right now, two, maybe three more acts than

last year," she says.

"The way I have it laid out, every act - from commercial to commercial - will have a performance in it, which I'm really happy about."

In addition to Dion, who leads the awards race with six nominations for My Heart Will Go On, the lineup of performers includes the Moffatts, Colin James and the Little Big Band, the Philosopher Kings and Sloan (nominated for best rock album).

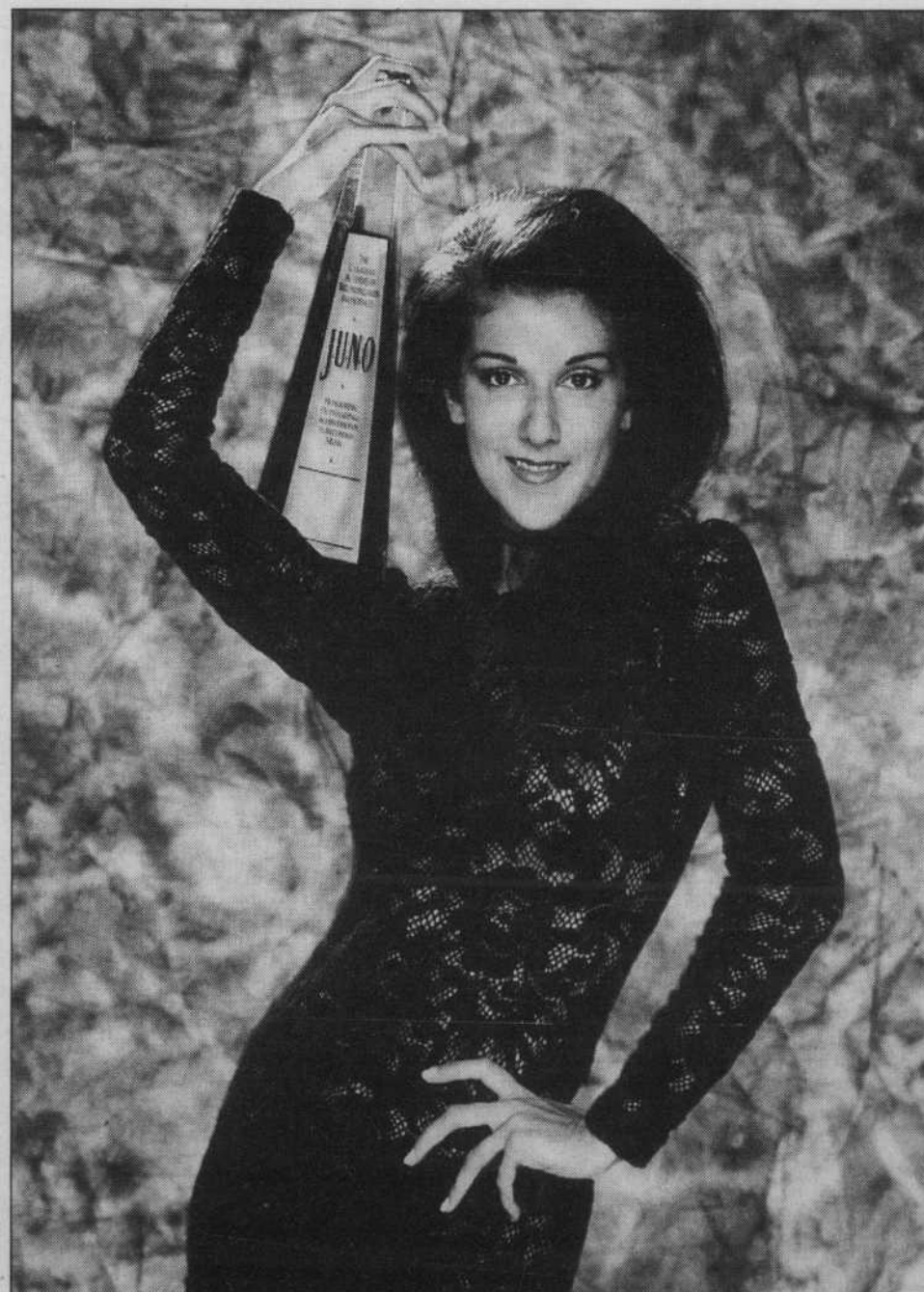
Dion is scheduled to sing one of her hits, receive the Canadian Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences's International Achievement Award and perform in a tribute to this year's Canadian Music Hall of Fame inductee, Quebec composer Luc Plamondon, creator of the 1978 rock opera Starmania and lyricist for the new Montreal musical Notre Dame de Paris.

After the controversy that marred last year's program when the rap group Rascalz declined its Juno in protest over the lack of urban music on the broadcast, this year's show has added a performance by Northern Touch, a collective of Canadian rappers that includes Rascalz.

There is a special performance showcasing a unique pairing, Cape Breton fiddler Natalie MacMaster and flamenco-inspired guitarist Jesse Cook, both nominated for best instrumental album.

"It's always great to see the nominated acts get up there and do their hits ... but I like to try and do something that's like a one-of-a-kind thing," Harvey says.

Last-minute schedule changes scotched plans to have superstars Shania Twain and Barenaked Ladies perform on the show, but, at press time, it looked as if Barenaked Ladies might be available for a brief performance via satellite from Australia.

Marine life in miniature

St-Joachim man keeps maritime shipbuilding tradition alive

Guy Dubois, a professional photographer by trade, has turned his trained eye in an unlikely direction. Dubois builds finely detailed scale reproductions of historic sailing ships from 16th-century Catalonian fishing ships to 19th-century frigates.

His works, which take anywhere from two months to three years to complete, have won awards for their craftsmanship.

"During the last four centuries," writes Dubois in his notes on shipbuilding, "the history of the great sailing ships was caught up in the political game of the great maritime powers and the great commercial currents. While the evolution of technical progress permitted the sailing ship to reach perfection in its many forms, it condemned it to disappear thanks to a newcomer, the steam ship."

Dubois acquired his love for sailing ships during his youth from a grandfather, a French mariner.

During his career as a photographer at Radio Canada and Théâtre Rideau vert, he began to build model ships as a hobby.

"For 25 years, in parallel with my trade as a photographer, I have been making models of ancient sailing ships. I avoided the use of sophisticated tools to keep the techniques of construction such as they were in earlier times, returning to the most rudimentary jeweler's tools," said Dubois.

"Some of these works took thousands of hours of work."

Using a book of scale plans compiled by the French maritime architect and historian Jean Boudriot, Dubois builds his replicas in painstaking detail.

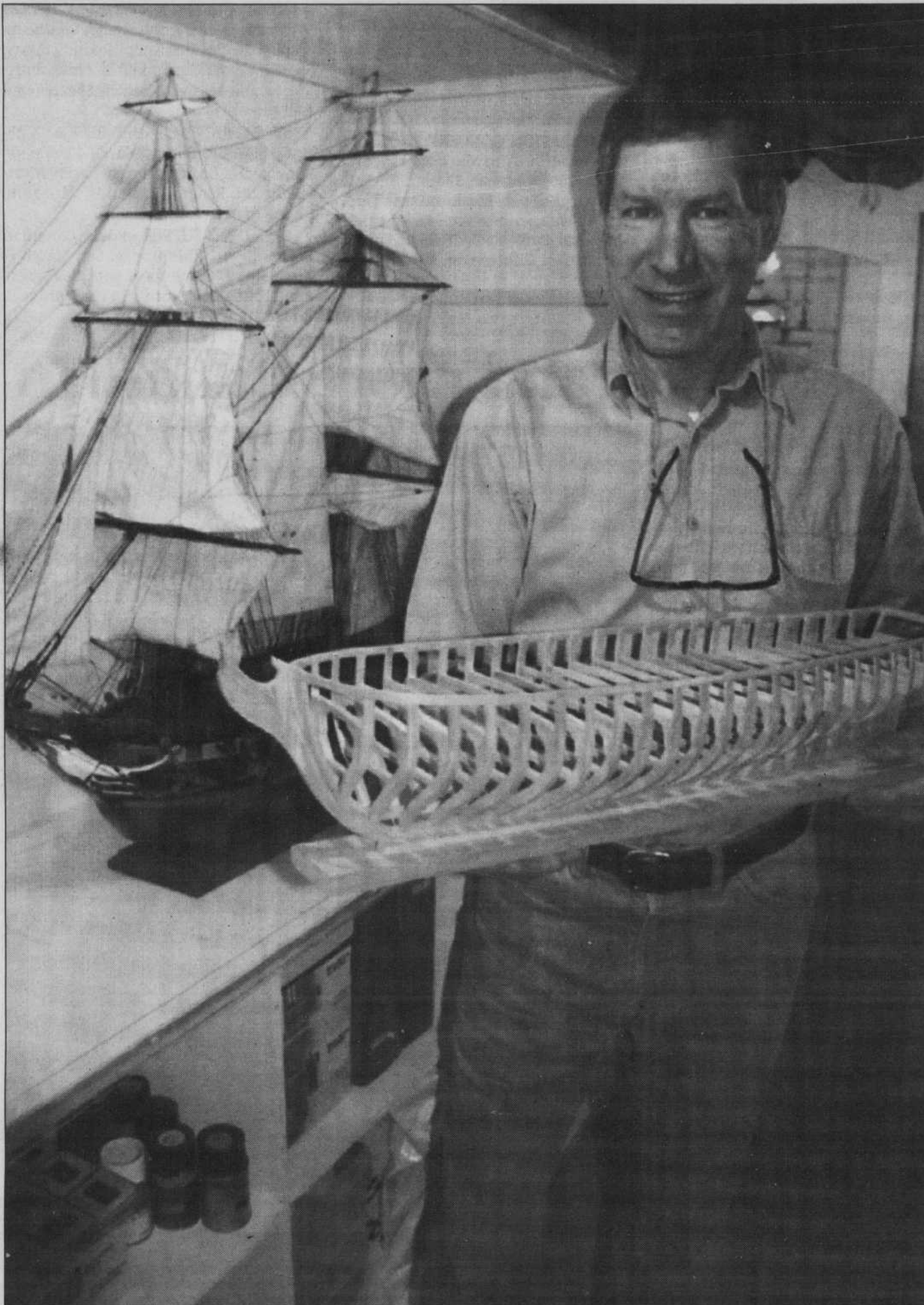
Dubois said that he uses only six types of wood and various metals such as brass, copper, bronze, and iron. Sails are made of cotton and rigging is hemp, flax, or cotton. His reproduction of "Le Cygne (The Swan)" took three years to complete and used over 5,000 miniature nails to secure its metal plates.

Dubois's ships have been on display at the Salon du miniature de Montréal (1989) where his frigate "Essex" received a prize (Meilleure présentation - bateau en bois). The frigate, Le Cygne, and his catalane appeared as part of 1997-98 exhibition "Zoom sur les miniatures" at the Musée de la civilisation de Québec.

Those who wish to own a work by Dubois should know that the price of workmanship is steep: Prices range from \$1,000 for a smaller piece to \$30,000 for the catalane. Yet each piece is unique and destined to be an heirloom in its own right a generation down the road.

Dapper Grant swashbuckles in new Pimpernel

It's a classic role that has attracted thespians as diverse as Leslie Howard, Anthony Andrews and, of course, Daffy Duck.

Now, actor Richard E. Grant erases all competition as he steps into the boots of Sir Percy Blakeney and his daredevil alter ego, The Scarlet Pimpernel, in a new series of movies premiering Sunday, March 7, on A&E Network.

Filmed in the Czech Republic with a supporting cast that includes Elizabeth McGovern as Percy's fiery French wife, Marguerite, and Martin Shaw as the Pimpernel's nemesis, Chauvelin, the visually sumptuous production is noteworthy for playing its story straight, without overt campiness.

Unlike past incarnations, Grant's Sir Percy isn't a grotesquely effeminate fop, but an apparently superficial English aristocrat who hides a secret life: rescuing French innocents from the guillotine.

It was that sense of duality that drew the versatile 41-year-old actor to the project.

"When I read the script and did the research, it struck me that the character is like an 18th-century Batman," Grant

says. "People who have a double life, that the audience is party to and the other characters aren't, are inherently dramatic and interesting."

"I think most people do have a public persona and then a different persona of who they really think they are. This guy who wouldn't seem to harm a fly yet secretly partakes in all this derring-do is something interesting for an audience to watch and for an actor to play."

He was in complete agreement with the creative team that this Sir Percy would be a social butterfly but stop well shy of caricature. Indeed, the relationship between this Percy and his Marguerite is the most passionate yet.

"What, more than Jane Seymour? Traitor!" Grant sniffs, with mock indignation. "I shall tell her you thought she and Anthony Andrews lacked passion!"

He acknowledges, however, that playing the Pimpernel as less of a fop works to his advantage. "Yes, you're right; in order for me or an audience to possibly believe that he could be sexually attractive to his wife or to anyone else, if he's a complete, outrageous hairdresser's assistant, it (just doesn't work)," he says.

Grant knows a thing or two about public image. Despite the fact that he is a gifted actor and an attractive man, his mainstream movies usually find him

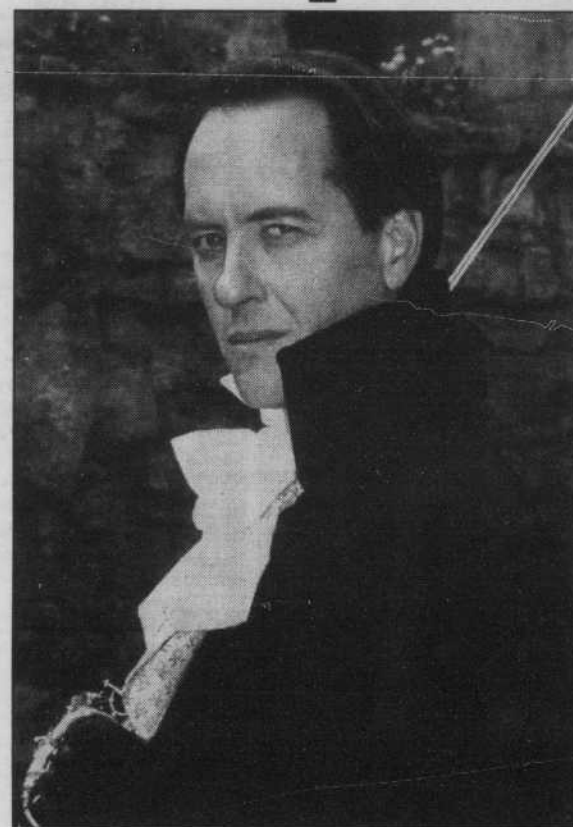
playing, well ...

"Freaks," he supplies, succinctly. "You can say it. Because of the way that I'm built, I've never imagined that I would be playing the roles that Mel Gibson and Arnold Schwarzenegger do. ... But this character, foppish though he may be to some extent, is something that I never really thought I'd get to play."

And he gets to play him in the King's English - no French accents here. Grant says the production steers clear of the comic overtones that have accompanied the British actor-French accent combination since Britain's lowbrow 1970s World War II comedy series 'Allo, 'Allo!

"We briefly considered making the French Scottish, then decided, 'No, that will just offend the Scottish,'" he explains, tongue firmly in cheek. "Finally, we decided, 'Let's just have all these people speak in English.' So that's what we did."

In any language, A&E's The Scarlet Pimpernel is splendid entertainment for the entire family.
