**Harris and Mendieta
break the musical mold**

Two decades after they disbanded, and without Lennon Beatles make best-paid entertainers list

NEW YORK (AP) — The Beatles are back on top . . . almost.

They haven't cut a new record in 25 years and lost band member John Lennon to an assassin in 1980, but the band now ranks as the No. 3 best-paid entertainer in the U.S.

Only director Steven Spielberg and talk-show host Oprah Winfrey surpassed the Beatles in Forbes magazine's ninth annual ranking, released Sunday.

Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr, the remaining Beatles, will make an estimated \$130 million US in 1994 and 1995, the magazine says in its Sept. 25 issue. A worldwide television deal should bring them about \$75 million US this year on top of album sales.

It's the Beatles first time on Forbes Top 40 highest-paid entertainers list, a survey that combines entertainers' two-year estimated gross earnings to get a more accurate assessment of overall income.

For the second consecutive year, Spielberg reigns as the highest-paid entertainer.

The 47-year-old director, who is still raking in the dough from his box-office megahit Jurassic Park, will make an estimated \$285 million US in 1994-95.

But Spielberg's earnings may slow down a bit in the upcoming years. He recently gave up a lucrative profit-sharing deal with Universal Studios to form DreamWorks SKG, a new Hollywood studio with partners David Geffen and Jeffrey Katzenberg.

Winfrey, who in 1993 became the first woman to ever top the list, ranked a distant second behind Spielberg, with a combined two-year take of \$146 million US.

A number of other other pop-music relics who recently went back on tour also made it into the Top 10.

The Rolling Stones came in at No. 4, with an estimated income of \$121 million US, while the Eagles were fifth with \$95 million US and Pink Floyd was seventh with \$70 million US.

Barbra Streisand, who last year went on the tour for the first time in nearly three decades, was No. 9, at \$63 million US.

Other first-time entries in

this year's list include Canadian comic actor Jim Carrey (No. 21, \$39 million US), and actress Demi Moore (No. 40, \$21 million US.)

Among those falling from

the ranks: actors Tom Cruise and Eddie Murphy; singers Whitney Houston, Eric Clapton, Rod Stewart and Billy Ray Cyrus; and radio commentator Rush Limbaugh.

Grant fantasizes about Diana People Shorts

LONDON (Reuter) — Actor Hugh Grant has confessed to having kinky dreams about Diana, Princess of Wales.

But the star of the hit comedy *Four Weddings and a Funeral*, who was caught in Los Angeles in June having oral sex with a prostitute, said today his long-time girlfriend Elizabeth Hurley is still his "dish of the day."

Giving an insight into the

hidden corners of his subconscious, the 35-year-old Grant said he also dreams about having tea with the Queen and meeting former Soviet leader Mikhail Gorbachev.

"I dream about Princess Diana but it is too kinky to go into," he told the women's magazine *Eva*. He was fulsome in praise of Hurley, cover girl for the cosmetics firm Estee Lauder.

"She just keeps getting better and better," he said. "When she does magazine shoots they give her a different look every time, so a new girl comes into the house each night. It's dead sexy," he said.

Hurley stood by Grant, despite her obvious disapproval, after his conviction for lewd conduct with the prostitute.

New Beatles CD features new Lennon song

NEW YORK (AP) — Imagine a new song by John Lennon.

An anthology of Beatles music to be released in November will include *Free As A Bird*, a "new" song built around a vocal track Lennon recorded in 1974, Capitol Records said Monday.

Lennon was shot to death in 1980. Surviving Beatles Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr completed the song in February 1994.

The Beatles Anthology Volume One is the first of six planned compact discs. It will be released Nov. 20 to coincide with the airing of ABC's six-hour, three-night TV documentary on the legendary British band.

Other previously unreleased recordings on the anthology will include the Beatles performing *All My Loving* during

their historic appearance on the Ed Sullivan Show in 1964.

Christopher Reeve said to be improving


NEW YORK (AP) — Christopher Reeve is making slow but steady progress after a horse-riding accident that left him paralyzed, his brother says.

"He can say three or four words at a time now," Benjamin Reeve told the syndicated American Journal TV show in an interview to air today.

"We talk about everything from the food, to the people who visit, to successes with the children and the things they do each day," Benjamin Reeve said, referring to his brother's two sons and a daughter.

The 42-year-old actor, best known for his title role in the Superman movies, is being treated at the Kessler Institute for Rehabilitation in West Orange, N.J.

Substitutions, cancellations change final lineup

Sherbrooke film fest expands its horizons

SHERBROOKE — Despite a few last minute substitutions, Sherbrooke's international film festival kicked off last night amidst optimism with the showing of the French film *La Cérémonie* based on a novel by mystery author Ruth Rendell.

Over the next week or so, some 25 films from 10 countries will be screened during the third edition of *l'International du cinéma de Sherbrooke*, most of them at the Maison du Cinéma in Sherbrooke.

Though most of the films are being presented at the downtown Sherbrooke theatre, English films have been added to the line-up, and a couple of films are being screened at Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University in Lennoxville.

The film *Smoke*, which was originally supposed to be screened Saturday night at Bishop's has been cancelled and replaced by *The Madness of King George* by filmmaker Nicholas Hytner, who conquered the stage with the hit *Miss Saigon*. The movie is a humorous portrait of a king who almost lost



his mind and his kingdom.

Centennial also presents *The Day The Sun Turned Cold*, by Hong Kong director Yim Ho on Wednesday night at 8. Presented in its original version with English subtitles, the film is based on a true story about a young man who reports that his adulterous mother poisoned his father some ten years earlier.

Also not available is the festival closer *N'Oublie pas que tu vas mourir*, which won the Jury Prize at the Cannes Film Festival earlier this year. In its place, organizers are presenting *Augustin* by Anne Fontaine, a French comedy about the ups and downs of an insurance salesman who aspires to be a movie star.

Festival goers who want to replace their tickets or want to be re-imbursed for the cancelled shows can do so by presenting themselves in person at the festival office at the Maison du Cinéma between noon and 8

p.m.

Tonight, the festival kicks off at 7 p.m. with the film *Double Happiness*, a Canadian movie about a Chinese-Canadian's (Sandra Oh) search for happiness and her traditional family at the same time. It is being presented in English with French subtitles.

Also playing Friday are the Russian drama *Katia Ismailova*, (7:10); *Adultère* (mode d'emploi), a French comedy looking at sexual relationships of a group of young people (9:00); and *Coup de Lune*, and Italian-French-Netherlands co-production (9:10).

Saturday, two silent films are on the program including *Laurel and Hardy's Laughing '20s*, a 1965 compilation of the comedy duo's best shorts, which will be screened at 9:30; and the 1927 Russian film *La jeune fille au carton à chapeau* by director Boris Barnet, which will be shown at 7.

The silent films will be presented with musical accompaniment by pianist Gabriel Thibodeau and percussionist Peter Magadini, and will be preceded by a tribute to Hollywood silent film producer Mack

Sennett.

Born and raised in Danville at the turn of the century, Sennett went on to Hollywood where he helped launch the career of Charlie Chaplin and produced more than 30 of the silent film star's movies.

Other English films being screened over the next week include *Party Girl*, a comedy about a single woman in New York (Sunday at 7); *Amateur*, Hal Hartley's thriller starring Isabelle Huppert (Tuesday at 9); and *Little Odessa*, James Gray's action film starring Tim Roth and Edward Furlong (Tuesday at 9:30);

Other festival highlights include the screening of a restored version of the the Quebec

classic *Kamouraska* by Claude Jutra. It appears on screen Sunday night at 9.

l'International du cinéma de Sherbrooke continues through till Thursday with nightly screenings every evening at the Maison du Cinéma. Tickets are \$7.50 each, \$9 for the silent film showings. Festival passes are available for three films at \$18 and five films at \$25. For tickets or reservations, calls the festival hotline at (819) 569-7203.

Free festival programs are available at Maison du Cinéma, 65 King W., Sherbrooke, Centennial Theatre in Lennoxville and some 50 other Townships locations.

Prince Edward Island commemorated on stamps

Abegweit, meaning Land Cradled by the Ocean Waves. Jacques Cartier is credited with the discovery in 1534 of this island so named by the Micmac Indians.

Samuel de Champlain claimed the island for France in 1603 and designated it on his maps as Ile St. Jean. The island was occupied by the British in 1758 and formally ceded to Great Britain in 1763.

In 1799 St. John Island was renamed Prince Edward Island in honor of Edward, Duke of Kent.

In 1864 Charlottetown, the island's capital, was selected as the site for discussions to join the Maritime provinces with Upper and Lower Canada. The Charlottetown Conference prepared the way for confederation and was the forerunner of the Quebec Conference by which the Dominion of Canada was founded.

CRADLE OF CANADA

Prince Edward Island therefore claims the distinction of being known as the 'Cradle of Confederation' even though it did not become a part of Confederation until 1873. A pictorial stamp issued in 1935 depicts the Fathers of Confederation on the steps of the Parliament building.

In addition to being known as the Cradle of Confederation, the island also boasts to being the home of Lucy Maud Montgomery, the famous author of the Anne of Green Gables books.

Montgomery was born in 1874 and died in 1942. Canada Post issued a se-tenet pair of stamps in 1975 as part of the Canadian authors series commemorating the hundredth anniversary of the birth of

Lucy Maud Montgomery and Louis Hémon, author of Maria Chapdelaine was born in 1880 and died in 1913.

Stamp Corner

Every souvenir and craft shop on the island sell these stamps mounted every which way for anywhere from \$4.95 to \$20. The catalogue price is \$1.25 for a plate block. The face value being 32 cents for a plate block that means quite a markup for the vendors.

Although lupins grow wild all over Prince Edward Island, the provincial flower is the lady's slipper. The coat of arms is made up of three small oak trees representing the three counties — Prince, Queen and King — under one large oak tree surmounted by a lion rampant. The motto is 'Little under the great'.

Both the Lady's Slipper and the coat of arms are depicted on the 1964-1966 stamp within the provincial coat of arms and flowers series. The lady's slipper can also be found on the 10 cent stamp of the floral definitive issue of 1977-79.

Every year that multiple stamps are issued for Canada Day, Prince Edward Island is represented. In addition to event commemoratives, it all adds up to a good number of stamps representing the island. Probably more for its size than any other province in Canada.

Like the other provinces, Prince Edward Island had its own postal administration prior to its entry into confederation. A total of 18 stamps

were issued between January 1, 1861 and January 1, 1872. A number of varieties exist including bisects on cover.

Including the pre-confederation stamps, a lovely collection can be made of stamps directly and indirectly related to P.E.I. Indirectly would include such stamps as those depicting Jacques Cartier, Samuel de Champlain and any of the Fathers of Confederation.

A great start would be the one cent green from the 1908 Quebec Tercentenary issue, or, if you can afford it, the 17 cent blue of 1859-67 issue.

The one stamp above all that must find its way into a P.E.I. collection is the one dollar stamp from the 1946 peace issue depicting the train ferry 'Abegweit'. Although trains are no longer ferried across the Northumberland Strait, the Abegweit still ferries the public across.

An interesting province, Prince Edward Island. Most of its history is depicted on stamps right down to the lobster for which the island is famous. That can be found on the one dollar fishing industry stamp issued in February of 1951.

Discreet mail-auction house stamps mark on the world

SMITHVILLE, Ont. (CP) — A discreet little shop in this small Niagara Peninsula town has stamped its mark on the world.

Its clients are scattered around the globe and include cabinet ministers in Ottawa and American senators in Washington.

Vance Auctions probably is the largest mail-auction company for collectible stamps in Canada. It advertises in stamp-collecting magazines around the world and has a mailing list of 8,000 in more than 60 countries.

Sales hover around \$1 million annually.

"We have customers from all over the world and all walks of life," says owner Vance Carmichael, who started collecting when he was six.

In 1962, his father opened the Stamp and Coin Drive-In in nearby Hamilton. Son Vance closed the retail store in 1974 to focus on his mail-auction business.

"I just like the idea of being able to reach large amounts of

people," says Carmichael.

MORE THAN STAMPS

Every day, Vance Auctions is buying something from private collections, from other dealers, from estates — and all will be in the next auction catalogue. Often the company ends up with valuable items other than stamps. The first item in the last catalogue, for example, was a John F. Kennedy autograph on U.S. Senate letterhead. Estimated value: \$2,000.

Every six weeks — eight times a year — a catalogue with the thousands of items that Vance Auctions has found is sent to its customers. A closing date is set and customers can phone, fax, or send in their bids on catalogue items. It might be one stamp or a set of stamps. Its estimated price might be \$10 or \$1,000.

A customer might send in just one bid for an item and wait for the result, or he might call constantly to find out what the highest bid is and then place his bid accordingly.

"There's something for everyone in a sale," says office manager Alison Murchie, who has been with the mail-auction

business since Carmichael started it as a sideline in 1972.

LOTS OF FUN
"You don't have to be a big spender," she adds. "The average collector can have a lot of fun. Just like some people like going to garage sales. Only they don't ever have to leave home."

Once the auction closing date passes, the winners are determined and are sent what they bought, along with an invoice.

While one mail auction is in progress, Carmichael, 44, and his staff of 15 are busy buying, writing up the next catalogue and getting ready for a new auction.

Carmichael no longer is a stamp collector.

"If you're going to deal — deal. If you're going to invest — invest. Don't mix them," he says. "If I started to collect, I'd be tying up a lot of our own money and depriving our customers of nice things."

Harris, Mendieta break bounds of musical conventions

Pastoral setting inspires local musicians

STANSTEAD — Musicians Allyn Harris and Peter Mendieta are not bound by the conventions of music, nor by those of traditional instruments.

That's what creates their unique new-age sound which the couple records at Crystal Creek Studio located in their pink farmhouse nestled among the rolling hills of the Eastern Townships near Stanstead.

In a way, their latest instrumental recordings reflect the pastoral setting they live in.

While their earlier pieces often used synthesizers to create special sound effects, the couple's latest work has evolved to include natural sounds they recorded around their home.

Their most recent release, *Sea of Green*, includes a myriad of pleasing sounds recorded in their backyard — the songbirds, crickets, cicadas, frogs, and other ambient noises that surround them are woven into original compositions using the more traditional sounds of steel-string guitars and piano and new and unusual percussion instruments.

"It sounds like a day in the life of our backyard with music put over it," Harris says, as the couple is interviewed on their deck to background music provided by crickets and birds.

"We like to not just play music but create an environment where people can lose themselves," Mendieta says.

FARAWAY QUALITY

Indeed, their relaxing new-age music transports you into another world. A review of a previous musical release *Pools of Light* in *Dimension Magazine* describes the music like this: "the pieces have a faraway quality as if they are floating on a great beam of sunlight. You feel you are walking a path on a mist covered mountain when the sun shines through."

"We like to experiment, to find something new," Mendieta says, adding that as well as using sound effects such as rainstorms, ocean waves and whale singing, they often play traditional instruments in non-traditional ways. "We try to get some new and interesting sounds to come out, like whacking the guitar with the palm of my hand."

Harris' latest piece, commissioned by Knowlton-area sculptor Maya Lightbody for her latest exhibition entitled *The Guardian*, explores a variety of sounds created inside a grand piano using such tools as mallets, guitar picks and bells.

Harris and Mendieta say that while they are home bodies and don't tour much, they enjoy getting out to meet other non-

traditional musicians at various sound symposiums, such as the recent First International Conference on Acoustic Ecology at the Banff Centre for the Arts. Harris came back from there inspired.

"I felt isolated here in ideas, and ways of working," she said. "Now there are kindred spirits all over the world. It's inspiring to discuss and share ideas with those people."

NO LIMITS

"What you learn at these sound symposiums is that there's no limit to what an instrument can be," Mendieta says, adding that they learn to stretch their imaginations and create unique instruments with new and unusual sounds, such as the antler harp. This one-of-a-kind instrument is a deer antler with various sized rubber bands which when plucked create unique sounds.

And speaking of unique instruments, the couple's garden is complete with an "apple-phone" or "tree-a-thon" — they haven't decided on a name for their invention yet. The multi-faceted percussion instrument is a tiny apple orchard hung with a variety of objects including steel pipes, tent poles, hangers, bells, "and stove dampers chosen at the hardware store for their sound quality."

Although they haven't recorded anything in the orchard yet, they use it at their campfires when guests are invited to create their own music.

Inside Harris and Mendieta have an eclectic collection of traditional ethnic and non-traditional instruments which range from Peruvian flutes and Tibetan bells to an aluminum bundt pan which has a special ring and "also makes great cakes".

ANYTHING GOES

"We'll play just about anything," Harris points out.

Harris is a classically trained musician who began playing the piano when she was eight. The former Montrealer has a degree in music, but had no specific plans except to compose and perform.

"I really didn't know what I was going to do with it," she said. "I knew something would happen."

Mendieta, who hails from Vancouver, started on guitar when he was 14, playing everything from folk to rock and jazz. From the start, he planned to make a living with his guitar.

"I didn't really care if I was a rock star, or a folkie, or whatever," he said, "And I ended up doing all those things."

Since the couple met, teaching extra-curricular music

lessons at Stanstead College, they have adapted and blended their different styles.

"We learned a lot from each other because of our radically different backgrounds," Mendieta said, adding that the different threads of influence can be found throughout their music.

The couple, who began playing together at Festival Lac Massawippi in 1985, is celebrating 10 years of playing music together this month with two concerts to celebrate the autumnal equinox.

UPCOMING CONCERTS

The concerts, which take place in late September at the Haskell Opera House in Rock Island and Calvary United Church in Sutton, will include selections from *Sea of Green*, *Pools of Light* as well as some older favorites.

Harris and Mendieta now make their living off music with a combination of teaching students, commissioned works and selling their own recordings. They also record other artists at their Crystal Creek Studios, actually a spare bedroom converted into an equipment laden studio.

"It's called a basement studio, but it's not in the basement," Mendieta points out, adding that they record

acoustic-based music, partly because they aren't set up for huge rock bands, but mostly because they prefer more intimate music.

"We only work with special people we believe in," Mendieta says.

"Having the studio in our home has brought some amazing experiences into our lives," Harris said, describing a scene last year when they had nine Tibetan monks complete with nine-foot long horns in their living room.

The monks, who recorded an album of traditional chants and music, were on a North American tour to raise money for their monastery which housed some 800 refugees from Tibet, Harris explained.

"I was trying to do this left brain technical stuff, and my right brain was blowing up," Mendieta said.

POETRY AND STORIES

Harris and Mendieta also do some special projects such as recording poetry and storytelling.

A recent example is *Hush Little Baby*, a children's tape commissioned by the St. Francis Literacy Council for mothers who have trouble reading.

It's a collection of best loved nursery rhymes and lullabies for babies and young children

so they can learn the traditional tales we all take for granted," Mendieta said.

While a new album is not in the works yet — they are still recovering from their latest projects — they are both working on new compositions.

"You just keep writing things and at one point you have a critical mass and you say we should start planning a new album," Harris says.

By the time the couple is ready to record their next album, their music will have changed and evolved further.

"We don't usually stay in one place for too long," Mendieta said referring to the couple's music. "You don't want to get trapped in a corner of the music world."

The Harris and Mendieta Equinox Concerts take place Sept. 22 at the Haskell Opera House in Rock Island and Sept. 23 at Calvary United Church in Sutton. Special guests include John Henderson on Irish bodhran and percussion, and, in Sutton, artist Liz Davidson will read to improvised responses by the musicians.

Singer adopts disguise as serial killer in *Outside*

Bowie probes link between art and media

David Bowie says he's unfamiliar with the crimes of Paul Bernardo, but he knows what they mean to art and the media.

Bowie's forthcoming new album, *Outside*, is based on his recent short story about the hunt for a serial killer named Leon Blank, who murders and dissects his victims, the first being a 14-year-old runaway named Baby Grace Blue.

It forms the basis of Bowie's double-header tour with rock band Nine Inch Nails that begins today in Hartford, Conn., and plays SkyDome on Sept. 20.

The murders of *Outside* have an uncomfortable reso-

nance with recent courtroom revelations in Toronto. The facts are coincidental, Bowie says, but there are parallels to be drawn in how such ghastly acts are being represented in the media as almost a form of entertainment.

MEDIA SPLASH

"I imagine (the Bernardo trial) made huge entertainment splashes for the media," Bowie said in an interview from Hartford.

"That's the thing. It's already become a staple part of the media as an entertainment form. The O. J. Simpson trial is obviously a great soap, and there's so many films about murder that it's a short step of the compass to extrapolate on that . . .

"It could be a new format, a new arena for making art."

It's certainly a new arena for Bowie, 48, who adopted another of his many disguises for *Outside*, and its highly visceral first video, *The Heart's Filthy Lesson*.

His role is as 'art crime' detective Nathan Addler, and the video shows him roaming amongst cadavers in a grim mausoleum, examining the depraved artwork of killer Blank.

ENO REUNION

The making of *Outside* reunited him with Brian Eno, the producer of Bowie's critically lauded album trilogy of the 1970s, *Low*, *Heroes* and *Lodger*.

"It was like we'd only been

away from each other for a weekend," Bowie said of his happy reunion with Eno.

And there's been a happy meeting of the minds with one of the many new rock artists to claim Bowie as an influence. Bowie approached Trent Reznor of Nine Inch Nails after the 30-year-old Reznor sampled one of his songs (*Time*, off *Aladdin Sane*) for a recent remix.

The result is the current tour, put together in a matter of weeks, and which will see Bowie and Reznor sharing the microphone and their songs in a 25-minute portion of the show linking performances by the two artists.

"I don't believe anybody would have conceived that we

would have been able to work quite so well together," Bowie said. "It's just terrific. We're quite like-minded."

One woman's fight against gangsta rap

WASHINGTON (AP) — Looking around the office of DeLores Tucker, it's easy to see why she's furious with rap artists whose songs characterize women, particularly black women, as whores, sluts or worse.

One wall is dominated by a portrait of Rosa Parks, smiling and serene. On a corner table stands a sculpted Sojourner Truth, the ex-slave suffragist, with clasped hands thrust forward.

Just behind the desk is a photo of Coretta Scott King.

Among the mementoes of the legendary, there sits a rather ordinary pair of white plastic police handcuffs that Tucker wore to jail for protesting outside a record store in 1993.

It marked her first stand against "gangsta" rap music that demeans women, glorifies violence and drugs and, Tucker says, tells kids it's OK, even heroic, to live lawlessly and die young.

AN ABOMINATION

"It's an abomination to all of us, after we were taught to sing songs of faith and hope and freedom in the days of slavery, to let this go on," Tucker says.

"I'd die before I'd let that music continue to be."

For nearly two years, Tucker, founder and vice chair of the National Political Congress of Black Women, has expressed her disdain for pro-violence, anti-woman lyrics through nearly every means and in

virtually every forum imaginable.

She has toted poster-sized blowups of rap lyrics and album covers into conferences and congressional hearings. She distributes printed excerpts of rap songs, sometimes to complete strangers, and urges them to read the lyrics aloud.

Frustrated in trying to meet with record company executives, Tucker bought 10 shares of stock in Time Warner Inc., which owns half of rap labels Interscope Records and Death Row Records, and went to the annual shareholders meeting with a Snoop Doggy Dogg single.

She handed out printed transcripts of gangsta rap lyrics, urging Time Warner executives Gerald Levin and Michael Fuchs to recite them.

They didn't, but they gave Tucker the meeting she wanted.

USED TO DESTROY

"I told him, 'Mr. Levin, you are head of the largest entertainment industry in the world. It's being used to destroy African-American people,'" Tucker said.

Now, Time Warner wants to unload its 50 per cent share of Interscope, which is suing Tucker, saying she tried to coerce Time Warner into severing its ties, effectively destroying the distributor's business with "extortion, threats and other unlawful acts."

Gandharvas becoming more aggressive Ontario band gets respect

LONDON, Ont. (CP) — Paul Jago refuses to let himself be pinned down when answering questions about his music.

"I don't want to get too deep into the meanings of the songs — that's dangerous territory," says the lead singer and principal songwriter with Gandharvas.

"I see the songs as living things — you have to give them their due respect, like you would any living thing."

Respect is one thing London, Ont., band is definitely attracting.

The band's first album, *A Soap Bubble and Inertia*, sold more than 30,000 copies, spawned a hit single (The First

Day of Spring), a memorable video and helped earn a Juno nomination for best new group.

Like their first release, the quintet's new album *Kicking in the Water* is a quirky, complex collection of sounds. It could be described as "pleasantly disturbing."

MORE AGGRESSIVE

"This album's been called less accessible than the first, which I agree with," says Jago, 22. "It's a more aggressive record. We were a little timid with the last one — you know, first-time recording jitters."

"We're much more possessive about this project. It's not a concept record, but it's verging on that. It's almost a sonic story. You can listen to the whole record as one piece, not just

separate entities thrown together. A mood continues from song to song, and it evolves from track to track.

While the musical energy is distinctly unique, the lyrics are more slippery. It's only after talking to Jago that it becomes clear that *Drool*, the first single, is his take on teenage lust.

"There are these two kids making out, and they're drooling over each other, and the drool is flowing around the room, and that's it," he says. "It's about a path of caustic drool."

When asked if this stream of spit is a metaphor, Jago squirms. He doesn't try to spin a tale or recount an event with his songs, he says. Instead, he tries to conjure up a mood or feeling.

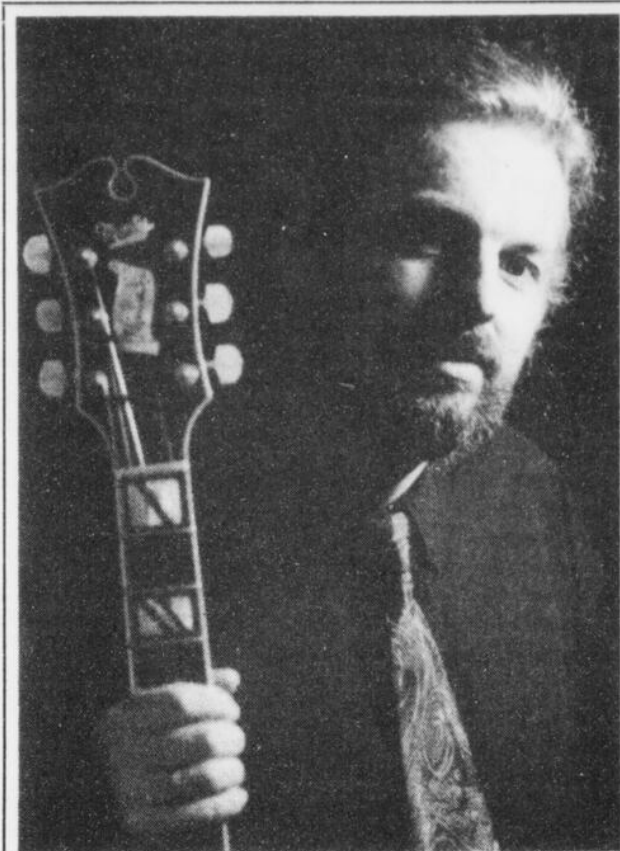

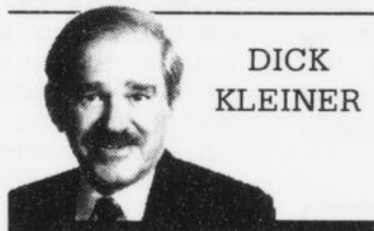
Q. Wasn't there a movie called "The Story of Louis Pasteur," with Paul Muni. Is there a video available? — M.S., LaVerne, Calif.

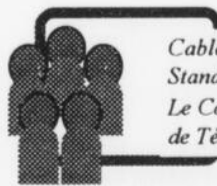

Profanity a growing trend on network TV

TORONTO (CP) — What do an angry native protester and a fictional New York cop have in common?

Both have pushed the envelope when it comes to foul language on network television, spewing on-air profanities that wouldn't have been broadcast a few years ago.

The trend is likely to continue into the new fall season.

On The National, CBC's nightly 10 p.m. newscast, viewers recently heard the notorious f-word used repeatedly in a clip that opened the show as an enraged aboriginal shouted to police officers at the Ipperwash stand-off in southwestern Ontario.

Over on Canwest Global Television, actor Dennis Franz, playing the grumpy Det. Andy Sipowicz on the Emmy-award-winning American police show NYPD Blue, continues to test the limits of what the censors traditionally call "coarse language."

Sipowicz has managed to utter everything from asshole to bitch in the show's first two seasons.

NO COMPLAINTS

Global senior publicist Sandra Puglielli says the network hasn't had any strong viewer complaints about Franz's volatile character. Viewers tend to give Sipowicz a break because his anger and inner rage are so well defined by the show's writers, she says.

Breaking the barriers has been the cachet of NYPD Blue producer Stephen Bochco, who also brought the world Hill Street Blues in the 1980s. More groundbreaking and pot-stirring can be expected this fall from his new show Murder

One. "It's going to be gritty," Puglielli warns.

Producers of prime-time drama, faced with increasing competition from uncensored cable and video programmers, are gradually dismantling the old rules.

But while the f-word has been permitted in what are deemed relevant news circumstances for some time, it remains a barrier unlikely to be knocked down any time soon by the network prime-time drama departments.

"We don't play the f-word," declares Gail Morrell, director of programming for CTV. "We bleep that out."

WARNINGS

Morrell says the network places a warning before airing shows that contain other offensive language. But she says some films, such as Martin Scorsese's Goodfellas, simply could not be edited or redubbed without ruining the integrity of the storyline.

"That's the classic one that just sat there," she says.

Unrestrained by network obligations, Toronto's feisty independent station CITY-TV allows the f-word after 9 p.m. But even CITY has its limits.

Program director Ellen Baine says the f-word isn't allowed if it's preceded by the prefix "mother," for example.

"When you put those two words together, I still think most people are offended by that," she says.

Which led to a bizarre situation recently when the station censor bleeped out the mother part of the word, but left in the other half.

Real-life drama continues to open doors for fiction.

The John Wayne Bobbitt case seems to have cleared the way for the term "penis."

But while vulgar language is

becoming more widespread on the airwaves, racial slurs are considered so offensive in the politically correct 1990s that

the term "n-word" is now a common part of the TV lexicon thanks to its frequent use at the O. J. Simpson trial.

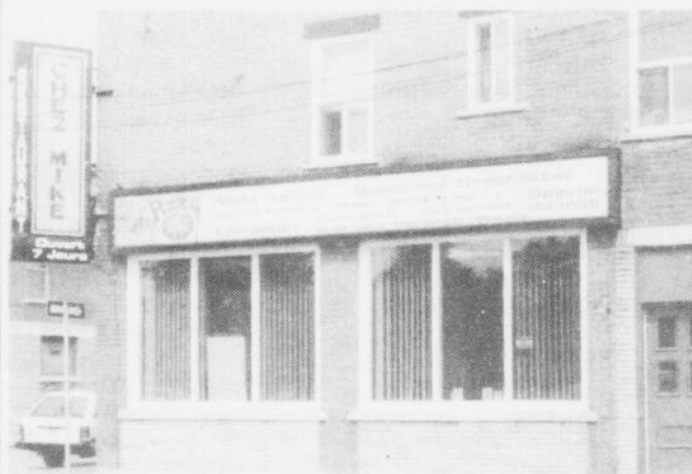

What the broadcasters say

F-word only after 9

Some Canadian broadcaster's comments on coarse language in TV programming:

"If it's integral to the story and you can't take out everything or you're going to destroy a lot of storyline, we will put a warning. We'll take the f-word out but we'll put a warning for any other coarse language." Gail Morrell, director of programming and vice-president of communications for CTV.

"We do say the f-word after nine o'clock and we've been doing that for a long time. What we try and do is keep in tune with the way people talk. And that word is basically acceptable by most adults." Ellen Baine, program director for Toronto's CITY-TV.

"NYPD Blue has been a huge, huge success. While the content can sometimes seem pretty volatile, we haven't had a lot of complaints at all. Not close to the Power Rangers outcry." Sandra Puglielli, senior publicist for Canwest Global System.

"Broadcasters shall employ discretion in the use of explicit or graphic language related to stories of destruction, accidents or sexual violence, which could disturb children and their families." Excerpt from the voluntary code of The Canadian Broadcast Standards Council.
