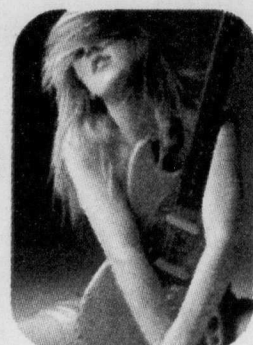

Why did the chicken cross Wellington Street?

Several years ago, Sherbrooke had an annual summer blues festival down on Wellington Street. Things were coasting along well enough, but gradually, somehow, the event lost its spark.

"It was the same artists who kept coming back year after year, so we wanted to do something more happening," explained Bernard Y. Caza of Productions BYC.

And Caza was in a good position to provide the change of direction the Weekend of Blues's sponsor, Labatt Blue, was seeking. As booking agent for the Vieux Clocher clubs in both Sherbrooke and Magog for the past 20 years, Caza has his finger on the pulse, or funny bone, of Quebec comedy.

"About 90 per cent of Quebec comedians get their start at the Vieux Clocher in Magog," he estimates.

"It's a natural for us to mount this festival." Together with Sherbrooke's Corporation Centre Ville, Caza and co. envisioned a comedy festival like

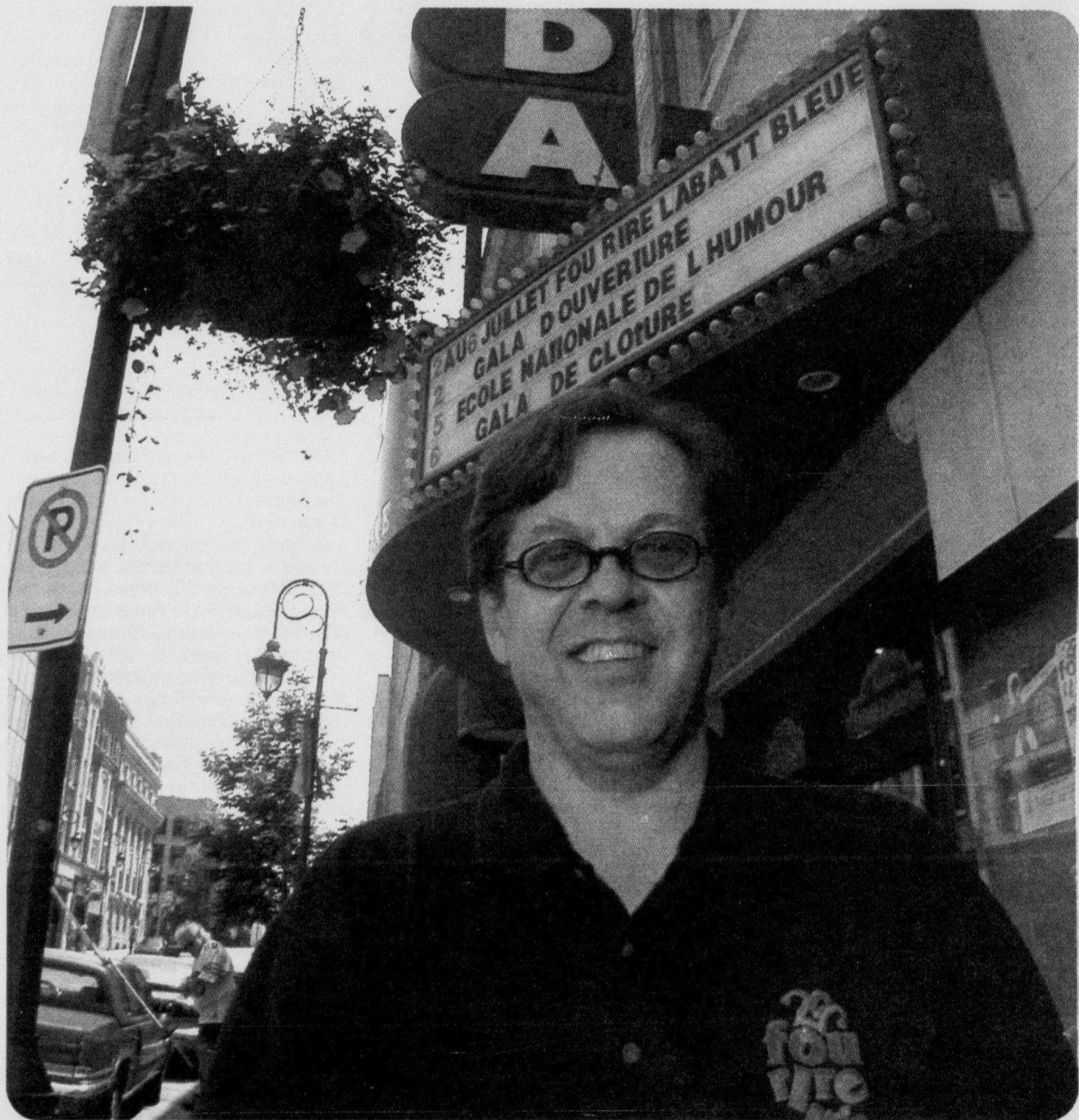
Montreal's Just for Laughs or the annual Grand Rire Bleue at the beginning of June in Quebec City.

Now in its third consecutive year, Fou Rire Labatt Bleue is going strong. With more than 70,000 visitors over the event's five days last year, Caza estimates a similar turnout next week to see the more than 100 performers who will take the stage and street.

Unlike the other festivals, though, Fou Rire has three important parts: free comedy on an outdoor stage on Wellington South, indoor gala performances at the Granada Theatre, and street performers.

Although the comedy is all in French, many of the street artists, whom Caza said have been an integral part of the event since its inception, are Anglophone.

Mint, peas give edge to light pasta

Weren't we all doubting summer would ever arrive? Well, it finally has — and these long-awaited hot days call for light dishes, served either cold or at room temperature.

Take this recipe, for example: papardelle with mint, bacon and peas. Despite those crispy little bacon bits (which could seem hearty, wintry stuff to some), it tastes just as good at room temperature as it would hot, thanks to the crunchy fresh mint and the smooth — yet creamless — sauce.

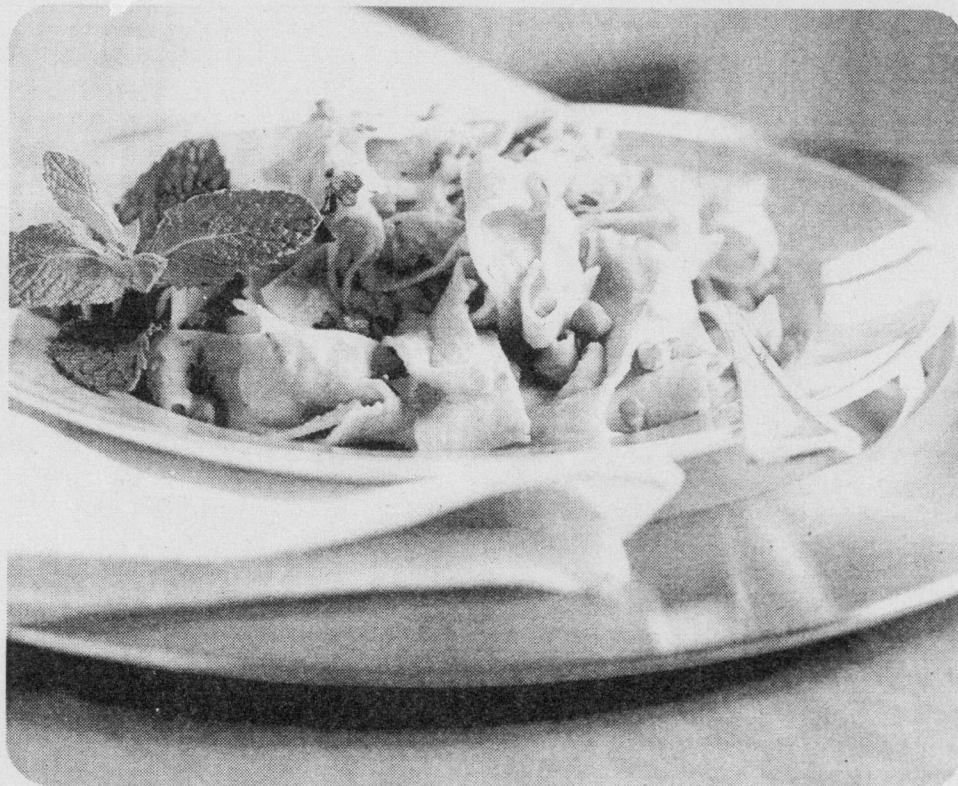
And before you ask, let me explain that papardelle is a wide and flat pasta, a bit uncommon around the Townships. So if you don't find it, just use tagliatelle or even spaghetti instead.

The important thing is not the shape of the pasta, but the way you cook and season it. So watch that boiling pot carefully, and don't let your pasta turn soggy.

One more thing: You can prepare the sauce and the other ingredients the day before and keep them in the fridge overnight. Perfect for those nights when you just want to quickly toss something together for dinner.

INGREDIENTS (FOR FOUR PEOPLE)

400 grams papardelle
30 large mint leaves
1 cup milk
1 tbsp. butter
1 small onion
400 grams bacon
1 cup frozen peas
1 cup canned peas



200 grams real Italian Parmesan salt and freshly-ground pepper

DIRECTIONS

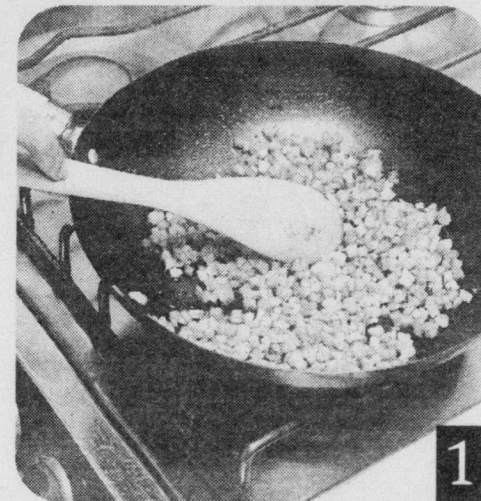
1. Grate the Parmesan. Thaw the frozen peas. Cut the bacon into small pieces and fry it in low heat until most of its fat melts, and the pieces become crispy and golden. Remove from heat, strain using a metal colander, and discard the fat. Set the bacon aside.

2. Peel and finely chop the onion. Using the same frying pan, sauté it in the butter, until translucent. In the meantime, bring a large pot of water to the boil. Add the frozen and canned peas to the frying pan, saving a spoon-

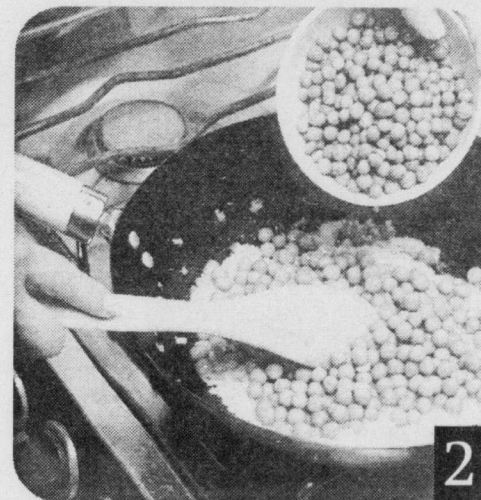
ful of frozen ones to garnish the finished dish. Add the milk, and some salt and pepper. Let it cook for just a couple of minutes.

3. Purée this pea and onion mix in a blender and adjust the salt and pepper if necessary. By this point, the water should be boiling in the large pot. Add salt and some drops of oil, and cook the pasta until al dente.

4. Chop the mint coarsely. Drain the pasta and transfer it to a big bowl. Toss it with the pea sauce, the bacon and the mint, and garnish with mint and the peas that were set aside for that purpose. Serve with the grated Parmesan on the side.

Pizza salad combines best of seasons

Is it a salad or a pizza? It's both! If the weather's hot, there's no need to cut pizza out of the weekly menu plan, just serve your warm pizza crust with cold toppings.

Get started on this quick and easy crowd-pleaser by popping the pizza crusts in the oven. While the crusts are heating, prepare the toppings. Spread the hot crusts with creamy boursin cheese seasoned with garlic and fine herbs, then sprinkle with fresh salad toppings. With just a light drizzle of olive oil and vinegar, dinner is ready to serve.

For dessert, top premium vanilla ice cream with sliced fresh strawberries.

INGREDIENTS (MAKES 4 TO 6 SERVINGS)

2 (12-inch/30 cm) purchased, prebaked thin pizza crusts
1 (125 g) tub light boursin cheese (with garlic and fine herbs)
1 small red bell pepper, chopped
1 small yellow bell pepper, chopped
1/2 small English cucumber, quartered lengthwise, then cut crosswise into thin slices (about 1 1/2 cups/375 mL)
1 cup (250 mL) grape tomatoes, halved
1/2 cup (125 mL) pitted kalamata olives, halved
1 cup (250 mL) crumbled feta cheese
2 tablespoons (25 mL) finely chopped green onions or fresh chives
2 tablespoons (25 mL) extra-virgin olive oil

2 tablespoons (25 mL) balsamic vinegar
Salt and pepper

DIRECTIONS

1. Bake pizza crusts directly on oven rack at 375 F for 10 minutes.

2. For each pizza, spread half the boursin cheese evenly over pizza crust. Top with half of each of the red and yellow bell peppers, cucumber, tomatoes, olives and feta cheese. Sprinkle with half the green onions. Drizzle with half the oil and vinegar. Sprinkle with salt and pepper to taste.

TIPS: Substitute 2/3 cup (150 mL) spreadable herb cream cheese for boursin cheese. Also, to save time, buy pitted kalamata olives and packaged crumbled feta cheese.

TLB pulling out all the stops

Theatre Lac Brome's 18th season is already upon us, and the local professional stage company is pulling out all the stops.

TLB will present three production during their 2003 summer repertory season, including a Cole Porter musical, a Shavian classic, and an original play conceived by the Theatre's artistic director Nicholas Pynes.

The building, now designated Arts Knowlton Playhouse, has also undergone renovations during the off-season. It now offers an 'Art Walk' with featured artwork lining the corridor, in addition to a new entrance on Mont Echo Road.

The Theatre board bought the building, formerly dubbed the Knowlton Pub Playhouse, last winter after years of renting. It took the non-profit group less than one year to raise \$350,000, enough money to purchase its longtime home.

Pynes is almost ebullient about the ownership status, and the whole concept of Arts Knowlton.

"This is an audacious undertaking," he admitted. "Here, we are an English based theatre in Quebec in 2003, we have this Arts Centre in the Townships, and we have enough interest to sustain it. Theatre is a particular activity that a lot of people in this area respond to and enjoy, whether it is professional or amateur."

Pynes is commemorating the recent changes at an opening night party this Saturday. Unlike previous years, Pynes noted that this Saturday will not be the premiere of the Theatre's first play. Instead, it will be a variety show, much

like the last performance of 2002. Pynes found the novel closing last year was so successful, both critically and with audiences, that he has decided to "start the season as we closed it."

"We are calling it the Arts Knowlton Follies," he noted. "We want to celebrate what has gone on this past year due to the capital campaign. We have completed phase one of our capital campaign, and are working on phase two."

Pynes also noted that The Follies is an all-inclusive night, with scenes from the amateur groups who have presented shows in the past year, as well as performances from the professional actors who are here this summer.

"Our actors will do their own thing, not just scenes from the upcoming shows," continued Pynes. "Although we will do a few songs from our Cole Porter musical, though not in the same style. It will be similar to last year's closing show — an evening of cabaret style, a vaudeville."

Long time Theatre Lac Brome patrons will also be interested to know that Alec Patterson will be appearing on opening night. Patterson was one of the original group that created the Theatre almost 20 years ago.

TLB's repertory season will get underway July 3 with the presentation of *You Never Know*, a Cole Porter musical written in 1938 and set in Paris in the 1920s. A remake of *By Candlelight*, this is an unusual musical that has a very small cast of six actors.

The idea of doing a Porter piece came from Pynes's love of Porter. A skilled pianist, Pynes stumbled on the show by accident while looking through his Cole Porter songbook and finding the name

You Never Know associated with some of the songs.

Porter, as Pynes notes, represents "the best English theatre writing from the American musical stage. *You Never Know* is a chamber musical originally written for a small cast. I read the script and thought it pleasant. I knew some of the songs, while there were many I didn't know."

Porter fans will recognize numbers such as 'Let's Misbehave,' 'Riding High,' and 'At Long Last Love' among others.

"We have done quite a few country music shows recently, and we did a Blues musical, so this is a bit of a change," noted Pynes.

Tickets for the opening on June 28 are \$50 (\$35 for voucher holders), and include the cocktail party.

Last of the Red Hot Lovers at the Piggery

Actors Glen Bowser and Karen Cromar are likely all too familiar with the old showbiz adage 'the show must go on' — well, the show did go on Tuesday night at the Piggery Theatre in Saint-Catherine-de-Hatley. In fact, it went on in front of only about a dozen people.

The classic Neil Simon play opened at the struggling Townships theatre June 17 and runs five days a week through July 5.

Directed by Clint Ward, *Last of the Red Hot Lovers* is the story of Barney Cashman, a middle-aged man who wants desperately to feel alive. He tries unsuccessfully to commit adultery in

his mother's staid New York City apartment with a succession of women.

Karen Cromar, who played weathered sex kitten Elaine Navazio, scatterbrained pot head Bobbi Michele, and mousy housewife Jeanette Fisher, was convincing in her various transformations. Her most successful caricature was Navazio, the blond, chain-smoking, booze-guzzling broad who was looking for a quick noontime romp.

The timing was just right in the first act, but the actors appeared to lose momentum by the final act, cracking jokes and trading jabs without the sorely needed punctuation of a full theatre's laughter.

Sporting a few different, but equally repugnant, blue suits, Bowser slouched

and slumped his way through the performance, aptly capturing the pathetic fish restaurant owner who was unable to follow through in his attempt to have an affair.

It was hard to tell if the three-act play billed as "a laugh a minute" really delivered Tuesday night in the nearly empty theatre. A Neil Simon comedy needs an audience, and an audience needs an audience. Laughter prompts laughter, things just seem funnier if other people think so

too.

Exhibition a primer for conservation projects next year

For Chantal Lagassé, the current railway exhibition at the Sherbrooke Historical Society was a very personal project. Lagassé, a Sherbrooke native, has always been intrigued by the area's past, its place as a crossroads of cultures and industries within the northeast.

"What I wanted to do was make the people of Estrie conscious of their history," said the artist with a Master's degree in clothing design.

Although brief, the exhibition she has curated documents the mass exodus from Quebec southward in the second half of the 19th century. Unable to find farmland in Quebec, many French Canadian men took their families through the rail hub of Sherbrooke and down to New England to work in the U.S.'s abundant factories.

From 1840 to 1930, almost one million French Canadians, including many of Lagassé's own ancestors, made the trek, what her mother referred to as 'la grande affaire.'

In addition to a series of informative placards, the Historical Society exhibition brings together a few interesting old photos, some sound ef-

fects on headphones and a National Film Board video with a wide variety of train footage.

But the small show is just the first stage, an introduction to the subject. Lagassé will give a more comprehensive treatment next year when restoration of Sherbrooke's two oldest stations will commence. Both the Depot St. Station, built in 1852 and rebuilt in 1890, and the Canadian Pacific station at Belvédère and Frontenac, also built in 1890, were classified as National and Provincial Heritage sites last year during Sherbrooke's 200th anniversary. The City has announced it will restore the currently barricaded landmarks starting next year in what will probably be a joint effort of all three levels of government.

"In Sherbrooke and Estrie we have really beautiful stations, and we should preserve them," said a happy Lagassé, ever mindful of the beauty around her.

But the structures are also important historical landmarks, she suggested, as the area's Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific lines were instrumental in Sherbrooke's development as an economically prominent south shore hub.


The brief but informative exhibition is on view Tuesday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday through Aug. 31 at the Sherbrooke Historical Society located at 275 Dufferin St.

Visitors wandering on Wellington can mingle with acrobats, fire dancers, musicians, jugglers and visual artists, so that, as Caza put it, "things are going on all over, rather than just a show where people are passive."

And since Caza, a Townshipper since age 13, mounts some 600 shows per year in the area through his production company, he knows a thing or three about engaging audiences.

"It's a festival for les Sherbrookoïis to come downtown and enjoy their city," he said, "but also to see a lot of different comedians from all over Quebec grouped together on the same stage."

Stand-up funny men and women from across the province, and one from Belgium, will appear onstage one right after the other at the Granada starting Wednesday night, and at the outdoor venue as of Thursday evening.

Established names such as Michel Barrette, Lévesque & Turcotte, Alain Dumas, Michaël Rancourt, Steeve Diamond, Pierre Verville, Julie Caron

and Patrick Groulx, among others, will be on view. While some comedians will try out new things, most bring their bread and butter, tried and true acts to the Sherbrooke stage.

"It's not of lower quality just because it's out in Estrie," assured Caza. With many of the same talents appearing in Sherbrooke are at the Montreal and Quebec festivals, Townshippers can see the same caliber, and often the very same acts, as at those more established events.

The opening and closing gala performances in the Granada Theatre are Wednesday, July 2 and Sunday, July 6 at 8 p.m. at a cost of \$23 or \$28. The National Humour School Gala is indoors Saturday night, \$13. Tickets are available at 822-2102 or at the Granada Theatre as of Monday.

Outdoor shows on Wellington South are every evening starting at 9 p.m., Thursday through Sunday. Street performers will circulate on Wellington South from 6 p.m. to midnight, Thursday to Sunday. The buzz will bubble over to Wellington North Saturday and Sunday evenings.

Five questions with Janna Kendall

Ayer's Cliff folk artist Janna Kendall is best known in the Eastern Townships for her paintings of local landmarks and her infectious smile. Her fondness for the area, in which she grew up, brings a special life to her paintings.

Although she has no formal teaching, her work is considered to be one of the many treasures that the area has to offer its visitors.

Kendall recently took time out to speak with *The Record*

THE RECORD: How did you first get interested in painting?

KENDALL: "I am basically a very shy person. Unlike many people who express themselves through the written word or a speech, I am more comfortable explaining myself through my painting. I enjoy working with vivid colours, using distinct lines of design to depict local scenes and landmarks."

THE RECORD: Will you still be exhibiting your paintings at local craft shows and fairs this year?

KENDALL: "Craft shows are not included in my schedule this summer. I will miss the contact with the people — the best part about doing these shows — but for now I am trying to concentrate on the marketing side of things. I still love to paint, but unfortunately it is also important to get out there and sell your work to be able to make a living at it. It is very time-consuming, and hopefully will be rewarding at the end of the road."

"I have been working with an excellent printing company who has helped me produce a really quality line of Christmas cards. I know no one wants to think about snow right now, but from now until September is when the retail buyers decide on the lines of products that they will be displaying at Christmas."

KENDALL: You say that your painting has changed somewhat lately. Could you tell us about it?

KENDALL: "As you will see on my Web site, I have been experimenting with what I call 'funky folklore'. My original paintings were clearly defined, well recognized, while the ones I have produced lately have a more subtle story to tell. Sometimes I explain what has been going through my head, but more often I like to let the viewer tell me what they see and thinks that it all means."

"A lot of the work that I have been doing lately has come out of dreams that I have had. I recently saw a vision of a massive white buffalo talking to an eagle in the midst of what seemed to be a great dust storm. I just knew that I had to paint that, even though I had never heard of a white buffalo. It wasn't until later that I found out that the white buffalo played an important part in the Indian culture — a symbol of peace and harmony."

KENDALL: "Are you still selling your line of soap and scented oils products?"

JANNA: "I will continue to keep these special soaps and oils on hand. I first became interested in natural products when I had a problem with allergies. You really should try 'moaning muscles'. It is amazing how different oils affect you."

THE RECORD: You have also been known to visit schools and senior residents. Could you tell us about that?

KENDALL: I wish I could spend more time doing these things. I believe that it is important to share the enjoyment of painting. Everyone has a talent of some kind, but the real joy comes from sharing it with someone."

"I spent a delightful afternoon with a group of North Hatley Elementary School children this spring. I brought along all my paints and brushes, and the kids were amazed at what they could actually create. I also like to visit seniors' residents. They are so pleased to tell me their stories and watch while I try to make them come to life again. I think it is important to give back to the community whenever possible!"

Writer knows his way around a crime scene

Forty Words for Sorrow, the first novel to feature Algonquin Bay police detective John Cardinal, was a more than solid read: It was a suspenseful, compulsive psycho-killer thriller.

Inspired by the Karla Homolka/Paul Bernardo murders, the second novel by Toronto writer Giles Blunt was marked by its Canadian setting, the vivid gruesomeness of its crimes and the dark moral ambiguity of its protagonist. Blunt, who had written extensively for American TV (including a stint on Law & Order), clearly knew his way around a crime scene.

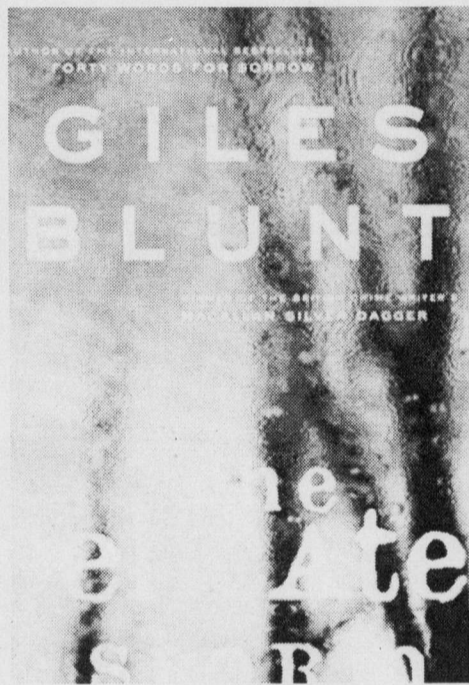
Impressive as it was, though, nothing in Forty Words for Sorrow prepares the reader for the creative leap Blunt makes in his new novel featuring Cardinal. The Delicate Storm begins with a rare day of warmth in the heart of an Ontario winter and the discovery of an American tourist's dismembered corpse in the forest outside Algonquin Bay.

Cardinal and Detective Lisa Delorme, along with RCMP Sergeant Malcolm Musgrave and a CSIS officer, investigate the murder. There is a frustrating lack of leads. Within days, a local doctor disappears. When her body is also found in the forest, Cardinal suspects a connection. There is one, and it's genuinely surprising.

As Cardinal and Delorme find their investigation blocked by various government forces, the trail seems to lead back to 1970's October Crisis and the legacy of the War Measures Act. In Montreal, Cardinal and Delorme discover that the sentiments of those dark days three decades past still linger and that former members of the Front de Libération du Québec, now living respectable lives, may be driven to murder to conceal their pasts.

The mystery at the centre of The Delicate Storm is intriguing, well considered and original. This is not a novel that relies on coincidence; Blunt writes of old-fashioned police work, its legwork and interviews aided by cutting-edge technology.

The dialogue feels completely natural. As for Blunt's use of Canadian history and current events, it's refreshing to have them — and not merely our landscape — as



a novel's backdrop.

The Delicate Storm is not a suspense novel per se. It largely avoids bloodshed. Instead, it's a character-centred examination of the lingering forces of guilt and betrayal, loyalty and violence. Key to this is Blunt's slow, convincing development of Det. John Cardinal. As he settles into writing a series of novels featuring him, he seems to relax, allowing for thorough, intimate, subtle knowledge of his character.

Cardinal is faced with more than a police officer's standard pressures. His wife, Catherine, who in Forty Words for Sorrow was institutionalized for recurring dementia, is home with him. He's estranged from his daughter, who's now living in New York, and bedevilled by the building sexual chemistry between himself and Lisa Delorme.

His final confrontation with the murderer, as an ice storm rages around them, is underscored by his sense of guilt and mortality, his own losses and regrets. It's a stirring scene — one that seems destined to resonate into the next Cardinal novel, which can't arrive soon enough.

The powerful vs. The weak

Foreign policy, like every domain of activity, has its theorists. Some of them reach the pinnacle and the popularity that goes with it. Henry Kissinger and Samuel P. Huntington, are among this club's select. They explain and inspire.

Robert Kagan, an author and foreign policy expert, is also among this category. As the new mentor of the American neo-conservative movement, he defends and promotes the unilateralist vision of US actions in the world. For him, America has no reason to be shy of its power and capabilities. Quite the contrary.

There was a time, in history, when the infant United States was a weak country, while its European counterparts were at the top of their game. In the last century, the roles were reversed. The United States is now strong and powerful, while Europe is weak.

Drawing lessons from Hobbes, the former believes "international laws and rules are unreliable, and where true security and the defence and promotion of a liberal order still depend on the possession and use of military might," while the later is faithful in the "perpetual peace" of Immanuel Kant. Such is the theory offered by Robert Kagan, in his latest book, *Of Paradise and Power*.

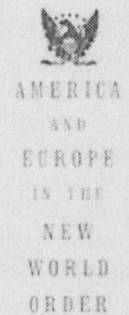
But being master of the world order doesn't happen magically. This requires power and force.

Actually, the U.S. holds such power, but on the other side of the Atlantic, Europe just can't impose such an order. Hence, the tolerance of rogue régimes — like the Saddam Hussein's former regime — does not come from mere tolerance, but from weakness.

In Kagan's view, one of the reasons that underlies Europe's situation is the unwillingness of its governments to invest in the defence sector. Europe lacks hard power. After the war in Iraq, the divide between the two worlds, which was masked by the necessities of the Cold War, is now more than apparent.

Needless to say, this situation — or confrontation — nurtures a gap between the two worlds. But Kagan supports the fact that if Europe can pretend to live without the necessities of power politics, it's because Americans are there to maintain peace on the planet. "By providing security from outside, the United States rendered it unnecessary for Europe's

supranational government to provide it. Europeans did not need power to achieve peace, and they do not need power to preserve it." In other words, America, with its foreign policy, defends the world with generosity.

Kagan's book is not a tortuous read, and unlike some other tomes on foreign policy, it is not boring. Using witty prose, he writes that "the United States does act as an international sheriff, self-appointed perhaps, but widely welcomed nevertheless, trying to enforce some peace and justice in what Americans see as a lawless world where outlaws need to be deterred or destroyed, often through the muzzle of a gun. Europe, by this Wild West analogy, is more like the saloonkeeper. Outlaws shoot sheriffs, not saloonkeepers." Briefly said, Americans believe in the law of the jungle, while Europeans subscribe to the law of reason.

Reinhold Niebuhr, the famous American theologian, thought that "the sad duty of politics is to establish justice in a sinful world." There are many neoconservatives who share this belief. After reading *Of Paradise and Power*, it is easier to understand the missionary tendencies of the American foreign policy, for Robert Kagan dares to say loudly and clearly what many most probably think in silence.

Lucas relishes own death in the Hulk

Actor Josh Lucas cheers his own demise every time he watches Hulk.

He considers the villain he portrays to be so totally despicable that he's the first to shout "hooray!" when he witnesses his fate at the hands of an angry green monster who stands 15 feet high.

Lucas figures he's done a good job in the movie because both he and the audience hate this character so much. The 42-year-old actor plays a ruthless research scientist who is prepared to exploit the mutation that is the Hulk for his own benefit.

"The thing that really blew me away about this movie was how incredibly much compassion I had for this pathetic Hulk character. He's like a wild animal who is clawing out violently at everything around him to try and survive. My character is one of the people that causes him to go through this. From the moment I arrive, I'm asking — when's he gonna die?"

One of the most violent scenes in the movie involves a fight between Lucas and Eric Bana in the role of the young scientist who's transformed into the Hulk whenever he gets angry. Lucas did the early part of the scene with Bana, but later when Bana became the Hulk, Lucas had to imagine that he was continuing to battle the real thing instead of empty air that would later be filled in by a computer-generated image of the monster. But after two weeks of shooting, Bana still felt that he was being beaten up every day.

"All the events that happen to my character are actually self-perpetuated. They are me doing it to myself. Me smashing myself against the railing. Me throwing myself through the air against the ground over and over and over. You're always trying to figure out how to make it look like someone is doing it to you as opposed to you doing it to yourself.

"I didn't break anything, luckily. But I suffered horrible bruising and was mashed badly on a daily basis. Basically, if anything, I was just wildly sore."

Lucas costarred with Reese Witherspoon in last year's romantic comedy, Sweet Home Alabama, and has lately been in the B.C. interior shooting Unfinished Life with Jennifer Lopez and Robert Redford.

**NOT YOUR EVERYDAY
HORROR CHILLER**

Rising Canadian star Scott Speedman thinks audiences will be surprised by his next movie, Underworld,

in which he costars with Kate Beckinsale. Word is that the film is about vampires and werewolves — but Speedman says it's no ordinary horror chiller. It also promises to be an exciting action film.

Movie was worth it for Charlie's Angels

Shooting the new Charlie's Angels movie clearly had its hazards. Cameron Diaz's shapely body was black and blue after days of waging battle against a villainous Demi Moore.

Lucy Liu actually caught on fire.

Drew Barrymore also found herself in flames during the filming of Charlie's Angels: Full Throttle. But that wasn't all that happened to her: she almost lost her life due to a failure of the safety harness securing her to a car hurtling along at 100 kilometres an hour.

The three of them are putting their own stamp on the word "angelic" as they glide into the hotel ballroom and seat themselves before a barrage of microphones. A pony-tailed Diaz is in a pink top and low-rise jeans. Liu, wearing a powder blue sweater and white polka dot dress, is keeping her hair in place with chopsticks but before the press conference is over, she has released it and let it tumble over her shoulders. Barrymore, who's wearing black, doesn't appear to have done anything with her hair and lets it simply hang down.

The accent is on friendship and camaraderie from three actresses whose exuberant teamwork in the first Charlie's Angels film three years ago grossed more than \$250 million U.S. Or as Lucy Liu puts it: "The first one was such a bonding experience that the second one was just like being with your friends and family and spending time together and making something creative and fun and also incredibly entertaining."

In this case, it seems that the physical mishaps merely enhanced that fellowship — and a collective determination not to be intimidated by a tough shoot.

Barrymore's car crisis occurred during the very first week of shooting, and she admits she nearly lost her nerve right then. She had wanted to get into the fearless mindset of angel Dylan Sanders, and she figured that this was one scene she didn't want to turn over to her stunt double. She ended up questioning her fearlessness and asking herself: Was she being stupid?

Barrymore, 28, has always been big on self-analysis — no more so than when examining her role as both producer and star of the two Charlie's Angels adventures. But right now, she's scrutinizing Drew the daredevil actress and risk-taker rather than Drew the cautious production overseer.

"In the moment, you get really pumped up with adrenaline and you feel that you're very immortal and there are all these stunt people around and you're just like — I can do it, I want to be stronger, I want to do the craziest thing

I've ever done so it works for the film. But when I was on the hood of that car, fishtailing at like 40 miles an hour down the bridge and that harness came off and I was actually holding on to that car for real and the guy stopped it and I slid down, I was like: 'Oh my god, I wasn't meant to die or get injured!'"

Then there was the fire incident. Lucy Liu, 34, who plays the intrepid Alex Munday, says she had just finished a scene in which the angels impersonate welders, and had sat down to munch a peanut butter and jelly sandwich when she started feeling "really hot."

Then she discovered that she was in flames. What happened was that their irrepressible director, McG, had decided he wanted more colour in the scene, so at the last moment each angel was given a final bit of costuming in the form of a

handkerchief. Unfortunately, the handkerchiefs were not fireproof — which meant they were vulnerable to welder's sparks.

Barrymore's posterior also caught on fire, but after the incident with the car, she saw this as a minor crisis and swiftly extinguished the flames. "I just smacked it a lot," she says nonchalantly, smacking her bottom by way of explanation.

The fire incident was caught on a video monitor. Liu says it was replayed constantly for the rest of shooting. "For example, I'd come back from changing my wardrobe, and I'd see everybody piled around the monitor laughing and I'd hear my voice screaming: Oh, my god! I'm on fire!" In the finished film opening June 27, the incident shows up in the end credits — and giggles Liu, "it's hilarious."

Cameron Diaz, who plays Natalie

Cook, the goofiest of the trio of angels, earned her war wounds tangling with a fearsomely fit Demi Moore who plays a fallen angel in the new Columbia release.

"Fighting Demi was awesome," Diaz, 30, reports. I was really excited about it — and she did a great job. She was really totally capable. She was so physical and so strong that it was really fun to fight her. We were head to head, so you're careful not to hurt one another, but at the same time you want to sell it. She's got a great drive. We're doing take after take of blocking punches and kicks and stuff and at the end of the day, you have welts all up and down your arms — but it feels SO good."

To Diaz, bruises are trophies. "Yeah, and they don't last very long so you want to get the most out of them."

For longtime Our Lady Peace fans, Live's selling point is its collection of material from the band's last two albums, not the least of which includes Somewhere Out There', Is Anybody Home' and Innocent'. For new fans, however, Live has that extra bonus of hearing the group play with the crowd or just jam (Naveed/Life is over nine minutes long). To top it off, Live also shows that Our Lady Peace's talent extends beyond the studio - they sound as flawless live as they do on their albums.

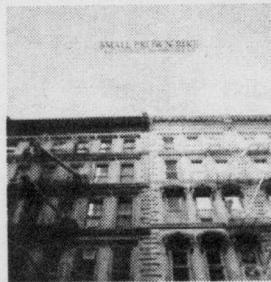

Movie was worth it for Charlie's Angels *Movies*

Shooting the new Charlie's Angels movie clearly had its hazards. Cameron Diaz's shapely body was black and blue after days of waging battle against a villainous Demi Moore.

Lucy Liu actually caught on fire.

Drew Barrymore also found herself in flames during the filming of Charlie's Angels: Full Throttle. But that wasn't all that happened to her: she almost lost her life due to a failure of the safety harness securing her to a car hurtling along at 100 kilometres an hour.

The three of them are putting their own stamp on the word "angelic" as they glide into the hotel ballroom and seat themselves before a barrage of microphones. A pony-tailed Diaz is in a pink top and low-rise jeans. Liu, wearing a powder blue sweater and white polka dot dress, is keeping her hair in place with chopsticks but before the press conference is over, she has released it and let it tumble over her shoulders. Barrymore, who's wearing black, doesn't appear to have done anything with her hair and lets it simply hang down.

The accent is on friendship and camaraderie from three actresses whose exuberant teamwork in the first Charlie's Angels film three years ago grossed more than \$250 million U.S. Or as Lucy Liu puts it: "The first one was such a bonding experience that the second one was just like being with your friends and family and spending time together and making something creative and fun and also incredibly entertaining."

In this case, it seems that the physical mishaps merely enhanced that fellowship — and a collective determination not to be intimidated by a tough shoot.

Barrymore's car crisis occurred during the very first week of shooting, and she admits she nearly lost her nerve right then. She had wanted to get into the fearless mindset of angel Dylan Sanders, and she figured that this was one scene she didn't want to turn over to her stunt double. She ended up questioning her fearlessness and asking herself: Was she being stupid?

Barrymore, 28, has always been big on self-analysis — no more so than when examining her role as both producer and star of the two Charlie's Angels adventures. But right now, she's scrutinizing Drew the daredevil actress and risk-taker rather than Drew the cautious production overseer.

"In the moment, you get really pumped up with adrenaline and you feel that you're very immortal and there are all these stunt people around and you're just like — I can do it, I want to be stronger, I want to do the craziest thing

I've ever done so it works for the film. But when I was on the hood of that car, fishtailing at like 40 miles an hour down the bridge and that harness came off and I was actually holding on to that car for real and the guy stopped it and I slid down, I was like: 'Oh my god, I wasn't meant to die or get injured!'"

Then there was the fire incident. Lucy Liu, 34, who plays the intrepid Alex Munday, says she had just finished a scene in which the angels impersonate welders, and had sat down to munch a peanut butter and jelly sandwich when she started feeling "really hot."

Then she discovered that she was in flames. What happened was that their irrepressible director, McG, had decided he wanted more colour in the scene, so at the last moment each angel was given a final bit of costuming in the form of a

handkerchief. Unfortunately, the handkerchiefs were not fireproof — which meant they were vulnerable to welder's sparks.

Barrymore's posterior also caught on fire, but after the incident with the car, she saw this as a minor crisis and swiftly extinguished the flames. "I just smacked it a lot," she says nonchalantly, smacking her bottom by way of explanation.

The fire incident was caught on a video monitor. Liu says it was replayed constantly for the rest of shooting. "For example, I'd come back from changing my wardrobe, and I'd see everybody piled around the monitor laughing and I'd hear my voice screaming: Oh, my god! I'm on fire!" In the finished film opening June 27, the incident shows up in the end credits — and giggles Liu, "it's hilarious."

Cameron Diaz, who plays Natalie

Cook, the goofiest of the trio of angels, earned her war wounds tangling with a fearsomely fit Demi Moore who plays a fallen angel in the new Columbia release.

"Fighting Demi was awesome," Diaz, 30, reports. I was really excited about it — and she did a great job. She was really totally capable. She was so physical and so strong that it was really fun to fight her. We were head to head, so you're careful not to hurt one another, but at the same time you want to sell it. She's got a great drive. We're doing take after take of blocking punches and kicks and stuff and at the end of the day, you have welts all up and down your arms — but it feels SO good."

To Diaz, bruises are trophies. "Yeah, and they don't last very long so you want to get the most out of them."

Strait returns to his roots

Music

George Strait has come full circle with the June release of *Honkytonkville*. The Texan's 31st album with MCA Nashville, the label he has called home since his 1981 debut 'Strait Country', is aptly titled — it's pure honky tonk music from beginning to end.

On his first studio disk since 2001's *Road Less Traveled*, Strait reunites with longtime co-producer Tony Brown (his 12th Strait record). The result is 12 songs that fit Strait like a glove. It's clear he is at ease crooning about honkytonks, truck-driving and love everlasting.

For *Honkytonkville*, the Lone Star State native has also chosen songs by some of the top songwriters in Nashville. Some of those include Bruce Robinson and Monte Warden, Anthony Smith and Bob DiPiero as well as Jim Lauderdale, Buddy Brock and Dean Dillon. They're all writers who have penned some of today's biggest country hits.

It was often said that Strait had a special gift for choosing the perfect songs, but there's more to it than just that. Strait has the ability of taking someone else's song and making it his own. Everything about the singer's talent is distinctive, from his interpretation to his shy ways to his stage presence.

Strait also has an innate talent to switch between songs about having a good time or aching over lost love. The album offers something for everyone, from twang to great ballads. The first single from the

album, 'Tell Me Something Bad About Tulsa' is good enough to become his record 51st country chart topper.

Fans will also enjoy some country classics like 'She Used To Say That To Me', and the rockin' piano, Haggard's style of 'I Found Jesus On The Jailhouse Floor'.

Honkytonkville also includes 'Look Who's Back From Town', which is about a man who loses his girlfriend to a rich city guy. Strait sings with pain: "My old truck could not compare to his Mercedes" but he still takes her back. It features great steel guitars work."

On the soaring 'Cowboys Like Us', Strait pays tribute to his home, while 'As Far As It Goes' features the singer's passionate romantic devotion.

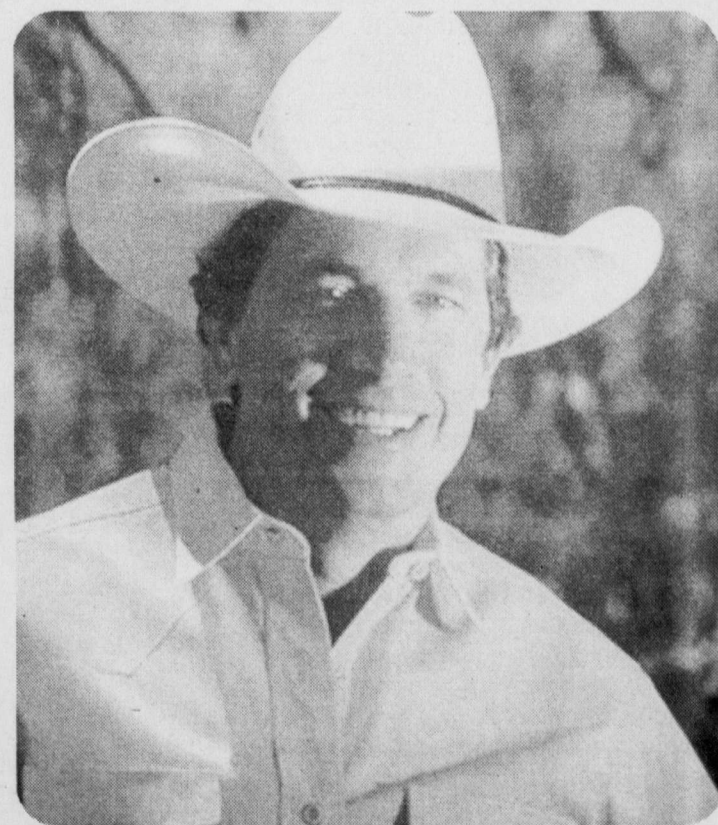
Something new for Strait is that he recorded all the vocals for *Honkytonkville* from his home studio instead of in Nashville. The record shows a much more centred singer who took the time to feel each song's emotion before laying down the track.

Strait stays true to his roots on *Honkytonkville*, and lives up to everyone's expectations by delivering another top notch album. This will easily be regarded as one of the best albums of this summer.
