WANTED VIGOROUS ACTION.

For additional particulars concerning the late Champlain street disaster, the reader is directed to another column of today's paper. In the meantime, the hour has arrived when we must speak plainly. At this date there must be buried in the ruins, no fewer than sixteen or seventeen persons. Of that number it is hardly within the range of possibility that a man, woman or child is alive. Want of food, want of water, want of air, nervous prostration, internal and external injury have long ago, probably, done their dread work. Those who will be brought out of the ruins will be brought out dead, and ready only for the coffin and the grave. This is a stern way to look at the matter, but it is the only reasonable way. We deplore the loss of life, but the fact remains staring us in the face like a specter.

NOTICE.

Up to this time, there have been engaged in the work of rescuing the living, and carrying out the mangled bodies of the slain, only the military, and such volunteer assistance as could be got in the vicinity of the accident. Heroic and noble as has been this work, it is entirely inadequate to meet the circumstances of the occasion. We must go into this matter at once and with the best energy at our command. To-day at the City Hall, at three o'clock in the afternoon, a meeting of citizens will be held. This meeting has been officially called by the Mayor, at the express request of a number of our citizens, and its first task will be to consider the best means of affording relief to the sufferers. The Mayor and the gentlemen who will attend this meeting ought to lose no time in taking up another phase of the question. The soldiers and the volunteers among the citizens, are well nigh exhausted. Working as they have been working, they have proceeded very slowly. What we want now is a well-equipped crew of say two thousand men, properly supplied with picks and shovels, and under good direction. We want an organized body of workmen to clear the street of the debris and to restore order out of chaos. The work must be done under a system which will admit of no cavil. A handful of soldiers can do but little. A few citizens without tools to use, and with no one to direct them cannot possibly accomplish much. The debris ought to be carted away, so that at a glance, may be seen, the extent of the calamity. The work must be done energetically, and above all, the men who engage in it must have a head to look up to in whom they have confidence. Two thousand strong men will not be any too many, and the sooner they get to work the better it will be for everybody. The soldiers and the volunteer citizens, who did so much, amid great obstacles, at the first, have placed the people of Quebec under deep obligations to them. But the time has come for more vigorous action, and it is highly necessary that a very large and well-organized body of workmen were engaged to do the work of clearing the street on a well-defined plan and under bold and intelligent direction.
