# First play wins CEGEP student \$300 drama-writing prize

SHERBROOKE — A 17-year-old College de Sherbrooke student came away from the annual *Theatre Entre Chien et Loup* drama writing contest with a \$300 first prize Tuesday.

Katia Grenier won the Yves Sauvageau prize over nine other entrants for her play, *Iphigenie ou l'art d'être une femme-enfant au coeur de baleine*. An imaginative and intellectual work, the play presents the meeting and conversation of the original Iphigenia, a figure from Greek mythology, and a modern-day counterpart.

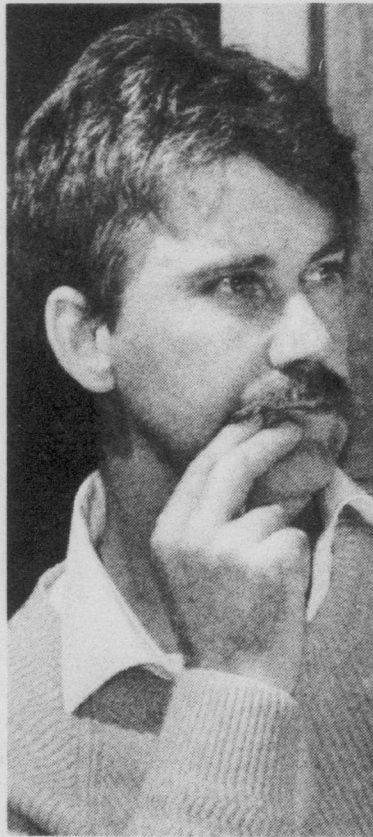
The play was the first attempt at dramatic writing for the psychology student. She says the experience of winning the contest is valuable to her in that it has shown her that others can understand the ideas she's trying to communicate.

"I know now that what I write is accessible to others," she said.

Obviously pleased with her triumph, the Katevale native says she plans to continue to write, although she doesn't have specific plans for her future.

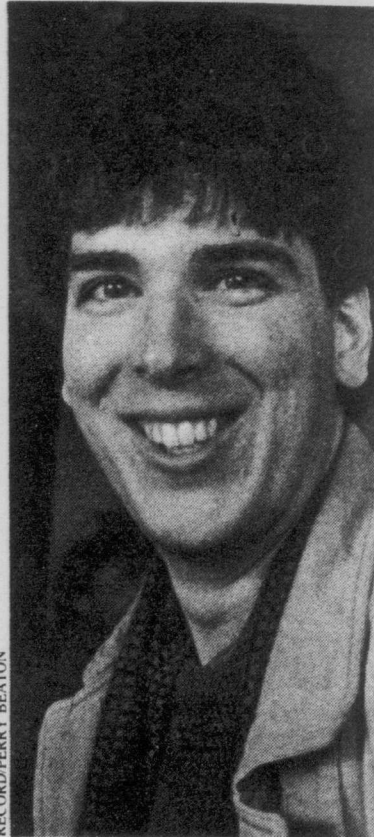
This is the fourth year the *Theatre Entre Chien et Loup* has held the contest, with increasing participation every year. This is the first year the top prize has been dedicated to Yves Sauvageau, an Eastern Townships poet and playwright who died in 1970.

The second prize of \$200 was awarded to Yvan Ruel, for his play, *Le Zoo*, a dark look at the lives of two alcoholics. Jean-Benoit Nadeau claimed the \$100 third prize for *Les Tartes*, a comedy

which, among other things, pokes fun at directors and other theatrical types.

The contest is designed to encourage the writing of French drama in the Townships, and to create a "bank" of regional drama.

In four years, 39 texts have been submitted to the contest, and \$2,400

in prizes handed out.

A jury of four people who have been active on the local theatre scene either through acting, directing or writing drama judged the submissions on the basis of rhythm, coherence of characters, flow of narration and dialogue, and the treatment of the theme.

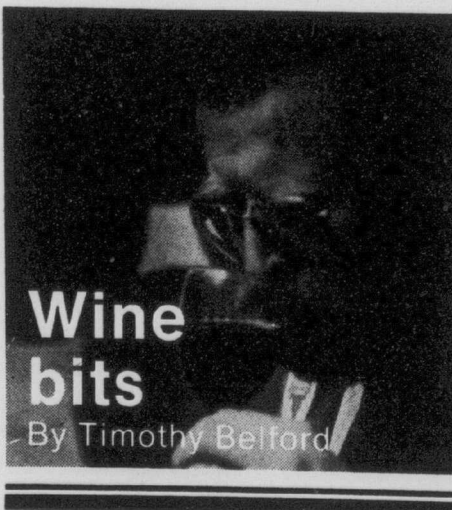
## South African wines right up there

Whether or not applying economic sanctions to South Africa will ultimately result in the overthrow of that nation's racist government remains to be seen. What is probably a safe bet, however, is that it will be some time before any major changes affecting apartheid come about.

I point out this rather obvious fact only because as long as apartheid lasts, sanctions will last, and as long as sanctions last Canadian wine drinkers will be deprived of some very good wines.

The history of wine production in South Africa is as old as the history of the European settlement of the Cape. The first vines were reportedly planted in 1654 with the first pressing of wine following four years later. With the arrival of French Huguenots settlers in 1688, the quality of South African wines to a turn for the better as more and more producers adopted traditional French methods of production.

Today, wine production in South Africa is centred upon two

regions in the south-western section of the Cape — the Coastal Belt and the Little Karoo.

The Coastal Belt region which contains such well-known names as Paarl, Stellenbosch and Malmesbury, stretches from the coast inward to the first set of mountains. Here, grape production is confined primarily to the rolling hills and lower mountain slopes. The moderating influence of the nearby ocean and the generally stable South African climate means that there is rarely a

bad year for growers. Subsequently, the dry white and red table wines of the region have a consistency that any French grower could not help but envy.

The wonderfully named Little Karoo (no phoney Chateaux here), is found inland of the Coastal Belt beyond the Drakenstein mountain range. Both sides of the Breed River valley are planted with a variety of grapes producing mainly sweet and fortified wines of the sherry type. The Little Karoo, although once again blessed by a stable climate, has considerably less rainfall than the coastal areas and thus relies on man-made irrigation.

Today, the bulk of South African table wine is white — 85 per cent — with red wine, rosé and sparkling wine making up the remainder. South Africa also produces both port-type and sherry-type wines of a fairly high quality. The latter, at least since the adoption of the solera method in 1942, are particularly good and represent, for many experts, the closest thing to real Spanish Sherry available.

One can only hope that the problems facing South Africa are resolved and that once again these many good wines find their way back to North America. Cheers!

# Woman waits 60 years to see favorite play performed again

COWANSVILLE — There aren't many people around who still remember a production put on by the Fordyce Players, a Cowansville drama club, in the 1920s.

It was called *The Dust of the Earth* and told the engaging tale of a man who loses his memory in a Swiss mountain-climbing accident only to regain it more than 15 years later when he sees his daughter all grown up and clad in her mother's wedding gown.

Irene Williams is one of the few who remembers the production. She was about 12 when it was performed and recalls singing *Can't You Bring Back the Golden Love Days of Long Ago* as part of the entertainment between acts.

Her older brother and sister were involved in the production, and she loved the play so much that she's kept a copy of the script all these years in hopes of seeing it performed locally again.

Last fall she realized her dream, but not without sticking out her neck just a bit.

A member of Trinity Anglican Church in Cowansville, Williams decided a group of her friends in the congregation would do just fine for the cast and crew of the 1986 production of *The Dust of the Earth*.

"I was anything but Christian one Sunday," she said. "I stood up and cast it from the choir loft."

**300 ATTENDED**

Between September and December last year the dynamic group of 10 people memorized lines, hammered away at props, designed costumes and rehearsed together for what was to be a phenomenally successful single performance of

the play. About 300 people crowded into the Heroes Elementary School gymnasium to see it.

But there were so many people who couldn't attend because of the "14 thousand" other things happening that night, and so many have said they would like to see the play, that the group decided to put on an encore performance this Saturday night.

It's a family play, Williams stresses, and should be of interest to all ages. "This isn't a four-letter word play," she says. "It's a wonderful story."

*The Dust of the Earth* is not only heartwarming, but amusing, says Williams. "There's comedy in it, my gosh," she says. Set in a small town, there are all kinds of eccentric characters and amusing social interaction.

Williams plays a "darkie" named Mose, with whom the poor amnesiac has lived since his accident. In masculine garb and with her face blackened, Williams says even her good friends in the audience didn't recognize her in last year's performance.

**DISCOVERED TALENT**

Williams says the production brought to light some surprising talent among the group, most of whom had never done any acting beyond grade school plays.

"In some cases this is the first time they've ever been on stage," she says.

The group has had so much fun doing this play that they hope to continue as a dramatic club, she says.

Because there are talented carpenters, artists and seamstresses within the small group, the props, costumes, programs and posters for the play have all been handled with remarkable skill, says Williams.

The four-act play requires a complete change of set for each act, and so the group designed components for the set which could be reversed fairly easily between acts. A front porch in one scene reverses to become a cupboard in

another, for example.

As in the 1920s production, local singers and musicians will perform between acts. *Can't You Bring Back the Golden Love Days of Long Ago* will be sung, as well as *A Basket of Old-Fashioned Roses*, during which a basket of roses will be given out as a door prize.

Curtain-time for *The Dust of the Earth* is 8 p.m. Saturday. Tickets are \$5 for adults, \$2 for children under 12. Proceeds from the play go to Trinity Anglican Church.

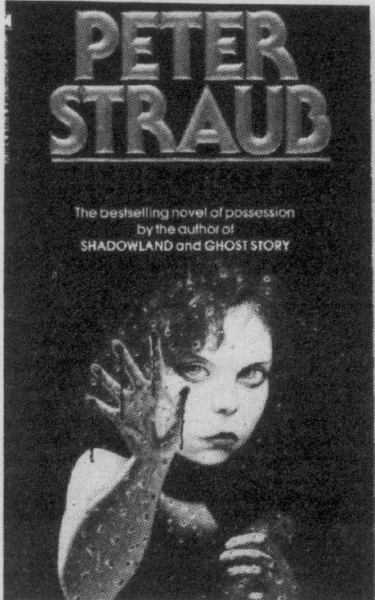


# Straub proves to be master of psychological horror

**Full Circle** by Peter Straub (BANTAM-CORGI BOOKS): \$3.95, 254 pp.

A reprint of a book that was published in Britain under the title **Julia**, Peter Straub's **Full Circle** is a novel of "possession" by the author of **Shadowland** and the very popular **Ghost Story**.

Straub's chilling story involves a young American woman named Julia who was wooed by and fell in love with a British man named Magnus Lofting in circumstances that she is not really able to comprehend. She has just been released from a hospital as the novel opens, and as it develops we learn that she is attempting to break off with her husband, following a fatal accident in which their young daughter Kate has been stabbed to death.



There is some question as to how the girl has been killed, in that she choked on some food and either Magnus or Julia were forced to perform a tracheotomy on the child which proved to be fatal to her. With this mysterious happening floating in the background, Julia buys a large home on Ilchester Place in Kensington and then the spookiness is unleashed.

The house that Julia is living in turns out to have been the home of a woman who killed her daughter in a scandalous London horror story, and she quickly learns that the home is more than haunted. Magnus is anxious to have Julia return to him and begins a campaign of placing her house under surveillance and threatening her with his sinister, aggressive behavior.

When Julia comes upon a blond-haired young girl in the local park who bears a strong resemblance to her dead daughter the plot begins to thicken. This girl appears to have captivated a number of young admirers and is caught doing ugly things to small animals. Julia becomes convinced that there is some link between her dead daughter Kate and this odd girl.

As the characters begin to sort each other out, Julia is growing more upset with the freaky situation developing in her Ilchester Place home. Noises, music, loud cries, thermostats that get turned on over and over again, and all kinds of other weird things begin to happen.

Julia's struggle with her own mind during all of this is part of Straub's forte, as is his ability to capture some of the British attitudes to seances and the kind of people who attend such extraperceptory sideshows. With her mind becoming unglued as the supernatural events become magnified, Julia is obsessed with finding out everything she can about the death in the house she is now living in.

Straub's handling of the atmosphere in this book is commendable, as is his talent with the psychological aspect of this novel about "possession". What Stephen King is able to do with the American family in his horror novels, Peter Straub is equally the master of psychological horror in this hard to put down novel about several kinds of hauntings.

Edmonton native Tim Feehan is not exactly a newcomer to the rock wars, having been instrumental in forming the highly successful group Footloose, whose "Leaving From Maui" became an internationally received record. With his eponymous elpee, his third solo effort, Feehan has a strong studio recording which has a recognizable eighties sound—to describe him as a Canadian version of Peter Cetera might give an indication of the groove that this record gets into. The presence of Canadian production wunder David Foster handling the studio moves on "Read Between The Lines" is only one indication of the influence on this record. Foster's pop crafting of things like the "Theme From St. Elmo's Fire" is felt throughout this record in a subtle fashion on the arrangements.

The hook up with Foster came about as a result of Tim Feehan having won the Alberta Recording Industry Association's 1983 songwriting contest, and that winning song netted him the prize of having his single produced by Foster. That single, the aforementioned "Read Between The Lines", was cut at Lighthouse Sound Recorders in Hollywood, featuring Toto's Steve Lukather on guitars and the Tubes' Fee Waybill on backing vocals. Another song of Feehan's included here is "Where's The Fire", which also happened to have been a featured soundtrack song in the horror movie "The Wraith", released last fall in Canada. With such early scores in the business and a voice and delivery that place him in the select company of male crooners such as

Cetera and other hearthrobs, western product Tim Feehan seems poised to make a big impression in the Canadian music industry.

## VIDEO SCREENINGS

### DOWN BY LAW (ODEON)

This movie is such a sleeper that it might manage to slip right by you, but the screenplay and direction by Jim Jarmusch in **DOWN BY LAW** announce that this filmmaker may just make some impression on the cinema biz. With a black and white image and a couple of uncelebrated actors, Jarmusch's little story is set in the heart of Louisiana. It concerns two men — Jack (played by John Lurie) and Zack (Tom Waits) — who find themselves victims of frame-ups by the police and subsequently they share a prison cell. Jack gets taken in by a sleazy pal who arranges a rendezvous for him with a prospective hooker to add to his string as pimp.

When Jack arrives at the hotel to meet the girl, whose description captivates him. She turns out to be about 12 years old and suddenly the hotel-room is filled with cops. Zack, on the other hand, is a semi-employed disc jockey with a smooth patter, who is down and out and is offered a \$1,000 payoff just to drive a luxury car across town.

Zack takes the job and while he's bopping along grooving on the tunes and his own chatter, he's pulled over by the police. When they find a body in the trunk of the car Zack is dispatched to the same prison that holds Jack. Jarmusch's cinema craft is uncluttered and heavy on atmosphere, with an almost documentary feel to the cinematography.

When Jack and Zack are provided with a new cell-mate, an Italian immigrant with rusty English named Roberto, the film takes on a comic appeal that had only been hinted at earlier. This odd trio pulls off a simple prison escape and the end of the movie involves their attempt to get out of the bayou with their lives.

Songs by Tom Waits, with his voice like a baritone gargling crushed glass, add a gritty edge to the movie, and for a couple of relatively unknown male leads, Waits and Lurie turn in quite credible acting performances—as do the female interests in the movie, Ellen Barkin as Laurette, and Nicoletta Braschi as Nicoletta. This movie received very little publicity, but it has more entertainment value than a lot of the much heralded flops that easily make it into video release. # Band makes video to help cancer kids

SHERBROOKE — Quebec-brewed rock band The Box is trading corner bell ringing for Max Headroom's glitzy medium to raise funds to help children suffering from leukemia and cancer.

The Box joins forces with Montreal Canadiens and pop singer Martine St-Clair in a recently-produced 25-minute video. The dialogue-free film shows some cancer-stricken children practising hockey with the Canadiens and enjoying entertainment provided by St-Clair and The Box, whose music plays throughout.

The Box's lead singer Jean-Marc Pisapia was in town Monday night promoting the video at the Sherbrooke Canadiens 5-4 overtime win against the Adirondack Red Wings, which he says "is the first hockey game I ever saw live."

Why the Montreal squad?

"Well you know, they're the best team if you want to display team spirit," he said. But the most memorable part of the effort came not via the sports celebrities, said Pisapia, but from the youngsters.

"It was a great experience — es-

pecially with the children. You learn from these kids. They put up a fight," he said. Where as the players were willing to contribute what they could during and between practices, they couldn't match the time and effort provided by the exuberant children.

Besides clips of rock stars singing and hockey stars playing their game, the piece adds some humor with role reversals.

The Box's lead singer Jean-Marc Pisapia and fellow band members don hockey gear, as does St-Clair, and take to the ice against some enthusiastic youngsters. Later, camera-eager Canadiens such as Chris Nilan, John Kordic, Patrick Roy, Dave Maley, and others take to the stage with The Box crew to do a little rock and rolling.

A particularly funny scene has Canadiens' enforcer Nilan raising his dukes against a hoard of tinier skaters who wrestle the burly forward to the ice.

Producer Liz Morency says the most difficult thing about making the tape was that "there was a whole bunch of people coming from different fields" which proved tricky to co-ordinate at times.

Nevertheless she says, everybody's heart was in the right place since it was for a good cause. After eight troubled-but-enjoyable months of planning and filming, the product was finally completed.

Not only do two original songs by The Box (including their first French one) add flair, but paintings by Quebec artist Richard Hé-tu are also featured. The works depict the characteristics of the children involved says Morency.

"You see it in their eyes. All the

kids look like that. It's not sadness" — she pauses — "but still it (the paintings of children) represents them."

The \$100,000 (privately funded) video will be sold through video and other stores such as Jean Cou-tu pharmacy in Sherbrooke. All proceeds will go to Leucan, a non-profit organization whose members are parents and friends of young cancer and leukemia patients. Leucan provides moral and financial assistance for families in need and donates money to the Centre of Onocological Research at Saint Justine's Hospital in Montreal.

# Dictionary of Biography publishes 10th volume

SHERBROOKE — In its continuing efforts to answer the question 'Who is Canada?' the *Dictionary of Canadian Biography* published its 10th volume this month.

The launching of Volume VI of the monumental work took place at the University of Sherbrooke Tuesday to recognize the work put into the dictionary by researchers at that university, as well as at Bishop's University in Lennoxville.

Volume VI features 479 biographies of people who died or were last known to be alive between the years 1821 and 1835. It's the 10th volume to be published, because Volumes VIII and IX covering 1851 to 1890 have already been published.

The series was begun in the 1950s through a bequest from millionaire businessman James Nicholson and has since been supported by the Canada Council and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada. The volumes are published simultaneously in French by *Les Presses de l'Université Laval*.

Among the local contributors are history professors Jean-Pierre Kestumen, Micheline Dumont, André Lachance and Andrée Désilets.

Désilets, who has contributed some 50 biographies to the dictionary over the past 20 years, says the dictionary is used both by serious researchers looking for infor-

mation about the past and by browsers who are just interested in reading about the lives of the pioneers of our country.

Before the dictionary, there was no such comprehensive collection of biographies of the people who shaped our country, she said.

"There's nothing as complete or extensive as this one," she says. "This is really a national work."

The sixth volume of the dictionary also has ties to Sherbrooke in that Sir John Coape Sherbrooke, the colonial administrator after whom the city is named, is featured in it, as well as Gilbert Hyatt, who acquired part of Ascot Townships in the early 1800s and established the village of Hyatt's Mills which later became Sherbrooke.

Francess Halpenny, editor of the dictionary since 1969, says the work has been described as a "vast historical novel" because each volume documents the people who had the major influences on the country during a particular era.

"It's not just politicians, soldiers and lawyers," she said. "It's all kinds of people in all the professions." It can even contain such personalities as criminals who were part of particular sensational crime stories of the era.

The editors insist the biographies be readable as well as correct, she said, making the dictionary enjoyable reading for the average history buff as well as students and professors of history.

# Innovative software puts culinary information at students' fingertips

SHERBROOKE (LS) — Know any recipes using both honey and mustard?

It's an unlikely combination, and if you really wanted to find out if these two items are ever used together it would probably take several days' research.

Until now that is. Now a Sherbrooke school has had a computer program prepared that reduces the time required for researching this and many other culinary to-

pics from days down to minutes.

Le Triolet high school is already well-known for its innovative professional cooking program which gives students a chance to serve real clients in its restaurant, La Petite Bourgogne. The school has innovated once again by arranging with the CEGEP de Sherbrooke to have two computer science students spend their four-month internship preparing a computer program to ease access to resource

material about cooking.

The result of their efforts is a program that makes any of 180,000 pages of text accessible on the computer screen within seconds.

Chef Jacques Latulippe says the program gives students and other researchers access to the same information a 900-volume library could provide. The only other program he knows of that uses the computer for pedagogical purposes in the culinary arts is in Lausanne, Switzerland.

The school plans to provide an information service to local hotels and resorts using its new program, says Latulippe. It should be useful to anyone who wants to improve the menu at their restaurant or hotel, or create an innovative menu around a particular theme.

The program is far more than a listing of recipes, says Latulippe. The emphasis, in designing the program, was on classifying information in theme areas that would help a chef find all the information needed to prepare food from start to finish — above and beyond the instructions a recipe can give.

There are still two years of work to be done, he says, but the two computer students have laid the groundwork for a system that will be continuously updated.

# Region's first military museum opens in Sherbrooke

SHERBROOKE — The Eastern Townships has a new museum this week, the first one in the region devoted entirely to military history.

The Sherbrooke Fusiliers Museum opened to the public for the first time Tuesday after months of planning and preparation by old soldiers, their younger counterparts and a couple of skilled curators.

The reserve regiment has gathered a fine collection of military artifacts over the years, and finally has a place to put them. Included in the collection is an Imperial German battle flag from the First World War, collections of medals, military equipment and period photographs.

Also on display are several examples of uniforms the Fusiliers have worn over the years with great pride — and great discomfort.

**SINCE 1984**

At a press conference announcing

the museum opening, Fusiliers commandant Lt. Col. Jean Gauthier said the museum project has been gathering steam since 1984, when he asked Lt. Denise Rioux to "start collecting items and get a nice place to put them."

"There was lots of talk about museums in the area, and we wanted to do our share," Gauthier said. "Since then we have added to our collection, become the only accredited military museum in the area, and thanks to government grants, engaged two professionals to get everything off the ground."

"We wanted to do two main things," Rioux said. "We wanted to recover the historical objects we knew were around, in private collections, and we wanted to show the public the social importance of the militia."

The theme of the museum's first exhibit is 'Dress Swords and Steel Helmets'. Both goals have been achieved.

The social relevance of the re-

serve armed forces is made clear by a glance at some of the photos taken of the Fusiliers on parade over the years.

The regiment's first members were mainly from a French-language company of the 53rd Regiment Sherbrooke Rifles. In 1910 they formed their own battalion, the *54ième Régiment Carabiniers de Sherbrooke*, which became one of the first French-language military units anywhere in Canada.

Over the years the ranks of the Carabiniers, later the Fusiliers, have been peopled by many of the leaders of Sherbrooke society. Perhaps the best know among them was one of the regiment's commanders, Lt. Col John 'Johnny' Bourque, later a leading provincial cabinet minister during the Duplessis days.

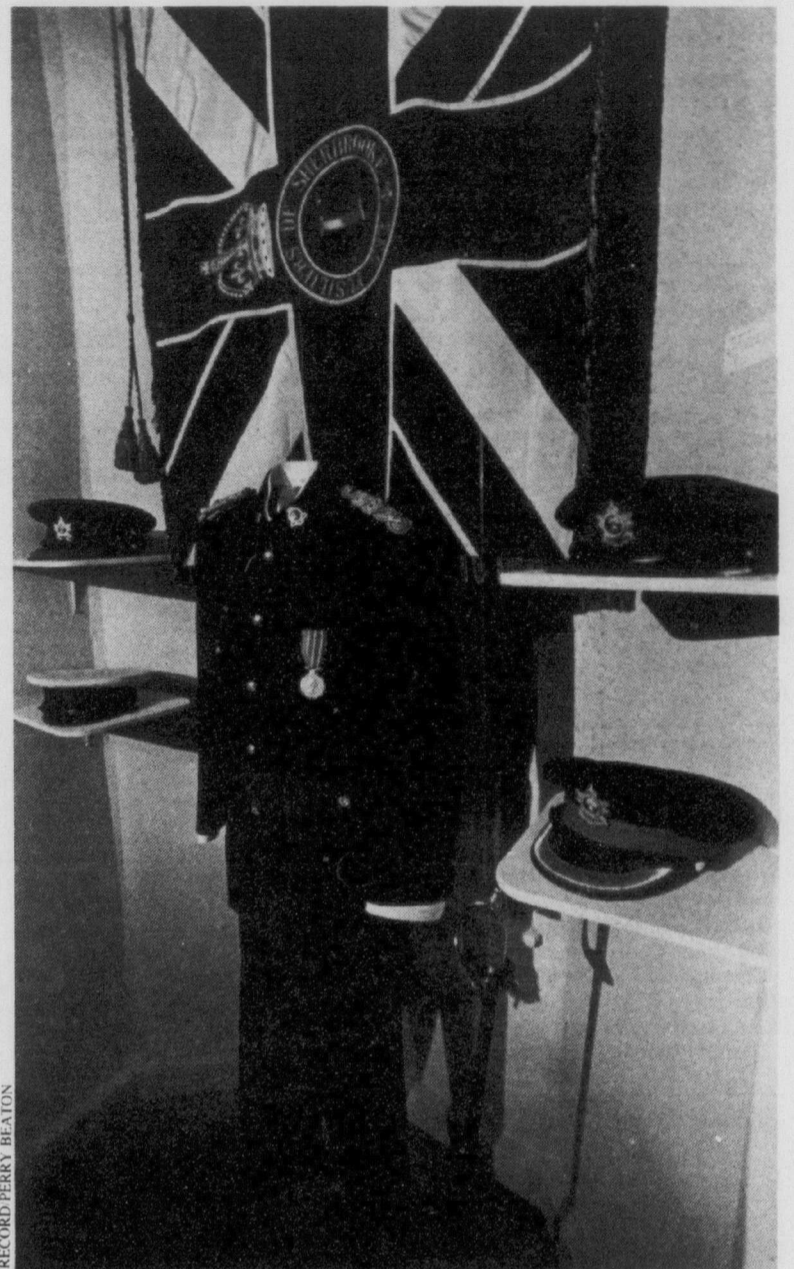
The Fusiliers have collected some impressive war souvenirs. Although some date from WWI, like the Imperial battle flag, most are from the second war, when the Fusiliers fought for the first time as a unit. Trained as infantrymen, the regiment was turned to tanks. "It was a painful transformation," Rioux said. "At the beginning of World War II most of them had never seen a tank."

## NOISY SHERMAN TANKS

By 1944 the Fusiliers were ready. Their noisy Sherman tanks rolled onto the beaches of Normandy on D-Day and never looked back until the Germans had been beaten.

The regiment's WWII battle honors read like a map of Allied victories in 1944 and '45: Authie — Caen, L'Orne; Bourgebus Ridge — Faubourg de Vaucelles, St-André-sur-Orne; Falaise — Falaise Road, Clair Tizon, The Liaison, Antwerp-Turnhout Canal, The Scheldt, The Lower Maas; The Rhineland; The Hochwald; Xanten; The Rhine — Emmerich-Hoch Elten; Zutphen — Deventer.

For anyone interested in the history of war or the history of the Eastern Townships, the Fusiliers

# Trudeau moves to television to become more complete journalist

SHERBROOKE — One of North America's most respected radio interviewers is taking a job on a relatively small-time TV show to "learn new skills and apply the ones I already have."

Dennis Trudeau has been host of CBC's public-affairs flagship magazine show *As it Happens* for the last two years. The program is broadcast across the entire CBC radio network, on the CBC's shortwave system Radio-Canada International, and in most of the United States, where it is repeated on the Public Radio system.

This summer Trudeau will give up his global audience for the host's chair at *Newswatch* on CBC's Channel Six in Montreal.

## MORE COMPLETE

Trudeau said in a telephone interview from Toronto he is loo-

king forward to the challenge and hopes to make himself a more complete journalist by learning the tricks of television.

"It's a tri-media world we live in," he said. "I've worked in newspapers and radio, but never in television. This is a chance to work in TV for the first time."

Trudeau said he will have "some regrets" at leaving the the pressure-pot existence of the national network on-air personality.

"I have enjoyed, and indeed I still enjoy working in radio," he said. Leaving *As it Happens* was "a difficult choice."

"This was something I had always wanted to do, and I think I did fairly well at it. It won't be easy to leave it. After all, I've been here for two years."

## 'LOTS OF FEEDBACK'

*As it Happens* "is a good show,"

he said, because "being national, it gets a lot of feedback."

Trudeau began his news career in 1970 at the *Chronicle Telegraph* in Quebec City. He worked at the Canadian Press news service, the *Montreal Star* and *Gazette* before switching to radio in 1979, when he became host of *Quebec AM*, the morning "wakeup" show broadcast from Quebec City and reaching most of the province via a string of repeating transmitters known as the Quebec Community Network.

Trudeau then switched to *Daybreak*, broadcast on CBM-940 in Montreal. He left that to take over the Montreal-based network open-line opinion show *Cross Country Checkup*.

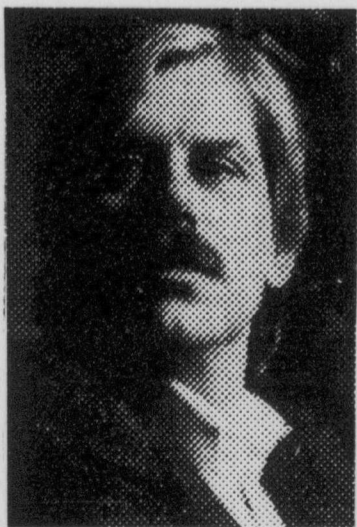
## RATINGS BOOSTER

During the two years Trudeau spent at *As it Happens*, the show's ratings "improved considera-

bly," according to a CBC press release announcing his new duties. At *Newswatch*, the network hopes he will do more of the same. He will replace Kathy Keefler, who hosted the supperhour show for five years. During Keefler's tenure, *Newswatch* increased its viewing audience by "100 per cent", the communiqué said, but it still lags far behind its main competitor, CFCF-12's popular *Pulse*.

Trudeau expects to use all his existing media skills on his new show. That will give *Newswatch* a new twist. "I hope to do some live interviewing on the show and bring some live reports on air with our reporters in the field."

"Mind you I will have a lot to do just learning the ropes but I hope to have time to get out and do at least some reports on my own."

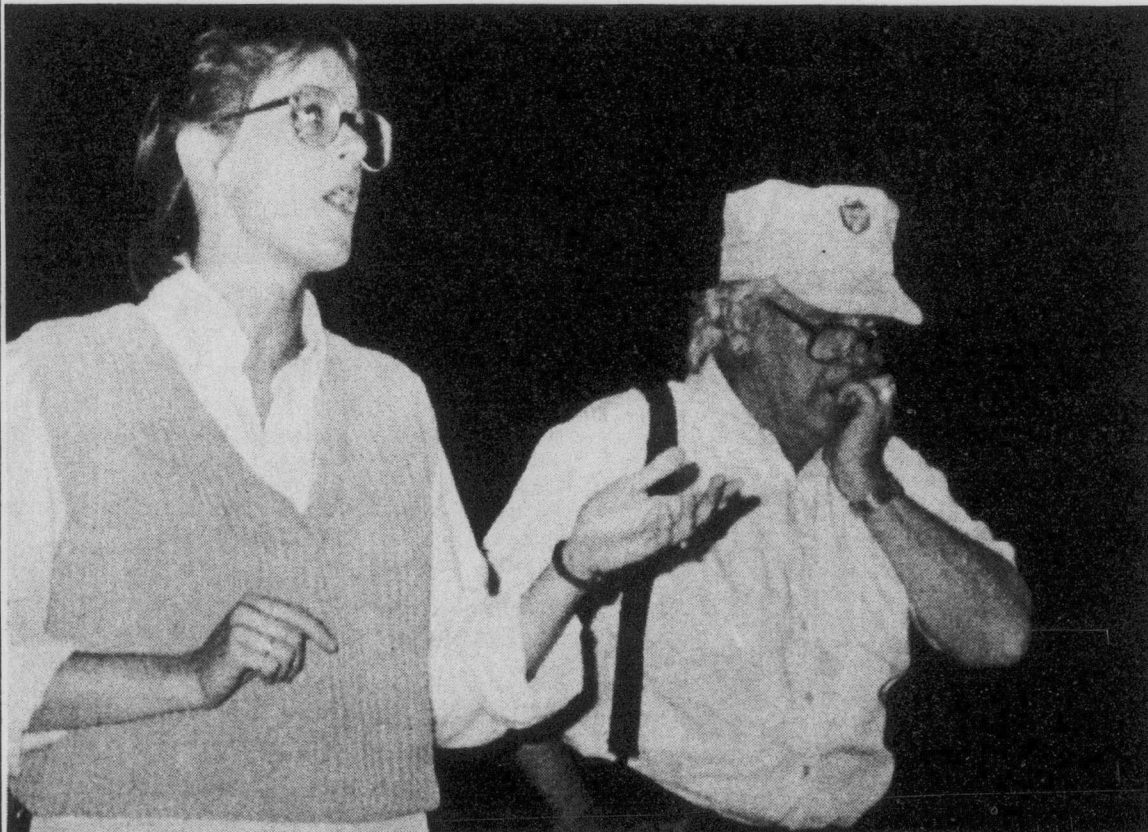

LENNOXVILLE (LS) — The community theatre group, the Lennoxville Players, returns to Gilbert and Sullivan for their annual production this year, presenting the ever-popular *Yeomen of the Guard*.
