The magazine Forces, most prestigious in Quebec, has just changed hands. LeStudio 1 announced out that the Group Decision Media, which is responsible for the International Economic Forum of Amériques/Conférence de Montreal acquired of the Forces review. The magazine was founded 38 years ago by Marcel Couture, deceased in 1999, who had wanted to create at the beginning a simple tool of communication for his employer Hydro-Québec. The new editor, Gil Rémillard, said to have carried out its dream by taking the bar of the only magazine of international matter having its home in Quebec. According to Rémillard, his group intends to give again to the publication its international seal and especially its regularity of publication of 4 numbers per year. Marie Dupont will assume the post of News Editor and Nicholas-Philippe Rémillard will be director of the operations. No indication has been given concerning the role of Michel Pelletier responsible for the magazine for the 20 last years.
