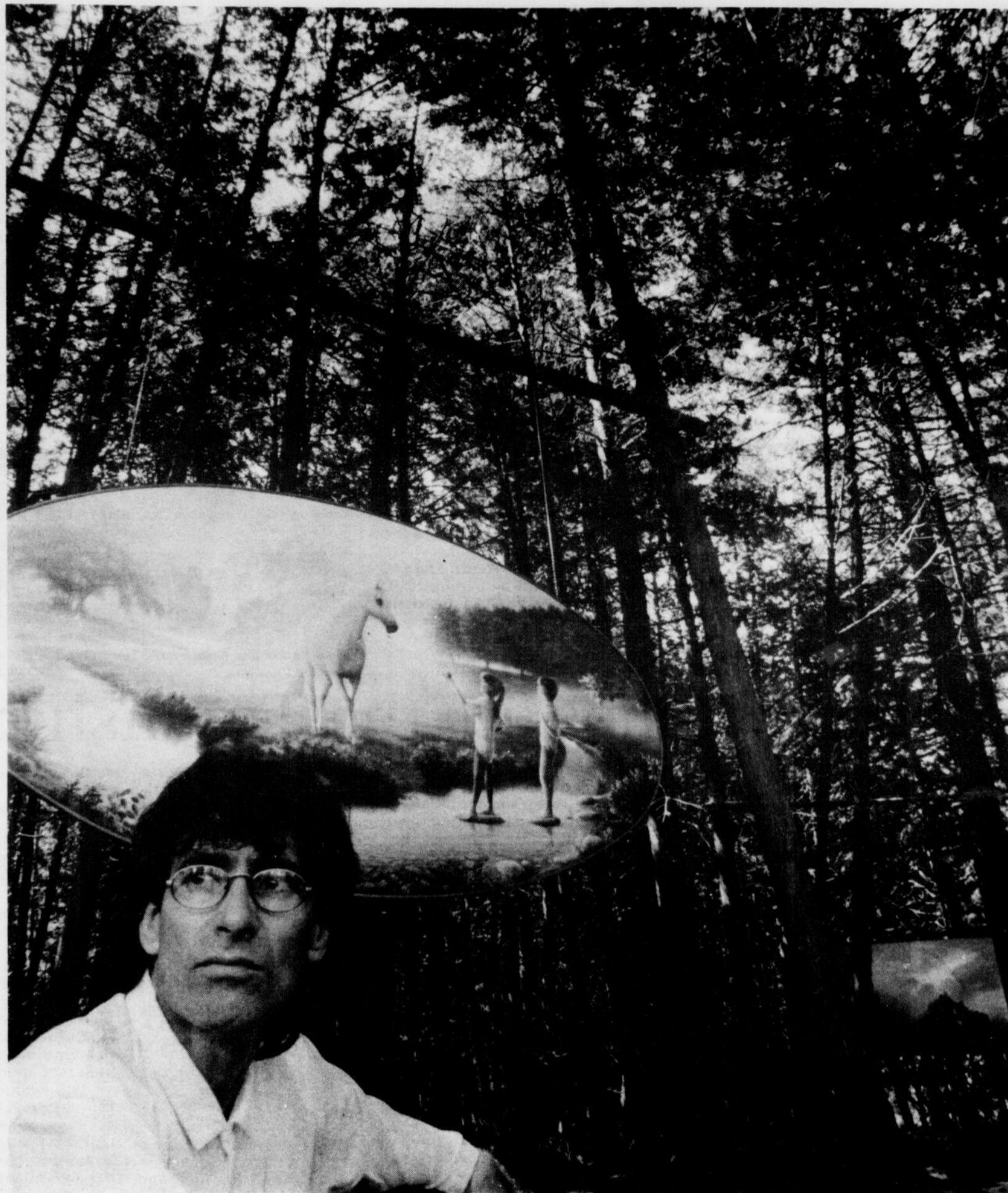

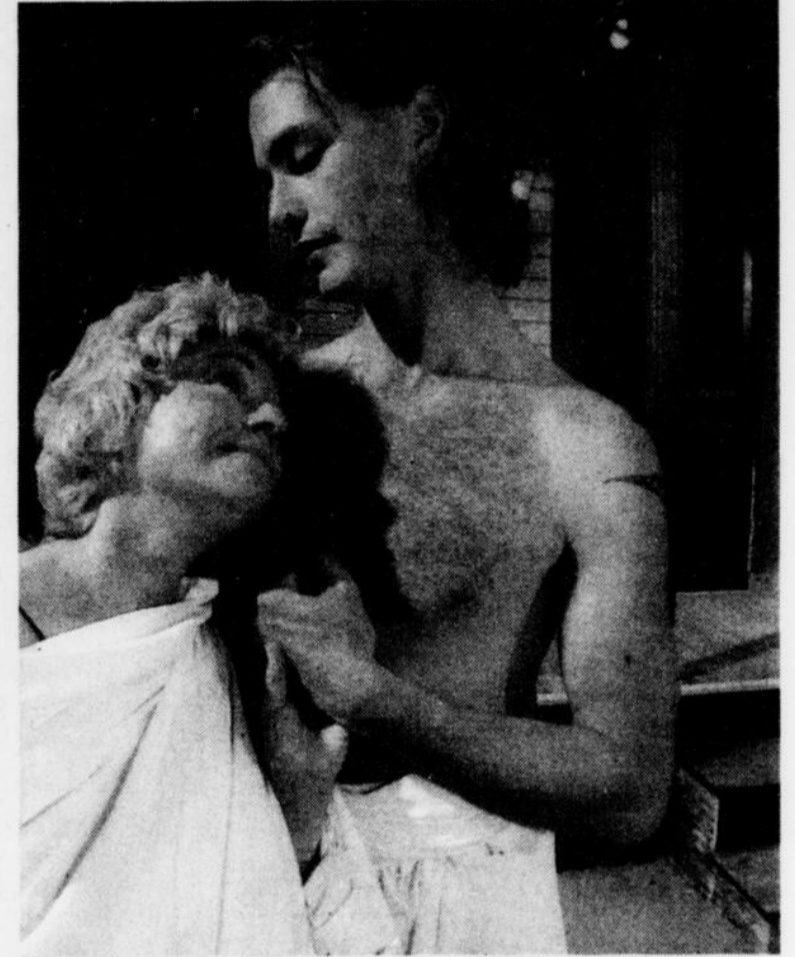

Highland Games in the Townships?

The Scots are frivolous and very alien and wild, though by intermingling with the English, they have been much improved. Caxton

I see in the *Record* the Townships Scots had a three-day celebration in Lake Megantic and tied it in with the annual Scotstown Ceilidh Society's annual picnic at

Irving's Meadow.

The Fraser Highlanders were there, piping, parading, shouting and shooting their muzzle-loaders. I'm told they fired several volleys and never hit a thing. There was the usual fancy dress, a scotch-tasting ceremony sponsored by a Highland distillery and Celtic beer introduced by Labatt. John Labatt, of course, was Irish but, I'm told, so were the Scots before moving to the knuckle-end of England.

My usual historical source 1066 and *All That* was a little confused by the Irish, the Scots, and the Picts, so I turned to a new edition of Caxton's *Description of Britain* (1480) and found this quotation from an earlier Latin compendium.

"Britons set sail from Scythia upon Ocean, the sea surrounding the world, 432 years before the founding of Rome. It happened afterwards at the time of Vespasian that Picts set sail from Scythia.

They reached the north coast of Ireland where they found the Scots."

"The Scots sent the Picts on to the northern extremity of Britain...and later followed and offered their help against the Britons but the Picts were nobler in heroic deeds and finer fighters than the Scots, although they were fewer. The Scots, made envious by that, turned to their native treachery which they often practised for they surpass other races in treachery, being naturally disposed to it. They invited all the Picts to a feast and waited for the moment when the Picts

were merry and had drunk a great deal."

"Suddenly, they pulled away the nails holding up the hollow benches. The Picts immediately fell backwards into a marvelously contrived pit. And were all killed."

At Lake Megantic, I am told, people born and bred in The Beauce were wandering around in skirts, sampling the scones while trying to say "Hoot mon!" and "Och aye!"

The recreation of the gunfight between Donald Morrison and Lucius Warren was conducted entirely in French and that local legend becomes more distorted each time it's told while continuing to grow until it is known across Canada, deep into the U.S. and even back in Scotland.

A Toronto pipe band recently released a C.D. entitled "The Donald Morrison Medley" and the four volume *Canadian Encyclopedia* published out of Edmonton gives Morrison his own substantial entry.

Alvin McAulay says the Ceilidh Society is thinking of beginning a Highland Games in the Townships. Tossing the caber, hurling the hammer, and golf. Sounds dangerous.

Lauzand's paintings marry well with nature

NORTH HATLEY — While most of the 110 artists on the *Circuit des Arts Memphremagog* are exhibiting their work indoors, André Lauzand decided to try something a little different.

Lauzand, as he prefers to be called, tied some logs between the trees on the grounds of his Hatley Acres home in North Hatley. He then hung some of his large oil paintings on these logs with the trees serving as natural frames.

But this was no gimmicky idea simply to stir interest in his work. His reflective and emotional paintings marry well with nature.

As I walked through the woods, between the trees and over rocks and grass, Lauzand's spiritual work began to take hold of me. Paintings with titles such as "Rivage d'Infini", "Terre-Ciel Retour" and "Détente — Voyage Interieur" stood out as larger-than-life reflections of the artists' imagination.

His peaceful paintings are inspired by nature and the shores of his dreams. They depict people and animals admist

natural settings. There also isn't much movement in his paintings. It struck me the New Age music of Enya would not be out of place here and almost immediately it began to play on sound speakers. It seems Enya's dreamy rhythms have the same effect on Lauzand and his wife, who puts the compact disc on for visitors during the *Circuit des Arts*.

Lauzand's home is one of 54 stops on the *Circuit*, an art tour that allows the public to visit studios and galleries around Memphremagog and meet the artists in person.

LANDSCAPES

Lauzand, a marriage of his first and last names, paints landscapes, be it realistic landscapes or the landscapes of his dreams.

It is not easy labelling his work. There are elements of realism, hyper-realism and the abstract in his paintings.

"I play with all the styles to obtain my images," he said.

He is satisfied with the term *art fantastique* because it refers to imagination and dreams.

Referring to his painting titled "Détente — Voyage Inte-

rieur", Lauzand said, "Before I do a painting, I take a *détente*, a voyage inside."

In fact, Lauzand said he is only a medium and that spiritual energy works through him.

"I love calm, tranquility," he said. "Peaceful, I love that word."

Lauzand is a man who never made it past the 1960s. "I love the era of peace and love," he admitted. "This is still the time for me."

To illustrate this, there's a painting titled "Minstrals" which is a depiction of the Moody Blues band. But it's not a typical image of a music group. Lauzand places the five members of the group in the forest.

"I like the softness of their music, it's close to symphonic music," he said. "They also used Oriental instruments, like the Beatles did with the sitar."

TRANQUILITY

Lauzand's views on spirituality are not obvious to the casual observer. For him, the first thing about his paintings he wants people to catch is their tranquility. After that, his non-violent philosophy

starts shining through.

"I am calm, soft, I'm not aggressive," he said. "Give me tranquility, after that communication."

Unlike many painters, Lauzand doesn't work with photographs.

Whether he includes animals, children or even his wife in his paintings, he uses his imagination to fill in the details.

Often the results are spectacular.

A painting of his wife has a magical, fairy tale quality to it. He began with her face and improvised the clothing after he couldn't find any in women's clothing catalogues he liked.

Lauzand is passionate about his calling. A full-time artist for three years, he works on his paintings from morning until midnight, taking few breaks, five days a week. He devotes the other two days of the week to his family.

His paintings take some two months to complete on average, although larger pieces can take almost half a year. At \$5-10,000 a piece, the price of his paintings reflect the amount of time and energy —

physical and spiritual — that goes into them.

The Joliette native began painting in 1975.

"I never thought about becoming a painter. I was working in a hospital as a receptionist and I just began painting."

It was in 1985, 10 years after dabbling in the art form, that Lauzand set his sights on devoting his life to it.

He moved to North Hatley just a few months ago and said the *Circuit* was a terrific find. He said it attracts a wide variety of people to the arts.

"Everyone comes, all sorts. Monsieur and Madame Everybody and also conaisseurs."

Lauzand welcomes all to his home, where he — and his paintings — are quite at ease in the middle of the forest.

Lauzand's studio is located at 39 Hatley Acres in North Hatley. The *Circuit des Arts Memphremagog* runs through August 6. The studios and galleries on the tour are open daily from 10-5. Flyers are available at the Mago tourist bureau and at various other locations. For more information, call (819) 843-2744 or 1-800-267-2744.

Stratford: Where to stay, where to eat & what to see

STRATFORD, ONT. — You've decided to go to Stratford this year and take in a couple of shows at Canada's premier playhouse. But you have no idea where to stay, where to eat is or what else to do while you're there.

Sit back and let me take you through some of my own Stratford Festival experiences.

Where To Stay

Most Stratford bed and breakfasts and motels can be booked right through the Stratford Festival's Accommodation Bureau. Simply call toll-free 1-800-567-1600 and tell them what you're looking for — a room with one or two beds, private or shared washroom, a bed and breakfast or a motel, etc. The courteous operators will do their best to fulfill your wishes and even reserve the room with the innkeepers for you.

If you'd like to try the bed and breakfast experience, the Avonview Manor (63 Avon St.) is a wonderful choice. It's an elegant Edwardian home with outdoor pool, hot tub and guest kitchen. Owner Gail Doupe also serves delicious full breakfasts.

If you'd prefer the privacy of a motel, you can't do much better than the Swan Motel (959 Downie St.). Twenty-four rooms overlooking spacious beautifully landscaped grounds with an outdoor pool and gazebo await you. It reminded me of the Townships

with its tranquil country setting and wheat field nearby, and it's less than five minutes from downtown. The rooms are air-conditioned and feature televisions and refrigerators. Owners Peter and Colleen Pola will help jump-start your days with coffee and delicious muffins from a Stratford bakery. Colleen is friendly and well-connected. If you need to know about the best restaurants, plays or anything else about Stratford, she'll be happy to share her knowledge with you.

If you want to forsake all luxuries and go camping in Stratford, you may set up at the Stratford Fairgrounds, call directly (519) 271-5130.

Where To Eat

We have hit upon what is perhaps my favorite subject of all — food, glorious food. And thankfully, Stratford is one tourist town that has some superb restaurants to offer visitors.

One of the most satisfying dinners I've had in three years of Stratford visits was at the Keystone Alley Café (34 Brunswick), just around the corner from the Avon Theatre. The casual elegance of the decor combined with fine food and excellent service make for an unforgettable dining experience. Chef Colin Alexander deserves standing ovations for his gastronomic creations. Try

the homemade duck liver paté served with apple-plum-brandy compote and pita points; the exquisitely tender rack of lamb; or the poached Atlantic salmon served with Jicama (Mexican vegetable) and watercress salad with an

orange saffron vinaigrette. You won't be sorry.

Bentley's (99 Ontario) is always a good choice for that English pub atmosphere. They specialize in grilled entrees, salads, pasta dishes, gourmet pizzas and burgers. The portions are generous and the atmosphere fun. It's also the place where go after their performances.

Woolfy's (127 Downie St.) is "to die for" as the saying goes. Kudos to chef Nancy Hutchison for her sublime vegetable stir-fry and Thai rice noodles with pad-thai peanut ginger sauce, wonderful seasonal soups and other irresistible temptations, including chicken Merrakesh with cinnamon couscous, Indonesian shrimp with cilantro cocounut broth or outback lamb rack with artichoke chips.

Fellini's Italian Café and Grill (107 Ontario) is the new kid on the Stratford block and has quickly become a hit among locals and visitors alike. The buzz word here is "lunch combos" and the place is usually packed as patrons try one of their numerous specials featuring stone-oven baked pizzas, pasta and panini sandwiches served with delicious soup or salad.

What To See

There are many things to see and do when you're not inside a Stratford theatre.

A fine introduction to the city itself can be had aboard a double-decker bus from England on a picturesque hour-long tour, or on an histo-

rical walking tour of Stratford. You can also rent a pedal boat or canoe and cruise down the Avon River.

Guided backstage tours of the Festival Theatre and the costume and properties warehouse offers visitors a glimpse behind the scenes.

Meet the artists and craftspeople who display and sell their work at Art in the Park of Stratford. If parks are your thing, you'll also enjoy the Stratford Festival Gardens. Spanning four acres surrounding the Festival Theatre, the garden features over 27,000 plants and flowers. There's also the English cottage-style Shakespearean Gardens, which contains roses, herbs and flowers mentioned in Shakespeare's plays.

Just six miles before Stratford, the hamlet of Shakespeare is a mecca for antique hunters and lovers of country crafts and quilts.

These are just a few of the accommodations, eateries and attractions I've discovered in Festive Stratford. Obtaining the Stratford Festival 1995 Visitors' Guide will help you embark on your own adventure at the Festival. It's a beautifully illustrated guide to all Stratford productions this year, including a city and area guide detailing accommodations, dining, shopping and attractions and excursions in the city and beyond. It also includes maps on how to get there and a city map of Stratford.

The Boy Friend a giddy, feel-good show

STRATFORD, ONT. — When most people hear the name Stratford, they immediately think of Shakespeare, yet the Stratford Festival of theatre is now almost as well-known for its musicals.

Over the past 15 years, the festival's artistic directors have delighted audiences by programming a wide variety of musical productions, including *Gypsy*, *Carousel*, *Guys & Dolls*, *Kiss Me Kate*, *My Fair Lady*, *Cabaret* and numerous mountings of *The Mikado* and *The Gondoliers*. Audience demand for these tune-filled shows is insatiable and they play to full houses time and time again.

The Boy Friend is no exception. Currently one of Stratford's biggest hits, the British three-act musical is a bright, giddy, feel-good show that goes beyond its corny dialogue and silly storyline to create fairy tale magic on the Avon Theatre stage.

There's not much to the plot; it's your typical needy-rich-girl-falls-in-love-with-lonely-poor-boy-only-to-find-out-he's-rich tale. But everything that surrounds the story is dynamite.

ENCHANTING

The curtain opens to an enchanting set that transports patrons to Mme. Dubonnet's finishing school in the French Riviera of the 1920s. The Villa Caprice is tinged in golds and ochres and bathed in a warm, inviting light.

The "perfect young ladies" at the school include heiress Polly Browne, whose father, in an effort to protect her from fortune hunters, has forbidden her to have a boyfriend. Thus, Polly invents one and even writes love letters to herself. When a handsome messenger named Tony arrives to deliver her dress for that evening's carnival ball, she immediately falls for him and invites him to the party as her date, telling him she's a secretary.

All seems heavenly until a misunderstanding at the beach breaks Polly's dream-like state. Not to worry, all is cleared up at the costume ball where "Pierrette" and "Pierrot" fess up to their white lies and declare their love.

There are also numerous sub-plots involving Tony's parents, Polly's father, Mme. Dubonnet and the young debutantes and their own boyfriends.

Though the show was written in the 1950s, playwright-composer Sandy Wilson fashioned memorable tunes that imitate the best music of the 20s, like the kind Cole Porter and Jerome Kern gave the world. The songs in *The Boy Friend* will play in your head long after you've left the theatre, including "Won't You Charles-

ton", "I Could Be Happy With You" and the title tune.

SUPERB DANCING

Even more infectious than the music is the superb dancing that's on display. As the girls pair off with their boyfriends to dance their hearts out, we are treated to some popular dances of the 20s, including the black bottom, shorty George, castle walk and the exuberant Charleston.

The luscious costumes and sets designed by Patrick Clark also evoke the glamor and the mood of the era quite well.

The Boy Friend is blessed with a fabulous cast that seem so high on life it's rather disgusting.

Ian Simpson fits the requirements of Tony to a T. Along with a wonderful singing voice, he has Hugh Grant charm and boyish good looks. Dare I say that? Unlike Grant's life of late, there is nothing unscrupulous of unseemly about this show or Simpson's performance. The Shaw Festival favorite fills his two-dimensional character well.

Patty Jamieson, on the other hand, is a sad little waif most of the time as Polly. She doesn't have as fresh a look as the other young ladies on stage even though her character is a complete innocent. Most of the guys and dolls in the show look like they just hit puberty; Jamieson seems older and rather prissy most of the time.

Danny Austin and Cara Hunter upstage Simpson and Jamieson with their cracker-jack dancing and excellent chemistry. Austin has charm to spare as Bobby, the show's "rich, good-looking American", while Hunter, in her Stratford debut, is as bubbly as champagne as Maisie, a girl who thinks "there's safety in numbers" as far as boyfriends are concerned.

HILARIOUS

There's also always someone to watch in hilarious comic character sketches in *The Boy Friend*.

Karen K. Edissi is simply wonderful as Mme. Dubonnet, the sexed-up matron of the school. The terrific comic actress also left her mark in her brief scenes as a stripper in *Gypsy* two years ago. Her flamboyant Dubonnet is a perfect counterpoint to Eric Donkin's straight-laced Percival Browne, who had an affair with Dubonnet as a young soldier in Paris. Edissi and Donkin make an enjoyable pair.

Garnering some of the biggest laughs in the show are Douglas Chamberlain and Lee MacDougall as Tony's parents Lord and Lady Brockhurst.

MacDougall, in drag, is a pure comic joy while Chamberlain is delightful as the frisky old gentleman. Chamberlain's flirtation song opposite debutante Blythe Wilson, "It's Never Too Late To Fall In Love", is charming as well as funny.

In his 16th season at Stratford, director-choreographer Brian MacDonald remains the reigning master of the musi-

cals game, having helmed *Gypsy*, *The Mikado*, the current *The Gondoliers* and countless other successes there. The former artistic director of Montreal's Les grands ballets Canadiens uses his players and his stages well.

The baton is also in the hands of a master — musical director Berthold Carrière, who won a Toronto award for

his direction of *The Boy Friend* in 1981.

Stratford has done it again with this wonderful, winning show that truly earns its standing ovations.

BITS & PIECES

Beebe Plain post office served two countries

The village of Beebe is located on the Canada-United States border in the Eastern Townships region of the province of Quebec.

Although the dividing line between Canada and the United States had been established in the early 1700s, the pioneers that settled in the Beebe Plain area in the early 1800s were far more interested in the rich farm land than in imaginary lines separating the two countries.

With granite having been discovered, it became the chief industry and most of the original homes and businesses in and around Stanstead county were constructed of the material, including what became known as the 'Old Stone Store' located in the center of Beebe Plain.

When the final surveying was done, the dust settled and the line agreed upon establishing it as being located at parallel 45.01, the international border had split the village of Beebe Plain in two and ran right through the middle of the 'Old Stone Store' which just happened to also be the post office. And so, the Old Stone Store became the first post office in the world to service two

countries with one postmaster.

OLD STONE STORE
The post office in Beebe Plain was officially established in 1864 in the old stone store that was owned by a Mr. Stewart. The first postmaster was John L. House. However, there are indications that a postal service existed prior to this era under a postmaster by the name of Mr. Grow who died in 1864.

The post office in Mr. Stewart's store was unique in that it had two separate entrances; one for U.S. citizens and one for Canadians. An iron post by the stoop served as the dividing line. There were also two separate postal counters but both were looked after by one postmaster.

John House held the position of postmaster from April 1, 1864 until his resignation on May 5, 1899. Meanwhile the post office was moved from the 'Old Stone Store' to the home of Charles Gordon in 1890. George H. House became the new postmaster in 1899 and held

the position until he was dismissed on April 11, 1912.

SOME CONFUSION
In 1907 the post office was moved to the home of a Mr. H.I. Bullock. At this point there seems to be some confusion. Historians of the area claim that Mr. Bullock became postmaster then until 1915 when the Beebe Plain and Beebe Junction offices were combined and the name changed to Beebe.

Post office records however show Porter Dixon succeeding George House as postmaster but there are no dates of appointment. The post office also lists the name changes May 1, 1909.

There's no doubt the post office amalgamated the two offices in 1909 and referred to them as Beebe. It was probably in 1915 when the towns themselves amalgamated.

Mr. Bullock probably served as postmaster from 1912 when George House was dismissed until the post office was moved to the Searle building in 1915. At that time, Mr. Porter Dixon became postmaster and occupied the post until 1933 when the post office was again moved.

tion of the Beebe Town Hall. Mr. Leon Winfred Miller was appointed postmaster on June 8, 1933 and occupied the post office until his death on January 31, 1956.

After the death of Leon Miller, Roger Langevin, a young man not yet 19 years old served as acting postmaster from February 1, 1956 until October 24 of the same year at which time Mrs. Elizabeth Miller, wife of the former postmaster Leon Miller, was appointed postmaster and served in that position until her retirement on February 5, 1966.

On February 8, three days after Mrs. Miller had officially retired, Roger Langevin, the 18-year-old who had been acting postmaster ten years earlier was appointed postmaster of the Beebe post office and held the post until recently when the post office reduced and changed its format.

In 1976 a permanent post office was erected about a two-minute walk from the original post office in the 'Old Stone Store'. Entering the town of Beebe from the east along highway 24, you can see that cars in driveways to the left bear Vermont licence plates while those on the right have Quebec plates.

A short distance away there is a stop sign and you are obliged to turn left or right. The U.S. custom house is on the south east corner of the street while Canadian Customs are on the north east corner. Directly across in between the two custom houses on the west side stands what was once the 'Old Stone Store'.

There is only one door now where there was once two. It is a private home that has been immaculately kept. The same iron post is still in place indicating the boundary line. Standing inconspicuously in its stately manner the once double post office of Beebe Plains, Quebec reminds us of the rich postal history of days gone by.

This story first appeared in the March 1995 issue of the Postal History Society of Canada Journal. It was inspired by a post card sent to me by Mr. George Buckland of Beebe.

Mrs. Elizabeth Brock, Assistant Archivist of the Colby-Curtis Museum of the Stanstead Historical Society kindly provided information as did Mr. Thomas Hillman of the National Archives of Canada, Historical research Branch.

Finally from Mr. Bernard Epps, author, historian and mentor, further information was supplied.

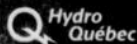

The 1995 edition of the Lancaster Fair is just around the corner, so I thought it would be worthwhile to write about the country shows they will be presenting.

Over the past few years we've had the pleasure to see shows called Country Legends which featured members of the cast of The Grand Ole Opry. Last year, the Country Legends show included Ronnie Prophet, Connie Smith and Johnny Russel. The audience enjoyed the show very much.

The show has lost none of its appeal. This year, we'll get to see Little Jimmy Dickens, Stella Parton and George Hamilton IV. True country music fans will be delighted to see these country greats perform for a glimpse at those who inspired new country artists.

Jimmy Dickens, the youngest member of a family of 13 was born in Bolt, West Virginia. His initial start in radio was at a local radio station and since he loved it, he aimed for a career in the field of entertainment.

Later, in Michigan, Roy Acuff offered "Little Jimmy" his big chance — to join The Grand Ole Opry. Dickens immediately organized his own band, which led him to where he is now. In 1964, Dickens became the first country music artist to circle the globe on a world tour.

He has a long string of record hits including: "Ole Cold Tater", "Country Boy", "A-Sleepin' At The Foot Of The Bed", "Out Behind The Barn", "I'm Just Blue Enough", "Life Turned Her That Way", "We Could" and the moving "Raggedy Ann".

Although Jimmy Dickens is small in stature, he is recognized as one of the most dynamic performers ever to grace a stage.

George Hamilton IV started with a career in the pop field, it's only in 1959 that he moved to Nashville. He was invited to join the cast of the Grand Ole Opry in 1976.

Hamilton was always an innovator and had an inquiring mind and he was eager to investigate musical rows. His hits are countless: "Abilene", "Steel Rail Blues", "Take My Hand For A While", "Canadian Pacific" and the well-known "Truck Drivin' Man".

As for Stella Parton, just about everyone knows that she is Dolly's sister. Like the rest of her family, Stella started by singing in the church choir. Parton was born in the Tennessee Mountains into a family of 12. She performs regularly at The Grand Ole Opry as well as at Dolly's theme park.

Nobody promised Lynn Anderson a "Rose Garden" but she sure got one with her number one hit, "Rose Garden". This song was written for a man to sing but Anderson got a hold of it. It climbed to the top of both country and pop charts in 1971.

Lynn got off to a good start early in life. Her dad was a music publisher, and her mom was a respected songwriter and singer. A horse lover, Lynn's first hit in 1966 was a song written by her mother, "Ride, Ride, Ride."

The North Dakota native was named Female Vocalist Of The Year by CMA in 1971. Lynn Anderson will perform on the Main Grandstand, Sunday, August 20.

knows how to spot his longtime fans in the crowd: they're wearing the "real ugly T-shirts" he once sold at concerts.

"They had a little circle thing on them that said Byrd Watcher, and a picture of me on the back that didn't come out too well," he said in a recent interview. "We only kept them about two months."

Byrd honed his style in East Texas honky-tonks and still meets with his fan clubs at every concert. His 1994 album No Ordinary Man has sold more than a million copies with such hits as "The First Step" and "Watermelon Crawl".

Take it from country crooner Sammy Kershaw: it pays to dream big.

Once he wondered if he could even earn a living as a country singer. He's thinking bigger now that he has a string of Top 10 hits under his belt.

His latest dream is to one day be inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame. In "20 or 30 years," he said.

"I made that (a) dream eight months ago," Kershaw told the (Nashville) Tennessean. "If those little dreams come true, we may as well dream the big ones."

Kershaw's greatest hits album is due out in February. His hits include "Cadillac Style" and "She Don't Know She's Beautiful."


