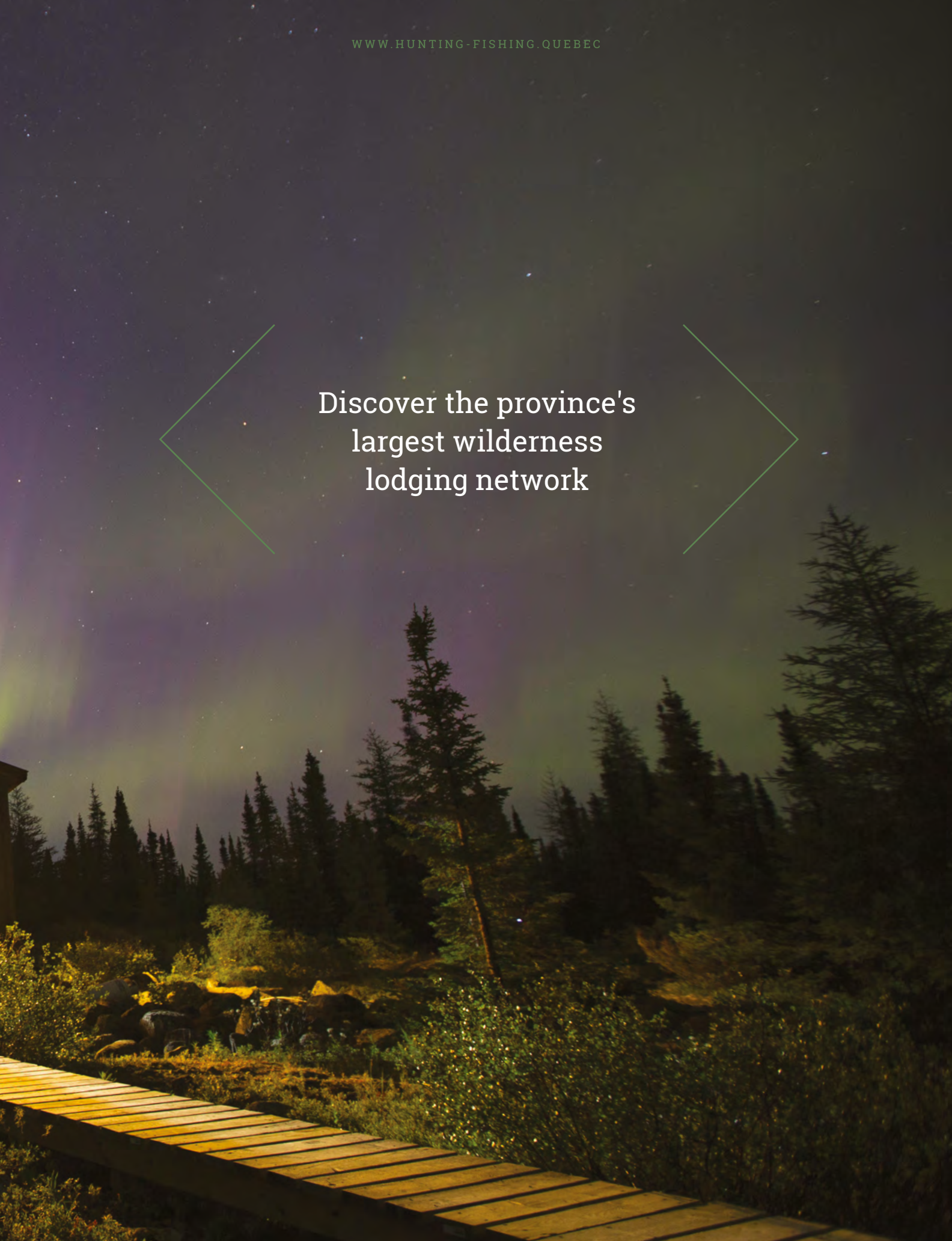

This summer, I had the opportunity to go back there to capture photos of the George and Leaf Rivers. The return to a place that so marked my life made me feel quite nostalgic. The film crew was curious to find out what awaited them;

they had great expectations. And the experience was out of this world! I personally caught my largest salmon and largest speckled trout ever, surrounded by a fantastic team, caribou and friends.

On this excursion, we first flew over the area by seaplane to scout the territory and discover the richness of the region surrounding the George River. We then embarked on big canoes and found the salmon and trout of our dreams.

I also got to introduce the new owners of an outfitter on the George River to salmon fishing.

The Nord-du-Québec region is always downright magical, completely unpredictable and full of incredible surprises! Nordic fishing is unparalleled here; it's different from anything you can experience anywhere else. This is certainly one of the most beautiful and special places in the world, and I recommend that you venture out to the area at least once in your life.



# ST-CYR ROYAL QUÉBEC'S CROWN JEWEL

As the host of Angler & Hunter TV I have been privileged enough to have traveled across Canada and experienced some of the finest fishing and hunting destinations the Country has to offer.



Now when I say finest I don't necessarily mean finest fishing or finest dining or finest accommodations... some have great fishing but rustic accommodations and simple hearty meals, others might have average fishing but offer lavish accommodations and gourmet meals... in general they all seem to have had a good mix of everything and usually offer most of what one might want on such an excursion and make for worthwhile adventures.

One part of the Country that we seem to always be drawn back to is the province of Québec, having experienced world class Caribou hunts, Atlantic salmon and Brook trout fishing, it tends to make you want to return for more. So this past summer we connected with the Québec Outfitters federation and booked a trip to what they called Québec's crown Jewel!

Now for those who have never been to Québec, I have to mention that it is closer than you think! Most of the locations are a short trip across the Ontario border from Ottawa, Mattawa or up at Temiskaming via North Bay; which is exactly why we like it so much.

Our hopes for this Québec trip were to chase walleye and try to hook into some Giant Pike so when we found out that our destination was going to be to the five star fly in outfitter St-Cyr Royal...well I had to do a google search and see what all the fuss was about. After a quick visit to [WWW.STCYRROYAL.COM](http://WWW.STCYRROYAL.COM) it was pretty much sleepless nights leading up to our departure date... this place looked way too good to be true!

It was mid-June when we packed the AHTV Ram 1500 for an 8-10 hr drive to Senneterre, Québec which is just northeast

of Val-d'Or. The drive is a scenic one and rather relaxing as you pass through small hamlets and forested hills into the wilds of Northern Québec. When we arrived at the landing we were greeted with friendly service and our gear was quickly transferred from the truck to a float plane and we were in the air for a short 20 min flight to St-Cyr Royal.

As you fly over the areas vast lakes, rivers and wilderness you can often spot wildlife like Moose and bear...but before you have a chance to take it all in the plane arcs and descends over a magnificent lake and into site comes the lodge and oh what a site it is! A massive modern Log Lodge set back in a clearing just feet from the shoreline.

At the dock we are greeted by staff and all our gear is delivered to our rooms, upon entering the lodge the first thing you notice is the pebble flooring and the billiard table in a common area for guests to relax, from there it's upstairs where you walk into only what can be described as the most relaxing room on earth! Cathedral ceilings and massive windows give way to a stone fireplace as a centerpiece that is surrounded by carvings, furniture, fish and game all from the property and surrounding forest. Leather couches and a snack area sit next to the dining room and as you stop to take it all in the owner welcomes you with a wave and invites you to the bar for a welcome beverage exclusive to St-Cyr.

After a warm reception and a meal fit for a king, it's off to get some rest...the rooms are on the third floor of the lodge and each has a view of woods or water and set up with private washrooms that put a Hilton hotel to shame. In short, the lodge makes sure that there is nothing you will do without and that includes having your bedsheets turned down each night when you return from a day on the water.

Did I mention this is a fishing lodge? Right... the fishing... So although we were only visiting for two days I wanted to get the full fishing experience and see what the lake had to offer. Our guide was more than accommodating and on the first morning took us for a Grand tour which had us traveling nearly 40 miles, making stops to fish rock bars, points and narrows. Each stop was as good as the last as we caught

keeper Walleye one after the other. Storm 360 search baits and curly tail minnows were all one needed to catch as many walleye as you wanted. Soaring Bald Eagles and Majestic Golden Eagles are around practically every corner of this beautiful lake and it was easy to just relax and enjoy what we were experiencing... but in the back of my mind were the photos from the website...the ones with guests holding Jurassic sized Northern Pike... our second day was going to be all about hunting down a pike that would be the crown jewel in this legendary trip.

The last day would prove to be a memorable one, I brought only a storm 360 swim bait and a Rapala rattlin spoon with me as these are my go to baits for catching big Pike. We slowly idled into a creek fed Back Bay where we would drift and cast to scattered weeds tight to shore...here I hooked several decent sized pike and with each fish my anticipation grew...would I be able to hook one of St Cyr's monsters? Not five casts later it happened the shallows came alive and a shark like wake was trailing behind my Storm swimbait, as my retrieve came closer to the boat there was a massive turbulent boil in the water but no contact with the fish. I made several attempts to get it to bite but it seemed the fish had disappeared... moving further toward the back of the creek one of my casts landed what must have been inches from a gator sunning itself as the water erupted and my line tightened to a fight with a 40 incher that came to the boat for a picture and quick release. With an hour or so passing we returned to the spot where the leviathan followed my bait, and like clockwork I cast to the area and began reeling the bait back to the boat...with only a few feet left in my retrieve it happened... the fish jetted out from under the boat and charged my bait as I lifted it out of the water... my heart stopped as the fish struck just short and again disappeared in the dark waters... after a deep breath and a heavy sigh to compose myself and knowing the day was coming to an end; I made one more cast to the same area hoping the fish had set up again... and with two turns on the handle my Rapala rod buckled under pressure and the massive fish was on! It charged straight at the boat as I burned the reel to keep up and put some leverage into the fight, the beast turned shook its head and gaping its jaw showing just how powerful it was.

I was celebrating that I had the monster and began reaching for the oversized Lucky Strike Gorilla net that would finally tame this beast for all to see...but my celebration was cut short as with one powerful rush the fish ran straight at me and under the Lund pulling my rod beneath the water and practically to the other side of the boat....where it once again flared its gills shook its head and in doing so my line went slack as the barbless spoon fluttered loosely in what was the aftermath of the King of all Pike making a fool of me, the fish was gone and I looked to the heavens and cried. My crown jewel had just slipped through my fingers and I knew I would never get another chance. What an incredible experience the lodge, the food the fishing and the heartbreak...however, that doesn't mean you can't take your shot at catching the Monster. If you think you can handle the fishing trip of a lifetime at a rate that is more than affordable you should check out St-Cyr Royal and maybe put that crown jewel in your collection.

# ANTICOSTI ISLAND

Anticosti Island is located in the Gulf of St. Lawrence off the southern coast of Québec and boasts a staggering 20 deer per square kilometer that started from just 200 animals. The original deer were introduced in 1896 and the herd now totals an estimate 160,000 animals. This alone makes it a whitetail deer hunters paradise but there plenty of other reasons to go and explore the island to find adventure not typically found in the lower 48. Safari Anticosti and the Québec Outfitters Association offered the perfect blend of travel, history, hunting and relaxation.

My trip started in Detroit Michigan and found me making my way on day one across the border to Toronto and then on to Montreal where I would spend night one. The next morning, I woke up bright and early to start day 2 of our travel which

would eventually land me on the island. From Montreal it was a quick 30-minute shuttle ride north to Mirabel airport. This is where I started the final leg of the journey which would make a quick pit stop in Québec City to pick up another group of excited hunters. After a quick 50-minute flight we began making our descent in to the Salmon River airport on the north shore of the island. Our group would arrive on day 2 with enough time to grab a late lunch, check to make sure our rifles were still zeroed and settle in for the evening and prep for the first morning of hunting.

The beauty of Anticosti is that you have the freedom to hunt at your pace in a style that best suits your personal preference. The preferred method of hunting for most of the guides is still hunting or spot and stalk. I was hunting the

last week of November and was able to catch the tail end of the rut. This can be a very exciting time on the island as the deer are very responsive to calling and even sometimes rattling. But if walking and stalking is not your style there are plenty of “caches” or blinds set up on productive spots if you prefer the sit and wait method. I prefer a mix of both and the guides were more than accommodating to make sure you were having the experience of a lifetime.

I stayed at the Lac Renard (Fox Lake) lodge which was more suited for a smaller group than one of the main lodges. This camp offered a central lodge where our group ate all meals and it provided some nice creature comforts of a pool table and satellite TV. In addition to the main building there were several personal cabins. This is where we would sleep and store all our gear which was nice because it offered us our own space to spread out, dry gear and get some quiet time. Each was equipped with 2 beds, and a personal bathroom and shower. We had 10 hunters in our group which offered a more private overall experience. However, Safari Anticosti offers several camps and you can certainly stay at one of the larger ones which house 20 plus hunters for the full lodge and camp experience. I hunted on their American plan which included all meals and guides, but they do offer a European package which is more of a DIY style hunt where you are given a specific territory and are responsible for providing your own food with minimal direction from guides. I highly recommend the American plan for the fantastic service and meals alone!

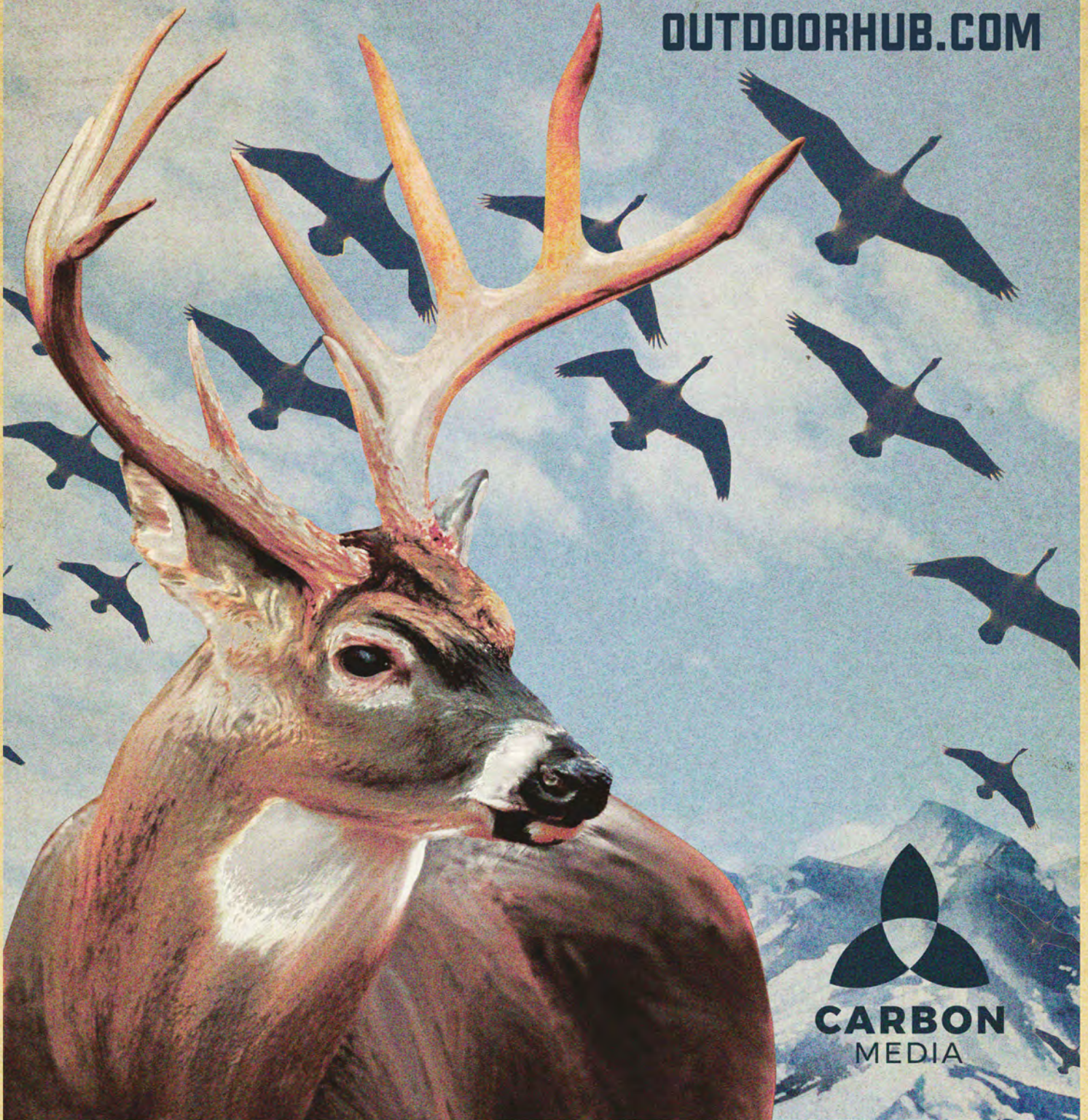
Days 3-6 were the hunting days and each day was a new experience in a new territory. They rotate all hunting sectors between the group which is great because it ensures all

hunters get to see the different parts of the territory and allows each person to hunt for a day in more productive zones. Mind you, I saw tons of deer in EVERY zone on EVERY day so there really is no bad spots, just different. You can hunt everything from deep and thick coniferous forest to river crossings and every type of terrain in between. The absolute highlight of the trip though was the beach! Not the white sandy beach with tropical drinks, sand castles and sunscreen... this beach was a cold and icy place with rocks, commercial fishing debris and deer! Loads of deer! This was the main draw of the island for me and I finally got to experience it firsthand. During the brutal winters the deer make an annual migration from the central parts of the island to escape the deep snow and find food. Here I was, on the shore of a 3,000 square mile island in the north Atlantic, still hunting along the coast... hunting white-tailed deer... on the beach! These deer have evolved and adapted to the winter conditions by migrating to the beaches in masses in the winter to feed on the kelp that washes up on shore. It is easily accessible and very abundant. It has become their main staple during the harsh winter months and is fascinating to watch. It is an experience like no other that I am not sure can be found in many other places across the globe.

Days 7 and 8 were the sad, “back to reality” days and required the same travel in reverse order which went off without a hitch. I was blessed to take two magnificent bucks and secured a lifetime of memories. It may seem like a far-off place in the middle of nowhere, but Anticosti is a hidden gem in the Province of Québec. If you are looking for a trip that offers a great hunt, some exciting travel, wonderful people, unique history and more than a touch of comfort and relaxation this is the adventure for you!



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# BOREAL BRUINS OF QUÉBEC

If I were to be completely honest, bear hunting has not always been at the top of my to-do list as a hunter. In fact, until recently the *Ursus americanus* were not even on my radar. Because I live in Colorado, elk, mule deer, whitetails and antelope always seemed to be at the top of my list. However, that all changed several years ago when I had a close encounter with a black bear while on an elk hunt.

His raven-black hide seemed to glisten as he fed in the evening sun. For several minutes I watched him lazily feed on the south facing slope less than 100 yards from me and I was truly mesmerized. His large blocky body told me he was a mature boar and when he turned and began feeding in my direction, our eyes eventually met. Needless to say, in that brief moment my elk hunt was far from my mind; and

although I didn't have a bear tag at the time, in hindsight I wish I would have. Once he figured out what I was at a mere 25 yards away, he bounded down the mountain in a huff. At that moment I knew that black bears would be on the menu every season.

Since then I've hunted bears in three states in the Lower 48 and three Canadian provinces, and by far the scenic Boreal forest and mountains of Québec have been one of my favorite destinations. Having been there twice and tasted what this region of Canada has to offer, it truly is a sportsman's paradise.

First of all, Québec is the largest province in Canada at over 600,000 square miles. Its Boreal forest is known for high



densities of black bears with high success rates, and the moose hunting opportunities are good as well. An added bonus is Québec's 500,000-plus lakes with the vast majority of them brimming with wild lake trout, walleye and northern pike, just to name a few. However, most importantly on any out-of-country hunt are the people and the Québécois are some of the finest. No matter what part of the province I'm spending time in, they are always willing to help.

When I was invited by Québec Outfitters ([www.pourvoiries.com/en-us/](http://www.pourvoiries.com/en-us/)) to hunt with Wapus Lodge ([www.wapuslodge.com](http://www.wapuslodge.com)) this past spring, I jumped at the chance. Like my previous Québec adventure I knew it would be another good one. After talking with Sophie Rousseau, the lodge owner, that suspicion was confirmed. For over 50 years the Rousseau family has operated the lodge. With over 270 square kilometers of forest and waterways to roam in their outfitting area, I couldn't wait for my feet to hit the Québec soil once again!

Upon arrival at the lodge in early June, I was deeply impressed with the accommodations. It was obvious that the folks at Wapus Lodge knew how to treat their guests. My two bedroom cabin was nestled next to a lake and the scenery surrounding it was inspiring. Needless to say, after the long journey from my Colorado home I was eager for the bear hunt to begin the following day.

For the next few days I lived the sportsman's dream! I would wake up close to dawn, eat a wonderful breakfast and fish one of the many lakes close to the lodge. Fly fishing for pike along the shores provided some exciting action as I stripped bunnies along lay downs and weed patches. As the morning progressed I would fish deeper for walleye but I often found myself drawn back to the shore for the fast pike action.

Afternoons were reserved for the bear hunting and it was obvious by the trail camera photos I was seeing and the bait sites that were getting hit, there were no shortage of bears. However, like anything else worth doing, bear hunting over bait is rarely easy. Bears are smart despite what some people think, but on the fourth afternoon of the hunt everything came together.

The guide knew this particular bear was coming in early so I was setup in my ground blind shortly before noon. I hadn't been there 30 minutes when I saw a flash of black hide sneaking through the forest beside me, and with each step he took closer to the bait my heart raced with anticipation. For several minutes he milled around in the brush scent checking for danger, and when he felt the coast was clear he stepped into view.



Just like that Colorado black bear that turned my eyes towards bear hunting, the raven-black fur on this Québec bruin glistened in the afternoon sun. As I slowly pulled my traditional bow into service, time seemed to stand still as he stood broadside just 20 yards away. In an instant my arrow was released and when it zipped through his chest, I knew my adventure was over.

As I stood over my fallen prize I knew once again Québec's boreal forest had delivered everything I had hoped for, and I honestly can't wait for it to deliver again in the future!

# SALMONIDS

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### **BROOK OR SPECKLED TROUT**

The brook trout, or speckled trout, is a combative fish found almost all over Québec, most often in streams, rivers and coldwater lakes. The best way to have the most fun with this species is by going fly-fishing for it.



### **RAINBOW TROUT**

Although famous for its voracious predator's appetite, the rainbow trout is also known for making legendary jumps out of water before surrendering to the net. It is delicious both smoked and fresh.



### **ATLANTIC SALMON AND LANDLOCKED SALMON**

Atlantic salmon and landlocked salmon are the same species. However, landlocked salmon lives exclusively in freshwater while Atlantic salmon migrate to the sea.



### **LAKE TROUT (GREY TROUT)**

Cautious yet eager, lake trout are often used as trophies once caught. They are mainly present in deep southern lakes, but can also be found in rivers and some shallow lakes in the north.



### **ARCTIC CHAR**

Able to live in both salt water and fresh water, this salmonid species is highly sought after as much for the quality of its flesh as for its combativeness and legendary stamina. Its northern habitat makes it a very important fish for communities in Northern Québec.

## 2 ENJOY AN AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCE IN AN INUIT COMMUNITY

A trip to Nunavik is an opportunity to explore a thousand-year-old culture, Inuit culture. Located near the Leaf River estuary and the village of Tasiujaq, Johnny and Billy Cain's outfitting camp is 100% Inuit-owned and all the guides who work there are also Inuit.

On site, you will have the chance to partake in the daily life of your hosts: a rustic camp, local cuisine, children playing and running, fish drying in the fresh air, and so on. In the area, Arctic char and Atlantic salmon are caught in the brackish waters of the estuary, which has some of the highest tides in the world. Some even say the tides here are akin to those of the Bay of Fundy!

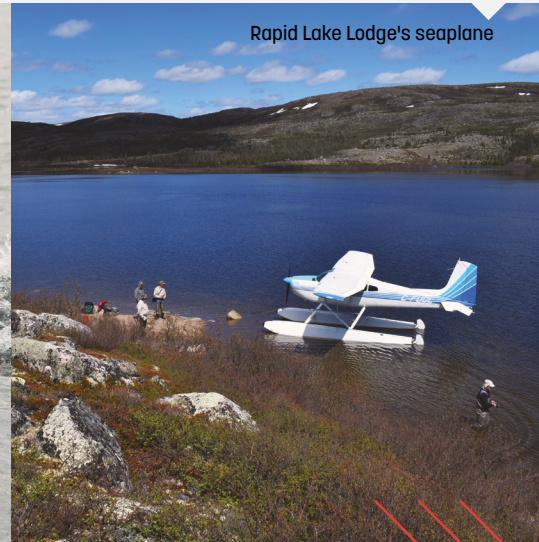

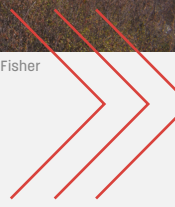

Helen Falls is the first obstacle encountered by salmon during their migration to their spawning area. So they come to this area in numbers. ## PRICES

Due to fluctuating exchange rates, the prices indicated in this brochure are subject to change. We therefore strongly recommend that you check the exact price when making your reservation with the outfitter of your choice. Prices quoted could include or not include applicable federal and provincial taxes.

## FISHING AND HUNTING ZONES

Each outfitting camp operates within a specific fishing and hunting zone. As you read through a given package, you will find the number under which the outfitter is identified and the number of the zone in which it operates. You can then locate the zone and outfitter identification numbers on the maps (pages 46, 47 and 48). For detailed information on hunting and fishing main rules (e.g., zone boundaries), contact the Ministry of Forests, Wildlife and Parks at [MFFP.GOUV.QC.CA/THE-WILDLIFE/HUNTING-FISHING-TRAPPING/?LANG=EN](http://MFFP.GOUV.QC.CA/THE-WILDLIFE/HUNTING-FISHING-TRAPPING/?LANG=EN) or 1-866-248-6936.

## EXCLUSIVE AND NON-EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS

Exclusive rights: only customers of the outfitter operating on the leased territory are permitted to hunt, fish or trap on that territory. Non-exclusive rights: hunting and fishing activities take place on public territory.

## ATTENTION NON-RESIDENT

Special rules apply to non-resident hunters. Don't be caught off guard: get the facts! Before your trip departure, please verify the policies and restrictions of each of the states/provinces you may go across on your way back home regarding meat and/or antlers transportation. Non-residents wishing to fish or hunt north of the 52<sup>nd</sup> parallel or east of the St. Augustin river (zone 19 south), as well as those hunting black bear, moose and woodcock south of the 52<sup>nd</sup> parallel (except in wildlife reserves and controlled harvesting zones (ZECs)), must use the service of an outfitter. Non-residents do not have to produce a hunter's certificate to purchase a hunting license. Although they may use a gun, rifle, crossbow or bow to hunt game, they must use a gear authorized for each species and zone. They must also comply with Canadian gun legislation. ## TRIP CANCELLATION

Whether you are dealing with an outfitter or an intermediary, make sure to inquire about cancellation policies and refunds on deposits or full payments. These conditions should appear in the outfitter's brochure or website.

## RESPONSIBILITIES OF FISHING AND HUNTING OUTFITTERS

Since they have no control over suppliers, outfitters cannot be held responsible if suppliers fail to provide the services described. In addition to the general conditions stated above, neither intermediaries nor outfitters can be held responsible for any damage, loss, delay, illness, injury or inconvenience arising from:

- A. errors, negligence or omissions on the part of other suppliers such as carriers, hotels, etc.;
- B. strikes, mechanical failures, quarantine or other restrictive government action, meteorological conditions, or other factors beyond human control such as forest fires;
- C. failure on the part of the customer to carry the necessary travel documents;
- D. any airport delays on the customer's day of departure, for whatever reason;
- E. any material damage, loss of property or theft;
- F. illness, injury, or death.

## INSURANCE

Most agencies offer trip cancellation, medical, and baggage insurance. For information on such policies, please contact the fishing or hunting agency of your choice. If the trip has not been completely paid for before your departure and you do not intend to settle the bill with cash, it is recommended that you verify whether the outfitter accepts personal cheques, traveller's cheques or the credit card you plan to use.

## BAGGAGE

Before departure, you should always check the weight limit on baggage with your airline carrier as well as the fees and policies related to bringing back meat and antlers.

## WEATHER CONDITIONS

While every effort is made to comply with published timetables, irregularities in flight operations may occur in some regions due to the weather. Such conditions can also affect the schedule of activities at the outfitter's camp. There is no refund for adjustments to activities resulting from such irregularities.

## CODE OF ETHICS AND BASIC PRINCIPLES

Professional ethics are the basic principles of moral conduct and obligations that QOF member outfitters must follow when dealing with society in general, as well as their clients, employees, and colleagues. They also include outfitters' duties to the profession. Each outfitter that becomes a member of the QOF must respect the Federation's Code of Ethics and basic principles. ## SAFETY REGULATIONS

All hunters and anyone accompanying a hunter must wear a fluorescent-orange vest that covers the back, shoulders and chest, and is visible from any angle at all times. A life jacket must be provided for each person using any kind of boat. In addition, all boats must be equipped with a bailer, a sound-signalling device, and a pair of oars.

## TRANSPORT AND EXPORT OF FISH AND GAME

Individuals who have in their possession, other than in their place of permanent residence, fish caught while sport fishing, must keep such fish in a condition making it possible to determine the species (enough skin left in place for identification), length (where length limits apply), and number. Non-residents may leave Québec with a quantity of fish equal to the possession limit for each species. Any hunter who has killed a deer, moose, or black bear must immediately detach the appropriate transportation tag from his or her licence and affix it to the animal. The tag must remain attached throughout the registration process and until the animal has been dressed and stored. Where a moose has been bagged by a hunting party, the hunter who killed the animal and any other hunter participating in the hunt must ensure that their transportation tag is also affixed to the animal on the same day it is killed.

## DRIVING IN QUÉBEC

By law, all vehicle occupants must wear a seat belt. Turning right on a red light is allowed in most of Québec, but some restrictions apply. Owning or operating a radar detector is strictly prohibited, as well as operating a cell phone that is not hands-free.
