The London Telegraph has a circulation of 240,000, or one copy for every 18 of the population. The London Times has 85,000, or one copy for every 41 of the population.

The New York Sun has 100,000, or one copy for every 14 of the population. The New York Times has 35,000, or one copy for every 45 of the population.

The Montreal Star has 10,000, or one copy for every 140 of the population. Counting the population of Montreal at 140,000 we find that the same number of people in London and New York give the most popular papers in the world.

These figures, although amazing as they stand, are still more remarkable when it is considered that a large portion of the population of Montreal are non-English speaking people; that the outlying districts are sparsely settled, and that the means of communication between Montreal and the surrounding towns and villages are very inferior to those of London and New York.
