LORD SALISBURY'S CABINET.

It was only with extreme reluctance that Lord Salisbury entered upon the work of forming a Government. With a party out-numbering any other two parties by nearly fifty, and having, with the support of the Liberal Unionists, a majority of over two hundred on the Irish question, the Tory leader was fain to shirk the responsibility of putting in practice the policy, the adoption of which he urged so warmly upon the people of England.

THE CHAMBLAY ELECTION.
