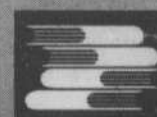

Mussels are marvelous at Belgian restaurant

But offal is awful

It's no secret Le Chou de Bruxelles serves up the most exquisite mussels in these parts. On a quiet Tuesday night, the Galt Street restaurant was bustling with diners huddled over pots of the succulently steamed seafood, smothered in a variety of accompaniments. Nearly every one of the 100 or so seats in the restored house was occupied with serious diners picking seafood from shells.

European to the core, the menu also offers a selection of delicacies not often seen in local restaurants, as well as a few surprises.

We began with the soups- a rich cream of tomato with a hint of cheese

and a fish soup in a cream broth, both of which came piping hot and stood the chef in good stead for the remainder of the meal.

For the main course, my mussels-loving partner opted for mussels 'au crabe' which was delivered in a small black pot of steaming tender mussels, with crabmeat and melted cheese. It was accompanied by a side order of homefries.

Suffice to say the restaurant's reputation is well-earned. Large, juicy melt-in-your-mouth mussels were incomparable to any that either of us had ever tasted.

I decided to try the restaurant's other offerings and chose from the table d'hôte a veal dish in cream with peppercorns described on the menu as 'Sambre et Meuse,' a term that only chefs trained in French haute cuisine can recognize.

I admired what looked like perfectly shaped mushrooms in the candlelight, but noted they tasted very strong. After a few tentative bites, I checked with our waiter who informed me, by pointing to his lower back, that I was eating veal kidneys. He took my 'yuck' in stride and did not appear to be offended when I told him I thought offal is awful. He politely offered another choice which I declined. For those so inclined to animal innards, the menu also offered veal sweetbread with scampi and leeks and the ever-popular, veal brain in hazelnut butter which made the kidneys swimming in cream on my plate look somewhat better.

Aside from these house specials, there was a wide range of more standard meat and seafood with some interesting combinations which I will definitely try another time. For example, the filet of sole is served with fresh

scallops in a creamy curry sauce, and chicken is twinned with shrimp in a garlicky cream sauce. Beef, lamb and veal are also prepared in mouth-watering sauces that would surely leave diners satisfied.

Our waiter returned with a luscious dessert for me of a light waffle in pureed pear with dollops of cream and melon balls which I thoroughly appreciated. And to show that customer satisfaction is important, when the bill arrived, it was for one person only.

Diners are invited to bring their own wine which keeps the bill for two to under \$50 which we agreed was a real bargain. Specialties range from 12.95 to \$26.95 and from Sunday to Thursday, you can eat mussels till the cows come home for an additional \$2.50.

Alcan quartet to broadcast Beethoven from BU

Music students get to hear their compositions played

The Alcan Quartet is recording all 16 Beethoven quartets in its cross-Quebec tour and Radio Canada will be on hand at Bandeen Hall at Bishop's University on Friday March 17 to record the Lennoxville leg of the tour.

Other tour stops include: Rimouski, Montreal at Ahuntsic, Chicoutimi, Aylmer and Domaine Forget. All concerts will be broadcast consecutively in the Autumn of 2000.

The Quartet, first violinist Brett Molvan, 2nd violinist Nathalie Camus, violist Luc Beauchemin and cellist David Ellis will also be sharing its musical ex-

pertise.

"We're expanding our stay at the University to work with the students," explained David Ellis. "It's a great opportunity for everybody. Some of the students in Andrew MacDonald's composition class have submitted pieces they've been working on this year. There are four or five string quartets. This is a chance for composers to hear their pieces played."

"This is the first time we've really done something like that," Ellis

continued, "We've played quite a bit of modern stuff but not in a teaching situation. The concert with the students is on Sunday March 19."

The quartet wants to familiarize students with musical life.

"We're bringing along a film of an American string quartet. This is a good snapshot of what it's like to have a professional musical life.

"On Thursday, March 16, there will be

an open musical rehearsal with an open discussion. At the end, people will be free to ask us questions about any subject concerning playing in a string quartet."

The Alcan Quartet has been together for 11 years - a long time in the life of a string quartet.

"There's a lot of luck involved in forming a string quartet. Nathalie and I are married. I was doing a lot of travelling by myself and she was playing with an orchestra.

"We really wanted to try something like this. We met Brett Molvan in classes at McGill and he had a friend who played viola. The four of us wanted to see how it would work.

"It wasn't what it is today, but we had the seeds of something that could work long term. The four of us got together and basically auditioned for the job."

The Alcan Quartet was created when the Saguenay Lac St-Jean Orchestra approached Alcan. The funding is split be-

tween the orchestra and Alcan.

Initially the group had to consider being named after a company.

"Over the years, it's become something, we don't even think about anymore," said Ellis.

"We have a good relationship with the company. They are so good to work with and open to projects and ideas and ways to work things out. All partners in our project work amazingly well together."

This is partially funded by Academic Enrichment - Bishop's University Foundation.

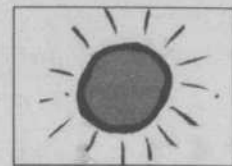


Exhibit takes children on world adventure

Three Countries in a Suitcase Exhibition in Sherbrooke

"It's like a maze, Mommy!" my younger daughter excitedly called back to me from where she had plunged into the "Three Countries in a Suitcase" exhibit now showing at the Musée du Séminaire de Sherbrooke. The cries of "Look at this! Look at this!" quelled parental fears of having to endure a boring museum display with two active children.

Instead, there was just too much to do - like try on a real Ivory Coast "pagne", a woman's wrap skirt made from 10 metres of printed cotton fabric (mirror provided); or bop along to Jayac La Fuerza del Canto (a popular Ecuadorean music group) on ear-phones; or put on a do-it-yourself Thailand puppet show.

The three countries are separated by "banana" curtains and there are "banana" couches at convenient places for

little legs to rest and just absorb all the information and fun. You can locate each country on a map and read about its size, population, religion, language and ethnic groups. There's lots of big, beautiful photographs of children playing, working and going to school. The exhibit organizers seemed to know exactly what kind of questions a child might ask about children in another country. What do the children wear to school? (Mostly uniforms.) What do they eat for snacks? (Chocolate bananas!) What kind of music do they listen to and what do they carry their books in to go to school? (Pop music and book bags just like us.)

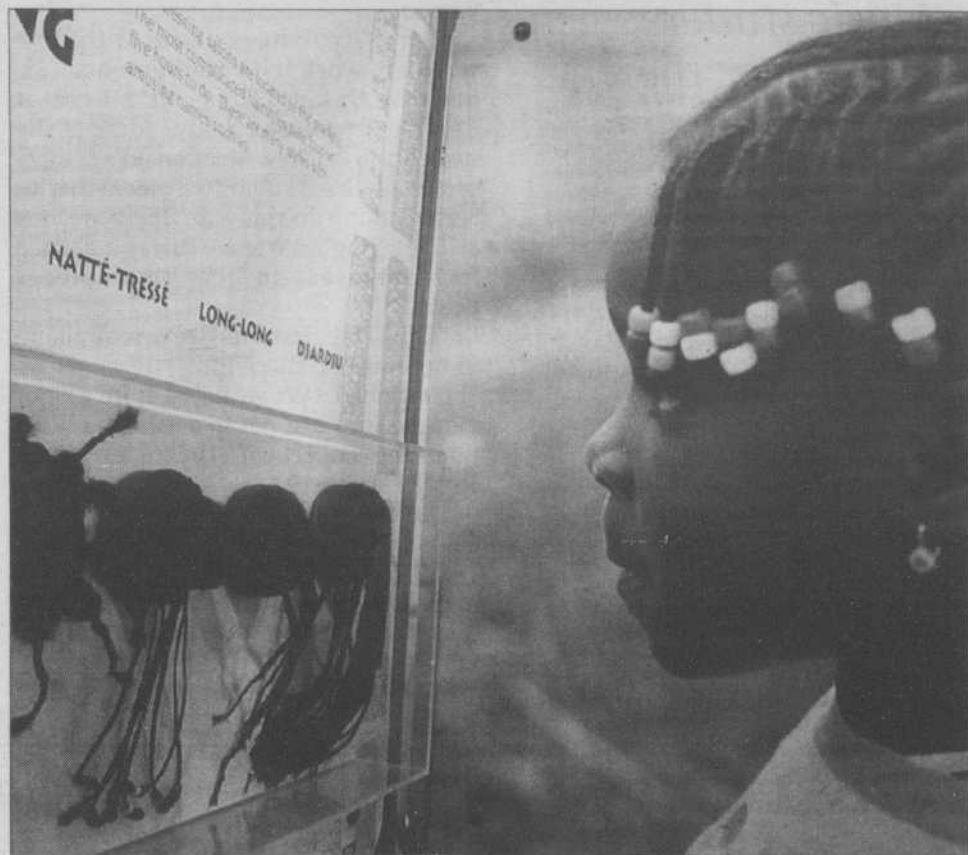
My ten-year-old liked trying to carry the "baby" dolls the best; in Ecuador she finally mastered the technique of tying the brightly coloured shawl around her waist without dropping the "baby" back on its head. She also got the message that in these countries children go to work at an early age, either at home or on the street, washing car windows or selling bananas. Babies were one thing, but trying to pick up the 50-pound sack of potatoes and carry it bound by a single rope on your back was truly a challenge.

For my eight-year-old, the most fun was the market stand, complete with apron, money and plastic fruit and vegetables in the Ecuador display. She also enjoyed the scene of people from the Ivory Coast whom she could clothe in various magnetized outfits. Wooden xylophones and an Ecuadorean rain stick (when it is turned the beads falling inside sound like rain) provide young musicians with plenty of scope and boxes of exotic "guess-the-smells" challenge the imagination.

A picture may tell a thousand words, but wearing the right hat, hoisting up a sack of potatoes and grinding "food" in a wooden grinder with a pestle (it's heavy!) gives the real feeling of being a child in one of these countries.

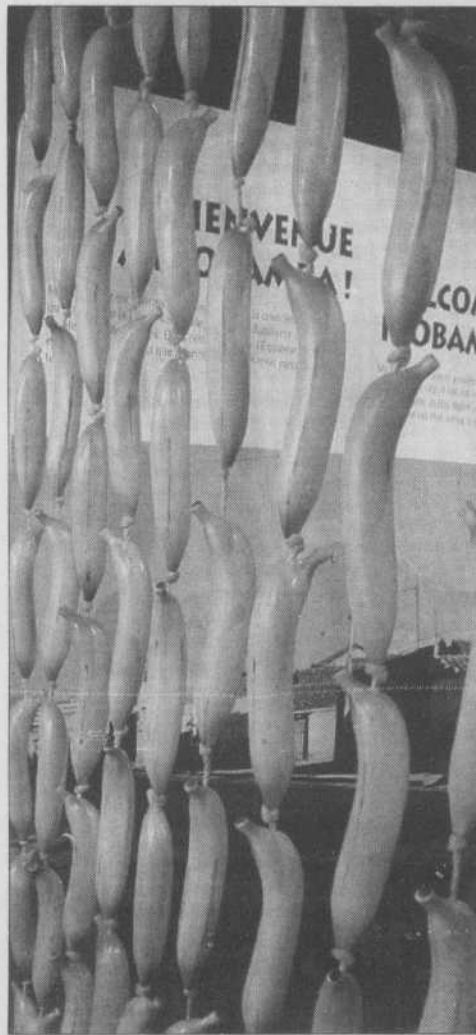
It took one hour to tour the displays, just about right for children, but adults may want to spend a bit more time to take in all the information. Everything in the display is child-friendly so parents need not worry about breakables or objects that may inflict injury.

The exhibit belongs to the Musée de la civilisation Québec and was produced in cooperation with the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) for the International Year of the Family (1994). The exhibit runs until April 24 and is open to the public every day except Monday.

BROKEDOWN PALACE

"It's strange how it's the little things that make the big things happen", says Alice (Claire Danes) at the beginning of this psychologically somber film. From this moment on, we know that this character will undergo a journey that will teach her important lessons.

Alice and Darlene (Kate Beckinsale) have been inseparable for years. However, now that they graduated from high school, their paths will inevitably separate them. To celebrate the end of this chapter and the beginning of the new chapter in their lives, the girls decide to take a memorable and inexpensive trip to Thailand. There, the girls devilishly dare to do as they please.

When they sneak into a first class hotel and get caught, a seductive gentleman, Nick Parks (Daniel Lapaine), helps them get out of trouble. Both girls are charmed by Nick, but Darlene is smitten and Nick somehow convinces her to go with him to Hong Kong. Alice has no choice but to follow her best friend.

When they arrive at the airport, Alice and Darlene are wrongly arrested for drug smuggling. Nick is nowhere to be found. An American Attorney, Hank Green (Bill Pullman), is their only hope to escape the cruel Thai justice system.

With extreme lighting contrasts, director Jonathan Kaplan has successfully created the sensations of gloom and desperation that these characters feel. Broke-down Palace is engaging and visually interesting. It's a good renter for those who enjoy psychological dramas.

REACH THE ROCK

This film is worse than last week's Story of Us. It seems that director William Ryan had a small budget. However, we should not blame the film's disengagement entirely on the budget because there is little you can do with a bad script. In short, the story fails to captivate us.

This is the story of a young man, Robin (Alessandro Nivola), who feels stuck in a dead end situation: his girl, Lisa (Brooke Langton), has left town and his best friend (Norman Reedus) died. The small town life is too boring and lacks opportunities for Robin. So far so good, but as the plot unfolds it completely disengages us. Instead of packing up his bags and leaving, Robin's idea of adventure is to break the hardware shop's window. He then

gets arrested by sergeant Quinn (William Sattler) who detests him. During the next hour, Robin plays tricks on the sergeant, and they engage in never-ending conversations.

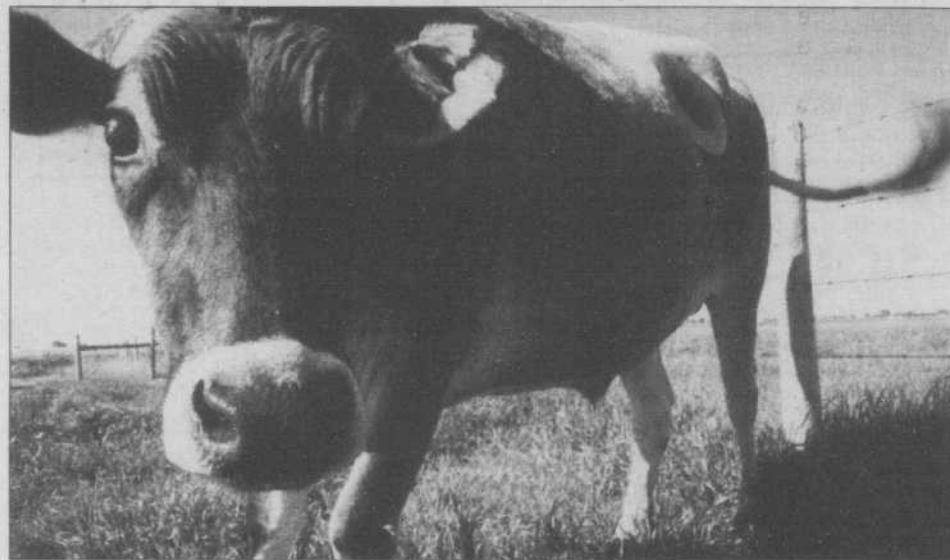

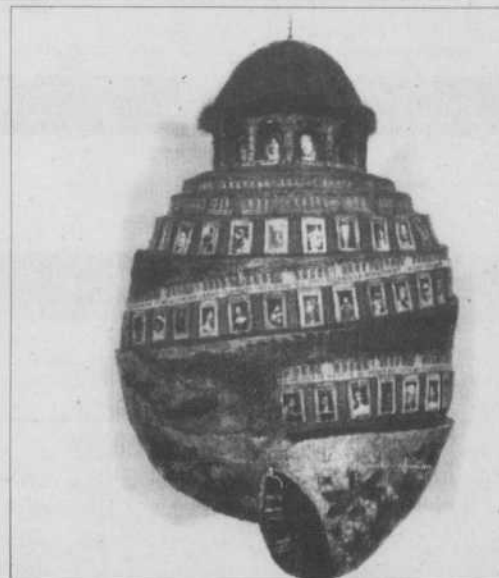


Special jazz invitation

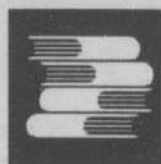
Artist in Residence

From novels and biographies to cookbooks and beyond, there's nothing like a good read

Pilgrim has a story to tell and a master to tell it

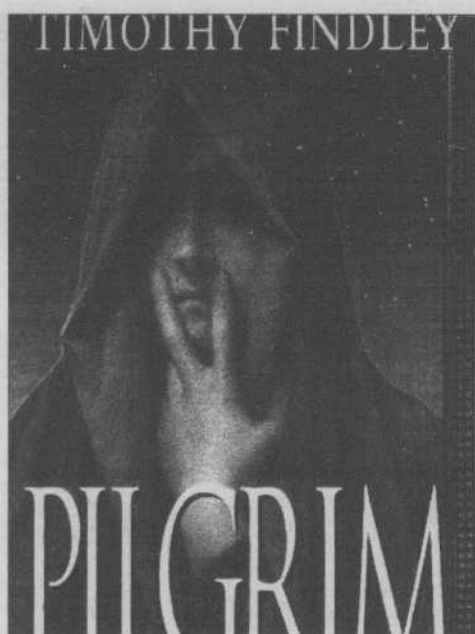

Pilgrim' is a good long read, delivered by one of Canada's most esteemed, prolific writers, Timothy Findley. 'Pilgrim' is a nice return to the kind of imaginative scope of 'Not Wanted on the Voyage' with the eye for detail present in Findley's more historical narratives.

The book begins as a good book should with lots of questions and intrigue. It would seem that Pilgrim, an imposing 6' 6" man of means - an art historian with good friends and fine clothes would have no good reason to kill himself. So why is he so determined to do so? His angelic friend Sybil, has brought him to the Burgholzli clinic of a certain Carl-Gustav Jung. Jung, portrayed variously as sympathetic, craven, jealous, brilliant and naive poaches his patient from his colleague, Furtwangler.

This is as much a story about Carl Jung and his wife Emma, as it is

Pilgrim's. The silent Pilgrim has a story to tell - a long story that encom-

passes many different time periods.

For ages, Pilgrim has existed as man, woman and child and Pilgrim is tired - of the excesses of genius, the cruelty of mankind and of his own minor impact

on the human story.

Findley takes great care to reveal Pilgrim's true story to the patient, intelligent and repressed Emma Jung in the form of Pilgrim's diaries, entrusted to Carl by Pilgrim's best friend.

Carl Jung, the great psychiatrist, in the end proves unworthy of the tale. The peripheral characters of 'Pilgrim' are treated with respect - assistant Kessler with his sad childhood and his own journey into mental illness is drawn to 'Pilgrim'. Countess Blavinskeya with her balletic finery and dreams of trying to get back to the moon and her devoted helper, Sister Dora are well-drawn.

Occasionally, Findley's vision of mental illness is a little emotional with maltreatment at the core of every disease, but the residents of the Burgholzli clinic are wholly believable.

The diaries are a nice addition to the narrative. The story of Leonardo da Vinci's lust for Angelo Gherardini is beautifully told drawing the reader in to the time of a repressive Catholic church and the Bonfire of the Vanities. A later rendering of the life of Oscar

Wilde suffers a little from didacticism.

One can feel the narrative stop and the factual life of Oscar Wilde begin. The story from the diaries of Teresa of Avila and Manolo the shepherd boy is again beautifully told.

Though Jung, like modern psychiatry itself, founders, his own struggles

with his inner voices redeem him. Like psychiatry, Jung goes from interesting case to interesting case, losing passion in search of the latest thing. Against all odds, Jung comes to believe in Pilgrim and the power of the inexplicable.

'Pilgrim' is an examination of the human psyche and of the servant/master relationship.

Its themes of the arrogance of science and the beauty of faith are timely. Findley has set himself the difficult task of mixing fact and fiction and does so with aplomb.

Misogyny is alive and well on Earth. Who knew Garry Shandling would have to play an alien to make us understand?

Shandling plays an alien on a sexual mission in his new comedy What Planet Are You From? The premise involves Shandling coming to Earth in the form of banker Harold Anderson, sent by his superiors to impregnate an Earth woman as part of a play to take over the planet. To this end, Shandling's character teams up with sleazy co-worker Perry Gordon (played by Greg Kinnear) to pick up babes at an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting.

Enter Annette Bening, as former wild-child Susan who is persuaded by Harold to marry him and procreate. Running gags throughout the film include Shandling's penis, a marvel of futuristic technology except for the humming noise it produces, as well as alien leader Ben Kingsley's meetings with Shandling in airplane lavatories and subsequent flushings to leave Earth.

This film is replete with appearances from big Hollywood names, including Linda Fiorentino as a dissatisfied housewife, John Goodman as an obsessed FAA agent and Camryn Manheim as a nosy gossip. And as long as the viewer takes this silly film for what it's worth, there are plenty of laughs watching an extra-terrestrial playing a would-be gigolo with Earth women.

Director Mike Nichols (The Birdcage) makes the most of his cast in this fluffy caper, which does not attempt to dissect the relationships between men and women, but in fact explores the lengths men will go to for sex. Those looking for enlightenment on the finer points of

love and romance should avoid this flick, since The English Patient it ain't.

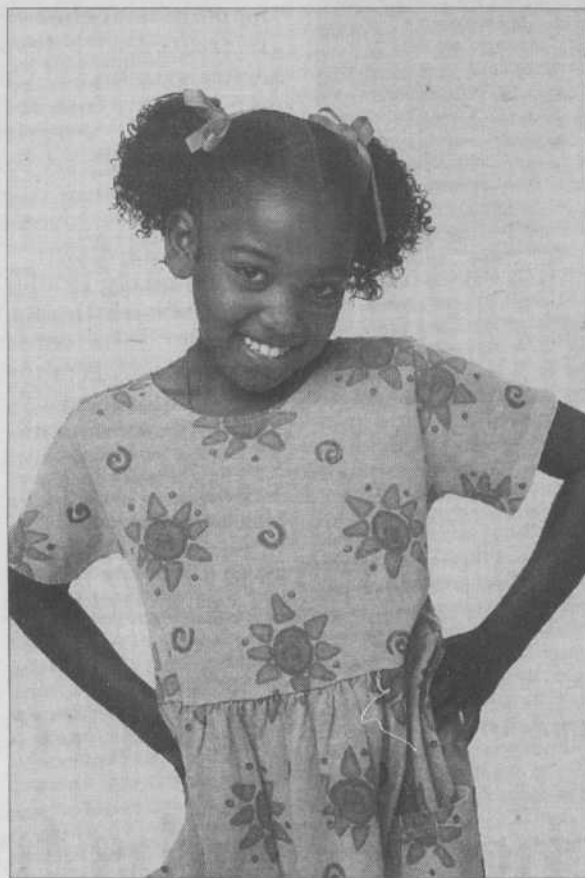

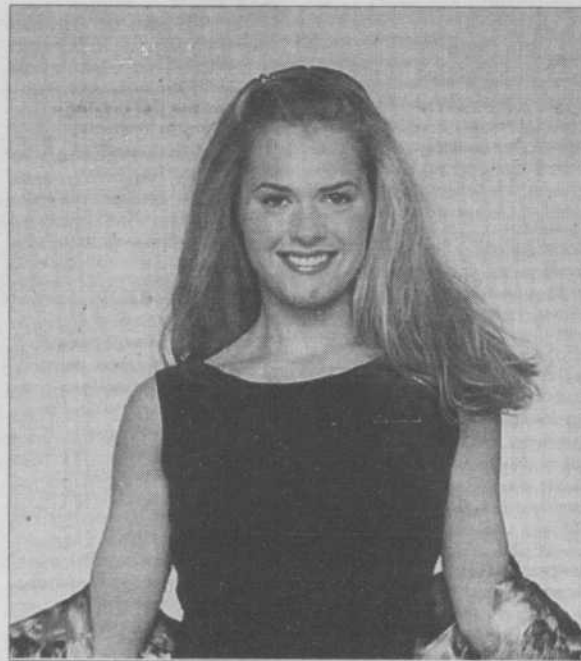

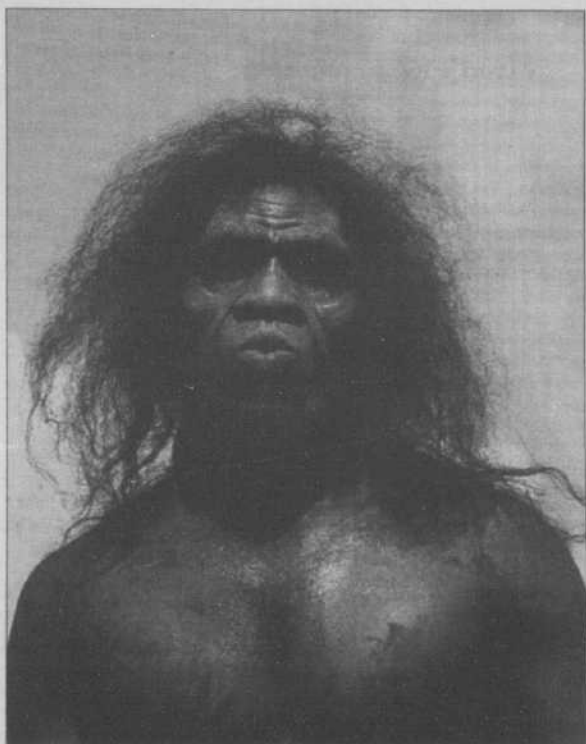
