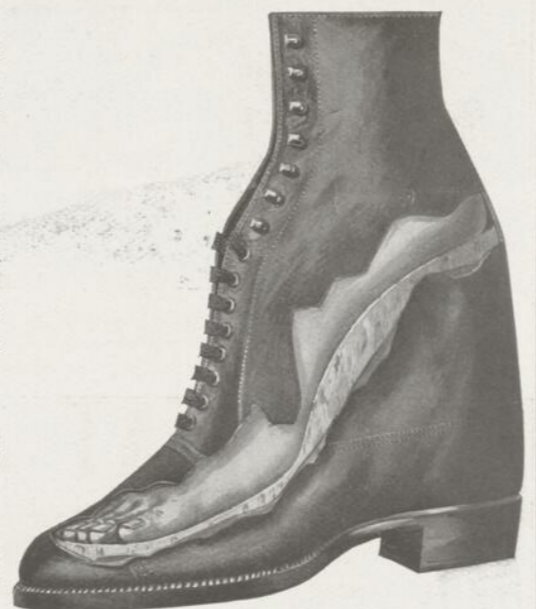

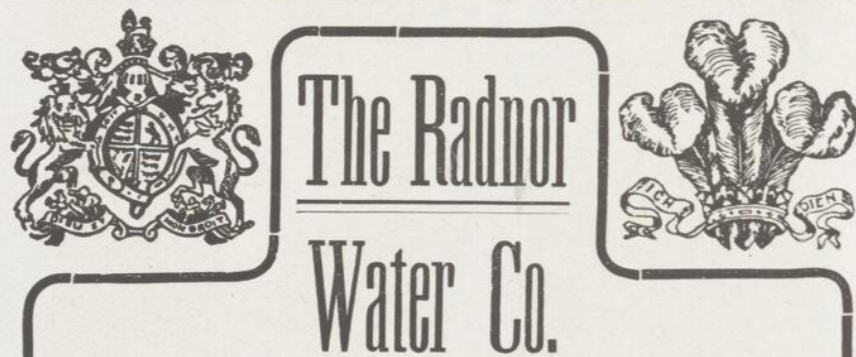

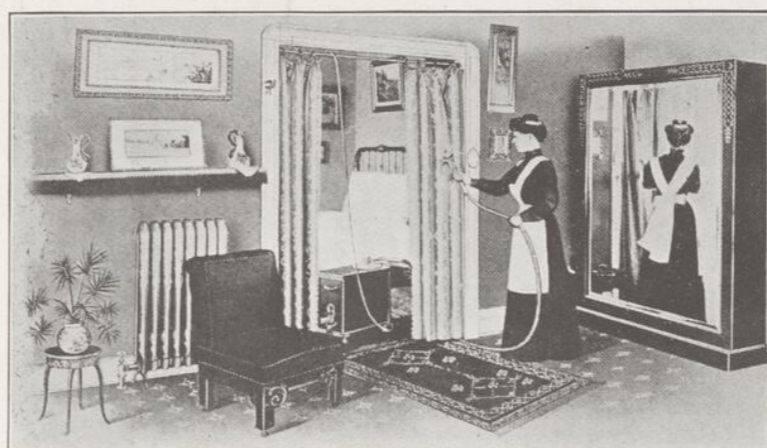

**Imperial Medal of India, 1877.**

Gold and silver medals were given when Her Majesty Queen Victoria was proclaimed Empress of India, on Jan. 1st, 1877.

On the obverse is a crowned and veiled bust of the Queen, with the legend, "Victoria, 1st January, 1877."

On the reverse, in Persian, English and Hindustani, "Empress of India." The ribbon is crimson, with yellow edges.

This medal was given in gold to the native chiefs of India, in silver to one man in every regiment, British and Native, serving in India at the time, and to leading civilians. It is worn suspended from the neck.
