Family's love of music creates a new traditionalist

A duet with grand dad

This time of the year traditions, especially family traditions, are very important in our lives. Tonight at Le Vieux Clocher in Sherbrooke, violinist Alain-François will show how he has taken those family traditions into a musical career.

Born and raised in Victoriaville, Alain-François (he goes by his first name only) recalls those holiday gatherings in which his entire family would gather round and share their love of music. The memory has a lasting impact.

"It was my grandfather who had the biggest influences on me musically," recalls Alain-François. "He was a violinist as well, and during the holidays, my whole family, all of who could play the accordion or violin, or other instruments, would all gather round and play songs together. As I grew up I participated and have continued playing the violin ever since."

Although his grandfather has passed on, it has not stopped Alain-François from continuing to duet with him, as with Alain-François' self-titled first album. It features 'Rosario', on which he and his grandfather both play. "We were able to find a song my grandfather had recorded for a soundtrack back in the day, so I went into studio and we turned it into a duet."

And as Alain-François comes from a musical world of passed on traditions, the very violin he used to play with his grandfather was the exact same one his grandfather had passed on to him years earlier. "It was something really special, to be able to do that."

Duets of the more common fashion — those played together live — are also common on Alain-François' debut album, as he collaborates with a number of musicians including France D'amour, Mara Tremblay, Vincent Gra-

Variations on a turkey

Food

Cook like this

If you must have turkey every Christmas, but the thought of cooking a whole bird does not interest you this year, today I offer three alternatives.

The first option delivers much the same taste as roasting a whole turkey, except you're not roasting a whole bird, you're roasting a piece or pieces of it that will cook up more evenly and are easier to carve.

These are the two key reasons why some choose to go this route. They say, why bother cooking a whole bird, nervously wondering if it's done or not, only to cut it up in the kitchen out of sight of your guests, when it would be easier to cook and cut smaller portions of turkey?

Grocery stores and some butcher shops are more frequently offering these convenience cuts, some of which include turkey breast roast, turkey breast roast rolled and tied with dark meat from the thigh, and whole bone-in thighs, wings and drumsticks.

Boneless turkey breast roast and breast roasts with some dark meat rolled inside require a cooking time of about 30 to 35 minutes per 500 grams.

Bone-in turkey thighs, drumsticks and wings, because the meat is denser and they have the bone, require a cooking time of about 60 to 70 minutes per 500 grams, or a little longer.

As when roasting a whole turkey, there can be some variation in the cooking time for turkey breast roasts and the leg and wing pieces, simply because some roasts and pieces will be thinner, and others will be thicker. No two turkeys are exactly the same, so always use an instant-read meat thermometer to gauge doneness. When cooked, the centre of the meat should register 77C (170F).

My other two alternatives to serving up a whole bird, although they are made with turkey, aren't anything like roast turkey.

I created a tourtiere using ground turkey, instead of the ground pork, beef and veal I usually use. And, although I don't know if my late French Canadian mother would approve of this, I accentuated the spice-filled meat mixture with a colourful mix of dried cranberries, cubes of roasted yam and flecks of chopped fresh parsley. It gave the tourtiere a very festive taste and look — serve it with green beans, roasted potatoes, a salad, and relishes and chutneys.

You can use homemade or a store-bought pie crust to make the tourtiere.

My other turkey dish sees single portion-sized pieces of boneless, skinless turkey breast rolled and sealed inside flaky filo pastry with cranberry sauce, brie cheese and fresh sage. It's a tasty combination that can be made oven-ready hours in advance and baked when you are ready to serve.

Cooking time is 25 minutes, not the three or more hours a whole roast turkey can take.

ROAST TURKEY BREAST WITH A TRIO OF VEGETABLES

The vegetables could be made oven-ready up to a day in advance. Keep them covered in the refrigerator until ready to place in the roasting pan.

Preparation time: 30 minutes

Cooking time: 90 minutes
Makes: 6-8 servings

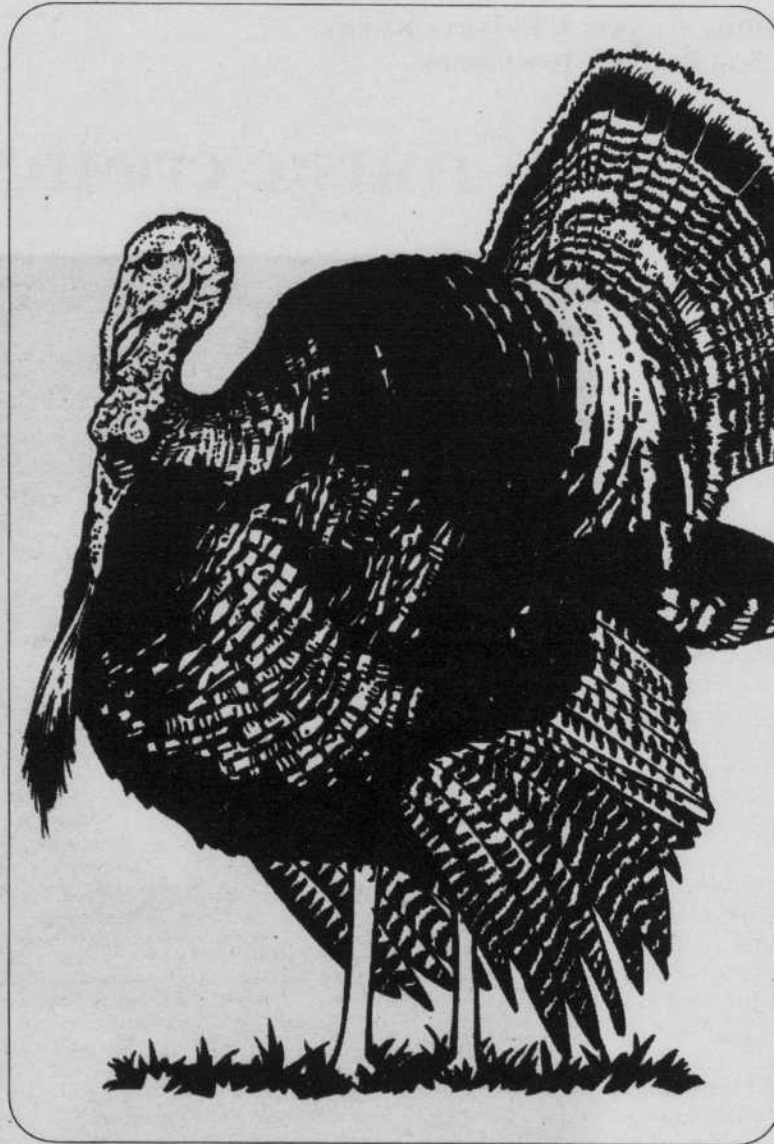
3/4 lb. mini (baby) carrots
2 large parsnips, peeled, halved lengthwise and sliced into 1/2-inch pieces
1 1/2 lbs. Brussels sprouts, trimmed

** salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste*
5 tablespoons olive oil or melted butter

3 lb. boneless, turkey breast roast
2 teaspoons dried, crumbled sage
1/4 teaspoon paprika
3 cups chicken or turkey stock mixed with 1/4 cup flour

Place the carrots and parsnips in a pot and cover with cold water. Boil until firm-tender, drain well, cool in ice cold water, drain well again and place in a bowl. Cook the Brussels sprouts in rapidly boiling water until firm-tender, about 3 minutes. Drain well, cool in ice-cold water, drain well again and place in the bowl with the carrots and parsnips. Toss the vegetables with salt, pepper and 3 tablespoons of the oil or melted butter. Cover and keep in the refrigerator until ready to roast.

Preheat the oven to 425F. Place the turkey in a very large roasting pan (you'll need the added room to add the vegetables). Brush the turkey with the remaining oil or melted butter, and then sprinkle and rub with the sage, pa-



prika, salt and pepper. Roast the turkey 20 minutes, and then reduce the heat to 325F and roast 25 minutes more. Surround the roast with the prepared vegetables. Roast 45 minutes more, or until the centre of the turkey reaches 170F on an instant-read meat thermometer. Remove the turkey from the pan and set on a plate; cover with foil and rest 10 minutes. Spoon the vegetables into a serving dish and keep warm in a 200F oven.

While the turkey rests, drain the excess fat from the roasting pan before placing the roasting pan on the stovetop over medium-high heat. Add the stock/flour mixture and bring to a simmer. Simmer until thickened gravy forms, about 5 minutes; season with salt and pepper. Slice the turkey and serve the vegetables and gravy alongside.

TURKEY TOURTIERE WITH YAMS AND CRANBERRIES

You can prepare the tourtiere a day in advance. Cover and store in the re-

frigerator until ready to bake.

Preparation time: 30 minutes

Cooking time: 50 minutes

Makes: 6-8 servings

1 medium yam
1 3/4 lb. ground turkey
1/2 medium onion, finely chopped
3 tablespoons flour
1/2 cup chicken stock
1/2 cup dried cranberries
1 teaspoon dried crumbled sage
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
** pinch ground nutmeg*

2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley
1 store-bought or homemade (see recipe below) double-crust deep-dish pie shell
** egg wash (1 large egg beaten with 1 tablespoon of milk)*

Preheat the oven to 350F. Prick the sweet potato all over with a fork and place in a small baking pan. Bake until tender, but still slightly firm, about 60 minutes. When cool, carefully peel the yam and then cut into small cubes.

Place the turkey and onion in a pot and set over medium heat. Cook, stirring occasionally to break up the meat, until the turkey is cooked through and no longer pink. Mix in the flour until well incorporated. Slowly pour in the stock, stirring constantly. Cook 2-3 minutes more. Mix in the yam, cranberries, sage, cinnamon, cloves, salt, pepper and nutmeg. Remove from heat and cool to room temperature. Cover and refrigerate until ready to use.

(Filling can be made a day before you make the tourtiere.)

Spoon and pack the filling into the bottom pie-crust. Brush the edges of the crust with the egg-wash. Place on the top crust, crimping the edges to seal.

Brush the top of the tourtiere with egg-wash. Cut a small hole in the centre of the tourtiere to allow steam to escape. Chill the tourtiere 20 minutes in

Hoping for a bright future

Theatre

Chickasaw's aftermath

The final, Nov. 11 curtain on Chickasaw's premiere run at Arts Knowlton was only the beginning for the original musical. Its creators are now hoping it will become a standard for amateur theatre groups throughout Canada, and hopefully the U.S.

"We think a lot of groups will want to try this show; with a cast of 24 it's really perfect for any amateur company — we've had the idea of marketing Chickasaw from the beginning. It would be great to see it done professionally too, but the vast majority of musicals on the professional stage now have only a few in the cast, two to eight, unless it's some extravaganza like Rent," says composer Donald Patriquin.

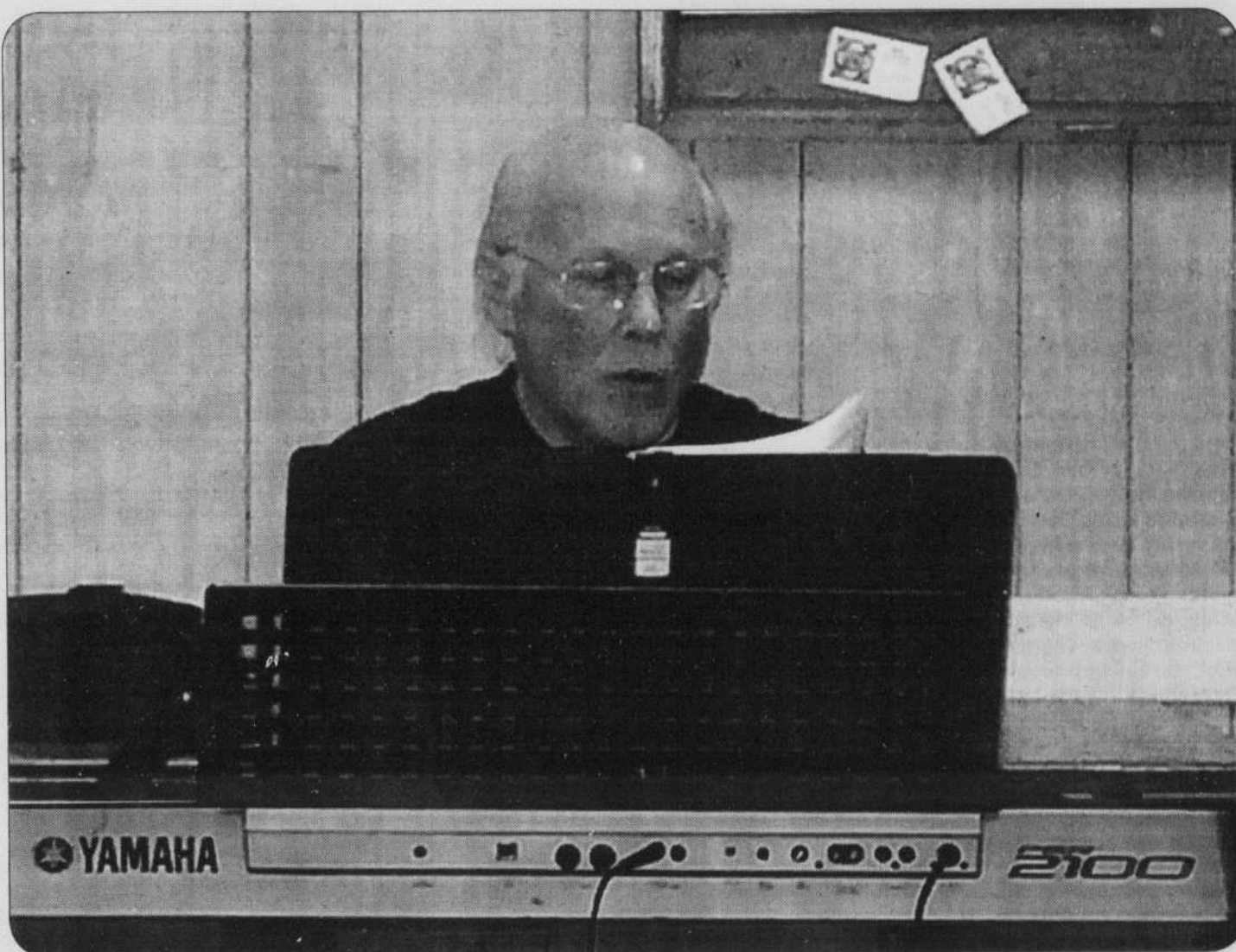
With this in mind the Chickasaw group has produced a DVD, which will be an important element in the promotional package. It will also be on sale to the public at Brome Lake Books (in Knowlton) and Townshippers' Association offices by mid-January (in Sherbrooke and Cowansville).

"Rugge Thompson created a wonderful video of the production, with sound by John Cameron — it is dazzling," says Patriquin. "Video and sound recordings were done over several days, and the resultant DVD is a remarkable blend of the best.

"Every show has its best performances, when everything is just right, tight and perfect — usually the middle Saturday. With Chickasaw it was the final Saturday, and thankfully we decided to video that show as well. We had the DVD produced professionally by Magra Multimedia in Montreal, it's a sophisticated product. You can go into individual scenes as well as play the whole show right through."

Even after the warm reception at Arts Knowlton, Patriquin and playwright Roger de la Mare are planning to further refine the script. "Before the premiere we took the script to the Playwrights Workshop in Montreal. You really need help bringing your work to fruition — you're too close to it, you can't see the obvious. They were a great help, they don't critique, they ask questions — what is happening here? How does this link with the plot? It made us think and be more objective," continues Patriquin.

"As a result I left out three musical numbers I wrote for kids. We were going to have a group of kids in the cast, basically because Knowlton Players traditionally has children in their musicals, they're our future actors and they love being in shows. But we realized that not all amateur groups work with kids, and being and set

during the civil war, there was no real reason to have children — so we dropped the numbers and the kids. Which made us realize what's applauded and loved in Knowlton, might not get the same reception somewhere else."

Yet as helpful as the Workshop was, this professional body is more geared to plays than musicals. "Jim Betts, artistic director at the ScriptLab in Toronto, has agreed to have a look at it, he's written and produced musicals. A seasoned veteran in the field, he will be able to help us polish it for general distribution. Guy Sprung at Infinitheatre in Montreal also agreed to go through a vetting process with us," Patriquin says.

"We've done a lot of rewriting already, lots and lots, and we're expecting to do more. As a composer I am not use to changing things. You write a score, take it to a conductor and either he likes it or he doesn't. With a musical it's different, it's part of a whole. When we start blitzing the country with Chickasaw we want it to be the best it can possibly be."

utes more. Allow the tourtière to set 10 minutes before slicing. Serve, as desired, with your favorite chutneys and relishes - homemade if you have them.

Eric's options: This tourtière, unbaked, freezes well. Thaw in the fridge overnight before baking.

DOUGH FOR DOUBLE CRUST PIE

Here's a rich and flaky pie-crust perfect for tourtière.

3 cups all-purpose flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 1/4 cups cold vegetable shortening, cut into 1/2-inch cubes
1/4 cup cold butter, cut into 1/2-inch cubes.

1 large egg, beaten with 1/3 cup ice cold water

Combine the flour and salt in a bowl. With a pastry cutter or two forks, or with the paddle attachment of your stand mixer, cut the shortening and butter into the flour until a pea-sized crumble forms. Pour the egg/water mixture into the bowl; gently work until a loose, moist dough that just holds together forms. Transfer dough to lightly floured work surface. With lightly floured hands, shape dough into a ball. Cut the ball in half; press each half into 1/2-inch (12 mm) thick discs. Wrap and refrigerate each disc until ready to roll for the tourtière.

PHYLLO-WRAPPED TURKEY WITH BRIE AND CRANBERRY

You can prepare the phyllo-wrapped turkey a few hours in advance. Once rolled and set on the baking sheet, cover tightly with plastic wrap until ready to bake. Consider serving the turkey with a salad of baby spinach or baby greens topped with mandarin orange segments, thinly sliced pears and almonds, all drizzled with your favourite vinaigrette.

Preparation time: 30 minutes

Preheat oven 425F. Bake for 20 minutes. Reduce the heat to 350F and cook 30 min-

Cooking time: 25 minutes

Makes: 4 servings

8 sheets phyllo pastry
1/3 cup melted butter
1/2 cup cranberry sauce
4 slices of Brie cheese, each 3-4 inches long and 1/2-inch thick
8-12 fresh sage leaves (see Note)
4 5-oz. pieces boneless, skinless turkey breast (see Note) * salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

Preheat the oven to 400F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Lightly butter one sheet of phyllo. Top with another sheet of phyllo and lightly butter it. Top with another sheet of phyllo and lightly butter it. Set on one more sheet of phyllo. Cut the phyllo sheets, widthwise, in half. Set a slice of the cheese near the bottom end of each piece of layered phyllo. Top the cheese with 2 tablespoons of the cranberry sauce and 2-3 sage leaves. Top the cranberry sauce with a piece of turkey; season with salt and pepper. Fold the sides of the phyllo pastry slightly over the turkey and then roll into a cylinder.

Place on the baking sheet. Brush the tops of the phyllo with melted butter. (To prevent them from drying out, cover with plastic wrap until the other two phyllo-wrapped turkey are prepared.) Repeat with the remaining phyllo and fillings. Bake in the middle of the oven for 25 minutes, or until puffed and golden.

Note: To get the 5-oz. pieces of turkey required for each serving, I cut 20 ounces of turkey breast steak into 4, 4-to 5-inch long, 2-inch wide and thick, pieces. If you can't find fresh sage, sprinkle 1/4 tsp of dried, crumbled sage on top of the cranberry sauce in each portion of turkey.

ton, Florent Vollant and Julie Lamontagne. While Alain-François' career may be steeped in tradition, his music has grown with the times. "I would describe my style of violin and music as new traditional I guess," explains Alain-François. "Everything we sing about is very new and very Quebec. We sing about the events that happen around us. While the sound of the music still has that traditional feel, we aren't playing songs that we've dug up out of old drawers, these are contemporary songs with themes and stories of things happening to real people today."

Although Alain-François admits that a lot of the music he draws from for

both influence and enjoyment is from the East Coast — the likes of Leahy and Ashley MacIsaac — he says there is something intrinsically Québécois about the stomping and violin combination, a sound he takes to heart, especially in his love shows. "We integrate sounds from country, rock and pop into our songs now," he says, "and the live shows bring even more of that, we make sure that the live shows bring something different from the album, you'll notice when we play a lot of percussion, sometimes all four of us are even playing drums, it brings a really fun dynamic to the live shows."

Alain-François plays at Le Vieux Clocher in Sherbrooke tonight at 8:30, tickets are \$22.50 and can be purchased at Le Vieux Clocher box office or by telephone at 819-822-2102.

things of this magnitude take time, but look at the time we've already wasted over the years. Can we afford to wait any longer?

Before Bali there was the United Nations Development Program's Human Development report, *Fighting Climate Change: Human Solidarity in a Divided World*, which provides a stark account of the threat posed by global warming. It argues that the world is drifting towards a "tipping point" that could lock the poorest countries and their poorest citizens into a downward spiral, leaving hundreds of millions facing malnutrition, water scarcity, ecological threats, and a loss of livelihood.

So here we are, faced with Armageddon and it's our fault entirely. I guess we have to get used to it. The party is over and now it's time to pay the piper and try to get our lives back if we possibly can. Either we start doing more things for ourselves, or succumb to an SOS selling us another device that will ostensibly improve our lives. We need help!

"We are issuing a call to action, not providing a counsel of despair," lead author Kevin Watkins has said of the UNDP report, adding: "Working together with resolve, we can win the battle against climate change. Allowing the window of opportunity to close would represent a moral and political failure without precedent in human history." He described the Bali talks as a unique opportunity to put the interests of the world's poor at the heart of climate change negotiations.

But we're all locked into lives that we've been told to live. Our basements are filled with unused exercise equipment, while big armchairs grace living rooms as an all-important part of life. Vacations? We certainly like to take vacations! How many of us think, as we are being whisked from a Third World airport to a luxury resort, that life isn't all that good for the locals? Comfortably installed in a mini-van or bus, we are exposed to the stark reality of poverty that most people in the world are subjected to, as one shanty town after another whizzes by our passenger windows en route to our dream destination.

This is the disparity of economic growth, which relies on the acceptance of our lives as being the only right way to live. It's the "Me" generation blinded by the light of our forefathers who only ever wanted the best for us. How could we possibly have the wherewithal required to fix the immense problems of the world today?

David Warnholtz, a resident of Lennoxville, understands economic disparity. He has seen it first hand and believes in taking action. "In all of our travels to help out others, from New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina and now to Africa," says Warnholtz, "our experiences have brought us closer to the real reason that we were put here on earth."

Along with four friends, he went to

Louisiana and helped mop up a couple of years back, and now he plans on traveling to Nigeria as part of a group of seven people to dig a well for a nursery/primary school serving 345 children in the community of Ika. The unique thing about the projects he co-organizes is that all participating members foot the bill themselves.

"Not only will it be another voyage of self discovery," he says, "but we will never regret the time and funds spent and we will never relinquish the concept of a reverence for life."

Included in the group of seven besides Dave Warnholtz, who is 50, are Paul Mclean (35), Robert Nutbrown (33), Kay Mclean (65, Paul's mother), Chris Hornibrook (40), Josee Parent (35) and Lukas Warnholtz (17, David's son). They plan to leave on the eighteenth of January, embarking upon a 16 and a half hour flight to the capital of Nigeria, Abuja, where they will catch a five and a half hour ride to Ika.

We don't need to respond to another SOS keeping us helpless and stupid. They don't tell us that their products are made by exploiting poor and desperate people, and ravaging the earth. No, they don't have to. They're protected by laws that they lobbied for or made, because they are in power, ensuring never-ending economic growth.

"Nigeria is an oil-rich country," says Warnholtz, "yet 95 per cent of the country is dirt poor."

Since we have become hooked on the idea of infinite economic growth, we have to reasonably accommodate the idea of "wanting to make a buck". We can't change overnight, so let's get rid of commercial corporations in favour of non profits; it's a way to take the sting out of being ripped off. The two organizations are very similar, except non profits can't show financial gain at the end of their fiscal year. Extra earnings have to be given away to others, hopefully good causes in need of financial help. Sounds good to me.

All the same, there is enough room for financial incentive in non profits, as administrators and employees can still earn a decent living (e.g. The Just for Laughs Festival and The Montreal Jazz Festival). Capping earnings by not allowing company directors to get overly rich through the acquisition of shares and investment of profits for their own personal gain is a good place to start.

Why should companies and the world be built on the only-a-few-get-rich concept and tough luck for the rest of us? You know, most of us put in an honest day's work and that's fine until someone points an accusing finger at us. Excuse me! It seems as though most people in positions of power don't care about economic collateral damage and the pain it

inflicts on innocent people.

Why is this? If we want to save the planet, we have to start thinking about others for a change. It can't always be about "Me, Me, Me!". When we start to realize that our community is the land we live on and that anything harmful to it endangers us, then I may start to believe there's some hope for us after all. Once we begin to understand that hurting others can only inflict pain upon ourselves, then I'll say we've made it.

It doesn't take a rocket scientist to figure it out, but someone with compassion. I feel we've been abandoned by our society's intelligentsia and that our taxpayer's money invested in universities over generations has propagated the belief in all for oneself and none for all. Where's the payback on our investment? We've been good. Secret worlds

Crime and young adults

Every society has its rituals for adolescents entering into adulthood. Some of these are explicit and formalized, such as graduation ceremonies, communions, and bar mitzvahs; others lie below the surface, such as norms for dressing and conversing with one's peers and elders. No wonder, then, that often young people are confused about their roles, and sometimes pattern their behaviour around the expectations of those around them. Disturbingly, however, others divide their world into compartments and enter secret worlds, a choice that may have tragic consequences.

This week's pick examines this transitional and crucial stage of young people's lives, and demonstrates how little is needed for events to take an ominous and tragic turn.

BARBARA FRADKIN

Montreal-born Barbara Fradkin attended McGill University and the University of Toronto, and completed her doctorate in psychology at the University of Ottawa. Her numerous short stories have been widely

published, and have garnered her three nominations by the Crime Writers of Canada for the Arthur Ellis Award for Best Short Stories.

Barbara's novels centre on Ottawa Police Inspector Michael Green, who in his private life is divorced, with a grown daughter and a new partner. *Dream Chasers* is the sixth in the series. Her previous two novels, *Fifth Son* and *Honour Among Men*, each won the CWC's Arthur Ellis Award for Best Crime Novel of the Year, in 2005 and 2006. She is the only author ever to have won this award twice.

Recently Barbara and co-conspirator in Canadian crime writing Mary Jane Maffini gave a talk and signing, and conducted a writer's workshop, on the Lennoxville campus of Champlain Regional College, to much acclaim.

Barbara currently lives in Ottawa with, as she describes them, "assorted pets and children."

DREAM CHASERS (RENDEZVOUS CRIME, 2007)

Lea Kovacev is a 17-year-old Ottawa high-school student, a former Bosnian refugee who emigrated to Canada with her mother several years earlier to escape the violence in their native land. Now Lea has gone missing. Her mother, Marija Kovacev, insists her daughter is a good girl and wouldn't simply run away without telling her.

But her mother's trust becomes leavened with fear when she learns that Lea has a serious crush on someone in her life, a secret she has zealously kept from those closest to her.

As head of the Ottawa Police unit for Crimes Against Persons, Inspector Michael Green is drawn to the case. Although he is on holiday he involves himself in the investigation, and when his own grown daughter,

Hannah, fails to come home and doesn't answer her cell phone for several days, Green begins to fear the two cases might be connected.

Matters take an ominous turn when a school board counsellor who had been looking into Lea's life also goes missing. It is not long before a backpack containing Lea's clothing is found near the banks of the Ottawa River. When the river gives up the nude body of a young woman, and an autopsy reveals she had taken drugs shortly before her death, Green wonders whether it is simply a case of death by misadventure, or whether a sexual predator is at work.

Probing the insulated world of high-school life, Green discovers that Lea had been rehearsing for a play involving a handsome drama teacher and a captivating lead actor. She also showed an interest in a talented local hockey forward who was poised on the edge of a professional career. Which among these, Green wonders, lies at the heart of her disappearance, and where is his own daughter? As he confronts his troubled history with Hannah, Green struggles to fathom the complex worlds of secretive students and defensive school administrators, aspiring actors and ambitious athletes, professional sports agents and family hangers-on, and before the case is resolved not only Marija Kovacev's world, but Green's own, will be turned upside down.

MY RECOMMENDATION

Dream Chasers is a well-crafted, character-driven novel in which events flow from the personalities of the key players in the story. The author draws on her considerable experience as a family psychologist to weave an intricate tale about the often-tumultuous lives of youths on the cusp of entering an adult world. The result is an intriguing (if not always comforting) novel that sustains the reader and will resonate with parents. Insightful, nuanced, and entertaining, *Dream Chasers* might well be Barbara Fradkin's best novel to date.

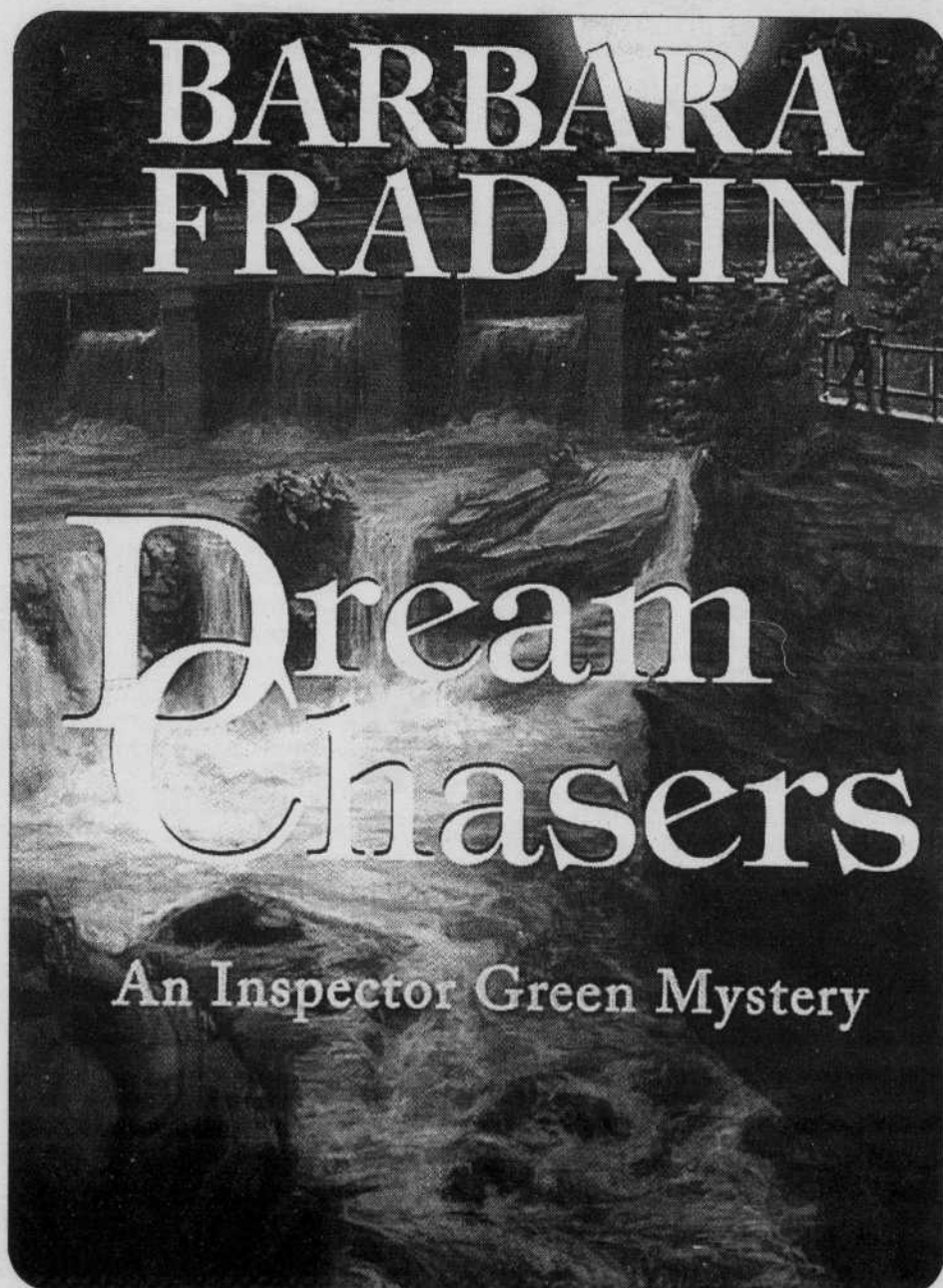

things of this magnitude take time, but look at the time we've already wasted over the years. Can we afford to wait any longer?

Before Bali there was the United Nations Development Program's Human Development report, *Fighting Climate Change: Human Solidarity in a Divided World*, which provides a stark account of the threat posed by global warming. It argues that the world is drifting towards a "tipping point" that could lock the poorest countries and their poorest citizens into a downward spiral, leaving hundreds of millions facing malnutrition, water scarcity, ecological threats, and a loss of livelihood.

So here we are, faced with Armageddon and it's our fault entirely. I guess we have to get used to it. The party is over and now it's time to pay the piper and try to get our lives back if we possibly can. Either we start doing more things for ourselves, or succumb to an SOS selling us another device that will ostensibly improve our lives. We need help!

"We are issuing a call to action, not providing a counsel of despair," lead author Kevin Watkins has said of the UNDP report, adding: "Working together with resolve, we can win the battle against climate change. Allowing the window of opportunity to close would represent a moral and political failure without precedent in human history." He described the Bali talks as a unique opportunity to put the interests of the world's poor at the heart of climate change negotiations.

But we're all locked into lives that we've been told to live. Our basements are filled with unused exercise equipment, while big armchairs grace living rooms as an all-important part of life. Vacations? We certainly like to take vacations! How many of us think, as we are being whisked from a Third World airport to a luxury resort, that life isn't all that good for the locals? Comfortably installed in a mini-van or bus, we are exposed to the stark reality of poverty that most people in the world are subjected to, as one shanty town after another whizzes by our passenger windows en route to our dream destination.

This is the disparity of economic growth, which relies on the acceptance of our lives as being the only right way to live. It's the "Me" generation blinded by the light of our forefathers who only ever wanted the best for us. How could we possibly have the wherewithal required to fix the immense problems of the world today?

David Warnholtz, a resident of Lennoxville, understands economic disparity. He has seen it first hand and believes in taking action. "In all of our travels to help out others, from New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina and now to Africa," says Warnholtz, "our experiences have brought us closer to the real reason that we were put here on earth."

Along with four friends, he went to

Louisiana and helped mop up a couple of years back, and now he plans on traveling to Nigeria as part of a group of seven people to dig a well for a nursery/primary school serving 345 children in the community of Ika. The unique thing about the projects he co-organizes is that all participating members foot the bill themselves.

"Not only will it be another voyage of self discovery," he says, "but we will never regret the time and funds spent and we will never relinquish the concept of a reverence for life."

Included in the group of seven besides Dave Warnholtz, who is 50, are Paul Mclean (35), Robert Nutbrown (33), Kay Mclean (65, Paul's mother), Chris Hornibrook (40), Josee Parent (35) and Lukas Warnholtz (17, David's son). They plan to leave on the eighteenth of January, embarking upon a 16 and a half hour flight to the capital of Nigeria, Abuja, where they will catch a five and a half hour ride to Ika.

We don't need to respond to another SOS keeping us helpless and stupid. They don't tell us that their products are made by exploiting poor and desperate people, and ravaging the earth. No, they don't have to. They're protected by laws that they lobbied for or made, because they are in power, ensuring never-ending economic growth.

"Nigeria is an oil-rich country," says Warnholtz, "yet 95 per cent of the country is dirt poor."

Since we have become hooked on the idea of infinite economic growth, we have to reasonably accommodate the idea of "wanting to make a buck". We can't change overnight, so let's get rid of commercial corporations in favour of non profits; it's a way to take the sting out of being ripped off. The two organizations are very similar, except non profits can't show financial gain at the end of their fiscal year. Extra earnings have to be given away to others, hopefully good causes in need of financial help. Sounds good to me.

All the same, there is enough room for financial incentive in non profits, as administrators and employees can still earn a decent living (e.g. The Just for Laughs Festival and The Montreal Jazz Festival). Capping earnings by not allowing company directors to get overly rich through the acquisition of shares and investment of profits for their own personal gain is a good place to start.

Why should companies and the world be built on the only-a-few-get-rich concept and tough luck for the rest of us? You know, most of us put in an honest day's work and that's fine until someone points an accusing finger at us. Excuse me! It seems as though most people in positions of power don't care about economic collateral damage and the pain it

inflicts on innocent people.

Why is this? If we want to save the planet, we have to start thinking about others for a change. It can't always be about "Me, Me, Me!". When we start to realize that our community is the land we live on and that anything harmful to it endangers us, then I may start to believe there's some hope for us after all. Once we begin to understand that hurting others can only inflict pain upon ourselves, then I'll say we've made it.

It doesn't take a rocket scientist to figure it out, but someone with compassion. I feel we've been abandoned by our society's intelligentsia and that our taxpayer's money invested in universities over generations has propagated the belief in all for oneself and none for all. Where's the payback on our investment? We've been good. Graphic novels come of age

The year's best

The last decade has been a stellar one for publishers of graphic novels and comic books. This once-maligned and marginalized literary medium fought and earned a place for itself in the bookstores and libraries of North America, as well as the respect of academics and educators.

The medium has finally come of age and is offering highly literate and mature reading options that are accessible to the general reader.

This last year saw a steady flow of

high-quality titles — from the vantage point of both the quality of the drawing as well as the text — from all major publishers. The output covers the full spectrum of art genres, from reprints of classic comic strips to politically oriented independent titles.

The following is a handful of the best comics/graphic novels from the past year that are still readily available and suitable for seasonal gift-giving.

- James Sturm's *America* (Drawn & Quarterly Press, hardcover). While a bit on the dark side, James Sturm's *America* was undoubtedly one of the best things (in any medium) I read this year. This talented trio of period narratives

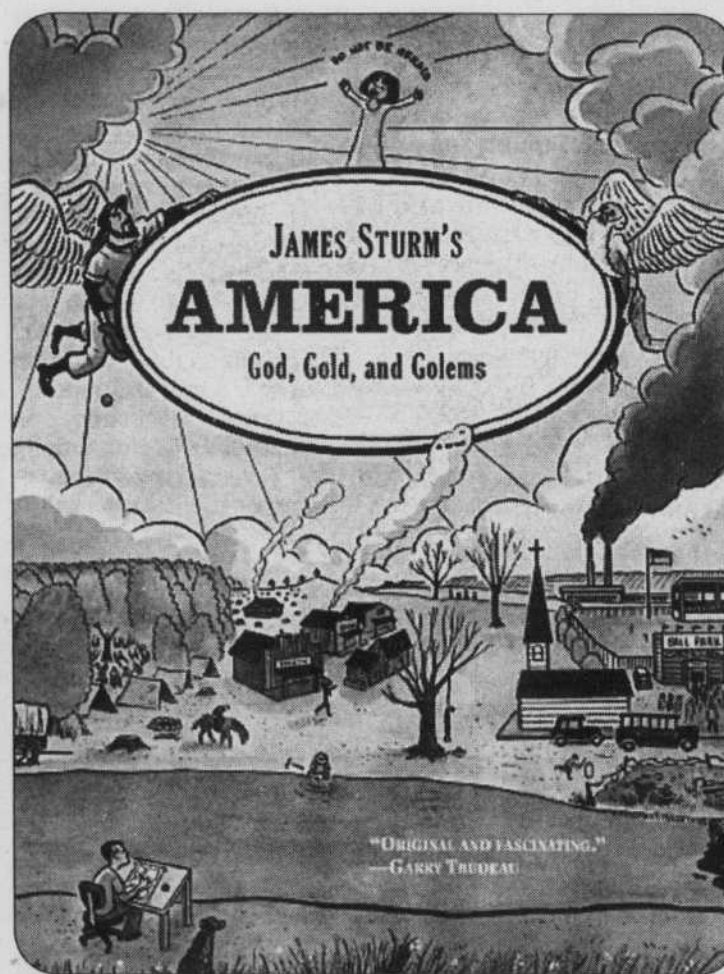

if I had to pick two, I'd settle for "heartwarming" and "funky." Using a nostalgically laden visual vocabulary that evokes mid-century advertising illustration, this book tells the compelling rise-and-fall story of the tiny, titular White Rapids, a hamlet built to service a huge Quebec hydro-project.

- E.C. Segar's *Popeye* (Fantagraphics Books, hardcover). Fantagraphics Books is on a roll of late with their comic strip reprint compilations, such as the wildly popular *Complete Peanuts*, *Hank Ketchum's Dennis the Menace* and *Krazy Kat*.

The most recent offering in this series is an oversized set of hardbound books collecting E.C. Segar's *Popeye* comic strips from the '20s and '30s. A surreal and evocatively drawn title, Segar's *Popeye* was not only brilliant two-dimensional slapstick comedy and easy to enjoy; the late cartoonist was an artist's artist who inspired everyone and everything from Charles Schulz to *The Simpsons*.

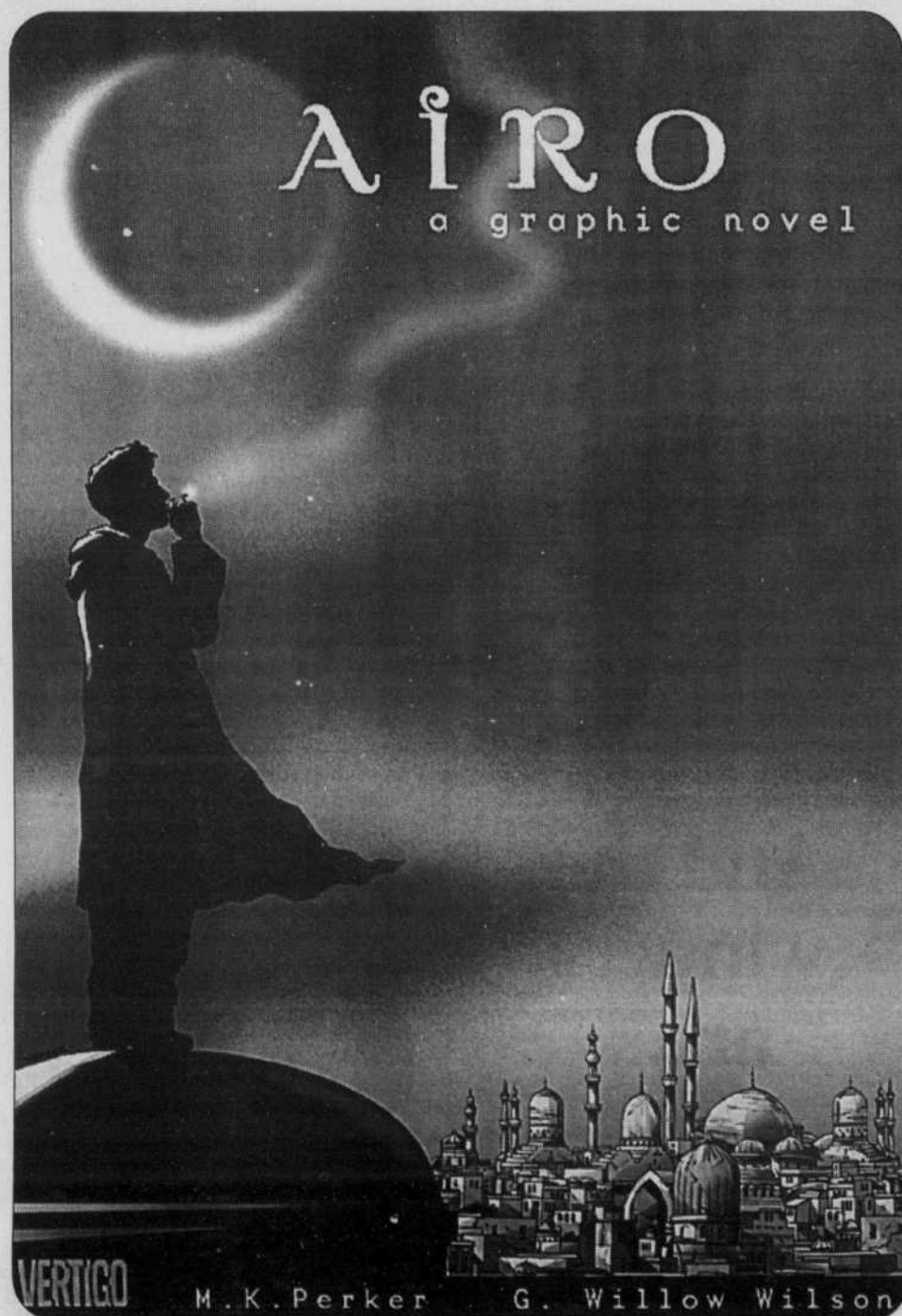
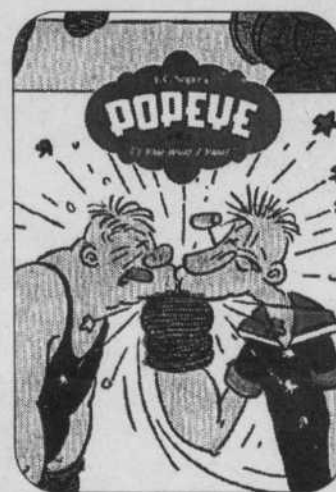
- *Y: The Last Man, Testament and Fables* (Vertigo Comics, trade-paper and magazine format). Because of their serialized nature, the titles of DC Comics Vertigo imprint (with the exception of Neil Gaiman's *Sandman* series) never get their full critical due. Sure, it's easier to wrap your head around a one-off graphic novel, especially the more traditional literary titles, but the collected trade-paper editions of my favourite three Vertigo titles (*Y the Last Man*, *Testament* and *Fables*) offer excellent writing and art in a post-modern and provocative light science-fiction vein.



ranges from a heartbreaking story of pioneer hardship set in an early 19th century evangelical revival meeting to a quirky tale about itinerant Jewish baseball players in the 1920s.

- *Cairo*, written by G. Willow Wilson, drawn by M.K. Perker (Vertigo Comics, hardcover). If I had to point to one tome as an example of high-end literary hybridness in the comic book medium for 2007, it would be *Cairo*. Part magic realist/suspense/action tale and chock-a-block with gangsters, probability-bending genies, a pampered university student from The O.C. and one out-of-place Israeli soldier, this book manages the neat intellectual feat of merging Orientalist literary theory, healthy dollops of geo-political insight and a rip-roaring story in one gripping black and white package.

- *White Rapids* by Pascal Blanchet (Drawn & Quarterly Press, trade-paper). Words don't do justice to this quirky work by Canada's Pascal Blanchet, but

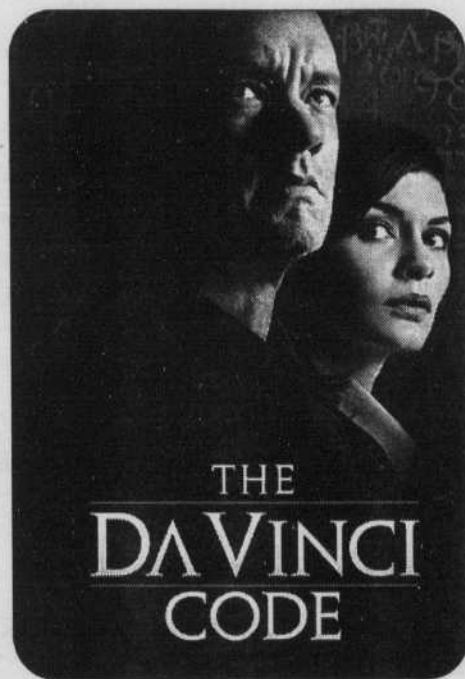
5. Angelina Jolie (Life or Something Like It)

The music includes some strong piano work, guitars, fiddles, banjo and drums and the production keeps things simple but effective.

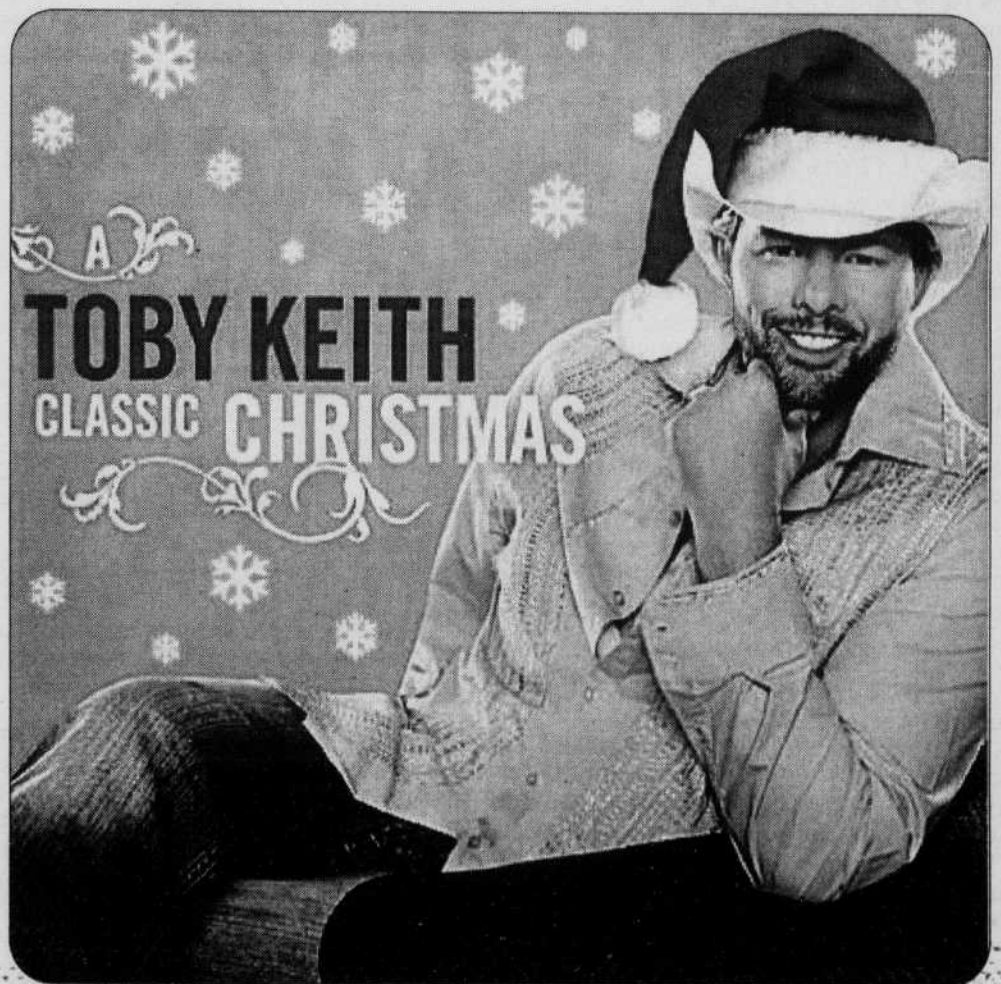
On the second album, it is more the religious and spiritual side of the season, with covers like 'Away In A Manger' and 'O Little Town Of Bethlehem'.
