ONE HORSE VEHICLES.

From any place to any others, provided the time occupied do not exceed 20 minutes:—

1 or 2 persons.....25 cents.

3 or 4 ".....50 "

From any place to any others, provided the time occupied do not exceed half an hour:—

1 or 2 persons.....40 cents.

2 or 4 ".....60 "

When the drive exceeds the time limited as aforesaid hour rates to be charged.

BY THE HOUR.

For the first hour:—

1 or 2 persons.....75 cents.

3 or 4 ".....\$1.00

For every subsequent hour:—

1 or 2 persons.....60 cents.

3 or 4 ".....75 "

TWO HORSE VEHICLES.

From any place to any others, provided the time occupied do not exceed 20 minutes:—

1 or 2 persons.....50 cents.

3 or 4 ".....65 "

From any place to any others, provided the time occupied do not exceed half an hour:—

1 or 2 persons.....65 cents.

3 or 4 ".....75 "

When the drive exceeds the time limited as aforesaid, hour rates to be charged.

BY THE HOUR.

1 or 2 persons.....\$1.00

2 or 4 ".....1.25

Fractions of hours to be charged at *pro rata* hour rates—but not less than one quarter of an hour shall be charged when the time exceeds the hour.

Fifty per cent, to be added to the tariff rates for rides from TWELVE midnight to FOUR a.m.

The tariff by the hour shall apply to all rides extending beyond the city limits where the engagement is made in the City.

BAGGAGE.

For each trunk or box carried in any vehicle, 10c. But no charge shall be made for travelling bags, valises, boxes or parcels which passengers can carry by the hand.
