GAZETTE December 12th, 1887.—At the present time the Port of Gaspe is in a very active state.

COGNAC. This important fishery has not been as good as last year in Gaspe Bay or along the St. Lawrence and Acton coast.

THE WHOLE FISHERY for which Gaspe was once noted has dwindled down from ten schooners employed twenty years ago to only one fitted out this year.

LEMONS. The Gaspe steam saw mill has been doing very fair work this season, having shipped several thousand boxes of lemons.

PETROLEUM. Early this summer the petroleum fever again invaded this retired spot.
