## Wherefore art thou, music man?

### Romeo and Juliet made modern

A tragic tale of star-crossed lovers is coming to Bishop's University, complete with fight scenes and lavish costumes. Except this version of Romeo and Juliet will be much easier to understand, says its director.

"Shakespeare scares some people" because of the sometimes tough dialogue, says Bishop's drama professor and playwright George Rideout.

"But this musical is adapted to take place in 1892 as opposed to the 13th century.

"We had such a great time and huge response last year (with A Beatles Midsummer Night's Dream) that we decided to keep the momentum going, although this musical is a tragedy. Last year we took Shakespeare and cut out parts of the script to make room for music but this year it is an entirely new script. This script jumps ahead by six centuries, but is still the classic Shakespeare tale."

Rideout is an accomplished theatre habitué. His work has been produced across Canada, including locally at the Piggery in North Hatley and at Theatre Lac Brome in Knowlton. His writing credits include Texas Boy, The Longstreth Line, Dead Together, An Anglophone is Coming to Dinner, and The

# In 1900, dinner took 6 hours to make

# Food

## Home-cooked dinner increasingly rare

The business of eating has changed, big time. Just have a look at Canada Safeway. The supermarket giant is slowly remaking all its stores and calling them Lifestyle Stores. Expanded deli sections with take-away meals are a big part of each remake.

Where once barbecued chicken, potato salad, coleslaw and three-bean salad were Safeway's mainstays for fresh, ready-to-eat meals, the revamped stores have prime rib, roast turkey, ham, pork ribs, meat loaf, shaved barbecue beef, mac and cheese, salads and side dishes. At Christmas, they have turkey dinners to go and by this fall, they'll have a new line of fully cooked meals, Main Dishes in Moments, which will take eight minutes to heat up.

"We're responding to how everyone's lives have changed," says Canada Safeway spokesman Scott Gibney. "Everyone has a frantic lifestyle. There's no free time."

According to the Dietitians of Canada, in 1900, dinner preparation took over six hours; 100 years later, it had dropped to 45 minutes a day; today, the average household spends 20 minutes a day preparing dinner.

Lack of time, lack of energy to cook, lack of ideas, lack of planning and lack of skills were cited as barriers to preparing dinner, in descending order of significance.

*Progressive Grocer*, an industry magazine, last year reported that 51 per cent of grocery shoppers wanted more varieties of fresh, prepared foods for quick dinner assembly. And an AC Nielsen report showed dry grocery sales fell by 8.3 per cent from 2001 to 2005 while deli sales rose 22.1 per cent in the U.S.

The *Wall St. Journal* reported that grocers have been expanding their array of prepared foods for the past decade, which is plain to see.

Families aren't alone in the race to dinner and other meals. Many 20-somethings as well as 70- and 80-somethings aren't keen about cooking and neither are a lot of singles. Together, they make up another big segment of the market for ready-to-eat meals.

Our culture jumped into the fast lane and accelerated through the decades. Consider that 70 per cent of families are dual-income and 14 per cent are single-parent families. In the workplace, downsizing, mergers and employment insecurity has led to longer working hours, less leisure time and tired souls.

Add to this, our modern-day impa-

tiency. Computers, microwaves, cellphones, beepers and the Internet whooshed us into a "faster, faster" mindset, expecting instant results.

While niche businesses have jumped in to quell dinnertime frenzy (personal chefs, frozen gourmet foods, full meal take-outs, kitchens where ingredients are prepped and customers cook up the meal, home delivery services of meals), supermarkets are the one-stop shop. You can get your meal and round it out with fresh fruits, pre-washed salad greens, bread from the bakery and pick up makings for tomorrow's lunches as well as Tide and toilet paper.

Putting things in context, Patricia Chuey, manager of nutritional affairs for the Overwait-ea Food Group, says Dietitians of Canada is astonished at the nation's 20-minute dinners.

"That's making and eating dinner," she says. "Seven years ago, it was estimated to be 30 minutes. In the 1950s, it took two hours. People were roasting and braising and making casseroles. Today, schedules are jam-packed and food is fuel for all the other activities. It's interesting how The Food Network cooking shows are popular but they're seen as entertainment. It's a novelty to see people cooking."

"There are drawbacks," Chuey says, "to the dinnertime squeeze. Doing dinner quickly often means sacrificing something nutritionally. Today, adults are only getting 50 per cent of recommended amounts of fruits and vegetables and seven out of 10 kids aren't getting enough."

Dinner, she says, is when children could learn about nutrition and cooking. "But kids have a diminishing sense of where food comes from and what it

means," she says.

At the same time, she recognizes that creativity takes the bullet when people are under pressure. "For so many people, the hardest decision of the day is what's for dinner; people are tired and hungry and there are arguments. No wonder it's a stressful hour."

She has some rules when it comes to picking up prepared meals. "At least half of the plate should be vegetables, one quarter should be protein and

rounded off with, ideally, whole grains," she says.

"The cool thing about grocery stores is, if the dish doesn't have enough vegetables, you can buy some salad mixes or cut-up veggies with a dip. You want to make sure there's not a lot of fat and salt and watch the sauces.

"Fresh food doesn't necessarily guarantee it's the most healthy, so don't be fooled."

# A summer potpourri

## Shoe polish and birdhouses

What do you get when you cross a rooster, shoe polish, and birdhouses made of forks and spoons? You get the eighth annual Bonheur d'été exhibit at the Uplands Cultural and Heritage Centre, comprised of dozens of pieces by 10 local artists.

Some articulate their talent through creating birdhouses like Michele Gagnon, some cast iron into sculptures like Jacques Desruisseaux, and others use fancy wood like Lyne Montmeny. All have a flare for the arts, says Uplands director Nancy Robert.

"Anything goes with this exhibit," said Robert, who is planning for the show's vernissage this Sunday. "It's a group show that gives local artists a

platform and a chance to promote their work. The show offers a variety of styles and pieces.

"For instance, Eve Pankovitch actually uses shoe polish to create her paintings and they are amazing, while Lyne Montmeny, who is referred to as La Madame des Coqs, creates different styles of roosters."

For Koni Marcoux, the fixation is with colour.

"I love colours," said Marcoux, who moved to Coaticook three years ago after her husband retired from the Embassy in Washington, D.C. "I visited Nancy in 2004 to show her some of my paintings and I was very pleased when she invited me to partake in this show. I will be bringing a total of six paintings in different sizes and I think my style is a combination of realism and impressionism. I think it's great for a small community to have something like

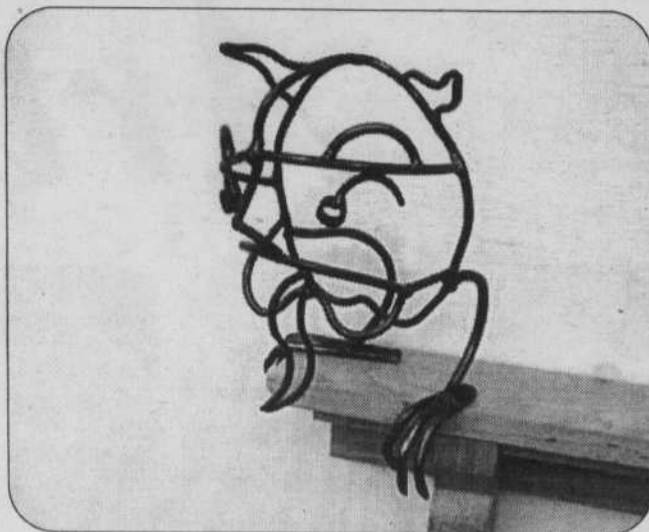

this." Works from painter Sylvie Gagnon, photographer Mary Landry, mixed media artist Lorraine Levesque, and ceramics by France Malo will dot the centre's halls for a real potpourri.

Tall Girl – and his A Beatle's Midsummer Night's Dream played to sold out houses.

This adaptation is The Ballad of Romeo and Juliet, in which – and this will sound familiar – a bitter feud between the powerful Capulets and Montagues leads to the tragic deaths of the two young lovers.

But the families inhabit the mountains of West Virginia. The original lingo is replaced with southern mountain dialect, or the folk speech of Appalachia.

Rideout will direct a cast of 27 actors and actresses, and he also wrote more than half of the 25 songs that will be performed live by three musicians.

"I wrote 14, I made new lyrics for seven old traditional songs, and the band will also perform three traditional songs ('Hard Times', 'Wayfaring Stranger', 'When I Die I'll Live Again')," Rideout said. "All of the music will be performed live in the Appalachian traditions with ballads, reels, folk arias, blues, jug band music, bluegrass, and good ole fiddle and banjo hog chasin' tunes."

The three-piece band is made up of Montreal fiddler Jonathan Moorman,

music student Fannie Gaudette, and Joe Grass on string instruments, which Rideout trusts will bring out even the non-stage performance lovers.

"This is going to be a feast for the ears," said the 20-year university prof. "For people who don't come out often to watch a play or musical the music alone will make it worth while."

This will make Rideout's second musical as director and he said what makes him the proudest is how all the "pieces fit together", including the music, which will be under the direction of Gaudette and Jamie Crooks.

Crooks, who heads the university choir, will also play Juliet's father and Rideout says his age and character will add realism.

"A musical in itself is not exactly realism, but some scenes are very realistic, like the ones with Crooks and Juliet (played by Stephanie Higgins), and very powerful. Anyone's greatest fear is losing a child."

The detailed scenes and props came with a heavy price tag and all the proceeds – tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for students – will go to expenses. The musical will take the stage Friday, June 8 to 11 and again from June 12 to 16 at 8 p.m. To buy tickets call the Centennial Box Office at 819-822-9692 or the Bishop's main switchboard at 819-822-9600, ext. 2628. The show is at the Turner Studio.

# ABR's big noise

## Mountain rock

Anything But Reason, a band originally from Brome-Missisquoi (with one member living in Lennoxville), has been chosen to lead off the first CIDI music challenge. Stop!

This is a community TV show produced by Radio Communautaire Missisquoi (RCM) in conjunction with Télévision Communautaire de Waterloo. Stop! will begin its first run this September on Canal Vox, Videotron's Quebec community network.

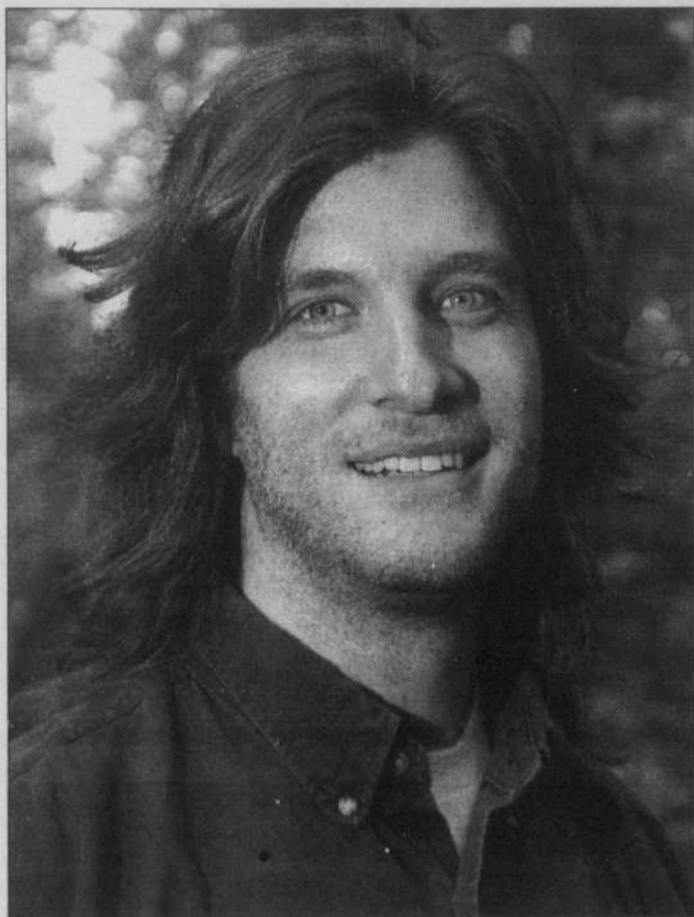
Our mission sets the music challenge apart from other

Star-Search type TV shows. All of the artists must have original material if they want to participate and must perform their own music. The idea of the show is to encourage individuality and creativity within the 15- to 44-year-old demographic of the Eastern Townships (okay, those are stats, so it's not etched in stone, and if you're a couple of years over or under, we really don't mind).

Each RCM music challenge includes six groups, lasts four months and produces three winners (first, second and third). Eventually these winners will be included in a top 30 play list that will be broadcast on CIDI 99.1 FM once up and running.

Small town boys Anything But Reason (ABR), from Knowlton, were raised in the country on genuine rock 'n' roll and are in their late 20s and early 30s. They make big-time noise and are anything but average. At a time when belly-aching urban rock bands are a dime a dozen, ABR's mountain rock is truly welcome. Look out, sasquatch!

Why "mountain rock"? If you've ever lived in Brome-Missisquoi you must cer-

tainly be aware of the wall of mountains stretching east to west along the Canada-US border, and until you leave the area you'll never know how much it affects you. Imagine now, if you will, what kind of rock music you'll be writing and performing if you are so inclined.

With catchy riffs and inspiring lyrics, frontman Joe Lambert, guitarist Ryan Clarkson, bassist Derek Charby and drummer Paul Giddings have been writing music since 1997. They have come down from the mountains on several occasions to play infamous watering holes such as the Thirsty Boot and the Knowlton Pub, becoming local favourites as a result, and have gone on to terrorize cushy urban Montreal — leaving only a foot print in the pavement as a warning.

Anything But Reason's accomplishments include shows at West Brome's Sunnymead Festival, the Brome County Agricultural Fair, the Maysen in Lennoxville and Montreal venues like Club Zone (currently Club One), Le Swimming and Club Dome, where they

recently placed third at a Rogers Wireless Battle of the Bands.

The band's independent recordings to date are 1999's *Anything But Reason*, 2003's *Ribs at Midnight*, *The Camp* in 2004 and most recently, *Six Pack* Press.

At the age of 34, Richard Semmelhaack, the bilingual host of the *Stop* show injects life into the local TV production and appreciates heavy rock as much as the lighter elements of pop music. Having grown up at his father's Frost Village farm, Semmelhaack traveled between Montreal and the country as a kid. He was always anxious for school to let out, looking forward to spending three blissful months of summer in the Townships.

After graduating from John Abbott college and then earning a degree from McGill University, he chose to remain in the Townships permanently and become an organic farmer. He never gave up his passion for music, which began after high school, and landed his first job in a hard rock Metallica tribute band in the early '90s. Wanting to play his own songs Semmelhaack soon left the group to form *IceScream* in 2001.

Semmelhaack takes on the hosting duties of *Stop* fully aware of what it takes to be a young artist looking for a break in today's music industry. He realizes as well that the business of music has changed and that one must have a new attitude in order to take on

the giant.

"We've all got to stop pretending and start being who we are," says Semmelhaack. "I guess you could say that I'm looking forward to promoting and helping bands that are playing originals... as I left the tribute band thing behind."

Remember, we only need 3,000 members to get our broadcast tower and CIDI up and running. With a potential audience of 26,000 Vox viewers (mainly francophone) exposed to RCM's goal of having a CIDI broadcast tower, the dream becomes more of a reality. We have about 200 members; that leaves only 2,800 more to sign up.

## CBC's fall season

### Reality shows

Reality is the new reality at CBC-TV. The public broadcaster's fall 2007 TV schedule, unveiled in Toronto before advertisers, features two new reality programs, as well as the return of *Dragon's Den* and *Test the Nation*.

*Dragon's Den* features aspiring entrepreneurs pitching business ideas to a panel of corporate CEOs. *Test the Nation* is a national quiz show that challenges viewers to predict the results of polls. Both programs performed strongly for CBC-TV last season, as the public broadcaster struggled to rebuild its schedule and stem the flow of viewers to other channels.

*Test the Nation: National IQ Test* was seen by 1.5 million viewers. The follow-up, *Test the Nation: Watch Your Language*, will test English-speaking Canadians on how they use — and abuse — the Queen's English.

The two new reality programs are *No Opportunity Wasted*, in which adventurer and *Amazing Race* host Phil Keoghan challenges ordinary, everyday Canadians to overcome their basic fears and realize their goals, and *Triple Sensation*, a nationwide talent search for young performers, aged 16 to 26, who can sing, act and dance.

CBC-TV will also unveil a pair of new documentary series, a new family drama set in Alberta called *Heartland*, a miniseries based on a Mordecai Richler novel (*St Urbain's Horseman*), *Torchwood* — a spin-off of the cult sci-fi series *Doctor Who* and the miniseries, *The Tudors*, based on the life of Henry VIII.

CBC will launch its fall season in the

first week of October, two weeks earlier than in past years.

Kirstine Layfield, CBC-TV's executive director of programming, said consistency is the watchword for fall. The new season will emphasize regularly scheduled programs and series over one-time-only event programming.

"We're trying to build a loyal, distinct viewing audience," Layfield said in an interview with CanWest News Service. "We have consistency, in that we have series. And we have variety, in that we have so many different genres this year. We're broadening our appeal."

CBC-TV is trying to reach younger viewers, Layfield acknowledged.

"All the networks are trying to make sure their programming is as fresh as possible," Layfield said. "I'm interested in audiences of all types."

Layfield insists CBC's new programs won't alienate CBC's core audience of older viewers who have come to know and appreciate a certain style of program. "We're hoping they watch together. We're really not trying to appeal to one segment of the audience. There's not a single show here that somebody over the age of 50 wouldn't watch. At the same time, we're trying to make sure we have no show that nobody under the age of 50 will watch. We found last year that shows like *Little Mosque* appealed to a wide range of viewers."

# Books

## Thriller becomes a quest for identity

One of the remarkable aspects of Canadian life is the cultural diversity we experience on a daily basis. It is often observed that, compared with our neighbours to the south, Canadians are a more open, more welcoming people, tolerant of other cultures and celebrating their differences. As a result, Canada attracts some of the most talented immigrants from around the world, enriching us all. Such is the case with this week's author.

Forsaking the familiar path of Cuban expatriates who settled in South Florida, José Latour left Cuba for Spain, and subsequently came to Canada in the fall of 2004. With less than three years on our soil, he has already enriched the Canadian literary scene.

JOSÉ LATOUR

Latour brings with him impressive credentials. A former vice president of the International Association of Crime Writers, and one of the Spanish-speaking world's top crime fiction writers, his novels have been published in Britain, the United States, Japan, Germany, Italy, France, Spain and the Netherlands. Latour currently lives in Toronto.

**OUTCAST**  
(McCLELLAND & STEWART, 2007)

With the fall of the former Soviet Union and the co-opting of China into the capitalist camp, Cuba remains today the last bastion of old-school Communism. Elliot Steil is a 44-year-old schoolteacher living in Havana, eking out a squalid existence teaching English to his charges. Because his father fled Cuba for America, Elliot is viewed with suspicion by the Communist Party authorities who run every aspect of Cuban life. His career has been placed on hold, and his personal life is not much better. He feels frustrated with his government and betrayed by his father, who abandoned him and his mother soon after settling in the United States.

Elliot has long considered trying to reach American shores, but he is all too aware of the dangers, both physical and political, in attempting to escape from the land of his birth. He has no desire to drown at sea, as have so many of his countrymen; nor does he wish to be-

come an outcast — a social pariah — if he were to be betrayed to the authorities.

Small wonder, then, that Elliot is intrigued when an American appears, claiming to be sent by his father to get him out of Cuba and into the US.

He makes his plans carefully and furtively, arranging to be picked up by the man in a small power boat just off the Cuban coast. The boat arrives as planned, Elliot swims out and is hauled aboard, and dares to dream of a new life in a new land.

Of course, things are seldom that simple. A few miles at sea Elliot is attacked by his alleged benefactor and thrown overboard. Several

hours later he is picked up by a family of rafters who are themselves trying to escape to Florida. After days at sea, and nearly dead from thirst and starvation, the group is finally spotted by a US Coast Guard patrol and taken to Miami. After they are subjected to close questioning, Elliot and his fellow rafters are given political asylum.

Elliot's first goal is to establish himself in his new home. Immersing himself within the local Cuban community, he takes a succession of subsistence jobs, legal and otherwise, and gradually improves his situation. Before long he begins to get his bearings and gradually acquires the means to allow him to

move to the next step: to track down the man who attempted to kill him, to find out why, and to discover just exactly what happened to his father and why he abandoned his family so many years ago.

Elliot's quest will be a journey that cuts across all strata of American life, from car thieves to small businessmen, to the dark halls of the CIA, and more than once he will find himself in the crosshairs of dangerous adversaries. The fears and uncertainties of his homeland, it seems, have followed Elliot Steil to the shores of America.

### MY RECOMMENDATION

Outcast is a richly complex, yet very readable novel. On one level it is a challenging and original crime story. On another level, it is a penetrating and insightful account of life in Cuba, with all the immediacy one would expect of a narrator who has spent much of his life there. Latour is not sparing in his criticism of his homeland: it is, he notes, a land of chronic black-outs, widespread shortages, rationing, favouritism among the Party faithful, indoctrination, constant surveillance, and control.

But neither is the author seduced by the affluence of America. He rejects both its rampant materialism and widespread violence, his protagonist reflecting:

"Somehow fifth- and sixth-graders manage to smuggle knives, marijuana, porno magazines and even guns into schools... Imagine. Hundreds of shiny patrol cars manned by beefy guys armed to the teeth, and they can't control gun-fights in elementary schools. The most dangerous thing ever found in Dani's classroom in Cuba was a razor blade for

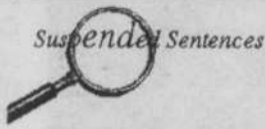

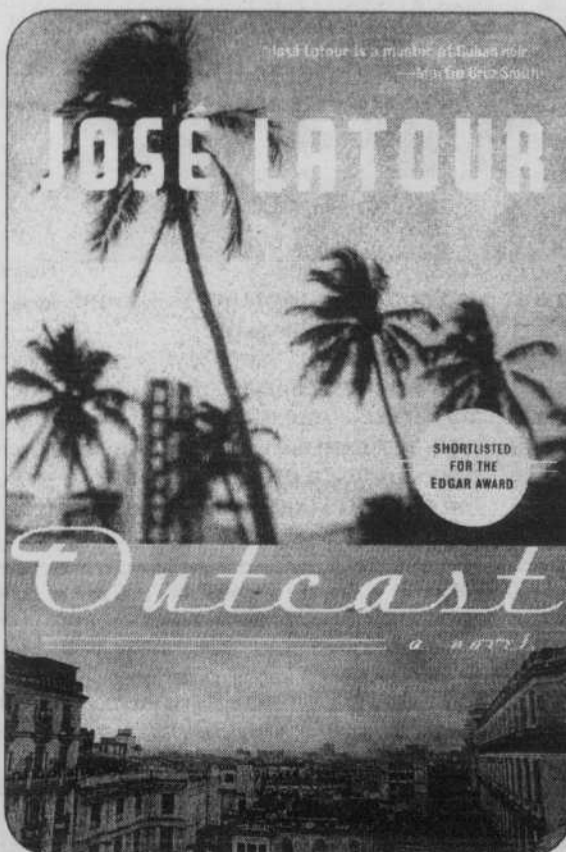

sharpening pencils; the heaviest drug, a stinking cigarette butt."

This then, is Elliot's dilemma: even as he closes the door on his life in Cuba, with its shortcomings that he knows all too well, he has not — nor, we suspect, will he ever — fully embrace his new land. Like so many immigrants, Elliot finds himself between cultures, a man without a country. It is an engrossing tale of an individual struggling to define himself in a world that, torn between two divergent value systems, ultimately defies understanding. In the end, Outcast is more than a simple crime novel; it chronicles one man's desperate quest to achieve personal identity and closure.

Outcast was shortlisted for an Edgar Award by the Mystery Writers of America.

# Film

*Broadway's brow goes even lower*

If Broadway legend Bob Fosse were alive today, there's a scary chance he'd be choreographing the "truffle shuffle," a kind of blubber ballet in which one's belly fat is made to dance through seizure-like gyrations.

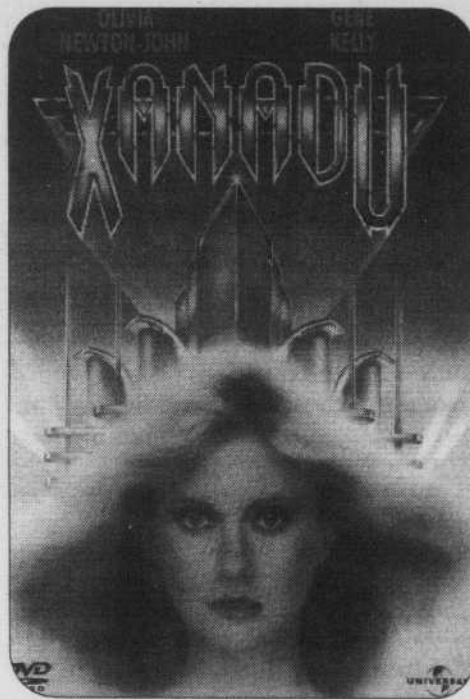
The shuffle first came to fame in *The Goonies*, a 1985 adventure flick that may soon be the inspiration for a full-fledged musical. Should director Richard Donner's attempt to set his movie to song prove successful, the adaptation will join a growing list of theatre productions based on lowbrow films.

From a \$12-million version of *Dirty Dancing* — which makes its North American debut in Toronto in November — to new Broadway adaptations of *Legally Blonde*, *The Little Mermaid*, *Cry Baby* and the campy disco classic *Xanadu*, playwrights everywhere are trading *Macbeth* for *McMovies* to attract the unwashed masses.

"Patrons are undoubtedly drawn from the same cohort of boomers who actually believe that they're eating healthy as long as they substitute a salad for fries when ordering their double-bacon-mushroom-swiss half-pounder," says David Long, a professor of sociology at King's College in Edmonton. "Fast food, fast theatre."

Although Long recognizes lowbrow entertainment has historical roots stretching "well before the afternoon matinee involved Christians being devoured by lions," he says there's a key difference between Shakespearean fare and the mass-market movie-based musical.

"While the former involved originality and creative, artistic expression, highly cost-effective *McBroadway* productions come pre-packaged for an easily amused, low attention-span audience," says Long.



According to David S. Thompson, a noted Broadway historian, it's all about making the investment back.

"It's difficult for someone to say, 'I'd like to spend \$10 million on a concept that's radically new, for a title that no one can pronounce, starring characters people might not find sympathetic,'" says Thompson, associate professor of theatre at Agnes Scott College in Georgia.

For that reason, it doesn't surprise him that movies such as *Young Frankenstein*, *Shrek*, *Leap of Faith* and *Father of the Bride* are all getting the chorus-line treatment for the upcoming Broadway season.



Thompson explains the trend in a single word: "cowardice."

Historically, stage musicals have been predominantly based on source material — mostly books, but also movies. These days, however, theatre insiders notice a greater tendency to put the film on stage rather than reinter-

preting its story, plot and settings for the theatre.

"I'm hoping to see more creative approaches to how we adapt things," says Thompson. "*Spamalot*, for example, is very little like *Monty Python and the Holy Grail*. It has elements of the film, but it's also a winking tribute to the Broadway musical."

*Dirty Dancing*, for which tickets are already on sale in Canada, reportedly transposes scenes almost verbatim from the movie that inspired it. Although critics of the London production grumbled loudly about the approach last year — *Theatre.com's* Mark Shenton said it could be "the death of the modern musical as we know it" — it became the fastest-selling show in West End history.

John Karastamatis, director of communications for Mirvish Productions in Toronto, says producers are giving audiences what they want.

"What's very special about *Dirty Dancing* is that it has a grassroots fan base that's multigenerational and huge, primarily because it came along just as the home-video revolution was starting," he observes.

Keeping faithful to the film, Karastamatis explains, fosters a kind of brand loyalty among the movie's admirers and may accordingly win new theatre converts.

"Part of the trick with communicating with the audience is providing a comfort level," he says. "And that comfort level is strengthened if it's a title and storyline and characters they're already familiar with."

A popular movie, however, doesn't guarantee its Broadway sibling will be equally successful. Last December, the musical *High Fidelity* — based on the book and film of the same name — defied high expectations to become a bona fide flop, closing after a mere 14 performances.

This first single didn't do so well on radio, nor on the country music charts for that matter. I think it was too different from what the party girl usually delivers.

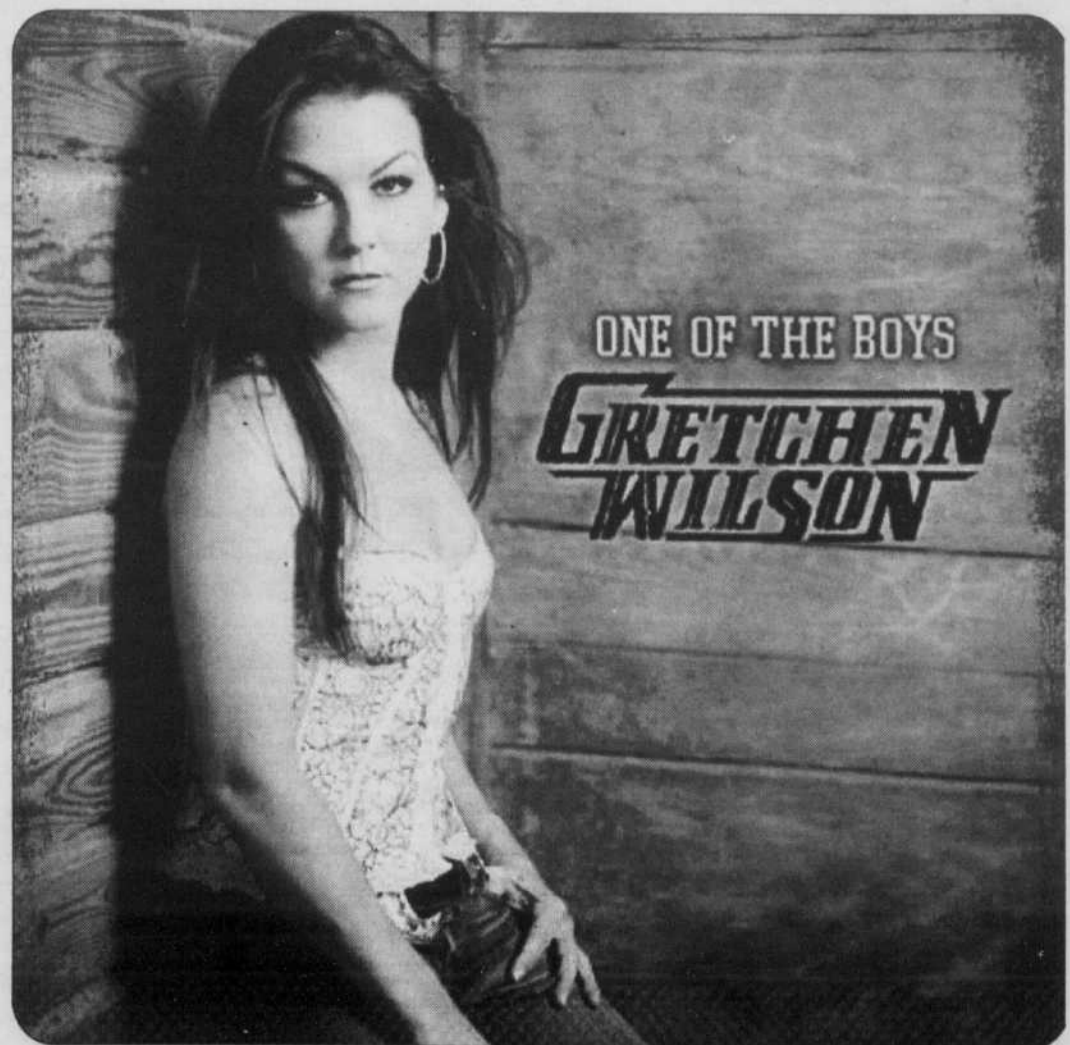

who she is.

This comes across very well on the album opener 'The Girl I Am', in which she explains that despite looking very tough at times she can also need a shoulder to lean on. This song, as well as the very traditional 'One of the Boys', sound autobiographical.

She's proud of playing a good game of pool, not much can make her blush, and she can drink with the boys with no problems, but still she is a woman who wants to be treated like one.

On 'If You Want a Mother' she tells her lover that if he wants a mother as opposed to a wife, she can easily do that. But his choice has implications that he will have to live with - such as being grounded for the week-end. It is up-tempo but mostly very well written.

There is a lot of humour in 'There Goes the Neighbourhood' while 'Heaven Help Me' and 'To Tell You The Truth' are soul-searching and solid ballads. It feels strange to hear Wilson on more introspective numbers because we always think of her as the party girl who doesn't have any problems.

Gretchen Wilson is very involved in the process of making her albums since she writes songs, she sings and she co-

produces.

The production work is excellent. The instruments seem to have been picked with a lot of care. The fiddle and the steel-guitar are very present here and everything sounds crisp and clear.

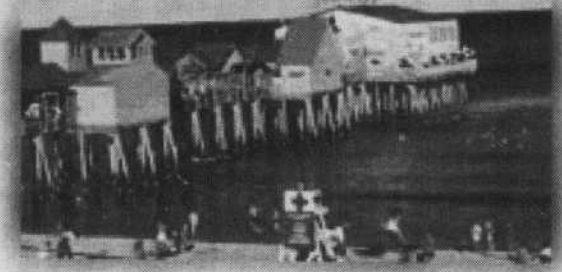
There's also the catchy 'Good Ole Boy' in which Wilson tells us that a blue-collar man can still get her attention anytime, while 'Pain Killer' is the type of slow song that will remind you of Tammy Wynette.

'There's a Place in the Whiskey' is an infectious number in which she quotes both Bob Seger and the melody of 'Call Me the Breeze'. This one will surely make people get off their seat to hit the dance floor.

When she finally delivers 'You Don't Have To Go Home' with some beautiful fiddle work and some AC/DC guitar licks, she just shows everyone that she's in perfect control of her talent. Don't let the guitar licks fool you because it is real country.

This album, although different from her previous work, is excellent and showcases a Gretchen Wilson who can be versatile. She's good at rocking and she sounds wonderful when she remains traditional country.

After only three albums you feel that she's building a career the same way that Dolly Parton, Tammy Wynette and Loretta Lynn built one - by staying herself and true to her roots.
