## Thriller unlocks secrets of wartime spy centre

LONDON (Reuter) — As the novelist himself is the first to admit, Adolf Hitler has been good to Robert Harris.

The British author made his name with *Selling Hitler*, the "stranger than fiction" story of how a forger tricked the world into believing he had found the dictator's diaries.

Harris's first novel, *Fatherland*, about life in a totalitarian post-war Germany that had won the Second World War, was a huge success. Translated into 25 languages, *Fatherland* has sold four million copies worldwide and is the most successful first novel by a British author in the last 20 years.

Now, after two years of research, Harris has returned to mine his favorite seam. This time he surveys the war from a British angle in the thriller *Enigma*, based on events at the top-secret Bletchley Park code-breaking centre.

*Enigma* (Random House, \$31) looks set to equal *Fatherland's* success, earning rave reviews and huge media coverage on its release. One reviewer called the gripping tale of mathematics, romance and betrayal the "thriller of the year, if not of several years."

Historians believe Bletchley Park, and its cryptographers' success in cracking the Germans' Enigma military code, was a major factor in the Allied

victory.

Intrigued by a TV documentary on Enigma, Harris quickly became obsessed by the achievements of Bletchley Park that at its peak employed 100,000 people who handled many millions of messages from Germany's armed forces every year.

*Enigma* is named after the encrypting machine — a set of preset, revolving drums — which provided codes the Germans believed, wrongly, were unbreakable.

Just as German work on jet-propelled rockets was the foundation of the U.S. post-war space program, Bletchley Park's success provided the forerunner for modern day computers.

"It seemed to be quite a modern story even though it

was set in the war," Harris said. "This business about it being the birthplace of the computer and the model of the secret intelligence state interested me.

"It's how (Microsoft boss) Bill Gates, the Internet and all that started. Trace it back and you end up at Bletchley Park."

The hero of *Enigma* is Tom Jericho, resident genius of Bletchley Park whose success in breaking the German navy's Shark code has caused him a nervous breakdown.

Hurriedly recalled from Cambridge, Jericho and his colleagues are given four days to break a new version of the code introduced by the Germans and save a huge American aid convoy being destroyed by U-boats in the North Atlantic.

But Jericho's battered mind is obsessed by what happened to his girlfriend, Claire, a clerk at Bletchley Park. Slowly he realizes her disappearance and the sudden change of code by the Germans could be linked.

The smell of espionage is in the air.

Harris, a former political editor at the Observer newspaper, spoke to Bletchley Park veterans, an eclectic mix of mathematicians, students and crossword experts, some of whom had never discussed their work with an outsider.

The Ultra project, as Bletchley Park's work was known, was kept a state secret until 1974 when a former cryptographer published a book *The Ultra Secret*, causing a literary sensation.

## Bookmakers make Salman Rushdie novel favorite for literary prize

LONDON (AP) — Bookmakers today made Salman Rushdie's new novel, *The Moor's Last Sigh*, the favorite to win the Booker Prize, Britain's prestigious literary award.

At a ceremony last week, the judges announced a short list of five books instead of the usual six from a record Booker entry of 141 novels.

The four other contenders are *The Ghost Road* by Pat Barker, *In Every Face I Meet* by Justin Cartwright, *Morality Play* by Barry Unsworth and *The Riders* by Tim Winton.

Both Rushdie and Unsworth are previous Booker winners.

"There was great enthusiasm from all of the judges for these five titles," said judges'

chairman George Walden, a Conservative lawmaker and newspaper columnist.

"There was no other book which had the same degree of overall support, and we didn't want to compromise for the sake of numbers," he said.

The other judges were crime writer Ruth Rendell, novelist and critic Adam Mars-Jones and newspaper critics Kate Kellaway and Peter Kemp.

# New England folk musician kicks off music series

AYER'S CLIFF — New England native Harvey Reid kicks off the latest series of folk concerts at the Auberge Ayer's Cliff Friday.

Six concerts will be presented at the auberge, also known as the Cliff House, about every two weeks. The series is primarily composed of artists which perform folk and Celtic music, reported spokesman William Floch, although many of the performers have eclectic influences.

Reid, a songwriter and multi-instrumentalist with 11 albums to his credit, plays the Cliff House October 6. He has honed his craft over the past 25 years in countless clubs, festivals, street corners, cafés, schools and concert halls, all the while absorbing a vast repertoire of American music and weaving it into his own distinctive style. He has mastered many instruments and styles of acoustic music from hip folk to country, slashing slide guitar blues to bluegrass, old-time, Celtic, ragtime and classical.

Although he remains somewhat reclusive, Reid's reputation as a musician's musician is spreading fast. He has been a featured act at many clubs and festivals, while dee-jays and critics are quickly discovering his recordings.

### 'MODERN MINSTRAL'

Reid calls himself a "modern minstrel" with elements of the traditional troubadour, the modern poet-songwriter, the American back-porch picker, the classical virtuoso and even a bit of Will Rogers-style dry humor and satire all blended in his singular personality.

On October 27, Montreal country trio Steel Rail is back by popular demand. Lead singer Tod Gorr, bassist Ellen Shizgal and lead guitarist

Dave Clarke will once again warm audiences with their mix of country, folk and bluegrass. Opening the show for Steel Rail will be David Francey and Sergio Abreu.

Folk duo Bill Garrett and Curly Boy Stubbs perform at the bar the following night, October 28. Having just returned from a tour of western Canada, they are sure to delight with virtuoso guitar performances. Robin Heilig, Evey Miller and Del Springate will open.

Montreal folk singer Penny Lang will continue the series with a show on November 11. "The First Lady of Canadian Folk Music" performs a spirited mix of original compositions and personalized versions of gospel, blues and country songs.

On November 25, popular Celtic duo Orealis play the Cliff House. Montrealers Kirk MacGeachy and Dave Gossage are known for their lively airs and serene marches featuring Scottish, Irish and Québécois influences. Floch promises to stock a good supply of Guinness, Smithwick's and Jameson's for the evening.

The fall series concludes on December 9 with the Jig's Up Trio, an energetic three-man band based in Quebec City. Guitarist John Powers of Saskatchewan and saxophonist David Parker, from the Maritimes, join Quebec City native Gaétan Jobin to deliver decidedly up-tempo music.

The Cliff House once again offers patrons "An Evening With..." the performers, which includes a four-course meal along with the show.

All concerts begin at 8 p.m. Tickets for the show only are \$8-10. For more information, call (819) 838-4277.

Community production showcases music, dance, fashion of bygone era

# Echo Art relives the turbulent 60s

KNOWLTON — They were dancing in the streets when the Motown record company was founded in 1960.

One year later, they stopped dancing and started marching when John F. Kennedy started to increase the United States' military presence in Vietnam.

At the end of the decade, new president Richard Nixon withdrew U.S. forces from Vietnam in 1969 meanwhile 500,000 hippies celebrated their freedom at a rock music festival in Woodstock, New York.

In between these events there was a loss of innocence, a search for identity and purpose, and a ferocious declaration of free will. Politics and music both defined the Age of Aquarius as clearly as the social and sexual revolutions spearheaded by long-haired hippies with a penchant for pot.

The social and musical evolution of the '60s is the subject

of a new community musical by Brome's Echo Art theatre company.

## DIVERSITY

*The 60s — A Musical Retrospective*, which opened at Theatre Lac Brome in Knowlton Thursday, illustrates the tremendous diversity of the era through music, dance and costumes with a cast of 36 and a four-member band.

Audiences can tap their toes through exuberant renditions of "Pony Time" by Chubby Checker, "Please Mr. Postman" by the Marvelettes and "My Guy" by Mary Wells which illustrate the frivolous and frothy side of the era.

But the serious side of the '60s is also represented, in Act 2, with songs and scenes representing the Vietnam War, war protests and coffee house gatherings, all ending with a sparkling finale of hippies celebrating this folkie era.

A skeleton story weaves its

way throughout the show, following a young couple (Caitlin Joyce and Eugene Brotto) as they meet, get married and how they are affected by the war and its aftermath.

"You get to know them and that makes it a bit more interesting," said Jean-Charles Rivard, one of the musical's producers and actors.

This also made it easier when it came time to choosing the songs to be included in the show.

"It took forever to decide which songs to do," Rivard said. "The deciding factor is those songs which were conducive to our storyline. So for every song we picked, we left 100 aside."

## ORIGINAL VERSIONS

The final decision was up to musical director Rick Ricciardi, whose number one objective was to present the songs as they were originally recorded rather than as they may have been done by other artists as cover versions.

"The music was a lot more

diverse than the stuff from the '50s," said Ricciardi, who took many trips down memory lane while researching and choosing music for the show.

The production does not simply stop at the musical artists of the era. Two defining television shows are also recreated — *Rowan & Martin's Laugh-In* and *The Ed Sullivan Show*.

The comedy-variety series *Laugh-In*, hosted by Dan Rowan and Dick Martin, changed the face of American TV in the late '60s with its fast-paced, unstructured delivery featuring a cast of then-unknowns including Goldie Hawn, Ruth Buzzi, Arte Johnson and Gary Owens.

"It was a show that meant something in the '60s," said Rivard, who plays Dick Martin. "We're recreating the crazy atmosphere of the show."

## BANTER

The segment opens with some fun banter between Rivard as Martin and Ricciardi

as Rowan before segueing into *Laugh-In's* famous recurring skit — the cocktail party.

"It's fast-paced one-liners," said Rivard. "Also, we're pretending this is the taping of one of the episodes of *Laugh-In*, so people will be seeing cameramen, the technical crew, someone with the cue cards, so they'll be privy to boo-boos."

Rivard said for this segment, the cast was asked not to memorize their lines, but to quickly read them off the cue cards. "That's the way they used to do it," Rivard said. "It was one of the first shows that used to air boo-boos."

The *Ed Sullivan Show* was the premier American showcase for international talent ranging from pop stars to magicians and even singing nuns.

"He helped change the face of music by introducing the Beatles to America," Rivard said.

## BEATLES

In the same vein as the *Laugh-In* segment, a taping of the show is recreated as Sullivan introduces various artists such as Sonny & Cher and the Beatles, complete with appropriate display of adoration from screaming fans.

Rivard said there are many reasons why people are still attracted to the music of the '60s.

"Some of the music had a definite message, some of the people who performed the songs became legends, and some are still around today, like the Rolling Stones. When the music did emerge, it did shake things up," said Rivard, adding for him, the Beatles are the biggest musical act of all time.

Director Emma Stevens said there is a large nostalgic movement for the '60s today.

"Young people play '60s

music a lot," she said, adding that the Vietnam War affected her most during the '60s.

"I got uptight, upset and the rest of it. I got caught up in the protest part and the music. People were reacting to things going on around them. I remember carrying signs, giving flowers to cops. I didn't get into the drugs. There was always a sense of hope, that's lacking today."

Stevens said the young people in the production love the music of the '60s, but they didn't know what went along with it.

"It wasn't just drug time," she said.

Sixteen-year-old Laura Allen said playing a part in the production has given her an education in the '60s.

"I didn't know Ed Sullivan, I didn't even know a '60s song before. Now I've gotten the clothes, the songs, the moves and the dances. A lot happened."

Choreographer Lorna Wayne, who was at the height of her dancing career during the '60s, said she was immediately taken by the popular dances of the day, including the Mash Potato, the Pony and the Jerk.

"I also think the freedom with the fashions was fun. It wasn't as structured as our parents had brought us up," said Wayne, who admitted to enjoying wearing mini-skirts, go-go boots and croqueted hats.

With 18 complete songs and another 14 sung in medleys, *The 60s — A Musical Retrospective* should prove to be a fun-filled recreation of the mood and the music of the era, appealing to audiences from six to 60 and beyond.

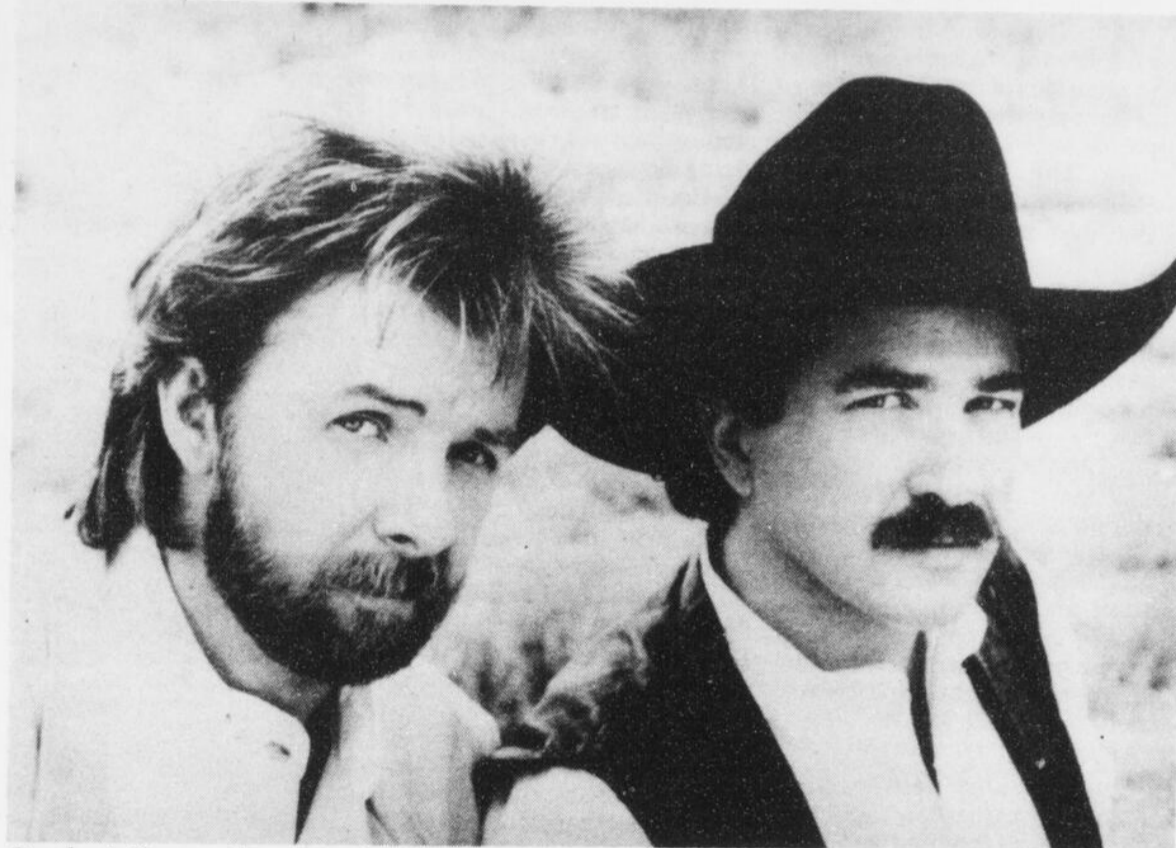

before they play "She's Not The Cheating Kind" and a few of their other hits.

Then it's Kix' turn as he bares his soul in an anguished interpretation of The Eagles' "Best Of My Love", his voice intertwining and soaring with Ronnie's to chase chills up and down the spine and draw squeals of pleasure.

"Let's honky-tonk!" shouts Ronnie. "Yes sir! Let's do it y'all!" Kix shoots back and if it wasn't for security, fans would rush to the stage to dance to the rollicking beat of "My Next Broken Heart".

Kix laughs as he playfully shoves a band member behind him when he comes to the front of the stage. Purple and tur-

quoise lights swirling behind him on a giant backdrop, Ronnie magically turns frenzied fans into silence, pouring the gravelled beauty of his voice into "Neon Moon".

### REDNECKS

Then Kix begins clogging with hillbilly abandon to a blistering hoedown fiddle that draws hoots from the crowd.

"How many rednecks we got here tonight?" Ronnie hollers as the bittersweet curl of a fiddle swells to soothe the crowd's fervor.

Screams fill the night air. "I gotta find that out before I find out I'm the only redneck here!" Ronnie says. "See if y'all can help me out... I'm a slow learner when it gets to this game of love," he begins as the band plucks out a heartbroken melody.

"Wife number two walked up to me the other day and said, 'Guess what redneck? You're about that close to working on wife number three.' So the redneck in me immediately said, 'Well, honey, let me help you to the door.' That's how you handle that," he jokes.

"She said, 'Before you do let me give you a little word of advice'. She said, 'I'm as big a redneck as you are. I love country music, I love Harley Davidson motorcycles. She said how about giving something else a try, cowboy? How about just 10

per cent of your time? That's all you got to start with. Come off that bus after a long tour, don't go out in that garage and start playing with all your toys, just walk through that door and let the whole world stop around you, kiss me and tell me you love me."

"So is that right ladies?" Ronnie continues. "Because she said, 'If you don't, I'll tell you what, you're gonna look out on the dance floor one of these days and I'm gonna tear your heart up one side and down the other.' I believed her too. So I wrote a song about what it would be like if she was to do that." Ronnie then slides into "She Used To Be Mine" with such potent, aching sorrow, it causes the throat to swell with emotion.

### PULL OUT STOPS

After that, smoke fills the space behind them, house lights flash and they pull out all stops with "Rock My World, Little Country Girl" Kix pumps his fist, inciting fans to sing along. He then engages in a frenzied performance of dueling guitar necks with a band member as lights flicker madly.

As Ronnie starts belting out "Hard Working Man", we're in for another surprise as an inflatable giant steer skull comes out of the floor, horns

dancing to the beat of the music.

The fury of the storm is glorious with lights flashing, honky-tonk music crashing and fans going nuts dancing at their seats. Then with lightning speed, Kix' black hat is thrown out over the crowd as he moves sideways across the stage by wiggling his rear, then whirls around to jump off stage to shake hands with mesmerized fans.

As an encore, they offer "Kind Of Crazy" and "Boot Scootin' Boogie" and now it's Kix' shirt that goes flying over the crowd.

The lights go out, the storm has calmed, there's a feeling of stillness and everyone has a dazed look as Brooks and Dunn end another sold-out concert of their 1995 tour. For fair organizers, it's a total success and for concertgoers, it's a dream come true and many memories to bring home.

Don't forget that this Friday, October 6, is the beginning of another series of country talent shows at Bar Wildwood in Lennoxville.

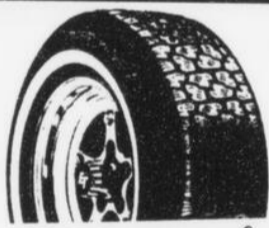

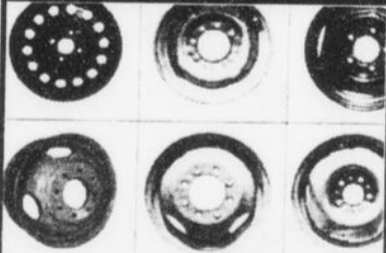

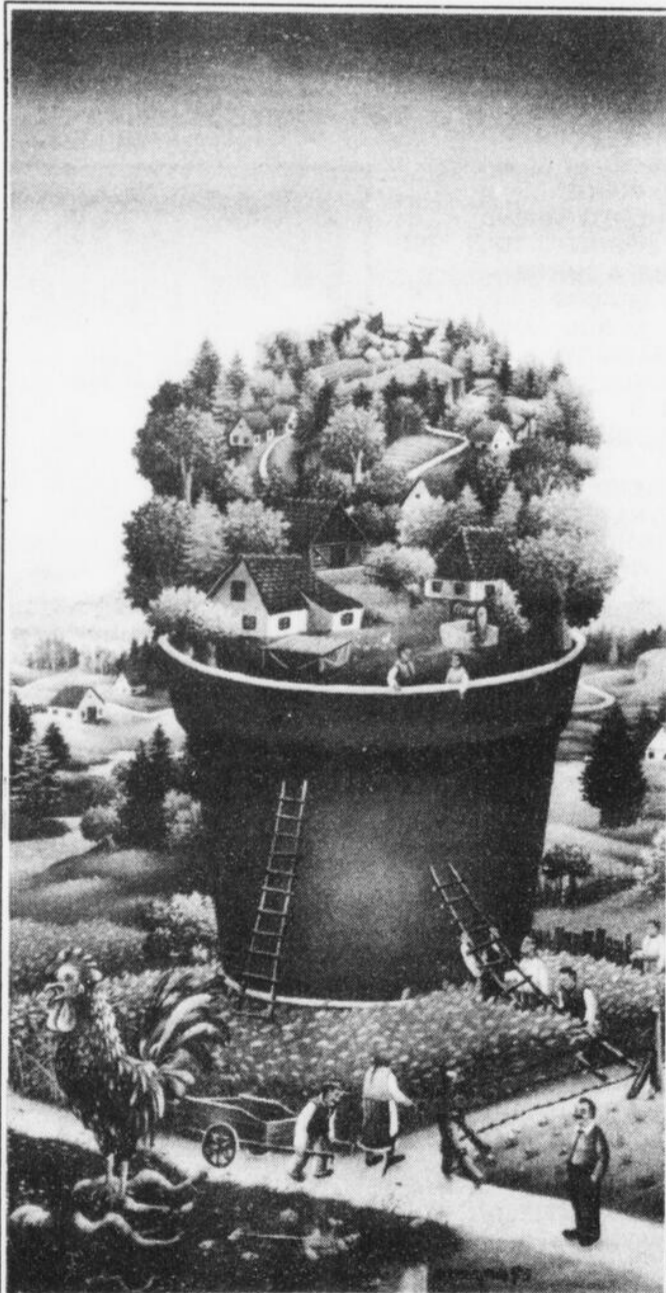

## Unscientific but true: TV guilty of annoying bad habits

LOS ANGELES (AP) — TV is taking heat for being violent, sexist, oversexed and more, with the medium's collective knuckles soundly rapped by all manner of Miss Manners.

Go to it, we say, as shameless as anyone in jumping in on the latest socio-psycho-political etiquette craze.

But what about the smaller annoyances TV visits on viewers?

Call us petty, call us superficial, but who's the watchdog for the fingernails-on-the-

blackboard stuff?

Among TV's annoying habits:

—The shoulder-to-shoulder striding cast shot. You've seen it in the credits of *ER*, *Chicago Hope* and, like a virus snaking its way through a defenceless throng, on newcomers like *The Monroes*.

Filmed in slow motion, the actors march down a corridor, preferably one of power. They're determined, they're driven, they're in drill-team synch.

But where are these people

going? And why? Did someone just yell, "Fresh-brewed cappuccino in the lunchroom!" Or maybe "Bowling league sign-ups!"

At other workplaces, only food, fire drills or five o'clock get people moving like that.

—Nicknames for those who haven't earned them. Who can resist a gangster's colorful moniker, like those bestowed on Lucky Luciano, Bugsy Siegel and Dutch Schultz? Not the news media, certainly, even when the honoree seems borderline. Take Craig (Tony The Animal) Fiato, a mob infor-

mant who got to kick up his heels in the O. J. Simpson trial chorus line.

What kind of track record does this tough guy have to have to get such recognition? Let's face it, hired legal guns like Robert (Hollywood Bob) Shapiro and Johnnie (Mighty Mouth) Cochran Jr. are way ahead of Fiato in the public consciousness. As is prosecutor Marcia (The Miniskirted Mauler) Clark.

Credit where credit is due, please.

—Politics and sitcoms as strange bedfellows. This sea-

son started out with John F. Kennedy Jr. making a cameo on *Murphy Brown*. Undeniably decorative and with the patina of myth, he was a prize catch.

Things quickly went downhill as First Brother Roger Clinton — less wooden than young Kennedy but without the charm — made a guest appearance on *The Nanny*.

Leave weighty concerns about the blurred line between reality and TV, or about inappropriate politicking, for another discussion. Our peeve: Political humor isn't for sitcoms and amateurs.

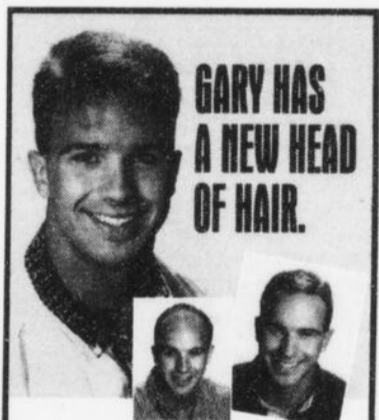

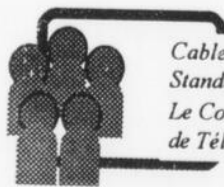

# Sunday gets bloody with prime-time rivalry

NEW YORK (AP)—*Murder, She Wrote* may have been exiled to Thursdays, but Sunday is still a killer.

Five U.S. networks have taken up arms with 11 new series, plus four returning series from other nights.

"The real fight for No. 1 in the '95-'96 network war is going to be waged, and won or lost, on Sunday night," says Sam Haskell, who heads up the West Coast TV department of the William Morris talent agency.

"With NBC's *Mad About You* moving from Thursday, CBS's *Cybill* moving from Monday with *60 Minutes* as lead-in, ABC's *Lois and Clark* finally getting Lois and Clark together — the whole season is going to come down to what's successful or not successful on Sunday night."

Will ABC, which captured the 1994-95 season, be victorious again? Or will it be last year's runner-up, NBC?

Let's survey the battlefield.

The pipsqueak WB network (unavailable in Quebec) has invaded Sunday with six half-hour comedies, five of them

*Adjustments*).

CBS panicked and, after 11 years, uprooted *Murder, She Wrote* from its 8 p.m. berth.

Filling Jessica Fletcher's shoes is January arrival *Cybill*, teamed at 8:30 p.m. with new: the animated cartoon *Pinky and the Brain*, as well as *Kirk, Simon, First Time Out* and *Cleghorne!* WB benefits from low expectations, and so far has fulfilled them: its Sunday newcomers won the bottom five slots of a recent ranking of 108 series.

Fox has a new one-hour science fiction series, *Space: Above and Beyond*, as well as new sitcoms *Too Something* and *Misery Loves Company*.

But more significant is moving its veteran *The Simpsons* from Thursday to Sunday at 8 p.m.

Here, from 8 to 9, is Sunday's main event.

NBC, repeating its successful strategy in August 1994 of moving its hit *Frasier* to Tuesday to tame ABC's *Roseanne*, decided last spring to risk meddling with its Thursday powerhouse again — this time by moving *Mad About You* to Sunday at 8 (following new sitcoms *Brotherly Love* and *Minor*

newcomer *Almost Perfect*, starring Nancy Travis and Kevin Kilner as two overachievers who fall in love.

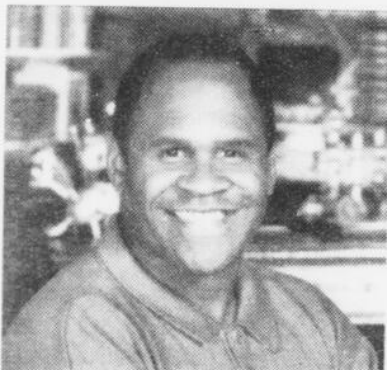
So what happened on the first Sunday of the new season? According to Nielsen ratings in the United States, *Mad* had

a robust 14.6 rating and 23 share, followed by *Hope* and *Gloria*, with an 11.7 rating and 18 share.

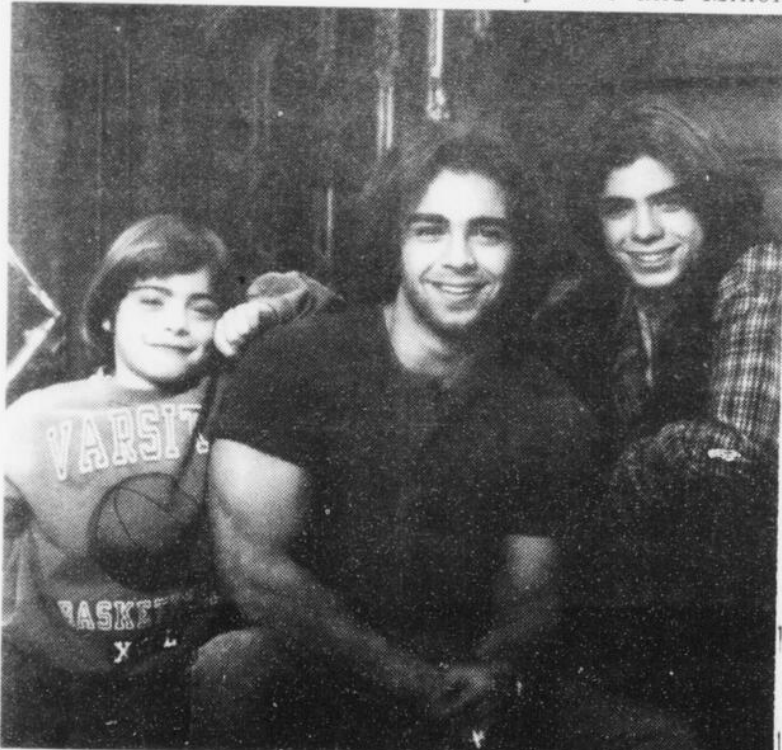
On ABC, *Lois and Clark: The New Adventures of Superman* had an 11.4 rating and 18 share. On CBS, *Cybill* had a

tepid 9.8 rating and 15 share while *Almost* had an 8.1 rating and 12 share.

One ratings point equals 959,000 TV households. Share is the percentage of TV sets in use at any one time tuned to a particular broadcast.
