## Watson always finds her groove on stage

**D**awn Tyler Watson tours on her recognition as a blues player, but it's not the only thing the versatile artist has going for her. She just recently starred in Jack Paradise with Roy Dupuis, which, she says, really helped her career.

"I was known in Quebec before to blues fans," she explains. "But now, I've got this whole new audience aware of who I am."

In the movie, Watson plays Curly Brown, Roy Dupuis' love interest in the romp through the history of jazz in Montreal from the 1930s through the 1970s.

Watson has even done some Jack Paradise concerts, in character and in costume. The last one had a moment Watson will never forget.

"It was the second song of the set," she explains. "I always move around a lot when I sing, and I had noticed the monitor. I guess because it wasn't my own show I didn't move it."

At the end of the second song, Watson is walking backwards, saying thank you to the audience, when she topples backwards over the monitor.

"It happens to everyone, they say," she says. "It happened to Britney, it happened to Celine, it happened to me."

Watson injured her finger and couldn't snap them.

"My right hand swings more than

my left," she said. "Even when it was still injured, I was trying to snap."

Her Jack Paradise dress was also a little worse for wear, but she's had it repaired in time for an upcoming performance of the show for the CBC.

Jazz isn't Watson's first love, but she's been drawn to it again and again — in Jack Paradise, and in what first brought her to Montreal: Concordia's music program.

"Nothing was really serious before then," she says. "I tried, but it didn't stick."

Watson put together her first band as a student, and got her first paying gig (for \$50). But, she says, Montreal might not be as kind to someone else starting out.

"For a francophone, Montreal is great," she says. "For an anglophone, well, it's harder. But Montreal really was great to me."

Before Jack Paradise, Watson was best known as a regular at Biddle's. She didn't stop there, though. She had a funk band which played at clubs around town.

"I love to make people get up and dance," she says. "I still love that. I'll play a show, play the standards, scat a bit, and some 10-year-old will tell me how much they loved my show. Then I'll play a Jimi Hendrix's Purple Haze, all funk up Red Hot Chili Peppers-style,

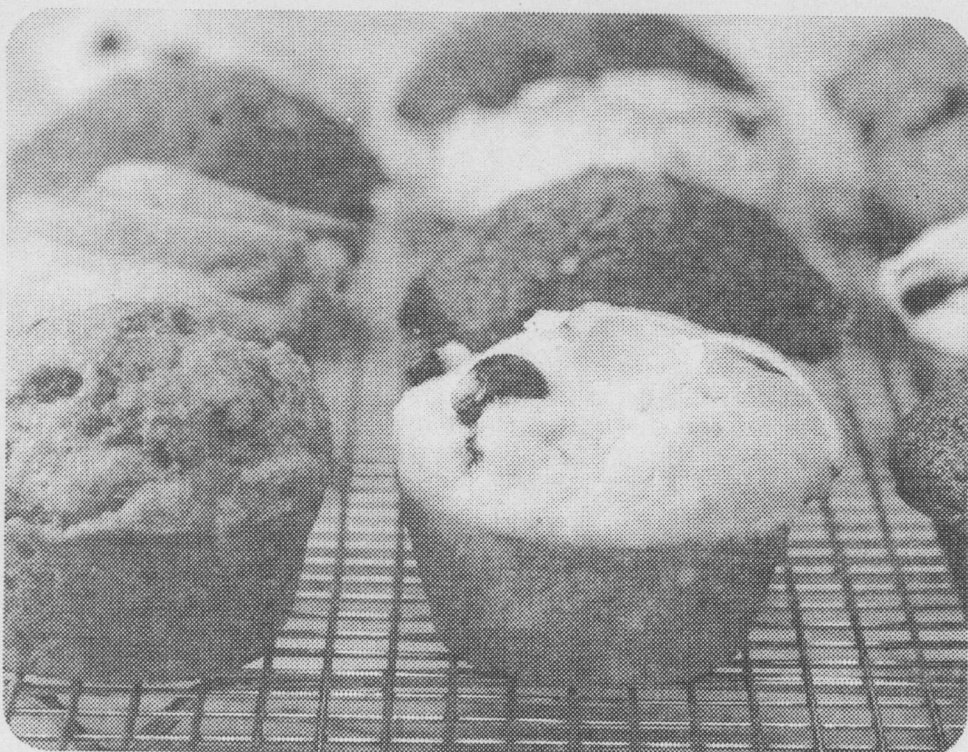

## Super-sized muffins have given way to healthier fruit-filled treats

My first – sort of – date with my wife was an invitation to her place for coffee and fresh baked muffins. Not overly romantic, but definitely trendy; it was the early 1980s and muffins were all the rage.

And why not? The morning glory muffins we enjoyed were deliciously filled with fruit, carrots, nuts and more. They did indeed bring glory to our morning; I can still taste them now.

Everyone seemed to have a muffin book in those days but, somewhere along the line, widely popular muffins began to fall out of vogue.

That seemed to occur a few years after some bakers felt the need to super-size their muffins and base them on what seem like sweet, white cake batter. Other sweet ingredients, such as chocolate chips, also found their way into their mammoth muffins.

Now, thank goodness, the tide has turned in favour of moderately sized muffins packed with nutritious ingredients. This trend has made the muffin once again a baked good to consider when you're looking for an energy filled food or tasty treat to enjoy with a hot cup of tea or coffee.

Keep the sweet, rich muffins as a very occasional treat.

My four delicious recipes today can be used for large muffins. To make mini, small or medium-sized muffins, simply reduce the amount of batter spooned into the muffin cups.

You'll also have to reduce baking

time accordingly. Muffins are done when the top quickly springs back when gently touched with a finger.

### BLUEBERRY MUFFINS WITH LEMON AND BUTTERMILK

Sweet and tangy muffins that can be made with fresh or frozen blueberries.

Preparation time: 20 minutes

Cooking Time: 25 minutes

Makes: 12 muffins

#### Dry ingredients:

3 cups (750 mL) all-purpose flour

3/4 cup (175 mL) sugar

2 Tbsp (25 mL) baking powder

1/2 tsp (2 mL) salt

#### Wet ingredients:

1/3 cup (75 mL) vegetable oil

1 1/4 cups (300 mL) buttermilk

2 tsp (10 mL) finely grated lemon zest

1/4 cup (1 mL) fresh lemon juice

3 large eggs, beaten

1 cup (250 mL) fresh or frozen blueberries

#### Garnish:

1 small lemon, cut in half and thinly sliced

**Directions:** Preheat oven to 375 F (180 C). Combine dry ingredients in bowl. Mix wet ingredients in another. Stir wet ingredients into the dry ingredients until just combined. Spoon into a greased or paper cup-lined muffin pan. Bake 20 to 25 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the middle of a muffin pulls out clean. Allow to cool for 10 minutes before removing from muffin pan.

## Simple chilled corn soup is to die for

Honestly, just thinking about this week's recipe – a delicious chilled corn soup – makes my mouth water.

I got the idea from a classic French-style New York restaurant called La Grenouille, where I had lunch with my family a few days ago. The little cup of soup was so good I just had to come up with my own version.

And what's better: I discovered that it is super easy and quick to make and requires only three main ingredients (milk, butter and corn).

I purposely kept it simple, because fresh, seasonal vegetables and legumes are always best on their own, without spices masking their flavour.

In this soup, the sweet and luscious corn taste comes through beautifully. I

like to serve it as an hors d'oeuvre, in mismatched espresso cups for easy sipping, but of course it works just as well in regular soup plates, as an appetizer.

#### INGREDIENTS: (FOR FOUR AS APPETIZER, OR EIGHT AS HORS D'OEUVRE)

4 ears corn

700 ml 2% milk

3 tbsp. butter

1 tbsp. chicken soup base

ground white pepper

**Directions:** Remove corn husks. Cut off the kernels with a sharp, serrated knife. Sauté the corn in the butter for four minutes on medium heat, then add the rest of the

ingredients and stir. Cook for 15 minutes. Process in a blender for two minutes or so, until very smooth. Taste and add a pinch of salt if necessary. Serve chilled

# Canadian movies face the world

Canadian movies will sink or swim in international waters at the 29th Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF). For 20 years, TIFF has cocooned Canadian feature-length and short movies in one exclusive program — Perspective Canada.

In so doing, the festival has probably done more to promote Canadian cinema than 50 years of government policies. Our most established English-language filmmakers were nurtured in that cocoon. Directors like David Cronenberg and Atom Egoyan have long since achieved world acclaim.

Now, Perspective Canada is no more. In their calculated wisdom, TIFF poohbahs have decided that our movie industry can compete without the coddling. And that's a good thing. But, for reviewers, separating the Canadian wheat from the chaff (not to mention inferior and superior grains from elsewhere) has become tougher.

It's not lack of access so much as competition for attention. What's more, with co-productions becoming the norm, the line between homegrown and foreign is more blurred than ever.

Clean, the best "Canadian" fiction movie we've seen thus far, is an excellent example of Canada's profile in world cinema. This France/United Kingdom/Canada co-production has no false notes. Stripped down to its essence, it's the story of a Yoko Ono-like character (Maggie Cheung) caught up in the downward spiral of the music biz. She struggles to overcome a heroin addiction to win back custody of her young son and get control of her life.

The action takes place in Vancouver, Paris, London, San Francisco and Hamilton, Ont. Rather than merely serving co-production requirements, these locations are all integral to the plot. One of Clean's pivotal moments is a spectacular pre-dawn scene where Cheung's character, having hit rock bottom, gazes across Hamilton Bay, with steel

mill smelters shooting hellish flames into the sky.

Clean is exquisitely directed and written by Olivier Assayas. Cheung is riveting. Nick Nolte does a tear-jerking turn as the grandfather and the late great Martha Henry, in her last role, becomes his dying wife. We predict a bright future for James Dennis, who portrays the young boy in their custody. Don McKellar, as the no-nonsense music agent, has never been better.

This international cast reinforces the interconnectedness of globalization, all in the service of a good story that never takes the cheap way out. As for the music - by David Roback, Tricky, Brian Eno and Emily Haines & Metric, Canada's hottest new group - we'd love to get our hands on the soundtrack.

Shaké Hands With the Devil: The Journey of Roméo Dallaire is a quintessentially Canadian film. It should be viewed the world over. Produced and directed by Peter Raymont, Devil teaches by exposing us to people who bear witness to the horrific events that flashed by us in a constant, confusing barrage of headline news.

Ten years after the genocide of almost a million Tutsis in Rwanda, Raymont follows the former head of UN Peacekeeping Forces back into his 'heart of darkness', a voyage where Dallaire faces his demons — the unbridled evil of racism, unleashed by imperialist greed and left to do its worst by an inept United Nations and an uncaring world.

We witness his anguish and trauma as his pleas to stem the senseless slaughter fall on deaf ears. We share the rage at his powerlessness to stop what could have been stopped. And we rejoice at his partial redemption.

This movie and this man of unflinching moral integrity make one proud to be Canadian. Dallaire refuses to be considered a hero but his persistence in trying to do what was right in an impossible situation is nothing short of heroic. Devil reveals the evil humanity is capable of and the dangers of ignor-

ing the lessons of history.

These are two examples of Canadian movies that stand on their own. The latest from other directors who have done impressive work in the past: Bruce McDonald's *The Love Crimes* of Gillian Guess, Don McKellar's *Childstar*, Peter Lynch's *A Whale of a Tale*, Daniel McIvor's *Wilby Wonderful* — these, and more, remain to be seen.

Within the festival's many high-profile programs, 27 Canadian movies are vying cinematically with 226 from 61 countries. They will either score or (like Blaine Thurier's trivial second feature, *Male Fantasy*) wimp out in the face of world competition.

Still, admit it or not, Canadian cinema continues to get special treatment

at TIFF. Instead of Perspective Canada, two new programs have been created to boost the work of "emerging filmmakers".

We've seen a few of the 10 CANADA FIRST! features. Rob Stefaniuk's *Phil the Alien* is an entertaining lark. *La Peau Blanche* is a haunting, surreal thriller. *Blood and I*, *Claudia* each have moments but are essentially plays filmed and called movies.

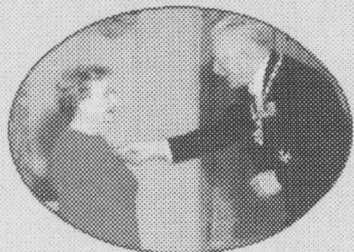

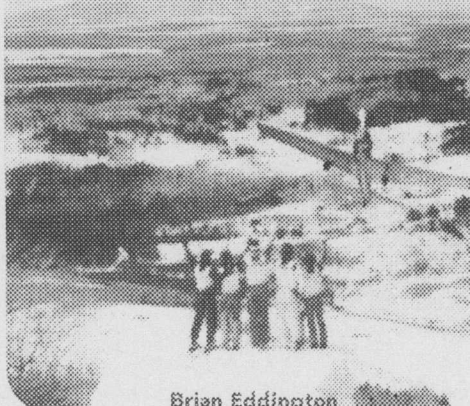

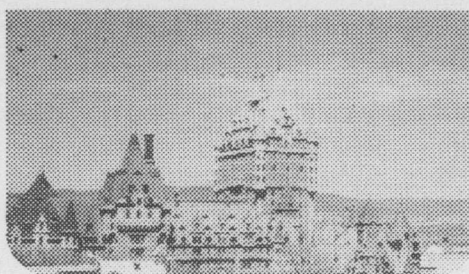

## Four Seasons in the Eastern Townships



**P**ublishing house Price-Patterson Ltd. of Montreal will be launching four Eastern Townships-related books this fall.

The first book, Eastern Townships Saint: Lily Esther Butters by Françoise Hamel-Beaudoin is the story of Lily Butters. In 1947, at the age of 53, she founded a centre for mentally disabled children in Austin (East Bolton) and expanded it to house over 400 children by 1966.

Lily's legacy through a new Butters organizations. The book includes photographs.

### GLEN MOUNTAIN

Out of Bounds: The Glen Mountain Ski Story by Brian Eddington is the history of Glen Mountain. The Glen is a great place to ski, raise a family or raise a glass — and the book tells the story behind all those activities.

It also tells the story of the people behind the Glen organization: Hank Rotherham, Peter White, Jackrabbit Johannsen, Bob Richardson, Pat Côté, Brian Robinson, Lucille Wheeler Vaughan, John Parry, Eddy Persons.

The book also introduces some of the

Glen's best skiers, including Peter Smart, Paul Cunnius, Leigh-Jay Quilliams and Trevor Gavura. The book is thorough, but not-too-serious at this wonderful mountain.

### LEARNING THE LANGUAGE

Quebec: Bonjour — Visitor's Visa to French-Speaking Canada (already in stores), was written by two Townshipers, Sharon McCully and Heather Keith. It is an introduction to all aspects of Quebec life: from language, politics, tourist regions and history to road signs and cuisine.

McCully and Keith first wrote the book in the wake of the 1995 referendum in order to portray Quebec in a pos-

itive light and as a fun place to visit.

It is now in its fourth edition and is a great guide to the whole province for newcomers and tourists.

## QNEK serves up Greater Tuna at the Haskell Opera House

**T**he QNEK Productions Resident Theatre Company at the Haskell Opera House will conclude its 11th season by presenting the Off-Broadway hit Greater Tuna.

This irreverent and sometimes politically incorrect comedy, by Jaston Williams, Joe Sears and Ed Howard, tells the tale of supposedly upstanding residents of the third smallest town in the United States — Tuna, Texas.

What makes this production special is that all the characters are played by only two actors — Tim Daley and Mark Violette. Fans of QNEK productions will remember Daley's marvellously funny

portrayal of Hysterium in A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum.

Most of the audience is accustomed to seeing Violette seated quietly behind the piano keys during performances but his performance in 'Greater Tuna' will leave no doubt that he also possesses ability in the theatre.

Daley's natural aptitude for comedic timing and creative wit has certainly not let him down this time. His role consists of a total of 10 different characters, ranging from men and women to a 10-year-old little boy — complete with beanie propeller cap.

While these two gentlemen each have changes both in character and costumes that involve 10 different roles,

the entire play revolves around more than 40 quick-changes which Daley and Violette seem to take in stride.

There will be a raffle for an original Vermont Teddy Bear which was donated by the Vermont Teddy Bear Company to benefit the Academy for Children in Theatre and the QNEK scholarship fund.

QNEK was negatively affected by the recent Phish concert that caused the closing of several of its performances of A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum.

The show will begin at 7:30 p.m. on Sept. 17, 18, 24 and 25 with a special matinee on Sept. 19 at 2 p.m. This show is not recommended for children — it contains adult humour and subject matter.

We're hoping for good things from Carole Laure's CQ2 (Seek You Too). But we have to wonder why Canadian first features should be segregated from the world when TIFF already has the very successful "Discovery" program, showcasing "provocative feature films by new and emerging directors".

Similarly, the second new program, SHORT CUTS CANADA, excludes foreign shorts, which don't have a home elsewhere in the festival. Shouldn't it be opened up to the world? Among this year's 38 shorts are two by master director Maddin. If he's included with the newbies, it's hardly the preserve of "Canada's newest filmmaking stars".

For good or bad, cinema Canada is stepping out into the world. Are we ready to simply be who we are and take our place in the global village?

# It's a bird! It's a plane! No, it's Super Brit!

Superman, that tights-clad icon of American heroism, is about to be reborn as a Brit.

Monty Python legend John Cleese has teamed up with author Kim "Howard" Johnson to create Superman: True Brit, a hardcover graphic novel that surmises how the Man of Steel might have turned out if his spaceship crashed in the United Kingdom rather than Kansas.

In this latest twist on the DC Comics series, due out Oct. 13, Clark Kent becomes Colin Clark and the Daily Planet is reinvented as the Daily Smear, a mud-slinging tabloid bent on bankrupting Superman's celebrity.

Described as a "man in a cape and rather garish tights," the superhero has small-town parents who laud him for wearing clean underwear on TV, and is hounded by reporters who are more interested in his sex life — not to mention who styles his impeccably coiffed hair — than in his crime-fighting.

"I encouraged (the authors) to do something that was a little more personal," says Mike Carlin, editor of the 96-page book. "John's experience with the British tabloids inspired the angle more than anything."

Although the Man of Steel's first experience as a Brit was in 1995's Superman: Kal, when the hero was transplanted into Arthurian times, this new book marks Superman's inaugural turn as a modern-day citizen of the U.K.

John Field, a noted Superman histo-

rian, is thrilled with the idea.

"(DC Comics) is letting their characters wallow in some forgotten mire, while Marvel Comics is doing an amazing job transferring their characters from comic books into movies," he laments. "Anything with a new twist is going to get attention, and that's great."

Field predicts this latest embodiment of Superman will lead to future cross-cultural adaptations of comics, partly as a response to the unauthorized versions now plaguing the industry.

"Foreign countries have really taken our superheroes to heart," he says. "So I think (officially) incorporating these characters into those different cultures would be fascinating."

Translating comics for different markets is standard practice, but totally reinventing a Western character for a new cultural landscape is a trend still in its infancy. In a slight twist on the DC Comics' Elseworlds series, where familiar heroes are placed in unfamiliar settings, comic characters are being fundamentally redefined to suit the mythology and culture of foreign countries.

This month, for example, Marvel Enterprises and Gotham Entertainment Group will launch the first edition of Spider-Man India, which sees Peter Parker reborn as Pavitr Prabhakar.

In addition to the classic Spider-Man mask and bodysuit, Pavitr wears an Indian dhoti (loincloth) and draws his

power from a yogic mystic rather than radioactivity.

"We have always dreamed of fully integrating a Western superhero character into the Indian market in this revolutionary way," says Sharad Devarajan, CEO of Gotham.

"This project is truly what we call a transcreation, where we actually reinvent the origin of a property like Spider-Man so that he is an Indian boy growing up in Mumbai and dealing with local problems and challenges."

Bob Rozakis, a 30-year veteran of the

comic book industry, says so-called transcreation needs to occur a few more times before it can be taken seriously as a trend.

But he considers it a "safe bet" that if Spider-Man India and Superman: True Brit sell well, there will be a proliferation of similar efforts in the future.

"If (the comic) is entertaining," says Rozakis, "even the purists will look past the inconsistencies with 'their version' of the character and enjoy it for what it is."

and a 70-year-old will tell me how much they enjoyed the show."

Watson's first album, Ten Dollar Dress, came out in 2001 to critical claim. Mostly original material — with that version of Purple Haze, the album is the basis for most of her touring material. She's currently working on a new album, which she says she thinks might have more of a direction, but she's not going to limit it.

"It might be just as eclectic as the last one," she says.

Watson is touring France next, with a stop at a Blues festival. She's just recently hoped for les Iles de la Madeleine to Salmon Creek, BC and back to Quebec.

"It's amazing to me that I get paid to travel and do what I love," she says. "You're not paying me to sing — you're

paying me to do all the other little things, the phone calls, dealing with the agent, buying outfits and looking good."

Watson, despite her recognition in Quebec growing, says she's not a star.

"You don't need to be a household name, have a two-storey poster at Place des Arts to be successful," she says. "I have a nice car, pay my bills, and I could buy a house if I wanted to. You just can't limit yourself to one thing trying to make it in the music business."

Watson, with acting, jazz, blues, rock, funk and composing under her belt, is doing anything but.

Dawn Tyler Watson appears at Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University Sept. 25 at 8 p.m. The concert is preceded by the the launch of the theatre's season at 7 p.m., with cocktails and appetizers. Tickets are \$23, \$18 for seniors, and \$13 for students, available at the box office by calling 819-822-9692.

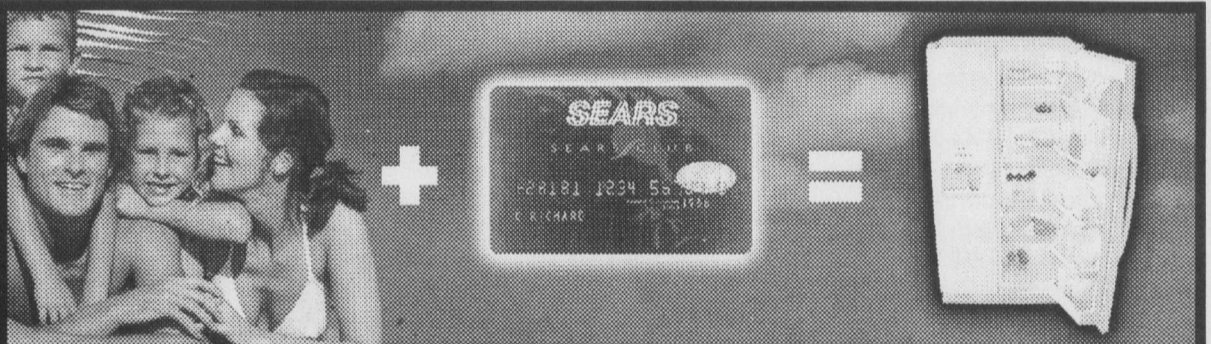

# Regular suspects vying for Emmys

**E**ntertainment question of the week: What do the Emmys and the new fall TV season have in common? Answer: Both are impossible to follow.

Call the Emmys what you will — consistently inconsistent, surprisingly predictable and yet predictably surprising — this year's nominations feature an even more mixed bag than usual. The same old same old, in other words — but different. Or, to put it another way, this year there are a few new faces amid the sea of perennial nominees.

And when the gold statuettes are handed out at Sunday's 56th Annual Primetime Emmy Awards, all bets are off as to who the big winners will be.

This is the year The Sopranos will finally earn the drama series Emmy it has deserved these past five seasons — unless, of course, it doesn't.

This is the year Sex and the City will finally be recognized for its six seasons of social commentary on loneliness in the urban landscape — unless, of course, it isn't. About the only safe bet is that for every young upstart, there will be two or three acknowledgements of the old standbys.

You want sentimentality? John Ritter was nominated posthumously for his role as the long-suffering dad in 8 Simple Rules for Dating My Teenage Daughter, and a win Sunday appears to be a lock. Unless, of course, voters are feeling sentimental about Kelsey Grammer's final bow in Frasier.

Or else they may just stay with last year's winner, Tony Shalhoub, of Monk fame and notoriety. Never underestimate the role laziness plays when it comes to voting for the Emmys.

That's why The West Wing has been nominated for a fifth consecutive term, despite having the kind of year that gets most real-life administrations booted out of office.

Unlike the Oscars, which recognize a different batch of movies each year, or the Grammys, which recognize musicians and singers at different stages of their career, the Emmys recognize ongoing TV programs, which is why the list of nominees — and winners — takes on a wearying sameness year after year.

There are signs that may be changing, but real change is slow in coming.

Fresh faces this year include Joan of Arcadia's Amber Tamblyn, The Practice's James Spader and Life with Bonnie's Bonnie Hunt. (That last choice is a surprise if for no other reason than Hunt's show has been cancelled.)

First-time series nominees this time around included Joan of Arcadia and Arrested Development.

And, adding spice to a generally ho-hum Emmy race: the newly created reality competition category, which this year pits The Amazing Race against The Apprentice, Survivor, Last Comic Standing and American Idol.

But while academy voters are trying their darndest to show they're open to change, old habits die hard.

24, CSI and The West Wing were again nominated for best drama, despite sub-par seasons; meanwhile, Deadwood, The Wire, Carnivale, The Shield, Without a Trace and Nip/Tuck were all overlooked.

Will & Grace and last year's winner, Everybody Loves Raymond, were again nominated for comedy, at the expense of Monk, Scrubs and Gilmore Girls. (As media critic Matt Roush noted in Broadcasting & Cable, perhaps Dr. Kervorkian should be allowed to vote — and often.)

Strangest of all is the omission of the season's single most

provocative performance, Ian McShane's ferocious depiction of foul-mouthed saloon keeper Al Swearngen in David Milch's brilliant, dyspeptic western, Deadwood. Despite 11 nominations overall and an Emmy last weekend (for sound editing), Deadwood failed to make the cut for drama series.

Meanwhile, back in the world, expect Sunday's Emmy ceremony to be dominated by the usual suspects, with the occasional surprise thrown in for good measure. And remember, if The Sopranos should win for best drama, it will be the program's first. Often a bridesmaid, perhaps a bride. Just this once.

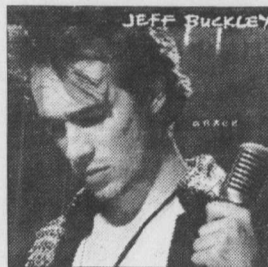
#### VARIOUS ARTISTS

This coming of age tale about a young man is differentiating by the star writing and directing. He is also the head man for this soundtrack production. The liner notes have a quote stating "you gotta hear this one song, it'll change your life I promise you." The whole collection, from the now famous Coldplay to the catchy Shins, classics like Simon & Garfunkel and along to Frou Frou, offers a chilled out kind of pensive rock and roll with Braff's cool creative force seeping through at every level. 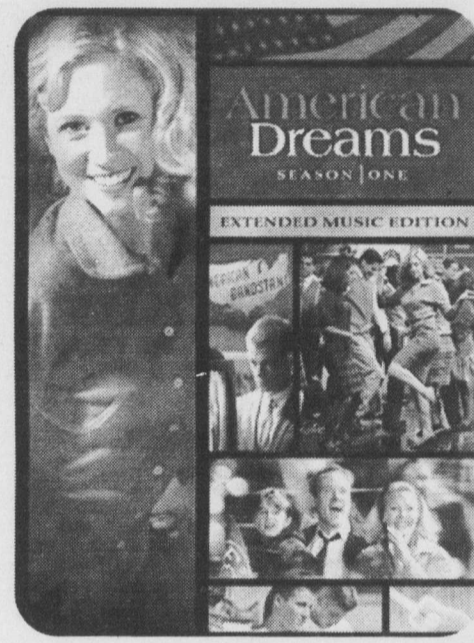

The 2002 first season of American Dreams introduced one of the more ambitious new dramas on a major television network since the debut of The West Wing. Deceptively nostalgic, American Dreams looks, at first blush, like a bone tossed to baby boomers who remember black and white TV, American Bandstand, and what class they were in when word spread of JFK's assassination. But the more one watches the show, the more apparent it becomes that American Dreams is not about memories but about bringing a pivotal chapter in 20th century U.S. history to life—sometimes electrifyingly so.

The series pilot introduces Philadelphia family the Pryors whose stern but not undiscerning patriarch, Jack (Tom Verica), gets an earful one night over dinner.



## Canuck comedians have conquered Hollywood

Canadians need to get over their cultural inferiority complex, and realize that they have already conquered Hollywood by giving it its funniest and most famous comedians, director Ivan Reitman said Tuesday during the Toronto International Film Festival. "It's time for us to revise our view of ourselves," Reitman, who created such comedy hits as Animal House, Ghostbusters and Kindergarten Cop, told a crowd of about 300 at a Canadian Club lunch in the Sheraton Centre. "Not only are we not second-rate, we are really good and remarkably influential."

He then listed 18 comedians, including Dan Aykroyd, Jim Carrey, Eugene Levy, Mike Myers and Martin Short, whom, he said, "changed the world-wide face of comedy in just the past decade.

"These performers aren't just a list of working actors — they are the cream of the comedy world, a conglomeration of talent and influence that a country with 10 times our population cannot match. Isn't it time to think about our culture big time? I do."

Reitman, 58, noted that he is a proud

Canadian: "I have a Canadian passport and it's the only passport I own. I love this country and feel indebted to it."

But he said Canadian cultural funding policies and Canadian critics encourage experimental, obscure work while criticizing success. He attacked a group of "self-appointed arbiters who feel the need to define 'All that is properly Canadian' and 'All that is good and legitimate in Art.'"

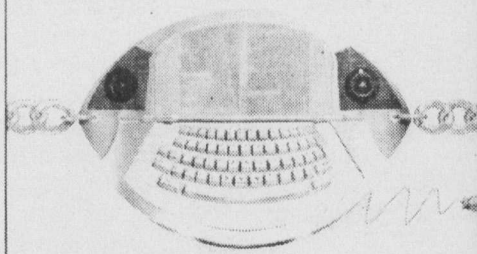
"Artists working in this country can't help but be affected by a constant condescending negativity applied to their work," he said.

Reitman said that while he favours government investment in the arts, subsidies can make Canadian creators focus on meeting content rules written by politicians and bureaucrats, while forgetting to make something that pleases the audience.

"It's as if successfully navigating the minutiae of this hermetically sealed world of institutionalized culture genetically selects against artistry," Reitman told the crowd. "Most importantly, the audience is forgotten."

## A perfect time for medical mysteries

Between Tess Gerritsen, who makes Edgar Allan Poe "look like goody-two-shoes," and Michael Palmer, who "will leave you hardly enough time to take a breath," lovers of medical mystery are in for a harrowing summer's end.

Perhaps the two most powerful writers of their ilk, Gerritsen and Palmer arrived in bookstores last week with their latest medical suspense novels — stories guaranteed to give anyone with a pulse the heebie jeebies.

Gerritsen's story, *Body Double* (Random House, \$35.95), features Boston medical examiner Maura Isles and homicide detective Jane Rizzoli, while Palmer's, *The Society* (Random House, \$37), stars Boston surgeon Will Grant and rookie detective Patty Moriarity.

It's Palmer's 11th mystery, Gerritsen's eighth.

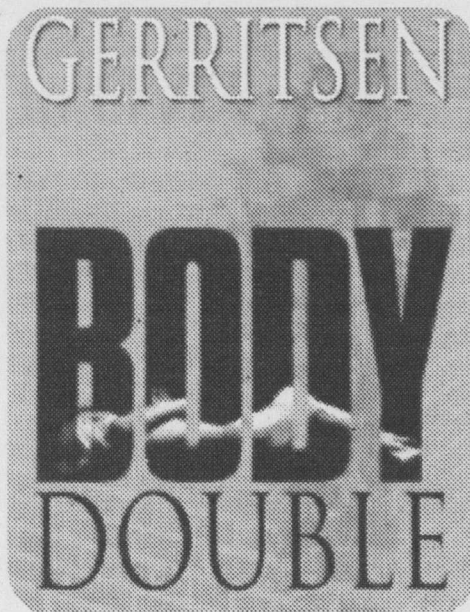
What has given the two authors such bestselling notoriety is the cutting-edge hospital drama that plays out with chilling reality in their novels, drama that could only come from the minds of medical practitioners, which both are. Palmer spent 20 years as a full-time doctor of internal and emergency medicine (and is now an associate director of the Massachusetts Medical Society's physician health program).

Gerritsen left a successful practice as an internist to raise her children and concentrate on writing.

It's Gerritsen's fourth novel featuring the Boston medical examiner and Rizzoli, and one that finds both women with their eyes set firmly on their biological clocks and their jobs. Gerritsen, who dazzled critics with *The Surgeon*, *The Apprentice* and *The Sinner*, probes both her characters' psyches.

Rizzoli is pregnant and Isles, divorced and 40, is not only thinking about where she came from but whether "there's a family in my future." And, of course, there's a serial killer.

Palmer's story, also of the serial-killer



variety, takes readers down a more societal path, looking at the hundreds of companies profiting wildly from the American medical system, companies that essentially exercise chequebook-control over the delivery of health care.

It was such stories as *The Patient* and *Fatal* that made Palmer a household name.

Dr. Will Grant, the overworked surgeon in Palmer's mystery, is experiencing the outrage of a system that puts costs before life. He's also a member of a group calling itself the Hippocrates Society, a society made up of medical practitioners who are trying to wrest the profession back from the corporate world.

Medical examiner Maura Isles has an equally troubling assignment to work through in Gerritsen's story: The corpse on her examining table looks suspiciously like herself. In fact, the woman, who was shot to death outside Isles' home, could well be her identical twin, a sister she never knew she had.

Gerritsen, a Maine author, rocketed to nationwide acclaim with her first medical mystery, *Harvest*. She quickly followed that with bestsellers *Life Support*, *Bloodstream* and *Gravity*.

# Vanity Fair star dreads repeating himself

He's played Edgar in King Lear and Ferdinand in The Tempest for the Royal Shakespeare Company.

On TV, he's portrayed a psychopathic rapist in Calling The Shots, a charming con man in The Guppy and a pathetic stalker in Metropolis. For film, he was a bisexual baker in Bedrooms And Hallways, a philandering gambler in Woman Talking Dirty and an enigmatic nobleman in A Knight's Tale.

And now, he's in Italy for the next few months playing that legendary Roman, Marc Antony in a major new HBO cable series called Rome.

If you find James Purefoy difficult to pigeonhole, that's how he wants it. In fact, the 40-year-old English actor will be delighted to bring up other vehicles — Arthur Miller's tragic Death Of a Salesman, Congreve's witty The Way Of The World — as further proof of his versatility.

You see, he has this horror of repeating himself: once he completes an acting job, he tries to make sure that the next one will be a total contrast.

But Purefoy does concede that he seems to be at the top of everybody's list for one type of film — the literary adaptation. So he suspects it was inevitable that when a new big-screen version of William Makepeace Thackeray's Vanity Fair received the green light, the filmmakers would come calling.

And he was happy to take on the role of Rawden Crawley, the likeable but feckless young nobleman who is ensnared by Reese Witherspoon's social-climbing Becky Sharp, because, once again, it was a type of character he'd never previously played. However, he didn't read Thackeray's massive novel until he'd finished the movie.

"I read the book afterwards. I've done a lot of literary adaptations in my time, and I increasingly found that it's not useful to read the book.

"That's because you're making a movie and you can end up trying to put things in that aren't actually there. So I find that counter-productive in nearly every job I've done of a literary adaptation."

But he still adores the novel. "It's a good read, a really good read. It's very

funny — an extraordinary novel."

In recent years, Purefoy — a former pig farmer who was named "hunk of the year" a few years ago by a British television magazine — has played in major TV or film versions of several literary classics — Anne Bronte's The Tenant Of Wildfell Hall, Thomas Hardy's The Mayor Of Casterbridge and (a particular favorite) Canadian director Patricia Rozema's controversial treatment of Jane Austen's Mansfield Park.

He enjoys the opportunity of working with a director with the potential of bringing fresh insight to a work.

That was the attraction of Mansfield Park — also of Vanity Fair which is directed by Mira Nair, the Indian director responsible for Mississippi Masala and Monsoon Wedding.

"Mira brings a sensibility to it which is so different from what most directors would bring. She is incredibly visual in the way that she pictorializes her ideas and thinks about her ideas. She's so precise — incredibly precise — about what happens in a frame, and that's sort of liberating.

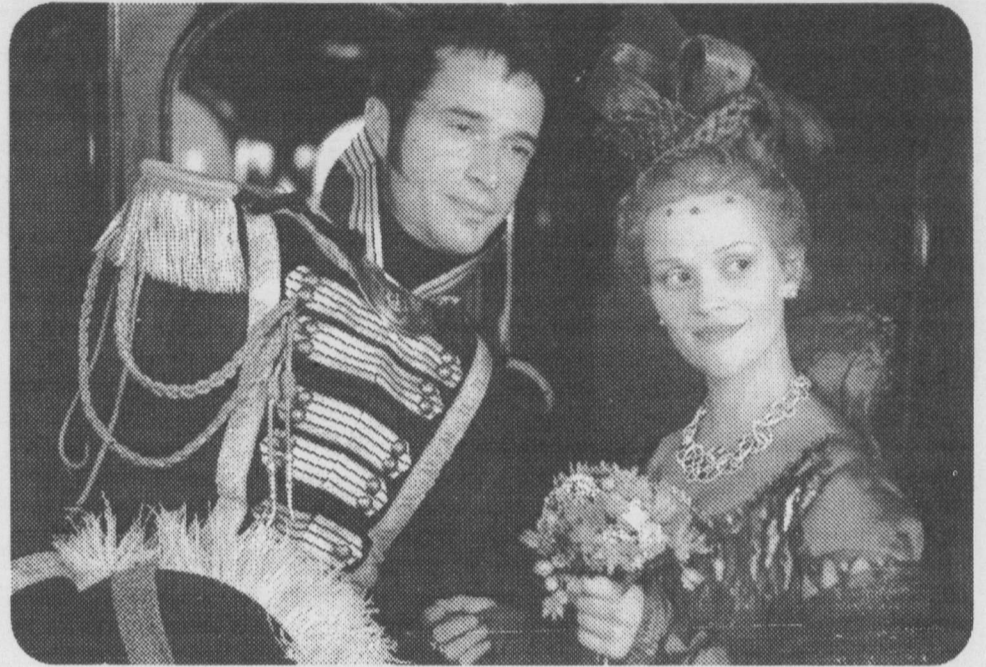
For example, she'll do things with hands — she's fascinated by hands. She likes doing shots of hands and the way they move and the way they hold other people and the way they hold objects."

So how is Vanity Fair different from how it would be under another director?

"She comes at it from the position of being an Indian woman," Purefoy says. "I know that people are going to have a go at the way she's interpreted it, but it IS an interpretation.

People had a go at Patricia Rozema about Mansfield Park. But Mansfield Park is still a novel, and it will always be a novel.

"It will always be there for people to pick up and read. It's the same with Vanity Fair. It will still be there. Vanity Fair the novel will survive this film."

"There's Heather Graham, me and a community of devil worshippers. I'm not really selling this movie to anyone, am I?"

Once in a while, an album is released without a lot of advertising. Most of the time, the collections are recorded for the love of music, the pleasure of sharing a musical vision and not intent on making it onto the country music charts. Be aware of these releases because they often end up being hits — as is the case with The Notorious Cherry Bombs.

This album is my special discovery of the summer. The Cherry Bombs were a band very popular in the 70's before its members went their separate ways to pursue solo careers.

Working without the pressure of having to prove something or compete to stay at the top often gives artists the opportunity to perform more freely, letting their artistry and inspiration take over. It becomes not only a work of art but also a labor of love.

The Cherry Bombs was composed of musicians who became extraordinary singers, songwriters and musicians — Vince Gill, Rodney Crowell, producer Tony Brown, guitar ace Richard Bennett, steel wiz Hank Devito, producer Emory

Gordy Jr and Larry Londin.

At the end of the 70's and beginning of the 80's, they were Rodney Crowell's backup band, when he was struggling to get his career going. The band reunited at the 2003 ASCAP Country Award dinner where Crowell was honored for his songwriting. Getting back on stage for the occasion re-ignited the passion of performing together.

From there, it became obvious to everyone concerned they were even better than at the peak of their touring. Totally inspired by this performance and rejuvenated, a decision was made to hit the recording studio.

In a way, The Notorious Cherry Bombs are doing exactly what the Traveling Wilburys (Roy Orbison, Tom Petty and George Harrison) did a few years ago.

A group of successful men who are having too much fun to let go or take themselves too seriously.

This album is their debut release but some fans have been waiting 25 years to see that happen. One listen will charm

you. This 11-track collection offers timeless country music performed by a world-class band. Strong material, superb melodies and great vocals makes this album so special.

There's honky-tonk twang, great ballads, rollicking boogie performed by artists displaying great musicianship and a friendship that we can feel in their music.

The first single released is a humorous tune which hides a lot of truth.. 'It's Hard To Kiss The Lips at Night That Chew Your Ass Out All Day Long' is performed by Gill and Crowell. It is so hard to imagine one of them including such a title on their own respective albums. But it sure works here and a video was even made for the song.

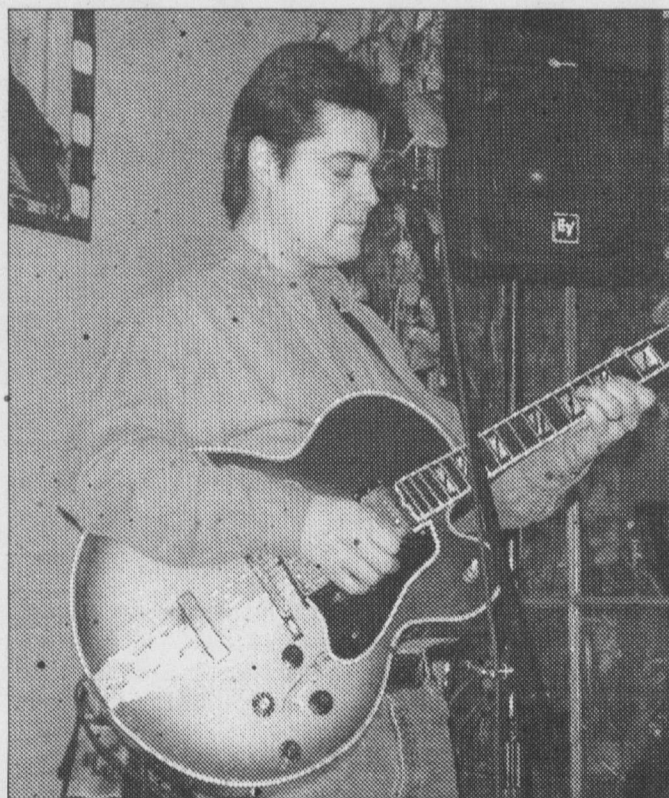
