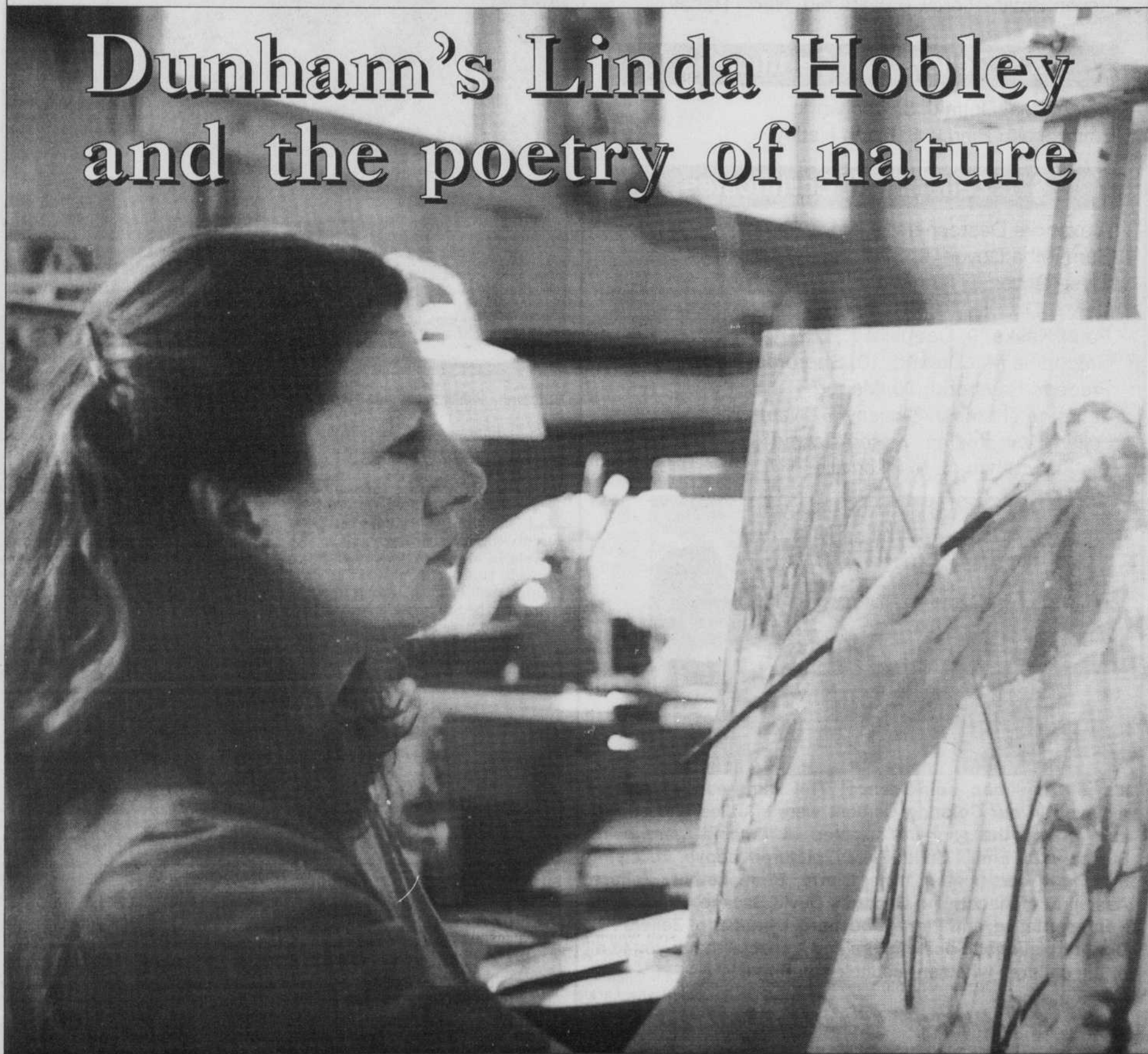

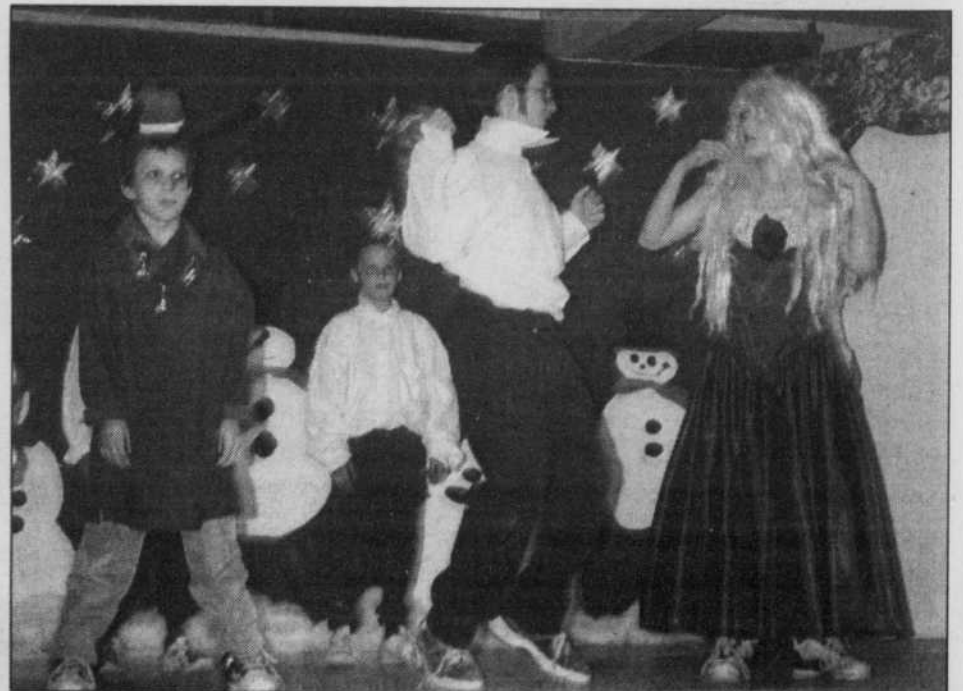
Eastern Townships Citizen Advocacy celebrated its 13th Annual Community Christmas Party and Parents' Night last Friday.

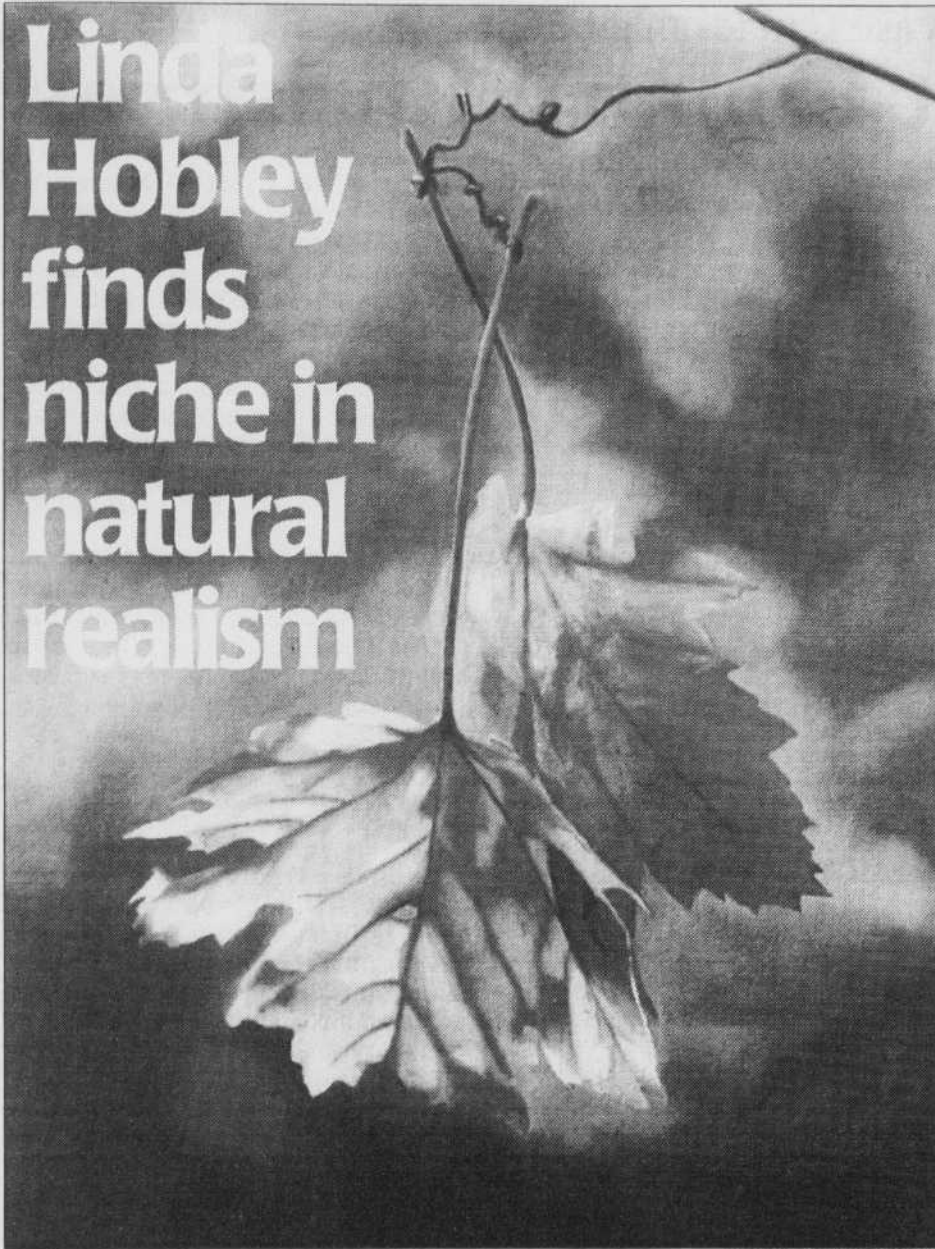

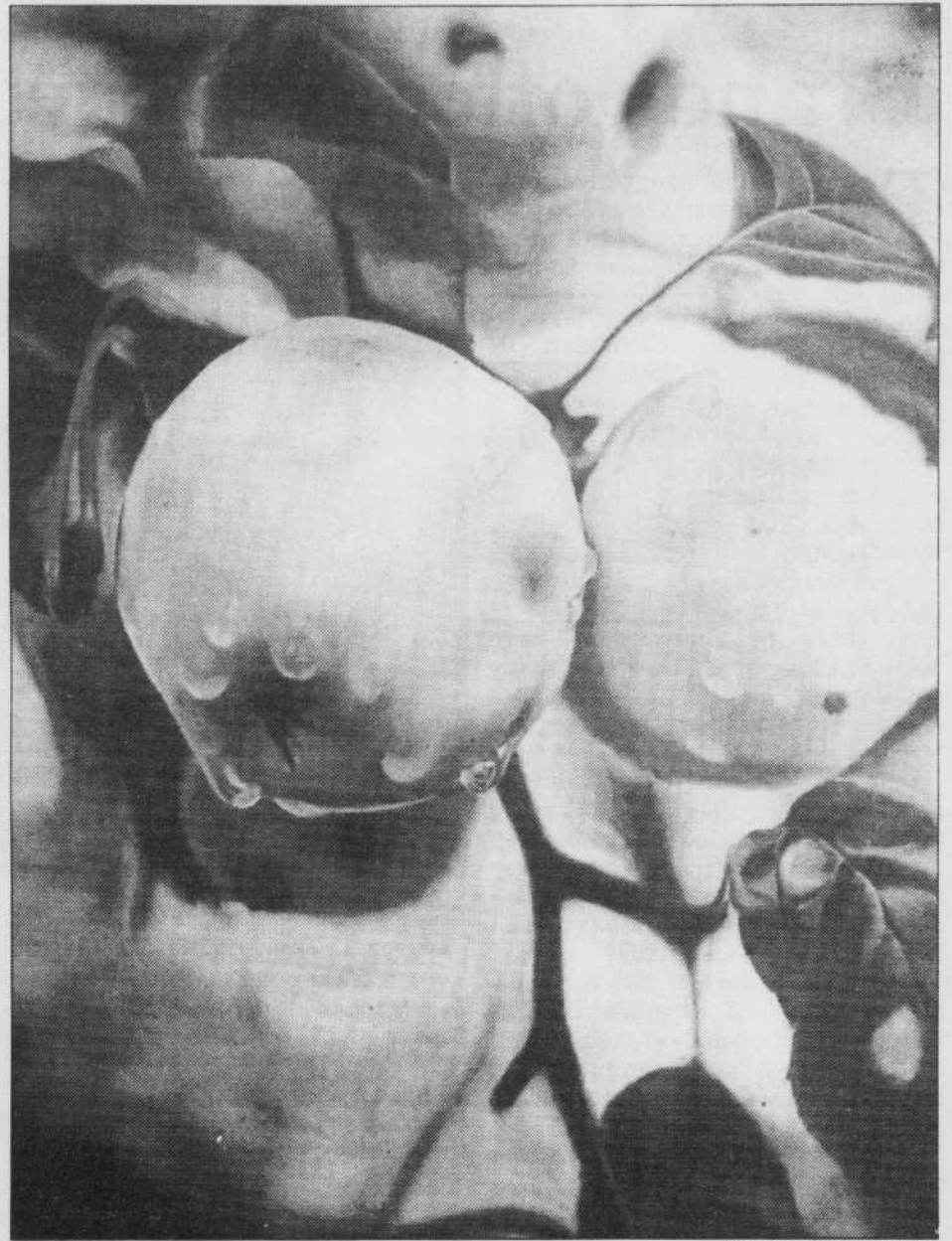

Linda Hobley finds niche in natural realism

Dunham artist Linda Hobley came to the Townships in search of serenity and solitude. Since her arrival in the 1980s, the U.K. native has been inspired by her surroundings to paint images from nature that have gone on to be exhibited in galleries across Canada.

"I've drawn and painted since I was 10 years old," said Hobley in a recent interview. "I wanted to go to art school after high school, but couldn't afford it; so, I worked as a secretary."

Throughout the 1970s, she took courses part-time in art and commerce. In 1980, she married teacher Ken Tannahill and the couple moved to Dunham, where they raised daughters Jennifer and Kerry. In 1991, Hobley enrolled in Concordia University's Fine Art program and graduated in 1994 with a B.F.A. Since then, she has worked from the studio in her Dunham home, painting nature subjects in oil. She also orga-

nized arts shows at the Dunham community arts centre but gave it up a year ago to dedicate more time to painting.

In spite of a warning from a Concordia teacher that "Dunham is not where it is happening," she said the local community is very receptive to the arts. Hobley is a regular participant in the Tournée des vingts and has had solo exhibits in Dunham for the last five years. Next spring, she will have a solo exhibit on invitation from the town of Brossard at the gallery and cultural centre. In addition, her work is getting notice beyond Quebec's borders.

"I'm now represented by two galleries outside of Quebec: one in Calgary and one in Vancouver," she explained.

Though Quebec's lagging economic performance put a damper on local art sales, Hobley said her work has sold well at the two western galleries. The painter recently completed a series of four paintings for the Nature's Garden Seed Company of Vancouver. Two of her works were recently sold to collectors in Korea and one, a portrait of a monarch

butterfly, will grace a future cover of the University of Texas scientific journal, "Lapidopterists' News."

"In a year I'll produce 26 paintings ranging from 8" x 10" to 30" by 24", Hobley said. In addition to the gallery sales, she sells from the studio. Heeding a painting teacher's advice to only display one's best works, she has found it a challenge to meet the demand for exhibition stock without lowering standards.

She describes her style as a variant of photographic realism, where natural objects are painted as she sees them, often using her original photographs for reference. However, she tries to take her paintings beyond photographic renditions of natural objects, incorporating human metaphors within the natural elements. Her preference for realism did not ingratiate her to Concordia arts instructors, who emphasized abstraction.

"I had one teacher who told me that she did not want to see those types of paintings in her class," Hobley said, re-

ferring to her own paintings. Still, she acknowledges the lessons she learned from studying abstract art:

"If the abstract elements in a painting don't work, no matter how well a painting is executed, it won't work."

She also acknowledges talent is abundant in the art world, but talent without persistence is doomed to obscurity.

"You have to ride out the crests and waves in art," she explained. "A lot (of success) is putting out feelers." To this end, she and husband Ken have established a Web Site where the public may read her bio or view copies of her paintings. Personal annotations accompany each work giving greater insight to the curious reader. Her site brings her 24-hour visibility in the global art market, allowing her to spend more time producing paintings and less time marketing them. That, in the end, is where Linda Hobley would prefer to be.

Songs old and new showcase Canadian's talent Brandt offers a perfect Country Christmas

PAUL BRANDT, A Paul Brandt Christmas - Shall I Play For You?, (WEA)

Paul Brandt has the greatest Canadian country Christmas album I have heard in a long time. This Prairie singer is able to combine just the right amount of Christmas and country for a great album.

It begins with "The Little Drummer Boy," one of the songs that I hate the most at Christmas, but I was very surprised to hear this version. I bet you can imagine the results of this with Brandt's deep voice. Let's just say the song doesn't fade away in the background.

The album continues with the popular "Santa Looked A Lot Like Daddy," which is up-tempo and very country.

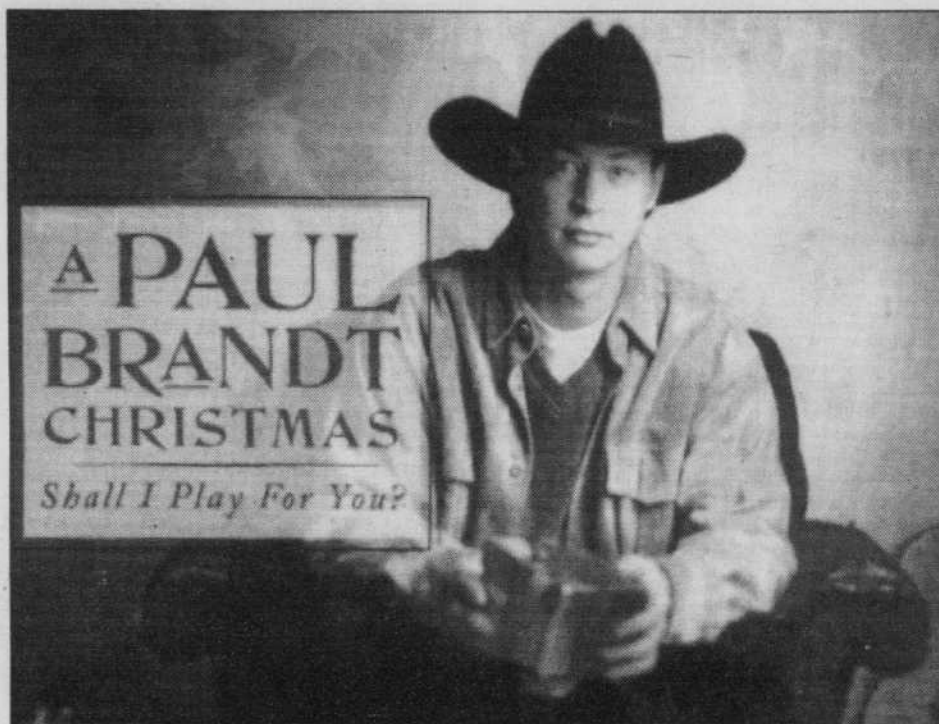
Then there is the five-minute rendition of "What Child Is This," that heads straight to your heart.

Brandt's Christmas spirit runs over on with "Run Run Rudolph."

He covers "Jingle Bells" very well with an upbeat tempo that makes you want to get up and dance and of course sing this holiday classic.

The album ends with "O Holy Night."

He does it as well as Gill and McBride but his deep voice makes it something very unusual.

VINCE GILL, Breath Of Heaven, A Christmas Collection with Patrick Williams and His Orchestra, (MCA)

What can I say about this charming man that I haven't said before? He's a sweetheart! An accomplished singer, songwriter and musician Gill does not disappoint his many fans with this latest album.

This time, he hasn't put his songwriting ability to work, but his singing talent. Needless to say it works in a very wonderful, subtle and charming way. The title of this collection expresses the feel of the album, it truly is a Breath of Heaven.

Gill has opted for a more traditional less country approach with this Christmas album than the first one. His first, *Let There Be Peace*

On Earth, was filled with songs he wrote.

On this great effort, Gill is backed up by 60 musicians directed by composer and arranger Patrick Williams. His credits include arranging Sinatra's Duets and Duets II albums.

Gill throws one emotion after another on *Breath Of Heaven*. He goes from a two-stepping "Winter Wonderland" to a love-filled and soul-touching rendition of the prettiest song of all "The Christmas Song."

He continues with the old-timer "Silver Bells" and the upbeat and true statement of "It's The Most Wonderful Time Of The Year." He then adds the most beautiful and I would dare say sad, very sentimental and heart-touching, "Blue Christmas."

It is pretty hard to top this last song, but he does indeed with the breathtaking long version of the amazing "O Holy Night."

With his soft voice, Gill is capable of much emotions on the wintry "Let It Snow, Let It Snow, Let It Snow." You are easily convinced that snow is slowly falling outside and your loved one has prepared a romantic dinner with candles everywhere and has opened a bottle of something bubbly and that there is a Vince Gill Christmas album playing... it gives me chills just thinking about it.

He ends this 11-track collection with the religious "O Come All Ye Faithful." I would say it adds a solemn sound to a very heart-warming and amusing album.

Vince Gill is one of the best talent around in country music and has been for at least 10 years. So I can absolutely guarantee you that you will enjoy to the fullest this wonderful Christmas album produced by Tony Brown and Michael Omartian.

MARTINA MCBRIDE, White Christmas, (RCA, BMG)

This is another great Christmas album and a first for McBride. The songs suit her well. The album features many ballads which showcase her powerful vocal chords.

McBride is accompanied by a full orchestra and with each note you can tell she enjoyed the experience. Stylistically it is very different and fans may forget McBride has her roots firmly planted in country music.

McBride opens the collection with a wonderful wish as she sings "Have Yourself A Merry Little Christmas." She adds a romantic feel to the song with her delicate yet powerful voice.

You've Got Mail made Ryan a convert, Hanks remains unconvinced

Ryan, Hanks amateur e-mailers before movie

In their new hit film, *You've Got Mail*, Meg Ryan and Tom Hanks play characters who fall in love by sending cosy e-mails to each other. But their own real-life experiences with the Internet have been decidedly different.

"I've been in only one chat room," Hanks reports. "It was for fans of the film, *2001: A Space Odyssey*, and there was nobody else in it. I kept asking: 'Hello. Is anybody there?' Nothing would happen. I decided this wasn't my idea of fun and I haven't been there since."

Out of curiosity, Hanks checked out his fan Web sites and decided that once was enough with them as well. "They read like press releases," he complains.

Meanwhile, although she was burned once by the system, Ryan is addicted to e-mail.

"I love e-mail," she burbles. "I never was a fan until I did this movie, and now I have all these people I send messages to. I love it because your friends emerge as totally different people. This way, you hear what's in their brains and get inside them. I just love it."

But Ryan does have one rule: "Never talk to anybody you don't know." She says this is particularly important with her messages because she has her own idiosyncratic way of writing them and doesn't want to annoy strangers.

"Once I sent an e-mail by mistake to the wrong person. It was a weird e-

mail, because I can be so very obtuse, and the person on the other end didn't like it. They wrote me back with all these questions: 'Who are you? What are you talking about? You've written to the wrong person. Don't ever e-mail me again!' " The experience was unpleasant and reminded Ryan that "there is a dark side to the Internet as well."

A top film industry journalist had harsh words the other day about Anne Heche and Ellen DeGeneres and their complaints that Hollywood has turned against them because of their relationship. The message from Peter Bart, editor of the show-business

weekly, *Variety*, is blunt: Chill out. The "victim" bit is getting tiresome. Bart let loose with his opinion in a recent open letter to the two stars: "Neither of you is good casting for a victim anyway. You're both vibrantly intelligent and attractive. According to your agents, whom you fired last week, there are plenty of offers lined up that would pay you vast amounts of money. The biggest obstacle in your life is your own self-destructiveness."

In a recent interview in the *Los Angeles Times Magazine*, DeGeneres complained she had "been treated disrespectfully for no other reason than I am gay" and that the main reason her TV show was cancelled was because of her lifestyle. Bart suggests DeGeneres's series ran into trouble because she could never decide what kind of show she wanted it to be. And he reminds Heche that Harrison Ford was fully aware she was gay before casting her as his romantic co-star in *Six Days Seven Nights*.

He suggests both actresses should read *Open Secret*, a new book by

David Ehrenstein "which provides some vivid reminders of what Hollywood was like when it was truly scary to be gay - or 'deviant' as it was then known.

"In the pre-war era, gays would flee all the way to Big Bear or Lake Tahoe for their assignations; Los Angeles was too risky. Arranged marriages were de rigueur for stars such as Rock Hudson, and studio publicity departments were superb at inventing instant biographies... Things have loosened up in Tinseltown. Rupert Everett is now 'the gay Cary Grant.' Gay characters are commonplace on sitcoms. Gay people run huge companies."

Canadian junior hockey plans to snap back at Worlds

Canada's junior hockey players are on a mission, as they try to erase the memory of last year's humiliating eighth-place finish at the World Junior Hockey Championship.

This year's edition, which takes place in Winnipeg, begins Sunday, Dec. 27, when Canada faces off against Slovakia.

On Monday, Dec. 28, Canada plays last year's champion, Finland, followed by the Czech Republic on Wednesday, Dec. 30, and the United States on Thursday, Dec. 31.

All the games are on TSN. Paul Romanuk and Gary Green call the action. Analyst Bob McKenzie of The Hockey News offers between-period commentary.

Canada had won five straight titles going into last year's world championship, which was held in Helsinki, Finland. But it finished with a 2-5 record, its worst in tournament history.

On and off the ice, the team was in turmoil, as several players were reprimanded and even benched for tardiness at practices and team functions.

Following the disastrous showing, captain Jesse Wallin said too many players tried to show off and not play as a cohesive unit.

"Not everybody checked their ego at the door," he said.

That team was the youngest ever. Unlike past squads, it didn't feature former junior-league stars who had made the jump to the professional ranks or who had been drafted by the NHL.

This year, coach Tom Renney has asked several NHL teams to free up younger players, including Boston Bruins center Joe Thornton, who played for the gold medal-winning team in 1997.

With a more experienced group of players and last year's painful lessons still fresh, odds are that Canada will not finish in eighth place again.

• Monday on CBC Television, there's a special Hockey Night in Canada, as Paul Kariya and the Mighty Ducks of Anaheim visit the Ottawa Senators at the Corel Centre.

Tuesday on Sportsnet, the Vancouver Canucks host the Colorado Avalanche at General Motors Place.

CBC's double-header on Saturday, Jan. 2, features the Washington Capitals visiting the Toronto Maple Leafs, followed by the Vancouver Canucks hosting the Montreal Canadiens.

• Sportsnet's World Cup Skiing coverage continues on Friday, Jan. 1, and Saturday with women's super-G and giant slalom events from Maribor, Slovenia.

• In figure skating action, Sportsnet airs the Cup of Russia men's and pairs competitions on Saturday.

Satire and silliness ring in 1999

Air Farce offers New Year's with a laugh

Before 1992, New Year's Eve was something most Canadian TV viewers celebrated long distance. Year-end festivities consisted of watching the ball drop in New York's Times Square and wondering where Dick Clark stashed the diabolical self-portrait that was aging in his stead.

Then along came the Royal Canadian Air Farce, which not only invented a distinctly Canadian way to mark the passing year, but launched a successful new genre of home-grown TV in the process. Unlike their American neighbours, it seems Canadians prefer greeting a new year with irony rather than nostalgia.

The first New Year's Eve Comedy special was presented by the Royal Canadian Air Farce in 1992. It proved so successful that CBC Television signed the popular radio comedy troupe

to produce a weekly series of current-affairs satire.

The series's success inspired others to follow suit. Now there are three national weekly current-affairs satire shows on the air: Air Farce and This Hour Has 22 Minutes on CBC, and Double Exposure on CTV and the Comedy Network.

This year, for the first time, all three series are airing hour-long year-in-review comedy specials on New Year's Eve. It may seem like too much of a good thing, but Roger Abbott (Air Farce) figures that the varied perspectives of each show will keep them distinctive.

Confirmed guests this year on the Air Farce special include Reform MP Deborah Gray (usually played by John Morgan in the troupe's skits), Patrick McKenna and CTV's Lloyd Robertson. If Abbott gets his way, we'll also see Joe Clark, and Rick Mercer if he is finished taping year-end reports for the 22 Minutes New Year's

special.

Producer Paul Bellini says the cast members and writers of 22 Minutes "rely on a lot of the year-end review stuff that comes out in magazines and newspapers to refresh your mind about stories you didn't touch (in the weekly show) for whatever reason, or stories that are really big and got bigger as the year went on. The APEC scandal, of course, has been a big boon to us."

Like Air Farce, the erstwhile radio comics of Double Exposure broke into TV after doing a couple of New Year's Eve specials for CBC. But when they got a series order last year from CTV's parent company, Baton Broadcasting, they didn't have time to make a separate New Year's special.

This year, however, subversive mimics Bob Robertson and Linda Cullen return with another "Swift Kick in the Year-End," with highlights from their best skits and doctored

news clips, as well as some new stand-up material.

While Comedy is airing the special on New Year's Eve, CTV plans to get a jump on the competition by premiering the program on Monday, Dec. 28, producer Nick Orchard says.

Meanwhile, for the second year running, Air Farce has a Canadian celebrity countdown featuring one cameo per second during a five-minute broadcast that straddles the outgoing and incoming years.

Last year, the stroke of midnight was marked by the Air Farce troupe firing the notorious Chicken Cannon - the scourge of the fatuous and fat-headed everywhere. This year, the doughnut shop crew rings in the New Year. But that doesn't necessarily mean the Chicken Cannon won't make an appearance. "We've never merged it with the doughnut shop before," Abbott says, "but everybody else is merging, so why not?"

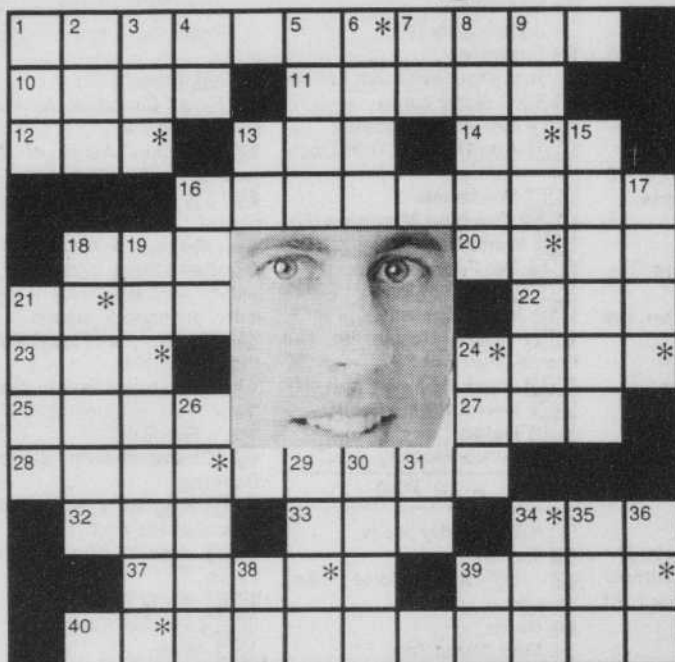
