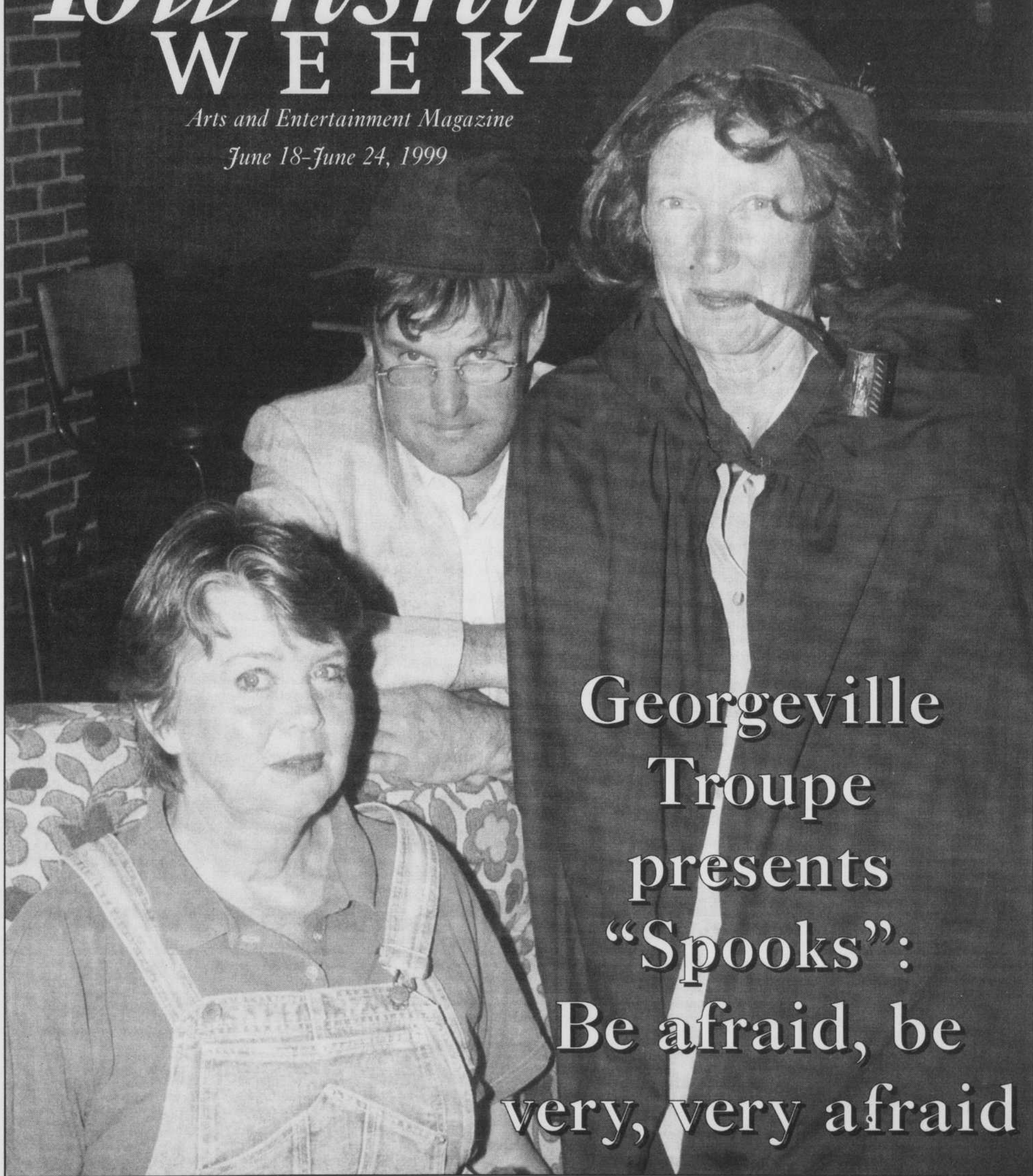

Newfoundland dog inspires Haskell fund-raiser

How does a dog lead to a concert on an international stage? Just follow the logic of an elementary school teacher with a passion for her Newfoundland dog and an equal determination to model for her students what it means to be a lifelong learner in this world.

Lisa Stoddard of Holland, Vermont, became so interested in the history of her Newfoundland dog, Molly, she and her mother traveled to Newfoundland, where they promptly fell in love with "The Rock," and its people.

Lisa wrote a grant to bring New-

foundland artists to the tiny school of Holland where they and the students are sharing and contrasting Newfoundland's seafaring people and coast with the mountains and inhabitants of this rural Vermont village.

A rollicking Maritime breeze will be blowing through Derby Line, Vt., and Stanstead when one of these artists, Jim Payne, brings his musical talents to the Haskell Opera House stage on Saturday, June 19, at 7:30 p.m.

Taste the salt spray in Jim's stirring sea shanties, ballads and work songs. Amongst his many talents, Jim plays

guitar, accordion, mandolin, tin whistle and violin and is a singer, storyteller, actor, writer, step-dancer and teacher of traditional Newfoundland dances.

He is half of the musical comedy duo, Sods 'n Rhymes, has a string of recording credits and operates his own recording label, Sing Song Inc.

Celebrated as an ambassador of Newfoundland culture, Jim is a world-class songwriter of traditional songs and a biting humorist with a take on Newfoundland culture that you won't get from the provincial tourism office.

This is a fund-raiser for the Haskell Opera House. As an added treat, local performer Jackie Hall of Ogden will accompany some of Jim's tunes with traditional clog dances. Bring your love of the sea and waves and enjoy some of the best music and stories Newfoundland has to offer.

There is no set charge but tickets are required. Suggested donation will be posted at the door. To reserve tickets, call (819) 876-2020 or (802) 873-3022.

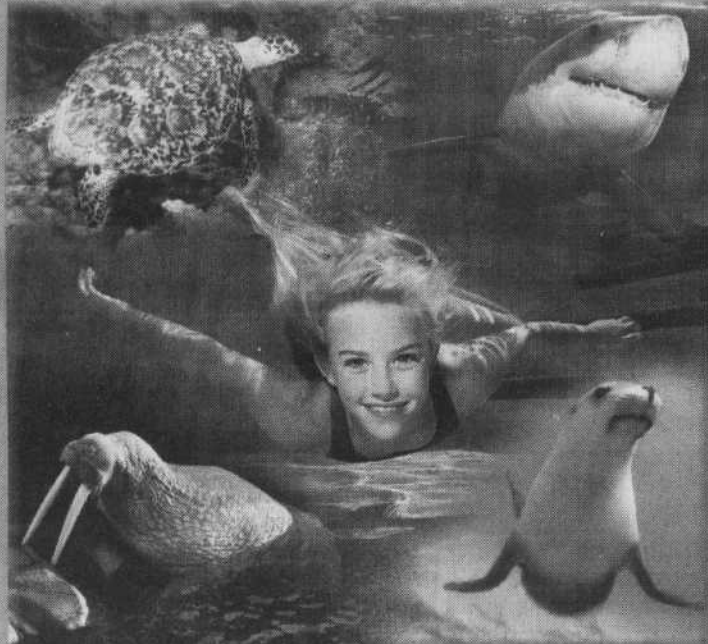

Words and music to fill the Uplands barn

*Authors, musicians
celebrate the
onslaught of summer*

Uplands Museum will be alive with words and music on Saturday, June 19. Local culture will take over the museum's barn, as authors and musicians gather to read, play and sing.

The evening, organized by Uplands coordinator Margaret Brand, is the first of the museum's summer barn activities.

Most of the readers will be coming from another Uplands-hosted project, a writing workshop run by Lennoxville resident Janice LaDuke.

"There will be eight people reading from Janice's workshop and one person from Anne Scowcroft's workshop," Brand said.

Both LaDuke and Scowcroft are part of the Common Ground Writers' Association, a Townships-based group of writers. As well as the poetry, the evening will be embellished with music.

"There's also a piano and guitar duo," Brand continued. "Allyn Harris is leading a women's choir that sings world music named Choro Mondo. There's also Juanita McKelvie, a singer-songwriter."

The readers, who include Liselyn Adams, Bill Cox, Bill Duncan, Nick Fonda, Dorothy Hewson, Carol McKinley, Susan Mastine, Margaret Owens and Gayle Pflaster, have never read their creative work in front of a live audience before.

"This workshop will be readers who are completely new," Brand said.

This evening will feature most of the elements that made the last Common

Ground reading a success. "Common Ground had music at their reading at Cliff House (in Ayer's Cliff)," Brand said. "The other event was in Stanstead, so we're hoping to attract a Lennoxville audience."

Brand hopes some audience members might become inspired to start exploring their inner voices.

"We're going to have a seniors writing workshop next fall. We hope this might encourage those who come to take the workshop," she said.

She is looking

forward to the event from more than an organizational point of view: As a member of Choro Mondo, Brand is also anticipating the group's first performance.

"We just started singing in February. This is a good opportunity for us to sing in public without doing a full concert."

This poetry reading is one of several events taking place at Uplands over the next few months. Brand hopes to recall the spirit of an event they had at about

the same time last summer.

"Last year, we had a concert in the barn with David Francey near the end of June, near the Equinox," she said. "It was lovely. We also had storytelling in the barn in August. We're trying to have more activities in the barn now. It's good to have something on the Saturday closest to the Equinox, when the days are longest."

Elvis Costello the hip, literate rebel

Elvis Costello, born Declan McManus, has a truly unique place in the canon of popular music.

In the early 80s, the bespectacled icon was the essence of hip, literate rebelliousness; tales of his drunken recklessness and tempestuous romances were buzz celebre for glossy rags.

A Liverpool lad, not of astounding good looks but of some musical talent, he followed the suit of the punks and glams and was reinvented as Elvis Costello.

Horn-rimmed, sporting a modish suit and slim tie, he looked like nothing so much as a fame-hungry Buddy Holly - and he knew it.

Costello rejoiced in the contradictions he embodied. His music was methodically crafted: The lyrics were tough and literate, loaded with irony and wit, but always approachable, immediately familiar; the instrumentation was infec-

tious, the melodies hooked and resonated and drove you through their twists that left you humming for days.

Onstage, he was exuberant and charismatic, engaging stadium audiences without the aid of pyrotechnics, as if he was born to it.

Offstage, he commanded a reputation, a street credo, that seemed more the domain of the Iggy Pops and Johnny Rottens. Hotel rooms were razed and

brawls begun and ended.

It was a highwire act, the music, the persona, the reputation, always caught in this fine balance.

There were stumbles along the way, ones that might have shattered lesser egos. After a much publicized fracas in a hotel bar and some drunken invective from the Costello camp, the U.S. end of the 'Armed Forces Tour' (1979) aborted itself on a shoal of violent tension and press antagonism resigning one of the great pop albums to an early American grave.

Costello could not be kept down for long, however. He was soon back in the saddle and numerous classic albums ensued. In 1993, Costello had let his punkish behaviour take a permanent back

seat to his music. In collaboration with the eclectic string musicians the Brodsky Quartet, Costello produced and put voice to the pop operatic masterpiece, *The Juliet Letters*.

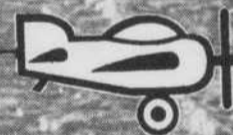
His has been a long dance along the line that separates popular and critical success. Despite occasional faltering, his dedication has always put him back on that line. Punk having become what it most despised, a fashion, and the sound of 60s rebellion long ago turned the stuff of contented living, rebellion has found its voice sardonic and wily.

This year sees Costello touring a new album, a collaboration with songsmith Burt Bacharach. I can't comment on the album, I haven't heard it yet, but I have faith. A faith which has proved well warranted in the past.

Georgeville Troupe bringing 'Spooks' to life

Community effort
set to take the stage
June 25-27

Georgeville is such a small community, everybody knows each other and people really get a kick out of seeing neighbours getting up on-stage," said John Dickerson of The Georgeville Troupe.

The amateur theatre group is getting set to stage "Spooks," a play by Montrealer Colleen Curran, from June 25 to 27 at the Murray Memorial Community Centre in Georgeville.

"It's a haunting comedy, in which there are ghosts, things that go bump in the dark, and furniture that moves on its own," said actor Sonya Rocke of the two-act play.

The troupe is proud of the way they handle the logistics of the play. They set up their own stage to transform the Murray Memorial into a palatable theatre, they build their own set and paint the flats themselves.

"The stage lives in John (Dickerson)'s barn over the winter. When we need it we load it onto a hay wagon to bring it here," Rocke said.

"Yes, so the whole village knows the play is underway when they see the stage rolling down the hill," added Maureen Cameron, who also stars in the show.

The cast agrees that putting together a play isn't an easy task.

"I guess our biggest headaches come from the building itself. It's a community building, so we can't always have it all to ourselves as much as we might want to," Dickerson said, adding that making a rehearsal sched-

ule that works for everyone is also a daunting task.

The play, set in the fictional town of Schwartzwald, Canada, at springtime,

is filled with strange and mysterious characters.

Dickerson plays Winston Aitken, a college professor he describes as "in his third marriage and has a secret past that eventually catches up to him."

Cameron plays Peggy Finch, Aitken's wife. She described her character as "a potter, and a heiress to a lot of money. She's probably the sanest person among much stranger people."

Rocke plays Oona Moriarty, who she said is "an Irish psychic investigator and ghost-chaser who is very eccentric."

Also in the cast are John Hoblyn, playing the part of Harry Gumm, a 'fix-it man;' Diane Kakebeeke, who plays Alice Gumm, a woman who 'does things to flowers;' and Marie Chantal Vincent, who incarnates Christabelle Lancaster, 'a phantom thing.'

The play is directed by Tammy Seale, who was the stage manager in the troupe's play last year. Also partic-

ipating behind-the-scenes are stage manager Monique St-Pierre, props manager John Seaman and costume designer Megan Seline, as well as a five-strong technical crew who will take care of the special effects.

"We did the rehearsals with only chairs and our imagination," said Cameron.

Dickerson added it was the troupe's first foray into the world of special effects and seemed quite thrilled at the idea.

Playwright Curran is expected to be coming down to see The Georgeville Troupe's rendition of her piece.

"She might find a few line changes," Dickerson admitted, adding they certainly wouldn't be intentional.

Getting down to the Nitty Gritty

New albums from the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band and Lonestar get people set for summer

Not a week goes by without an event, an album release, a special concert or a book release taking place to rock the country music industry. To rock your country world this week, there's a new Nitty Gritty Dirt Band album, one that fans have been anxiously waiting for.

NITTY GRITTY DIRT BAND: Bang Bang Bang (Dreamworks/Universal)

It's been five long years since the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band released a new album. Now the new release has hit the stores and it's been worth the wait. Originally slated to be released last year, the album never saw the light of day because Rising Tide, their label at the time, went under.

It was hard on the 33-year-old group which once released four albums in just two years (1967-69). Here's a few more facts to refresh your memory:

The Jerry Jeff Walker song "Mr. Bojangles" provided the Dirt Band with a monster pop hit in 1971, while "Fishin' in the Dark" went to the top spot on the country charts in 1987.



DREAMWORKS

The Nitty Gritty Dirt Band... new album is good from beginning to end.

The Dirt Band, which also includes bassist Jimmy Ibbotson and keyboardist Bob Carpenter, is one of the oldest groups in country music. Two of the band's albums, Will the Circle Be Unbroken Vol. I and II, became major milestones. The first, a platinum-selling three-record set, featured such talents as Roy Acuff, Maybelle Carter and Doc Watson. The second won CMA album of the year honors in 1989.

The new collection features the Dirt Band's sense of variety as the musicians have created an unusual musical montage rather than just picking a style and sticking with it. Bang Bang Bang is a real good-time record with a lot more happy-go-

lucky material.

Three great producers worked on the album - Emory Gordy Jr., Josh Leo and Steve Fishell - bringing three times more input to the project. The Dirt Band also got material from some of Nashville's best songwriters, such as Jim Lauderdale, Gary Nicholson, Al Anderson, Craig Wiseman, Mac McAnally and Lonnie Wilson.

The collection offers 11 songs, kicking off with "If This Ain't Love," an up-tempo rouser, while "Bang Bang Bang" was the first single released and proved

to be radio-friendly. Some of the album's tunes will be familiar to concertgoers since they included a lot of them while on the road last year.

Most of their material is full of energy, such as "Forget the Job (Get A Life)," "Down the Road," "The Monkey Song" and "Southbound Train." There's also "Dry Town," which has a strong Bluegrass influence.

The highlights of the album are "It's About Time," a well-written love song, and the wishful "Nickel in the Well," about the guy who's trying everything to get lady luck on his side in order to get the lady of his dreams.

There's the potential number one hit "Rent, Groceries and Gasoline," about getting a new start and putting priorities in the right order.

This album is good from the opening to the closing. Hopefully it won't take another five years before we hear from the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band again.

LONESTAR: Lonely Grill (BNA)

Lonestar burst onto the country music scene and onto the charts in 1996 with hits like "No News," "Tequila Talkin'" and "Running Away With My Heart." They soon became a hot country band capturing fans both young and old.

This new album features a band in excellent vocal shape with a sound as fresh and vibrant as ever. This 12-song collection includes something for everyone, from the traditional country lover to those who loved the Eagles sound.

Last year's "Say When" was their first big ballad hit and there are more strong, slow numbers included on this third album. There's the beautiful "Tell Her" and "Smile," the hopeful "I've Gotta Find You," and "Amazed," which offers a nice blend of Richie McDonald's voice and the harmony of the other Lonestars.

This album captures the excitement of their live shows; the arrangements are strong and the harmonies soaring. There's the dramatic title song on which they show their Eagles roots, along with the pulsating "Saturday Night," a hard-hitting good-old-boy anthem.

There's a huge display of energy on "Don't Let's Talk About Lisa," a real summer number which is a laundry list of women in our hero's life, topped off by the evil Lisa.

There's "What About Now," with a nice blue-collar touch, while "All The Way" is serious and easygoing.

The guys have been working hard and the new album they offer has a definite winning recipe for continuing success.

Another World Ends



When Christopher Goutman joined *Another World* as executive producer seven months ago, he was determined to turn the show around. For years, *AW* had struggled in limbo, going through a series of writers and producers with little continuity. Goutman found himself with a talented cast involved in muddled storylines. When he streamlined the stories and concentrated on the relationships among the characters, some of the fans' favorite actors were persuaded to return. The 35-year-old soap appeared to be on the comeback trail. Unfortunately, Goutman arrived too late to save *AW*. NBC's longest-running serial airs its last episode on Friday, June 25. When Paul Rauch was the executive producer, he would go to a lot of theatre. He would find someone in a production he loved, and he'd bring them on. He really helped set the standard for our show." Anne Heche, Ray Liotta, Morgan Freeman, Susan Sullivan, Charles Durning, Faith Ford, Thomas Gibson, Kelsey Grammer, Billy Dee Williams, Luke Perry, Marla Maples, Brad Pitt and Kyra Sedgwick are just a few big names who are *AW* alumni. The goodbyes on *AW* will still be difficult for fans, as well as members of the cast and crew. But Goutman promises to leave fans with a smile. "I want to celebrate the show in every aspect," he says. "It will be happy endings for everyone, and a sense of completion for fans."
