Queen's Own Rifles

No Canadian Regiment can point to a more honourable history than the Queen's Own Rifles of Canada (allied with the Buffs, Royal East Kent Regiment) which became a unit of the Active Militia of Canada in 1860 and began its active service on Christmas Eve, 1864, when two companies were ordered to the Frontier in consequence of the St. Alban's Raid. After adding to its Battle Honours in the Northwest Rebellion and in South Africa, the Regiment sent to the Great War 205 officers and 8,104 other ranks, before the Military Service Act was enforced—a record unparalleled in the story of the Canadian Militia. Members of the Regiment were awarded four V.C.'s and 343 other decorations.
