## Brompton to host soprano Hardy, Edgar Charlebois

The Maison des arts et de la culture in the Sherbrooke borough of Brompton will be the stage for a concert showcasing everything from Mozart to Gershwin this Sunday.

The matinee performance, compliments of vocalists Michèle-Lyne Hardy and Edgar Charlebois, accompanied on piano by David Faulkner, is something of a reunion of old friends.

"The three of us haven't been seen that often together," said soprano Hardy, noting this is only the second time the trio has come together to perform.

"Edgar and I met 15 years ago, and we sort of lost touch in the last 10 years. We met again two or three years ago and decided to sing again together."

Faulkner had been accompanying the baritone Charlebois, and will be accompanying the two voices for this weekend's performance.

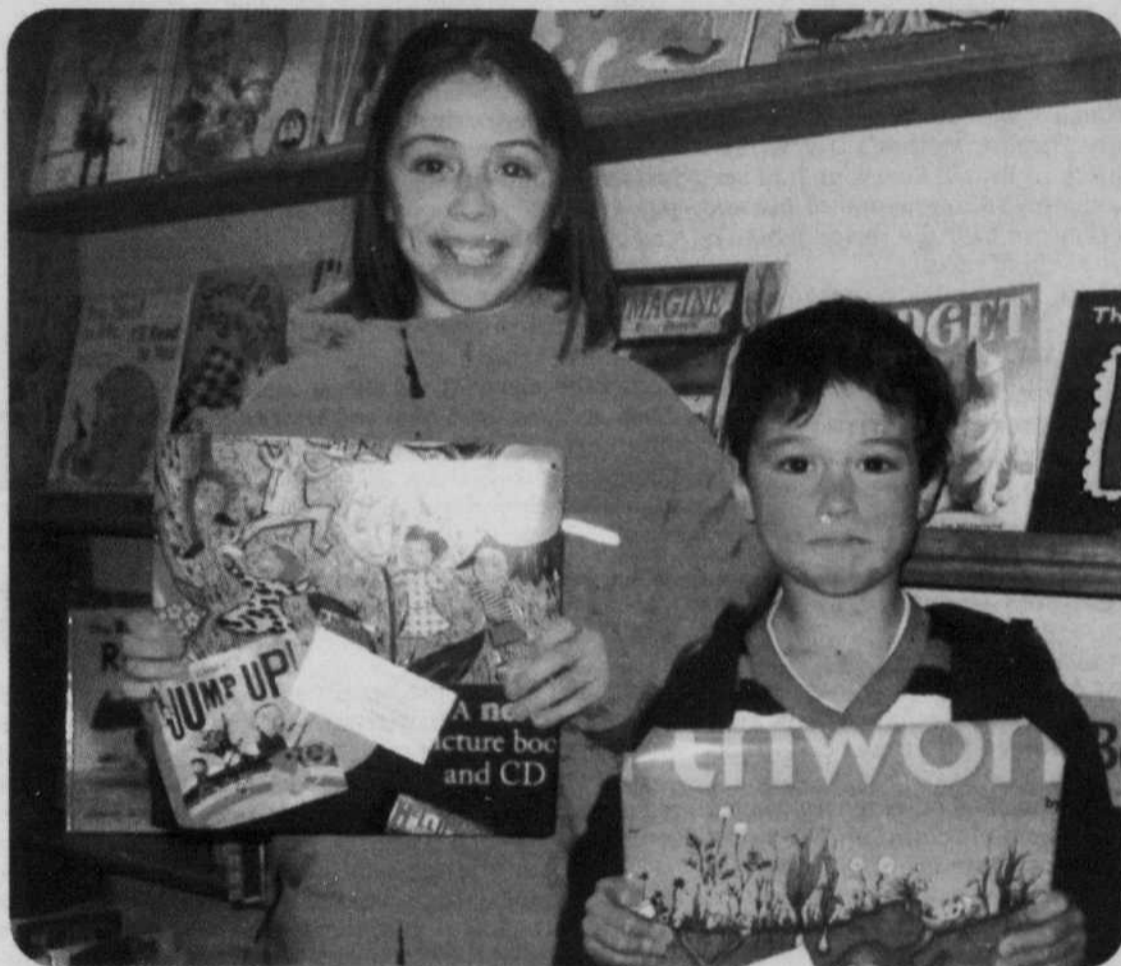
Hardy and Charlebois met through music and they were reunited through music, Hardy said.

"I was giving a concert with a group of singers from Ottawa in Montreal, and it just so happened that Edgar was in the audience."

Hardy is a relative newcomer to the Eastern Townships. She spent most of her life in Ottawa, and her voice is better known in other parts of the province where she has performed more regularly, including Gatineau, and around Montreal.

# Strawberry sauce is simply great

Today I'm making one of my favourite things: A very fresh and no-fuss strawberry sauce.

I realize it's not yet strawberry season here in the Townships, but... the supermarket ones are getting redder and riper by the week, and look too tantalizing to pass up on.

I served this sauce with a good-quality vanilla ice cream (Häagen Daz) for Mother's Day, while I was away in Brazil. Everyone had seconds, and my siblings e-mailed me asking if they can have the recipe, which is always a sign of success.

So here it is: Quickly cooked strawberries, a bit of sugar and not much else. The fruit stays true and fresh, a real delight. Try it!

## VANILLA ICE CREAM WITH FRESH STRAWBERRY SAUCE

Ingredients (for six)



ALEX'S PANTRY

900 g very ripe strawberries (1 big box or 2 small ones)  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 1/2 tbsps. cornstarch  
3 tbsps. cold water

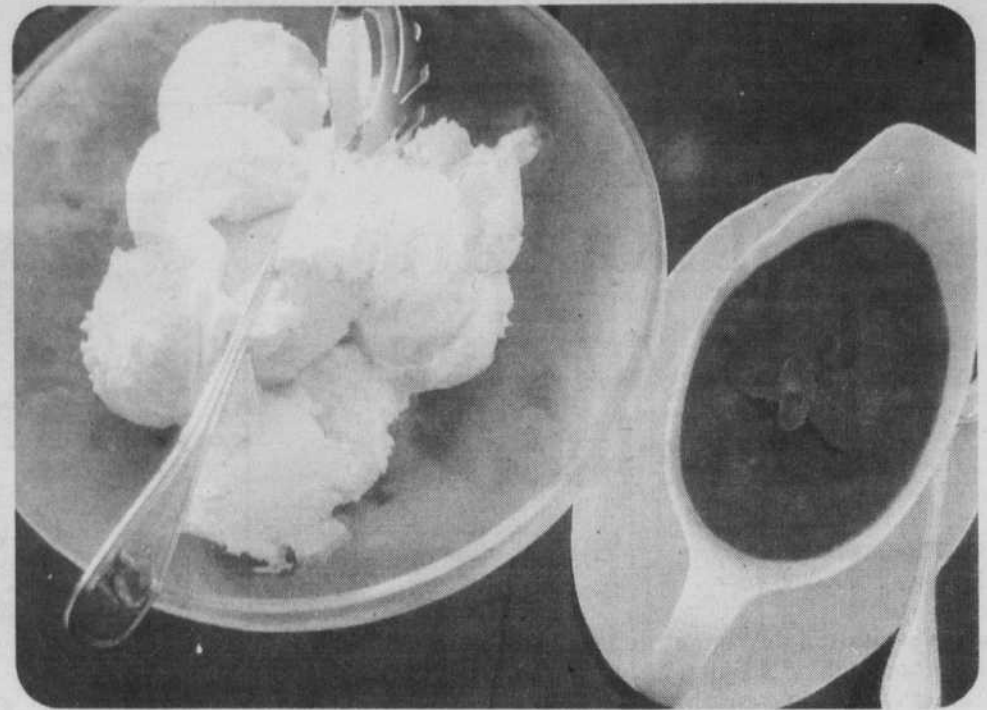
**Directions:** Wash strawberries and remove the stems. Cut the very big ones in half. Place them in a pot, preferably non-stick. Cook on medium heat for about 30 minutes, or until strawberries have dissolved.

There's no need to stir up until the last five minutes or so, when you should pat with wooden spoon to break apart any big chunks of fruit.

In a cup or glass, whisk the cornstarch in cold water until fully dissolved. Add this white liquid to hot strawberry sauce.

Add the sugar. Stir, and let it come to a boil. Remove from heat and let it cool. Sauce can be served warm, room temperature or cold. It keeps in the fridge for at least three days.

## Crusty crustacean tops the charts

I am often asked what my favourite foods are, and it's never easy to decide.

But in the seafood category, boiled Dungeness crab is definitely No. 1. Eating this crustacean is not just a meal — it's a celebration. You crack, you snack, you smile and you savour the sweet, rich and succulent meat.

Because of these qualities, Dungeness crab is frequently on the menu for special occasions, whether it's a birthday, anniversary or "gosh it's been a long week" Friday night supper. I've learned during these feasts and now know a lot more about buying and cooking crab than I did when I moved to the West Coast 13 years ago.

The first lesson was to buy live crabs on the day you intend to cook them, and to keep them stored in fridge until ready to do so. The longer you store crab, the greater chance of it dying — and like other live seafood, such as lobster, its quality quickly deteriorates.

I've bought live crab mid-morning and they've been fine for dinner that night, if they were very lively when I bought them.

When you find a crab you think looks good, it should struggle mightily when the salesperson lifts it out of its holding tank. If the crab is docile, don't buy it; it's been in the tank too long. Make sure the crab has all its limbs and get the salesperson to squeeze the upper middle section of one of its legs. The shell

should feel firm, not soft; softness is an indication the crab has recently molted and won't be as full of meat.

For presentation purposes, many like to cook and serve a whole crab per person.

A 750-gram (one-and-a-half pound) to one kilogram (two-pound) crab will yield about 175 to 250 grams (six to eight ounces) of cooked meat. However, there seems to be a bit of debate as to how long to cook it, with some sources suggesting boiling a one-kilogram crab for 18 to 20 minutes. (However, the informative B.C. Seafood Online website, [bcseafoodonline.com](http://bcseafoodonline.com), says a crab of that size should be boiled in salted water for approximately 10 to 12 minutes.)

During several tests, I came up with the recipe below that has an even slightly shorter boiling time.

It takes into account that the crab starts to cook the moment you set it in the water, even before it returns to a boil, and that there is enough residual heat that it continues to cook once out of the pot for cooling before eating.

That being said, several crab aficionados told me years ago they never cook a whole crab, because boiling them with their innards negatively affects the taste of the meat.

Instead, for a cleaner-tasting meat, they kill and clean (remove the guts and top shell) the crab before cooking it, which is what I now most often do for this reason — and also because it boils more quickly (about five minutes) and

the abundant body meat of the crab is more accessible.

I provide instructions on how to kill and clean a crab below. If you're not up to the task, most seafood retailers will do the work for you if you ask them. Once home, store the cleaned crab in the fridge for a similar period of time as you would a live crab.

If you're buying a whole cooked crab, do so from a retailer that cooks them fresh daily. Make sure the product has the qualities I suggested you look for in a live crab (firm shells, all their limbs, etc.). When buying fresh cooked Dungeness crab meat, opt for shimmering meat that looks like it just came out of the shell and has fresh, sea-like aroma — not a tired, fishy one. It's best to use cooked whole crab or crab meat the day you bought it, but if very fresh, you can store it in the fridge for up to a day.

### DUNGENESS CRAB FOR TWO

I find Dungeness crab so rich and delicious that it doesn't require any other embellishments, except, perhaps, a little melted butter for dipping and lemon wedges for squeezing. In the summer-time, new potatoes and corn, especially when locally in-season, are my favourite vegetables to serve alongside the crab.

Makes 2 servings  
Preparation time: 5 minutes  
Cooking time: About 10 minutes  
1/4 cup (50 mL) sea salt  
2 1-3/4 lb. (875-gram) live Dungeness crab

melted butter and lemon wedges

**Directions:** Bring 1 1/2 gallons (5.7 litres) of water to a boil in a tall pot. Add the salt and return to a boil. Add the crab and return to a boil. Boil for 7 to 8 minutes. Carefully remove the crabs from the pot, holding them above the water to allow them to drain. Set on large plates. Serve with melted butter for dipping and lemon wedges for squeezing.

### HOW TO CLEAN A LIVE CRAB

Make the crab docile by placing it on a tray in the freezer, or by submerging it in crushed ice, for 15 minutes. Place the crab on its back on a well-secured cutting board.

Steadily hold the handle of a large, heavy knife or cleaver and set the blade along the centre line of the crab, between the two sets of legs. With your other hand, firmly and carefully strike the top of the knife or cleaver with a rubber mallet or similar tool, chopping the crab in half.

This will kill the crab, but don't touch it until it stops moving. Remove the triangular apron from the underside of the crab and then pull off the top shell. Remove the beak-like mouth parts and discard the gills, the feathery fingers just above the legs. Pull and — using cold water — rinse away the other innards. Two cleaned crab halves are now ready to be boiled, steamed, broiled, grilled or cut into leg pieces and stir-fried.

# Summer arrives early at Uplands

Summer doesn't officially arrive for another couple of weeks, but the new season is already being celebrated with a group art show at the Uplands Cultural and Heritage Centre in Lennoxville.

Bonheur d'été 2006 features the recent works of 10 talented local artists in a variety of media: Maureen Bean's stained glass (North Hatley), Peter Belland's paintings (Cowansville), André Belle-Isle's sculptures (Stanstead), Oscar Bajofer's stained glass (La Patrie), Vrigina Cope's paintings (Georgeville), Réjean Côtes' pottery (Hatley), Dominique Choquette's mosaics (Sherbrooke), Chantal Julien's paintings (Sherbrooke), Francine Mercier's stained glass (La Patrie) and Margrethe Ulvik's drawings (Sherbrooke).

Ulvik's four dog drawings bring history and the present together, as they are done on vintage colour printed-paper from Italy.

"My mother once brought me to Florence, Italy, where I bought a selection of pretty printed paper," said Ulvik, who grew up in Norway. "I can still remember vividly the shop, and the smell of the the dust. It was a dark wood-brown, narrow space with a ceiling that must have been very high. Then there were the large and shallow drawers from where I picked my favourite papers. What a thrill.

"The paper roll was securely stocked in some dark corner of the house, where it stayed for many years... and could have still stayed there, if it was not for my daughter who one day brought home a dog!"

Ulvik, who has a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the University of Norway, is concerned with the saying that 'what is not used is lost.'

"So I keep on creating my art using the skill of my hands - like sewing, dyeing,

drawing, weaving, writing, etc. Handwork that once for everybody now seems more and more to the privilege of the artist. It is my wish that my work, including these drawings, can add a poetic touch to life."

Meanwhile, art was Bean's favourite class in school, and she has now been exhibiting for about 20 years - though she drew and painted years before that. She has a total of 11 watercolour paintings in the show.

"All of my paintings are of nature," said Bean, who noted the vernissage last Sunday was well-attended and well-received. "I was told by many viewers that my paintings are clean, uncluttered, and precise. The show is varied with many interesting pieces, pottery, oils, mixed media, sculpture, etc. There is something for everyone's tastes," said Bean.

Ulvik added: "Visiting Uplands is like visiting a friendly home, where you will find all these pictures and various objects you can buy that will create Bonheur in your home."

And she hopes admirers will take something away from her art.

"Live with it. I think it would bring good luck to me as well as to them."

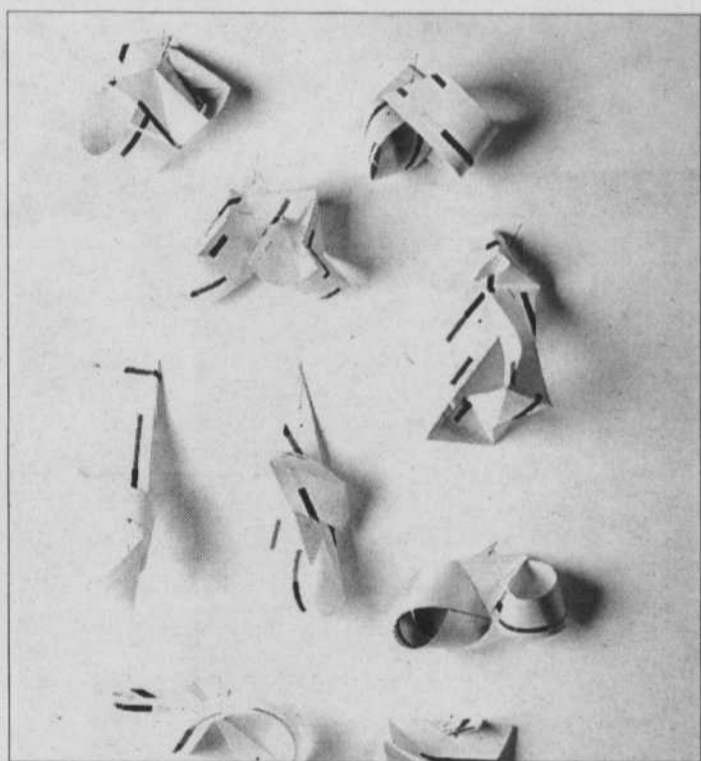
### Still lives restored

Still lives restored is the title of the next art show, opening June 11 at the North Hatley library.

The subjects are shells, fossils and skeletons, collected over the years. They were actually rendered with oils on a plastered and primed canvas. At that point they were obliterated by the application of more plaster. 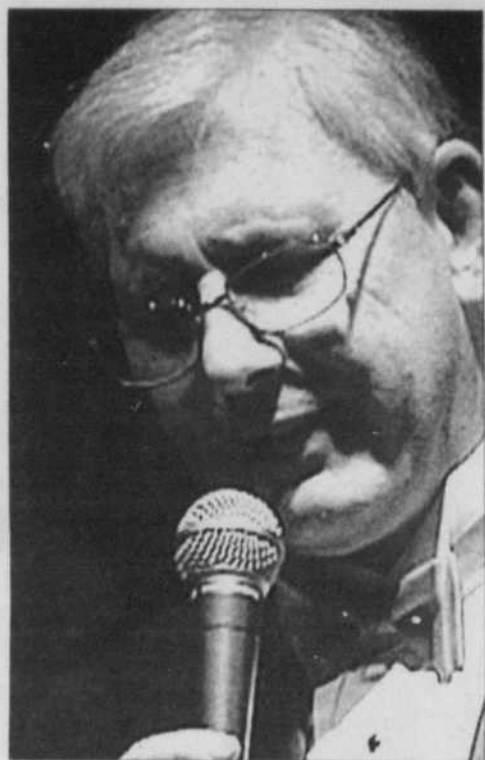

men, and much more recent tunes such as Gershwin's Porgy and Bess and The Man of la Mancha.

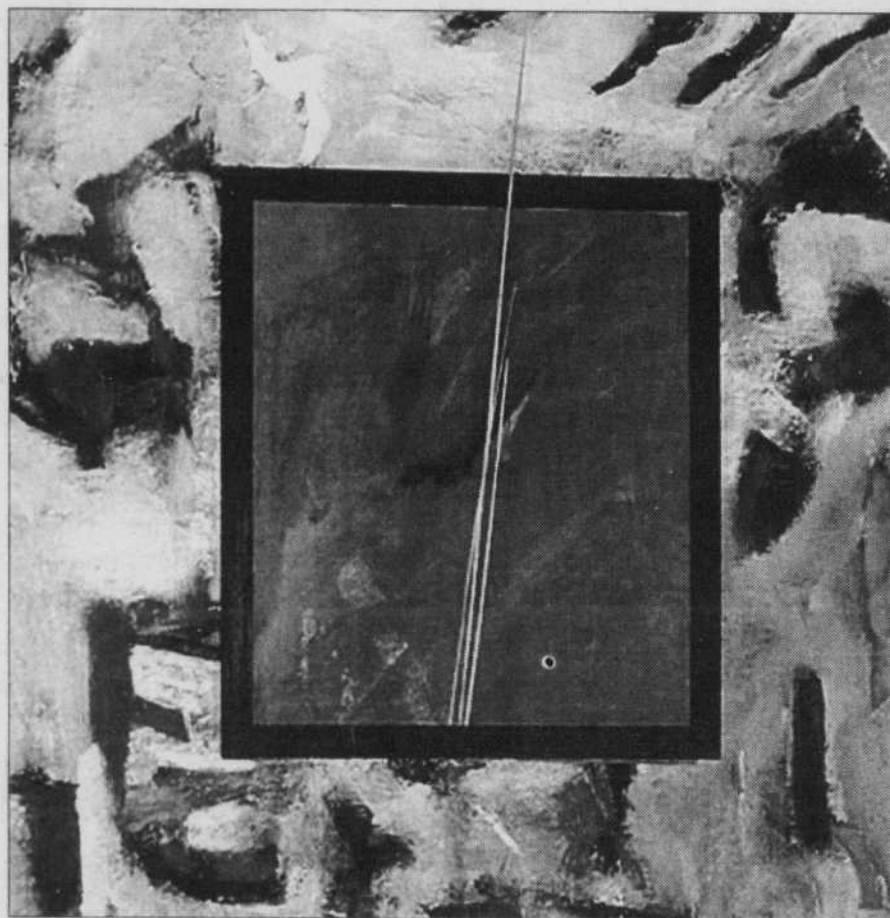
Hardy promises the music will warm the arts centre, and her one hope for the weekend is that the weather does the same.

# Summer CD forecast: Scorchin' hot rock

The winter freeze on new releases has thawed and, as the thermostat rises, so does the heat coming from the music industry's it-bands. Here are the top rock, club and pop albums coming out this summer that are sure to provide a soundtrack for all your sun-fuelled debauchery in the moshpits, house parties, clubs and lake-side cabins.

#### TOP ROCK ALBUMS

- Alexisonfire, *Crisis*

These screamo spazs conquered the country with relentless touring, and the experience has worn off on this new full-length: lyrically, singer George Pettit says fans can expect a darker turn and, musically, the rhythms have picked up in pace. He's also taking inspiration from tour-mates such as Hot Water Music, Rise Against and Planes Mistaken For Stars.

- Three Days Grace, *One-X*

They hit it big telling you how they hate everything about you, and now Canada's radio-friendly agro-rockers follow-up their smash debut with a dozen distorted, chugging wails of woe, including such uplifting tracks as 'It's All Over,' 'Pain,' 'Time of Dying' and 'Let it Die.' Get on your Le Chateau Sex Pistols T-shirt and rebel all summer long with this as your soundtrack.

- Billy Talent, *Billy Talent V.2*

Expect more foot-stomping, more snotty vocal sneers and much, much more love from the teenage depressed

rebel sect.

#### TOP POP ALBUMS

- Justin Timberlake, *Untitled*

Everyone's favourite 'Nsync refugee will undoubtedly be ruling your radio when the first single from his monster sophomore solo album — which includes production work by heavy hit-makers Timbaland, Rick Ruben and the Black Eyed Peas' Will.i.am — drops this summer. Expect to hear his collaboration with Canadian sweetheart Nelly Furtado, 'Crowd Control.'

- J. Simpson, *And the Band Played On*

This long-delayed disc, originally due in November, has been on the backburner since America's favourite ditz split from her boy-band dropout, Nick Lachey. Originally, it was supposed to feature country-meets-club tunes, but Simpson went back to add in tracks about her broken heart post-Lachey, which are said to have a more typical power-ballad sound. Let's just hope it's better than Lachey's driveling, my-hot-rich-wife-dumped-me disc, *What's Left of Me*.

Christina Aguilera, *Back to Basics*  
Xtina declares she's "Still Dirty" on her buttless-chap-approved fourth album that also promises to supply jazz and soul standards.

## Professor's latest book a study of Quebec society

The Eastern Townships Research Centre will be holding a book launch for Jack Little's latest publication, *The Other Québec: Microhistorical Essays on Nineteenth-Century Religion and Society* (UTP), on June 9, at 1:30 p.m. in the Cleghorn Common Room (McGreer) of Bishop's University in Lennoxville.

Little, professor and chair of the History department at Simon Fraser University and a recently elected Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, is one of the leading experts in the history of the Eastern Townships and specializes in religion — Protestantism in particular — in this area.

He is the author of several publications on the communities established in the province of Quebec by families

from the Isle of Arran and the Isle of Lewis. His previous publication, *Borderland Religion: The Emergence of an English-Canadian Identity, 1792-1852*, published in fall 2004 by University of Toronto Press, will also be available at the event.

# Unspeakably evil

With more than six and a half billion people on the planet, it is a statistical certainty that many persons will lie outside the norms of ordinary, civilized behaviour.

A smaller number will be so dysfunctional as to require custodial care, and a tiny fraction of those will perform horrific, terrible deeds, actions that cause us to question our most basic assumptions about what it is to be a human being.

Most of us, thankfully, will never encounter such individuals; but those who do — and live to tell about it — will carry the scars, inside or without, of their experience for the rest of their lives.

This week's pick is about just such twisted souls, and the many ways that they affect the lives of those around them. It is also a moving account of ordinary people, with human flaws and failings, who help to make us safe from those walking aberrations of humanity who are unspeakably evil.

## THE AUTHOR

Giles Blunt is a bestselling author in Canada, and is rapidly winning international acclaim. He was raised in North Bay, Ont., as he puts it, "a child of parents so English that the space on their passports for citizenship could only be filled in: British Beyond Belief." After attending a Catholic boys school for most of his youth, he moved to New York City in 1980, where he shared an apartment with an American woman, Janna, who was later to become his wife.

Blunt Giles began his literary career writing poetry. After emigrating to the US, he worked in bars and hotels until landing a job as a screenwriter of police dramas, including a script for Law and Order. His first novel, *The Cold Eye*, was eventually made into a film by French director Alain Jessua, which was released as *Les Couleurs du Diable*.

In 2002, Blunt and Janna returned to Canada, settling in Toronto, where they continue to make their home.

*Forty Words for Sorrow* (2000) is the first novel in the John Cardinal series; it won the British Crime Writers' Silver Dagger Award in 2001. It was followed by *The Delicate Storm* (2002) which won an Arthur Ellis Award in 2004, and *Blackfly Season*, nominated for an Arthur Ellis Award for Best Canadian Novel of 2005.

Blunt is currently working on his fourth John Cardinal novel, called *By the Time You Read This*.

## FORTY WORDS OF SORROW (RANDOM HOUSE, 2000)

Algonquin Bay, in the depths of winter. Detective Sergeant John Cardinal, an investigator with the Algonquin Bay Police Department, is summoned to the site of a body found in the Manitou Islands. The victim's remains have decayed and been mutilated by animals, and are frozen in ice.

They are the first tangible evidence in a string of disappearances, all involving young people, that has haunted the isolated community in recent months.

Cardinal and his partner, DS Lise Delorme, are assigned the case. Complicating matters, Delorme has been ordered to look into Cardinal's personal life, to discover just how it is that a small-town police officer can afford to send his daughter to Yale University to study art.

Cardinal has other baggage: His wife Catherine has been institutionalized once again in the psychiatric wing of the local hospital, suffering from manic depression.

In the course of his investigation Cardinal will wrestle with his feelings about his wife, cross paths with his arrogant superior, be drawn into a case that involves a secret from his past that will threaten to end his career, and look down the barrel of a crazed killer.

## RECOMMENDATION

A clearly talented writer, Blunt skillfully explores the full gamut of the human psyche. He lays bare the sordid souls and twisted thinking of sociopathic killers; but he also examines, with great sensitivity and insight, the range of emotions experienced by those who suffer from bipolar disorder, and family members who must somehow cope with their afflictions.

His characters are believable (sometimes all-too-much so), and his protagonists, John Cardinal and Lise Delorme, are fresh and engaging.

*Forty Words for Sorrow* is a deftly-constructed, literate tale. It has a puzzle at its heart, with sufficient police-procedural forensics to satisfy even the most intransigent CSI buff, and enough suspense to keep you reading until the final, gripping, conclusion. Despite his dark themes, you will want to read more of this author.

## Tennyson of Toronto unveils new book

If Elmore Leonard is the "Dickens of Detroit," as the mystery world has long proclaimed, then Peter Robinson is, undeniably, the "Tennyson of Toronto."

Who else but this Canadian crime writer can, like a literary shaman, pull tragedy from a bag and transform it into a good thing — with haunting, remarkable murder stories as complex as they are redemptive, as profound as poetic?

Robinson has been building an international reputation — one book at a time for 19 years — with a series starring curmudgeonly Yorkshire detective Alan Banks.

*Piece of My Heart* (McClelland & Stewart, \$34.99), is the 15th in that series by the 56-year-old author who came to Canada from Yorkshire in 1974.

Still, despite Robinson's international appeal, the slew of crime writing awards he's collected and the buzz surrounding his latest book, the author is aggrieved at the lack of recognition afforded him in Canada. Bestseller-list performance the world over, he complains, just doesn't seem to cut any ice with Canadian lists.

*Piece of My Heart* is a deftly constructed murder story running on two threads — the murder of a teenage flower child at a rock concert in Yorkshire in 1969, and the slaying of a music journalist in another small Yorkshire village in 2005.

Stanley Chadwick, war veteran and concerned father, is the detective assigned to the stabbing death of the

young woman at the Brimleigh Festival while Pink Floyd, Led Zeppelin and Fleetwood Mac hammered out their legendary sounds. Banks and partner Annie Cabbot are handling the case of the poker-beaten journalist.

The common thread linking the 36-year gap in the two cases is the psychedelic rock group the Mad Hatters, an

on-again, off-again band whose keyboardist was related to the girl murdered at the festival. The now-aging rock star was being hounded by the 38-year-old journalist who had been trying to construct a 40th-anniversary story about the band.

Banks, like his creator, is a music junkie, coincidentally rolling Pink Floyd's 'Breathe' (from *Dark Side of the Moon*) on his dead brother's stereo as he and Cabbot get ready to share a meal together. Murder intervenes.

This story finds Banks nearing recovery from his last case, one in which his brother died. The stereo, big-screen plasma TV, wine cellar and Porsche in the laneway are but a few memories from his sibling's much larger estate.

The beauty of Robinson's series lies not only in his storytelling of British crime, but in his ability to open a portal into the hearts of characters like Banks and, in this case, Det. Chadwick, too.

Robinson, who suffered a mild heart attack last fall in Banff, makes a point in the book of thanking cardiac specialists in Banff and in Calgary for their unwitting contribution to the story.

Set in bleak, off-season Atlantic City, Duane Hopwood is the portrait of a man who has it all, but is losing everything because of his alcoholism. After a run-in with the law threatens to destroy his relationship with his daughters and ex-wife, Duane struggles to reclaim his life.

Duane Hopwood offers a highly realistic representation of the disease, painting the alcoholic not as some flamboyant scene-stealer, but as a sad person whose life nonetheless contains moments of joy as well as pain. David Schwimmer, of TV's Friends, is almost unrecognizable as the title character, and Janeane Garofalo gives a precise performance as his ex, who merely wants to protect their children. Duane Hopwood is quite intelligent in its depiction of how easily lives can splinter, but the film is not as convincing in regards to the ways in which they can be rebuilt.



# Pixar's Cars a flag-waving remnant from the scrap heap

There's something altogether creepy about Cars, the new Disney-Pixar animated extravaganza that's looking to rev up summer box-office.

It's not an easy feeling to explain, but this kid-oriented story about the secret life of automobiles contains elements of horror movie cliché that conjures memories of everything from Psycho to The Hills Have Eyes.

The immediate connection comes through the landscape. Much of the film takes place in the quaint virtual world of Radiator Springs, a small town on old Route 66 where cars once lived the good life: Drive-in restaurants, full-service gas stations, dirt track racing on the weekends, and plenty of theme motels with private parking.

That was in the old days. Radiator Springs is now little more than a boarded-up desert ghost town populated by rusty chassis and urban highway exiles who couldn't handle the strain of the daily commute.

The people — or, I should say, cars — who live there are outsiders who feel abandoned by the rest of the world. So when egotistical NASCAR rookie Lightning McQueen (Owen Wilson) finds himself in the tumbleweeds of Radiator Springs after being separated from his fancy semi-trailer, the old-timers are a little taken aback.

If Cars had been a horror movie, Lightning McQueen would have been put on blocks and stripped down, one sparkplug at a time, in the same way young women are usually cut to pieces in movies such as The Hills Have Eyes, or House of Wax, or any movie that takes place against the eerie backdrop of a ghost town.

Fortunately, the bright brains at Pixar decided against disemboweling and focused on the moral challenge

faced by Lightning as he's given a choice: Either fix the damage he caused to Main Street on his arrival, or spend his days behind bars at the impound lot while the rest of the NASCAR racers compete for the Piston Cup, racing's most coveted prize.

Lightning is full of Piston Cup adoration and vinegar. He wants to win and become a huge racing star, but the more he learns about Radiator Springs and its eclectic mix of cars, the more he learns about himself.

Pushing him to look under his own hood are Sally Carrera (Bonnie Hunt), a Porsche power hitter from Los Angeles who lost her taste for the fast lane, and Doc Hudson (Paul Newman), a curmudgeonly old-timer with a secret past. Doc used to be a dirt track champion until a bad crash put him in the shop.

Filling out the cast of cars are an Italian tire salesman, a hippie VW microbus, a hillbilly tow truck and the local law enforcement cherry top. They're simple modes of transport, but they've got a lot of heart, and as Lightning repaves the main drag to pay his debt to Radiator Springs, they teach him a few things about the bigger picture as well as himself.

The self-improvement through self-awareness formula is tried and true, and as Doc finds the dimensions of Yoda, Lightning finds the dimensions of young Luke Skywalker as he offers Radiator Springs hope for a better tomorrow.

The narrative gets us to the expected destination — a happy ending — but the journey feels stuck in a rut. Despite Pixar's technological wizardry in rendering this desolate car town and the physics of car motion, there's no spark in the dramatic engine.

We can predict every turn and twist the movie takes along the road, which leaves us little to focus on except the cali-

bre of the writing, the performances and the eerie premise of talking, living cars.

Whether it's merely the lingering memories of Stephen King's Christine, or the current angst surrounding global warming and the evils of gas-burning cars, but endowing a motor vehicle with human feelings is a disturbing idea.

Though Herbie the Love Bug remains a warm and fuzzy memory for me and many others, Herbie needed a human companion in order to be a happy Beetle. The cars in Cars don't need any humans. In fact, this whole world that looks and acts much like our own doesn't contain any humans and that's what makes the whole experience just a little unsettling.

Moreover, the underlying message of the film celebrates the automobile and the internal combustion engine as noble human achievements that should be celebrated with more highway driving, more gas stations, more back roads and car-friendly activities for the whole family.

In this day and age, celebrating the

car just feels wrong. Cars clearly had their day in the sun, and memories of those Sunday-drive loving days of the 1950s may well prompt memories of America's golden age when the automobile represented nothing less than personal freedom.

That nostalgia continues to fuel the American Dream, but not for long. We're on the verge of rethinking our relationship with the automobile, and this flag-waving remnant from the scrap heap of American culture feels like a desperate attempt to resuscitate the romance of a dying industry.

The movie feels hollow at the core, but it does look good and that will no doubt prove enough to woo the kids — at least for the duration. But Cars does not possess the same Pixar magic as previous gems such as Toy Story and The Incredibles, and will most likely prove forgettable once the smoke and screeching tires of a high-profile release subside.

# The Wreckers shine with modern country Music

Moving away from a career in pop-rock music, and living her new motherhood to the fullest, singer Michelle Branch has formed a new band with friend and Kansas City native Jessica Harp.

The duo is called The Wreckers and they have just released their debut album — Stand Still, Look Pretty — which offers modern country music seasoned with pop and rock.

Performing with heart and energy, The Wreckers offer a pleasing mixture of country styles that has become a standard in Nashville today.

They deliver some standout tracks, with some enjoyable tasting filler in between. I am still wondering why The Wreckers are being marketed to country music audiences — with the exception of two tracks ('Crazy People' and 'My, Oh My'), the album leans more toward other genres.

A better description would be acoustic or semi-acoustic pop with a dash of country. If you're a real fan of country music, you might have to listen to the collection a few times before you start enjoying the debut album.

I think both of the numbers cited above would make good singles with

strong charting possibilities, but the rest of the album still offers good work.

The current single, 'Leave the Pieces', is a pure modern country-pop song with tight vocal harmonies, violins and banjos as well as heavy guitar work.

There is a nice mixture of ballads and faster songs which is always interesting to find in an album. I read somewhere that Michelle Branch really wanted to make an album that would be more bluegrass, but was prevented from doing so by her label.

If this is true, it is really too bad, because with the nice vocal harmonies that Harp and Branch provide, this would have made a magnificent totally acoustic album.

Although it is a pretty decent album, it would be nice if their sophomore effort goes further toward bluegrass or else has a real traditional country sound. As it is now, it is too edgy to please fans of traditional country and too acoustic to please rock fans.

Produced by John Leventhal, the collection is polished, but not slick enough

to overpower the good musicianship displayed here.

Branch and Harp harmonize very well because their voices are pretty similar.

The album is quite serious, but ends up with the humorous 'Only Crazy People.' Finally, a little of Branch's pop and folk style does come through on songs like the title track and 'Rain.'

The songs feel familiar because it sounds like Branch's earlier work or it might be their ability to sound a lot like the Dixie Chicks, but you soon realize they're not the Chicks.

Fans of the television show One Tree Hill will remember 'The Good Kind', a more plaintive and emotional song with the duo trading lines. Sometimes it's hard to tell where Branch's voice begins and Harp's ends.

'Tennessee' is another potentially huge single, it has a definite Faith Hill feel to it, with a soaring chorus and is one of the best tracks on the album.

'My Oh My' is more traditional country, driven by banjos with a bluegrass flavour, it becomes a highly addictive combination.

The powerfully gentle title track 'Stand Still Look Pretty' and the soft track 'Rain' are more somber and musically very different, but they fit in with the rest of the material found on the record.

Spending the summer on tour with Rascal Flatts seems appropriate for The Wreckers, since they deliver the same type of easily digestible modern country that radio programmers seem to enjoy so much.

It's not the most adventurous songwriting we have seen but it is still noteworthy. If you enjoy Rascal Flatts or Michelle Branch's previous work, you will enjoy this album.

The music is as slickly produced as you would expect it to be.

Stand Still, Look Pretty is not the greatest album to come out in 2006 for country music fans but the effort is honest and the talent is there.

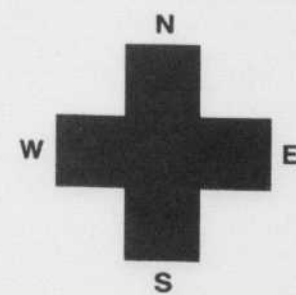
