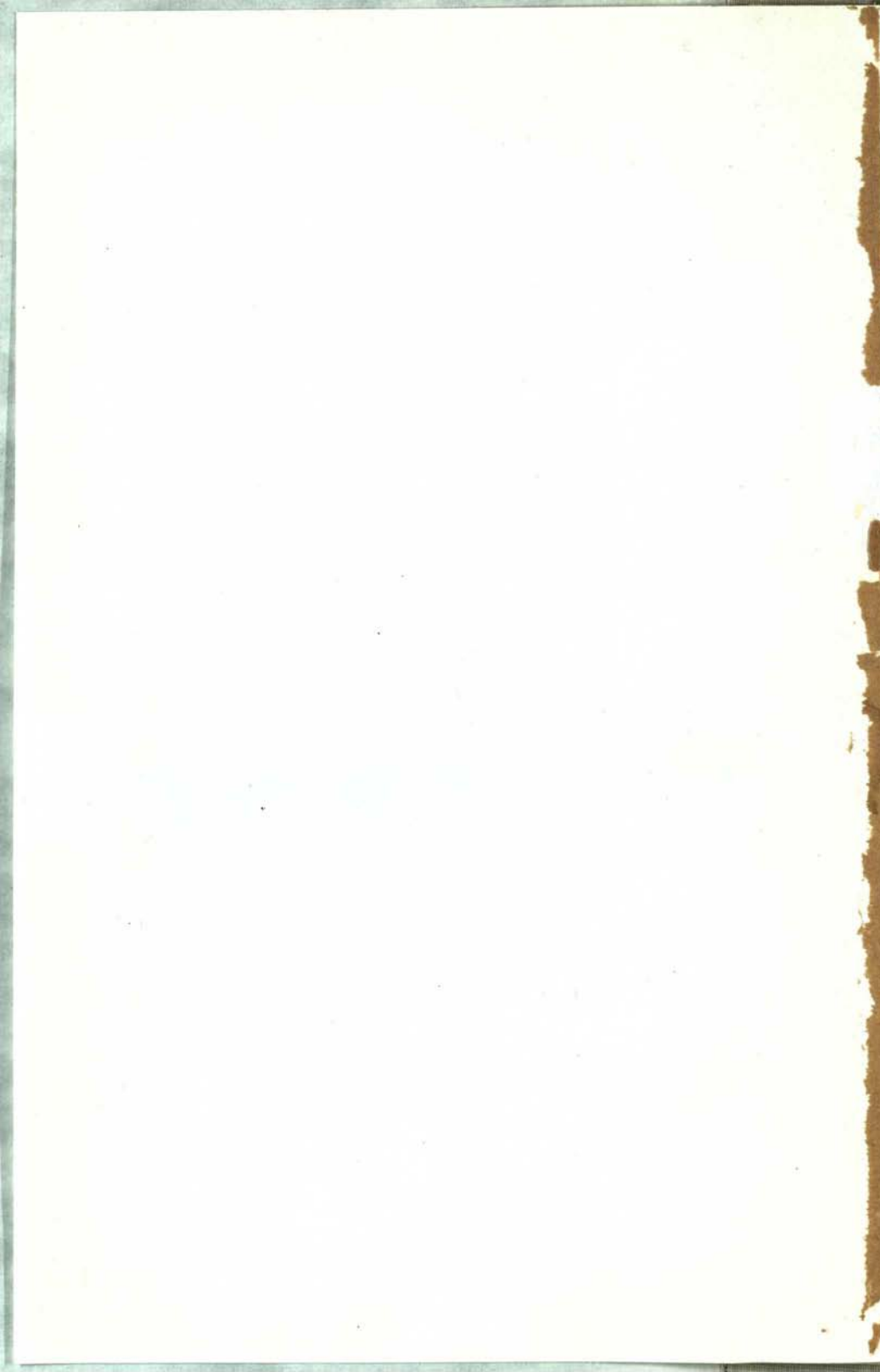

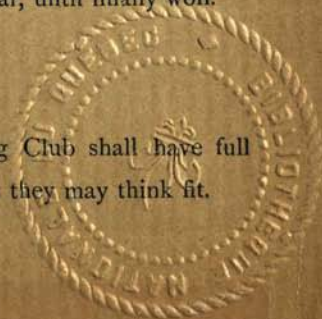

# CHALLENGE CUP RULES.



- 1.—That the cup be known as the Ste. Anne Boating Club Single Scull Skiff Challenge Cup.
- 2.—The races shall be open to amateur members of recognised boating clubs, and the club of whom the holder is a member shall be responsible for the safe return of the cup, at least one week before the race each year.
- 3.—The distance shall be about one mile, and shall be competed for in lap streaked skiffs, not to exceed 20 feet on the keel line, 4 feet 2 inches in width, outside measurement, and not less than 11 inches deep, inside measurement. The race to take place each year at the Annual Regatta of the Ste. Anne Boating Club.
- 4.—The cup must be won twice in succession, or three times in all before becoming the actual property of the holder, but the club will present a prize to the holder each year, until finally won.
- 5.—Entrance fee shall be 50 cents.
- 6.—The Committee of the Ste. Anne Boating Club shall have full power to add to, or amend these rules as they may think fit.

- 1.—All races open to Amateurs only.
- 2.—The Committee reserve the right to decline any entry.
- 3.—Sculling races under Province of Quebec Rowing Association rules. Skiffs not to exceed 20 feet on the keel line, 4 feet 2 inches in width, outside measurement, and not to be less than 11 inches deep, inside measurement.
- 4.—Canoe races under A. C. A. rules, single paddles, measurement not to exceed 16 feet in length, beam not less than 30 inch, depth not less than 12 inches, and weight at least 40 lbs.
- 5.—Swimming race and Water Polo, full bathing costume must be worn.
- 6.—Sailing races to be finished by 6 o'clock or declared off.
- 7.—Stations according to numbers on programme, and to count from the shore.
- 8.—Competitors must wear a number corresponding with their number on programme, and will greatly assist the Committee by being at starting post as soon as their race is called.
- 9.—Two to start, or no race; three to start, or no second prize.
- 10.—Entrance fee to races Nos. 1 and 14, \$1; Nos. 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 11 and 13, 50c.; Nos. 8 and 12, free; Nos. 5 and 10, 25c.
- 11.—Decision of Judges to be final.
- 12.—Entries for boys' races must be accompanied by letter giving date of birth.
