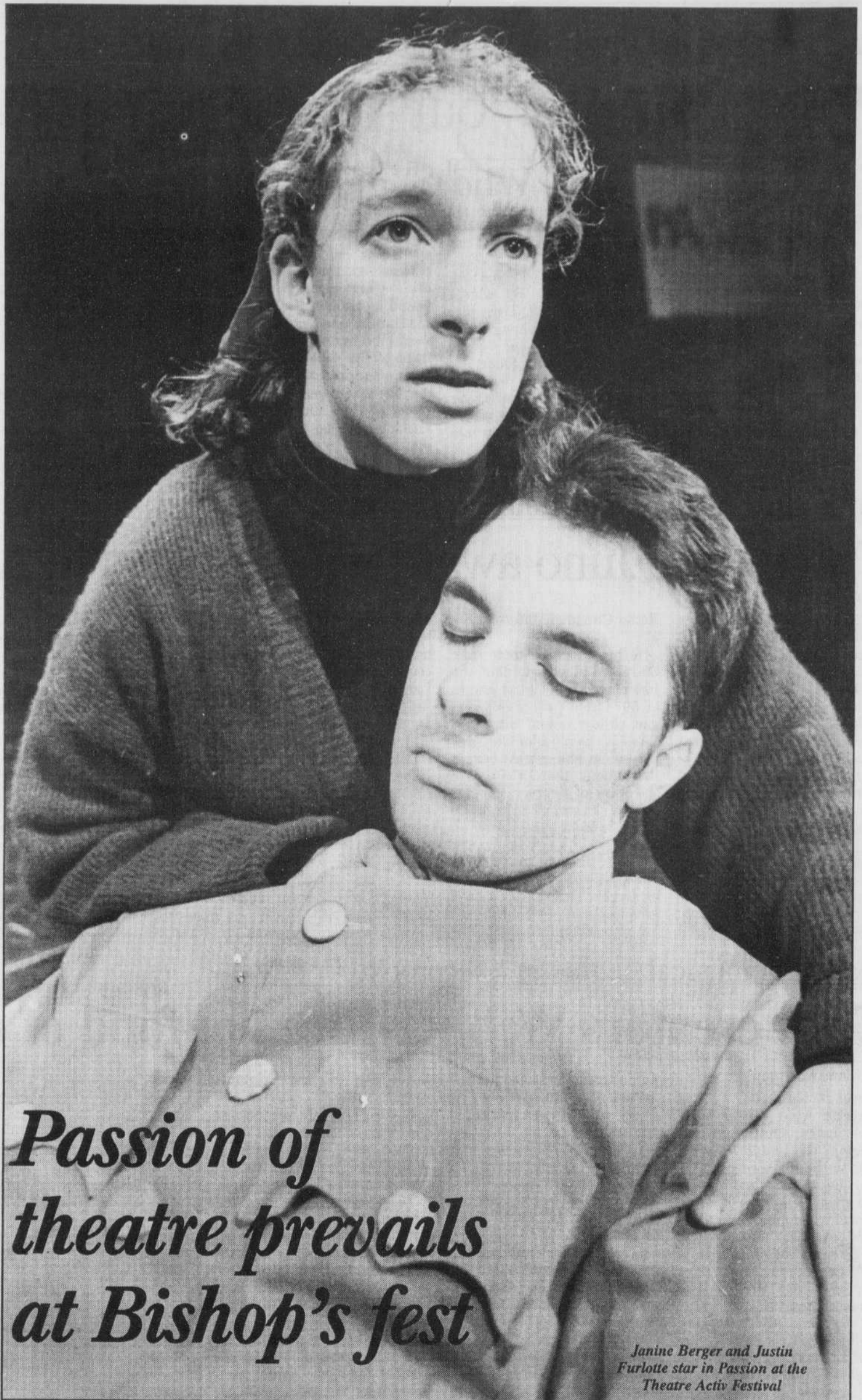

### Bill Usher at the Cliff House on Saturday

## Three-time Juno award winner plays in Ayer's Cliff

AYER'S CLIFF - Triple Juno winner Bill Usher will appear at the Cliff House pub on Saturday, Jan. 25, for an evening of music and storytelling.

Usher has had a varied career in the arts, wearing at various times the hats of radio journalist, T.V. and record producer, performing musician, actor and author. Some of his credits include four years at the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation as a freelancer, producing over 75 radio documentaries for shows like *Touch The Earth*, Gzowski on FM, *Concern* and

Radio Canadian Inter-national.

He has produced more than 60 record albums to date and has played on at least another 50 - from rock & roll, reggae, children's and folk.

As a percussionist, Bill played on the world's stages throughout the 1970's with the likes of Bruce Cockburn, Ronnie Hawkins, Valdy and dozens of other Canadian greats.

Bill is the winner of three Juno Awards - Canada's highest music award - two as a producer and one in 1987 for his own album *Drums!*. The

stage show of *Drums!* has been performed in concert halls and schools across the country from Happy Valley, Labrador to Hornby Island, B.C. including two appearances at Roy Thomson Hall in Toronto.

Following on its success, Usher wrote *Son of a Drum!* - a one-man performance that features his storytelling and music.

For his Cliff House performance, Usher will be accompanied by 19-year-old Ben Burton, a virtuoso guitar player.

Allan Fraser, formerly of

Fraser and DeBolt, will join Usher and Burton for a special guest appearance. Fraser is well-known to Townships folkies, having been based in the Sawyerville area in the 1970s.

Usher's most recent work, and perhaps his most passionate, has resulted in a new collection of timely songs entitled *Baby Boomers Go Boom!*; released as an independent CD on his own label, Bam Boom.

Usher continues to perform for all ages. He has recently returned from a three-week tour of the Yukon and B.C.

where he performed for a variety of audiences, including festivals, elementary and secondary schools and community concerts. Upon returning to Toronto, Bill and his four-piece band unveiled a concert 'workshop' of a new performance piece entitled heart beat. The evening was videotaped and Mixed Company director Luc Logna and Usher are currently at work shaping the songs and stories into an evening-length performance.

In spring of '96, Usher also released a five-song cassette titled *No Justice, No Peace*.

## Evita creators Webber-Rice not fond of each other

Director Alan Parker faced some hefty challenges in bringing the stage musical *Evita* to the big screen.

But he thinks his biggest coup may well have been to persuade composer Andrew Lloyd Webber and lyricist Tim Rice to collaborate on a new song, "You Must Love Me", especially for the film version.

At one time, the two were musical theatre's hottest new team thanks to *Jesus Christ Superstar* and *Joseph And His Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, as well as *Evita*. But they haven't worked together for more than a decade, and a couple years ago Rice publicly trashed a

new Lloyd Webber-initiated version of *Joseph*, saying it failed to show an ounce of originality.

"I think it's fair to say that they're not overly fond of one another," Parker says. "They have a truly strange relationship which I truly don't understand. It's a very English, upper middle-class public schoolboy type of relationship which is a complete mystery to me." (Parker prides himself on his working class origins).

Parker needed help from both Lloyd Webber and Rice in preparing for the film which captured a bouquet of Golden Globe awards last weekend, including one for Parker, one for star Madonna and another for "You Must

Love Me", as best original song.

"It was very difficult getting the two of them together," Parker now says of Lloyd Webber and Rice. So getting a new song out of them proved an unexpected bonus.

After much prodding, the two teamed up for a work session in France. Parker reports that "they managed to be nice to one another but I can't see it continuing. It was a huge strain for both of them."

The continuing deep freeze will disappoint those Lloyd Webber fans who think that apart from the special case of T.S. Eliot, whose poetry was the inspiration for *Cats*, the composer hasn't had a first-class lyricist since he and Rice parted company.

LENNOXVILLE -- Jeunesses Musicales of Canada will bring the comic Italian opera *The Barber of Seville* to Lennoxville this weekend.

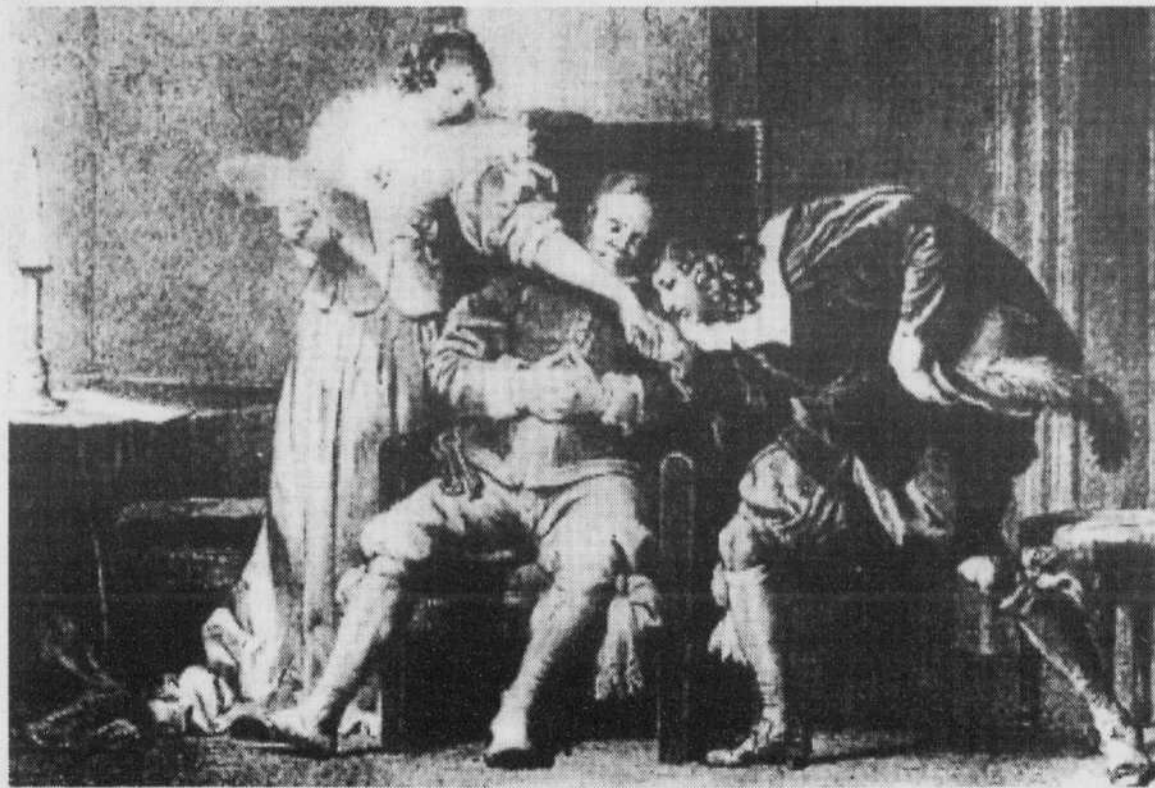

# White winning over audiences with his maturity

Bryan White has been seen as a role model for teenagers for a while now he and although it hasn't gone to his head, it's something that he doesn't take lightly.

This brilliant young country singer didn't spare any efforts to please his fans and do a great job in the trade he picked. The 22-year-old's sheer talent and clean-cut image along with his work was rewarded this past October as he became the youngest artist to win the Country Music Association Horizon Award.

White is definitely the leader of the youth pack, his popularity has blossomed in part because to his all-ages shows. Dismayed at seeing young listeners shut out of his honkytonk performances because they weren't permitted to go in clubs, White decided to stage special matinee performances for them.

He is considered a representative or spokesman for "young country" but both his feet are firmly on the ground.

"There are just a lot of fabulous young artists out there," he has said.

#### DIFFERENT STYLES

"There's not one of us the same," he said recently. "We've learned to be open-eyed and attentive to our audience. We all have different backgrounds, different influences and we're not ashamed of them. The way I do something might be totally different from the way Wade Hayes or Rick Trevino would do it."

The baby-faced singer has already reached gold status with his Bryan White debut album and scored a series of No. 1 and top country singles such as "Look At Me Now," "Rebecca Lynn," "Someone Else's Star," "I'm Not Supposed To Love You Anymore" and "So Much For Pretending." He's now achieving more success with his second effort, *Between Now and Forever*.

White's parents divorced when he was quite young, but no matter which household he visited, music was always around him. The young performer began playing drums at age 5 and was on stage before he reached his teens.

When he turned 17, White switched to guitar, began writing songs and made the decision to make music his profession with a gutsy move

to Nashville following high school graduation.

"Mowing lawns and fishing were the only two options I could even think of besides music," White has said. "It was pretty scary to make the move at the time, but when you are that young, I think you feel invincible to a certain extent. Everybody is full of hopes when they first move to Nashville - and those hopes are so strong that nothing can discourage you."

#### DETERMINED

You do not accomplish what White did if you're not a positive and determined person.

"When I set my mind to do something and say I'm gonna do it, I just have to do it. I knew I wanted to sing. I knew I wanted to play. I knew I wanted to write. I didn't think about anything else. I just packed up and left."

Barely three months after his arrival in Music City, White had already found a staff songwriter's job and artist management deal with Glen Campbell Music. Everything fell into place when he was signed to Asylum Records, he was just 20 when he began recording his debut album. During his career launching year, White performed more than 200 concerts and travelled throughout Canada and the United States.

At that time, White opened shows for Pam Tillis, Tracy Lawrence and Diamond Rio. No band, no back-up whatsoever, just his acoustic guitar. It was an experience that honed his playing and developed his amazingly mature stage presence.

"It was tough," White has said. "There was no one to hide behind and no one to catch me if something went

wrong. I learned a lot and I think the experience made me a much better player and singer."

The time came when he was able to hire a band which gave his show another perspective and things started changing. He began to hear his voice on radio stations everywhere. Audiences began to sing along. Girls began to scream. Somewhere along the way, he grew up fast.

One of the reasons why he appeals to teens so much is that he got a lot of exposure in teen magazines - a first for a country artist.

#### NEW PERSPECTIVE

White's fresh interpretation and youthful perspective have drawn interest from some of Nashville's finest songwriters. White, who was a sought-after demo singer, now collaborates with some of the writers he admired when he moved to Nashville,

including Bob DiPiero, Gerry House, Lonnie Wilson and many others.

The young singer has taken the weight of celebrity in stride, but not for granted. After the tragic Oklahoma City bombing in April 1995, White, who grew up near the city, organized a benefit that raised more than \$60,000 to provide scholarships for children injured and orphaned in the blast. This was part of the way for White to give a little back of what he has been getting out of his career, his life and his fans.

White is really overwhelmed by his career.

"I really didn't expect for half of this to happen to me in the amount of time that it did," White has said. "We were hoping to maybe have one hit record in two or three years. It just seemed like everything we did took it up to a different level."

Now comes the best part of it all, we'll get a chance to hear Bryan White performing at the next Champlain Valley Fair in August. White will be opening for another of your favorite stars, Vince Gill.

Get ready for a fantastic show. White will take you on a multi-textured exploration of moods and meanings while singing hits from his two albums with the help of his expressive tenor and his mature professionalism.

The time when White was wishing on "Someone Else's Star" is long gone, now he has his own.

## Two student-penned plays at Theatre Activ

LENNOXVILLE — Lori McHarg and Alison McElwain will have the joy of seeing plays they have written performed during Bishop's University's 12th annual Theatre Activ Drama festival.

The student-penned plays will be among 10 featured at the festival, running from Jan. 28 to Feb. 2.

McHarg's *Voices* was created as a final assignment for her playwriting class. Having her work chosen for the festival was a major thrill.

"I never thought I would be acknowledged as a playwright," she said, adding at first she was hesitant about submitting the play for the festival.

"But then I thought it wouldn't hurt to try," she said. "When David (Moase, co-ordinator) told me that my play was chosen, I couldn't believe it. I was shocked. It was wild. I mean, I was up against plays that were professionally written!"

*Voices*, about a girl named Alice who is dealing with dyslexia, is a play that is very personal to McHarg. She said she drew from personal experiences to write about someone who learns to overcome being different.

Following Alice from age five to 16, the play traces her relationship with a boy named Bobby. As young children, they are first seen playing together, then Bobby behaves cruelly to Alice. Finally, at 16, he realizes his actions as a child were wrong, while Alice realizes she can do anything as long as she believes in herself.

"You have to believe in yourself," said McHarg. "Anyone can believe in you, but if you don't believe in yourself, you won't succeed."

Having her play selected for the festival has given McHarg the confidence she needed to continue writing.

"I have a lot of ideas," she said. "It's something I could use to continue in theatre."

For McElwain, writing *The Characters Of Lennoxville* was like a history lesson.

"I was hired by the town to write a play about the history to celebrate its 125th anniversary," she said. "It was supposed to be presented in October, but was postponed until now."

It tells the story of people who actually lived in Lennoxville. After doing some

research and conducting interviews, McElwain put these characters in different situations based on the facts. She describes the play as a compilation of stories that form a collage. The same characters are followed for a day in each of the four seasons, with a decade separating each season.

One of these characters is Nellie McCurdy.

"She was the leader of the Lennoxville Women's Christian Temperance Society," said McElwain. "They were advocates of banning all forms of alcohol in town. They stopped the opening of a third hotel in town, and stopped the church from serving wine with mass."

Another interesting historical figure is Gabriel Carron.

"He was the first French

person to settle in Lennoxville and a very prominent member of the community," she said.

The starting point for much of McElwain's writing came from the memories of Bishop's oldest living graduate, Dorothy Dutton.

"She was very helpful," McElwain recalled. "Every time we met she had a new detail to add to her stories

that would make the play more real."

*The Characters Of Lennoxville* will be presented once only, on Sunday, Feb. 2, at 2 p.m. *Voices* will be performed twice, on Jan. 30 and Feb. 2, at 8 p.m. All plays will be presented at Bishop's University's Studio Theatre.

# Bishop's drama fest spotlights student talent

LENOXVILLE — Bishop's University students once again get their chance to spread their dramatic wings at the 12th annual Theatre Activ festival of short plays.

Ten plays — two written by students — will be performed from Jan. 28 to Feb. 2.

Co-ordinators Erin Kemp and David Moase preside over a diverse selection of plays that aren't necessarily linked by a common theme.

"Each play was chosen on its own merit," said Moase. "It's good to have a broad range, from comedy and drama to experimental."

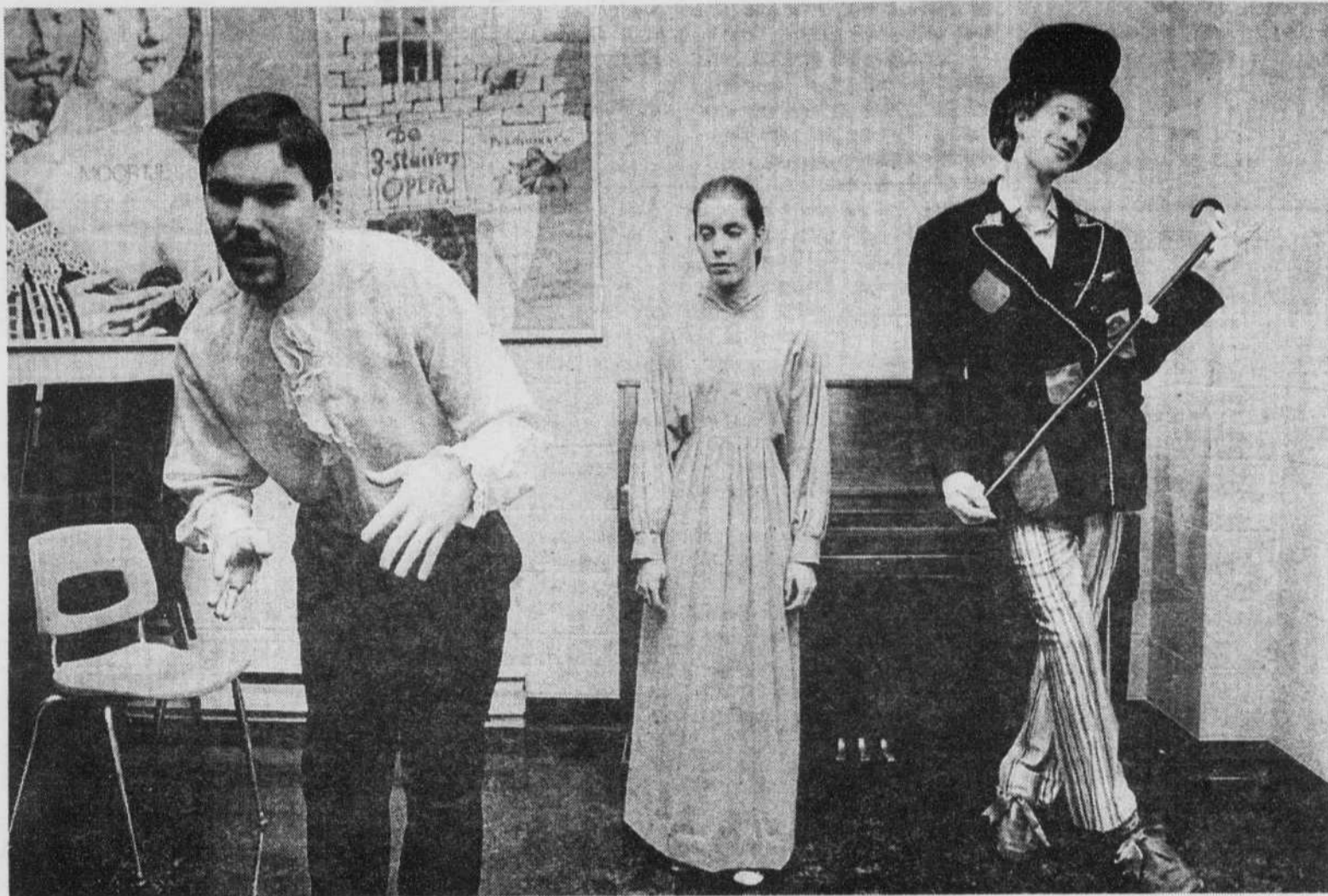
The plays have been divided into three different lineups, which will each be performed twice over the six nights.

"Each night will start with a comedy, then a drama, then probably finish off with something lighter," said Moase. "That way you won't go home feeling down."

The only exception is *The Characters of Lennoxville*, a play written by student Alison McElwain for the town's 125th anniversary celebrations last year. Originally scheduled for the fall, it will be performed once only, a matinee on Sunday, Feb. 2.

The second student work is *Voices* by Lori McHarg.

The Theatre Activ Festival allows students to put togeth-

er a theatrical production from inception to realization.

"It's basically run and organized by students with very little supervision," said Ian Kemp, a drama graduate directing *Passion* by Edward

Bond.

Alanna Mason, a fourth-year drama student who is directing *Maker of Dreams*, said they get to do what they want.

"There are no strict guide-

lines on what to do," she said. "We're not graded on this. It's done all in our own free time, by our own initiative. We put in as much effort as we want to."

This is Mason's first experience as a director.

"I'm more interested in the acting," she said. "I've worked in other Theatre Activ's. It's a learning experience. We have to do everything — costumes, building sets — try to do things we've never done before."

Kyla Piper, director of *Women and Wallace* by Jonathan Sherman, said the festival is a chance for people to experience the stage.

More than drama students flex their creative muscles at the fest. All Bishop's students were given a chance to submit plays for consideration as well as audition for parts.

"People who wouldn't normally act have come to audition," Piper said, pointing out that of the nine cast members in *Women and Wallace*, only three are drama majors.

"I think it's a good confidence-builder for people and a good way for people to get experience," she said. "It's a way for meeting people. The bonding experience is very intense for such a short peri-

od of time."

Thirty-two plays were read by festival organizers in late October. Then, when the final 10 were chosen, auditions were held the last weekend of November, leaving few precious weeks after the holidays for designing the sets and costumes and rehearsing the plays.

Though cramming so much work along with classes and assignments in such a short period may seem daunting, Kemp remains positive:

"It shows us what it's like in the real world."

The 12th annual Theatre Activ Festival runs from Jan. 28 to Feb. 2. The schedule is as follows: On Jan. 28 and 31 — *Women and Wallace*, *Watermelon Boats*, *Waiting For Lefty*. On Jan. 29 and Feb. 1 — *Passion*, *Maker of Dreams*, *This Is A Play*. On Jan. 30 and Feb. 2 — *Swimmers*, *Voices*, *Lone Star*. On Sunday, Feb. 2 at 2 p.m. only — *The Characters of Lennoxville*.

Tickets for each night's performance cost \$6 and can be purchased either at the door or by calling the Centennial Theatre box office at (819) 822-9692. All evening performances start at 8 p.m.

## Lucas brings out Special Edition of his classic films Two decades later the force is still with *Star Wars*

OTTAWA — The original game plan was modest: to return George Lucas's legendary *Star Wars* trilogy to a few selected cinemas — no more than 100, possibly as few as 25 — across North America in 1997.

But the response of the public to the promise of such an event was anything but modest when Lucas and 20th Century Fox decided on a cautious testing of the waters with a teaser trailer. They simply weren't prepared for the reaction to its test-screening at a single Los Angeles movie house in the spring of 1996.

"The moment the Lucasfilm logo came up, everybody just went insane," producer Rick McCallum marvels. "For the first 40 seconds you couldn't hear the voice-over at all. At the end there was this standing ovation — and it was just for a trailer!"

"Until that night we had thought that the chances of releasing it on any wide scale were pretty impossible. We felt we would be bringing it back mainly for those hardcore fans who had grown up with the film and wanted their children to see it on the big screen. We saw it as a pretty minimal effort."

"Suddenly we realized that something was going on here — something bigger than all of us," McCallum recalls by phone from California.

Lucas decided that maybe the reborn *Star Wars* would get away with opening on as many as 500 screens. Then the number was upped to 700, then 1,000, then 1,500. Theatre chains were clamoring for the chance to show a movie trilogy that was first launched two decades ago and

that has long been available on TV and video.

Which is why, come Jan. 31, some 2,000 screens will be welcoming back Luke Skywalker, Princess Leia, Han Solo, R2-D2, C-3PO, Obi-Wan, Darth Vader and all the other members of Lucas's galactic gallery. The two succeeding films in the *Star Wars* trilogy — *The Empire Strikes Back* and *Return Of The Jedi* — arrive later, on Feb. 21 and March 7 respectively.

The Lucas people refuse to call the package a "reissue." Instead, the official tag is the *Star Wars Trilogy Special Edition*: a 20th anniversary celebration of a phenomenon that changed the face of movie entertainment.

It's also the fulfilment of Lucas's dream of finally giving audiences the films he always wanted to make. That means new visual effects, a freshly minted soundtrack — and some moments that will

surprise even the most knowledgeable *Star Wars* addict.

Lucas is so fussy about making the proper impact this time that he is restricting the trilogy to movie houses equipped with full digital sound.

The legendary filmmaker only directed the first movie, but he was very much the hands-on producer for its two successors. And for two decades he has been saying that the trilogy was an unfinished work.

"George always felt this way," McCallum says. "His frustration came from the technological restraints and the financial compromises he had to make. George always felt compromised in not having the time, money and technology to do what he wanted to do."

Today, it's a different story. But back in the mid 1970s, Lucas had to fight to get *Star Wars* made. Studios like

Universal and United Artists thought he had lost his reason when he showed up with his 13-page treatment for a film project about interplanetary war. And when Fox finally said yes, it imposed a stiff budget ceiling of \$10 million U.S.

That initial investment spawned a trilogy that has now earned \$1.3 billion U.S. in worldwide box-office sales and a further \$3 billion in licensing fees for *Star Wars* merchandise. It also spawned the creation of Lucas's pace-setting International Light And Magic special effects empire — responsible among other things for the computerized dinosaurs in *Jurassic Park* — and made him one of the most powerful figures in Hollywood.

And it gave Lucas the clout to recreate this "Special Edition" *Star Wars* and a further incentive finally to proceed with a long-promised second trilogy whose release

will begin in 1999.

Ironically, the technological genius of the Lucas organization faced some of its severest testing in bringing the restored trilogy to the screen this winter. It almost didn't happen because of the poor condition of the original *Star Wars* film stock.

So the restored *Star Wars* is the product of a variety of sources — the original negative when possible, 20-year-old color separations, usable portions of an existing print and digital technology.

"What's most scary is that had we waited another two years, the negative would have deteriorated so badly that we could have done nothing," McCallum says.

More enjoyable challenges came with creating new scenes and visuals. Two stand out in particular — the entry of Luke Skywalker's landspeeder into the Mos Eisley spaceport and a hilarious confrontation involving Han Solo and the giant slug, Jabba the Hutt.

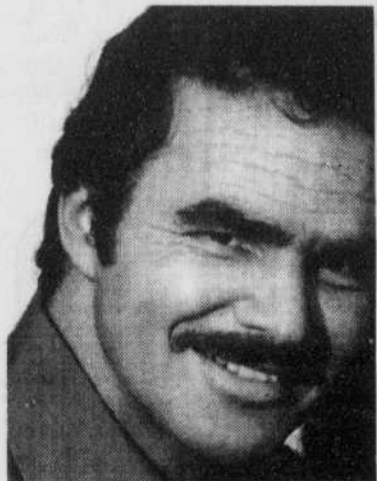
Twenty years ago, Lucas couldn't create the bustling spaceport he envisaged. This time, his computer graphics team has populated the streets with several new creatures, droids and people. This time, as well, the landspeeder really does appear to be floating. In the original, Vaseline was put on the camera lenses to hide the vehicle's wheels, a primitive solution that left Lucas dissatisfied for 20 years. This time, computer technicians have simply removed the wheels from the film image.

In the case of Jabba the Hutt, the original encounter was shot back in 1976 but never used because of Lucas's dissatisfaction with the human actor impersonating Jabba. This time, computers have simply removed the original human and replaced him with a digital creation fashioned by the same technology that produced *Jurassic Park's* dinosaurs.

McCallum knows the *Star Wars* phenomenon is not being embraced everywhere these days, with some commentators complaining that it ushered in two decades of mindless, megabudget action spectacles. But he still believes *Star Wars* belongs in a unique category because of the mythology surrounding it.

"It's such an easy classic story about the struggle between good and evil," he says.

- Sissy Spacek was originally set to play Princess Leia, and then swapped parts with Carrie Fisher who refused to play the title role in another film, *Carrie*, if it meant doing nude scenes. Jodie Foster was also considered for the Leia role.

- Burt Reynolds was initially cast in the role of Han Solo and then backed out. Other candidates prior to the signing of Harrison Ford were Christopher Walken and Nick Nolte.

- Legendary mythologist Joseph Campbell helped George Lucas write his screenplay.

- The inspiration for Chewbacca was Lucas's dog, Indiana, whose name later became the inspiration for the *Indiana Jones* films.

- During the frightening scene in the trash compactor, Mark Hamill held his breath for so long he burst a blood vessel in his face. For the next few days, he could only be shot from the opposite side.

- Cardboard cutouts were

used to portray background starfighters in one scene and members of the crowd in *Star Wars'* final decoration ceremony.

- Alec Guinness's Obi Wan Kenobi character was inspired by Japan's Samurai warrior tradition.

- Three new *Star Wars* films, the first to be directed by Lucas, will form a prequel to the existing *Star Wars* saga, and show how Darth Vader became a fallen angel. They are slated to be released in 1999, 2001 and 2003.
