## All roads lead to Waterloo

### Road Scholars to launch debut CD in Townships

At last, the long-awaited release of the Road Scholars' debut solo CD recording, *The Road Home*, is at hand. On Sept. 6, the five-member bluegrass band will hold its official launch at Townships Bluegrass and Old Tyme Music Society's opening jam session at Waterloo's Royal Canadian Legion.

An Eastern Townships launch for *The Road Home* (2003 Sunnymead Village Records) is, indeed, appropriate, given the band's long association with the region. Though based in Chateauguay, they are familiar faces at coffee houses in Lennoxville, Stanbridge East and coming up this fall, Farnham.

The band, featuring Rick Rossi (banjo and vocals), Garth Priest (lead guitar and vocals), Bill Welburn (mandolin and vocals), Cheryl Maude-Milot (mandolin, rhythm guitar and lead vocals) and Perry Benedik (bass and baritone vocals), is hardly cut from traditional bluegrass cloth.

Founder Rossi started as a rock-and-roll guitarist before adding bluegrass banjo to his repertoire. Garth Priest, a self-professed acoustic enthusiast and band funnyman, has been playing guitar since 1962. He spent the 1970s performing in pop bands around Edmonton, where he absorbed the folk sounds of Gordon Lightfoot, the Kingston Trio and Ian & Sylvia. Over the years, he has shared the stage with Jim and Jesse McReynolds, Valdi and John Hyatt.

Mandolin player Bill "Homey" Welburn, the band's senior statesman and the soft-spoken foil for Priest's wit, was part of a traveling band in the 1960s. He has performed with Ginette Reno, Michel Louvain and Robert de Montigny at the Paul Sauve Arena in Montreal.

# Crunchy quesadillas in five minutes

# Dining

Dinner on the table in five minutes? Absolutely — as long as you buy ready-made guacamole (but of course it is more fun to make your own, following the recipe below).

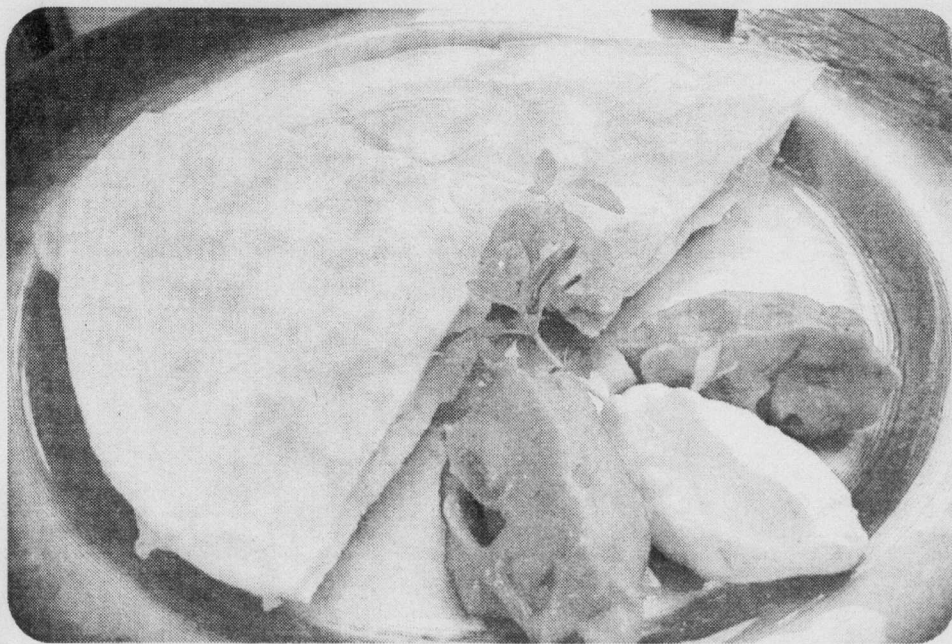
This Township's version of the classic Mexican treat is not just an easy dinner solution: It is also a surprisingly sophisticated treat.

Quesadillas are light and crunchy, yet meltingly hot in the centre — and can be as spicy or as mild as you like. As long as you stick to the cooking instructions, the ingredients in the filling can be added to or modified, in order to incorporate any leftovers that you may want to use.

Try adding salami, prosciutto, green pepper... anything! It all seems to go well in this versatile recipe, as long as the fillings are very finely chopped, so they are able to cook through as fast as the cheese melts.

## INGREDIENTS (FOR TWO)

9 to 12 Gruyère or cheddar slices  
2 tomatoes, sliced  
3 large tortillas  
2 tbsp. jalapeño salsa  
salt  
1 cup sour cream  
For the guacamole (makes about 2 1/2 cups):  
2 medium-sized ripe avocados, halved, seeded and peeled  
1 tbsp. lemon or lime juice  
1 tomato, seeded  
1/2 medium-sized onion  
2 tbsps. fresh chopped cilantro (optional)

1 to 2 fresh jalapeño peppers, seeded (optional)

## DIRECTIONS

1. Start by making the guacamole, if you did not buy some ready-made. Cut the tomato and the onion into small cubes. In a bowl, mash the avocado using a fork or the back of a wooden spoon, until you get a very coarse paste.

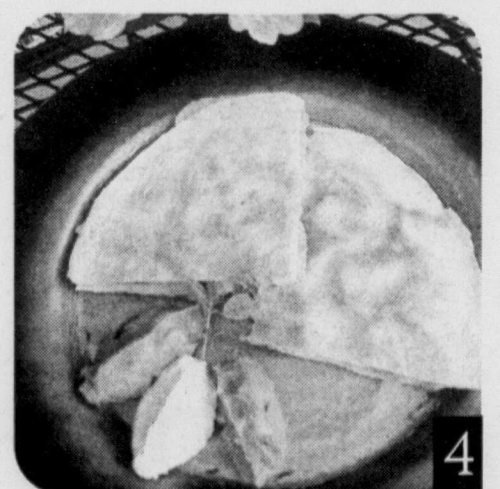
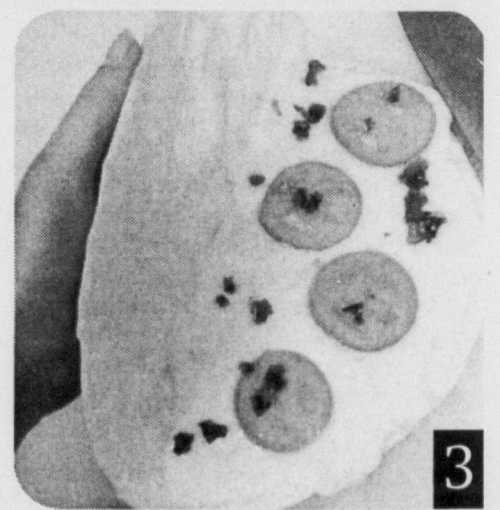
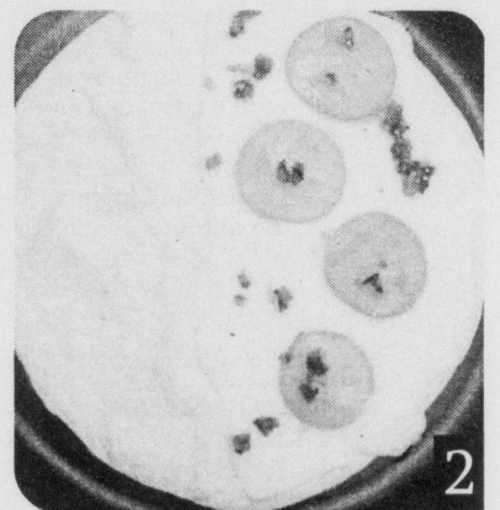
Add the lemon juice, the salt, the cilantro and the jalapeño pepper, finely chopped. Add the diced tomato and onion and mix. Taste and add salt if necessary.

2. Place a tortilla bread on a non-stick frying pan large enough so that it lays flat. Cover one half of it with cheese slices. Top the cheese with 3 or

4 tomato slices, a little bit of jalapeño salsa and salt.

It is very important to have the cheese underneath the tomatoes and salsa, so that the juices they release during the cooking won't wet the tortilla and turn it soggy. It is also very important not to use any oil in the frying pan.

3. Turn the heat to medium. Toast the quesadilla until the bottom of the tortilla has brown spots on it, the cheese is completely melted and the tomato is warm, being careful not to burn it. This should take about one minute. Slide it onto a hot place so that the tortilla folds in half and forms a half moon. Repeat the process with the second and third tortillas. Cut each quesadilla in two and serve at once, with sour cream and guacamole as garnishes.



## Warm chicken salad's a winner

Sturdy greens are the best choice for warm salads because they withstand some heat.

Here we used a 283 gram (2/3 pound) package of washed ready-to-use European salad blend (iceberg, romaine and green leaf lettuce, plus radicchio and endive).

Go ahead and add a few tender baby greens, if you have them in the crisper.

### HOT CHICKEN SALAD WITH CREAMY HONEY-GARLIC DRESSING (FOUR SERVINGS)

#### Dressing:

2 tbsp. (15 mL) white wine vinegar  
2 tbsp. (15 mL) liquid honey  
2 tbsp. (15 mL) light mayonnaise

1/2 teaspoon (2 mL) dijon mustard

1 large garlic clove, minced

1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) salt

1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) pepper

1/2 cup (125 mL) olive oil

1 tbsp. finely chopped fresh basil

#### Grilled chicken:

4 boneless skinless chicken breasts

1 tbsp. (15 mL) olive oil

Salt and pepper

#### Salad:

8 cups torn mixed sturdy salad greens  
3/4 cup halved grape or cherry tomatoes

1/4 cup (50 mL) sliced green onion

**Dressing:** In small bowl, whisk together vinegar, honey, mayonnaise, mustard, garlic, salt and pepper. Slowly whisk in oil until blended. Whisk in

basil.

**Grilled chicken:** Pound chicken breasts until 1/2-inch (1 cm) thick. Brush with oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Place chicken on greased barbecue grill over medium-high heat and cook for 8 minutes or until no longer pink inside, turning once.

Remove to cutting board and cut into thin slices.

**Salad:** For each salad, put 2 cups (500 mL) greens on plate. Top with a quarter of the tomatoes and hot chicken. Sprinkle with 1 tablespoon (15 mL) green onion. Drizzle with a quarter of the dressing. Sprinkle with salt and pepper to taste.

**Tip:** Fresh Italian (flat-leaf) parsley can be substituted for basil.

# Dot marks the spot in Scatter the Ashes *Theatre*

## Barclay and Desormeaux give play local flavour

**S**catter the Ashes, the last of Theatre Lac Brome's professional plays this season, opened this week. It is a homegrown play, developed from an idea by artistic director Nicholas K. Pynes.

Co-written by Trish Barclay and Marc Desormeaux, Scatter the Ashes tells the story of Bridgit (Biddie) Moira Mary O'Donohue, an Irish immigrant who landed at Grosse Ile in 1914.

Musicians Barclay and Desormeaux played in Hank Williams's back-up band for two years, and in the variety show that ended last summer's theatrical season they re-emerged as The Brookfall Bottom Feeders.

They developed the personas of Dot Bottom and Bert Feeder, and in Scatter the Ashes the duo is attending the memorial service of Dot's grandmother, Biddie.

Dot never met her grandmother, but finds she has been bequeathed a very precious gift - her heritage. O'Donohue comes alive through letters, journals and photos left in a basket to her only surviving relative, Dot.

"This is Biddie's gift to Dot, to let her learn a little bit more about herself," explained Barclay.

"At a certain age, you become more interested in your background, you want to learn about where you came from.

"When we are young our parents are never fully fleshed out human beings. They are not someone's daughter or sister, son or brother, they are

just our mother or father. But they are more than our just our relatives."

Biddie's cache of mementos gives Dot the chance to see how her grandmother existed as a woman, with her own passions and history, through her lifelong correspondence with her first true love, Chappie.

"Biddie and Chappie parallel Dot and Bert," noted Desormeaux, who plays the guitar. "They meet at the end of prohibition in Quebec. He's a chanteur, a Canadian Guthrie."

Biddie traveled across the country and the folk music of the era sings through the show. Desormeaux remarked that the "script is inspired and generated by the tunes."

Desormeaux and Barclay wrote six of the 30 songs in the piece. True to the emphasis on family ties, both of their mothers contributed to the music.

"My mom would call every week and sing a song on my voice mail, an old folk tune she would remember," Barclay related.

Desormeaux's mother put them on to Edith Fowke, who collected Canadian folk songs and went around the country taping them in 1952.

Barclay spent about 12 years in the Yukon before buying a house on Brookfall Road in Sutton.

During her years up North, she wrote and performed a summer show, while partner Desormeaux wrote two shows including Time after Time, a musical about Chet Baker.

Together they believe they have created a "homespun, authentic, earthy and rooted kind of piece."

Lovers of Canada's folk heritage will not want to miss this show.

# Bluegrass band returns to Haskell

**B**anjo Dan and the Mid-Nite Plowboys will give local bluegrass aficionados a treat this weekend when they return to the Haskell Opera House in Stanstead July 25.

This marks the fourth consecutive year that the group returns to Stanstead. The group's frontman Dan Lindner admits a lot has changed since their first trip to the Townships, or as he put it, "pre 'O' Brother' days."

"We are all great fans of country music, the kind that existed before it became influenced by pop culture," explained Dan Lindner, who despite growing up surrounded by rock 'n roll still managed to wind up playing bluegrass.

"Our music is not the super sophisticated slick type, but more the down-home and harmony type that comes from the heart with a purely acoustic sound — banjo, guitar, fiddle and contrabass."

Lindner added that most of the group's members help write their original compositions.

"We feel that our shows are different because we do include a lot of original work, creating a broad repertoire outside the Appalachian region where it first began in the U.S.," said Lindner. "We are bringing this new/old sound to some people who really have no idea that all tunes played on a banjo are not the same."

"We try to integrate themes into our songs that relate to life in the Northeast. The relaxing yet energetic music in our shows is a simple sound that gives great enjoyment to audiences as well as to us."

## Frontman unapologetic about 'newgrass' sound

Lead vocalist Cheryl Maude-Milot, began singing in her church choir, where she learned gospel and close-harmony singing. Bass-player Perry Benedik, a professional musician since 1968, played bass in a traveling rock-and-roll band in the 1970s, and 20 years with a Montreal wedding band.

This motley musical crew, with roots in rock 'n roll, folk, pop, gospel and even Eastern European klezmer produces a sound in the "newgrass" style that vexes "old-time" purists even as it expands the bluegrass audience into the young, urban elite.

Priest is unapologetic about the band's non-traditional sound. He believes bluegrass must go forward into new directions. He points out it already has, as The Road Scholars have

opened for headliners like Kane's River, Karl Shifflet and Big Country, and Canadian Grass Unit, all representative of the new, slick generation of bluegrass performers.

"When we open for a band like Kane's River, as performers we always try to take something away, whether it's an instrumental trick on the banjo or the way the group communicates with the audience," says Priest. "We realize that we don't have to be Ralph Stanley or Bill Munro."

While there will always be an audience for the traditional bluegrass and "old time" country, he believes that modern audiences, exposed to everything from world music to heavy metal, are open to the softer sound of "urban hillbilly" groups such as the Road Scholars. It's a sound tempered by folk, gospel, rock-and-roll and just about any other influence these city-slickers can muster.

Band members, all of whom have

"real" jobs, juggle the priorities of home, working and band life, but share what Priest calls a "practice-at-all-costs" philosophy, meeting one night a week for an intense practice.

The results show in the member's tight sound and relaxed style that has entertained audiences in the Townships, the Outouais and Montreal.

The new compact disk recording, produced by John Cameron and Maurice Singfield of local Sunnymeade Village Records, includes two original works including Dreams and Pennies (Garth Priest), Ice Storm Song (by Bill Welburn and Richard Rice). It also features familiar tunes such as Rocky Top (Bryant and Bryant), Think of What You've Done (Carter Stanley) and Abilene (J.D. Loudermilk, L.Brown and Bob Gibson), a song that could be called the band's signature song.

As the debate rages on about what "real" bluegrass music is, one thing

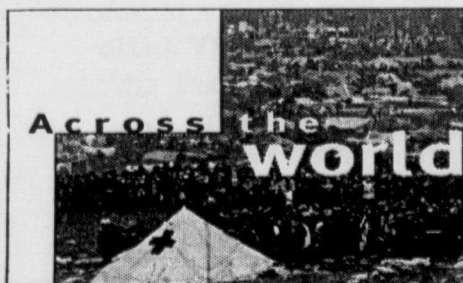
remains certain: On Sept. 6, The Road Home leads to Waterloo and it promises to be a pleasant journey.

# Five questions with Catherine Benoit

If you take the time to travel the Circuit des Arts this year, nestled in the woods around Austin, you will find Catherine Benoit under a story-book type canopy tent. Benoit has been perfecting the art of making blown glass for the past four years.

Between visitors to her display area, Benoit took time out to visit with The Record:

**THE RECORD:** How did you first get interested in this art form?

**BENOIT:** "I knew at an early age that I didn't have the patience for classroom studies. I was much happier when I could create something with my hands. I was lucky enough to be selected at 'l'Espace Verte' in Montreal. It was there that I decided that this was what I really wanted to do."

**THE RECORD:** You say that you felt that you lacked the patience for learning in the classroom but you have chosen a career that seems to require a great deal of patience. Isn't that a little ironic?

**BENOIT:** "I suppose that it may appear that way, but working with glass keeps you thinking and moving all the time, if not by constantly rotating the pole that the glass is attached to, then by trying to keep one step ahead of the transformation of the glass substance so that you can achieve your original plan. If that doesn't seem to be working, then you have to be able to think quickly enough to come up with another idea that will work. Sometimes it is a slow process, but when everything is going well, time just goes by so very quickly."

**THE RECORD:** Could you tell us a little

about the process that you use to create these works of art?

**BENOIT:** "Glass is an unusual substance that sticks to itself when heated to high temperatures. I start with a uniform block that is attached to a long pole, turning it constantly to keep its uniform surface. The glass is returned to the 'glory hole' and the firing oven many times throughout the process. It is important to keep the glass at a uniform temperature to make it easier to work with. If it begins to cool down too quickly, or unevenly, in all likelihood, the piece will become cracked."

**THE RECORD:** You have some very unusual pieces that look like a stalactite suspended from a glass bulb and dangling a ballerina. How is that possible?

**BENOIT:** "Working with glass is a fascinating art because there are no limits to what you can create. Your only limitations are the techniques that you have yet to learn. To make the ballerina shape, I used something called the Lost Wax Technique. When the wax is dry, I remove any imperfections before finally seizing the waxed form."

"It also uses a plaster-type casting for the stalactite shape. I pour wax into the shape I want and then let it cool until the plaster is set. I then heat the entire unit until the wax melts and leaves a distinct shaping in the plaster. The plaster cast is then heated with glass blocks which melt into its new shape. When everything cools down, the plaster cast is broken to display the results. The ballerina is then glued onto the elongated piece of glass which is attached to the bulb at the top."

**THE RECORD:** Do you live in the Estrie area?

# All dressed up with everywhere to go

# Music

Quebec is seen as a place where jazz has blossomed, and where it continues to thrive, and in this thriving environment, Stéphanie Biddle is quickly building her niche.

Not that she's an overnight success; Biddle has been belting out tunes since she was a toddler, whether her family was ready for it or not. "I starting singing when I was three," she said Thursday afternoon from Montreal. "I took maybe four formal singing lessons in my life, but really I learned on my own. I learned jazz through growing up with it."

Biddle grew up in what many have termed the Royal Family of Montreal music. Her father, Charlie Biddle, was a jazz legend in the city, the man who kicked off the first Montreal Jazz Festival 24 years ago and ran Biddle's Jazz club in downtown Montreal until his passing away last February.

Despite the fact that her family's reign of jazz was always centred in Montreal, Biddle grew up in the Laurentians — a tomboy, by her own admission.

"I only came back to Montreal from the Laurentians when I was 15 to play in a movie. They thought I should be a model, even if I was a total tomboy — slap some makeup on her and she looks alright!"

Biddle did model for years, all the while studying Fine Arts at Dawson College. She acted in a host of films, ranging from *The Whole Nine Yards* with Bruce Willis, a Christmas special on VH1 with Vanessa Williams, and *Karmen Gea*, a film that she participated in while in Africa. The movie went on to win best film at the Pan-African Film Festival in 2000.

"Acting and modelling has been good to me," she said, "but that's something I want to step away from right now."

Instead, Biddle said she has rediscovered the passion that first inspired her when she was three: music.

"I've been performing for 15 years already, but when I started, I was doing Top 40, singing with bands at weddings, Jewish weddings, Greek weddings, corporate shows, that kind of thing. That's pop," she reflected.

Performing at the recent Montreal International

Jazz Festival in June before singing at another festival, Rivière du Loup en Blues, Biddle is making the time to throw a grab-bag of jazz and R&B at the Chat du Moulinier crowd in Magog this coming Thursday.

"This show (in Magog) is the exception because it won't be just jazz, but a lot of blues and a lot of R&B. It'll be a bit more contemporary, a bit more rockin'. But, we'll mostly be doing jazz numbers. Jazz is my forté. That's my thang, that's my roots, man."

As her mother's hometown, Magog has a special resonance with Biddle. She said it will be touching to return and sing in the town where much of her family still lives.

Speaking of family, Biddle noted that her father occupies much of her heart and her mind when she's performing.

"There's this song 'Autumn Leaves' that we used to do together. It's a kind of a bittersweet song, and you know, I think about Dad a lot. The song's about separating from the ones you love, but also seeing that it's inevitable. When I do that song, I always dedicate it to him."

Life's not all bittersweet, though, as she recounted some of Charlie's lessons.

"Enjoy life and don't panic. That's what he taught me. Don't let the tax man get to you, you know? You can't go and sweat the little stuff. You see some people and they grow up and get all serious, and you want to say hey! Keep a good sense of humour."

As for her next step, Biddle said that she hopes to release an album dedicated to her father this year, but that she's still courting a couple of record labels.

"I have a lot of songs recorded, it's just a matter of getting it out there. I'm an artist at heart, not a business person. I do have a sense of carrying the torch. You know, jazz is a legacy, and it deserves to go on into the next generation."

## Granary Blues All-Stars to rock The Lion

The Golden Lion Pub in Lennoxville will be holding a major blowout tonight to celebrate its 30th anniversary, including live entertainment by the Granary Blues All-Stars.

The group's frontman Brian Monty, was raised in the Townships, and is a familiar face to those who were part of Lennoxville's late 60s and early 70s music scene. Monty and Terry Gillespie co-founded the band as a way to feed their desire to play close to home after discovering that being on the road was sometimes frustrating.

Opening with a weekly gig at The Granary in Vankleek Hill, Ont., the band quickly became a mainstay. Their unique style of blues, with just a hint of R&B, soon

became addictive to their many audiences.

"There are many different types of music today, but there didn't seem to be any entertainment out there for most crowds," said Monty.

"Times have changed — staying out late and drinking beer 'till dawn has become a thing of the past for those of us who have families and daily responsibilities.

"I think our band is also unique because of our age. We are in it for the pure pleasure of the music itself, and being able to play as a group."

Besides being an accomplished guitarist, Monty is also known for restoring vintage guitars. He has even toured extensively throughout Canada and the United States, opening for likes of Albert King and Long John Baldry.

Gillespie, co-founder, singer and rhythm guitarist for the group, is credited with bringing blues to Ottawa. With a classical music education under his belt, he moved to Detroit where he was quickly inspired by greats like Albert Collins, John Lee Hooker and Buddy Guy. He went on to open for such familiar acts as Muddy Waters and The Police.

When Gillespie arrived in Ottawa in 1968, he founded Heavens Radio, which still is one the air. He is also co-founder of the Vankleek Hill School of Rock & Roll where he teaches elementary school students how to play guitar.

Monty and Gillespie will be joined tonight by bassist Stephen Barry, drummer Gordon Adamson, keyboarder Peter Measroch, mouth harpist Martin Boodman and fiddler Bobby Lalonde.

Barry has performed on just about every blues stage in Quebec, Ontario and the Maritimes. He was named 2002 Best Blues Bass Player by the Toronto Blues Society.

Barry's band also won Album of the Year for *Happy Man*, and Blues Group of the Year by the Jazz Report Magazine (Toronto). Their repertoire includes blues and folk-blues music.

Finally, Adamson's talent as a drummer has led him to performances at Carnegie Hall, the Hong Kong Arts festival and the Berklee Performing Arts Center in Boston. He has also played and recorded with Michel Pagliaro.

## After the War

Post-war planning, disagreements within the U.S. administration about the direction of such planning, meetings between the President of the United States and the Prime Minister of Great Britain. Does that all sound familiar? Of course, since it is happening today with the war in Iraq. But it also happened in the past.

Sixty years ago, the Allies were planning the fate of Germany, even before it was vanquished. Franklin D. Roosevelt, Winston Churchill and Joseph Stalin naturally took it upon themselves to map out the future of Germany.

In a recent book, *The Conquerors*, Presidential historian Michael Beschloss explains how it all happened. And, after reading this book, one has no alternative but to feel a sense of déjà vu.

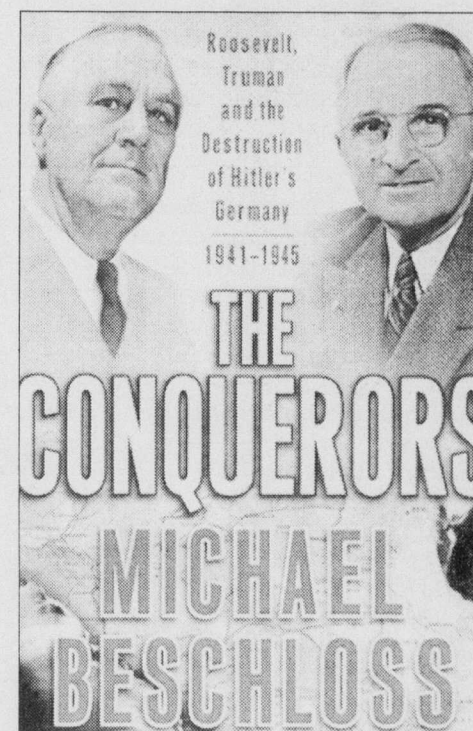
First, there was the debate inside Roosevelt's cabinet as to what should happen with Germany after the end of the hostilities. Some, like Treasury Secretary Henry Morgenthau Jr., were eager to impose harsh treatment on Germany. Others, like Secretary of War Henry Stimson, favoured a softer approach. His camp believed Germany should be allowed to get back on its feet.

The debate was intense, with leaks in the media by the protagonists of both sides, alliances to defeat options and, of course, attempts to lure the President to one side and the other. Reading *The Conquerors*, it's easy to grasp the fact that politics didn't change much.

Along the way, Roosevelt gave few indications of his personal policy preferences on that matter. Roosevelt was a savvy politician who liked to be in total control of the events around him. Like he told Henry Morgenthau Jr., who was also a personal friend, "I am a juggler, and I never let my right hand know what my left hand does." People around him were, for the most part, left in the dark about the President's inclinations and intentions.

On April 12, 1945, Roosevelt died and vice-president, Harry S. Truman, was called upon to succeed him. But Truman never had any chance to grasp the details surrounding the post-war planning of the meetings between the allies. In those days, the VP didn't have the influence of an Al Gore under Bill Clinton or a Dick Cheney with the current President. In Truman's days, the role of the VP was minimal.

But the 33rd President nevertheless decided to follow the softer path with Germany. Along the way, Morgenthau



was dropped from cabinet. In that sense, *The Conquerors* is also a very interesting portrait of the contrast between Roosevelt and Truman. Author Michael Beschloss writes that "Truman's approach to administration was as crisp as his double-breasted suits. He had disapproved of Roosevelt's frequent resort to special envoys and troubleshooters, who had undermined the late President's Secretaries of State and War, and the messy public struggles of all-against-all that, Truman believed, had afflicted too much of Roosevelt's war leadership."

Truman was right, in the sense that Germany came back to the family of nations, prospered and reunited. It's doubtful that the hardline policies would have produced such an outcome.

There is another interesting aspect of Beschloss's book. Throughout the discussions and debates about what should happen to Germany once it was defeated, few seemed to envision the confrontation between the Soviet Union and its former allies. Winston Churchill was among those very few.

*The Conquerors* draws a very interesting parallel with what is now happening with the war in Iraq. Like Presidents Roosevelt and Truman, President Bush's decisions will have an impact on what will happen in the years ahead.

## More than a chick book

I was quite looking forward to reading *Blessed Are the Cheesemakers*, the new novel from New Zealand journalist Sarah-Kate Lynch. It had been a while since my last chick book, and I was feeling that yen...

What? Yes, I said "chick book," and I'm not going to apologize. It's not a pejorative term. I have a soft spot — whether in my head or my heart, I'm not sure — for them. I've spent a number of very satisfying weepy evenings with Nicholas Sparks, and Bridget Jones is my type of girl. Hell, I was one of the first people in North America to read *The Bridges of Madison County*, long before the hype set in.

From the outside, *Blessed Are the Cheesemakers* bears all the hallmarks of a quality chick book, including a slightly out-of-focus pastoral, windswept cover and enthusiastic blurbs using words like "heartwarming" and "enchanting."

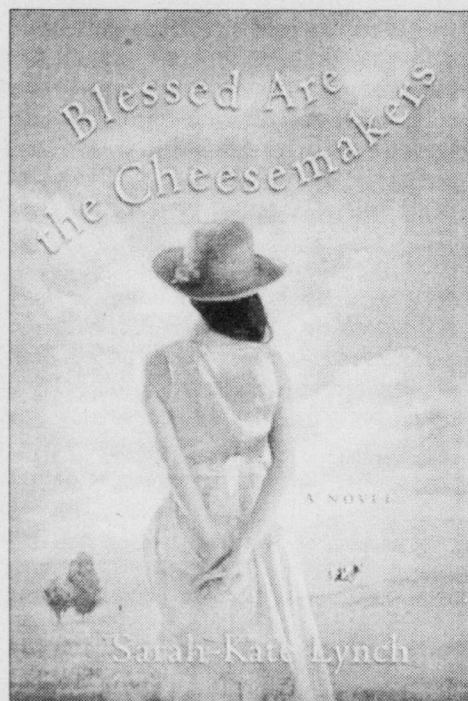
Most of the novel's action takes place on Coolarney Farm in County Cork, Ireland, where Joseph Corrrigan and Joseph Feehan have been making the finest cheeses in the world for decades. However, Corrie and Fee are growing too old for the intensive labour of cheesemaking, and a call goes out for successors.

Drawn to the farm, in complete ignorance of this call, are Abbey Corrrigan and Kit Stephens. Abbey is Joseph's granddaughter, pulled away from the family years before by her mother, who has settled on a remote South Sea island with her husband, who, it turns out, has been assuming the missionary position with many of the local women.

Kit arrives at Coolarney in full flight, leaving a cocaine habit, a lost job and a dead wife in New York City. He and Abbey come to Coolarney seeking refuge from their lives, little expecting that what they'll find is a reason to live again.

See, that's a good chick-book line: a balance of pathos and hope, hinting at romance and a change of circumstances.

Except that *Blessed Are the Cheesemakers* isn't a chick book at all. It turns out to be a quite delightful, often bawdy, quite funny and slyly subversive novel that respects both its characters and its readers. (I should have known something was up from the title, cribbed



from a mishearing of the Sermon on the Mount in Monty Python's *Life of Brian*. "What's so special about the cheesemakers?" is the response.)

The story contains colourful locals, three cats named Jesus, Mary and All the Saints, and a group of pregnant, unmarried, vegetarian dairymaids who serenade the herd with songs from *The Sound of Music* as they milk. Sarah-Kate Lynch comes close to wallowing in clichéd rural charm, but largely avoids it through the full-bloodedness of her characters (including Lucy, the most recent arrival among the dairymaids, whose pregnancy hasn't dulled her sex drive or her need for love) and the hard edge of contemporary reality, which none can avoid, despite the bucolic beauty of the setting.

*Blessed Are the Cheesemakers* is not a perfect book. At times, you can almost hear the gears grinding as the plot machine kicks in. It probably won't linger long in most readers' memories.

Still, it really is quite a delightful read, perfect for a summer afternoon with a glass of wine and a plate of fruit and — what else? — cheese.

I, in the meantime, have a chick book to find. Wish me luck.

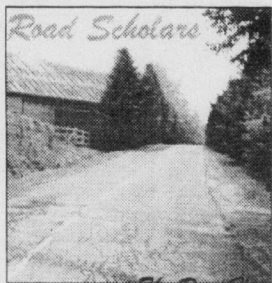

**ROAD SCHOLARS  
The Road Home  
(Sunnymead)**

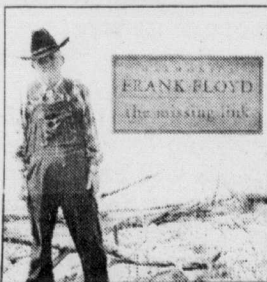
Bluegrass lives! Already well known at the popular Eastern Townships Bluegrass Society's monthly jam sessions in Waterloo, the Road Scholars have released their debut album on local label Sunnymead Village Records. Entitled The Road Home, the 12-song offering is what bluegrass fans would expect from a group of musicians who have decades of experience under their collective belts. Singles like 'Down Yonder' and 'Home. Come on Home' are fast, clean and powered by Rick Rossi's quick fingers on the banjo. Others, like 'Mama's Rocking Chair' and 'Dear Someone', are slower, smoother and rich thanks to Cheryl Maude-Milot's majestic vocals. On tracks like these, Maude-Milot provides just enough of a "woman's touch" to balance out the album. The Road Home's real strength, however, lies with the group's smart selections (nearly all are covers). The five-member band's familiarity with all of the album's tracks are immediately evident on a perfect bluegrass collection.

**HARMONICA FRANK FLOYD  
The Missing Link  
(Memphis International Records)**

Harmonica Frank Floyd could play two harmonicas at once, one with his mouth and one with his nose. He could also play the harmonica without a neck brace while playing his guitar, sticking the harp into his mouth like a cigar. He is also a specialist at reproducing farm animal noises. All this is not surprising for a guy who started working as a



clown, musician and general labourer for carnivals and medicine shows at the age of 14, drifting around the country for the next 30 years. Later on, Floyd toured as the only white member of The Memphis Blues Caravan. The Missing Link is an album of live recordings from 1979, five years before Floyd died. It's an interesting collection of curios. The music and the lyrics betray Floyd's rootless existence, travelling the backroads of the rural U.S. But there is a simpleness to many of the tunes here that makes listening to it little more than an interesting historical exercise.

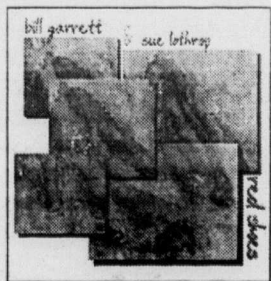
**JAMES COTTON

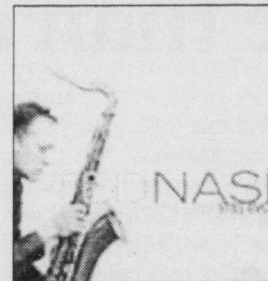

**TED NASH  
Still Evolved  
(Palmetto Records)**

Yes, there is life and creative achievement in the world of straight-ahead jazz, and New York-based tenor saxophonist Ted Nash has proved it in this superb CD. His quintet includes fellow members of New York's Jazz Composers Collective - Frank Kimbrough (piano) and



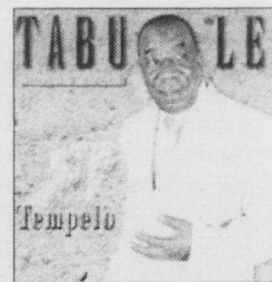
Ben Allison (bass) - as well as Matt Wilson (drums), and Wynton Marsalis and the adventuresome Marcus Printup alternating on trumpet. The music is mostly up-tempo, forward-looking and in the groove, and it is fascinating to compare the trumpets. Listen to Marsalis and his blistering attack on The Shooting Star, then compare it to the sizzle in Printup's playing on The Competitor. All compositions are by Nash, who holds a tenor chair in Marsalis's Lincoln Centre Orchestra. He is at his subtle best in the mellow and tender Bells of Brescia. Listening to this CD has been one of the joys of this summer season.

**TABU LEY ROCHEREAU  
Tempelo

The history of modern Zairean music began with Joseph Kabasele, aka Grand Kalle, in the late 1950s. What followed - and lasted close to 30 years - was one of Africa's famous rivalries, with Franco Luambo in one camp and Kabasele protege Tabu Ley Rochereau in the other. These are the guys who passed the torch to next-generation superstars Sam Mangwana and Papa Wemba. But that's the history; what matters today is the high quality of Tempelo, arguably Rochereau's best release in two decades. A beautiful melange of Congolese possibilities, from vintage, 1960s-sounding African rumba to the raucous soukous stylings of today, it's a total package - sweetly produced, dynamically arranged and as much a showcase for Rochereau's songwriting (he has more than 2,000 titles to his credit) as for his fine voice and honed performance skills.

David El Malek on tenor saxophone and guitarist Michael Felberbaum, while less distinctive than Turner and Rosenwinkel, are also quite accomplished. # Jolie's a bundle of contradictions

There's something oddly touching — also perplexing — about the way Angelina Jolie talks about her efforts to live a normal life.

Take her love affair with Montreal, where she's shooting a new thriller, *Taking Lives*, and where she doesn't constantly have to be looking over her shoulder. She and two-and-a-half-year-old son Maddox have been having a ball there.

"It's great. There are really good things for kids. There's the Biodome and the parks. So we've been having a really good time. We went to a jazz festival. Maddox loves jazz. He's two."

In New York it's different, because she's doing press on behalf of her new *Tomb Raider* movie, *The Cradle Of Life*, in which intrepid archeologist Lara Croft wages battle with a Nobel Prize-winning maniac who wants to control the world. She's in the full glare of publicity — the paparazzi lurk outside the hotel — and that, she claims, isn't how she wants life to be.

"The thing is I so much want to live a normal life in a healthy state of mind so that I try not to think of myself as somebody in the press."

It's a different Angelina Jolie — or so you think. Trouble is — she's a contradiction. This is the same weekend in which a Barbara Walters TV special will have her attacking her father, Jon Voight, for commenting publicly on her mental condition and will also feature the admission her failed marriage to Billy Bob Thornton has soured her on ever getting hitched again.

And a few weeks before that, she confessed in another interview it's been a long time since she had sex.

She's an enigma — a private person who nonetheless behaves as if she was public property. Her numerous tattoos are a case in point: witness her proud announcement a few years ago she had the Latin phrase — *Quod me nutrit me destruit* (What nourishes me also destroys me) — tattooed across her chest; or her candour about the vials of each other's blood she and Billy Bob swapped to wear around their necks at the time of their 2000 marriage.

Thornton announced recently he burned his ex-wife's blood in a small box he called "the marital coffin." Meanwhile Angelina announced in the spring that laser surgery removed a tattoo bearing Billy Bob's name from her arm.

Few Hollywood stars have generated more bizarre headlines.

Yet, it's the restrained professional who's in control this morning as she talks about bringing back an action heroine whose first *Tomb Raider* movie grossed more than \$400 million worldwide. This film franchise, of course, is the product of

a popular electronic game — and that, says Jolie, created problems in developing an electronically-created heroine such as Lara Croft for the big screen. That's why she jumped at the chance to do a follow-up.

"It was hard to go from the game to the first one. We couldn't adjust too much. This time we wanted a solid story. We wanted a real flesh and blood woman with relationships. There was so much we didn't feel satisfied with in the first one so I wanted to finish it and do it right."

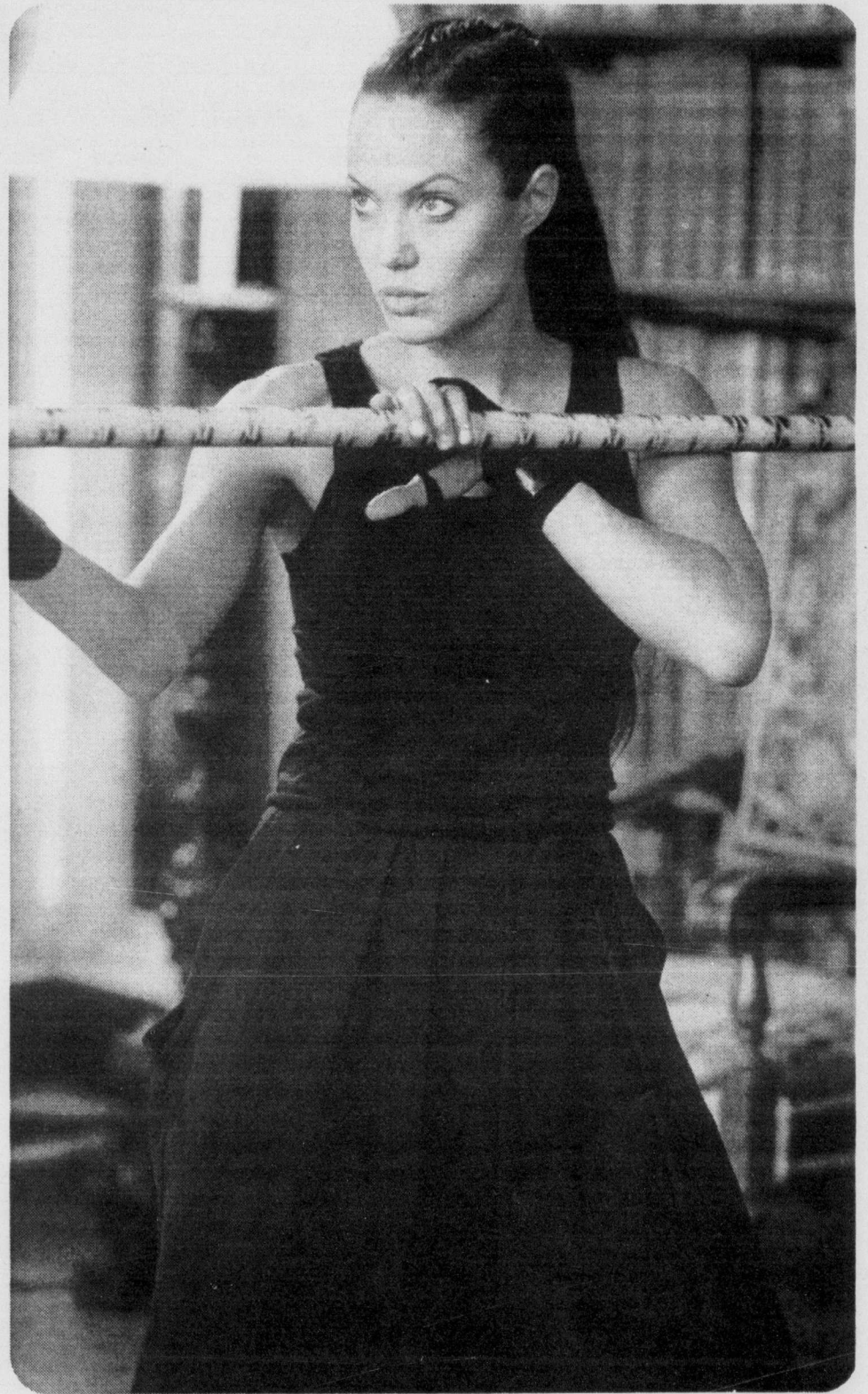
Once again in the film opening July 25, she must be the most resourceful of action heroines — she spent months perfecting her skills in gymnastics, weightlifting, bungee jumping, motorcycling, kick-boxing and weapons training. But she also wanted to show the aristocratic side of a woman who, when she's not battling evil around the world, inhabits a stately manor house in the English countryside.

As always, Jolie did many of her own stunts — including a 150-foot drop head-first over a cliff and a chase scene in which she rides sidesaddle on a horse while she fires a gun at her enemies, reloads, and fires again.

"I like to do as much as I possibly can and as much as the insurance will allow me to do. Because it's a great opportunity to try something new — because I'm an adrenaline junkie, which is part of the character."

Jolie, who was paid \$12 million to do the movie, took her responsibilities seriously — to the point of butting heads with director Jan de Bont. De Bont, who is best known for *Speed*, has the reputation of being a demanding, dictatorial filmmaker, but Jolie makes it clear she was never intimidated by him. "I think we fight pretty even," she says.

The longer she talks, the more the notorious figure of the tabloids recedes. Inevitably, she touches on yet another side of Angelina Jolie — the Angelina Jolie who has clocked tens of thousands of kilometres as a goodwill ambassador for the United Nations Refugee Agency. Anxious to learn more about the UN's relief work, she made two incognito missions to Third World African countries nearly three years ago, and then assumed a higher public profile as the agency's ambassador. "I took a journey in my own life," she says simply.

The Chatham, Ont. native's road to success has been a long one. Born on July 1, Wright's parents were both performers; she literally grew up on stage with her mother and father.

Wright began performing as a teenager. For a while, she traveled between the United States and Canada, but finally signed an American recording deal. Soon after, she moved in Nashville, where she has been living ever since.

Wright may reside in another country, but it never stopped her love affair with Canada's country music fans. She's a proud Canadian, and loves it

when her tour brings her back to her native country. In the music industry, some people are artists while others are entertainers. Wright is both.
