Armadillo features well-developed characters and rich details

The unconventional world of Lorimer Black

Armadillo by William Boyd

When insurance adjuster Lorimer Black discovers the hanging body of a factory owner, he has no idea how his own life will change. Like the blowtorched surface of Lorimer Black's company Toyota the carefully cultivated carapace surrounding Lorimer Black blisters in a series of traumatic events that cause Black to question his identity, his integrity and the principles of those around him.

William Boyd's seventh novel, appropriately titled *Armadillo*, is the comic yet touching story of the fall and eventual resurrection of Lorimer Black, né Milomre Blocj, a transplanted Transnis-

trian whose immigrant Rom family has laboured to make him into the consummate English gentleman.

The change of identity has not been precipitated only by a desire to fit into an English way of life, but through an unlucky life-changing incident from Black's recent past with which he cannot come to terms. This and other revelations of Lorimer Black's inner life, some serious, like the sketchy Blocj family history and some comic, like the Classic British caffs' series, an annotated list of Black's favorite eateries, come to light in the pages of the 'Book of Transfiguration,' a journal cum sleep diary, kept by the protagonist. He is being treated at the 'Institute of Lucid Dreams' by his friend and Pimlico

neighbour, Dr. Alan Kenbarry, for a sleep disorder.

We discover Black has a greater than average ability to

control his dreams (dreams over which the sleeper influences the outcome are termed lucid dreams) which results in an extremely light and broken sleep. While Black exhibits substantial control over his dreams, his life, is another story.

From Black/Blocj's giddy infatuation with the beautiful Flavia Malinverno, initially glimpsed through the window of a taxi, to his dealings with the world weary bawdy Marlobe of the local flower stall whose sense of floral aesthetic runs to robust loud colors, Lorimer Black shows himself to be a man of heart. Though his business and personal life go awry, the reader has the

sense that Lorimer Black is cushioned by the love of his extended immigrant family and his loyal friends.

Grounded in relationships and friendships, the book offers a scathing satire of show business, the angry working man, and the affectations of the upper class.

In order to overcome his sleep disorder and his identity crisis, Black will have to learn that life is not wholly controllable. It is testimony to William Boyd's fine character development the reader is left unsure that such a lesson can really be taken to heart by the main character. Lorimer Black, like even the most peripheral of the novel's characters is eminently human and redeemable. William Boyd's seventh novel overflows with credibility, humor and pathos.

Local actor featured in new sitcom

Yarmush shows his comedic side on YTV

Knowlton's Michael Yarmush has landed a lead role in a zany new sitcom *Radio Active*.

The show features four high school students at the campus radio station. Yarmush plays willing-to-please Ethan St. John. It is scheduled to debut on the YTV network in January 1999.

"I like comedy. It's a lot more fun because there's more stuff to play around with," said Yarmush who was chosen for the challenging role in Les Productions Tele-Action newest television series based on the popular French program *Radio Enfer*.

"It's not too heavy-handed with messages, it's basically kids just having fun," said comedic director and writer Jennifer Seguin from Montreal's improv comedy team *On the Spot*.

Seguin, one of four writers for the 13-segment series, said the show is a combination of the series *WKRP, Welcome Back Kotter* from the 70s and the current *Saved by the Bell*.

Since she has loads of experience with improv comedy, Seguin wanted the series taped before live audiences for two reasons. To feed the actors energy in developing their skill with jokes and to make the audience feel part of the show.

Casting Yarmush as Ethan St. John was easy for Seguin. "We needed someone who was able to understand the depth of this 14-year-old, and all the other kids who auditioned just couldn't get that balance between being a kid and being an adult, plus have the comedic timing, skills and professionalism," Seguin explained.

"Michael's got it all, so it was a very, very easy choice.

"Michael has been wonderful, his character is developing so much we just want to write him in more and more," she said.

Yarmush said he is able to relate to the character's attention-seeking gimmicks but doesn't feel as smart as Ethan who skipped a grade.

"Ethan says dumb remarks and I'm always talking dumb stuff all the time - I mean I just say things to get people to laugh," he said.

"But I didn't skip a grade like he did and I sure won't be doing that any time soon," said Yarmush worried about his school grades.

This role is Yarmush's biggest challenge since he finds it hectic combining classes at Massy-Vanier High School and taping two and three weekly sessions of *Radio Active* in Montreal, so he's count-

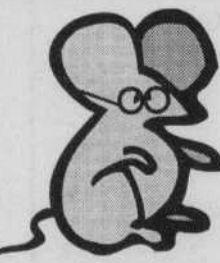
ing on his lucky stars to complete his final year.

He said that on a movie set he usually had time to do his homework but during taping this latest series, not only is he missing a lot of school but he has no time between scenes.

"During this show we have three cameras set up so we're always rehearsing and when we shoot two episodes I miss a week of school," said Yarmush who's often too tired in the evenings to do his homework.

Lately he doesn't even have time for his second greatest passion - inline skating. The day before a taping, he usually sleeps in and then goes to the arcade or to a movie to relax.

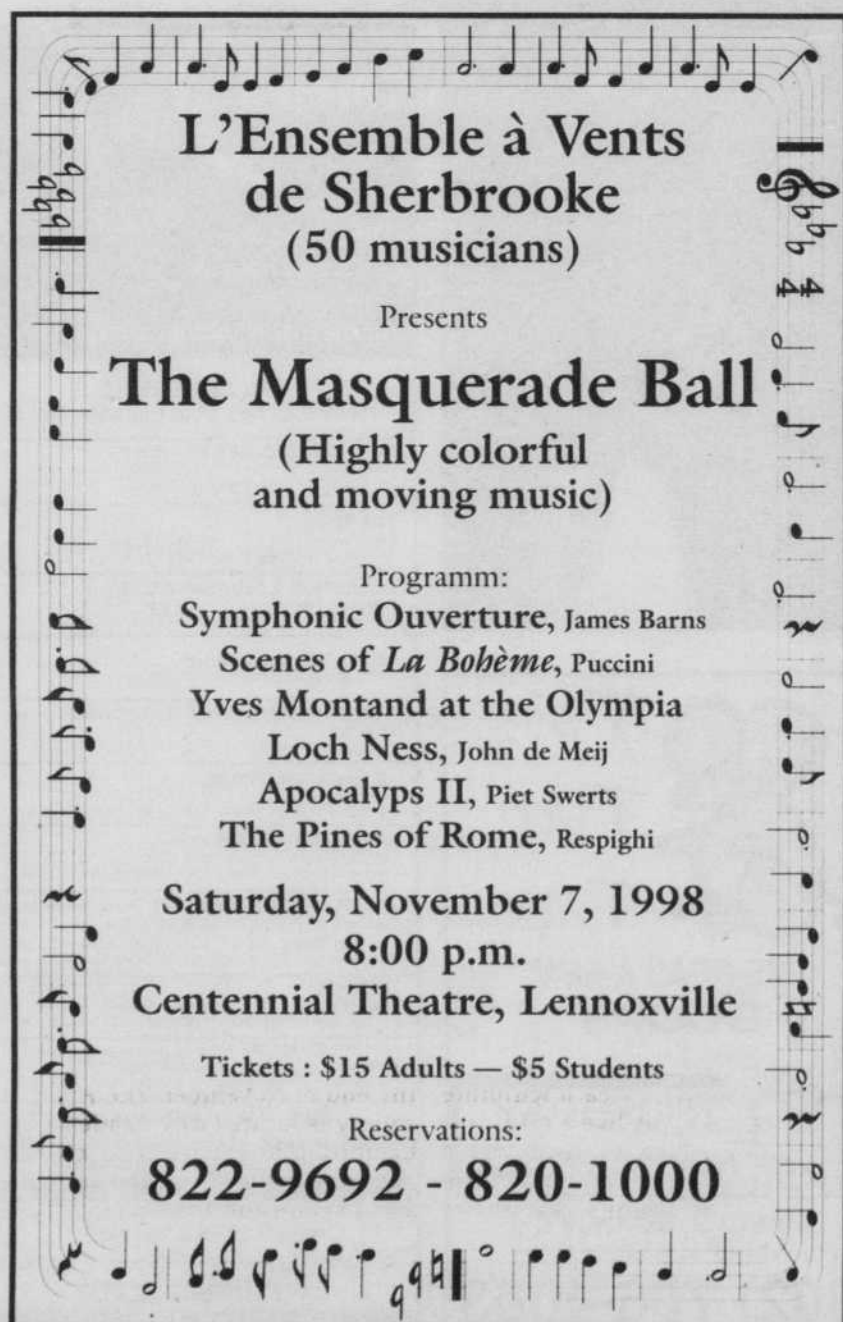
With a large body of parents willing

Arts Sutton artists complement one another

Although executed in different media, the works of architect-painter Joanne Béland and sculptor Linda Santo complement one another both in color and mood. Both artists are co-exhibiting their works at Arts Sutton through Nov. 28.

Béland's paintings are figurative landscapes executed in bright primary colors inspired by the Group of Seven. Santo's sculptures in soapstone, resin and clay offer rich earth tones with a subdued, meditative quality.

Béland, a Sutton architect, studied fine arts as part of her professional training. Her subjects are local landscapes and "landscapes through windows" in which interior decorative motifs echo natural landscapes, executed in large and small formats.

The painter is a regular participant in the Tour des Arts in July. An avid hiker and backpacker, the artist - equipped with sketch pads - recently completed a 600-mile trek through the Canadian Rockies. She met co-exhibitor Linda Santo when the two were chosen from the Arts Sutton membership for the November exhibition.

Santo, a Montreal native who has been coming to Sutton on weekends for the past 10 years, has taken up permanent residence in Sutton, creating sculpture from her small studio. Santo came to sculpture from a career in teaching. She enrolled in the Sadie Bronfman School, studying sculpture

with Stanley Lewis.

"I became interested in sculpture because I was teaching and looking for a way to relax," she said. "I found that I,

too, could be creative. ... I could create things."

After trying her hand in different media, she focused on sculpture. This led to a stint in a studio doing mold-making, followed by an invitation to work in Lewis's studio. There she learned to use the tools and how to select stone. After two years, she felt confident to strike out on her own.

For Santo, sculpture is a form of art therapy, a process she feels has enabled spiritual growth.

"Each sculpture is like a mini-voyage: You have many, many decisions to make

along the way," she said. "My lesson has been that when I do something with joy and pleasure in life, other people like it as well."

Still, Santo said each person has his or her favourite. Her personal favorite is a work entitled "Yoga Mutra," stone-carved into the shape of a woman bending over, a pose she likens to the yogic "child's pose."

Another of her favorites, titled "Five Heads," is a sculpture carved of Brazilian soapstone with five faces representing different ethnic groups, all rooted in a common ancestry. The imported Brazilian steatite from which it is carved is black at its uncarved base, gradually lightening to an almost wood-like color in the carved faces. Other works in Mansonville soapstone have an almost jade-like appearance.

The works of Linda Santos and Joanne Béland will be on exhibit until the end of November. The Arts Sutton gallery is located at 7 Academy Street. Exhibition hours are Thursday, Friday and Sunday 1 to 4 p.m. and Saturdays 10 a.m. to noon and 1 to 5 p.m.

"The pride of playing on a stage where some of Quebec's most popular artists have performed is very rewarding it feels like we are taking a giant

step in the right direction," said Branchaud.

Since their last performance at Le Vieux Clocher, the three musicians have worked hard to hone their skills performing at summer festivals and happenings. They also produced a promotional video to try and crack the lucrative summer festival markets in Quebec and in Ontario.

Since January they have been the house band for the variety show *Visage d'Artiste*, which is produced in Sherbrooke. Keyboardist Alexandre Branchaud wrote the theme music for this show.

The group also spends a lot of energy promoting *Bound For Nashville*. Doing all the work themselves, Cherry River is looking for a business manager so they can concentrate on all their energy on the making great music.

So far, they've received rave reviews in newspapers and appeared on numerous TV shows across the province.

All this hard work seems to be paying off, said Dan Goupil. Sales of *Bound for Nashville* are great. The disc is available at the HMV store at the Carrefour de l'Estrie in Sherbrooke.

The guys have a great respect for the tradition of country music.

They took a much harder road and used their creativity along with each

their musical influences along with their personal tastes to cook-up a delightful brand of jazzy, rockin' country.

The tunes in this collection are fresh and catchy while the subtle delivery makes repeat listening a pleasure. The band definitely has its own style and members display a good sense of humour, a great range of emotion and a convincing and mature way of handling each song.

Who's who of Canadian literature attend award ceremony

Short story writer Alice Munro takes Giller

Alice Munro fulfilled expectations Tuesday night by winning the country's richest literary prize.

"This is a wonderful moment for me," she told 400 invited guests at a black-tie dinner for the \$25,000 Giller Prize, carried live for the first time this year by the Bravo! cable channel.

"And I think it's a wonderful moment for those who can't kick the habit of writing short stories."

Munro, 67, one of the country's most accomplished fiction writers, won for *The Love of a Good Woman*, a collection of eight stories showing what some people will do for love and the consequences that can befall them.

It is Munro's 10th collection. Five of the stories were originally published in *The New Yorker*.

The decision is certain to add fuel to a controversy that began two weeks ago

when the same book was left off the shortlist of the annual Governor General's Literary Awards, to be announced in Ottawa on Nov. 17.

"I think (the oversight) was a tremendous shock to everybody," Ellen Seligman, director of fiction at McClelland and Stewart, said at a packed cocktail party prior to the announcement.

McClelland and Stewart published the Munro book under its Douglas Gibson imprint, making the publishing house the winner four times out of five in the history of the annual award.

Two of this year's Giller nominees also made the Governor General's shortlist. One was Barbara Gowdy for *The White Bone*, a novel told from the perspective of African elephants.

The other was Wayne Johnston, a former Newfoundlander now living in Toronto, for *The Colony of Unrequited Dreams*, written from the point of view of former Newfoundland premier Joey Smallwood.

The other Giller nominees were:

Andre Alexis, formerly of Ottawa and now of Toronto, for his first novel, *Childhood*; B.C. writer Gail Anderson-Dargatz for *A Recipe for Bees*; and Toronto novelist Greg Hollingshead for *The Healer*.

"I remind myself that the decision is already made," Gowdy said prior to the prize announcement, giving her strategy for staying calm while on the Giller shortlist for the second time, the first for her novel, *Mr. Sandman*.

"It's like sitting on a plane and watching the movie, because you can't fly the thing."

The Giller Prize first appeared in 1994 when Toronto businessman Jack Rabinovitch decided to honour the memory of his late wife, Doris Giller, a book lover and former book-page editor at the *Montreal Gazette* and *Toronto Star*.

A modest, fuzzy-haired man, Rabinovitch funds the bash at a cost he has never made known and "never will," he said as he stood smiling at the ballroom door to greet everyone as they arrived.

One turn of the head brought into

view a stunning array of personalities from the worlds of business, law and the news media, not to mention book publishing.

Margaret Atwood was a judge this year with broadcaster Peter Gzowski and novelist Guy Vanderhaeghe.

"Choosing the shortlist was the difficult part," she said. "We could have picked 10."

Nearby could be seen high-profile defence lawyer Clayton Ruby, former magazine editor June Callwood, broadcaster Patrick Watson and film producer Sylvia Sweeney.

Munro, speaking minutes after the prize announcement to Bravo!'s Ziggy Lorenc, said her feelings during the evening were of "incredulity, then delight, then gratitude."

"It isn't just the award," she said, "because every writer who was on the shortlist has something so unique and so refreshing and so exciting - I actually forgot about the prize in the delight of being in that company."

Mulder, Scully and Cigarette-Smoking Man return Sixth season of X-Files sets small screen afire

Temperatures rise on The X-Files as the popular Fox series begins its sixth season Sunday, Nov. 8.

Hot on the heels of this summer's feature film, the new season begins with an episode set in Phoenix, an unfamiliar terrain for Mulder and Scully (David Duchovny, Gillian Anderson).

But there's a good reason why the two agents are traipsing around the sweltering city. After several years of filming in Vancouver, B.C., the series now is shot in Los Angeles.

"The (episode's) opening shot starts on the sun and we hold on it - a bit longer than we should probably - and then we come down and we reveal the desert landscape, and it's sort of a wink to the

audience," executive producer Frank Spotnitz reveals.

The new locale isn't the only thing causing blood to boil. In the film, Mulder and Scully almost shared a kiss. Now, as outside forces threaten their partnership, the two agents must come to terms with how that intimate moment changes things between them.

"I think you will see the good and the bad of that moment, not just in the first episode but in several of the episodes in the new year," Spotnitz says. "It leads to tensions as well as increased closeness between the two of them."

Also in the season premiere, Spender and Fowley (Chris Owens, Mimi Rogers) return and are partnered up to protect chess prodigy Gibson Praise (guest star Jeff

Gulka).

Spotnitz says the teaming of Spender and Fowley creates an intriguing contrast to Mulder and Scully's pairing.

"There's also the interesting personal connection between Mulder and Fowley because they were once romantically involved, whereas Mulder and Scully have never been," he notes. "And then Spender's connection to the Cigarette-Smoking Man becomes increasingly clear in the new season."

The next mythology episodes won't air until February, but the producers have plenty planned for fans. Episode 3 is filmed in the wide-screen format and plays in real time, while episodes 4 and 5 feature a two-part comedic story line set in Nevada's Area 51.

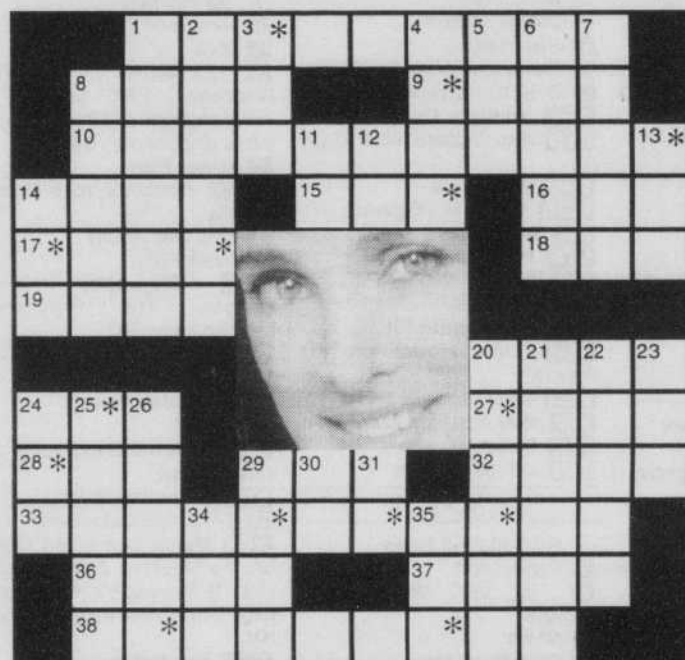
