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Top 8 Must-See Attractions



Abbaye Saint-Benoit-du-Lac

With a towering steeple and imposing stature, the beautiful Abbaye Saint-Benoit-du-Lac is an iconic landmark. Explore the grounds, take a guided tour and definitely exit through the gift shop, which is stocked with small-batch food products made on-site.

Did you know?

Men and women are welcome to book a spiritual renewal retreat at the Abbey by reserving a stay at the Guesthouse or Villa Saint Scholastique, respectively.

Zoo de Granby

No matter the season, a day at the zoo is always memorable. There are the animals, of course—some 1,500 of them, but who's counting?!—but also rides and Amazoo water park in the summer and a skating rink and slides in the winter. One visit? Never enough!

What's more, the entire family will leave with newly acquired knowledge gleaned from the activities, talks, and workshops presented throughout the year.

The Popular Observatory hosts a wealth of events that are open to the public, including fascinating astronomy soirees.

Four National Parks

With mountains to climb, lakes to jump in, and trails for biking, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing—not to mention an abundance of nature lodging!—the region's four national parks are at the heart of its identity. Visit Mont-Orford, Mont-Mégantic, Frontenac, and Yamaska parks for endless opportunity for adventure and relaxation.

With four national parks on its territory, the Eastern Townships region proudly holds the highest concentration of Sépaq parks in all of Québec.

1980 _____

The story begins in 1980, when passionate—and admittedly, slightly crazy!—vintners Christian Bartheumeuf and Jacques Breault traveled to Ontario to obtain cuttings to plant the first vineyard in the Eastern Townships. Just like that, Dunham's Domaine des Côtes d'Ardoise was born.

A few years later, Dr. Jacques Papillon purchased the vineyard and exploited it for 30+ years while Christian Bartheumeuf opened Clos Saragnat in Frelighsburg, where he would eventually develop the very first ice cider.

1982 _____

Four more visionaries (Charles-Henri de Coussergues, Hervé Durand, Frank Furtado and Pierre Rodrigue) work tirelessly to establish the region's second vineyard, l'Orpailleur.

2003 _____

The Brome-Missisquoi Wine Route was inspired by this beautiful story. Today, some 45 years later, it proudly unites 25 producers.

SHERBROOKE

With restaurants, museums, and theatres, our capital city offers a vibrant urban scene tucked right in the heart of nature.

MUST-DO: Stock a picnic basket at Marché de la Gare farmer's market and enjoy it at the summit of Mont Bellevue.

MAGOG

Nestled on the shores of Lac Memphrémagog, Magog is a charming town that's brimming with activity year-round. Take a stroll and discover everything that makes this spot so popular.

MUST-DO: Loop around Pointe Merry before hitting up one of the city's two craft breweries.





GRANBY

This town is so much more than the zoo! There's an outdoor museum, some excellent restaurants, a farmer's market and a bustling cultural scene (Festival International de la Chanson de Granby is a signature event).

MUST-DO: Celebrate the fusion of Polish and Québécois cuisine at Bistro Kapzak.

BROMONT

As for art and entertainment, the region has plenty to offer. Heritage buildings repurposed as museums and craft breweries, and festivals, including the Ceramic Festival in Way's Mills or Nuit de la Poésie in Saint-Venant-de-Paquette, are mainstays you won't want to miss.

You must be at least 18 years old to enter bars, pubs, night-clubs and casinos, as well as to purchase or consume alcohol (be prepared to produce ID if asked).

Cell Phones

Use of a cell phone is prohibited while driving.

Drugs

The law has introduced a zero-tolerance policy for drug use while driving. To buy or use cannabis, you must be 21 years of age or older.

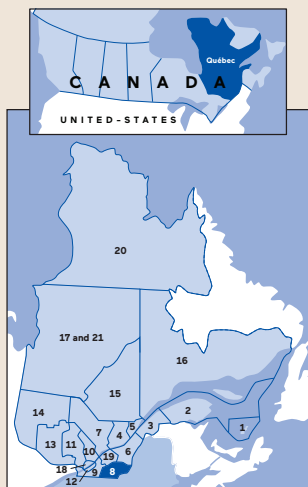
