WORLD'S NEWS IN BRIEF.

SERIOUS RIOTS IN FRENCH INDIA. Lord Salisbury Back in England—Important Tariff Decisions at Washington—North-West Ordinances to be Disallowed.

A corn agent of Pease has failed with liabilities of one million dollars. It is believed that other failures will be the result of the high prices of the harvest.

The Italian Committee on the Chicago World's Fair has been dissolved. The reason given is that few Italian houses care to send displays to America in the face of the high duties imposed by the McKinley tariff.

The importation of Dutch cattle into England has been prohibited owing to the prevalence of rinderpest among the cattle of the Netherlands. The trade was a small one compared with the American, but had an average of about \$400,000.

Russia has recently adopted a more liberal and vigorous policy than hitherto in respect to the mineral resources of the empire. Numerous special grants and licenses to work for coal, iron, copper, and other minerals, most of which are principally composed of foreign capitalists.

The Ontario miners who took the places of the strikers at Bull, N. S. W., were attacked on Thursday by the unionists who drove the non-union men and occupied the mines. The police were unable to cope with the strikers, and reinforcements have been sent to aid them in restoring order.

Despatches from Pondicherry, the capital of the French settlement in India, say a riot broke out in the city on Thursday between a mob and the police. During the riot several Europeans were wounded and property being looted.
