New season, director for Piggery

The new season at the Piggery reflects a new direction – the famed actor Douglas Campbell has agreed to take over as the overall director of the Piggery, bringing with him his talented wife Moira Wylie, as well as a vision that lifts the Piggery out of the doldrums.

After several uninspiring seasons, this summer's offerings are exciting and innovative: The Fantasticks, Twelfth Night, and Tango. It is also the first season the Piggery will go into a repertory schedule.

The question, however, is how did Campbell, whose name is synonymous with Stratford, come to be director of the Piggery?

"We've had a house out here for the past 30 years, a house left to us by my wife's relatives. So we are at home here," explained Campbell. "I had decided not to return to Stratford this year, so I was in the position of being able to say yes when they asked me to take over here."

Officially, Campbell will only be called artistic director, but he balks at the title.

"I don't use that title. I am just the director. Someone like Jean Gascon could have been called artistic director – he was a visionary with many, many talents, a true Renaissance man. Me, I am just directing the shows."

And choosing them. Campbell is responsible for finally bringing Shakespeare to the Townships – a long time in coming it seems.

"I chose The Fantasticks because it was appealing but with quality," he said. "The music is tuneful, there is a cast of eight, which is not large for a musical, and as a production it has been a very successful."

"Twelfth Night I chose because I wanted to introduce Shakespeare to Township's audiences. It is charming, witty and entertaining with a dark side, but it is light compared to Othello. As well, there was only a cast of 10, and I had to work within the constraints of a repertory season."

As for Tango (by Slawomir Mrozek), Campbell explained he had performed the play years ago in Minneapolis, and thought it was funny and satirical, a savage attack on Polish society under Russian control.

"You have the mom and dad, who are like leftover hippies, the rebels,

and their son who has chosen to rebel against them by becoming extra conservative," Campbell continued. "It has elements of absurdist theatre. It starts off quite reasonable, but goes a little mad. I think it is a vastly amusing play but with an edge to it."

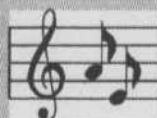

Celebrating locally-grown food

Tour a big, public market this week and you'll see that we're nearing the best of times.

Coming up are those magical four months when local food takes over from imports and we become so taken with the pleasures of local lettuce and strawberries, tomatoes and corn, we buy more than we need, and sit down to food that tastes as it should.

The signs of the 2002 harvest are already evident - pencil-thin local asparagus, leaf lettuce looking like a full-blown rose, radishes Peter Rabbit would relish, fresh-cut rhubarb, and the first strawberries.

It's easy to shop for local produce at this time of year, particularly if you visit the public markets or small fruit-and-vegetable stores. The latter are always more likely to offer local food because they need small quantities; frequently, the chain supermarkets must offer imports, even when local food is available, because they need such huge quantities.

Lately, chefs are saying it's become easier to buy local food year-round. That's because they have finally convinced specialty food producers that if they produce delicacies like game meats and free-range chickens, red and white carrots and yellow beets, fingerling or blue potatoes, and a big variety of fancy lettuces, their food will sell.

The budding relationship between chefs and growers was discussed recently at Marche des Saveurs du Quebec, the fancy Quebec food shop in Jean Talon Market. Chefs had turned out to promote the Quebec agriculture department's Renaud-Cyr award, given to chefs and growers who can prove they work together.

Sainte-Adele chef Anne Desjardins, who tied for the award last year, said the local supply scene has changed vastly since she and husband Pierre Audette opened L'Eau a la Bouche in 1979.

Back then, she remembered that, if she wanted any specialty fruit or vegetable, "You had to have produce coming from France and Italy." Now, she can get many of the fine fresh ingredients she likes almost year-round. "I have growers who understand we are ready to pay good prices," said Desjardins.

Members of two food-loving organizations sat down earlier this week to a dinner that showed off the best of Quebec's foods, including trout, goose foie gras, guinea hen, venison, wapiti, spring vegetables, various cheeses, and a cream and strawberry dessert.

The groups - Cuisine Canada's Quebec chapter and the Alliance des Femmes Professionnelles des Metiers de Bouche - were

the guests of Genevieve Longere, who with her husband Yves runs a restaurant at their farm near Joliette, and the chefs and students at Riverside Park Technology Centre in LaSalle. Below are two of the recipes served at the event.

Larger portions of fish can be used to make this a main course. Chef-teacher Guy Rivet suggests buying cedar planks, which give the trout flavour, at a building-supplies store. Fiddleheads are coming from eastern Quebec and New Brunswick; substitute asparagus if you wish.

PLANKED TROUT WITH FIDDLEHEADS AND APPLE, CELERY AND POTATO PUREE (Serves 4 as an appetizer)

1 cedar plank (about 8 inches/20 cm wide by 12 inches/30 cm long)
1/4 cup (50 mL) olive oil
1 cup (250 mL) chopped celery
2 cups (500 mL) chopped Granny Smith apples
Water
1 1/3 cups (325 mL) peeled, chopped potatoes
Salt and freshly ground pepper
2 cups (500 mL) celery juice (see note)
1/4 cup (50 mL) butter
2 tablespoons chopped fresh chives
2 tablespoons chopped fresh chervil
1 cup (250 mL) chopped onions
1 1/3 cups (325 mL) fresh, cleaned fiddleheads
4 portions trout (3 ounces/85 g each), skin on
Fresh chive blossoms
Chervil sprigs

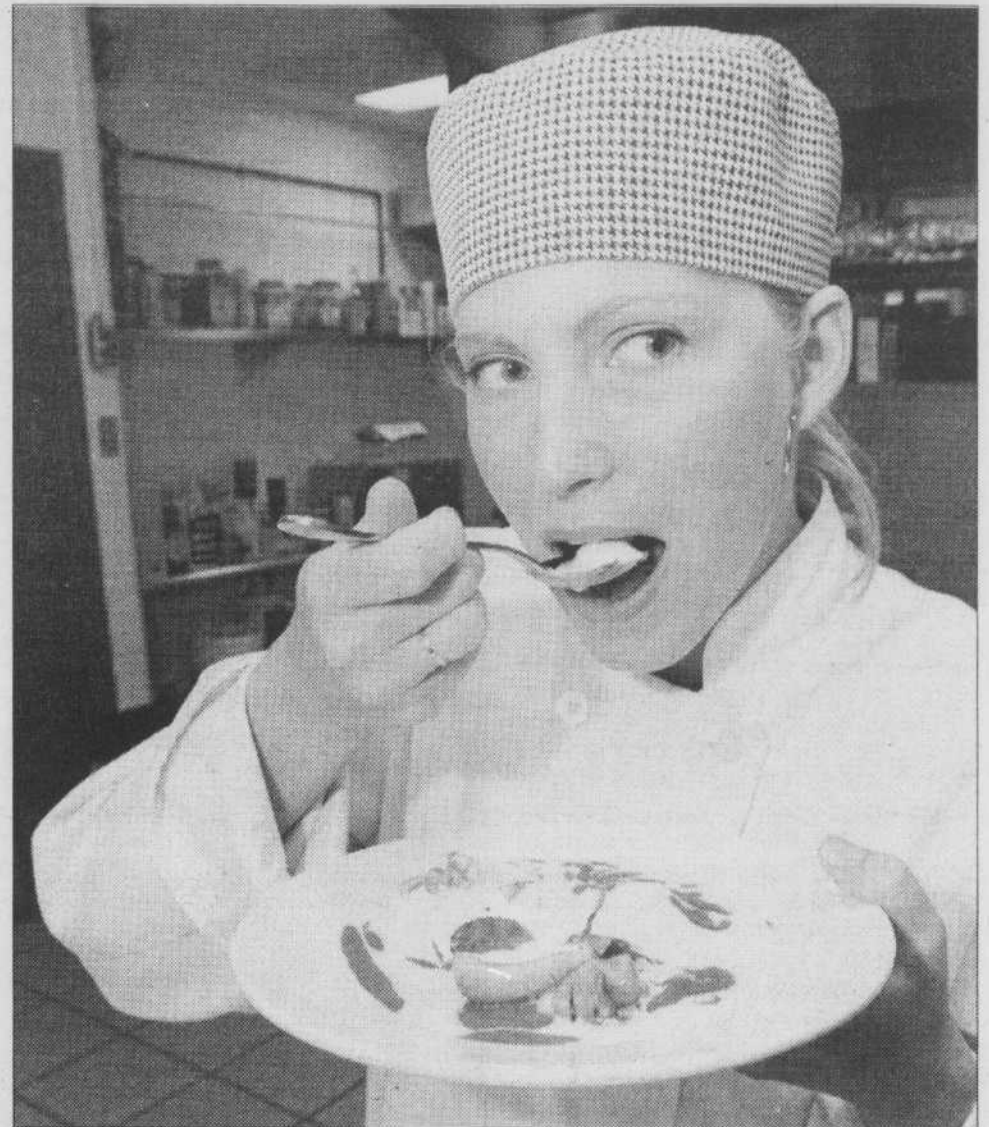
Note: Celery juice sells in natural-food stores or can be made in a juicer.

• Brush plank with olive oil and heat in a 425 F (220 C) oven for 20 minutes. Meanwhile combine celery and 1 cup (250 mL) of the apples in a medium saucepan, cover with water and simmer for 7 to 10 minutes, or just until soft, then drain.

At the same time, place potatoes in a medium saucepan, cover with water and simmer until tender, then drain. Add celery and apple mixture to potatoes and mash with potato masher until smooth; do not use a food processor or mixture will turn gluey. Season with salt and pepper, place in a non-stick pan and keep warm over low heat.

Make sauce in a medium saucepan by adding celery juice to remaining 1 cup (250 mL) apples and simmer for 15 minutes. Strain, season with salt and pepper, whisk in all but 1 tablespoon (15 mL) of the butter, and stir in the chives and chervil. Just before serving, blend briefly with a hand blender.

In a non-stick pan, melt remaining 1 tablespoon (15 mL) butter and cook onions until golden-brown and caramelized. Drop fiddleheads into boiling, salted water for 2 minutes, then drain and sea-

son with salt and pepper. Arrange trout on oiled plank, skin side down, and roast at 425 F (220C) for 4 to 5 minutes or until fish flakes with a fork.

To serve, spoon potato puree into 4 wide shallow soup bowls or plates. Top with fish, skin side up. Arrange fiddleheads and onions around the fish and ladle sauce on top. Trim with chive blossoms and chervil sprigs.

Chef-teacher Nancy Gagnon uses Lait d'Antan, an old-fashioned milk from cows fed soybeans. The milk has a slightly sweet taste. It is produced by Laiterie Ferme Bord des Rosiers in Sainte-Aime.

PANNA COTTA CUSTARD WITH STRAWBERRY WINE SAUCE (Serves 6)

2 tablespoons (25 mL) cold water
1 tablespoon (15 mL) unflavoured gelatin
1 1/2 cups (375 mL) whipping cream
8 tablespoons (120 mL) Turbinado sugar
2-inch (5 cm) piece vanilla bean, halved lengthwise, pulp scraped

1 1/2 cups (375 mL) Lait d'Antan (see notes) or whole milk
Toasted hazelnuts or pinenuts
Fresh mint leaves

Strawberry Wine Sauce (see recipe)
Measure water into a small bowl, sprinkle with gelatin; let soften for 5 minutes.

In a small saucepan, warm cream with sugar and vanilla bean and pulp, stirring until sugar dissolves. Turn off heat and add softened gelatin. Stir until it dissolves, then whisk in milk.

Strain mixture through fine sieve into a bowl or pitcher, then pour into 6 8-ounce (225 mL) ovenproof ramekins or custard cups. Chill until firm, about 5 hours or overnight.

To serve, set ramekins in small bowl of warm water to loosen custard, about 20 seconds each. Run a knife between custard and edge of ramekin, then invert onto plates. Spoon sauce over panna cotta and sprinkle with toasted nuts. Top with fresh mint.

Rhythm and variation fill Orford's woodlands

The 51st edition of the Orford Festival kicks off today, Friday, June 28. Running until Aug. 17, the festival will feature chamber music, opera and jazz under the artistic direction of Angès Grossmann, of the Orford Art Centre.

Rhythm and variation is the theme of Festival Orford 2002. In addition to a wide variety of musical concert events there will also be an art exhibit and music lectures.

The inaugural concert, the first of four presentations by the Orford Chamber Musicians, takes place on Saturday, June 29 and is sure to set the tone for the rest of the performances.

According to communications co-ordinator, Isabelle Langlois, all of the performances this year will be excellent but admitted she is excited about the arrival of the prestigious Beaux Arts Trio that will celebrate a return to the festival after eleven years of absence. The pianist, Menahem Pressler founded the ensemble in 1955 and is accompanied by renowned violinist Young Uck Kim and violoncellist Antonio Meneses.

According to Langlois, the "best of the summer" will be the show on Friday, July 26 that brings back the Orford Winds who made their debut last summer at the Centre.

Five celebrated talents will reunite to make this evening magical: flautist Robert Langevin, soloist with the New York Philharmonic, Louise Pellerine, André Moisan, Stephanie Lévesque, solo bassoon for the Montreal Symphony Orchestra, James Sommerville, principal horn for the Boston Symphony, and Quebec pianist Henri Bassard.

Langlois said that the opera will also be something great to see. Mozart's opera Don Giovanni will be performed on July 19 and 21. Agnès Grossmann and musicians from the Ensemble Montréal will lead the musical part of the performance. The performance will be accompanied by the young singers of the Orford Lyric Workshop, students at the Art Centre's summer music school. The performance on the 21st will be followed by an Italian meal served on the Centre's terrace.

As in previous years, the festival will have a benefit concert. This concert will be held on Friday, July 12 and will be presented by the singers of the Orford Lyric Workshop who will perform a vocal arts concert.

The musical presentation will be followed by generous dining and a silent auction. Tickets cost \$200 and proceeds go toward a scholarship fund for students who attend the summer music school. Students who attend this school come from across the globe, and are attracted to the Centre by the teachers who, in some cases, are world renowned according to Langlois.

Always popular, according to Langlois, is the Picnic Symphony. This early-evening event appeals to many different people Langlois said and is usually quite successful in attracting families. The entertainment for this evening is provided by the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Stéphane Laforest. People are encouraged to bring a picnic basket, some fine wine, a blanket and outdoor chairs, according to Langlois.

Last year's musical lectures were well-received and as a result, almost all of the concerts will be preceded by a lecture delivered by Carol Bergeron. Bergeron is a musicologist and former music critic for *Le Devoir*.

François Tousignant, musicologist and current critic for *Le Devoir* will also be hosting lectures. Tousignant will be speaking on the theme "musical styles - a mirror of their environment" every Tuesday at 5:30 p.m. until August 13th.

The visual art exhibition will feature the works of artist Guido Molinari. Molinari has significantly contributed to and influenced the history of Quebec and Canadian art. He will have two exhibits on display at Orford. The vernissage will take place on Friday, July 5 at 5 p.m. Molinari will also be at the Centre on

Saturday, Aug. 10 at 2 p.m. to meet visitors and share with them his experience and wisdom.

The Centre has three exhibition halls. In addition to Molinari's work which will occupy two of the halls, the Festival will also exhibit the works of Marie Lacourcière, a Montreal artist and pianist. On display will be Lacourcière's study of sound projected visually into a series of works on paper titled *Résonance*.


The festival will close on Saturday, Aug. 17 with what Langlois says is one of the highlights of the festival. A triumphant conclusion will be reached with a traditional concert held at the Saint-Patrice Church in Magog that boasts excellent acoustics. The talent to perform for the evening includes Agnès Grossman and her Ensemble Montréal who will present Joseph Hayden's masterpiece, *The Seasons*.

Festival Orford is a major event and tourist attraction in the Eastern Townships. Last year, the Orford Arts Centre was honored with the first prize in the regional category, tourism event: development and innovation in the Eastern Townships, at the Grands prix de tourisme québécois gala in Sherbrooke. With its exceptional quality, character and originality, the Festival 2002 is expected to be another event not to be missed.

Street Art symposium attracting local artists

In an effort to make their event better known in Quebec, the organizers of the Danville Street Art Symposium have invited more artists from different regions of the province, including several from different parts of the Eastern Townships.

"It's always been our intention to include more artists from all over the Townships," said symposium president and painter Régnald Gauthier at a press conference held Tuesday at the Temps des Cerises restaurant.

"This is our fourth time, and the event has become popular enough that more artists from outside the Danville-Asbestos area want to come here. We are glad that more of them are from the Townships."

Those artists include Virginia Cope from Georgeville, René Tardif from Fréghsburg, Ginette Laplante from Drummondville, Lise Tetreault from South Durham and Marie-Claude Demers from Inverness.

Gauthier also confirmed a possible appearance by noted Knowlton artist Mary Martin.

"I can't confirm she will be come just yet. We are still discussing it with her," he said.

In all, over 40 artists will be on hand for this year's symposium, the fourth to be held in Danville.

The popular event draws in thousands of visitors to this historic town every Labour Day weekend. The artist's room, board and other expenses are covered by local sponsors, leaving them free to paint and sculpt anything they see in the town. The artists then show off their works to visitors and offer them up for sale.

Lucie Lapointe, the event's honorary president and an artist from Jonquière, said the symposium is getting a good reputation in Quebec and hopes more artists from outside the province become interested.

"We would like to see artists come here from Europe and other continents," she said.

"But it takes time to build up a network of artists who are willing to come this far to show off their work."

So far, the only out-of-province artists coming to the event are Guy Leclerc from the State of New York and Joseph-Allison Robichaud from

Prescott, Ontario. Artists coming from other parts of Quebec include Christianne Gagnon from Tewksbury, near Quebec City, Jeanne Hart from Huntingdon and Sylvie Brunet from Valleyfield.

Well-known local artists again appearing at the event include Françoise Vermette Dionne from Ascot, Josée Perreault from St. Adrien and Lorraine Levesque from Windsor.

Pierre Grimard, the event's vice president, said the main reason an artist will come to Danville is the possibility of selling their works here.

"Last year, about 25 of the artists were able to sell their works at the event," he said. "The total value of the sales was over \$30,000. That amount has been increasing every year since we started this symposium, and we hope to top last year's figure again this year."

The organizers also count on large corporate sponsors such as Magnola Metallurgy, Cascades Paper, Caisse Populaire and Gaz Métropolitaine for contributions to cover event costs and artists expenses.

Grimard said these companies and a host of smaller sponsors will be responsible for the event's \$50,000 budget.

The organizers also hope to give visi-

tors to the event a memorable time. They said the town square will be closed to traffic during the weekend, allowing street performers and four bands, including one from South America, to entertain the crowds, which last year totaled over 10,000 people.

Town mayor Charles Noble said it makes sense to close off the square to traffic given that the large number of visitors to the event make it hard for traffic to move at all.

"We also have a new bypass road opening up this week, which means anyone wanting to get through can go that route instead of having to crawl through the crowds in the square," he said.

Besides the familiar viewing sites at the United and Anglican Churches, the local art gallery and the Canadian Legion, the symposium will now make use of the Ecole Masson elementary school on College St.

The school will feature works of art made by their own students.

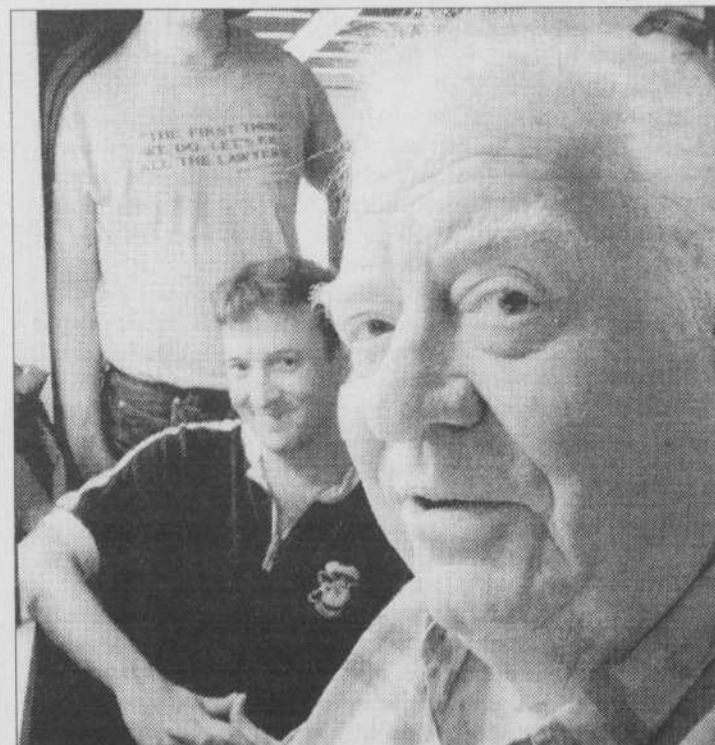

Hank Williams returns to Knowlton

Theatre Lac Brome revives popular production

Theatre Lac Brome's artistic director Nicholas Pynes is in the happy position of remounting last year's hit *Hank Williams - The Show He Never Gave* due to popular demand. The play's run away success last season left many unable to purchase tickets - it was sold out for most of its brief run.

This success is not difficult to explain. The show is a pleasing combination of great music and gripping narrative, excellent acting and wonderful musicians. Knowlton native Ralph Steiner stars as Hank, and his local reputation guaranteed a built-in audience for the production.

Pynes plays the bass in the play, with Marc Desormeaux on guitar and Trish Barclay on fiddle. The four have toured the show over the past year, finding themselves guests on both the church circuit and the Anglophone political scene!

Due to the faith-based nature of the play the United Church of Canada sponsored appearances in Packingham Ont. and Howick Qc. The script delves into the strong religious faith that carried Williams forward, despite alcoholism and a strong streak of depression. The second act especially conveys this, with Williams

reciting Psalm 13, and reliving the revivalist preaching of the 1930s

Alliance Quebec, in an effort to support English culture and bring English communities together socially, also sponsored an appearance in St. Lambert.

"The tour was an outreach for Theatre Lac Brome," said Pynes. "The reception was uniformly fantastic. This was the first time we have ever toured a show, so it raised our profile throughout Quebec. We did get a lot of calls to tour."

In addition to the aforementioned venues, Pynes, Steiner and Co. also brought the play to Metis Beach and Hudson.

Steiner, who enters his second season as a professional actor, is also appearing as King Cole in *Old King Cole*. According to the actor, the minor role leaves him free to work as set builder again, and to take his star tour as Hank.

"I'm very happy to be back and to get a chance to do Hank again," he said. "A lot of people missed it the first time, so it nice to be able to give them the opportunity to see it."

Steiner has thrived on the touring, and audiences can expect a stronger and more assured performance this year. Not that there was anything amiss with the work he did in 2001!

Sounds to soothe the savage beast

UK rock 'n roller reinvents himself, again

Heathen
(ISO/Columbia)

No one artist has reinvented themselves quite like rock 'n roller David Bowie. Following the release of his 24th solo album, entitled *Heathen*, the Brixton-born singer continues a unique musical odyssey, which has taken Bowie from '60s pop to '90s alt rock. Again, Bowie plays on themes of vision and inner peace through powerful lyrics and sombre vocals. The 55-year-old musician plays just about every instrument featured on *Heathen* except

bass, which longtime friend Tony Visconti takes over. *Heathen* still screams of Bowie's UK mod beginnings, but it also features the unique instrumentalization that originated from 1977's *Low* and *Heroes*. Renowned for influencing current heavy metal alternative heavyweights like The Smashing Pumpkins, Marilyn Manson and Nine Inch Nails, Bowie surprisingly avoids the brand of music he made famous. Whether it's another twist on his musical journey, only Bowie himself knows. However, if the past says anything, it will probably be the right move.



NASHVILLE PUSSY
Say Something Nasty
(Epic/Sony)

Guitarist/singer Blaine Cartwright, guitarist Ruyter Suys, bassist Katielynn Campbell and drummer Jeremy Thompson may not be household country superstars, but that's for good reason. Short of the group's name including a reference to the country music capital, Nashville Pussy's music is far from the non-controversial twang of Randy Travis and Kenny Rogers. Instead, the group is a pure hard metal rock band, complete with solid guitar riffs, and soaring lyrics — think Nitty Gritty Dirt Band meets ACDC meets NWA. That is not to say that the guitar group does not have its country influences. Cartwright brings a definite country sway to the mix on vocals, while Suys belts out her share of honky-tonk rhythms on lead guitar. Yes, the lyrics are controversial, yes the name is contentious, and yes, the album jacket is argumentative. Still, from specifically a musical point of view, the rock/country sound, although not new, is catchy and of high quality. The guitar work is superb, both on electric and bass, and the lyrics fit perfectly with the rough and nasty nature of the music. If the old adage 'Don't judge a book by its cover' fits anywhere, it is here.

Laid low by their gritty alt-rock lives, resurrected by the ethereal in their souls, the Deal sisters have a story to tell, but not in narrative form. From its title to its first woozy lurch through *Little Fury*, *Title Tk* initially seems less an escape from than a casualty of the drugs and the jail and the rest of it. It is instead a little Polaroid of rock survival. They're old-school down to the label (4AD, whence the Pixies launched alt-rock) and Steve Albini's acetone-washed production, and they won't walk a reliable line between melody A and rhythm B. At its most opiated ('*Off You*'), it sounds the way smeared mascara looks.

Domino

Local guitar hero Steve Hill's first two albums showed the promise of a young musician who'd learned much from the blues greats who'd come before. This time, the music owes as much to digital effects and the influences of hip-hop as it does to his blues roots. Hill lets us know in the first track that this album is a departure. *Bad Boy* is a vicious put-down that includes a mean, misogynistic rap from bass player Heavy T. Fortunately, it eventually segues into *Run*, a rocker with surf-guitar overtones that is one of the album's better tunes, and then to *Home*, a mid-tempo ballad that features nice lead lines from Hill's guitar. Great blues albums are timeless. *Domino* is of the here and now.

British actor worried career can only go downhill

Sir Ian Holm - one of Britain's most honoured actors - is brooding about his future.

"There's nothing happening at the moment. I've been out of work for eight months. People keep asking me: what's your next project? Well, I don't have one. There just doesn't seem to be any work around at the moment."

• He's chatting on the telephone and his voice is not so much plaintive as it is ruefully accepting of the facts of advancing age. Holm - acclaimed by theatre critics as perhaps the greatest King Lear of his generation - is now 70, and he sees twilight on his horizon.

Of course, he seems to question his own reputation. He finds it difficult to accept that anyone should consider him worthy of being termed a "star" - even on the stage where his presence in a production guarantees a box-office stampede. This self-doubt even extends to his latest film, *The Emperor's New Clothes*, a piece of historical whimsy in which he stars as Napoleon Bonaparte. Holm considers this to be the best film role he has ever been offered - a chance to show one of history's greatest and most controversial figures in a new and unexpected light.

Yet he seems to be thrown by the fact that in this movie - which opens June 28 in Toronto and Vancouver, July 12 in Montreal and July 19 in other cities - he receives top billing. He feels compelled to point out that this is only the third time this has happened to him in film. He's been showing up on the screen for years - in movies like *Night Falls On Manhattan*, *Chariots Of Fire* (for which he received an Oscar nomination), *The Madness Of King George*, and last seen as Bilbo Baggins in *Lord of the Rings: The Fellowship of the Ring* - but he has always been very much a supporting player.

His first leading role in a movie didn't happen until Canada's Atom Egoyan cast him as a troubled, ambulance-chasing lawyer in *The Sweet Hereafter* - a performance that won Holm a Canadian Genie award. The actor then received top billing in two further movies - the well-reviewed but little seen Joe Gould's *Secret* and *The Emperor's New Clothes*.

"The Sweet Hereafter was pretty much my first top billing," says Holm whose gratitude is such that he says he will work for Egoyan any time, anywhere.

"To reach the ripe old age of 67 and play a lead role - well, yes, that is kind of rare." Then the brooding resurfaces as he contemplates a career of diminishing returns. "I can't see it continuing, to be perfectly honest. I'm just getting too old, and I fore-

see my future roles getting smaller and smaller. But hopefully, I shall continue to work anyway."

He snaps back to more cheerful matters - the sheer pleasure of doing a vehicle like *The Emperor's New Clothes*. Kevin Molony's screenplay is based on the novel, *The Death Of Napoleon*, by Simon Leys and turns history on its ear by amiably rejecting the documented proof that following his defeat at the Battle of Waterloo, Napoleon died in unhappy exile on the island of St. Helena.

According to the film, he manages to escape after a vulgar, look-alike imposter becomes available to assume his identity. But unfortunately for Napoleon, he encounters unexpected obstacles in his drive

to take back his throne.

One problem is that back in St. Helena, his bogus replacement enjoys being an emperor and refuses to reveal the truth. And in Paris, the real Napoleon's growing problem is that nobody will believe him if he does try to reveal himself.

Further complications ensue when he falls in love with a lovely widow, helps her rebuild her fruit and vegetable business, and finds himself taking up a new and totally unexpected life.

Holm loved the challenge of taking on a complicated assignment. "Both the real Napoleon and his double are playing both themselves and impersonations of the other," he explains. Holm had to assume a

quartet of identities in a movie which was not being shot sequentially, and he says he was indebted to director Alan Taylor for keeping him sorted out.

"I was very grateful to have someone like that at the helm. This was a 47-day shoot, and when you're in a film for 46 of those days, you tend to lose track of where you're at and even what country you're in."

But he had the most enjoyment with the real Napoleon.

"That is the fun part of the movie. It's what makes it really comedic - the fact that this is one of the world's most famous characters (and a despot), yet he's reduced to this totally banal real situation falling in love and selling melons."

Jones, Smith glad to be back in Men in Black

It's no surprise that Will Smith is in a friendly, outgoing mood this morning. He always is. He has loped cheerfully into the hotel suite, planted his rangy frame into the empty chair awaiting him at the interview table and greeted the assembled reporters with a wide, wide Will Smith grin. We expect nothing less from him.

But it is a surprise that Tommy Lee Jones — an actor of notoriously volatile temperament — is displaying such a sunny disposition. Jones is known for his short fuse and for his refusal to suffer fools gladly.

Ask him a question he considers to be dumb and he's apt to demolish you with a withering response. And any reporter who dares to mention his friendship with Al Gore — the two were once roommates at Harvard — risks setting off a massive explosion of wrath. Which is why many film publicists consider it expedient to restrict Jones's encounters with the media.

Yet here he is today, belying all those alarming stories, with a genuine smile cracking that stone-like countenance, and with a robust greeting all prepared.

"Hello! We meet again! Good morning, everybody!"

There must be something in the air. Or perhaps it's the potent power of the Men In Black franchise in melting the flintiest of dispositions. One thing is certain — Jones is as upbeat about being here this morning as his affable costar, and he clearly shares with Smith the guilty pleasure of

reprising the roles of Agent Kay and Agent Jay, that intrepid duo of intergalactic cops whose mission is to monitor and control alien activity on Earth. They also stand to profit mightily from one of the most lucrative fantasy worlds ever created by Hollywood.

When Columbia Pictures unveils Men In Black II on July 3, it's going to make heaps of money — that's a given. The big question is whether it will surpass the box-office record of the original Men In Black which grossed \$600 million US worldwide when it was released in 1997. Smith figures the new movie has every chance of doing just that.

"I think the second film is definitely funnier," Will says. "The big jokes come in all the right places. What we can never recapture is the element of surprise which the first film had when people were walking into the theatre with no idea of what they were going to see. But now, everyone's up to speed with Men In Black, so I think overall this is the more enjoyable film to watch."

Jones — a more cerebral performer who graduated cum laude from Harvard with a degree in English literature — is fascinated by the Men In Black mystique. When he started working on the original movie five years ago, the Oscar-winning actor had a feeling in his bones that he was involved in some kind of phenomenon.

"Its appeal was its originality. People hadn't seen anything like it before," Jones says. "The first minutes of the film were dedicated to creating a premise — in putting forward a world in which there are Men In Black and there are aliens, some legal and some illegal, living on Earth, and that they require monitoring and policing.

"It was mysterious and then it was very funny and then scary and then funny again. And then, after the laughter ended, you had this real sense of a wonderful, gratifying experience."

Jones remembers his own emotions the first time he saw the earlier film simply as an audience member.

"When it was over, I looked around and

said: 'Hey, it's not over yet, is it? I want to see what happens next'. Which is why Jones didn't even question the need for a sequel. "I had no concerns about the second one except for - when are we gonna start? I'm ready!"

Men In Black II has new screenwriters in Robert Gordon and Barry Fanaro who have concocted a story that pits Jay and Kay against the diabolical Serleena (Lara Flynn Boyle), an alien from the planet of Kyothea. She has disguised herself as a sexy lingerie model capable of turning human males to jelly, and is aided in her quest for power by a dim-witted, two-headed accomplice named Scrad (Johnny Knoxville).

The only Earthling capable of unraveling the truth about Serleena's infernal mission is MIB Agent Kay (Jones); unfortunately he has left the ranks, having been neutralized (a process by which all memory has been erased) and is leading a placid

existence as an employee of the U.S. Post Office. So it is the job of Agent Jay (Smith), who is now the top MIB operative, to denaturalize Kay and restore him to the ranks.

Everyone connected with the Men In Black films agrees that the essential ingredient in their impact is the comic chemistry between Smith's exuberant, laid-back agent Jay and Jones's more humourless, uptight Agent Kay. Or as director Barry Sonnenfeld puts it: "Like all the great comedy teams, Burns and Allen, Laurel and Hardy, there was a quiet one who didn't do much and then the loud one."

Sonnenfeld remembers one night, after shooting a key comic scene at New York's Grand Central Station, when Smith turned to him and said: "Kay makes Jay."

Sonnenfeld agrees. "Without Tommy's character, there is no Will character. Without Abbott there is no Costello."

Smith says this character chemistry has its roots in ancient Greek and Roman comedy.

"Contrast creates conflict which creates comedy. You're not going to put two more different people on screen than Tommy Lee Jones and myself. Just in real life, we're really different, and we drew on some of those same differences in our characters... So Agent Kay is much more cerebral, while Agent Jay wants to dive in and figure it out later... he's impetuous and raring to go without any clue as to what the situation is."



Griggs is greaaaaat with sophomore album

Freedom is Andy Griggs' second album, but three years went by since his debut release. This sophomore effort features some work that comes from the heart and talks directly to the heart.

Nashville still considers Griggs as a newcomer, despite the success of his first album. The quality of this collection, however, will bring him a giant step further and onto a higher level of stardom.

You can hear Griggs musical influence when you are listening to this new album. From Haggard to Jennings and gospel to bluegrass, it is all in a melting pot, creating a very unique sound. Even the slick and modern production leaves plenty of room for Griggs' expressive and strong voice. The numbers can be everything from light and funny to haunting and romantic.

On this new album, Griggs sounds more self-confident and more at ease as he pushes the boundaries of his musical

capabilities. Everything is a little more. More bluesy on singles like 'Where's a Train' and 'A Hundred Miles of Bad Road'. More honky-tonk hardcore on tracks like 'Brand New Something Going On'. More haunting on 'The Road To Lasting Love'. Even more sensual with the smash ballad 'Tonight I Wanna Be Your Man'.

The highlight of the album, however, is a beautiful and heartfelt rendition of 'Someone Like Me' a gospel number written by his older brother and hero, Mason who died of a heart attack at age 22. Also featured is the Cajun flavoured 'Sweetheart of Beinja Bayou'.

Martina McBride lends her talent to the wise and witty 'Practice Life', and their vocal collaboration proves very effective. 'How Cool Is That' is a sultry num-

ber set to be a big summertime hit, while 'I've Learned' spreads words of wisdom to those who are willing to listen.
