## Interpreted Tours

### Where Montréal Was Born (permanent exhibition)

Elementary • Secondary

There was once a town founded on a point of land between two rivers, which would grow and evolve around its public square. Explore Montréal's history as you roam through authentic archaeological remains, with virtual experiences, hands-on fun, touch screens and 3D images. Forget those dry history lectures – our interpreter-guides make young visitors part of the experience!

### The Beatles in Montréal (interactive temporary exhibition)

March 29, 2013 to March 30, 2014

Secondary

This is a rare opportunity, as Pointe-à-Callière focuses on the role that music has played in shaping our city's history. The 1964 event was truly memorable and the Beatles' music helped liberate an entire generation. Your students will get to relive the heady excitement of the 1960s, thanks to film clips, stroboscopic images and karaoke. The exhibition is sure to spark their emotions and their imaginations. This is a self-guided tour where students can set their own tempo.

### Here's to Progress – 19<sup>th</sup>-Century Style! (permanent exhibition)

Elementary Cycles 2 and 3 • Secondary

19<sup>th</sup>-century Montréal. British leaders have embarked on some spectacular projects. The industrial revolution is in full swing and there is much to be done: paving the way for business, building wharves, digging a canal to avoid the rapids, installing the aqueduct, replacing sailing ships with steamships and more. But what exactly does "progress" mean? Through this guided tour and role-playing exercise and as they explore a new interactive fresco, your students will learn about the huge British contribution to Montréal society.

### Archaeo-Adventure

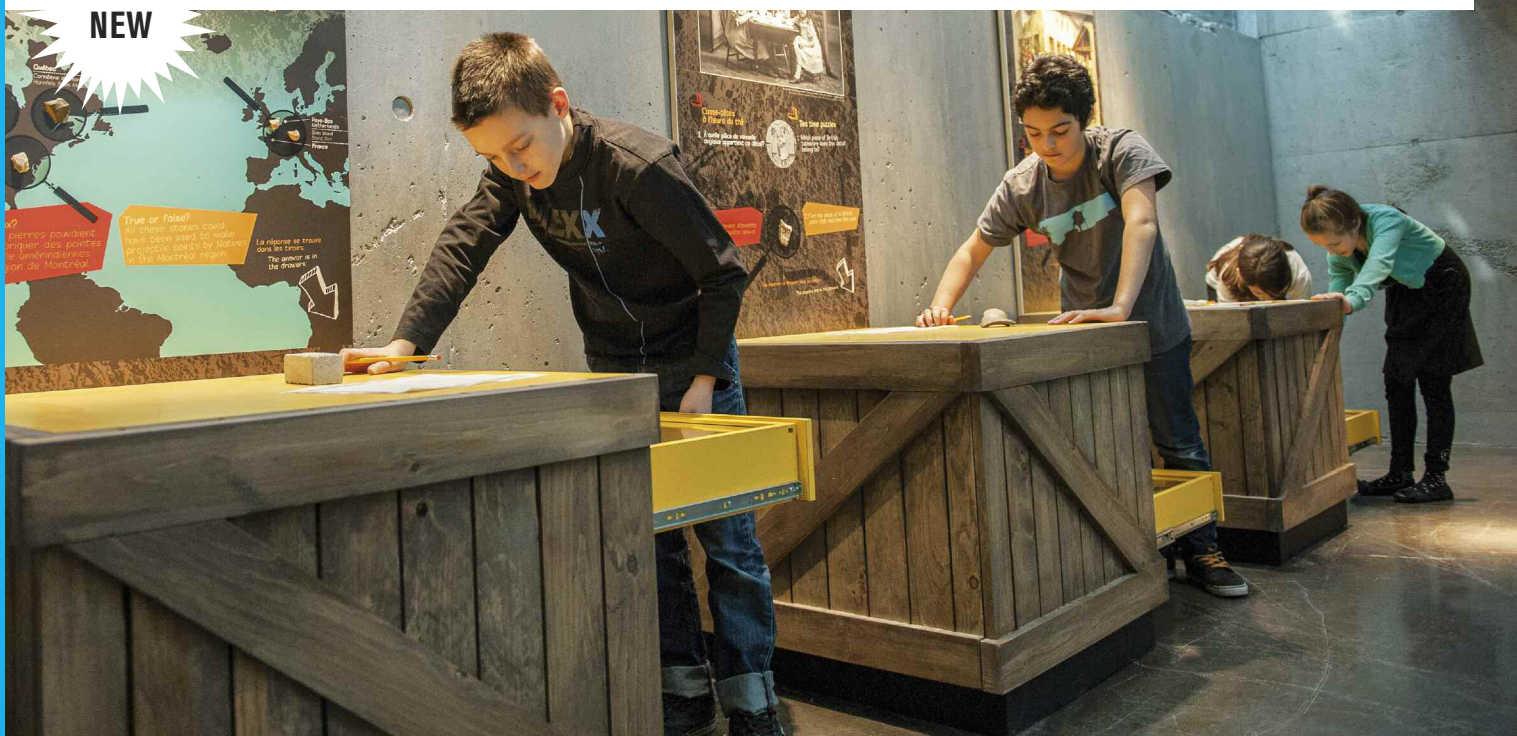
Elementary Cycles 2 and 3 • Secondary Cycle 1

This workshop is the perfect opportunity to find out what archaeologists do. Under the supervision of a chief archaeologist (interpreter-guide), your students will use the scientific approach to conduct an investigation. They'll dig in the ground, find traces from

the days when Natives camped here right up until the British regime, analyze their finds in a laboratory and learn how people lived in days gone by.

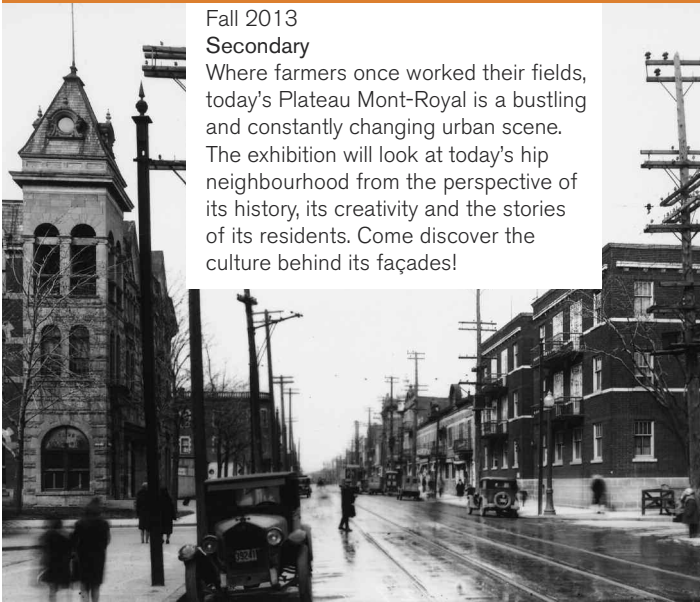

### Growing Up in Ville-Marie

Elementary Cycles 1 and 2

Walking on the Pointe à Callière site, crossing a little river and going to market is all much more fun when you get to wear a habitant's apron or a noblewoman's cloak or carry the parish priest's breviary. Students learn about how French and Native children lived back then and even try some old-time games. Bilboquet isn't as easy as it looks!

### Natives on the Point

Elementary Cycles 2 and 3 • Secondary

Lots has happened on the Pointe à Callière site over the centuries, for travellers were forced to stop here by the Lachine rapids. Native people spent time here, at first fishing and gathering food, and then later to attend the annual fur trade with the French, and to sign the Great Peace treaty in 1701. Your students will explore the site's Native history with the help of models, artifacts and remains.

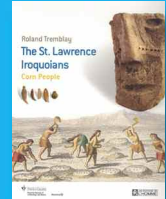
### The St. Lawrence Iroquoians

Elementary Cycles 1, 2 and 3

Long before Europeans arrived, the St. Lawrence Iroquoians were living in villages of longhouses on Montréal Island and all along the St. Lawrence River. See how they lived from day to day, how they used the furs and bones of the animals they hunted, how they prepared their food every day, and more. Your students will be captivated by the ingenuity and know-how of the members of this aboriginal nation. Can they use the same skills?

Elementary Cycle 3 • Secondary Cycle 1

We've come a long way since people used to draw their drinking water straight from the St. Lawrence and dump their wastewater in the street! Water has a whole history of its own. In this multidisciplinary workshop, your students will be joined by our friendly mascot, Romeo the sewer rat, as they learn about how Montrealers have found ingenious ways to manage this precious resource all the way back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century. They will be immersed in some vital issues – access to drinking water and wastewater management through the years, right up until today.

## Interactive Exhibition

### Pirates or Privateers?

Starting in December 2013

Elementary Cycles 1, 2 and 3

People often mix up pirates and privateers – they all sailed the seas in search of bounty, but one group was lawless and the other one had letters of marque from the king. Which of them were the true heroes of the St. Lawrence? Students ages 6 to 12 are sure to have a blast with this interactive, immersive experience. They'll explore the world of the privateers who marked the history of Montréal and Québec in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. They'll set sail from Montréal as crew members on Captain Pierre Lemoyne d'Iberville's ship. While aboard they'll learn how to navigate and have to prove that they're worthy privateers! They'll need to be sure to bring their brawn and their brains with them, along with their imaginations and their team spirit. NB: For Cycle 1, this is a guided activity. For Cycles 2 and 3, it is a self-guided activity, but a guide will be on hand to supervise.
