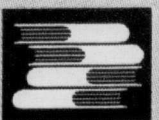

Couple makes sweet music

Violin and piano tonight at Bandeem

In 1997, pianist Timothy Steeves flew from Germany, where he had been studying, to interview at Newfoundland's Memorial University for a professorship in the music faculty.

While there he met Nancy Dahn, a talented violinist who had just started teaching out on The Rock. Two weeks

after Steeves arrived to take up the position, Dahn called him up to do a concert together. From there, everything took off.

"We knew as soon as we started playing together," said Steeves. "There was no adjustment time or getting to know the other person musically; we gelled right from the first rehearsal."

Duo Concertante, as they soon called themselves, marked their first season, 1997-98, with a successful tour of Ontario. But offstage, they were making music of a different sort.

"It all happened pretty fast," admit-

ted the still-smitten-sounding Steeves. Soon kids arrived, and life's harmonies began imitating art. Despite the whirlwind, Steeves said it has all been simple enough to sight-read.

"It's never been confusing for us. It's difficult for us to find boundaries. When are we husband and wife, when are we duo partners, when are we parents? - it's all sort of a big mish-mash."

The jumble that is their lives/careers seems to straighten itself out well enough by the time they hit studio or stage, though.

We all know how convenient it can be to have a ready-made caesar salad kit on hand. Two

minutes throwing everything together and... voilà! Dinner!

Well... those artificial bacon bits, half-wilted greens and rock-hard croutons are fine when we are on the run, but just wait until you try the real thing. The true caesar

is the king of salads, with its unctuous dressing, crunchy leaves, bits of bacon, and striking slivers of parmesan crowning the whole dish.

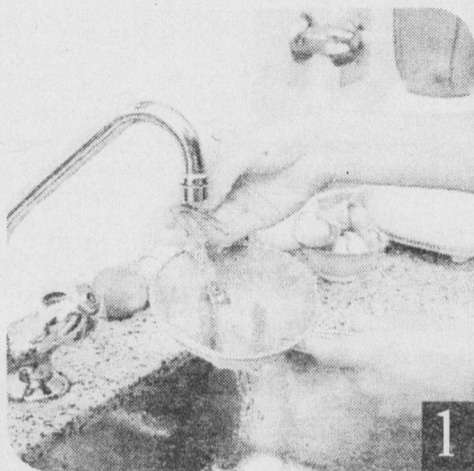
Talk about versatility... A real caesar salad looks and tastes so good that it can serve as an elegant appetizer (in which case you should half the quantities below), but also as an accompaniment to a main course of anything grilled, like salmon or chicken breast.

The extra work required for the homemade dressing and bacon bits will be rewarded with plenty of oohs and aaahs – so long as you toss your caesar at the last minute, for maximum crunchiness.

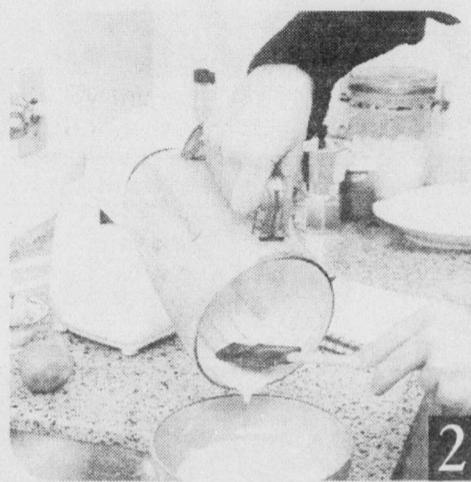

INGREDIENTS (FOR 4 PEOPLE):

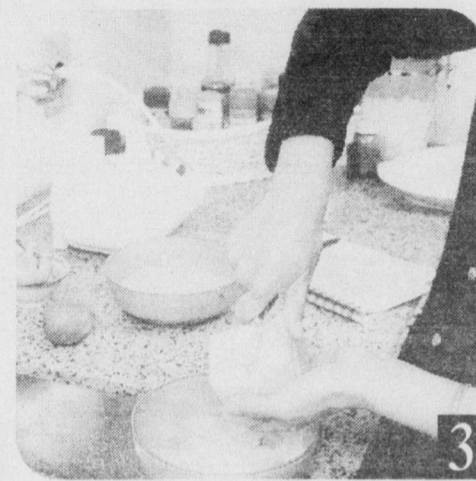
4 heads of romaine lettuce
7 strips of bacon
4 cups of plain croutons
1 wedge of real parmesan cheese, of about 250 grams

FOR THE DRESSING:

2 peeled garlic cloves
6 canned anchovies
4 tbsp. fresh lime or lemon juice
2 tbsp. mayonnaise
8 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
4 tbsp. water
salt and pepper to taste

DIRECTIONS

1. Run the anchovies under tap water to remove excess oil, and pat them dry with a paper towel. In a skillet, fry the bacon strips in low heat for about 5 minutes, until they are brown and crunchy. Remove them from heat, pat them dry and discard the hot grease. You can do them in the microwave if you prefer.

2. Beat all the dressing ingredients in a blender or food processor until the mixture becomes a smooth cream. You should add some freshly-ground black pepper to the mix, but very little salt, if any, because the anchovies and the mayo are both quite salty already, as is the parmesan cheese. Wash and drain the lettuce. Chop it into bite-size pieces. Chop the crispy bacon into bite-size

pieces too.

3. Make parmesan slivers by using a vegetable peeler. Reserve. When it is time to serve, toss the greens with the pieces of bacon, the croutons and the dressing. Serve in a very

large bowl, topped with with the parmesan slivers.

SSYO tackles Schumann's Symphony No. 1

You don't have to watch the Sherbrooke Symphony Youth Orchestra very long to notice it's growing. A year ago its players numbered only 30, and at that size the repertoire is limited. Now it has doubled in size, and the new musical director François Bernier explained that his expansion program was fairly straightforward.

"You make some phone calls, you call teachers, and you try to get some good repertoire to interest the kids in playing," he said.

This season he chose some more difficult pieces to interest better calibre players, and it paid off: 10 new recruits from the University of Sherbrooke and one from Bishop's.

With its new mass of 60, Bernier now has the guns to go after a full-fledged symphony. He chose Schumann's Symphony No. 1, on display Saturday night as the ensemble plays its second concert of the season in Maurice O'Bready Hall at 8 p.m.

The Schumann piece was written in four days, and is very light and happy because its author had just been married. That tone of piece was a bit of a strategic choice for several reasons beyond its audience appeal, explained Bernier.

"I like, if I can, to try one symphony per year with the (SSYO). It's a big challenge, but it's something they have to learn to concentrate for half an hour, 40 minutes without a break."

But not just any symphony will suit. "We have to be careful to choose a symphony for kids, which is not obvious technically and mentally," said Bernier. With players ranging in age from 12 to 25 and averaging about 17, Bernier admits "it's a big challenge to interest everybody."

Thirteen-year-old Isabelle David will be the featured soloist Saturday evening. She has won the Sherbrooke and Estrie region Festival contest as solo pianist for the past four years, and will bring her skills to bear on Beethoven's Piano Concerto No. 1, under the direction of her father, Marc David, who will guest conduct.

Many will remember that the elder David conducted the SSYO from 1986 to '94 (while Bernier was a player under him 1988-93) and the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra from 1988 to '95, before going on to be in high demand as a guest conductor with the Montreal Symphony Orchestra and the National Arts Centre Orchestra,

among others. He is currently artistic director of the Montérégie and Newfoundland Symphonies.

Also on Saturday's program will be the overture to the opera Hansel and Gretel by Englebert Humperdink (1864-1921), which Bernier said was like program music, drawing visual images with sound.

Rounding out the program will be the world premiere of a new piece by Jacques Desjardins, a former theory and composition teacher at the University of Sherbrooke, now at the University of California in Los Angeles (UCLA).

Au gré du vent, au fil du temps, which plays with notions of musical time and involves different ways of reading music, was a piece Bernier said took some of the players a while to grasp and embrace.

"You have to sell this music, because it's not something they're used to playing."

Bernier, who is in his second year leading the SSYO, also leads the Youth Orchestras of Joliette and Shawinigan,

plus the Ensemble Vent at the University of Sherbrooke. The multiple hats do require him to be, if not in two places at once, at least in many places in rapid succession.

"The last three weekends, I had concerts and dress rehearsals on the same day in different cities. With the weather, it's hard to do," he said. But he's happy to have so much work fresh out of his Master's studies in instrumental conducting at Indiana University. "In my second year I'm pretty happy to get so many jobs — it's unbelievable."

Bernier is working his way up the conducting ladder, he explained. "If we can make a parallel with sports, every coach starts with the midget and junior leagues, then makes it to the NHL. So you get your experience with the youth."

And that's not a bad way to learn. Any conductor is part artist, part teacher; the latter naturally figures more into the role for the leader of a youth orchestra. Bernier says he enjoys the pedagogical aspect, but finds that in the end, musicians are musicians, regardless of age.

"In every orchestra, youth or professional, I

will say exactly the same thing if I don't get what I want," he said.

Tickets for the concert are available at the University of Sherbrooke's Centre Culturel before the concert.

Since completing her training at the New England Conservatory of Music, the Julliard School, and the Cleveland Institute of Music, where she completed a doctorate in violin performance in 1997, Ms. Dahn has performed extensively in recital throughout Canada, the United States and Europe and has appeared with numerous North American orchestras. Similarly, Steeves has toured widely in the two continents after studying with masters in Hannover and Freiburg, Germany. His performances have been praised for their expressivity, beautiful sense of line, nuance and stunning colours.

All these qualities are discernible on their two CDs, *À Deux*, their debut recording of Beethoven, Brahms, Stravinsky, and Ravel, and *Of Heart and Homeland* (ATMA Classique), which explores the nature of national identity through the music of

Janacek, Smetana, de Falla, and Dvorak. Both albums were nominated for East Coast Music Awards.

Duo Concertante champions and promotes new Canadian works, frequently presenting premieres at their recitals. Since 1998, they have commissioned some of Canada's finest composers: Chan Ka Nin, Jean Lesage, Kelly-Marie Murphy, Andrew MacDonald and Omar Daniel; these works, written especially for the Duo, will be featured on their forthcoming disc, to be released by ATMA classique in the fall of 2003.

Steeves said that disc was recorded just after Christmas over five days he described as "grueling," because of the difficulty of the pieces involved. The MacDonald piece alone took two days as they strove for the perfect take, explained Steeves.

"When you perform them you can get away with stuff, but when you have to record them, you know, a tape never lies. So you just go over it and make sure you

have everything really well covered. It was exhausting."

Which is not to say that they're slouches on stage. Since banding together, Duo Concertante has played large and small centres alike in nine provinces and all over the States, travelling everywhere with their two kids in tow. Steeves said the variety of venues and responses has been interesting, but the only pattern he sees is that audiences in remote areas, starved for culture of this calibre, are much more appreciative and "tend to go wild."

The usually appreciative Lennoxville audience may do just that tonight, when the performance will be recorded for rebroadcast on Société Radio-Canada. The duo will open with the lush but mellow Brahms's Sonata No. 1 in G major for piano and violin, perhaps the most personal of the three sonatas by the romantic giant.

Following will be Andrew MacDonald's Sonata No. 2 for violin and piano, "The Phoenix." Although the piece was not

specifically written for Duo Concertante, this is the "grueling" piece they have just been first to record, which they premiered last summer in Newfoundland. But what is daunting to record is a pleasure to perform, it seems.

"Andrew's piece is great, it's a lot of fun to play," said Steeves. "There's a lot of work involved for both of us, and it shows the capabilities of both performers really well... Andrew's music just explores so many extremes, it's just exhilarating."

After the break they will break out Beethoven's Sonata No. 9, The Kreutzer Sonata, one of the milestones of the piano-violin repertoire. His largest sonata, the demanding piece was on the Duo's first CD, and was one of the first pieces they began playing together.

O' Brothers, where art thou?

The Gibson Brothers add some credibility to the saying that "nothing is purer than close brother harmony."

On Tuesday, March 25, the Gibson Brothers return to Waterloo's Royal Canadian Legion for the second concert in Townships Bluegrass and Old Tyme Music Society's (TSBOTMS) 2003 Winter Concert Series. Concert time is 8 p.m.

TSBOTMS President Gord Cameron says that brothers, Eric, 32, and Leigh, 31, have a longstanding relationship with the club.

"In March 1992, I had just started the club and I went to a concert at the Gibson family farm (in Ellenburg Depot, New York)," said Cameron, who is also a member of Hooked on Bluegrass, the opening band for the Gibsons. "I was member #1 and the Gibsons were #3."

Eric and Leigh grew up steeped in the country tradition, listening to Merle Haggard, Buck Owens, Jimmie Rodgers and Hank Williams, as well as bluegrass masters Flatt & Scruggs, Bill Monroe, Jim and Jesse, Reno & Smiley and the Stanley Brothers. They also draw inspiration from the "second-generation" masters such as Ricky Skaggs and Tony Rice.

The brothers have been performing together since 1983 and, in the 1990s, joined forces with renowned resophonic guitarist Junior Barber and his son, Mike, to form the first Gibson Brothers Band. With Eric on banjo, Leigh on guitar, Junior Barber on resophonic guitar and Mike on standup base, the group recorded four albums, *Underneath a Harvest Moon* (Big Elm Records, 1994), *Long Forgotten Dream* (Hay Holler Records, 1996) and *Another Night of Waiting* (Hay Holler Records, 1998).

Since the mid-90s, they have performed at major Bluegrass festivals throughout the U.S. and Canada. Their debut album, *Long Forgotten Dream*, reached Bluegrass Unlimited's singles and albums charts, with the title track reaching 10th place on its Top 30 Survey.

Since then, the band's new releases have earned top marks. 'She Paints a Picture' reached fourth spot on BU's singles chart. In 1998, the band received International Bluegrass Music Association's Emerging Artist of the Year Award while their CD *Another Night of Waiting* spent a year on the bluegrass charts.

In 1998, Eric and Leigh signed with Ricky Skaggs' Ceili Records and recorded a yet-to-be-released album. As a result, they asked to be released from Ceili and returned to their Bluegrass roots, signing with Sugar Hill Records, one of the most highly regarded Bluegrass labels.

On March 11, the new Gibson Brothers Band, with Eric, Leigh, Mike Barber and Marc MacGlashan (replacing Junior Barber), released its latest CD, *Bona Fide* (Sugar Hill, 2003). The album also features Luke Bulla, Jason Gibson, Tom T. Hall, Jeff Taylor and Sam Zucchini. The brothers are also joined by their sister, Erin, who performs background harmony on *Beautiful Brown Eyes* and lead vocals on *The Lighthouse*.

The CD is dedicated, not surprisingly, to their parents, Kelly and Shannon Gibson, "the best friends the Gibson boys will ever have", who supplied not only the genes, but also the upbringing. The dedication reads: "We learned how to work, we learned how to play and we learned how to love."

Judging from advanced ticket sales, which Cameron said indicate an early sell-out, Eastern Townships Bluegrass fans love the Gibsons too.

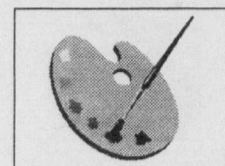

U of S exhibit puts you in the spotlight

No, your eyes are not playing tricks on you. The latest exhibit at the University of Sherbrooke Cultural Centre's Art Gallery features one of the most well-known light artists of his generation, Axel Morgenthaler.

Entitled *BeamBeat*, the exhibit is unique in that its centrepiece is you.

"I have always been fascinated, obsessed really, with the interaction between light, human beings and architectural spaces," explained Morgenthaler. "My work centers around photonic matter (light) and its dialogue with the environment. The inclusion of human perception is for me a constant concern and an inexhaustible source of inspiration."

Growing up in Europe, Morgenthaler worked with several well-known luminaries such as architect Roman Dobrovodsky, painter Sol Lewitt and actor Massimo Rocchi. In later years, he turned his attention towards dance and theatre.

In *BeamBeat*, Morgenthaler explores new concepts in set design, visual arts and architecture by using light as his raw material for creation and video, multimedia and cinema as his supporting elements.

"The language of light is really quite poetic. Imagery exists only in motion – in itself, 'light' is an invisible entity," he said. "The installation that I have created is an interaction between mind and body. It could be called 'action painting', but instead of using paint, participants manipulate light beams and leave ephemeral traces on the floor that last only for a short while."

BeamBeat includes a phosphorescent projection surface where the analyzing process is presented to visitors so that they may understand the influence of their presence and actively participate in manipulating the lighting sculpture.

The overall movement within this area is analyzed in real time by a custom video camera and movement analyzing software. Additional software is used to create a live MIDI stream resulting from the analyzing process which in turn controls and influences the exhibit.

Well-known throughout Canada, Asia, Europe and the United States, Morgenthaler's interactive installation *BeamBeat* has been showcased in *The Season of Quebec* in New York.

In 2001, he co-founded the visual design company *Photonic Dreams* with Martin Gagnon. Its objective was to offer a global visual approach to dance, theatre, architecture and art show projects.

Morgenthaler's lighting designs are considered, in themselves, works of art. He won the Bessie Award in New York in 2002 for the best set and best lighting design for 'Luna' by the O Vertigo Dance Company. He has also been associated with renowned choreographers as Edouard Lock, Ginette Laurin, Jocelyne Montpetit and The Alvin Alley Dance Foundation.

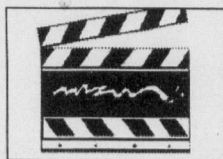

Women's film festival hits St. Albans

The Friends of the St. Albans Free Library recently announced the start of the 2003 Women's Film Festival, in conjunction with the Welden Theatre.

The annual spring festival, which coincides with Women's History Month, consists of four consecutive Mondays featuring recent films by or about women.

The festival began in 1994 when Mary Pat Larrabee approached the Welden Theatre's Mary Schumer with the idea of a film festival dedicated to small, independent films. Schumer agreed and now, twice a year (in the spring and fall), she arranges a series of Monday night screenings before the busy summer season and again, before the Thanksgiving and Christmas releases.

Julianne Moore, Dennis Quaid and Dennis Haysbert star in the story of a perfect suburban couple, Frank Whitaker (Quaid) and wife Cathy (Moore). Cathy is a 1950s housewife living a cookie-cutter, dream-life in conservative Hartford. She and Frank, outwardly, the picture of middle-class sobriety, are inwardly rocked by Frank's attempts to suppress his homosexuality. She seeks solace in the friendship of her African-American gardener Raymond (Haysbert), an innocent act that crosses the acceptable social lines of the day and risks scandal.

Filmmaker Todd Haynes employed the melodramatic style of 1950s filmmaker Douglas Sirk to capture the suffocating mores of the white, middle-class in mid-20th century American society. The film garnered four Academy Award nominations, in-

cluding Best Original Screenplay, Best Actress (Moore), Best Score and Best Cinematography.

This film by Indian director Mira Nair and screenwriter Sabrina Dhawan won the Golden Lion Award at the 2001 Venice International Film Festival, the first Indian film to capture the top award in 44 years and only the third film in the festival's 58-year history given to a woman director. Nair, an Academy Award nominated director, sets her film in modern upper-middle class Punjabi, India, where old traditions mix with contemporary "dot.com" culture as relatives travel to New Delhi for an arranged marriage. The film stars Naseeruddin Shah as Lalit Verma, Lillete Dubey as Pimmi Verma, Shefali Shetty as Ria Verma and Vijay Raaz as P.K. Dube

There, she discovers that she must leave home to become her own woman and that "real women have flaws, embrace life and take chances".

The screenplay is based upon a play by Josefina Lopez and won the Dramatic Audience Award at the 2002 Sundance Film Festival, as well as a Special Jury Prize for Acting for cast members Ferrera and Lupe Ontiveros.

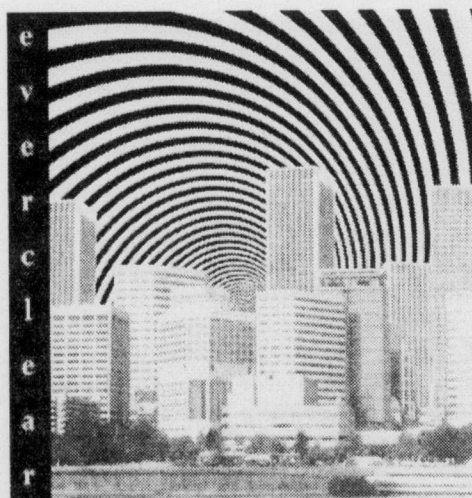

(EMI Virgin Music)

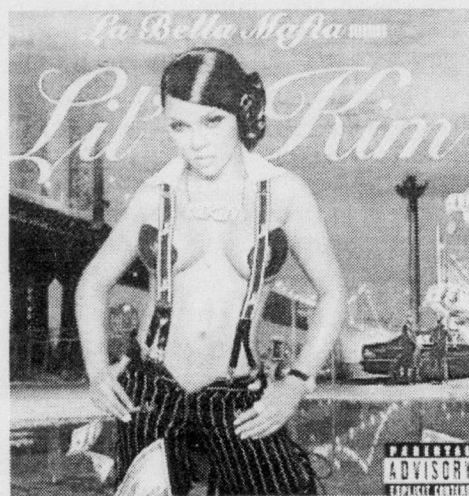
Any artist that can go from funk to folk to rock without missing a beat deserves some recognition. Yet you wouldn't notice its rareness on Ben Harper's long-awaited follow-up to *Burn to Shine*, entitled *Diamonds on the Inside*. It's a challenge that the singer/songwriter is seemingly focused on as two songs are never the same. It can be as folk as James Taylor, rock as Jimi Hendrix and funk as the back beats to a '70s porno flick. If *Welcome to the Cruel World* was labeled folk, *Fight for Your Mind* folk/rock and *Burn to Shine* pure rock, then *Diamonds on the Inside* is all of the above and more. That doesn't mean that Harper still won't just let go and rock like his renowned live performances — it's just the opposite. The talented singer/songwriter just does it with a little bit of reggae or even some heavy metal. Although *Diamonds on the Inside* is being paraded as a solo effort, Harper is still joined by Innocent Criminals regulars on select songs. Four years is a long time to wait between studio albums, but as fans will discover, it was a wait well worth it.

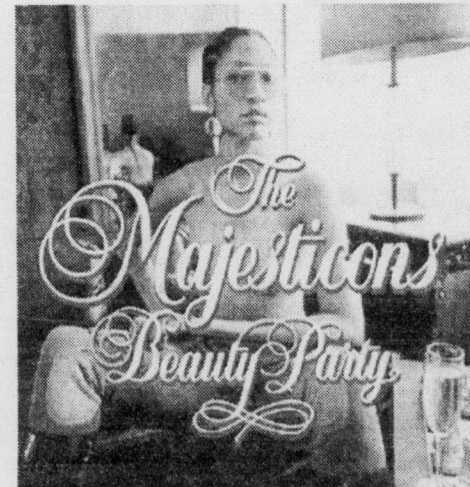

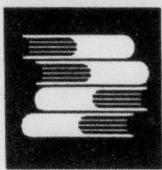

Why should the US act against Iraq?

In the last weeks and months, many people have been asking why the United States should act against Iraq? While there have been numerous voices condemning such intervention, the case in favor of military action is

also well articulated. From politicians to policy experts, the reasons to get moving are compelling. And they may well carry the day.

Two authors and eminent American conservative intellectuals Lawrence F. Kaplan and William Kristol help shape the debate in their recent book *The War Over Iraq*.

Kaplan and Kristol begin by documenting the atrocities carried out by Saddam Hussein on his people. Readers learn that "Saddam, who is fond of Stalin as a role model, carried a gun when he went to school in his youth. He did not stuff envelopes in a campaign headquarters. Upon taking charge of Iraq, in 1979, "mass arrests, public hangings and summary executions became common events." And, it is worth mentioning that, most of the time, when the authors elaborate on various actions committed by Saddam's regime, their sources are not the US government, but from human rights groups.

They also elaborate on the poor relations between Saddam and his neighbors and his intention to use weapons of mass destruction. But the core of their arguments is about how the United States should react towards Saddam.

Many have speculated that President Bush's policy towards Iraq is the continuation of his father's policy during and after the Gulf War. Kaplan and Kristol disagree. In their words, "Rather than press hard for a change of regime, President Bush halted the U.S. war against Iraq prematurely and turned a blind eye as Saddam slaughtered the insurgents whom the United States had encouraged to revolt." They also are very critical of Bill Clinton's actions towards Iraq.

But the authors applaud George W. Bush's strategy. First, they talk about preemption, which is preventing Saddam Hussein from becoming a greater threat. The United States shall not wait till Saddam "assembles the tools of aggression." And "preemption means striking first." Taking this road, the authors argue, is the less costly way to deal with Saddam, since he could - and would - become a bigger threat if nothing is done now.

To those who criticize the United States for acting alone, the authors present a very interesting argument. In fact, they mention the fact that while the French government denounces and opposes the US position, French soldiers were deployed - unilaterally - in Ivory Coast to defend the interests of their country. That's a double-standard they claim.

The second pillar of President Bush's strategy is regime change in Iraq. In their words, "the ultimate goal of regime change is liberal democracy." On that matter, they quote Woodrow Wilson, who said that "the world must

be made safe for democracy, because otherwise democracy will not be safe in the world." In that regard, they see America's actions as a moral obligation. But, contrary to the approach promoted by Bill Clinton, commerce and technology are not sufficient to achieve this goal of promoting democracy. Strong action must be taken.

Finally, the United States must keep on assuming a vital leadership in the world. And "even if the threat posed by Iraq were to disappear tomorrow, that would not relieve us of the need to play a strong and active role in the world. If America refrains from shaping the world order, we can be sure that others will shape it in ways that reflect neither our interests nor our values."

In the authors' mind, "there is nothing reactionary about wanting to rid the world of a dictator who gasses his own people, invades his neighbors (Iran and Kuwait), develops weapons of mass destruction, and flouts an entire catalog of U.N. resolutions." The authors present many well-articulated and supported reasons Saddam Hussein must be toppled.

Finally, the authors draw a parallel between the Bush Doctrine and the Truman Doctrine, which was designed to confront communism expansion and promote freedom. In their opinion, President Bush's actions are also follow the tradition of Presidents Kennedy and Reagan's foreign policies.

Anybody seeking to know more about the looming confrontation between the United States and Iraq should definitely look at Kaplan and Kristol's book which may well be part of the roadmap of America's foreign policy in the months and years ahead.

New head at Corus Ent.

Phil Kallsen, program director at Calgary's Country 105 radio station, just became one of the most powerful men in Canadian country music.

It was announced this week that Kallsen, 42, has been named director of country radio programming for the media giant Corus Entertainment. The new position puts him in charge of programming for all Corus country radio stations, including the country's top eight markets.

Kallsen, who hails from Calgary, began his career in the early '80s after attending broadcasting school in SAIT. In those days, he wasn't a big country music fan. "It's funny," he says. "I remember going to school in the '80s and listening to Devo and all that punkish stuff."

But once he began working in radio, Kallsen says he quickly gravitated to country music and developed a passion for the genre.

Not including a short stint as a DJ on adult contemporary radio stations, Kallsen has spent 20 years of his career in country radio. He worked stints in such places as High River, Grand Prairie, and Red Deer, before coming to Country 105 18 years ago.

Hunted actor learned more than he wanted

When it comes to inflicting terrible damage with a knife, Benicio del Toro knows it all. He's acquired cutting edge skills in the art of engaging in a hostile encounter with a blade his only weapon. He's schooled in Sayoc Kali, the lethal combat style spawned from centuries of Filipino tradition. He knows how to stalk an adversary swiftly and silently and how to eliminate that adversary ruthlessly.

In fact, del Toro now knows far more about fighting and killing with knives than he really wants to know. Here, he's echoing Tommy Lee Jones, his co-star in *The Hunted*, the sombre new Paramount thriller opening March 14.

Jones said last summer that making the film was in many ways an unsettling experience because of the things he learned in the course of a rigorous training program in which he acquired an intimate knowledge of various unpleasant killing techniques.

"I agree - I'm with him," del Toro says. "I don't think it's human nature to kill."

But in *The Hunted*, the Oscar-winning actor plays a lethal killing machine, a trained U.S. Special Forces assassin whose Silver Star for valor does not halt his drift into psychosis as a result of his experiences in the Balkan conflict.

del Toro's character, a sad-eyed loner named Aaron Hallam, goes AWOL from the Special Forces on returning to the United States and becomes a renegade killer who stalks the Oregon wilderness - murdering and mutilating his victims. And he takes a perverse pride in always using a knife - and never a firearm: early in the movie, for example, he easily disposes of two hunters who are no match for his knife-throwing skills despite the fact that their rifles are equipped with high-powered military telescopes.

"It's very hard to kill, but if you can, you become desensitized," del Toro muses.

In preparing for his role in *The Hunted*, he worked out something of a back story for Aaron Hallam, speculating that there were other factors dating back to childhood which helped push him over the edge - for example, abandonment as a youngster or a simple lack of love. But the bottom line is that he has become a rogue killer who must be eliminated.

"I think he's become so numb and desensitized that feelings have ceased to exist."

Jones plays a wilderness survival expert named L.T. Bonham who has Aaron very much on his conscience.

Bonham is the one who trained Aaron and hundreds of other soldiers in the art of covert killing, and he must now bear responsibility for Aaron's accelerating killing rampage because he ignored Aaron's pleas for help when his brightest and best protégé began drifting into madness. And because Bonham is the one who knows Aaron best, it becomes his job to track Aaron down and end his killing spree.

The script and the challenge of playing someone like Aaron were two factors in del Toro's decision to do *The Hunted*. But he also wanted to work with William Friedkin, the notoriously demanding filmmaker who made movie history with *The French Connection* and *The Exorcist*.

"Billy's old school," del Toro says. "He's like one of those basketball coaches who expects 120 per cent from everybody around him - and who might get emotional about it. He wants to win. He's kind of a military kind of guy - but not in a bad way."

Friedkin wanted to make the sparest of chase thrillers in which the genre was stripped down to its essentials.

del Toro, who won an Academy Award for his performance as a compassionate Mexican cop in *Traffic*, was handed a script containing two, possibly three, pages of dialogue. It would be his job to convey the tormented nature of his character through face and body language and through using the potentially rich resources of on-screen silence.

"This movie is different. It's a chase. It's going so fast and there's so much fighting. Of course, there's not going to be any dialogue in the middle of a fight - unless you're Muhammad Ali."

But even scenes with did contain dialogue at the start would receive the chop.

"Billy was very much into reducing the dialogue when it was redundant or fatty. It was a challenge - but it was a challenge that was fun. And for this movie, I think it was a wise choice."

As for those scenes where del Toro had to show his terrifying dexterity with a knife, he admits that he was both repelled and fascinated by the underlying

ing techniques required.

"The knife fighting stuff was kind of cool because there's a logic behind it," he says. "It was like - if you do this move, you have to be here. But then what do you have to do to get back to that earlier place? In order to get better, you have to practice, you have to do a lot of repetition."

That was the purpose of the training sessions - to make him totally at home with a knife but also to teach him necessary safeguards. But he still suffered one injury when he accidentally fell on top of Jones during a training session: del Toro miraculously escaped being slashed, but he did crack a wrist.

Although the film moves like a thriller, it carries a serious subtext about the darker side of military warfare as practiced by Special Forces members.

In an earlier interview, Friedkin emphasized renegade killer Aaron Hallam's problems begin during the

Balkans conflict at a time when the United States was decimating Kosovo with bombs and covert ground action under NATO auspices.

"It was totally surreal," Friedkin said. "Benicio's character gets an overdose of indiscriminate killing and he's never able to snap out of it."

del Toro knows full well that his character's psychosis stems from the fact that he's been trained to kill in a war, and he wonders how he himself would function in a conflict.

"I don't think I could be a foot soldier. I don't know if I could take orders." He has misgivings about the looming war with Iraq.

"I don't think war is a solution to what is going on right now. There are some wars that have been necessary. World War II was an important war. If there was a situation like World War II now, I'm sure you would believe in war. But what's going on now - I'm not clear on that."

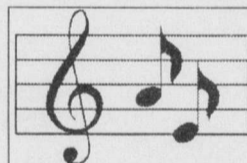

Mahtani makes debut as assistant director at Centaur

Mathematics may not impress us as the most suitable subject for drama. After all, how many of Shakespeare's plays revolve around logarithms or calculus?

Yet playwright David Auburn manages to make mathematics as riveting as love and death by interweaving those themes into a plot based on a passion for math.

Unusual and elegantly written, Proof, currently playing at Montreal's Centaur Theatre, is one of those plays that lingers in your mind long after you leave the building.

The story takes place in Chicago, and tells the tale of a mathematical genius who has recently died. What quickly emerges is that Robert, the deceased, was a genius who had slid into the dark world of mental

illness. His daughter Catherine has inherited her dad's love for numbers, but has she inherited his genius - and just as compelling, his mental illness?

The story unfolds as Catherine, who turns 25 the day before she buries her father, wrestles with her dangerous legacy.

Her father has left a cache of 103 notebooks, and a former student insists on going through each and every one, looking for any signs of a returning genius among the scribbles and ravings of a madman.

Hal Dobbs, the student, is an appealing nerd who reaches out to Catherine, an awkward yet pretty girl, who makes a cactus look like a cuddly stuffed toy. Adding to Catherine's stress is the return of her sister, Claire, a relentless over-achiever whose perfect life is matched by her perfect wardrobe, in sharp contrast to Catherine's lackluster life and fashion sense.

As the play unfolds Catherine's own genius is revealed, along with her bouts of depression. Auburn also manages to depict Robert's illness in

a realistic way by bringing us scenes from the past, watching him

live out the transition from remission to relapse, wrenching our hearts along the way. His daughter's unwavering commitment to keeping him at home makes us admire Catherine all the more, despite her prickly exterior. Auburn throws a lot of humour into the mix, and ends on an optimistic note. This makes Proof, despite its very painful subject of mental illness as well as unglamorous math, an uplifting and affirming work.

Jim Warren ably directs this production, starring Amy Price-Francis as Catherine, in a sterling performance that conveys the pain and loneliness, along with a yearning for normalcy that accompanies genius and mental instability.

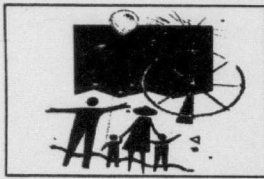
James Dallas Smith makes an appealing geek, former student Hal Dobbs, who knows that in his field, 28 is already past his prime. Allana Harkin portrays Claire, the perfect young woman whose attempt to steamroll her sister into moving to

New York is met with both passive resistance and nastiness. Harkin makes us feel some sympathy for Claire, whose composure and perkiness is in too sharp a contrast to her younger sister's depression. Jerry Franken is Robert, the tormented father, and Franken brings a kind of 'Father Knows Best' warmth to his role. His moment of relapse is movingly portrayed, and our hearts sink as we realize that he is once again lost to the real world.

It is a good cast and former Sunshine Theatre producer Sunil Mahtani makes his debut at the Centaur as assistant director. But the real star of this show is the script, and Auburn deservedly won a Pulitzer Prize and a Tony Award for best drama. This is a must-see play for theatre lovers, and this production will be running at the Centaur until the end of the month.

Rhinestone cowboy Glen Campbell still shines

Many young country fans may not realize what a big star Glen Campbell was at his peak. He scored Pop and Country hits by the dozen, songs such as 'Gentle On My Mind', 'Rhinestone Cowboy' or 'By The Time I Get To Phoenix' and 'Galveston'.

He also co-starred with the legendary John Wayne in the classic movie True Grit, and had his own TV show, the Goodtime Hour from 1969 to 1972. This is just a few highlights in the career of a man who became an American music icon and whose appeal spans four decades.

Capitol Records just released a wonderful album that can be seen as a recap of Campbell's huge career titled, *Glen Campbell, All The Best*. The collection includes 25 top songs which are part of his musical legacy.

Over four decades as an entertainer, the artist has released more than 70 albums, sold over 40 million albums and has established a reputation as a great instrumentalist. He is recognized as one of the best guitar pickers in any musical genre.

For the true blue fans, this is a must

own album. It's nice to put on an album of your favorite singer and find so many songs in one collection. For younger country music fans it might be the perfect way to discover this impressive artist who's an accomplished musician as well as a top notch singer.

Actually fans from the younger generation might be surprised to learn that many of the songs they recognize were made popular by Glen Campbell. He's one of the first to pave the way for crossover artists such as Kenny Rogers and others.

Glen Campbell was raised in Delight, Arkansas in a very musical family. Every one of the 11 children and the mother and father could pick and sing. He got his first guitar when he was just four and learned how to play from relatives.

He perfected his skills by listening to masters such as Django Reinhardt and Barney Kessel while he started singing in the local church of Christ.. At 14, he played with his uncle's band in the local

bar circuit but by age 22, he decided to move to California.

In 1960 Glen Campbell was in Los Angeles where he started to do studio work as a back-up musician. The young man was a very talented guitar player and soon got to play on recordings by Frank Sinatra, Bobby Darin, Rick Nelson, The Monkees, Mamas and the Papas, The Association, Ray Charles and even Elvis. As a studio musician he was very much in demand.

He started touring with different band and even filled in for Brian Wilson with The Beach Boys for six months. He was asked to become a permanent member of the band but things didn't work out which was as well since a few months later he signed a recording contract with Capitol Records.

His first single showed how much potential he had as a country act. 'Burning Bridges' hit number 18 on the country charts in 1967 while the same summer he released 'Gentle On My Mind' which draw

a lot of attention.

His name was starting to be known when he released 'By The Time I Get To Phoenix' a song that charted on both country and pop charts. A legend was in the making as he rapidly released a succession of hits such as 'I Wanna Live', 'Dreams of the Everyday Housewife' and 'Wichita Lineman' which turned out to be such a big hit that it landed him his own national television show *The Glen Campbell Good Time Hour*, from 1968 to 1972. Until the 90s, he kept scoring hit after hit, including the number one hits on both country and pop charts, 'Galveston', 'Rhinestone Cowboy' and *Southern Nights*.

Something particular about Campbell is that he always played lead guitar on his recordings. The fact is that he is such a talented guitar player that he stands up there with the likes of Chet Atkins and many musicians who have followed credit him with being their inspiration.

The collection of songs found on this new release is without a doubt, a great recap of a very fruitful career that started four decades ago.
