Sparks from the Telegraphs. The Sunday closing bill has passed the Ohio Legislature.

General Ignatieff has been appointed Ambassador to Paris. Heavy frosts did considerable damage to early fruits in Virginia.

Amnesty is to be granted to insurgents in Herzegovina who return to their homes. The arrival of five French ironclads at Barcelona has created great excitement there.

A Paris dispatch says that Mr. Parnell intends to return to Ireland almost immediately. Three persons are reported to have lost their lives while ascending the Alps on Easter Sunday.

The assessment of Portage la Prairie is expected to amount to six million dollars this year. The deadlock in the British Columbia Legislature has been broken after a block of four weeks.

The French-Canadian annual convention is to be held at Cohoes, N. Y., on the 20th and 21st of June. Over 720,000 gallons of spirits was produced in the United States during the year ending June 30th last.

A Rio, Brazil, dispatch says the ladies of the Imperial family have been robbed of jewels valued at \$20,000. Direct cable communication has been established between Germany and the Anglo-American system at Valencia.

A bill for the construction of a railway from New Westminster to Port Moody is before the British Columbia Legislature. The striking shoemakers of London, Ont., have returned to work, having secured the equalization of pay for which they contended.

A Manitoba first party has been formed at Portage la Prairie, the interests of the Province take precedence of everything in politics. On Tuesday, halibutes as large as hens' eggs fell for twenty minutes, smashing windows and doing great damage to crops in sections of Louisiana.

The coronation of the Czar is officially announced to take place in August next. The expenses of the ceremony are estimated at ten million rubles. The crop reports from the West and North-West show a materially decreased average in Minnesota, Iowa and Wisconsin, and a slight increase in Dakota and Manitoba.

The German Polar Commission has decided to erect a station in the North Arctic at Cumberland Sound, and another in the South Arctic on the island of Georgia. Lake St. Louis is now open and clear of ice. The steamer "Portmeil" will run from Lacine to Beauharnois. This is the earliest opening of navigation known for many years.
