The Supreme Court has both original and appellate jurisdiction—*Original*, as to (1) habeas corpus in criminal and extradition cases; (2) judicial opinions to the Crown; (3) private bills and petitions therefore referred by the Senate or House of Commons and (4) civil suits in which the validity of a Dominion or Provincial Act is questioned. *Appellate*, in appeals (1) from

the Exchequer Court; (2) from the Provincial Courts; (3) in habeas corpus cases; and (4) in election cases.

Exchequer Court

The Exchequer Court has original jurisdiction (1) in revenue cases; (2) in civil suits, when the Crown for the Dominion is plaintiff; (3) controversies between the Dominion and a Province, or between two Provinces.

The Judges and officers are the same as in the Supreme Court. They reside in Ottawa, where the Court sits 3rd Monday in January and June.

If insufficiently paid (not less than one full rate), double the amount of the deficient postage will be charged on delivery, except letters for the United-States, which must be paid one full rate.

Short paid letters to the United-States are charged with the balance of postage due thereon.

Dominion of Canada and United-States, 3 cents per ½ oz. Newfoundland, 5 cents per ½ oz.

Post Cards—Canada Post Card pass through the United States without additional postage.

Great Britain, by Canadian or New York Mail Steamers, 5 cents per ½ oz.

Drop Letters, for City Delivery, St. Sanveur, Bergerville, Spencer Cove, Sillery, Point Lévis and Indian Cove, 1 cent per ½ oz.

REGISTRATION.

Dominion of Canada or Newfoundland, prepaid by stamp, in addition to the postage rate, 2 cents. To the United-States and United Kingdom, 5 cts.

NEWSPAPERS AND PERIODICALS.

To places in Canada, United-States and Newfoundland, one cent per 4 ounces prepaid.

Newspapers and periodicals weighing less than one ounce posted singly, one half cent prepaid.

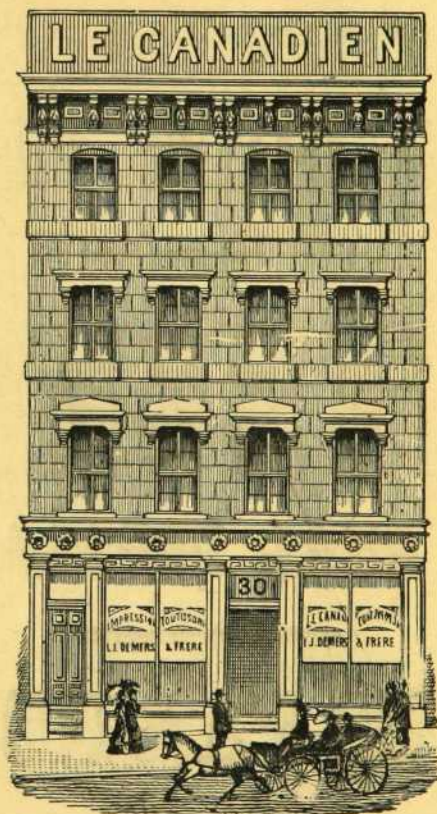
